
## **Exploring the Sierra Ancha Cliff Dwellings at Bullion** Plaza's 2nd Friday



## Mobile pet clinic coming to Miami


Gila County Animal Care & Control reminds dog owners that an upto-date rabies vaccine is required for your dog to be licensed - and that annual Gila County dog license is required by law. A license is also essential to prove ownership if your stray dog ends up at the shelter. Are your pets microchipped? If they aren't, consider this: only 22 percent of lost dogs without a microchip get reunited with the anxious owners who love them, and that number drops to just two percent for stray cats. Lowcost vaccines, preventative care, microchipping

and even nail trimming are all available when Pet-Vet mobile clinics visit the Tractor Supply store one Sunday afternoon each month: Sept. 15, Oct. 13 and Nov. 10, from 2:30 – 4 p.m.

Did you know there's a snakebite vaccine that can help dogs survive being bitten by a rattler? Pretreatment with the snakebite vaccine also reduces a pet's pain and suffering - and dramatically reduces the overall cost of treatment if bitten, too.

## Why You Don't Want a God You Can Completely Understand

Perhaps a better question would be: why would you want a God you could completely understand? This seems to be the goal of many people. Before they are willing to trust God, they want to be able to understand Him. But why? Is it to feel equal to God? So that His decisions, actions, and purpose become more palatable? Or perhaps it is so they can approve of God.

Whatever the reason, if you could understand everything about God, who God is, why He does what He does, then wouldn't you be God? In the book of Isaiah, God said:

Isaiah 55:8-9 – For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

According to these verses, God's thoughts, God's methods are way beyond our own comprehension. Some people struggle with that. They want a God created in man's image instead of

man created in God's image. Another passage of Scripture that jumps out at me is:

#### 1 Corinthians 1:27-29

- But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence.

There you have it. No one can ever say, "I have God all figured out." It's just not possible and why would you want it to be? Why would you want a God that is no larger than your capacity to understand?

I believe in a God and a Savior that is vastly larger than my ability to comprehend and to fully imagine. I thank God that He is larger than my finite ability to comprehend. I thank God that He is vastly larger than anything I can imagine.

Let's be blunt: You don't want a small God!

There is no way that I would want a God who can be contained within the confines of my own

brain and imagination. I don't want to find an end to my God or my Savior, Jesus Christ. And I don't want a God that can be quantified, digested, and distilled in the confines of man's inventions, imaginations, or even sermons.

I want a God I am always learning about, who can make me awestruck at any time, any place, and in any way. When I pray, I want my prayer to be heard by a God who is not limited to what I imagine is possible—or even to what I think needs to be done. I want the God of infinite might and ability. I want the God of the Bible.

If God is so much larger than my imagination, then my prayers and faith connect to something so vast and so awesome that my limited understanding constantly fails to articulate it. It means that I don't need to understand God to have a relationship with Him... which means that all I really need to understand is that I can have a relationship with Him. Give me that relationship any






