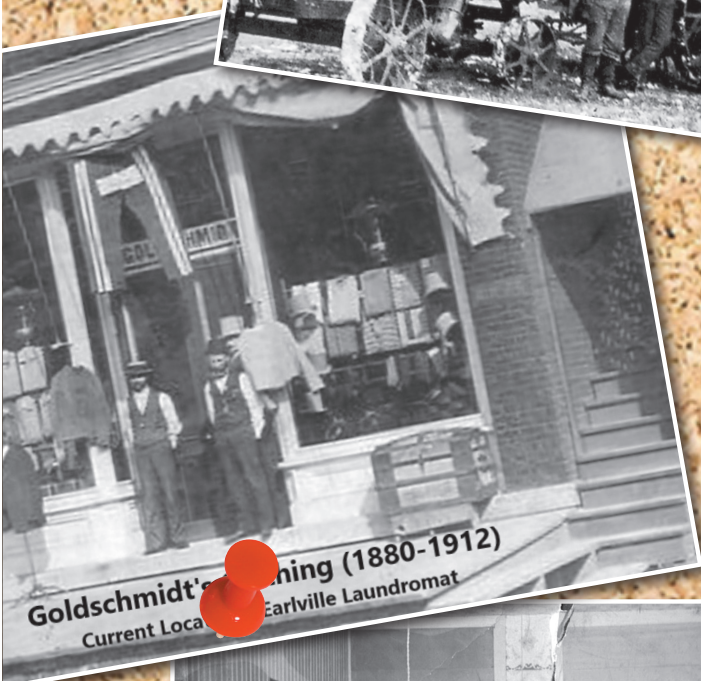

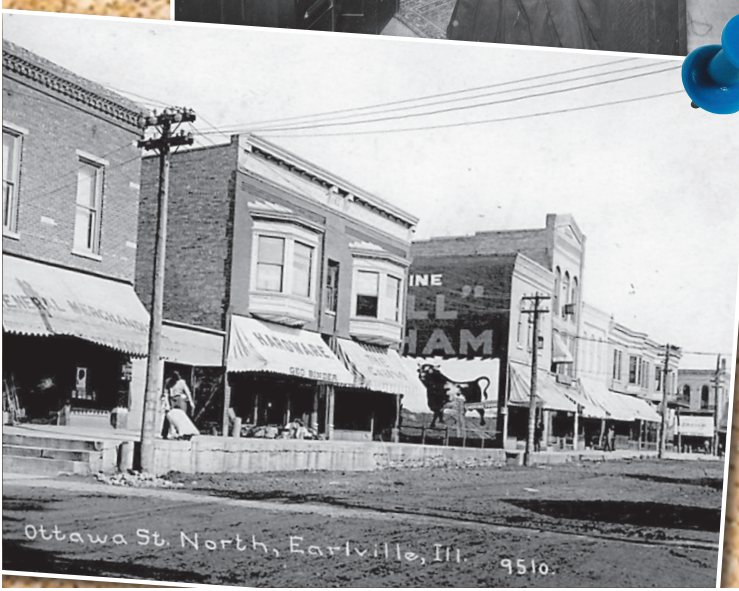

The Tri-County Veterinary Service, located just off U.S. Rt. 34 in Earlville, is at the service of all area pet owners. The veterinary service has been in business for 51 years, the last 20 years under the direction of Dr. Kevin Zollars.

According to Dr. Zollars, personal care is a point of pride for the clinic.

“We pride ourselves on good service,” he said. “It’s important to have contact with the people we serve.”

Tri-County Veterinary Service is a full-service clinic, offering diagnosis and disease prevention for both pets and livestock. Consultations can be obtained at the clinic, as well as pet vaccinations.

The Earlville Community Historical Society (ECHS) Museum is located at 136 S. Ottawa St. in downtown Earlville. The Museum was opened in 2013 as a headquarters for the town's 150th celebration. There are two floors of exhibits that showcase items from the early settlers of Earlville, businesses through the years, Earlville public school, and a military section honoring the local veterans. The attached shed was converted to a display to honor the history of Earlville's agricultural industry in 2021.

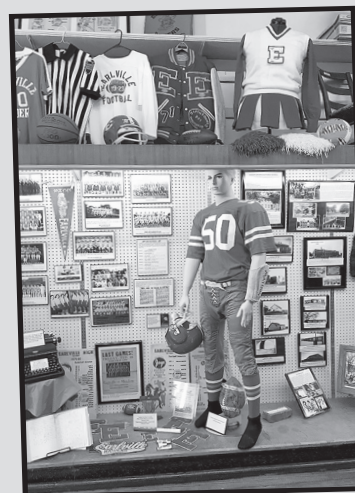
ECHS sponsors free public programs of historical interest and is available to speak about the museum and Earlville history at clubs or organizations. ECHS also participates with other civic organizations and clubs for community events.

There has been much work done this past year on providing resources for those looking to research family histories or local businesses. Binders of family information, houses and busi-

nesses are being updated frequently. In addition to having electronic access to the local newspaper prior to the 1900s, there are many volumes of the physical newspapers available as well.

The museum is staffed by volunteers and always looking for new members. Anyone interested in volunteering is encouraged to contact Anna at (815) 985-3763 or Kris at (815) 252-9380. Annual memberships are \$15, and lifetime memberships are \$150. Membership forms can be accessed on the organization's website.

Museum hours are Saturdays from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. and Sundays from noon-2 p.m., or by appointment. Appointments can be made using the contact numbers above. The museum is closed except by appointment during the months of January, February and March.
