Developing downtown

City enters into agreement with Seldal Properties

ROCHELLE — At its June 13 meeting, the Rochelle City Council unanimously approved a development agreement with Seldal Properties, LLC for the redevelopment of five downtown properties on Lincoln Highway.

The agreement is for 318, 320, 322, 324 and 326 Lincoln Highway and the redevelopment will consist of mixed-use retail and residential space. The total project will be just over \$1 million. The city will reimburse Seldal Properties, LLC \$300,000 in five separate \$60,000 payments, starting upon the acquisition and completion, but no sooner than Dec. 31, 2023. The money will come from the city's downtown and southern gateway tax increment funding (TIF) district.

The work planned by Seldal Properties, LLC Owner Bruce Seldal includes an extensive remodel of the front facade of the downtown building and remodeling to 10 rental units upstairs and three of the commercial units below

for potential future tenants to open businesses in.

City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said June 15 that the project is "exactly why" the city established that TIF district.

"It's to redevelop older, blighted vacant buildings and beautify them, get them up to code, replace roofs and facades and all those types of things," Fiegenschuh said. "And then in turn, people will

want to rent commercially or live upstairs. We have people who are investing significant dollars into our downtown, which is great and it means people believe in our downtown and know there's an opportunity to turn a profit. People open businesses to make money. Obviously there are people who believe they can sustain their business in our downtown. And I'm very happy about that."

Fiegenschuh said that mixed-uses of commercial and residential are used in "a lot of successful downtowns" such as in DeKalb. The Lincoln Highway project is going to redevelop older rental units and address issues such as beautification, windows and energy efficiency that haven't been addressed in the past, he said.

Fairways building on record year

ROCHELLE — Last year was the best that Fairways Golf Course Superintendent Mitch Hamilton has seen in his 22 years at the facility.

Just over 13,000 rounds of golf were played at Fairways in 2021. During the pandemic-impacted year of 2020, high round numbers were seen as well, with around 11,000 rounds played despite the course not being able to fully open up until May due to restrictions. The one thing people could do that year was golf, Hamilton said.

"It's in the golf world now," Hamilton said. "COVID-19 sprung golf because we were able to go outside and play. The thing was, to retain those golfers after that."

HIVE Powered by BroadPath cuts ribbon

Business hiring for unique hybrid model in healthcare industry

ROCHELLE — A ribbon cutting was held Wednesday afternoon by the Rochelle Chamber of Commerce for HIVE Powered by BroadPath, a new local business at 448 Lake Lida Lane.

BroadPath has been a business process outsourcing company in the healthcare sector for over 12 years with over 4,000 employees working from home across the United States and abroad. Clients include seven of the top 10 health insurance companies, BlueCross BlueShield organizations and a number of regional and specialty plans.

The Rochelle site is part of a new program BroadPath has launched in partnership with UnitedHealthcare called HIVE, which is designed to bring quality work-from-home jobs into smaller communities where United does not currently have a presence.

"You think about a Fortune 50 company, they're not likely to come

into a small town like Rochelle or even Rockford and build an office," BroadPath Founder and CEO Daron Robertson said. "They're typically establishing themselves in more significant labor markets...but then so is everyone else. With wages skyrocketing, the compe-

tition for talent is fiercer than ever and it's become very difficult to attract and retain good people."

At the new Rochelle business, employees will enter a paid 6-week "college of insurance" program during which they will earn a health producer's license from

the state of Illinois and get trained to represent UnitedHealthcare in the Medicare marketplace. After successful completion of the program, they relocate to home offices and begin a 4-5 month tour of duty as BroadPath employees working on behalf of United.

Finally, if successful, they are positioned to transition to UnitedHealthcare around January or February as regular full time employees with "access to great benefits, higher earning potential and a wealth of career opportunities."

“I think part of any vibrant downtown is having a nice residential component to it,” Fiegenschuh said. “And this goes along with that theory. Housing is definitely an issue in our community. And we’ve got the new workforce housing project coming on the south end of town. We’ve had some discussions about some additional senior housing maybe coming to the community. Again, this is just one component of an overall issue that needs to be addressed and that’s good quality housing for our residents. If you want people to move to your community, they have to have a place to live.”

TIF is a geographically-targeted economic development tool that captures the increase in property taxes, and sometimes other taxes, resulting from new development, and diverts that revenue to subsidize a development. Construction of new buildings is not TIF-eligible.

Development agreements are “based on the financial need” of entities like Seldal Properties that the city works with, Fiegenschuh said.

“Our job at the city is not to pay for the project,” Fiegenschuh said. “It’s to close the funding gap to make the project possible. And that’s what that TIF district

does. [\$300,000] was the need Mr. Seldal requested. Those TIF dollars are just us rebating a portion of his tax dollars back to him. Everything Mr. Seldal wants to do is TIF-eligible. To get reimbursed, he’ll bring in all of his receipts and we’ll verify them through our

legal and finance teams and every year for five years in December after the project is completed, we’ll pay \$60,000.”

Fiegenschuh said having renovated spaces for new businesses is “great” and hopes they’ll bring in new business types the

city doesn’t currently have or give a business that’s currently home-based to chance to find a storefront.

The city manager has enjoyed seeing new downtown businesses open up recently and people investing in the buildings. The Lincoln Highway project

could yield “a lot of positive economic and social impacts,” he said.

“It’s one of the projects I’m most proud to have been part of because along with the Kennays and everyone else who has put money into downtown properties, it shows that

people are willing to invest in our downtown and that’s a good thing. It says a lot when someone wants to make that kind of investment downtown.

“And what it says is they believe in the downtown and the direction of our community.”

Kishwaukee College earns ICCTA Equity and Diversity Award

MALTA — Recognizing Kishwaukee College’s commitment to equity, the Illinois Community College Trustees Association (ICCTA) has recognized Kish with the 2022 Equity and Diversity Award. The honor recognizes the commitment of Kish’s board of trustees and leadership to achieve diversity, equity and inclusion in the college’s education programs.

ICCTA officials announced the award at the organization’s annual banquet on June 10 in Chicago. At the banquet, Dr. Laurie Borowicz, president of Kishwaukee College, accepted the award and recognized the effort the college has made over the past several years to improve the achievement gaps for all Kish students.

“In 2019, we produced our first annual data book. It pointed out some of the challenges we had as a college in student success. While our overall student college completion rate was increasing by double digits, this was not the case for some of our student

populations,” Dr. Borowicz said. “It’s hard to argue with numbers — we had work to do.”

In the same year, Kishwaukee College joined the Illinois Equity in Attainment Initiative (ILEA), the signature initiative of the Partnership for College Completion (PCC). This partnership between 25 other colleges and universities in Illinois allowed Kish leadership to take a hard look at the institution’s achievement data. Matching trends with the rest of the state, it was clear Kishwaukee College needed to provide more assistance to its low-income students and students of color.

The first step was creating a strategy. Kish officials worked with the ILEA and sought feedback from students and the community to design the Kishwaukee College Equity Plan, including a new equity statement: “We are committed to a sustainable culture of equity, focused on respect and fairness, in all aspects of the Kishwaukee College experience.”

Kish earned the recognition by implementing strategies to improve the college’s diversity, equity and inclusion over the past several years. College board members, leadership, faculty and staff were present at the ICCTA’s annual banquet to accept the honor.

Along with the college’s commitment to equity, the plan focused on six strategies, including developing an Intercultural Center, cultural competency training for employees, improved hiring practices, enhanced wrap-around services, creation of a math success program, and implementation of the Office of Instruction retention project.

ICCTA President Jon Looney praised Kishwaukee for its record of accomplishment in its equity endeavors.

“Three years ago, Kish-

waukee College made a bold commitment to inclusion, accessibility and success for all students,” Looney said at the award ceremony. “We applaud the work of the Kishwaukee Board and staff to reflect the needs of an increasingly diverse world.”

Early returns on Kish’s initiatives are positive. Students have received mentorship, tutoring, textbooks, supplies, financial support, food support and more. Completion and retention rates among underrepresented groups are

improving.

“In the last three years, I am proud to say we have made considerable progress in improving the outcomes of all of our students. We have not arrived but are on our way,” Dr. Borowicz said.

Many activities and processes are now systemized into Kish’s operations, and planning continues to expand under the leadership of a nine-member diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) core team.

“The Illinois community college system is truly one

of the leaders in the area of diversity, equity, and inclusion,” Looney said. “The work of Kishwaukee College and other community colleges is so important at a time when public discourse is too often filled with divisiveness and disunity.”

The Illinois Community College Trustees Association was founded in 1970 to support all public community college trustees through information exchange, training, and advocacy to assist them in effective leadership locally and statewide.



Deputies respond to two-vehicle accident with injuries

OREGON — On June 21 at approximately 8:42 a.m. deputies responded to a two-vehicle accident at Big Mound Road and Kilbuck Road. A preliminary investigation revealed Glenn Wille, 41, of Davis Junction, was eastbound on Big Mound Road in his 2015 Dodge Dart when he failed to stop for the stop sign at that intersection. Wille's vehicle collided with a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado being driven by James Sundly, 37, of Machesney Park. Sundly and his passenger, Dominic Patton, 19, of Lindenwood, were transported to Rochelle Community Hospital for suspected minor injuries. Wille was cited for disobeying a stop sign. All subjects are presumed innocent. The accident remains under investigation.

On June 21 at approximately 5:29 p.m. deputies, Monroe Center, Lynn Scott Rock, Stillman Valley and Kirkland Fire/EMS responded to the intersection of East Illinois Route 72 and North Mulford Road for a two vehicle accident with injuries. After investigation, it was determined that a gray Chevrolet sedan, driven by Mark Dunklau, 61, of Paw Paw, was traveling southbound on North Mulford Road, just north of East Illinois Route 72. The Chevrolet then continued traveling southbound into the intersection without stopping at the posted stop sign. The Chevrolet was then struck by a red Volvo truck-tractor, hauling a silver trailer driven by Alfredo Mantiel, 27, of Kirkland, who was traveling eastbound on Illinois Route 72 just west of the intersection. Both vehicles came to rest in the southeast

“We’re basically playing matchmaker between a world-class employer and an overlooked community,” Robertson said. “We get to bring awesome jobs into the community while giving our client access to an untapped pool of great talent.”

HIVE held a hiring event Wednesday and currently has 40 employees in the Rochelle office undergoing training. It plans to hire and train another 50 employees this year and if the process is successful, will recruit 100-150 new employees annually.



The danger of electing extremists

MARY Miller frightens me. Yes, I’m talking about the member of Congress from Southern Illinois who is running against Rodney Davis for the Republican nomination in the 15th Congressional District.

She is not pitching policies. She is selling anger.

But I could also say it is the same about a whole host of candidates on the far left or far right who mix anger, pandering and rigid orthodoxies.

You may remember Miller as the person who quoted Adolf Hitler on her third day in office and said his efforts to indoctrinate the young were worthy of emulation.

It doesn’t surprise me that there are people like Miller in politics. After all, I’ve been covering politics for more than 35 years. I’ve encountered plenty of cranks and conspiracy theorists during that time.

But the difference is that until recently, no one took those folks seriously. And then they began winning elections.

Today, extremists are redefining both political parties. And the country is not the better for it.

There are too many folks interested in stirring up anger but too few willing to get stuff done. The era of constructive compromise seems to be a memory of a bygone time.

My political leanings are not a secret. I believe in limited government, low taxes and protecting individual liberties. That said, I split my ticket between Republicans and Democrats in just about every election. There are good people in both parties.

I even vote for folks I often don’t agree with. For example, the late Sen. Paul Simon was far more liberal than me. But he consistently earned my vote because he exhibited integrity in how he conducted himself. He was also a thoughtful individual who considered all sides

of an issue.

The older I get, the more I’m convinced the key to progress is electing good people who think independently and act with integrity.

Miller is not one of those people.

She is running in the Republican primary against Rodney Davis, a conservative Republican from Taylorville. By all accounts Davis knows how to bring home the bacon to his district. If he is reelected, he’s in line to be a committee chair.

And most folks, no matter their political persuasion consider him to be a serious member of Congress.

But Miller, quite literally, has the Trump card. The 45th president has endorsed her and will be holding a rally for her June 25 in Quincy – three days before election day.

Miller is a member of the hard-right House Freedom Caucus along with others including Marjorie Taylor Greene, a Georgian known for comparing COVID-19 mask mandates to steps the Nazis took to control the Jewish population during the Holocaust. Greene is said to have lobbied Trump to endorse Miller.

Lord, help us. Miller, Greene and Lauren Boebert, the congresswoman from Colorado who falsely accused a Muslim member of Congress of being a terrorist, are card-carrying members of the Kook Klux Klan.

The 15th District was drawn by Democrats to consolidate Republican votes. Quincy is the biggest city in the horseshoe shaped district that covers one-third of the state’s counties including much of Sangamon.

Robin Johnson, a lecturer at Monmouth College and a Democratic consultant on rural voting behaviors, lives in the 15th and perceives an angry electorate.

“I see Mary Miller and Darren Bailey signs all over the place. I sense there is a real appetite for insurgent candidates. Could Trump’s visit make a difference? Yes. In a close race, it certainly could. And

we know in the areas where he had rallies he boosted his own vote totals. Whether that translates over to candidates he is campaigning for, we really don’t know yet.”

Davis is traditional, much like his old boss, John Shimkus. By no leap of the imagination is Davis anything but a conservative. Whether its taxes, guns, abortion or any of the other GOP litmus tests he comes out solidly on the right. But he has avoided the confrontational far-right politics.

In other words, he’s gentlemanly with those he disagrees with. And he seeks consensus to get things done.

Miller goes for the flash. She is more about capturing headlines and soundbites than seeking legislative achievements. It is a race between hard work and Hollywood. Or maybe it’s a choice between steak and sizzle.

A lot of political pundits have written Miller’s candidacy off. I’m not one of them. There is a real chance she can win. She is trying to tap into a pervasive disillusionment permeating rural America.

I know of which I speak. I live in the 15th District, grew up on a hog farm and reside in a village of 650. I know rural America.

Republican consultant Patrick Pfingsten said Miller is a member of the Trump personality cult. “Miller is part of a group of people who are content on raising cane, but never getting anything done.”

He added, “And at some point that playbook is gonna run out of plays. The dude’s 76 years old and one Big Mac away from having a grabber. So, he’s not gonna be around forever. And I have a really hard time believing that the party is forever in the eyes of Trump.”

The question rural voters – and all of us face – is do we give into the temptation of anger or the desire to get things done?

GOLF: Fairways seeing increasing number of rounds played

"Last year we noticed we were able to hang on to those golfers that basically tried it for maybe their first or second time in 2020. We retained some of them because our rounds went up. Now year after year, we're going to see if those golfers are going to stick with us or if we're going to lose them."

After the current season started slow at Fairways due to wet and cold weather, rounds have gone "right back up" to where they were in 2021 and have even surpassed them on a daily basis, Hamilton said. On Memorial Day weekend, over 100 rounds were seen each day, which is a lot for Fairways, Hamilton said.

"Eighty is usually a lot out here," Hamilton said. "That following week, we even averaged about 75 rounds per day. That was kind of the kick off of summer like everybody says. Since then, the weather has been great and we've been able to keep those rounds going up. Hopefully we can catch back up to where we were last year."

Fairways keeps track of where golfers live that play the course. In a recent report that was run to give a yearly update, Hamilton found that around 37 percent of its golfers came from outside the local ZIP code.

"That was nice to see," Hamilton said. "We do a lot of marketing outside of the area. We try to reach out to the new golfers from the suburbs and the

Rockford area to at least come down one time and try it and then we hopefully grab them and they keep coming back."

Hamilton called the golf industry "still tough," but said numbers coming up the past couple of years has helped to be able to sustain the golf course. Operations of the golf course have also been helped by working with the City of Rochelle and Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District financially.

Fairways has also been able to use park district and city equipment, which helps with work on the course that it used to have to contract out and has in turn saved money.

"Since the city and park district have been part of this, we've put some money back into the course," Hamilton said. "We're seeing a lot of people who have played it beforehand see all the upgrades we did and that's one thing that's attracting them to bring other people out here. We've done quite a bit of work these past couple of years."

When the city and park district took over Fairways, one of the goals was to upgrade deteriorating features of the golf course, Hamilton said. Equipment to maintain the grounds has been upgraded. Another project has been tree work and a major tree renovation was done this past year. 30 trees were cut down over the winter and the stumps were removed, ground, filled in and seeded. 30 more "problematic"

trees that were starting to impede on the golf course were trimmed.

"Whenever we do things like this, we work off our master plan we had done by a golf architect," Hamilton said. "Those trees weren't making the course fair. That's part of our master plan, to open up the course to see how it played when it was originally built."

Another recent project was a major renovation on every irrigation head on the course this year. A lot of them were old and leaking and were too much for the grounds crew to keep up with, Hamilton said. New irrigation heads were put in and the ground

around them was leveled out. That was a "huge project" that Hamilton never thought would get completed.

As far as future projects, the city has plans to put a shared-use path along Illinois Route 251 on the edge of the golf course that Hamilton said will most likely happen in the spring of next year.

"When they do that, we're going to end up repaving all of our existing cart paths that we have on the course right now," Hamilton said. "And then I will be looking into adding some that we want off our master plan. We're not going to hit every one on there, but we're going to

see where the costs are and go from there."

Hamilton said it's felt good to make progress on larger projects and that the city and park district have not only helped financially, but have understood the effort that goes into the golf course.

"And it's a process," Hamilton said. "It's not just throwing money at something and fixing everything right away. We're trying to make sure we're able to fix things without costing anybody any extra money. We're working within our budget and getting a lot done. I didn't think we'd be able to get this much of it done. And I think it's been because

of the uptick of golfers, where we've had the extra money coming in to actually really help and get some of these bigger projects done."

The Fairways superintendent has enjoyed hearing positive feedback from golfers since course improvements were made.

"People see it," Hamilton said. "That's the main thing. It's not even about me seeing it get done. It's when I hear longtime golfers that have been here since it was the country club see changes. We've had so many compliments about the tree work we did this year. It's good to hear them agree that everything we're doing looks nice."

Real estate financing options

THE decision to buy a home is significant. Real estate is the biggest investment the average person will make in his or her lifetime, which underscores just how significant the home buying decision can be.

The real estate experts at Zillow recently reported that the national median price of a home in the United States is \$272,446. However, since the National Association of Realtors reported a record low housing inventory late in 2020, the average house price has been rising rapidly nationwide. The Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis estimates the median home sales price at \$374,900, and certain states have much higher prices. WOWA, a real estate and finance technology company, says the average sale price of a home in Canada was \$679,051 in July 2021.

A Home Equity Line of Credit, commonly called a HELOC loan, borrows against the available equity in your home to create a line of credit, much like a credit card. These funds can be used for large expenses or to consolidate

higher-interest rate debt on other loans, according to Bank of America. It may be possible to use a HELOC to secure funding to make improvements to a home for those who want to flip it as an investment property.

Individuals investing in real estate who do not intend to use a property as a primary residence may turn to private money lenders. These investors can tap into capital from personal connections and lend at specified interest rates and payback periods, according to

Fortune Builders, a real estate investing resource. Keep in mind the interest rate will likely be higher with a private lender than through a conventional lender. The repayment term also will be shorter.

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has a program for acquiring loans through conventional lenders that will be partially guaranteed against loss through the VA. This enables a lender to give better loan terms, such as the option to pay no down payment. Interested parties need to

qualify for a Certificate of Eligibility and then work with qualified lenders.


The youth camp for fifth through eighth-graders will be held July 11-14 from 11-12:30 p.m. and the high school camp will take

Jackson takes first place at 2022 USTA Nationals

LAKELAND, Fla. — Seven-year-old gymnast Isabel Jackson of Rochelle can now call herself a national champion tumbler as well as one of the best young trampolinists in the United States. Jackson's tumbling and trampoline skills were on full display during the 2022 USTA Nationals, which were held from Monday, June 13 through Saturday, June 18 in Lakeland, Florida.

Jackson took two passes during the tumbling competition, scoring 19.5 on her first pass and 19.1 on her second pass to finish with a total score of 38.6 points, which landed her in first place out of 24 tumblers in the Age 7 Girls Sub-Novice Division. Tumbling is a gymnastics discipline in which athletes perform a series of acrobatic skills down a long track. Each pass includes several elements including jumps, twists and flips. Athletes are judged based on difficulty and form.

"It feels really good to be a national

champion," Jackson said. "I wasn't nervous, but I was confident and my coaches did a good job of getting me ready. The size of the room was different from the school gyms we are normally in. Being at nationals was a lot of fun. I enjoyed hanging out with my tumbling team and I enjoyed going to the beach with my family."

Jackson also brought home a fifth-place finish in the trampoline competition, scoring 15.8 points on her lone pass to take fifth out of 36 athletes in the Age 7 Girls Beginner Division. Jackson, who trains out of All the Wright Moves, has only been performing gymnastics for a short time. Jackson began tumbling in October 2020 before taking up trampoline in April 2022.

"I enjoy tumbling with all of my friends and I love jumping," Jackson said. "I like doing flip-flops and even though I don't have to do backflips during my routine on the trampoline, I like doing them at practice. I want to work on three flip-flops with a tuck during my tumbling routine. I want to start working on the next level of trampoline as well."
