L.P. RESOLUTION NO. 23-331
A Resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), on Saturday, November 18, 2023, for the purpose of authorizing the renewal of a ten (10) mill tax on assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation in the Parish, for a period of ten (10) years, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating the Livingston Parish Library; and further making application to the State Bond Commission for consent and authorization to hold the aforesaid election; and further providing for other matters in connection therewith.
WHEREAS, the Parish Council of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), desires to order and call a special election to be held in the Parish on SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2023, to authorize the renewal of the levy and collection of a ten (10) mill ad valorem tax for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2025 and ending with the year 2034 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating the Livingston Parish Library (the "Tax"); and
BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Authority, that:
1. Election Call. Subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 26(B) of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, by Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (the "Election Code"), particularly Chapters 5 and 6A thereof, and by other constitutional and statutory authority supplemental thereto, a special proposition election (the "Election") is hereby called and ordered to be held in the Parish, on SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. in compliance with the provisions of Section 541 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (L.A. R.S. 18:541), and that at the Election there will be submitted to all registered voters residing in the Parish, qualified and entitled to vote at the Election under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to wit:
PROPOSITION
(TAX RENEWAL)
Shall the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), renew the levy of a special tax of ten (10) mills on all property subject to taxation in the Parish (an estimated \$6,841,406.58

Pursuant to the provisions of the Act, the District is authorized to finance, fund, plan, establish, acquire, construct or reconstruct, enlarge, extend, equip, operate and maintain systems, facilities and basic infrastructure (the "District Infrastructure") for the following: (1) water management and control for the lands within the District, including the connection of some or any of such facilities with roads and bridges; (2) water supply; sewer and wastewater management, reclamation, and reuse, or any combination thereof, (3) bridges or culverts that may be needed across any drain, ditch, canal, floodway, holding basin, excavation, public highway, tract, grade, fill or cut and roadways over levees and embankments; and (4) street lights, roads and streets within the District equal to or exceeding the specifications of the Parish of Livingston, Louisiana (the "Parish"); and

In accordance with La. R.S. 33:9039.29(B), the District is further authorized to levy and collect maintenance special assessments ("Maintenance Assessments"), to maintain and preserve the District Infrastructure and facilities located within the District; and

Ordinance 2023-03

The Maintenance Assessments shall be levied against all assessable lots or parcels of immovable property situated within the District, as indicated on the Parish tax rolls (the "Assessable Property"), and as more fully described in Schedule 1 attached hereto; and

Pursuant to a duly noticed public hearing held on even date herewith, the Board now desires to determine, adopt, order and levy the Maintenance Assessments for fiscal year 2023-2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Carter Plantation Community Development District, Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority thereof, that:

Section 1. Levy of Maintenance Assessments. Pursuant to the provisions of the Act, particularly La. R.S. 33:9039.29(B), this Board hereby determines, adopts, orders and levies the Maintenance Assessments upon the immovable property in the amounts set forth on attached Schedule 1 for fiscal year 2023-2024. The Maintenance Assessments hereby levied shall constitute a lien and privilege on the properties hereby assessed (the "Assessable Properties") until paid in full, and shall be on a parity with the lien of state, parish, municipal, and school board taxes. Immediately following the adoption of this Ordinance, the Board shall certify said Maintenance Assessments to the Livingston Parish Assessor who shall enter same on the tax rolls of the Parish.

Section 2. Collection/Enforcement. Collection of the Maintenance Assessments levied herewith shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law, particularly the provisions of Sections 9039.29(C) and 9039.30 of the Act, providing for the collection of the Maintenance Assessments and enforcement of the lien against the Assessed Properties by the Livingston Parish Sheriff's Office, as tax collector.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or ineffective for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being expressly hereby found and determined that the remainder of this Ordinance would have been adopted despite the invalidity or ineffectiveness of such section, paragraph, clause or provision.

Section 4. Publication. Having been adopted hereby, this Ordinance shall be published in full in one (1) issue of the Livingston Parish News, a weekly newspaper of general circulation within and the official journal of the Parish.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and any provisions of any previous ordinances or resolutions in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby superseded.

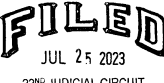
