Heritage Festival next weekend

‘I look forward to everyone having a good time’

ROCHELLE — Lincoln Highway Heritage Festival preparations ahead of its 2022 dates of Aug. 19-21 are going well, LHHF President Lisa Chrisco said.

The heritage festival will be a full, three-day event for the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic. The event is celebrating its 25th anniversary, and this year's theme is "Through the Years," celebrating the past of LHHF.

"It's this time of year when things get hectic and everything has to fall into place," Chrisco said. "And so far things have been perfect. The weather looks like it will be gorgeous right now. Our layout and plans are all ready to go. After the past two years, I'm ecstatic to get back to the full three days. Things are falling into place nicely. It's been a long time coming and I'm glad it's about to be here."

There will be a carnival and beer garden for all three days of the event. There will also be a 50/50 raffle, a vendor basket raffle, craft, vendor and business booths, a food court and various local talents performing each day.

Friday, Aug 19 will feature the Little Miss Peanut competition from 6-7 p.m. and Soul 2 Soul from 8-10 p.m.

On Saturday, Aug. 20, the Hub City Cruisers Car and Motorcycle Show will take place from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. There will be a pancake breakfast from 7:30-11 a.m. along with a free kids zone from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Rochelle Performing Arts will perform from 10-11 a.m. The Moose's haunted maze will be open from 4-9 p.m. Class Field Trip will be from noon to 1 p.m. Burn-n-Bush will perform from 2-4 p.m., followed by Project Nostalgia from 5-7 p.m. and Hi Infidelity from 8-10 p.m.

Sunday, Aug. 21 will start with a pancake break-

fast from 7:30-11 a.m. and church service at 9:30 a.m. From 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Magic Matt's Family Fun Show will be strolling the festival grounds. Ballet Folklorico Xochicquetzal will be on the main stage from 11:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.. There will be an old fashioned ice cream social from 3-6 p.m. The parade will begin at 1 p.m. After the parade, hacky sack world record holder Andy Linder will be strolling the festival grounds. The Beaux Band will perform from 4-6 p.m. and the Moose's haunted maze will be open again from 2-5 p.m.

"I think the community is very excited," Chrisco said. "It's been a full two years since we've had

a carnival in town. The festival does bring a lot of families from other areas. People from all around attend. I think that helps our businesses in Rochelle and downtown."

Chrisco thanked the City of Rochelle, Stillman Bank, Rochelle Municipal Utilities, Flagg Township, Central Bank, Holcomb Bank, Rochelle Community Hospital, Americold, Tess & Crull, LLC and all of the sponsors that have donated funding, raffle money and give ways to LHHF.

The LHHF president said that planning is already underway for LHHF 2023 and planning takes over a year.

Hillcrest board talks gaming fee increase

HILLCREST — At its monthly meeting Wednesday, the Hillcrest Village Board resolved to vote again next month on the issue of increasing gaming fees after tabling the issue last month.

The only business in the village with gaming machines is Fat Cat Slots. The ordinance resolution in question would increase the fee the village gets per machine on an annual basis. The fee is currently \$25 per machine. The 2023 annual fee would be \$150 per gaming machine. In 2024 it would be \$200 per machine and in 2025 and the years after that it would be \$250 per machine unless amended.

A recent change to state law allowed municipalities like the Village of Hillcrest to increase gaming fees per machine to \$250.

The owners of Fat Cat Slots attended last month's meeting and spoke against the proposed increase before it was tabled. Trustees discussed the possibility of a percentile-style increase instead, but plan to vote on the change as previously written next month.

Village trustees voiced differing opinions on the idea of increasing gaming terminal fees during Wednesday's meeting.

"We should encourage and support the success of our local businesses, not hinder their growth by increasing costs," Village

Trustee Tim Ball said.

Village Trustee Dan Potter spoke in favor of increasing the fees.

"Every one of our costs for this village has gone up in the past year," Potter said. "All of our costs have gone up and we need to generate more revenue."

Solar

Representatives from Enel Green Power attended the meeting and requested extensions on a special use permit and variance that were previously granted by the village due to delays in the work for a planned solar farm (Rochelle Solar) within Hillcrest limits.

The variance the village granted for the solar farm previously was for six months. The special use permit granted was one year and will need to be at least a two-year extension

and that would require a change to village policy.

Enel Development Manager Emily Skill said the extension is needed due to interconnection delays with energy grid companies PJM Interconnection and ComEd. Operation is now planned to begin in 2025 after original hopes were this year or 2023. No changes were made to the requests of Enel Green Power besides the time frames.

Village trustees plan to host a public hearing and vote on the matter next month.

Meter increase

Village President Randy Salsbury said the village plans to vote on making an increase of \$5 for use of water meters for homes.

No changes to COVID-19 policies from last year

ROCHELLE — At its monthly meeting Tuesday, the Rochelle Elementary School District Board of Education unanimously approved a memorandum of understanding with the Illinois Tutoring Initiative through Northern Illinois University for a tutoring program that is planned to begin next month at Rochelle Middle School.

The program involves after school tutoring for middle school students by

NIU college of education students. District Assistant Superintendent Tony Doyle made a presentation to the board about the program and said the district is excited to implement it.

"This program is just for the middle school," Doyle said. "It has potential for expansion. We would have a site coordinator in the district that would help with parent communication and matching up the needs of the student using data and teacher recommendations. NIU will hire and pay students that are already in

the college of education in their second or third year to come over and work with our students after school."

There is no cost to the district for the program other than paying its site coordinator. NIU will pay for the supplies and the elementary district will keep any supplies NIU purchases. Data will be the first thing to determine which students would be good fits for the program along with teacher recommendations, Doyle said.

Kishwaukee College

Board approves contract with faculty association

MALTA — During the Aug. 9 regularly scheduled Kishwaukee College Board of Trustees meeting, the board unanimously voted to approve a four-year contract with the Kishwaukee College Education Association (KCEA).

The negotiating team, consisting of three faculty and three college administrators, utilized interest-based bargaining (IBB), which is a negotiating strategy that focuses on developing mutually-agreeable solutions to issues brought up by both parties. The college has been utilizing IBB since 2016. Members of the KCEA negotiating team included: Dominica Blalock, assistant professor-mathematics; Dr. Nicole Potts, associate professor-chemistry and Kyra Rider, assistant professor-mathematics (KCEA lead negotiator). Members of the administration team included: Chase Budziak, dean, Office of Instruction; Barbara Leach, interim vice president of instruction (administration lead negotiator) and Cindy McCluskey, executive director of human resources.

Rider commented, "It has been a very collaborative experience. We went into negotiation topics that we thought would be difficult, and through careful and thoughtful communication, we came up with solutions that made everyone feel good. In the end, we have a contract that both teams are mutually happy with."

Financial highlights include an average raise of 4.98 percent over the four years, health insurance percentage of premiums and coverage to remain the same with the addition of a health savings account incentive for those members electing a high deductible plan, and compensating faculty rank advancement.

Bob Johnson, chair of the board, praised the team for their efforts, "The board is very appreciative of the efforts by the negotiation team to reach a mutually-agreeable, four-year contract. We feel the contract recognizes all the hard work and dedication of our faculty and speaks to the ability of the College to continue to provide quality instruction. We believe the contract is not only fair for the faculty but for the taxpayer and the students. Inflation has taken a toll on everyone, and we remain committed to investing in our employees during these challenging financial times."

Leach commended the faculty for their dedication to the process, "After five months of good-faith negotiating, I am proud of where we have landed. We utilized data from peer institutions in compensation, benefits, and best practices to support discussions and ensure the college continues to be a fair and desired place to work."

The new contract is effective on the first day of the fall semester, Wednesday, Aug. 17.

Kishwaukee College recognizes medical assistant students

MALTA — Kishwaukee College graduated its second class of medical assistant students during a pinning ceremony earlier this month at the college. Kish pinned four students before family and friends as recognition for their completion of the medical assistant certificate.

Kishwaukee College's medical assistant program trains students to work in clinics, hospitals and other health care facilities, where they complete both administrative and clinical tasks. Through collaboration with area medical partners, Kishwaukee College identified a strong need for qualified medical assistants within the local community and started the program in spring 2021.

"After graduating from the program, I am so grateful that I did not give up because I am looking forward to such a rewarding career and have become a better person because of it," graduate Ann Fogelsanger said.

Kish worked to create a state-of-the-art learning space for the program by

modeling existing classrooms after medical facilities to include patient rooms, a reception desk and a lab area. Additionally, Kish works with area health care facilities to offer externships and on-the-job training.

"I really enjoyed the classroom and externship. The classroom was made to look like a real clinic, and that really helped when it came to the externship and real-world experience," said graduate Leticia Cardenas.

Graduates also commended the program for helping make the transition into a professional career as seamless as possible.

"The last semester of the program was designed for career readiness and professional development through building our resumes, preparing for interviews, and even doing in-person interviews with health care professionals from the surrounding area," Fogelsanger said.

"The program definitely made it easy to find a job after graduation. I have

“Hopefully by doing this, we’ll be able to generate a little more revenue to get our water tower worked on,” Salsbury said. It would be \$5 more per month. This would act as sort of a fundraiser for the water tower. It’s part of a long-term plan. It’s a three-year project.”

Garbage

Village trustees said that Wednesday that due to a new seven-year agreement with Northern Illinois Disposal, residents will be receiving a 95-gallon cart for weekly trash service and a 65-gallon cart for bi-weekly recycling service. Each home is allowed one bulk item per week. Extra carts can be rented annually for \$36 with a one-time delivery

fee of \$60.

All trash must be inside the container and bags and items on the ground will not be collected, with the exception of one large item and bundled cardboard for recycling. As of Sept. 1, recycling will only be collected if it is in the new 65-gallon container. Detailed information on garbage changes will be distributed with upcoming village water bills.

“These changes should address a lot of the mess this community sees on Thursday mornings,” Salsbury said. “It’s a windy community and these are large containers that should help quite a bit and there should be less loose debris around the village.”

Water program

The board unanimously

Holding bullies accountable

I have never been a talk radio fan. Even when it was at the height of its popularity I stayed away.

The reason? It was all shouting, negativity and finger-pointing nonsense. It led to division and not societal solutions. It was all about making certain people or groups look bad. It was all about putting people down.

I know a lot of people loved that screaming radio, including friends of mine and even family members. Well, more power to them, but I don't ever want that kind of negativity in my life.

To be clear, I am talking about talk radio of any political stripe – the left as well as the right have had radio “personalities” that have just belittled those who disagree with them.

No thanks.

But there was one who stood out as the top – or bottom – of the crazy heap. That is Alex Jones. Jones had the typical raving and ranting thing, but he also swam in the deep end of the conspiracy world. And the Internet has given him a very wide reach into that world, a place where outright lies and invented schemes destroy lives and do harm to people. And he has made a lot of money doing all the damage he has done.

Jones is a man who sells “alternative facts.” Those are things most of us call lies.

I could list all the crazy, unhinged things he has pushed over the years, but it is honestly too sickening for me to delve into. Google it yourself if you want the specifics.

But one thing Jones is well known for is his claims of “trauma actors” at events like school shootings. He has said that the 26 people – including 20 children – slaughtered in the 2012 shootings in Newtown, Conn., did not exist. So, the parents of these children, who were mostly 6 and 7-year-olds, didn't actually have children. They are all actors, and this is a way to get rid of guns.

Take a deep breath if you

haven't heard this before. Yes, it is insane that anyone could believe this, and especially spout the nonsense publicly.

I can only feel for these parents. Their young children were gunned down in school, and Jones is telling them their kids never existed and they are liars.

It makes me equal parts sad and angry. I can't imagine the pain they felt of losing a child so young in such a violent way. And then for someone to take to the airwaves and say they are actors and not parents. Well, that is simply evil and cruel.

Turns out, it is also expensive.

The families of the victims sued Jones, and in 2021 a Connecticut court found him liable for defamation. And this month, a Texas jury recently ordered Jones to pay the parents of a 6-year-old killed in the massacre millions of dollars.

(I could write a series of stories on the trial, and the judge forcing Jones to answer honestly, not spew his usual “alternative facts,” and his attorney basically showing the world that Jones lied in court).

And Jones also, finally, admitted that yes, these were real children, their parents are not actors and the shooting happened.

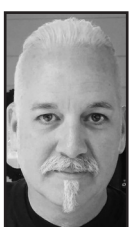
Isay he knew it all along, of course. But reality is not a great thing for a person who makes his living off selling conspiracy theories to listeners who buy into them.

There could be more damages coming, but I don't think they will financially ruin a man who is worth millions of dollars.

I do hope it gives pause to those who try to profit from the suffering of others, and to those who gobble up the lies spewed by charlatans like Jones. Jones is an opportunist, a school yard bully with a lot of followers who buy into the garbage he is pushing.

But bullies can be held accountable, as Jones found out. We need to hold them all accountable in this country.

There is little sympathy for a rat

THERE is little sympathy for a rat.

On July 25, a giant inflatable rat rose 15-feet in front of Staab Funeral Home in Springfield and a woman came out of the business and repeatedly stabbed the rodent with a knife.

The rat is intended to call public attention to companies employing nonunion labor.

John Nicks, business manager for Roofers Local 112, said he and two of his union brothers – and Scabby the rat – were well within their rights protesting outside the venerable Springfield business that employed a non-union roofing contractor.

I can't argue with that.

The First Amendment exists to protect even the most offensive speech. In fact, if someone didn't find it offensive, there would be no need to protect it.

But as my mother used to say, “Just because you can do something doesn't mean you should do something.”

And this job action was stupid – really stupid.

Nicks portrays himself as – just a working stiff – protesting outside a funeral parlor. But even he wasn't prepared for how heated things became.

“She came out running, hollering and screaming and had a knife that was maybe four, six or seven inches long. I don't know what she was screaming, but she was screaming, and then she stabbed the rat eight times – in the back,” he told me in a recent interview.

One of the picketers called the cops and the woman returned to the business.

The 911 call went like this: “We're union workers and we are kinda protesting here because there is non-union here. And a lady came out of Sta-

ab's and poked a hole in one of our rat things or whatever. They are getting kinda nasty and we have all the right to be here.”

He added the perpetrator was wearing a “leopard top.”

Meow. You just can't make this stuff up.

A police report said Funeral Director Lauren Staab, daughter of the firm's President Paul John Staab, admitted to the attack. Neither of the Staabs would comment on the matter for the record. She has been charged with criminal damage to property.

When I wrote a news story on the incident last week, I received emails and comments from across the United States. The victim – Scabby, the now flaccid rat – received no sympathy.

Lauren Staab, on the other hand, may be on the way to folk-hero status.

I should note that the Staabs buried several of my in-laws. And I've attended a number of funerals there and always found them to be dignified and professional.

They are just nice folks.

Inflating a giant rat outside a family business is a bullying tactic. A legal bullying tactic, but a bullying tactic nonetheless.

I can empathize.

When I was 10, my family's small business was picketed by a union. We'd hired union carpenters to put on an addition. It seems the carpenters were carrying their own boards. So, the laborers' union picketed because they thought they should be carrying them.

Being a rather nosey child, I walked out front and asked the fellow picketing why he was there. He said, “Unfair labor practices, Kid.”

I asked what was unfair? The fella wouldn't make eye

contact but did tell me to call the union hall. I couldn't help but wonder if he knew why he was picketing.

After all, orthodoxies demand blind obedience. Instead of taking a nuanced view and noting that the Staabs have employed union contractors in the past and have contributed much to the community, the roofer's union chose to brand them as “shameful” and target them for a picket.

What do they hope to accomplish? Maybe someone will drive down the road, see the picketers and say, “Mom, when you kick the bucket, we won't have your funeral at that place with the giant rat.”

I suppose it could happen. But I kind of doubt it.

A more likely scenario is that the union will reap nothing but ill will. Instead of the champion of working people, it came off as a bully picking on a family business.

Increasingly, rank-and-file union workers are uncomfortable with these actions. They may not be voicing their misgivings in the union hall, but they are voting with their feet.

Unions are finding it hard to get workers to participate in job actions like the one with Scabby. The street.com has reported some labor organizations have resorted to hiring non-union temporary workers at minimum wage to man their picket lines.

John Nicks, of the Roofers union, acknowledged that some unions “play that game” but not his.

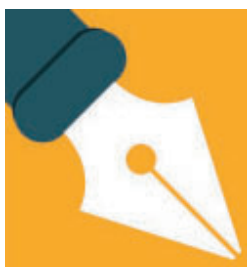
All the same, whenever I see folks suffering out in the weather on a picket line, I can't help but wonder, “Are those temps? And is the union paying them prevailing wage?”

“Aparent could call and ask for their child to be involved in it,” Doyle said. “We won’t make kids do it. We’ll encourage them. Hopefully we can build on celebrating that it’s a fun thing and it helps them with homework and tests and build it up. It will be based on their needs academically.”

Doyle said the district has been “pretty much guaranteed” that there will be plenty of NIU students to work as tutors in the program and the elementary district is early to work on the program with NIU in terms of other area schools. The program is planned to start in mid-September after Labor Day.

The tutoring initiative could also work for the district as a recruitment tool amid a nationwide teacher shortage. Along with NIU, Doyle said the district would like to strengthen its relationships with Rock Valley College, Rockford University, Western Illinois University and other area institutions.

“We can make connections with those people for recruitment and retaining efforts that every district is faced with right now,” Doyle said. “We can get them in our doors and possibly find some matches. These are students from NIU coming to us. And other colleges are doing it.

We’re not tied to just NIU and we are trying to expand ourselves and have people come and see Rochelle.”

Once the program moves along, the district plans to get student and teacher feedback to assess its progress. Tutors will work with no more than three children at a time.

“This is going to be more specialized,” Doyle said. “It won’t be a big group and that makes for a bigger chance of impactful growth. And you hope those relationships grow and it’s one more person for that middle school kid to talk to. I only see the positives. I think once we get going, we can only build and take it as far as we can take it.”

The tutoring initiative came about as the district faces uncertainty with the state grant that funds its after-school HUB Program. That program is funded completely by a grant and an application to continue that funding is currently being reviewed

and the district will know its fate later this fall. Doyle said the district wanted to look for new programs to address student needs due to the uncertainty.

It’s also possible that the district could fund the HUB Program itself in some form if the grant is not received. Doyle said if the HUB Program continues, it can be married to the tutoring initiative.

The tutoring program does not have plans for transportation for students like the HUB Program does. Superintendent Jason Harper said there are ways non-parent transportation could still work for tutoring students at RMS.

“If we do have a student who is also in the HUB Program and this program, we have discussed how we could help support more students,” Harper said. “A student could do tutoring and then finish at the HUB Program and use that transportation. We also have a high percentage of students that walk home from the middle school. If we’re able to have both programs, we’ll work on how we can make them work together.”

COVID-19

Harper said that with school starting in the coming days, the district will be operating with minimal COVID-19 restrictions in the same way that it did to end the previous school year.

“We haven’t made any changes to our daily operations since then or the end of last school year,” Harper said. “There are fewer COVID-19-related procedures. The portable testing site at May School will not be used this year. SHIELD testing for staff members will not be done either. Masks remain optional and we’re going to move forward with what we did at the end of last year. There are no changes to transportation or extra-curricular procedures.”

Employment

The board unanimously approved the resignation of certificated personnel including Megan Monfils (second grade dual language teacher, Central School) and Michelle Mairs (second grade teacher, Central School) along with the employment of Madison Bromfield (special education teacher, Central School) and the transfers of Melissa Bowers (reading teacher, Central School, to second

grade teacher at Central School), Yharosliv Cruz (fifth grade dual teacher at Tilton School to long-term substitute) and Brooke Freeman (ESL to seventh grade ELA at RMS).

Support staff personnel changes were unanimously approved including the resignations of Linda Niemeyer (paraprofessional at RMS), Marina Martinez (paraprofes-

sional at Tilton School), Enrique Lopez (paraprofessional at Central School) and Katie Paulsen (paraprofessional at RMS) and the hiring of Nayeli Ramirez (paraprofessional

at RMS), Heather Sandlin (paraprofessional at RMS part-time) Angel Cruz (bilingual paraprofessional at Central School) and Maria Estrada Garcia (cafeteria at Central School).

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Hub soccer team kicked off its first week of fall practices for the 2022 season Monday afternoon. Rochelle will lean on its returning seniors as the Hubs look to build on a 9-12 record from last season, the program’s first losing season since 2015.

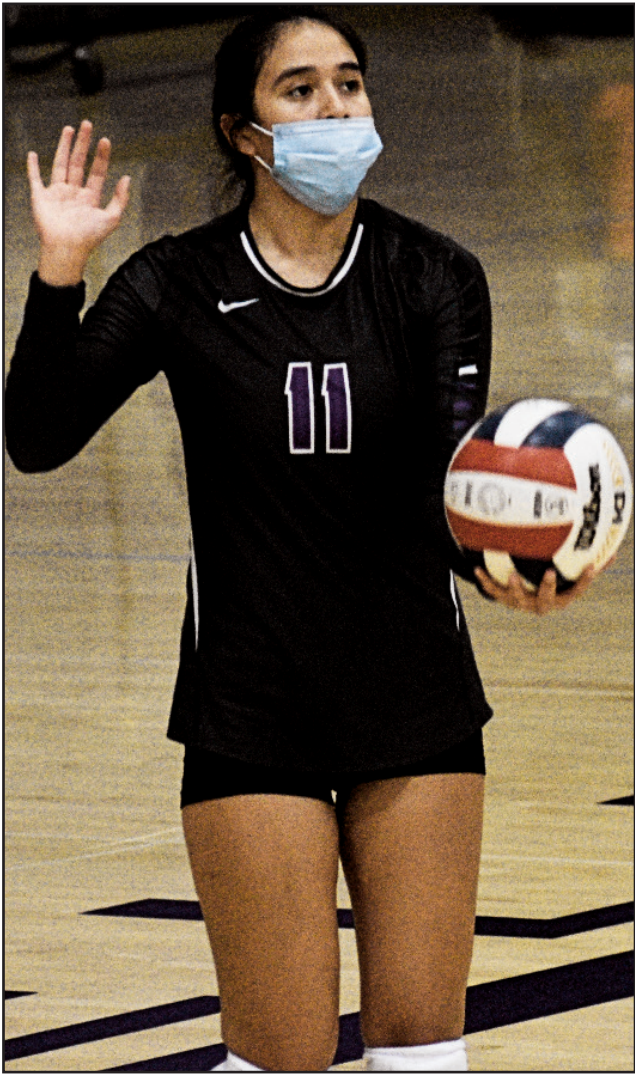
will look for its returning seniors on the front line to fill the shoes that were left by three-time MVP and three-time All-Conference First Team honoree Sylvia Hasz.

Thiravong ties SVSU record to highlight freshman season

Former Rochelle Township High School golf standout Megan Thiravong had a special supporter in her corner as she competed alongside her Saginaw Valley State University teammates in the 54-hole William Beall Fall Classic hosted at the esteemed Findlay Country Club this past fall.

In what was ultimately her strongest tournament showing of her freshman season with the Cardinals, Thiravong carded back-to-back 77s through the first 36 holes before capping off the two-day event with 73 over her final 18 holes. Thiravong's 227 was not only the best score on the team, but it landed her in 15th overall and tied a school record for the lowest 54-hole score.

"That was the defining moment of my freshman season, especially considering that it was raining pretty heavily," Thiravong said. "What helped me push through that tournament was having my heavenly Nana Jet there. She was definitely my best cheerleader and I wore her special pin during the tournament. It was an amazing moment to highlight my freshman year."

Thiravong made her collegiate debut at the ODU Champions of Women's Golf Classic in September, shooting 163 over 36 holes to tie for 15th overall and help lead SVSU to third place in the tournament. The former Lady Hub student-athlete made nine starts for the Cardinals during her freshman season, competing in six fall tournaments and three spring tournaments.

"The collegiate golf experience has been very eye-opening to me," Thiravong said. "Playing with the boys at RTHS definitely helped me increase my distance and accuracy in preparation for college. My freshman season was really a blur and it went by really fast. Our coaches have worked with us on minimizing risk and I feel like my shots into the greens improved a lot during the fall season. My putting has really improved and my short game has gone to the next level."

A four-time state qualifier in high school, Thiravong said her goals for next season are to help her team advance beyond the NCAA Division II Regional Series, which was where the Cardinals saw their 2021-22 season conclude earlier this year.

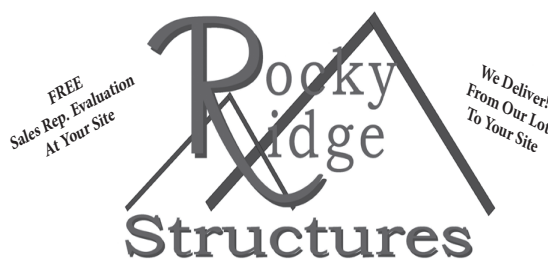

Veteran offensive line poised to lead up front

DEKALB — Whether it was opening holes for the fourth-best rushing attack in the country, which averaged 241.4 yards per game, or allowing the second-fewest sacks in the nation, just 0.79 per game, the NIU Huskie offensive line was a backbone for many of the accomplishments of the 2021 season, which is just the way head coach Thomas Hammock envisions his teams being built.

"The success of our offense was predicated because of our offensive line, it starts there," said Hammock. "That's how we build our football team. We build our team inside out; I've said that from the moment I took over this job until the moment I'm no longer here. We will always be a team that's built inside out on the offensive line and defensive line and that's going to be the strength of our team."

"That's how you have to play in the Midwest, that's how you have to play at NIU with the elements, the wind and all those different things. I couldn't be happier with the guys we have up front and the young guys developing behind them."

Among those guys up front are four starters from a season ago: Marques Cox (Peoria/Peoria) at left tackle, J.J. Lippe (Milwaukee, Wisconsin/Whitefish Bay) at left guard, Logan Zschernitz (Spencer, Wisconsin/Spencer) at right guard and Nolan Potter (Cedar Rapids, Iowa/Washington) at right tackle. That type of continuity

up front has the Huskies feel very good about their offensive line heading into the 2022 season.

"Those guys have a lot of experience, they have a lot of reps under their belt," said Hammock. "Those four guys started (last year), but John Champe has started games for us, and we feel very confident that Pete Nygra is going to step in there and do a tremendous job. We have great comfort with our top seven, eight guys up front, we feel like we're extremely deep. We feel like we can rotate guys, we feel like we have guys that can play multiple positions, which is important throughout the season. And we feel like we have depth and I think all those things hopefully can propel us to be great up front."

At center, Pete Nygra (North Indianapolis, Indiana/Brownsburg) steps into the spot previously held by All-MAC performer Brayden Patton. Nygra saw action in three games last season and NIU offensive line coach Daryl Agpalsa has been impressed with his work ethic since he arrived in DeKalb.

"From the very first day he got here, he was a mid-year, high school kid, all he has done is put his head down and work and been one of the hardest workers on our football team," Agpalsa said of Nygra. "I think he's getting a lot of respect and trust from his teammates by the way he goes about his business. He's a tireless worker, he

has a great understanding of our system, and I think they're really excited about it."

Lining up to Nygra's right, both Potter and Zschernitz have started 20 consecutive games heading into this season. Potter was a Second Team All-MAC selection in 2021 while Zschernitz earned All-MAC Third Team honors. To his left, Lippe appeared in all 14 games a season ago, making 13 starts, while Cox has started 29-straight games dating back to the Vanderbilt contest in 2019. With that type of stability, it's easy to see why Agpalsa believes Nygra will fit in seamlessly.

"I think with the other four having such great continuity with each other,

they can see things and have the ability to transition to make the play work," explained Agpalsa. "They've spent a lot of time with Pete, and they have built that continuity, so I think there's a lot of trust there."

As both Hammock and Agpalsa were quick to point out, the Huskie offensive line goes well beyond the five starters, with plenty of other talent, and experience, in the group.

"John Champe, from Brookfield, Wisconsin, he started games for us in 2020 and has been an active starter and backup for us inside," said Agpalsa. "He's doing a fantastic job in the first few days of camp. Evan Buss from Kimberly, Wisconsin, he's been a starter for us and

been a swing, tackle/tight end for us a year ago and has a plethora of reps, game reps from last season, he is having a wonderful camp too. And then Matthew Schooley is coming along. He's doing a great job as our center with our younger group and lots of those guys are coming along."

After splitting the team into two groups for practice on Monday and Tuesday, allowing everyone to get more reps, the Huskies held their first full team workout of camp on Wednesday morning. Hammock was extremely pleased with the efficiency of the session.

"I thought it was fantastic," said Hammock. "We got off the field eight minutes early and this was the most reps we have ever gotten in my four years

here. With the way we have structured practice we have been able to get quality reps, we are getting guys developed, young guys are stepping up and showing up and guys are trying to earn their way onto the bus which is exciting for us. The deeper we are, the better chance we have to win. I'm excited about this team, I'm excited about their mentality, their approach, and the way they go to work."

"We have to continue to stack days, we have one more practice (Thursday), then they get a day off, I love what the NCAA did with the schedule this year, allowing us to have two extra days for recovery, that is going to be important, and we are going to take full advantage of that."

Deep corps of running backs leads Huskies into 2022

DEKALB — Nothing quite gets the sideline hyped up like a running back bursting through the trenches en route to a big gain. On Thursday, during the NIU Huskies' practice before a much-deserved day off, the running backs were getting their work in during the team's 11-on-11 drills. Right behind the backs and keeping a watchful eye was assistant coach and run game coordinator, Nic McKissic-Luke. He made sure each running back had his opportunity to get reps in as the competition for a starting spot is wide open.

"I think you always want to go into the season with a running back by committee because of the physicality of the position." said McKissic-Luke. "You don't want to get to a point where you have to wear one guy down."

NIU running backs Mason Blakemore (Centralia/Centralia), Antario Brown (Savannah, Georgia/Beach) and Harrison Waylee (Johnston, Iowa/Urbandale) have emerged as potential starters, but that doesn't mean the Huskies won't ride anyone that gets hot.

"You know, we have those three guys right now, but we're going to go into it running back by com-

mittee," McKissic-Luke added. "And if a guy gets hot, he's going to be the guy."

The five other running backs on the 2022 roster include: Nathan Castor (Fort Myers, Florida/South Fort Myers), Jaiden Credle (Columbus, Georgia/Carver), Terron Kellman (Clinton, Maryland/St. Frances Academy), Christian Nash (Omaha, Nebraska/Millard South) and Billy Dozier (New Lenox/Lincoln Way West).

"Harry' (Harrison Waylee), 'AB' (Antario Brown) and Mason (Blakemore) - they're guys that can easily get hot and take over a football game. And then we add in a guy like Billy Dozier or Jaiden Credle - he's (Credle) a true freshman who came into camp and has already opened people's eyes."

Head Coach Thomas Hammock echoed McKissic-Luke's statements.

"It's a great group of players and they're very competitive. As of today, I couldn't tell you who the starter would be. I think we've got three guys that are competing - Antario (Brown), (Harrison) Waylee and Mason Blakemore, it's exciting. Blakemore's put himself in position to compete and I think Coach McKissic-Luke has done

a fantastic job getting that group to have a high-standard of play that's beyond my expectations. I couldn't be prouder of that group and what they bring to the table each and every single day."

Of course, someone will have to take the first handoff versus Eastern Illinois on Sept. 1. Last year, it was Waylee who led the team with 114.8 yards per game and logged four touchdowns before an injury ended his season early.

"He's been a constant pro since last year and I think he's taking on that

leadership role. Obviously getting hurt last year, I think it allowed him to step away from the game and learn and see things from a different perspective. He has that hunger and that desire. He came back in the spring and really grew up and matured. Now you see him out there competing and he's got some guys he's competing with."

Despite the praise from his head coach, Waylee stays humble and hungry.

"Right now, I'm just trying to get better on my footwork, but every day I

come in and try to be better than I was yesterday," said Waylee.

Regardless of being only a sophomore, he's one of the older guys in the room. He's taken it upon himself to be a leader and a teacher to the younger guys around him.

"From time to time they'll come to me with questions. I told them to ask me anything on their mind and I'll give you the answer. Or on the sidelines when we're looking at our plays or our hand signals, I'll quiz them and ask, 'what is that?

and 'tell me what that is' or 'tell me what he's about to do' or 'tell me or who's our ID, who's our read'."

Waylee added, "this season, I want to play my best and help my team make it to the championship again."

Although young, NIU has one of the strongest running back rooms in the Mid-American Conference.

"We feel like we've got a three-headed monster right now," said Hammock. "And, you know, those guys want to start and it's important to them."
