## Arizona Forestry implementing Stage 1 Fire Restrictions to State trust lands in central Arizona

## Webb graduates with honors

**Phoenix, AZ** – Increasing fire activity coupled with warm temperatures and dry conditions prompt the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management (DFFM) to implement Stage 1 fire restrictions on State Trust lands within some areas of Central Arizona.

Starting Thursday, May 23, 2024, at 8:00 am, Stage 1 fire restrictions go into effect on State Trust lands within Gila, Maricopa, and Pinal Counties. DFFM fire managers report an uptick in fire activity in these areas and believe restrictions are necessary at this time for public and firefighter safety. DFFM along with federal and

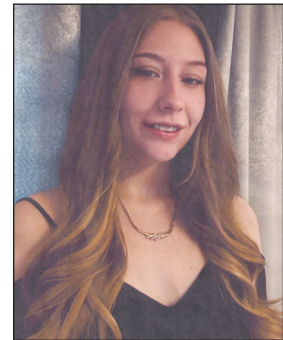
tribal cooperators continue to evaluate restrictions for other parts of the state on a weekly basis. Restrictions remain in effect until rescinded. Restrictions apply to the following state-owned and

lands within the above-mentioned counties including: State Trust lands outside incorporated municipalities. All Game and Fish Commission Wildlife areas and department

properties outside incorporated municipalities. All State Parks outside incorporated municipalities – State Parks will remain open with fire restrictions in place. Please refer to <https://azstateparks.com/fire-safety/> – for park-specific fire restriction information. All Department of Transportation highway, right-of-way property outside incorporated municipalities, not owned by federal land management agencies. Restrictions include: Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, charcoal, coal, or wood

stove, other than in a developed campsite or picnic area is prohibited. Exemptions include, a device solely fueled by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off. Such devices can only be used in an area that is barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding flammable materials within three feet of the device.

- Smoking is prohibited unless it is within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site/improved site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barred or cleared of all flammable materials.

- Fireworks or another incendiary device are prohibited.

- Welding or operating acetylene or other torch devices with an open flame is prohibited.

Exemptions include:

- Any federal, state or local law enforcement officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting organization in the performance of an official duty.

- All land within a city boundary is exempt unless otherwise stated in a city ordinance.

The State Forester must approve all exemptions to restrictions. If local authorities have imposed stronger restrictions than those listed above, the local restrictions shall apply. These restrictions apply to all permit and leaseholders and other authorized users of state-managed lands. Restrictions do not apply to private lands under ARS § 37-1303.

These restrictions went into effect Thursday, May 23, 2024, at 8:00 am, and will continue until rescinded.

## Plan for daytime lane closures and delays on US 60 between Superior and Miami May 29

The Arizona Department of Transportation advises drivers to plan for the following lane closures on US 60 between Superior and Miami during daylight hours on Wednesday, May 29, for construction activities related to the US 60, Queen Creek and Waterfall Canyon Bridges replacement project:

- US 60 between Superior and Miami, mileposts 227-231, will be intermittently reduced to one lane only with alternating east- and westbound travel.

- o On-site flaggers and a pilot car will assist drivers through the work zone.

- o Drivers should be prepared to stop when approaching and proceeding through the flagging operation.

- o Expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Motorist should plan for:

- Lane restrictions and speed reductions in the work zone.

- A 12-foot vehicle width restriction will be in place. Oversize loads may be accommodated with advance notice.

Full closures of US 60, when required, will occur from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays through November.

# Learning to pause

*When anger flares, stop to ask for God's wisdom.*

How do you respond when someone mistreats you? Are you quick to judge that person, cataloging all the reasons you didn't deserve to be treated so unfairly? That was David's initial response when the fair treatment he expected was denied.

David, while still on the run from Saul, sent men from his army to request provisions from Nabal, a rich man in the area. David felt sure Nabal would look favorably on him and meet the needs of

his army. Not only would that have been customary, but David had also earned the favor by protecting Nabal's flocks. Yet the request, though reasonable, was scornfully rejected.

When we feel spurned, mistreated, or unappreciated, it can cause us to respond in a way that only makes the situation worse. In David's case, his anger flared and he set out for revenge. But before he and his 400 warriors could make it to their destination, Nabal's

wife Abigail intercepted them, falling on her face to apologize for her husband's behavior and to reason with David.

In that moment, David had a choice to make. He could either charge right past her, fueled by his own rage and need for justice, or he could pause (James 1:19). God gave him the wisdom to make the better choice. The next time anger erupts in your heart, will you follow David's example and stop to listen to wisdom?
