Historic Hill Street School Transformed into Affordable **Senior Housing: Grand Opening Celebration Announced**

GLOBE, Ariz. - Gorman & Company is proud to announce the grand opening of the Hill Street School Apartments, an adaptive reuse project that breathes new life into the historic Hill Street School. The celebration will take place on Friday, April 11, at 11 a.m. at 435 S. Hill St., Globe, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony and remarks from key part-

Originally built in 1920, the Hill Street School has been thoughtfully repurposed into 64 mixed-in-

come, high-quality apartments designed to serve seniors (55+), earning between 30% and 60% of the Area Median Income (AMI) of Gila County. The project also includes market-rate units, ensuring a diverse and inclusive community for residents.

"Hill Street School Apartments serves as a model for historic preservation and community-driven development," Sally Schwenn, Arizona Market President for Gorman & Company. said. "We are honored to be part of this partnership, bringing high-quality, affordable housing options to

seniors in Globe."

The transformation of the former schoolhouse into vibrant senior housing was made possible through an innovative financing strategy, including 9% Low-Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC), American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds provided through the City of Globe and the Southern Gila County Economic Development Corporation. and funding from the Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH).

GLOBE, AZ - Cobre Valley Regional Medical Center (CVRMC) is excited to announce the future opening of its much-anticipated "Highway 60 Clinic," a walk-in clinic located near Cal Ranch and Walmart. This new facility is set to provide essential healthcare services to the community, offering a convenient option for those seeking immediate medical attention without the need for an appointment.

The journey to establish the Highway 60 Clinic has not been without challenges. The initial plans for the clinic encountered an unexpected delay when it was discovered that the proposed location fell within a designated floodway.

Determined to bring this vital service to the community, CVRMC worked with local and federal agencies to reassess the flood maps that impacted the clinic's location. Through extensive modeling, updated maps were drawn to better reflect the actual conditions of the area. CVRMC then submitted a request for a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), requesting an official change to the flood designation.

On July 29, FEMA issued a LOMR, paving the way for the new clinic. The new facility will offer extend hours to walk-in patients, providing a convenient, affordable option for healthcare services. While the specific timeline for construction and opening is still being finalized, the team is working diligently to bring the project to completion as swiftly as possible.

CVRMC is committed to keeping the community informed as progress continues. Updates on the clinic's development will be shared regularly, with a focus on ensuring that residents are aware of the new healthcare options that will soon be available.

The opening of the Highway 60 Clinic represents a significant step forward in CVRMC's mission to provide comprehensive, accessible healthcare to the region. The medical center looks forward to welcoming patients to this new facility and continuing its tradition of high-quality care for the community.

How To Help Someone with a Broken Heart

It can be agonizing to watch a friend or loved one suffer through a broken heart. However, there are things that we can do to help them through it. If you are a friend, relative, or bystander who knows of someone who has had their heart-broken by someone else, there are some things you can do to help.

DON'T LET THEM GO INTO ISOLATION

Get them involved with life again. Don't let them wallow in self-pity for very long. The more they isolate themselves, the more walls they will build between them and every other relationship they have. It is very dangerous.

They need to get involved with life again to begin the process of healing a broken heart. They need to interact with people, so get them involved in activities and clean social events. They need to invest in others' lives in some way. I never recommend a broken-hearted person just to lie low. Get them involved.

TRY TO GET THEM TO OPEN UP AND TALK ABOUT IT

So much pain is released when people can talk about their broken heart. If you can get them to talk, they will find a release for a lot of their pain. The problem is in getting them to talk at all. They may want to so withdraw into themselves that they have no interest in conversation. Or, more likely, they may fear reliving the pain if they talk about it.

They still need to talk about it. You don't necessarily have to agree with their viewpoints, anger, or reaction, but being sympathetic is important. Allow yourself to sympathize with their pain. Tell them so.

When they do start talking, you need to be a good listener. Don't interrupt, don't do the talking yourself. Learn to listen. Your thoughts, suggestions, and solutions are not relevant at this moment. Let them flush some of the pain out of their system. You don't have to have a solution; you just need to be a shock absorber.

USE HUMOR TO DRAW THEM OUT

Get them to laugh. If you can get a person to laugh, chuckle, or grin, you will have broken past the pain for just a moment.

Having breached the barrier of their pain, you are now in a unique position to help. Not only are they more apt to listen to you, but they have found a moment's relief from their pain and that is invaluable to them.

POINT THEM TO GOD

You or they may not be necessarily a Christian as I am but having a God who loves you (Psalm 34:18) and a Savior who cares for you is very comforting (Psalm 51:17). Having a faith that is greater than the sum of all our lives brings tremendous hope and provides a solid rock on which to stand when the storms of life rage around you.

The great tragedy of life is having no hope. Give a person hope, and they will find strength and reason to heal their broken heart.

These are some things that you can do to help someone with a broken heart.

"The Hill Street School project is a great example of the power of the State Housing Tax Credit program," ADOH Interim Director Ruby Dhillon-Williams said. "We have shovel-ready federal lowincome housing tax credit projects that can be bolstered with critical additional financial resources in order to quickly bring to market the attainable housing our state needs, in this case specifically for seniors, and the State

Housing Tax Credit program fills that crucial gap."

A key component of this financing was S.B. 1124. Arizona's firstever state tax credit program. This program has been instrumental in driving rural development and expanding affordable housing opportunities across the state. It is set to expire at the end of the year. This rural project is the first in Arizona to utilize the state's new tax credit program, proving its effectiveness in attracting private investment and serving as a model for future rural affordable housing initiatives.
