

Discover National Park Week at Tonto National Monument

Every year, National Park Week celebrates the beauty and significance of America's national parks, offering a variety of events and activities across more than 400 parks around the country. This year's celebration will run from Saturday, April 19, to Sunday, April 27.

The first National Park Week, designated by President George W. Bush, celebrated the National Park's 75th anniversary in 1991. It has since evolved into an opportunity for parks to educate the public about environmental stewardship, encourage people to visit these protected areas and raise awareness of the National Park Service's vital role in protecting natural

and cultural heritage across the country. It's a chance for local communities to build


connections with their local park, highlighting the value of the park and encouraging visitation that can positively impact the local economies of communities surrounding them.

Tonto National Monument is part of this week-long celebration and will join all

parks in building public engagement by encouraging people of all backgrounds to visit the park on Saturday, April 19, for a fee-free day. That day, all fees charged to hike the Lower Cliff Dwelling trail and fees charged to those with reservations on Upper Cliff Dwelling tours will be waived.

Tonto National Monument commemorates National Park Week with various programs and events designed to connect visitors to the cultural and natural significance of the park. To kick off the week on Saturday, April 19, at 1 pm, a presentation by Will Moore, a local historian, on "Who Found this Place?" offers a history of Tonto National Monument. The park continues its celebrations on Sunday, April



The new Upper Pinal Creek Bridge (AKA Connie's Bridge Replacement) and Hill Street Corridor projects are nearing completion.

A ribbon cutting ceremony is scheduled for April 3, 2025, 2:00 pm and members of the public are invited to attend!

Following the ceremony, the new bridge will be opened to traffic. The new intersection will be a 2-way stop condition as shown below. East and West bound traffic on Broad Street and Walliman Road will have to stop. North and South bound traffic on Hill Street and Jesse Haves Road will be free flowing. Transferring Your Values To Your Children

"Praise the Lord! I found One!"

These were the words spoken by my 5-year-old and my 3-year-old as they rummaged through a toy box looking for legos. They are much older now, but it is my joy to hear them still speak of God, the Bible, and their walk with God. In a society and generation where God takes a back seat to political correctness and social humanism, it is refreshing to hear children reference God with such eager excitement.

Some may raise the cry of "brainwashed." but I care not. My children are incredibly happy and excited about life, especially now that they are entering adulthood. If that is brainwashing, so be it. It disturbs me that parents today shy from instilling solid values, even Christian values, into their children—as if cultivating a mentality of morality, decency, honor, and spirituality is a bad thing.

The world teaches us that we need to allow our children to go their own way, to become their own person, but that implies that such an end result will always be a good thing and parental interference a bad thing. That's absurd. The Bible clearly warns that a child left to himself will naturally and invariably bring shame (Proverbs 29:15).

Here are some things you might want to consider:

TAKE THE TIME TO TEACH YOUR CHILDREN VALUES

When my children were little, I would often, just before bed, took a value that was important to me and taught it to my children. We used the Bible. And I used anything else that helped. One particular value I recall well was teaching them what "considerate" meant. Don't just assume they will get it. Teach them! Show them! Practice with them!

TAKE LIFE CIRCUM-STANCES TO TEACH YOUR CHILDREN VALUES

I love chess. So, naturally, taught my children to play. But I made it into a learning experience for them. As I taught them the lessons of chess, I also taught them the lessons of life. For example, watching one son play against his brother, he had an overwhelming major piece superior-

ity. So what did he do with this advantage? He started gobbling up all the loose pawns on the board. He didn't even think about checkmate and started making mistakes because of his greed! I pointed the problem out to him and taught him a life lesson.

These lessons are ongoing. People often call them "teaching moments." Take advantage of those moments, no matter where or when they come (Deuteronomy 6:7).

LIVE BY YOUR OWN VAL-UES

The right example is the best example. Teaching your children values is wonderful, but they may end up following what you do, not what you say. Do your best to follow your own values. Live them. Allow your children to see how following those values benefits you and them. Show them the importance of the values you hold!

And when you are older, you may be able to agree wholeheartedly what John wrote:

3 John 1:4 — I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

GLOBE, AZ – Cobre Valley Regional Medical Center (CVRMC) is excited to announce the future opening of its much-anticipated "Highway 60 Clinic," a walk-in clinic located near Cal Ranch and Walmart. This new facility is set to provide essential healthcare services to the community, offering a convenient option for those seeking immediate medical attention without the need for an appointment.

The journey to establish the Highway 60 Clinic has not been without challenges. The initial plans for the clinic encountered an unexpected delay when it was discovered that the proposed location fell within a designated floodway.

On July 29, FEMA issued a LOMR, paving the way for the new clinic. The new facility will offer extend hours to walk-in patients, providing a convenient, affordable option for healthcare services. While the specific timeline for construction and opening is still being finalized, the team is working diligently to bring the project to completion as swiftly as possible.

CVRMC is committed to keeping the community informed as progress continues. Updates on the clinic's development will be shared regularly, with a focus on ensuring that residents are aware of the new healthcare options that will soon be available.

The opening of the Highway 60 Clinic represents a significant step forward in CVRMC's mission to provide comprehensive, accessible healthcare to the region. The medical center looks forward to welcoming patients to this new facility and continuing its tradition of high-quality care for the community.
