'Dandelions' filmed in Rochelle area

Movie scenes shot at Headons, Spring Lake and Helms Stadium

ROCHELLE — A movie crew recently wrapped up filming in the area including locations in Rochelle and Creston. "Dandelions" stars Scott Michael Foster, Kate Cobb and Kevin Bigley and is about a writer that returns to his rural hometown filled with the friends and places that he's used as inspiration in his successful novels. "When he comes home to pick up the pieces after his dad dies, he's faced with those people," Bigley, also the writer and executive producer of the film, said. "They're seemingly OK with his success, but what transpires is kind of this twilight zone series of events that makes him unable to leave. His car doesn't work and his phone stops working and he starts to feel like he's potentially being kept there and all of these people that are seemingly fine with his success might be harboring some resentment and a form of payback. It plays with his own perception."

Cobb, who is also the director and executive producer of the film, said it's about a hometown kid who "forgets where he came from and comes back and people have issues with the way he's portrayed them." The "Dandelions" film was born out of a short that was shot by the group in Bigley's hometown in Northern California, which he said is similar to rural Illinois. When their production company, Dandelions Movie, LLC, partnered with executive producers Chicago Media Angels, the story was envisioned in rural Illinois.

Baneski enters 14th year with RPD

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Police Department Detective Elvis Baneski is in his 14th year with the department. He works days and is on-call for major incidents and serves as one of RPD's bike patrol officers. Baneski is currently assigned to the investigations division. He's responsible for follow-up investigations and investigating felony-level crimes.

Baneski has a bachelor of business from Northern Illinois University and attended the University of Illinois Police Training Institute. Prior to being an officer with RPD, he was a corrections officer with the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office.

The RPD detective has training in driving under the influence enforcement and is an advanced roadside impaired driving enforcement (ARIDE) officer. He also has training in complete traffic stops, rapid deployment, truck weight enforcement and is a certified juvenile officer.

Baneski grew up in Eastern Europe in North Macedonia, just north of Greece. He moved to the United States when he was 12 years old and did not speak English at the time. The first U.S. city he lived in was Rochelle and he attended Lincoln School.

"The greatest part of my job is helping people and interacting with the community," Baneski said. "Also, coming back to

Rochelle, the first city I lived in, and serving the community that was so welcoming to me when I arrived not knowing much about U.S. culture.

Baneski enjoys going back to North Macedonia to visit family and friends. His interests include fishing and playing sports. He enjoys spending time at the beach and has a chihuahua named Rosie that loves being outside with him.

Baneski's grandfather was a police officer in North Macedonia and he passed away before his grandson was born. That's why Baneski chose the career path he did.

"As a child, my grandmother always told me stories about him and the great person and police officer he was," Baneski said.

DAR Patriot Tree honors ancestors of local members

Chapter Regent Perry: ‘Remembering is our connection to the past’

ROCHELLE — Before getting involved with the Rochelle Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the name William Porter didn’t mean anything to Laurie Perry. Perry is the DAR chapter’s regent. A requirement of joining DAR is being able to trace your ancestry to a patriot of the American Revolution. Porter was a private and a volunteer soldier and served in the militia in his community before enlisting in the continental army for a year and getting directly involved in the Revolutionary War. Porter is Perry’s seventh great grandfather. She has two other patriots in her lineage as well. Porter’s name is one of 80-90 that adorn the

DAR Patriot Tree. The tree features names of patriots of each of the 85 active members of the Rochelle DAR. In recent months, the tree has been housed by organizations in town spreading awareness as the DAR prepares to celebrate America’s 250th birthday on July 4, 2026. The tree is currently on display at the Flagg Township Museum. “The focus for us is recognizing our patriots,” DAR America 250 Chairman Becky Danner said. “Recognizing and marking and honoring the patriots that gave us this 250th birthday coming up. It found a home at the VFW over Memorial Day and then it went to city hall over the 4th of July and it’s here for the month of August.”

City of Rochelle receives \$1.1 million redevelopment grant

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle is “thrilled” to be a recipient of over \$1.1 million for downtown redevelopment as part of Governor Pritzker’s Rebuild Illinois’ Downtowns and Main Streets program, a Tuesday press release said. Improvements to the downtown to attract small business, create jobs and improve the quality of life for residents are the intended uses for the money, the release said. Rochelle is one of just 50 communities to receive the award. “I am extremely excited to officially receive word of the receipt of the \$1.1 million grant for our

downtown. This grant will allow our community to continue to prosper and grow with some long-awaited projects in the downtown area,” Mayor John Bearrows said. “Thank you to the State of Illinois and my hats off to our staff who worked very diligently through the documentation process required to achieve this for Rochelle.” The city plans to construct a public restroom facility, add two additional parking lots and rehab several existing parking lots. Also included in the plans is the continuation of lighting, landscaping and beautification projects that have been underway

over the last several years. The city’s portion of the project will be \$306,000 and construction is anticipated to take place in 2023. The Downtowns and Main Streets Capital Program is designed to support local commercial corridors, with concentrations of businesses that experienced difficulties during the pandemic due to declining foot traffic, tourism and business from downtown offices. The program drives investment in infrastructure and public amenities that continue to fuel economic activity as more Illinoisans patron their local town centers.

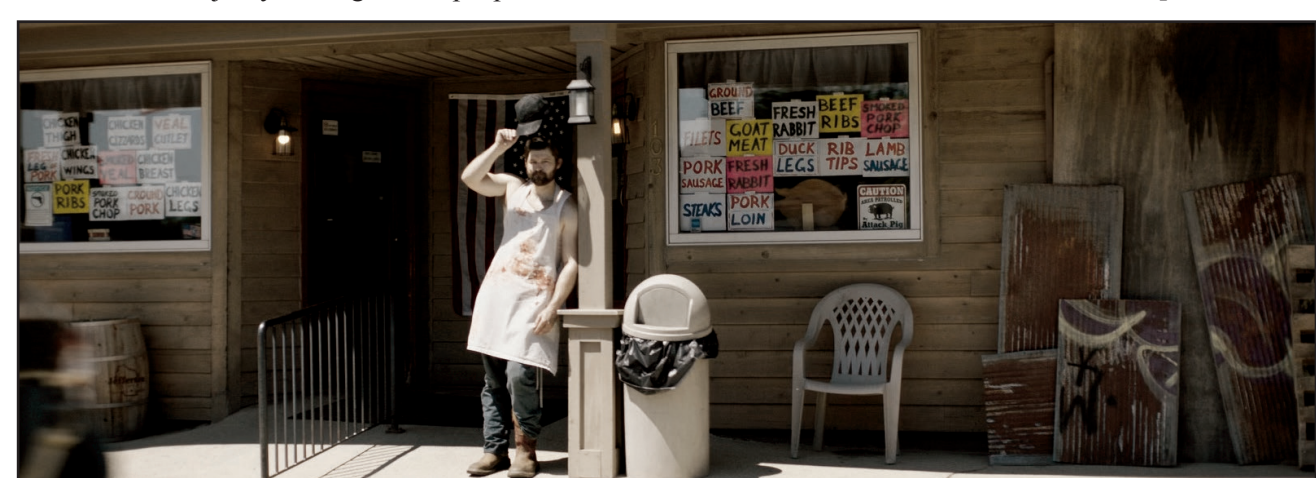

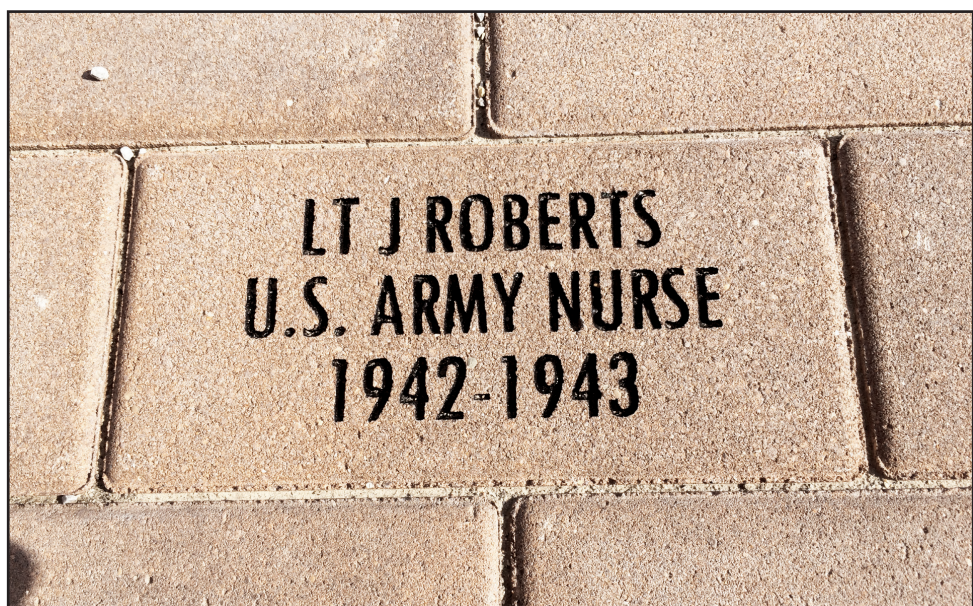

“Bad choice,” another commented. “Do your research.”

I hate to break it to this

person, but do you think for a second that a national restaurant chain didn’t do its research before making this option available? Not that common sense is at play here but come on.

Of course, there were a country breakfast plate full of snarky comments poking at the people getting mad about this. And some of them were gold.

“I also hate the idea of a menu having options that I specifically don’t want to eat!” wrote one person I really want to have a beer with. “Restaurants should limit their options to exactly my specifications and nothing more! How dare they cater to anybody other than myself!”

I don’t care who you are, that comment is funny and spot on. It also shows how selfish and entrenched people have become in this country: What I like is good, what anyone else likes is bad.

One final comment that just brought it all home for me.

“The fact that you sell stuff other than crackers in barrels is why I’ll never go here again!!!!”

If that doesn’t make you at least chuckle, check your pulse.

I am not a vegetarian, so I will not be choosing that option if I ever go to a Cracker Barrel again. Yes, I have eaten there, and it was excellent, but I don’t go to them often.

But if you are genuinely offended that a restaurant is offering options for people that you don’t want to eat, you are the problem. The world is changing, and people are starting to change the way they eat. What does that mean for you? Deal with it.

If you want to eat what you want to eat and don’t want to be exposed to things that you don’t agree with, like vegetables, I encourage you to eat at home. In fact, just stay at home – you’ll be safe from the big bad ever-changing world out there.

A good man who did something

WHO would sacrifice a job they loved to reveal a wrong committed against a child?

Very few would. In fact, in my 35 years in journalism, I’ve met only one such person. Just one.

In our society we talk a good game about how much we treasure children. But it’s a lie. Kids are violated and large institutions sweep it under the rug every day. As a reporter, I have seen it happen over and over.

The sexual violation of a child is the most horrific act imaginable. I should know. I was violated when I was just 12 years old. It is a pain that has hung over me for decades.

I have written about teachers, cops, coaches, pastors, scout leaders, tutors and others who have sexually abused youngsters.

And time after time, powerful institutions worked hard to cover up the crimes.

But Michael Leathers was a good man who did something. The Chatham man died Aug. 3 at age 62 of a heart attack.

He spent 20 years as a public relations person at Springfield Memorial Hospital. And he did a good job there. But his first love was newspapers.

Back in 2002, he was the editor of *Illinois Baptist*, a newspaper covering Southern Baptist congregations across the Land of Lincoln. Before that, he was a reporter for the *Alton Telegraph*.

When he learned that a pastor, Leslie Mason, was criminally charged with sexually abusing girls in the southern Illinois town of Olney, he reported it. One of the girls apparently was only 13 years old.

Instead of receiving praise for informing Baptists about a potential predator in their midst, he found himself in a room with a lawyer and his boss, Glenn Akins, who then ran the Illinois Baptist State Association.

They wanted him gone.

I wish I could say I found this response surprising. But those in power often find comfortable ignorance preferable to hard truth.

During my own career, editors have called me obsessed, pedophiles have threatened suicide, lawyers have threatened to sue and victims keep calling because they want their story told.

My response is always the same: If newspapers don’t hold those in power accountable, who will?

Leathers understood this as well.

I learned of his courageous stand in 2019 when newspapers in Houston and San Antonio published a damning exposé of how Southern Baptist churches had repeatedly covered up pastors who abused children.

Leathers’ story was included. Next the *New York*

Times wrote about what a brave man he was.

And a couple of days later, I found myself having lunch with Leathers and interviewing him for this column.

According to Leathers, Akins offered a peculiar complaint about the story: That writing about one pastor who committed sex crimes was unfair because that “ignores many others who have done the same thing.”

Forrest Gump could have come up with a smarter excuse. By the way, I reached out to Akins on Aug. 8 – he didn’t get back to me.

But sitting across from Leathers, I sensed heartbreak -- 17 years after he lost his job. He not only lost his career in newspapers but no longer felt comfortable in church.

I invited him to join a Bible study

I’m a part of, but he shook his head and said, “It wouldn’t be like the Southern Baptists – that was special.”

Michael’s widow, Tammy, said he came to forgive those who fired him and he continued to love Jesus.

“People would ask how his faith had remained so strong after all that had happened to him. And he would say, I put my faith in God, not in men,” she said.

In case you’re inclined to mark his dismissal as some sort of misunderstanding, it wasn’t. Leathers knew his

boss didn’t want the story to appear in the newspaper. But he said when he was hired he was assured of editorial autonomy. So, he published the story anyway.

Southern Baptist leaders are hardly unique in how they responded to predators in their midst.

We have seen this story play out time and time again with school boards, churches, scouting groups, teacher unions and sports teams. Powerful institutions often don’t want the truth told.

“I think there is a tendency for people in leadership to want to protect the institution by covering things up,” Michael Leathers told me. “The interesting thing is that when I wrote the story, I got plenty of positive feedback from laypeople in various congregations. They get it. It was people in positions of authority who had problems with me writing the story.”

Leslie Mason, the pastor Leathers wrote about, was sentenced to seven years in prison. Upon being released from prison he began working as a pastor again.

Glenn Akins, the boss who gave Leathers the boot, is now assistant executive director of the Baptist General Association of Virginia.

As for Leathers, a service was scheduled for him at a Chatham reception hall on Aug. 10. No pastor was slated to speak.

Rochelle man sentenced on battery charges

OREGON — Ogle County State's Attorney Mike Rock announced that on Aug. 11, the Honorable Judge John B. Roe sentenced Everett Bradley of Rochelle to five years in the Illinois Department of Corrections on the charges of aggravated domestic battery and aggravated battery.

The defendant is required to serve 85 percent of his sentence on the aggravated domestic battery charge and 50 percent of his sentence on the aggravated battery charge. Bradley was found guilty of those charges following a jury trial in March of this year. In February 2018, the

Rochelle Police Department conducted an investigation after a child was brought to the hospital with injuries. During the investigation, the defendant was developed as a suspect. The case was reviewed by the Ogle County State's Attorney's Office and charges were authorized.

"It will go over to the library for constitution week and the month of September. I wanted it here at the museum during the heritage festival. We want it to be a traveling display."

Danner joined DAR through a distant cousin and patriot that she had a direct lineage to. When she joined, Perry went through her information and went back to Danner with a list of more possible patriots. Perry and other DAR members undertake "significant" research projects to collect all the evidence needed to trace lineage back to patriots.

"I think most people would be surprised at the connection our members build with their patriot ancestors," Perry said. "Our membership embraces that relationship with them and they're 9-12 generations from us. But we have such heartfelt respect for what these men and women did to help America become America."

DAR Member Lydia Roberts can trace her lineage to eight patriots. She initially joined the DAR

through her paternal grandmother, who joined DAR in 1902. The organization was founded in 1890.

"At that time, it was only two generations from the patriots," Roberts said. "Now we're so many generations away and it's more about research and finding more about our ancestry and families. It's a common thread between all the different pieces of information and it becomes alive when you find this person and what they did."

Anybody who aided the cause of the American Revolution is considered a patriot. It's "much more" than just soldiers, Roberts said. Women and minority patriots have been found when DAR members have traced their lineage.

Patriots are often found as people who signed their names at the time as supporters of the revolution.

"Signing your name sounds like a simple thing," Perry said. "But it took a lot of consideration. You knew if that document was captured, your name was on a hunting list. It wasn't something that was undertaken lightly."

Perry said she's spent thousands of hours doing genealogy research to help families learn their stories.

"Remembering is our connection to the past," Perry said. "That's why I enjoy doing genealogy work so much. Today's DAR is active and vibrant in our communities and we are open to anyone interested in membership. We're willing to work very hard for women interested in finding out. I think most people would be very surprised by the number of people they know in our community who are members of DAR. Most don't realize they already have friends in DAR."

The second requirement of DAR membership is the desire to serve local communities. The organization makes donations and organizes campaigns like Wreaths Across America, which places wreaths at the graves of veterans during the holidays.

"We consider ourselves to be the living embodiment of those men and women who served and sacrificed," Perry said. "We serve in their honor in our communities."

“I just wanted to follow in his footsteps and have something in common with him, which is serving our community and helping people.”

One memorable experience on the job for Baneski involved being called to assist in opening a vehicle with a child locked inside. When he arrived, he saw a newborn in a car seat locked inside a running car. The mother said that as she was getting groceries out of the car, somehow the car locked itself.

“I was able to unlock the car and as I was leaving, the older brother, about 6 or 7 years old, thanked me for saving his little brother,” Baneski said. “That moment can be seen as an unmemorable interaction; however, I will forever remember it because it shows the impact we can have on people’s daily lives.”

Baneski wants the Rochelle community to know that every officer at RPD sincerely cares and strives to help the community in any way possible.

“There is nothing like the feeling of knowing that you helped someone at a time when they needed you the most,” Baneski said.

When he arrived, he saw a newborn in a car seat locked inside a running car. The mother said that as she was getting groceries out of the car, somehow the car locked itself.

DeLille training for comeback season at Carthage College

FORMER Rochelle Township High School student-athlete Mason DeLille has found success as a javelin thrower for the Carthage College men's track and field team over the last two seasons. While DeLille intends to continue throwing the javelin next season, he's also training hard to return to the triple jump, which he excelled in throughout his four-year track career at RTHS.

DeLille made five starts in the javelin throw during the outdoor season earlier this spring, finishing seventh or higher in each of those five starts. The RTHS alum set a new personal record of 47.40 meters at the UW-Whitewater Drake Alternative on April 29 before taking sixth out of 19 athletes at the 2022 CCIW Outdoor Track and Field Championships in early May.

"I became mentally stronger last season and a lot of that growth came near the end of the season," DeLille said. "It's also carried over into the summer and I'm hoping that growth will continue into my senior season. My overall experience with the Carthage track and field team has been great. The

friends and bonds I've made over the last few years have been my favorite aspect about the program. Continuing to stay active and compete has been nice as well."

DeLille currently holds collegiate-best marks of 12.59 meters (41 feet 3 ¾ inches) in the triple jump and 6.13 meters (20 feet 1 ½ inches) in the long jump. DeLille, who currently holds the RTHS varsity triple jump record and was an IHSA State Championship qualifier, said he's cut around 20 pounds off his frame over the summer in preparation for his final collegiate season.

"My goals for next season will be to make a comeback in the triple jump and to make the needed performance jump in the javelin throw," DeLille said. "I took a break from triple jump over the last two seasons but I've been working hard over the summer to lose weight and retain muscle so my body is in the best position for me to make a return. I felt like I had an average junior season. I fell short of my high expectations, but I didn't feel that I performed too poorly."

DeLille is currently studying mathematics and economics at Carthage College. With his education, DeLille said he intends to pursue a career in sports or business analytics.

NIU Football

First day in full pads brings out the intensity

Youthful talent on display as Huskies work through second week of camp

DEKALB — The defending Mid-American Conference champion Northern Illinois University Huskies donned full pads for the first time this preseason as head coach Thomas Hammock put the Huskies through a two-hour workout Sunday afternoon at Huskie Stadium.

With most of the practice spent in live tackling and the new “heavy thud” tempo, Hammock saw the intensity level upped during the team’s sixth preseason practice. NIU moved the workout to the afternoon in order to practice outside on the first day in pads.

“The intensity really ramped up,” Hammock said. “We had to add a new tempo to practice. We had to have a tempo in between thud and live tackling, so we call it heavy thud. With that, we have the ability to get some guys that have played a lot of football a lot of work without tackling guys all the way to the ground and exposing them to injury. They handled that well.”

One of the most energetic segments early in Sunday’s practice saw the offensive and defensive players face off one-on-one in an “open field avoidance” drills with running backs and receivers attempting to get past defenders in a limited space. The entire offense and defense cheered on their respective teammates, upping the competition level heading into 11-on-11 situations. Quarterbacks Rocky Lombardi (Clive, Iowa/Valley HS) and Ethan Hampton (Elburn/Aurora Christian HS) took all the snaps with the first and second team offense, respectively Sunday as the offense appeared to have the edge in the daily competition.

“It was an intense practice,” Hammock said. “The defense got after the

offense [Saturday] and there was a response. I’m sure the offensive coaches took that personally and the offensive players responded. There was leadership, there was energy, there was intensity, there was an edge, and it was good to see. As the head coach, you don’t know who to cheer for, there’s always a catch 22, but I loved the response. I’m sure [Monday] there will be another response. I love the competition and how these guys are playing.”

For the offense, Hammock named running backs Antario Brown (Savannah, Georgia/Beach HS) and Mason Blakemore (Centralia/Centralia HS), and wide receivers Fabian McCray (Chicago/Phillips HS) and Jalen Johnson (Aurora/Metea Valley HS) as players who have played well and put good days together through the first week of camp, while also mentioning freshman linebacker Nick Alvarado (Bloomfield, New Jersey/Union City HS) and the Huskie defensive line among those who have caught his eye.

Alvarado had a pair of tackles for loss and safety Jordan White (Havre de Grace, Maryland/Havre de Grace HS) picked off a pass to provide the defensive highlights Sunday. When the Huskies moved to short yardage and goal line situations, touchdowns by Brown, tight end Tristen Tewes (Pleasant Plains/Pleasant Plains HS) and McCray highlighted those segments. Running backs Blakemore, Brown and Harrison Waylee (Johnston, Iowa/Urbandale HS) all broke free for long runs at one point or another during practice.

“I really like the progress [I’ve seen so far],” Hammock said. “We were able to get a lot of quality work. With the twos, we went a lot of live tackling

today and that was good for those guys to get a lot of work. I like how we’ve been able to break down the practices and get guys a lot of work. We continue to split the practices and as long as we’re able to stay healthy, I want to continue to split the practices and get work and develop our whole football team. You see guys getting reps, making plays – young guys making plays. They’re getting better and it’s helping our football team as a whole.”

The final few periods were spent in hurry-up, move-the-ball situations with the number one and two offenses taking on the young defenders and the number one and two defenses going up against the young offensive players as part of the “split” practices Hammock referred to. Lombardi connected with receiver Shemar Thornton (Miami, Florida/Hallandale HS) on a 70-plus yard touchdown pass to close out practice.

Second Day

The old adage in col-

lege coaching is that the best thing that happens to freshmen is that they become sophomores.

For the Northern Illinois University football team, the second-youngest in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) in 2021, that youth movement has been bolstered by both veteran transfers and a freshman class that is already making a good first impression on head coach Thomas Hammock.

“We got some young guys who are extremely developed for their age, guys like Roy Williams (Crestwood/Shepard), Nick Alvarado (Bloomfield, New Jersey/Union City), Jalen Johnson (Aurora/Metea Valley), Rashon Myles Jr. (Hazel Crest/Homewood-Flossmoor), Reggie Jean (Ocoee, Florida/Foundation Academy) and Jaiden Credle (Columbus, Georgia/Carver),” Hammock said. “Those guys are ahead of the curve physically, picking up the schemes and competing with everyone else. We’re going to give them a lot of reps and see what they can

handle.”

That talent was on display in Monday morning’s practice in the Chessick Practice Center, as thunderstorms in the DeKalb area forced the Huskies inside. Credle, a running back, converted a third down on the first team offense’s first drive in the final 11-on-11 period of practice. Quarterback Rocky Lombardi (Clive, Iowa/Valley/Michigan State) threw a short touchdown pass to Brock Lampe (Kenosha, Wisconsin/Bradford) to punctuate the drive. On the next possession, redshirt-freshman quarterback Ethan Hampton (Elburn/Aurora Christian) hit Johnson in the back of the end zone for a 40-yard touchdown.

When it came time for the young guys 11-on-11 at the end of practice, it was Alvarado and Williams on defense getting in the offensive backfield for tackles for loss. In a year where NIU has a Mid-American Conference championship to defend, Hammock knows that developing depth in

every facet can be good not just for this year but years to come.

“It’s been fun to see because they add depth to your team,” said Hammock. “This is a physical game, and we need to continue to develop young players to make sure they can step up when the opportunity presents itself. Last year we lost Devin Lafayette, Eric Rogers and Harrison Waylee and guys stepped up and made plays. That’s why we’re splitting the practices up, so we can continue to develop our depth because you never know when you’re going to need somebody.”

Monday’s practice was the second in as many days in full pads. Hammock remarked that the two practices saw a rise in intensity and energy as the second week of practice is in full swing.

“It’s been an intense two days. We had to dial them back a bit today. It feels like we played two games in a row. The team’s in a great spot and the competition is at an all-time high. It’s good to see.”

WHEREAS, the loan shall bear an interest rate as defined by 35 Ill. Adm. Code 662, which does not exceed the maximum rate authorized by the Bond Authorization Act, as amended, 30 ILCS 305/0.01 et seq., at the time of the issuance of the loan; and
WHEREAS, the principal and interest payment shall be payable semi-annually, and the loan shall mature in 20 years, which is within the period of useful life of the Project; and
WHEREAS, the costs are expected to be paid for with a loan to the Village of Hillcrest from the Public Water Supply Loan Program through the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, the loan to be repaid from the Utility Fund, and the loan is authorized to be accepted at this time pursuant to the Act; and
WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, the Village of Hillcrest is authorized to borrow funds from the Public Water Supply Loan Program in the aggregate principal amount of \$3,000,000 to provide funds to pay the costs of the Project;

WHEREAS, the loan to the Village of Hillcrest shall be made pursuant to a Loan Agreement, including certain terms and conditions, between the Village of Hillcrest and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency; NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Hillcrest, Ogle County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1.
INCORPORATION OF PRE-AMBLER
The Corporate Authorities hereby find that the recitals contained in the preambles are true and correct and incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.
SECTION 2.
DETERMINATION TO BORROW FUNDS
It is necessary and in the best interests of the Village of Hillcrest to construct the Project for the public health, safety, and welfare, in accordance with the plans and specifications as described; that the System continues to be operated in accordance with the provision of the Act; and that for the purpose of constructing the Project, it is hereby authorized that funds be borrowed by the Village of Hillcrest in an aggregate principal amount (which can include construction period interest financed over the term of the loan) not to exceed \$3,000,000.

SECTION 3. PUBLICATION

This Ordinance, together with a Notice in the statutory form (attached hereto as Exhibit A), shall be published once within ten days after passage in The Rochelle News-Leader, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the Village. If no petition, signed by electors numbering 10% or more of the registered voters in the Village of Hillcrest (i.e., at least 69 of the 681 total registered voters) asking that the question of improving the System as provided in this Ordinance and entering into the Loan Agreement, therefore, be submitted to the electors of the Village, is filed with the Village Clerk within 30 days after the date of publication of this Ordinance and Notice, then

this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. A petition form shall be provided by the Village Clerk to any individual requesting one.

SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL ORDINANCES

If no petition meeting the requirements of the Act and other applicable laws is filed during the 30-day petition period, then the Corporate Authorities may adopt additional ordinances or proceedings supplementing or amending this Ordinance providing for entering into the Loan Agreement with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, prescribing all the details of the Loan Agreement, and providing for the collection, segregation and distribution of the Utility Fund, so long as the maximum amount of the Loan Agreement as set forth in this Ordinance is not exceeded, and there is no material change in the Project or purposes described herein. Any additional ordinances or proceedings shall, in all instances, become effective in accordance with the Act or other applicable law. This Ordinance, together with such additional ordinances or proceedings, shall constitute complete authority for entering into the Loan Agreement under applicable law. However, notwithstanding the above, the Village of Hillcrest may not adopt additional ordinances or amendments which provide for any substantive or material change in the scope and intent of this Ordinance, including but not limited to interest rate, preference, or priority of any other ordinance with this Ordinance, or otherwise alter or impair the obligation of the Village of Hillcrest to pay the principal and interest due to the Public Water Supply Loan Program without the written consent of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

SECTION 5. LOAN NOT INDEBTED- NESS OF VILLAGE OF HILLCREST

Repayment of the loan to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by the Village of Hillcrest pursuant to this Ordinance is to be solely from the revenue derived from the Utility Fund, and the loan does not constitute an indebtedness of the Village of Hillcrest within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory limitation.

SECTION 6. APPLICATION FOR LOAN

The Village President is hereby authorized to apply to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for a loan through the Public Water Supply Loan Program in accordance with the loan requirements set out in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 662.

SECTION 7. ACCEPTANCE OF LOAN AGREEMENT

The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize acceptance of the offer of a loan through the Public Water Supply Loan Program, including all terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement as well as all special conditions contained therein and made a part thereof by reference. The Corporate Authorities further agree that the loan funds awarded shall be used solely for the purposes of the Project as approved by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement.

SECTION 8. OUTSTANDING BONDS

The Village of Hillcrest has outstanding debt, payable from revenues of the System, that are senior to the loan authorized by this Ordinance. The Village of Hillcrest establish-

es an account, coverage, and reserves equivalent to the account(s), coverage(s), and reserve(s) as the senior lien holders in accordance with 35 Ill. Adm. Code 662.350(a)(9) (C)(PWS).

SECTION 9.

AUTHORIZATION OF VIL- LAGE PRESIDENT TO EXE- CUTE LOAN AGREEMENT

The Village President is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Loan Agreement with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The Corporate Authorities may authorize by resolution a person other than the Village President for the sole purpose of authorizing or executing any documents associated with payment requests or reimbursements from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency in connection with this loan.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11.

REPEALER

All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
