Heavenly minded prayers

Be sure that you are asking God for what's most important in your life and the lives of those you love.

Then they would have strength to persevere and be good witnesses during difficult times. Take steps now to make your prayer life more heavenly minded than earth-bound.

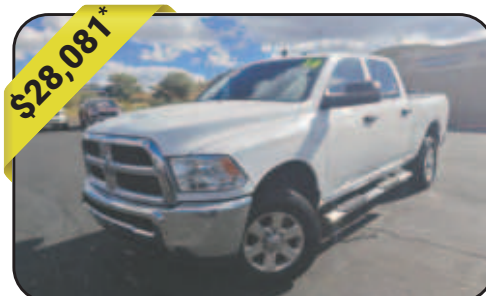
