## Creston library referendum passes

District able to issue \$2.2 million in bonds after 117-46 vote

**ROCHELLE**—After a referendum passed on Tuesday, the Creston-Dement Library District is now able to issue \$2.2 million in bonds to build a new library building.

A total of 163 votes were seen on the issue in the Dement precinct with 117 voting in favor of the new library and 46 against it.

The total cost of the project is \$2.6 million. At least \$400,000 of that will be covered by grant dollars. With a 3.75 percent interest rate, which is the lowest and where the market is now, the property tax increase on a homeowner with a \$100,000 home will be \$72 on an annual basis. At 4.75 percent, the worst scenario for an interest rate, it's a \$79 year property tax increase for a \$100,000 home.

The process of bringing a new library to Creston has taken about 10 years. The main reason for the desire for a new building is the library outgrowing its current space at 107 S. Main St. The new library would be built at the corner

of Main and Cederholm Streets on land that was donated years ago for a new library.

"The library is a very important part of the community," Creston-Dement Library Board Member Doug Kroupa said prior to the vote. "What we'll see in town coming down Main Street if the referendum passes will be a new library that will be just about 7,500

square feet. This is a great time to do it. We're at low interest rates. The prices of materials are coming down. We're out of room in this facility."

In recent years, fundraisers have been done and donations have been received in the effort to bring a new library to Creston. That money has been used for the planning and legal processes. Cres-

ton's current library is not handicap accessible. The current bathrooms at the facility have had issues and senior citizens sometimes struggle with the stairs at the entrance. There is no storm shelter at the current location. The new library has plans for all of those issues.

Construction will likely start on the new building in 2023. The library board has

worked with an architect and has plans made up. The new library is planned to be a high-durability building with a children's area, adult area, study rooms, facility for meetings, a staff area, bathrooms that could be used as storm shelters, storage space, a patio, handicap parking and a 30-spot parking lot.

## Reflecting on five years of progress

**ROCHELLE** — In recent years, the downtown area of Rochelle has seen various new businesses and development projects.

Most recently, in a decision made by the Rochelle City Council earlier this month, a development agreement with Seldal Properties, LLC was approved for a \$1 million redevelopment of 318, 320, 322, 324 and 326 Lincoln Highway that will consist of mixed-use retail and residential space. The city will reimburse Seldal Properties, LLC \$300,000 after the completion of the project with tax increment financing money as part of the development agreement.

The storefront portion of the properties involved in the development agreement has been vacant for a number of years and is one part of the downtown area that has gone unchanged in recent years.

Included in recent changes to the downtown are the Hub Theater being

purchased and renovated into Kennay Farms Distilling and the renovation of other buildings and the opening of new businesses such as Midwestern Clothing Company, Acres Bistro, the ScaleHouse Lounge, Midwestern Clothing Company and Steder Tat-

too.

New businesses have opened on Cherry Avenue as well including gun shop DownRange, LLC, and Brewski's Bar & Grill filled the space vacated by The Rack Bar & Grill. Sissy's WildCard Saloon also changed ownership and

will be rebranding.

The News-Leader spoke with Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh June 15 about the recent progress of the downtown that has been a priority of the city's.

"There's just a lot of interest in our downtown and I think that's a great

thing," Fiegenschuh said. "It's definitely a testament to the vision our mayor and city council had and continue to have and the commitment of our staff. I'm very proud to be a part of it."

## District governor awards Rotary Club members

### Heal sworn in as newest club president, RTHS football team speaks at meeting

**ROCHELLE** — At Monday's meeting of the Rochelle Rotary Club, Rotary District Governor David Bills was in attendance and presented two awards.

"One thing that got left out during the pandemic was district awards where we recognize some of our clubs that have done so well over the year," Bills said. "We had some clubs really step up. Rochelle Rotary really stepped up this year."

The first award presented to the club was the Service Project of the Year for its work on the From the Heart Gala. Earlier this year just over \$68,000 was raised and just over \$8,500 each was distributed to area nonprofits including the Rochelle Area Community Foundation, HOPE of Ogle County, Rochelle Christian Food Pantry, Pegasus Special Riders, Hub City Senior Center, Shining Star Children's Advocacy Center, CASA and FOCUS House.

"That's absolutely amazing," Bills said. "That your gala was able to raise that money and the amount of organization it took. I hope each of you took time to think about the people you helped in the community. That's outstanding."

The second award was presented to Rochelle Rotary Club Member Chuck Watkins as Club Officer of

the Year. Watkins is a past president of the organization and has been with the club for many years.

Bills read from Rochelle Rotary Club President Sarah Flanagan's nomination of Watkins.

Up until 2009, the library had 60-90 patrons come in monthly and operated 15-20 hours a week. In 2010, changes were made and the library is now open over 40 hours a week and has seen 500 patrons a month at different times. Computers and resources have been added such as 3-D printing and model rocketry.

### Other local races

In the local Republican Ogle County Board Third District member race, Dan Miller, Austin Gillis and Joseph Simms will be moving on to the general election. Miller received 28.3 percent of the vote, Gillis received 28.2 percent and Simms received 27.7 percent. Jamey Sulser will not advance after receiving 15.7 percent of the vote.

In the Democratic Ogle County Board Third District, Lloyd Droege, Guillermo Martinez and Robert Snow will move on to the general election after the three of them ran unopposed in the race.

In the local Republican Ogle County Board Fourth

District member race, David Williams and John C. “Skip” Kenney ran unopposed and will be moving on to the general election.

### Ogle County

Republican Darin LaHood had a strong showing in Ogle County in the June 28 primary election, taking nearly 53 percent of the vote on his way to securing the nomination as 16th Congressional District representative.

There is currently no Democrat running. LaHood is seeking to replace U.S. Rep. Adam Kinzinger in the newly re-drawn district. Kinzinger is retiring.

“Thank you to the Republican voters in the 16th Congressional District for delivering us a resounding victory in the primary election,” LaHood said in a statement. “It’s clear that 16th District voters want a strong conservative voice and local advocate in Congress who will defend our Midwestern values. I look forward to the work ahead to earn the trust of 16th District voters in the general election this November.”

Gubernatorial candidate, Republican Darren Bailey, also carried the county with more than 64

percent of the vote. He will face incumbent Democratic Gov. J.B. Pritzker in November after beating a crowded Republican field vying for the governor’s office.

Bradley Fritts defeated Li Arellano in the Republican 74th State Representative District after winning 58 percent

of the vote district-wide. Fritts won 55 percent of the vote in 19 Ogle County precincts. No Democrat is seeking that office.

Locally, Tiffany O’Brien, who took over as Ogle County treasurer/collector on June 30 after Linda Beck resigned, garnered 5,817 votes running unopposed. No Democrats

are seeking the office.

Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle ran unopposed and received 5,896 votes in the county. No Democrat is seeking that office.

County Clerk and Recorder Laura Cook received 5,907 votes running unopposed. No democrat is seeking that office.

More than 81 percent of those casting ballots in the county were registered as Republicans.

## CITY: Fiegenschuh details biggest projects over last five years

Fiegenschuh said he liked the downtown when he started as city manager just under five years ago, but he’s enjoyed seeing more investment since. He likes seeing investment in any corridor of the city.

The city does what it can to assist those in the private sector that want to conduct businesses in corridors of Rochelle such as downtown.

“Nothing happens if you don’t have private investment,” Fiegenschuh said. “They’re the ones who fund it, pay the taxes and bring the people to the community. I firmly believe our job at the city is to be a partner with that and provide financial assistance when we can to bridge any gaps. And to also provide an environment where those businesses can grow and thrive through utilities and a lower tax environment.”

Fiegenschuh said that the city has made the beautification of the downtown area a priority. It replaced outdated streetlights with new colonial-style units with LED lighting. New Christmas decorations were purchased with pro-

ceeds from a city auction.

Utilities are also part of attempting to foster growth in town. On 4th Avenue in the downtown area, \$400,000-500,000 was recently spent by the city to replace outdated storm sewer.

“It’s not just reinvestment that you see,” Fiegenschuh said. “We’re updating utilities. You can have a beautiful downtown, but if you have heavy rainfall and half the town floods, there’s an issue there. We had flooding issues 4-5 years ago and that’s why we made those storm sewer upgrades. I’m proud of the infrastructure, too.”

The city recently applied for a grant through the state for \$1.25 million that if received, would pay for improvements such as additional parking and public restrooms. The beautification of the Page Park area has also been discussed by the city.

A facade grant program the city has that covers half the cost of improvements made to business fronts in town has been utilized recently by downtown businesses such as 926 Custom Embroidery, Pickin’ Station and Cheri Picked Vintage.

“I think there are a lot of additional things we can do,” Fiegenschuh said. “But none of that happens if you have empty storefronts. Our top priority is continuing to do what we can to assist people so they can open up a business in our downtown. And everywhere else in town.”

The city manager said he’d like to see more beautification downtown in the future along with more events like Cinco De Mayo and Lincoln Highway

Heritage Festival to attract visitors to the community.

Fiegenschuh recalled early in his tenure as city manager when staff sat down and talked about what they’d like to see downtown that would attract visitors. Different businesses have come into the area since. He’s excited about the Lincoln Highway development agreement that is planned to yield renovated spaces for new businesses.

“It just shows there’s

people who are willing to put a business in and there’s revenue to be derived from that,” Fiegenschuh said. “I’m hoping those open spaces will bring in businesses that we don’t have or it will bring in somebody who is working out of their home and maybe doesn’t have an opportunity at this point to find a storefront.”

The city’s portion of improving the downtown and other corridors of Rochelle is to provide an

area where businesses can grow through lower taxes, stable rates for reliable utilities, beautification and making sure that people that come to shop, eat and drink see a nice-looking, well-kept area, Fiegenschuh said.

“We’re going to keep plugging away,” Fiegenschuh said. “But downtown is not our only priority. We’re going to continue to focus on all of the corridors in our community.”

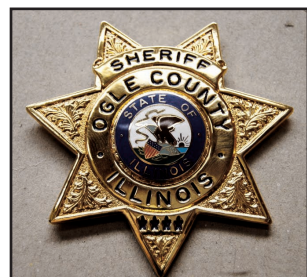

### Stay alert with school out for summer

**ILLINOIS** — School's out for summer. That means more children playing, riding bikes, running through the neighborhood, walking dogs and possibly playing sports on sidewalks and streets. The Postal Service is asking moms and dads to remind children about taking extra precautions to avoid accidents around mailboxes and postal vehicles. "Summer months bring more than heat and humidity, they also bring

kids outside to play," said Postal Spokesperson Sean Hargadon. "While this is the best time of year to be outdoors, a child can very easily ride a bike or dart into the path of a postal vehicle." There are several precautions children can take to avoid accidents. First, never approach a postal vehicle when a letter carrier is delivering the mail. Second, wait for the mail to be delivered before retrieving it from the mailbox. Third, children should never take mail directly from a letter carrier that is delivering mail from inside a vehicle. "If children approach a

vehicle, the letter carrier will get out and ask the children to move away," added Hargadon. "The carrier will deliver the mail directly to the box." Children should also limit the use of cell phones and other portable devices as well as pay attention to local street signs and observe the rules of the road when riding a bicycle. Observing these tips will help keep children safe during the busy days of summer. The Postal Service generally receives no tax dollars for operating expenses and relies on the sale of postage, products and services to fund its operations.

Suicide rates in the U.S. are down.

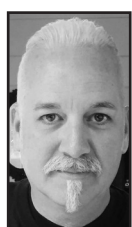

I thought of Jesus' words in John 8:7 when a woman caught in the act of adultery was thrown in front of him in the temple court. The religious leaders demanded that she be stoned. But Jesus said,

I was perplexed enough by this seeming dichotomy that I asked a Trump supporter about it.

His name is David Blumenshine, and he coordinates GOP gubernatorial hopeful Darren Bailey's campaign for much of central Illinois. He also was at the rally.

I asked him, as a believer, if he was OK with the "F- Biden" flags all around us.

"My wife and I aren't, uh, real pleased about it, but you know, it is what it is. We have a First Amendment for a reason."

I agree that Trump and his supporters have every right to say those things. But that doesn't mean they're constructive, unifying or good for the country.

Many in the crowd were ebullient over the U.S. Supreme Court's recent rulings overturning Roe v. Wade and

expanding gunowner rights. Trump promised he would appoint justices who supported such measures – and he delivered.

Those are political accomplishments his supporters can point to when explaining their support for the 45th president. All politicians cite their accomplishments, but few have the devotion that Trump draws.

A chaplain gave the invocation for the rally. During the prayer, which was interrupted multiple times by cheers, the pastor expressed dismay at the blurring of lines of masculinity and femininity. Hours later, Trump was critical of the transgender movement.

But in between, the crowd was entertained with such songs as "Macho Man" and "YMCA" by the Village People.

In my more than 35 years in the news business, I've never covered an American political rally like this one. The closest I have come was in 1999 in Havana, Cuba.

I had traveled there with Gov. George Ryan, and Fidel Castro held an impromptu news conference. A reporter asked the dictator, who had ruled for 40 years, if it was about time for there to be an election.

Castro walked out of the news conference and stood before a crowd of hundreds, perhaps thousands, who had waited in the heat to see him.

Castro yelled, "Is it time for an election?" The crowd in unison shouted "No! No! No!" And then they chanted, "Fidel, Fidel, Fidel."

It was unlike anything I have witnessed – until this past week.

As Trump cited his accomplishments, the crowd responded with their own chant, "Thank you, Trump. Thank you, Trump. Thank you, Trump."

My mind was transported back to Havana, and once again, I thought: "This is a personality cult."

## Consider this: Assault rifles

ACCORDING to Merriam-Webster dictionary, the definition of assault weapon is "any of various automatic or semiautomatic firearms especially: assault rifle." Let's consider why a semi-automatic AR-15 may be considered an assault rifle. Yes, it can be used for hunting, however, there are many rifles that can be and are used in this capacity. How about the semi-automatic point? Again, there are many rifles that are semi-automatic. A person can hunt with any of these rifles. And some of them are more accurate than others. Then we could consider the ammunition. One more time, the ammunition that is usually used in the assault rifle can be used in many other weapons.

Now let us consider the weight of these weapons. I cannot tell you whether an assault rifle is heavier or lighter than other rifles, but does that really matter? Maybe then it's the prey that dictates which type of weapon that should be used. Take prairie dogs and other varmints for instance. Some owners say they need AR-15's to take care of them.

One thing I do know is that assault rifles usually have designed attachments to cool the barrel as the rifle is being fired. Why cool a barrel? As the gun is fired multiple times, the barrel begins to warp a bit with the heat that is expended. This causes the gun to be slightly off causing the subsequent ammunition to land astray from the original target. Why is this important? Well, since most rifles are fired only a very few times when hunting most animals, it wouldn't be. But I guess in the case of varmints, a hunter must fire more often because there are so many and they would, eventually, be aiming improperly.

Other than varmints, what other prey requires the use of an AR-15 style weapon? It could be that because these rifles are sometimes smaller (shorter) than other rifles that would help maneuverability in small spaces. I guess I'll have to look at past news stories to find out what they have been used for in the past.

# Seebach continuing to chase MLB dream

**F**ORMER RTHS baseball standout Kyle Seebach wanted one more opportunity to showcase his talents in hopes of hearing his name called in the 2022 MLB First-Year Player Draft next month. After a successful five-year career at Northern Illinois University, Seebach began pitching for the Rockford Rivets earlier this summer, and the 6-foot-8 left-hander is off to a strong start.

Seebach recorded quality starts in each of his first four outings for the Rivets, who compete out of the Northwoods League. The RTHS alum currently holds a 3.07 ERA with 34 strikeouts and only 11 walks over 29 and one-third innings pitched. Seebach began his summer with back-to-back shutout performances against the Kokomo Jackrabbits and the Kenosha Kingfish.

“I trained on my own over the last two summers, but since I don’t have any more eligibility left, I wanted to continue to play and show myself in front of potential scouts,” Seebach said. “The Rivets had a spot for me and my plan is to keep throwing for them until after the MLB Draft. I think I’ve been performing pretty well so far and I know there are always things I can improve upon. It’s one last time for me to showcase myself in front of any scouts who are watching.”

Seebach, who earned his bachelor’s degree in computer science and probability and statistics last year and is nearly finished with his master’s degree in data analytics at NIU, said his primary focus this summer is to be selected in the MLB Draft, which would fulfill a dream he’s had since beginning his college career with the Huskies. The MLB Draft will run from July 17-19.

“It would mean a lot to me because I’ve been working so hard,” Seebach said. “I’ve had this dream since college and I’ve always wanted to be drafted or signed to an affiliated club. It would mean a lot because it would show me that I actually did it and all of my hard work was fulfilled. I think I can bring a lot of raw talent to whichever club takes me and I don’t think I’ve reached my full potential yet. I think that with a lot of proper help and work, I can become even better.”

Seebach threw a career-high 74 innings and struck out 64 batters for the Huskies during the 2022 season, his fifth with the NIU baseball team. After losing his junior season to the COVID-19 pandemic, Seebach opted to use his extra year of eligibility and return for a fifth season while studying for his master’s degree. Seebach appeared in 66 games during his career, throwing 172 and one-third innings and finishing his career with 172 strikeouts.

“Losing our 2020 season really hurt but it was exciting to learn that I would have an extra year of eligibility,” Seebach said. “It worked out to where I was able to finish my master’s degree and I wanted to continue

playing baseball because I didn’t think I had reached my full potential.”

Seebach last threw for the Rivets during the 2019 summer season, where he posted a 3.18 ERA with 22 strikeouts over 17 innings and two starts. Combined, Seebach has started six games and thrown 46 and one-third innings for the Rivets, striking out 56 batters and recording a 3.11 ERA. When asked to reflect on his career with the Huskies, Seebach said some of his fondest memories with the program include the 2019 Mid-American Conference tournament.

“It was a fun experience at NIU,” Seebach said. “It was amazing being close to home because my family was able to come out and support me. My coaches supported me and helped me progress a lot throughout my career. I made a lot of memories and I made friends that I’ll have for the rest of my life. The biggest improvement I’ve made since high school has been my general knowledge of pitching mechanics and how to make adjustments while on the mound.”

Seebach’s arsenal includes a fastball that has topped out at 93 MPH this summer, but sits between 89-92 MPH. In addition to throwing a changeup, slider and curveball, Seebach said he’s recently developed a cutter, which he has been throwing for the Rivets this summer.

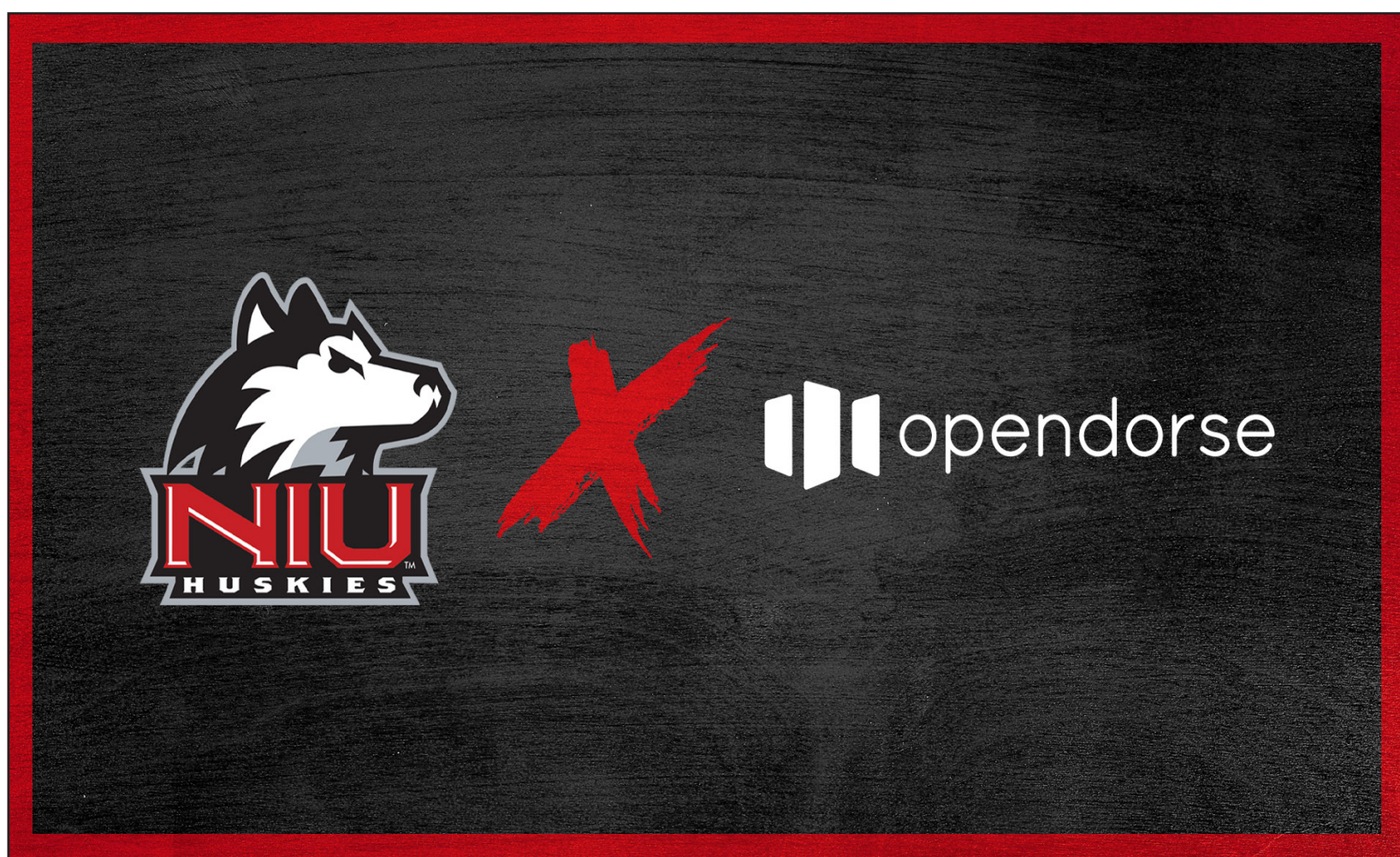
### Partnership with Opendorse enhancing NIL opportunities Huskie student-athletes to benefit from relationship with industry leader

ing initiatives, ticket sales and more.

The Opendorse platform will be available to NIU student-athletes and staff beginning in August. In addition, a community event is being planned for August for local businesses interested in learning more about NIL partnerships.

#### APR

All 16 Northern Illinois University programs once

again surpassed the NCAA Academic Progress Rate standards which annually measures the eligibility, graduation and retention of Division I student-athletes.

The report, released by the NCAA earlier this week, is based on annual rates from 2017-18 through 2020-21; the NCAA and member institutions have established a minimum standard four-year APR of 930 for every sport program.

Five Huskie programs posted a multi-year APR that ranked at the top of the Mid-American Conference in their sport. The NIU gymnastics and men's and women's golf teams all had

a perfect multi-year APR of 1000. The 2021 MAC Champion men's soccer team led all league programs with a 994 APR and women's tennis topped the MAC with a 993 mark. Volleyball's 995 APR ranked tied for second in the MAC; women's soccer's 997 APR ranked as the second-highest mark among all NIU teams.

In all, 11 NIU teams recorded a rate of 980 or higher for the 2020-21 report with 14 earning an APR above 975. The Huskies also did well in comparison with the national average by sport with 11 teams compiling an Academic Progress Rate

at or above the national average.

Each academic year, every Division I sports team across the country calculates its APR using a simple and consistent formula. Each term, scholarship student-athletes can earn one point for remaining eligible and one point for staying in school or graduating.

Last year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, APR data was not released publicly and penalties were not assessed. This year's APRs for each team, as well as previous year's numbers, are available online through the NCAA's searchable database.
