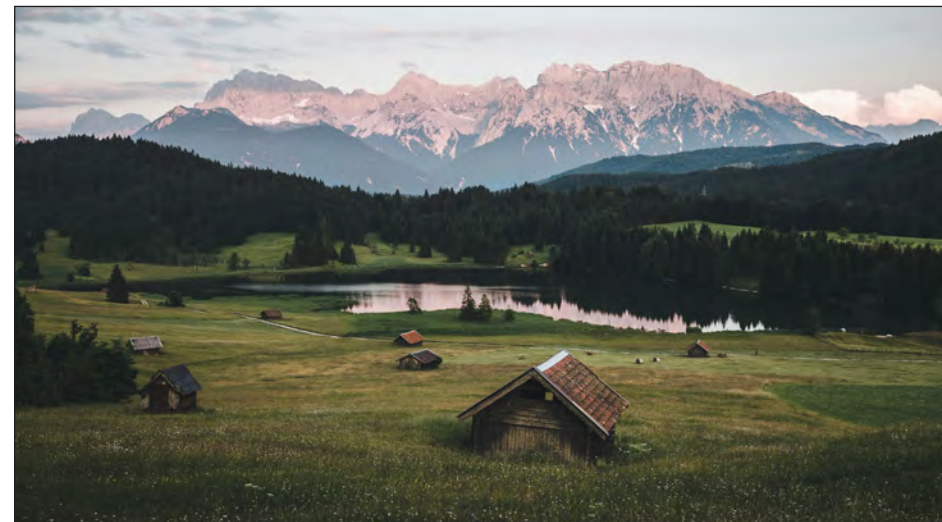
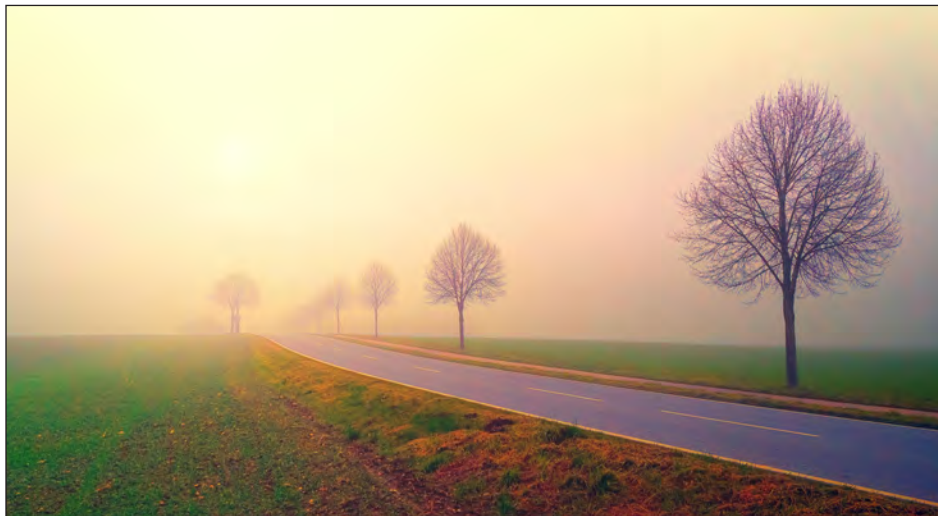
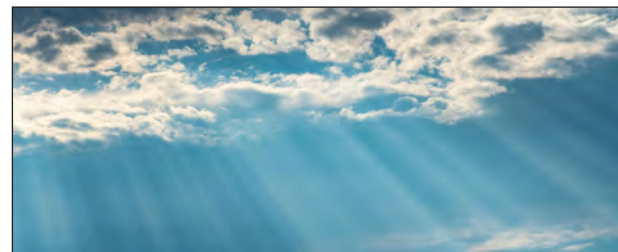
Joshua graduated from Globe High School in Globe, Arizona.

Now that we are in the new year, many of you may have decided to make New Year's Resolutions in an attempt to improve this year over last year. I applaud you. We should always be striving to improve.

GOD LOVES NEW BEGINNINGS

Throughout the Bible, we see that God loves fresh starts. When the Children of Israel first left Egypt, God told them to make that month the first month of the year (Exodus 12:1-2). This was to be a new beginning for them, a fresh start, so God made that month the first month of the year to confirm this new beginning.

People in the Bible, such as Peter, Paul, David, Moses, and many others all had fresh starts at some point in their lives. They turned over a new leaf and forged ahead, sometimes redefining themselves in the process. God always encouraged this and blessed it.

And the beginning of this year should be no excep-

Most growth comes when you can successfully add a good habit to your life. Habits can take time to form. They don't happen in a day, so keep doing them until they do become a habit.

When I set goals of growth for my life, I don't aim for perfection. I aim for habit-forming repetition. I always fail to be perfect, but I can always make the next day the first day again! And press onward.

That which isn't growing is dying. Two years ago, as a 48-year-old man, I took the challenge to learn the cello. My entire musical background and experience was playing the radio on occasion. I had to learn everything. I had nothing to draw on or fall back on to aid me in this. But I didn't want my life to grow stale. I wanted to continue moving upward, forward, and onward. Have I failed in my cello learning? Practically every day. But I am also improving and growing and getting better.

That is the goal.

GLOBE, AZ – Cobre Valley Regional Medical Center (CVRMC) is excited to announce the future opening of its much-anticipated “Highway 60 Clinic,” a walk-in clinic located near Cal Ranch and Walmart. This new facility is set to provide essential healthcare services to the community, offering a convenient option for those seeking immediate medical attention without the need for an appointment.

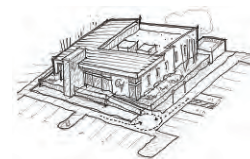
The journey to establish the Highway 60 Clinic has not been without challenges. The initial plans for the clinic encountered an unexpected delay when it was discovered that the proposed location fell within a designated floodway.

Determined to bring this vital service to the community, CVRMC worked with local and federal agencies to reassess the flood maps that impacted the clinic’s location. Through extensive modeling, updated maps were drawn to better reflect the actual conditions of the area. CVRMC then submitted a request for a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), requesting an official change to the flood designation.

On July 29, FEMA issued a LOMR, paving the way for the new clinic. The new facility will offer extend hours to walk-in patients, providing a convenient, affordable option for healthcare services. While the specific timeline for construction and opening is still being finalized, the team is working diligently to bring the project to completion as swiftly as possible.

CVRMC is committed to keeping the community informed as progress continues. Updates on the clinic’s development will be shared regularly, with a focus on ensuring that residents are aware of the new healthcare options that will soon be available.

The opening of the Highway 60 Clinic represents a significant step forward in CVRMC’s mission to provide comprehensive, accessible healthcare to the region. The medical center looks forward to welcoming patients to this new facility and continuing its tradition of high-quality care for the community.

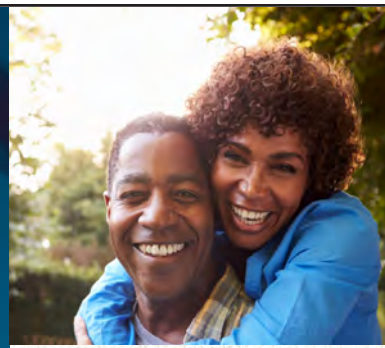
