## Deadline for County Fair entries Sept. 18: From apples to zucchini

Have you entered your blue-ribbon apples or best-in-show zucchini to be judged amongst other competitors in our community's annual Gila County Fair?

Sept. 18 is the deadline, and you can enter online at [gilacountyfair.com](http://gilacountyfair.com), or in person at the Globe-Miami Chamber of Commerce from 12 – 7 p.m. That's for entry forms -- you'll deliver your actual entries to the Gila County Fairgrounds exhibit hall Sept. 21, and the fair runs from Sept. 25-28.

Gardeners: you can enter fruits and veggies literally 'from A-to-Z' if you grew superb apples, zucchini, or just about any horticultural category in between – and yes, even unusual varieties such as quince, Jerusalem artichokes, kohlrabi or elephant garlic. Homemaking Arts is another competition

area; if you've sewn a unique garment, crib blanket, costume, onesie, or fashion accessory – enter yours for a shot at Best In Show! Bakers are invited to submit bread entries ranging from white and whole wheat to sourdough, banana, zucchini, coffee cake – or a dozen other entry options. Cakes, pies and cookies, too.

Do your homemade tamales score rave reviews from friends and family? 'Mexican Cookery' classes in the fair include tortillas, frijoles, sopapillas, tamales and hot sauce. Winemakers are encouraged to enter their zinfandel, malbec, sangiovese, tempranillo or pinot noir. Beer categories range from ales, lagers and porters to "spontaneous fermenting amber."

Canning competitors include pickles, vegetables, jellies,

jam, butter, marmalade – and even meat, poultry or fish. 'Photography' has divisions for youth, adult and age 75+; with a separate class for pros – and no less than 45 categories for subject matter from 'abstract' to 'wildlife.' Ques-

## Mobile pet clinic coming to Miami Sept. 15

Gila County Animal Care & Control reminds dog owners that an up-to-date rabies vaccine is required for your dog to be licensed - and that annual Gila County dog license is required by law. A license is also essential to prove ownership if your stray dog ends up at the shelter. Are your pets microchipped? If they aren't, consider this: only 22 percent of lost dogs without a microchip get reunited with the anxious owners who love them, and

that number drops to just two percent for stray cats. Low-cost vaccines, preventative care, microchipping and even nail trimming are all available when PetVet mobile clinics visit the Tractor Supply store one Sunday afternoon each month: Sept. 15, Oct. 13 and Nov. 10, from 2:30 - 4 p.m.

Did you know there's a snakebite vaccine that can help dogs survive being bitten by a rattler? Pre-treatment with the snakebite vac-

cine also reduces a pet's pain and suffering - and dramatically reduces the overall cost of treatment if bitten, too.

No appointments are needed but call PetVet Mobile Clinic staff at 800-427-7973 if you have questions about vaccines or specific services when their mobile clinic sets up outside the Tractor Supply store in the Cobre Valley Plaza at 2260 W. 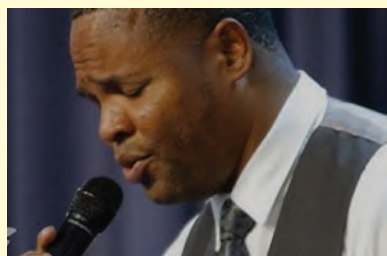

## Cheryl Richards

Services for Cheryl Richards, 78, formerly of Globe, will be held at Whitney & Murphy Funeral Home on Indian School Road in Phoenix at 11 a.m. on September 14. Cheryl passed away in Mesa on 8-2-2024 from complications of Alzheimer's. A proud Globe native, Cheryl's family first arrived in Arizona in 1913 when her German-born great-grandfather, an employee of ASARCO in Mexico, got work at the smelter facility in Winkelman after leaving Mexico due to Pancho Villa's attacks on the company's facilities dur-

ing the Revolution. Her Mexico-born grandmother later settled in Globe, residing in a bungalow on US 60 near East Globe School until her death in the 1980s. Cheryl grew up in Miami Gardens with many of her cousins before the family moved to a ranch at Dripping Springs. While attending Globe High School, Cheryl was active in music and drama. After graduating from Arizona State University with an education degree and completing her student teaching hours in a one-room schoolhouse near the Mexican border,

she married and briefly lived the life of an Army spouse before returning to Arizona.

Settling back in Globe to raise her family, Cheryl began a thirty-year teaching career with the Globe School District. She taught math at East Globe, music and elementary grades at Copper Rim and, finally, English at Globe High School after she had "retired." The opportunity to teach the same kids in high school that she had taught at Copper Rim brought her great joy. Other professional highlights included be-

ing awarded Gila County Teacher of the Year in the 1990s and serving as a Representative and the Treasurer for the Arizona Education Association in the 1980s. Cheryl was active in Eastern Star in the early 1980s, in the restoration of Besh-Bagowah in the late 1980s, as an actress and director with the theater at the Cobre Valley Center for the Arts in the 1990s and 2000s, and as choir director at Holy Angels Catholic Church in the 2000s. Later in life she enjoyed traveling, first to Italy and later, cruises.

Cheryl was briefly survived by her second husband, James Richards, before he joined her in peaceful rest on 8-25-2024. She is survived by her brother John Frazier, her children Shannon (Lou) Pontigon, Ryan Ferland, and Sara Ferland, and three grandchildren. Her parents Bert and Ida Frazier and her sister Carol Carl preceded her in death.

## James (Jim) Richards

Services for James (Jim) Richards, 88, formerly of Globe, will be held at Whitney & Murphy Funeral Home on Indian School Road in Phoenix at 11 a.m. on September 14. Jim passed away in Phoenix on 8-25-2024 from pneumonia. He was born prematurely in Chicago on 8-12-1936 and the picaresque tales of his early childhood are from a world long gone...sledding down coal heaps in the winter, stealing random boxes off trucks to find pineapples or girdles or other unfamiliar items inside, riding freight cars to a wartime Ford plant and sitting in a cockpit of a naval plane still under construction, hanging on the outside of streetcars, and with his hands holding onto a passing car's bumper while letting his feet slide on the ice.

Fortunate encounters with supportive teachers in high school led him to Eastern Illinois University, which recruited him for both wrestling and football

(he passed on the football once on campus) and where he studied physical education and business. He joined the US Army before graduating and spent nearly three years in West Germany with a mobile hospital unit in support of the Berlin Crisis that led to the construction of the Berlin Wall. Taking advantage of the G.I. Bill, Jim finished his degree at EIU upon his honorable discharge from service. After a short sales career in the Midwest and the South, he settled in Globe as a teacher and later school administrator after obtaining his master's at Northern Arizona University. In the course of his thirty-year career he was a teacher, a vice principal, a wrestling coach, a DECA club sponsor, and above all, a mentor.

His legacy lies not in his formal professional highlights but in his impact on his children and students. For as long as he lived in Globe, people would stop by the house, ask him for a hug, and say, "Everything I am, I owe to this man." He believed in his kids and they knew it.

Jim Richards is survived by his brother Chuck Richards, his children Shannon (Lou) Pontigon, Ryan Ferland, and Sara Ferland, and three grandchildren. His wife Cheryl, his parents Charles and Lucille, and his brothers, Bobby Richards and Jerry Richards, preceded him in death

## Is It Possible to Forgive and to Forget?

We've heard it said often that we need to forgive and forget. What a wonderful thing it would be if we could actually forget the wrongs done to us! Wouldn't it be great if by forgetting, we could erase all the pain, all the worry, all the stress, and all the negative emotions from the wrong? I know I'd love that. And if there is a magical formula somewhere on how to do it, I certainly would want to know about it. Life would be easier if we could forgive and then forget.

### CAN YOU FORGET?

I've counseled people for over three decades as of this writing, and in that time, I've learned that people remember more easily the wrongs done to them more than the good things. For example, someone could smile and say, "Hi!", to you six out of seven days in a week, but that one day where they turn their eyes away, frown, sniff maybe, and hasten off, you say to yourself, "What a jerk! What's his problem?"

That is just human nature, I guess. We have a very hard time forgetting the things that are done to us. In marital counseling, you'd be surprised how many times someone dredges up something that happened ten or twenty years ago. When we are hurt, we can only see and feel the pain. All the good that a person does is hastily erased by one thing they do wrong that injures us.

It's unfortunate, but true. I think only God can truly forget. We can't. You'll never forget the wrongs done to you, so forgetting them is out of the question. That doesn't mean, however, that we can't heal from these injuries, where the pain no longer dominates our lives.

### FORGIVENESS ISN'T ABOUT FORGETTING

With that being said, forgiveness isn't about forgetting. To truly forgive someone, you won't be expected to just forget it. You may have the strength not to be offended by it; you may have the ability to shove it aside or to bury it deep in your subconscious. But it is still there, still rattling around in your head somewhere.

Forgiveness is about releasing your pain, anger, and the bitterness that comes with being hurt or injured. You forgive more for your own sake than you forgive for the sake of the person who hurt you. Consider the following Scripture:

Ephesians 4:31-32 – Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

But don't mistake forgiveness for trust. If someone steals ten dollars of mine, I would forgive him so that I don't walk around with a chip on my shoulder or bitterness in my heart.

That doesn't mean that I'll trust him with any more money. I may start out with a quarter, but definitely not with another ten dollars.

Forgiveness does mean that you give the person opportunity to redeem himself if he has a desire to do so. It doesn't mean that you have to trust him. Trust is earned. When you forgive someone, you give them an opportunity to earn that trust back.

Forgiveness also means that you won't carry a grudge. If you forgive someone, you don't thrust them away, slander them, or attempt to harm them in any way. If they come back to you, seeking forgiveness, you need to find some way to allow them to begin to earn your trust back. That is forgiveness (Colossians 3:13).

### C O N C L U D I N G THOUGHTS

Let's say the person who stole my ten dollars returns and says, "I'm so sorry. What I did was wrong. I want to make amends. I'll pay you back, I promise. Will you forgive me?" At this point, my forgiveness allows him to make amends. It even means that I'll give him an opportunity to earn my trust back. I'll lend him a quarter and see what he does with it. I'll let him pay me back. And I'll interact with him again. I still won't give him ten dollars. That might be a long way off. He has to earn my trust. I haven't forgotten what he did, but I have forgiven him.

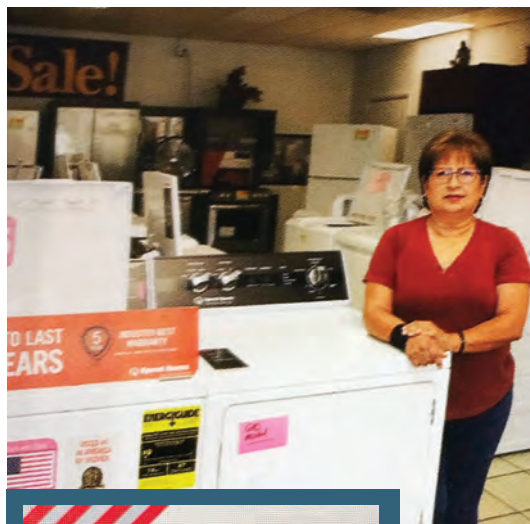

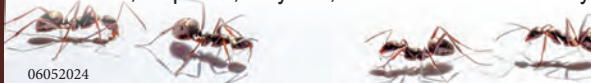

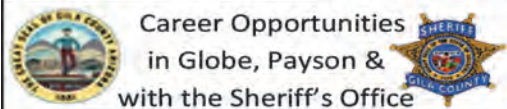
