ToMorrow's journey to success

David and Angie Morrow, owners of ToMorrow's Therapy &

Fitness Center have served their home and community for over 17 years. One of our favorite power couples attribute success to their faith in God first and their faith in each other second. Highschool flirtations, college romance and wedding bells are just the sweet beginnings of their story. When David was called to active duty in Iraq during 2003-2004 as a U.S. Army Reserve he choose to put his psychology degree on hold. He was able to finish his studies and earn his Bachelors degree once he returned. During this time Angie was able to complete her Doctorate degree in physical therapy at UCA in Conway, Arkansas but staying in Conway for work after David returned was not the dream.

Receiving an invitation to work in her hometown, Hot Springs Village, she jumped at the chance. She worked with Rob Jordan whom had an office near the West gate and her love for the community grew even deeper. Bouncing back and forth from Conway (where they lived) to Hot Springs Village became tiredsome, though. Their oldest, Spencer, was welcomed into the family around this time and Angie decided to take a job back in Conway. The dream became much more clear. They wanted a business of their own. A business that served their family and friends (past, present and future). A business to be proud of in Hot Springs Village.

Discovering Angie's true passion and their desire to own their own business, they followed their hearts home. Angie shared "But I wasn't happy doing that (working at a rehab center in Conway). Outpatient therapy was where my heart was and I was hearing from patients in the Village. So we got a loan and we

Five short years later the business had grown so much that they needed more space. 2012 also came with constructing a brand new building to serve physical therapy needs along with a full size fitness center with access to personal trainers such as Todd Reid. Seven years later in 2019 the Villagers from the West were gifted a convenient location with a short drive from their homes. The West gate highlights physical therapy services more so but also provides lots of room for fitness classes and strength training.

Dr. Cardin Vo, PT, DPT has been a blessing to the Village with a ton of great reviews. You can find him at the East gate with assistant Corey. Dr. Angie Morrow, PT, DPT/owner holds down the fort at the West gate with assistant Jennifer. David Morrow, owner/accountant/maintanance/marketing/doer of all the things except P.T., is most likely at one location or another. "He (David) is our handyman. He's everything but a physical therapist," Angie said. "And I fill in (at the front desk) when someone is sick," added David.

Join in the Hot Springs Village Walk for Cancer Research on Saturday, Sept 28 at Balboa Pavilion.

Cancer survivor Joey Clampit is among this year's honorees. Memorial honorees are Bill Nosek and John Prince.

"How are we going to beat cancer?" the organization asks. The answer: "Research."

For more than 20 years, the Village Walk for Cancer Research has been raising funds and awareness of cancer. Money raised will go to fund cancer research and cancer-related projects in our community.

This terrible disease will impact nearly 50% of us at some point in our lives. The key to finding better treatment options and cures is through research.

Village Walk for Cancer Research's mission is to improve the lives of those with cancer.

HSV WFCR has raised \$680,000 in support of cancer research projects at University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and CHI St. Vincent.

Programs like "Seeds of Science" fund new research to understand how cancers form and grow, and find ways of eliminating them.

For those in need, HSV WFCR provides essential services and support to our communities. They believe that everyone deserves access to basic necessities such as food, shelter, and healthcare.

Help honor those fighting cancer one day at a time by registering for the 2024 Walk. Registration forms are available at KVRE, the Village Voice, Clampit's Country Kitchen, Arvest Bank near the West Gate and at RE/MAX of HSV or visit walkforccancerresearch.org for a printable registration form.

Entry is \$35, and additional donations will be accepted. Online payment may be made by credit or debit card, or via an Automated Clearinghouse, or ACH, direct bank payment.

WFCR says that no one should have to go through cancer treatments alone. Cancer treatments are expensive and take time for treatment and healing. There are many support programs to help those who might otherwise not be able to afford treatments or transportation for treatments. WFCR has provided funding to organizations including Genesis "Our Promise" Foundation and the American Cancer Society that have programs supporting cancer patients.

One of WFCR's goals is to award funds raised annually to eligible organizations through its "Hope Request" grant program. Any organization with a cancer research center or cancer-related projects in Arkansas may be eligible.

Melinda's Café and Coffee cooking up a new future

Melinda's Café & Coffee in Hot Springs Village experienced a devastating fire on January 13, 2023. However, Melinda's Café & Coffee has made a remarkable comeback, as the Phoenix rose from the ashes. This year, their Readers' Choice Award nomination is even more meaningful, reflecting their continued success and popularity.

Alanna and Daniel are food artisans who want to put their customers on notice; they serve "purposeful" food.

Daniel explains their philosophy: "We don't make chili just because we have leftover meatloaf. Everything is made with the freshest ingredients following the farm-to-table concept. Additionally, we make our soups fresh every day. We won first place last year in the People's Choice Hot Springs Soup Contest with our chicken tortilla soup."

Breakfast is served all day, and the food blog "The Mighty Rib" designated our breakfast taco as the best in Arkansas," Alanna delights in sharing. "Our breakfast Panini is so large, I can't eat it all. It's the perfect dish to share between two people."

Some new items will be added to the menu featuring lighter portions with special pricing. "Typically, all of our sandwiches contain ½ pound of meat. The "Simple Sammie" sandwiches will be smaller and at a lower price point. For instance, the hamburgers will resemble a "smash burger" style. We've also added gelato, which is different for our customers."

Melinda's Café & Coffee caters for events in and around HSV. While Alanna and Daniel typically cater to groups of 30 or more, they are willing to provide quotes for groups of almost any size. "I love catering events. I enjoy interacting with the hosts, understanding their expectations, and planning the menus. I love creating something new, flashy, and fun—something unique. We have catered for as many as 500 people and as few as two. It's so much fun," said Alanna.

The Owen crew is rarely satisfied. To better serve HSV residents, Melinda's Café & Coffee is partnering with Cork and Bottle Liquor and the Property Owner's Association to host "World of Wines" wine tastings at the Coronado Center. The evening focuses on a specific country and its wines while Alanna and Daniel provide appetizers, entrees, and desserts that complement the wine.

Alanna and Daniel were devastated when the phone rang at the Owen household in January

2023. "We wouldn't be here without the Village. This community is so unique and special. We're all tight-knit and know one another," Alanna explained.

"When the fire happened, our first thought was to move to Hot Springs." However, they soon changed their mind. "The outpouring from this community was far beyond anything I'd ever seen. We had nothing and were selling things out of a half-burned strip center. People were coming in and we were selling everything we had, just trying to figure out what we would do next. It was the most sales we'd ever had in a day."

Daniel added, "There was no power and no electricity, and they were there. One gentleman picked up a one-gallon can of green beans and gave us \$100 for a can of beans. I was in awe. So let's make this bigger and better for this community. We realized we couldn't leave; they loved us."

Melinda's Café and Coffee is open Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and Sundays from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Melinda's Café & Coffee reopen on Fridays at 4:00 p.m. for Friday Night Dinners. These are by reservation only and feature a sit-down dinner with tablecloths and plenty of good food.





Jeff Harrington opened Village True Value in 2013 (in the former Village Home Center), and immediately remodeled and expanded the store to 16,000 square feet of retail space.



















Lisa Clem nominated for Readers' Choice Woman of the Year

years and has rescued thousands of pets. Clem moved to Hot Springs Village in 2009 and opened Barkansas Pet Supply.

Lisa and staff have helped many pet owners lead their pets to healthier and longer lives. Her passion to continue rescuing lead her to start the Arkansas Chapter of FOCHP. She supports HSV Animal Welfare League, Humane Society of Garland County and Hank's Rescue. She also gets help from Waggin' Wheel and is forever grateful for them.

A recent rescue mission took her to a local dog facility with deplorable conditions that left her heart-broken and speechless. She knew two of the dogs being boarded and contacted the owners who were out of town. Lisa volunteered to take responsibility for their safety. They were bathed, medicated and put in a foster home, until the owners returned.

"If there's a problem, she'll go to great lengths to help," stated DJ Wisehart. "When I've had a problem, she is the first one I call. My dogs broke free and ran down a ravine where their leashes got tangled around a tree. I couldn't get down there and it was getting dark. I called Lisa, who rushed over (in her bathing suit cover and flip flops) and went down that ravine..... thorns, bugs and all! "

"Lisa Clem is not only an incredible asset to our community; she is an incredible human being as well!! I've watched her help so many people and so many animals in our area! After our business caught fire,

Lisa hired us to do catering at her house. But, she didn't stop there!" stated Alanna Owen. "The people she invited for a special dinner were there to make donations to our family. Can't say enough good things about her! Grateful to know her and call her friend!"

Tanya Bryant stated, "I had an exhausting week. While at Barkansas, Lisa asked me to run a card over to TLC Massage. I get there and Christian, the massage therapist, told me the card was actually for me and to open it. Lisa gave me her massage appointment. I was taken by surprise and had an hour of heavenly bliss!"

The person she seems to forget about is herself. In November 2023, after ignoring symptoms and severe pain, she was admitted to the hospital in acute kidney failure. After being discharged, in typical Lisa fashion, she insisted on stopping at Crumble to take cookies to her staff before heading home. Lisa is currently fostering 10 dogs who are waiting for their forever homes.

At this time, Lisa has 13 dogs in her home shelter. Three as personal pets and 10 are up for adoption as they have veterinary clearance and have been trained to respect people. Luckily they get plenty of exercise on her acreage lawn and puddy pool.

Lisa has personal goals to make certain boarding and grooming facilities in Hot Springs and Hot Springs Village follow all the rules of immaculate pet care.
