City declines Hickory Grove proposal

Rochelle planning to issue new RFP in coming months

ROCHELLE — During executive session on Monday, the Rochelle City Council discussed a proposal that was received for the development of the Hickory Grove property that was received from a request for proposal (RFP) process that the city put out to potential developers.

A city statement from City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh on Tuesday said the city would not accept the proposal at this time.

“The City of Rochelle has received one proposal to redevelop the Hickory Grove property,” the city statement said. “The city council will not accept the RFP provided at this time. We appreciate the developer’s willingness to invest in Rochelle and look forward to issuing a new RFP for the future development of the property in the coming months.”

Fiegenschuh and the city declined to provide more details on what sort of development the proposal involved.

The city council plans to meet privately in ex-

ecutive session again next month to talk about next steps for the property. Fiegenschuh said the council will discuss ideas of what they’d like to see at the site and a more specific RFP will likely involve a larger search and get into

the Chicagoland area. “We kept it pretty regional for the last one,” Fiegenschuh said. “Everyone on the council has different ideas, and we want to get them down on paper. There are specific things they’d like to see

at that site.” The Hickory Grove building demolition was completed earlier this year. The city assumed ownership of the deteriorating building in early 2020 for \$1 with the intention of demolishing it and devel-

oping the property. The building was previously owned by the Ogle County Civic Center Authority (OCCCA) board, which was under the Ogle County Board umbrella.

Rainwater Farms opens sweet corn season

‘Of all the 30-something years I’ve done this, I haven’t seen anything like it’

ROCHELLE — This past week, Jeff Rainwater got a call from a customer that said he’d been buying his family’s sweet corn for 30 years.

“He remembered when we used to sell just off Illinois Route 38 in town when our field in that area was larger before the business park back there,” Rainwater said. “I thanked him. People like that are why I’m still in business. Moments like that are why I farm. Hearing stuff like that makes me feel good.”

Rainwater Farms started selling sweet corn for the season on July 22 and opened its stands at 17557 Twombly Road and just off Illinois Route 64 in Kings. They’re open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Rainwater estimates the season will last until around Aug. 25 and possibly Labor Day weekend if the weather stays mild.

The demand for sweet corn at the Rainwater Farms has been “pretty high” in the past week. Rainwater believes that may be due to opening up before other

area sellers. He does his best to get sweet corn ready for sale as early as possible in the year.

“Maybe because we had a colder spring and others

waited,” Rainwater said. “I’ll gamble a little bit at the beginning of the season to try to be open earlier. My first two plantings are close to the buildings and

surrounded by feed corn on higher ground that’s warmer. It soaks up the sun and it’s a great place to start. It does well up by buildings. It keeps it out of the wind.

Sweet corn is a little more fragile than field corn and you have to expect less to be standing.”

"I was very interested in makeup and eyelashes growing up," Howlett said.

"When I went to school, it just came naturally to me. And then I just took the bull by its horns. I graduated last year in June. I took some time off for myself and I have a two-year-old son. This year I got the process started to open up and in March I started taking appointments and booking."

Howlett said similar self-care businesses such as AP Massage Therapy also inhabit the building at 951 S. 7th St. and then went into her decision when looking for a space. She hopes the services she offers locally will keep residents from having to drive out of town.

"Facials are so helpful," Howlett said. "I like to get my eyebrows done. To avoid having to go to Rockford or DeKalb for things like that, it will just be so much more convenient for people in Rochelle just to stop by. And with the other businesses in this building, they go so well together. It's like a one-stop shop here."

The work to get her business set up wasn't easy, but Howlett said she was thankful to her "very supportive" family that helps her create ideas and bring them to life. She thanked the chamber and the community for being welcoming.

Hogan named president of Ogle Natural Areas Alliance board

BYRON – Enjoying and protecting the natural beauty of Ogle County clearly means something to Trevor Hogan.

Hogan, a Byron native, has served on the Byron Forest Preserve District board and is now president of the new Ogle Natural Areas Alliance board.

“Nature, the outdoors, has done a lot for me,” Hogan said. “The world is more indoors, more virtual these days. The more we spread the word that getting outside is good for you and healthy for you, we are definitely advocates for that.”

Hogan and the rest of his board are also ready to spread the word about the new organization. They are hosting a deck party at the Jarrett Prairie Center in Byron on Friday, Aug. 12 from 6-9 p.m. Everyone is invited to learn about how they can support natural areas in the county. There will be live music, food and a cash bar.

The Ogle Natural Areas Alliance is a public non-profit that will work with the Byron Forest Preserve District to help with acquiring lands for public use through charitable donations and finding grant opportunities. Hogan said

that it is easier for people making a donation to go through the non-profit rather than a government agency.

Although the board came about after the Byron Forest Preserve District board put the need for such a foundation in its strategic plan, Hogan said they are open to helping other similar local agencies.

“What we are saying as a board, we are willing to work with any of these public land holding agencies that need assistance, or if there is opportunity there, we are here to help,” he said.

That includes the Oregon Park District, Byron Park District, Rochelle Park District and others.

“Our board can give anybody the benefits of what we receive,” Hogan said.

For now, the board needs to raise some funding to get started. It held its first meeting last year, but it wasn’t until all the paperwork cleared that it officially came together this March.

Hogan, a Rockford firefighter, said he served on the Byron Forest Preserve District board for nine years. The Ogle Natural Areas Alliance board has five members, who Hogan describe as conservationists.

He said the goal is to protect the land, and hopefully help it become a space for the public to enjoy.

“There are plenty of spaces still left in the Byron area, and tons of spaces in Ogle County that are great parcels of land,” Hogan said.

Some of that land, of course, is privately held. He said the Alliance board would be looking to work with people who want to sell or donate that land so it can be protected and enjoyed in the future.

“There are those opportunities out there, and people do want to protect some of their private land that they have put their life into,” he said.

For now, Hogan said the goal is to get their name out in the public and raise money. They will do that through private donations as well as grant funds.

Over the next few years, the plan is to build relationships with private donors who could make large donations.

Even further down the road? Hogan said that could see the county have its own forest district. But that would take time and a public vote, so that is not in the immediate plans.

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle will run an extra brush pickup on Monday, Aug. 1.

Large piles of brush that are too large for yard waste recycling will be picked up by the city. The program is intended for the disposal of limbs and branches removed by the property owner. Brush should be placed curbside in piles not exceeding eight feet in length. Limbs larger than 6-8 inches in diameter should be in a separate pile cut for crews to handle.

If your service will be affected, you will be notified via door tag with specific dates that work will be completed. Occasionally during

cleaning and televising, air pressure in the sewer can force water out of traps and cause water to splash out of toilets, sinks and drains. Please take the following precautions to prevent water damage in your home. Keep toilets flushed and close lids to cover toilet bowls when not in use. Close drain plugs in all sinks and bathtubs when not in use. Cover basement floor drains. You may return things to their normal state when

the equipment has moved off your block. Sometimes the sewer cleaning and televising may leave an odor in your home caused by drying out sewer traps. If so, run water down all sinks and bathtub drains, flush toilets, pour water into each basement floor drain and open your windows. After a short time, the odor should disappear. Basically, he says all life forms want to live, and other lifeforms are an unknown, so the safest course of action is to kill other lifeforms before they kill you.



Funding poses a threat to democracy

TWO of the biggest contributors to hard-core, Trump-supported candidates are not who you might guess: Gov. J.B. Pritzker and U.S. House Speaker Nancy Pelosi. Pritzker and his allies spent \$30 million trying to help Sen. Darren Bailey, a Trump devotee, to be the Republican gubernatorial nominee. Pelosi worked hard to see that two Colorado Make America Great Again candidates won the Republican primary. I'm not a fan of Pritzker, Pelosi or Trump.

As New York Times columnist David Brooks pointed out June 30, the Democratic Party is behaving recklessly and unpatriotically.

They think far-right Trumpist candidates will be easier to beat in the general election than more moderate opponents. So, they are intervening in the other party's primary to ensure that voters have the worst possible choices.

It's not even a remotely patriotic thing to do. Folks who love their country ought to want the very best candidates to advance – not the worst.

But here is the problem, these far-right yahoos whom Democrats are supporting could end up winning.

A retired state lawmaker took me aside recently and gave his objection to this relatively new phenomena.

"You've heard because of redistricting that politicians are choosing their voters rather than voters choosing their politicians. Well, this is even worse. The politicians are choosing their opponents."

And there is the rub. Democracy is based on a vigorous competition of ideas.

When the system is rigged to deter competition and limit voter choices, we no longer have a democracy.

Some Democrats believe that the U.S. Supreme Court's decision overturning Roe v. Wade will motivate pro-choice voters to come out en masse to support their candidates.

Sigh. How often in a lifetime does the average voter contemplate whether to have an abortion? How often do they fill their car with gasoline or their shopping cart with groceries?

In a world of hyper-inflation voters will be voting their pocketbooks. And that does not

bode well for Democrats, the party in power. It's also worth noting that the party controlling the White House almost always loses seats during the mid-term elections.

The more the Democratic Party becomes a group of Prius-driving vegans intent on fighting cultural battles, the less they understand working-class voters. You know, those folks who bag our groceries, pick up our garbage and babysit our kids.

They are hurting. Escalating gas prices have made their drive to work expensive and skyrocketing food prices have made feeding their families difficult. And no, they don't want a handout from the government. They just want to make ends meet.

An unbelievable 83% of Americans believe the economy is poor or not so good, according to a May Wall Street Journal-NORC poll. And an equally staggering 83% of Americans are dissatisfied with the way things are going in the country, according to a Gallup Poll.

And what kind of nonsense are we seeing debated? Whether mothers should be called child-bearers, and whether menstruators should be called "people with vaginas" rather than "female." Academics love such debates. But working-class folks find it off-putting. They see "mother" as a term of endearment, a point of pride — not a word of exclusion.

When a centrist candidate, Bill Clinton, defeated George H.W. Bush, he did it with the campaign mantra: "It's about the economy, Stupid."

Increasingly, party elites have lost touch with this message.

And before you think I'm defending Republicans, I'm not. Increasingly, the GOP has descended into cult-like devotion to a man who seeks to divide and for at least one day posed a threat to democracy itself.

But that doesn't mean his disciples won't do well at the polls. Voters are angry and his politics of grievance will play well in November. If they win, Democrats like Pritzker and Pelosi, who donated to their campaigns, deserve the blame.

The parties to be included in the lottery are Democratic and Republican.

First 2022 mosquito pool of West Nile Virus in Ogle County found

FORRESTON — The Ogle County Health Department (OCHD) has confirmed the first mosquito pool of West Nile virus reported in Ogle County for 2022. A mosquito pool in Forreston tested positive for West Nile Virus (WNV). Mosquitoes with WNV should be assumed to be present throughout the county. Mosquitoes will be present through the fall, so it is important to take precautions to prevent West Nile Virus in humans.

Monitoring for West Nile virus in Illinois includes laboratory tests for mosquito batches, dead crows, blue jays, robins and other perching birds, as well as testing humans with West Nile virus-like symptoms. People who observe a sick or dying crow, blue jay, robin or other perching bird should contact their local health department, which will determine if the bird will be picked up for testing.

West Nile virus is transmitted through the bite of a Culex pipiens mosquito, commonly called a house mosquito, which has picked up the virus by feeding on an infected bird. Common symptoms include fever, nausea, headache and muscle aches. Symptoms may last from a few days to a few weeks. However, four out of five people infected with West Nile virus will not show any symptoms. In rare cases, severe illness including meningitis or encephalitis, or even death, can occur.

People older than 50 and individuals with weakened immune systems are at higher risk for severe illness from West Nile virus.

Precautions include practicing the three "R's" — reduce, repel, and report.

Reduce: Make sure doors and windows have tight-fitting screens. Repair or replace screens that have tears or other openings. Try to keep doors and windows shut. Eliminate, or refresh each week, all sources of standing water where mosquitoes can breed, including water in bird baths, ponds, flowerpots, wading pools, old tires and any other containers.

Repel: When outdoors, wear shoes and socks, long pants and a long-sleeved shirt and apply insect repellent that contains DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus or IR 3535 according to label instructions. Consult a physician before using repellents on infants.

Report: Report locations where you see water sitting stagnant for more than a week such as roadside ditches, flooded yards and similar locations that may produce mosquitoes. The local health department or city government may be able to add larvicide to the water, which will kill any mosquito eggs.



The city decided to purchase the site so it could control it and likely would've had to deal with it later if it was abandoned due to OCCCA being in financial trouble.

The \$361,900 demolition project of the facility at 1127 N. 7th St. began in January. Half of the total cost of the project will be funded by a Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois grant reimbursement up to \$365,750.

Land transfer work is currently ongoing between the city and the Comfort Inn Hotel next to the Hickory Grove property. Four parcels the hotel currently owns would be beneficial to the city and eventual

developer and one parcel the city owns would be given to the Comfort Inn.

While the city manager is looking forward to eventual development of the property, he said he's happy to have made it to demolition completion, which was the main objective when the city bought Hickory Grove.

"And today, that site looks 1,000 times better than it did before," Fiegenschuh said. "That was the main focus. Our engineers and contractors did a fantastic job on that demolition. I'm happy we're at the point we're at now."

Short-term, community-type uses for the vacant property before it's developed may come up in future council conversations, Fiegenschuh said.

The city wants to be good neighbors to businesses in the area both in the short-term and when it comes to an eventual development.

More will be made clear on the property's future after council members bring back ideas and discuss them next month. The city hopes to get multiple development proposals in the future.

"Any time you have a vacant lot, you want to have multiple ideas for future development to review," Fiegenschuh said. "We want a project that the community can be proud of. This isn't a short-term process. We want to make sure we get the best fit for the site. We need to be patient and vigilant. But the main priority of the project was the demolition, and we got that accomplished."

Rainwater called the first 10 days of sweet corn selling a “monumental” amount of time, work and effort for himself and his employees. He’s a soybean and corn farmer as well. His hardest harvest work comes at this time of the year.

“It’s like starting a football season with the super bowl,” Rainwater said. “Everything else gets easier afterwards for the rest of the year. Sweet corn season feels never ending, but you try to get as much done as you can. It’s a lot.”

When anticipating storms before the weekend of July 23-24, Rainwater Farms employees were in the fields on Friday night picking sweet corn trying to beat the wind and rain. Rainwater said “there’s no normal” when it comes to sweet corn season.

In the 30-something years he’s grown and sold sweet corn, Rainwater said he hasn’t seen a product like this year’s and neither have his employees.

“Things have just looked so consistent and all the kernels on the cobs and the ears are so perfect,” Rainwater said. “It almost doesn’t look real. I don’t think I’ve had anything look or taste better than this year. We’ve had rain when we needed it. Temperatures have been right where we needed them to be. We’ve just been lucky to be blessed by Mother Nature. It’s been great.”

Sweet corn season takes “quite a bit” of manpower for Rainwater Farms. A team of people works to get sweet corn onto customers’ tables.

“It’s people like my vendors, employees and customers,” Rainwater said. “Farming is never just one person.”

Whether it’s sweet corn, feed corn or soybeans, it’s all farming to Rainwater. He appreciates the work most on days when things go right.

“I feel pride in and feel lucky to do whatever I do,” Rainwater said. “That’s why I get up and do it again. Being one with Mother Nature and having her help so much. Some days everything goes right and I think, ‘This is why I farm.’ It’s definitely something in my blood that I grew up with.”

“Our fifth-grade numbers are better than they were last year and I’m excited about that. It’s nice to see our kids back on the field. They learn a lot of life lessons throughout their time with our program. We understand that kids grow at different rates and it’s always exciting to see our kids stick with the program. They learn a lot about teamwork and they learn a lot about the game.”

The tackle football schedule runs through Saturday, Oct. 1 and includes eight games against Sterling, Princeton, DuPec, Stillman Valley, Dixon, Byron, Rockton and Oregon.

Throughout their time with the Rochelle Junior Tackle program, athletes learn the skills and lessons that will prepare them for future success with the Rochelle Township High School football program.

“The kids learn how to support each other,” Johnson said. “It makes us feel proud to see our kids succeed. Between our board and our volunteers, our coaches do a tremendous job and they’ve been through the high school program so they understand how to instill those skills at

the youth level. Seeing our numbers translate over to the high-school level is important to us. We’re a fundamental football league and when the success comes, it’s exciting to see.”

Rudolph named to Biletnikoff Award Watch List

Sophomore safety Brown named to Paycom Jim Thorpe Award Watch List

DEKALB — Northern Illinois University sophomore wide receiver Trayvon Rudolph (Crete/Crete-Monee HS) has been selected to the preseason watch list for the 2022 Biletnikoff Award, the Tallahassee Quarterback Club (TQC) Foundation announced on Thursday. The Biletnikoff Award annually recognizes the college football season’s outstanding FBS receiver.

Rudolph led NIU in 2021 with 51 receptions, 892 receiving yards and seven touchdowns. He set a new NIU and Mid-American Conference single-game record for receiving yards

with 309 at Kent State on Nov. 3, 2021 on 14 catches, adding three touchdowns. Rudolph also averaged 25.1 yards per kick return, scoring on a 100-yard kickoff return against Bowling Green. He was an All-MAC selection as both a receiver and returner in 2021.

“Trayvon has certainly made tremendous strides in our program,” head coach Thomas Hammock said. “He made his mark on special teams and made a jump last year as a receiver. We expect him to contribute even more. His best football is in front of him and this is a year he has circled on his calendar. He has put in the

work in to fully develop as a receiver and he’s ready to show what he can do.”

Rudolph is the fourth Huskie to be named to a watch list this week. Northern Illinois University sophomore safety

C.J. Brown is one of 35 NCAA Division I football players named to the Paycom Jim Thorpe Award 2022 Preseason Watch List announced Monday by the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame and Jim Thorpe Association. The award is annually presented to the nation’s top defensive back.

Brown, a Canton, Michigan (Walled Lake Western HS) product, led the Huskies in tackles in 2021 with 109 stops, 61 solo, en route to earning first team All Mid-American Conference honors. He finished the season ranked 10th in the MAC in tackles per game and had double-digit tackle totals in

four games.

He was named the Defensive Player of the Game in the MAC Championship game win over Kent State after leading NIU with 10 tackles, including a sack and tackle for loss, breaking up a pass and returning his first career interception 26 yards for a touchdown to give NIU a 24-3 lead late in the third quarter. Brown also earned MAC West Defensive Player of the Week honors versus Buffalo when he made 13 tackles, 10 solo, with 1.5 for loss in NIU’s overtime win over the Bulls.




