

The singer/songwriter's musical background started at a young age playing piano and sketching out song ideas. It wasn't long before he picked up his brother's guitar and had a creative connection with playing and singing. "I would hear melodies, choruses, and song inspirations in my head. I then felt compelled to create and put my thoughts and sounds into a song format," remembered Shane. Learning to play guitar by ear he soon found himself starting a rock band with friends from school and practicing to play a few club shows and house parties.

As an emerging regional talent, the young singer/songwriter self-released his first solo album in 1998, entitled "Moody Waters". This six song acoustic e.p. featured the song "She Could Cry in Heaven", which appeared on the television show "The Young and the Restless". From 2000 - 2003 Shane fronted the group "Faith Nation". In 2005 Martin released his sophomore solo poject entitled "Thread", co-produced and recorded with Levi Seacer from Prince's The New Power Generation, featuring the fan favorite "It's Alright" and the song "White Fences" that was featured on the sound track of a Michael Wilson documentary.

Martin's 2010 release "REWIND" was recorded in Nashville with EMMY award winning engineer/producer Kenny Royster. Shane states "I finally found my sound and writing style and started to dig deep into my songs getting back to my small south". Martin states "We've had an Alatown roots and experiences. Dennison Lions Club - Service to Dennison & the Surrounding Area



What is The Dennison Lions Club?

The Dennison Lions Club was started in Dennison Minnesota around 1977 by a group of local business

owners, farmers and individuals from Dennison and the surrounding area. Local Lions clubs, like the one in Dennison are part of the larger Organization of Lions International. A Service Organization. You can learn more on line at www.lionsclubs.org Many times, in smaller towns, like Dennison, the Clubs serve not only as a service club supporting activities in the community, but also like the "chamber" to help promote events and businesses in the community. Other area clubs can be found supporting their hometowns in Goodhue, Wanamingo, Kenyon, West Concord, Mazeppa, Zumbrota, Northfield and more.

Lions Clubs international is the largest membership-based service organization in the world. With 1.4 million members in more than 49,000 clubs and serving in over 200 countries and geographic areas. Since 1917 Lions clubs have improved health and well-being, strengthened communities and supported those in need locally, regionally, nationally and globally. The Lions Clubs international motto is "we serve".

Lions clubs act as the local or regional civic organization in many small medium and larger communities all over the United States and the world. Lions International represents both the Lions Clubs International and the Lions Clubs International Foundation. The Lions Club International Foundation is the global foundation supporting the 1.4 million members of Lions Clubs through grant funds that expand their works and empower service at home and around the world. Since its founding in 1968, the foundation has awarded more than 19,000 grants totaling more than \$1.2 billion.

Locally, The Dennison Lions Club and its members work to support the Dennison area in a variety of ways. This includes awarding scholarships each year to area graduating students or making donations to families and individuals that may be experiencing a medical emergency or financial hardship. In addition to local contributions, the club supports area school activities like class field trips that help further student education. The Dennison club supports several of the larger programs Lions International works on like Lions Eye Bank program and The Leader Dog program, and also provide support to other area Non-profit groups, schools and activities that benefit the area and its residents.

The club has continually worked to support the city park in Dennison, helping get new equipment in the park for several years ago. The club also supports area fire departments and first responders, including the Nerstrand Volunteer Fire Department, which not only provides fire protection to Nerstrand, but also the City of Dennison, area townships, and mutual aid to surrounding fire departments. The club made contributions to help expand the Nerstrand Fire Department to include keeping an additional truck in Dennison and add equipment back into the Dennison Fire Hall on Main Street.

Other local community events and activities the club supports is the annual Dennison Days Festival in August, The Halloween Pizza and Game Party at City Hall, Thanksgiving Turkey Bingo, Christmas with Santa and Christmas Sharing, The Flake Out Festival (The Clubs winter community event in February) and annual Spring breakfast.

All of these activities, in addition to the club's charitable gambling location at Fireside Lounge in Dennison, help raise funds to support these activities all year round. The club generally meets monthly to take care of the business of the club and plan events and activities in the town and the area.

The members acknowledge it can be a challenge to get new members to step up and be a part of this important community organization, but for the club to survive and continue doing this important

hometown work, the Dennison Lions Club is always looking for local volunteers. The club understands everybody can't always make a monthly meeting, nor do you need to. Some members come in and help a couple times a year with various events but still stay a part of the club, community and what the lions' clubs stand for. 
1957 Organizing Youth Programs



Dennison, MN: A Brief History

In the coming months, the Messenger will be looking into our areas history and small towns from their beginnings to present day. As we celebrate Dennison Days 2024, we look back at a few historical photos of buildings around the city.

Morris Denison was an early settler on the land now known as the village of Dennison. According to historical accounts, originally from Vermont, Morris P Dennison arrived in Minnesota in 1849 and brought his family to the area in 1856. He built a log house and what later became the center of the village. While the railroad line was being built in 1884, the village was platted as spring Creek, then later given the name Dennison. In 1885 the The Chicago Great Western railroad connected towns in southern Minnesota with markets from Saint Paul to Chicago. Dennison was incorporated as a village

By the turn of the century, Dennison was a fair-sized town with nearly 200 people, overwhelmingly of Scandinavian descent. The town boasted a school three general stores, a hardware store, a bank, a Barber shop, two blacksmiths, a

Creamery, a Methodist and Lutheran Church, a lumberyard and cafe. The town was also home to a post office at that time with two rural routes. Dennison maintained a population of around 200 thru much of the 20th century. Dennison was also home to Albert H Quie, the state of Minnesota's 35th governor from 1979 to 1983. Quie was born on a farm

meat market, the farmers elevator, a outside of Dennison, attended Saint Olaf college and graduated with a degree in political science. 30 years after his tenure as the governor. Quie was honored again here in his home town of Denison, in 2006 Congress voted designate the post office on main street in Dennison the Albert H Quie post office.

Though a relatively small gesture, the post office shall forever bear his name. Quie passed away in 2023.

Dennison today is considered a bedroom community by most accounts, however, continues to serve its residents, with the bank, post office, convenience store, meat market, auto and truck repair shop, plumbing shop, several cabinet shops, several eating establishments, church, The Lions Club community non-profit, along with a small, but growing commercial business area east of town. 




