Chamber Playday held Tuesday Herrera 'We are excited to be back to full strength...'

ROCHELLE — On Tuesday, the Rochelle Chamber of Commerce held its annual play day at Fairways Golf Course. The event was in full swing after two previous years limited by the COVID-19 pandemic.

"On behalf of the chamber, we thank you for coming out today," Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Tricia Herrera said to kick off the play day. "We are excited to be back to full-strength, sold out and full sponsorship. We had a rough couple of years, but like everything else, we're back. We couldn't do this event without our sponsors. This is our largest fundraiser and makes up a significant portion of our budget to do the things we do at the chamber every year."

The presenting sponsor of the event this year was the Burlington Junction Railway and the organization had employees on hand at the play day, including General Manager AJ Martin. The golf outing had a patriotic theme, and

participants were asked to wear red, white and blue. \$100 in Community Cash was given to the sponsor or foursome that was most star-spangled Tuesday.

Herrera said seeing the event back at full-strength was an "amazing" feeling.

"I love to see the people and members," Herrera said. "I love talking to them and asking them what we can do to help. All of that networking that's done on the course is such a great part of today."

The chamber enjoys helping members and people from the community

meet and facilitate relationships at the event that can result in the exchange of services or products in the future.

While attendance at the event in the past two pandemic-impacted years was down for safety purposes, sponsorships were not, Herrera said.

"Our sponsors knew that this was a big event for us and they supported us whether they were physically here or not," Herrera said. "For them to continue that through the pandemic and now get to see and thank them in person is just excit-

ing to me."

The play day had "a lot" of hole sponsorships Tuesday, where golfers played games and learned about services and how to help nonprofits. Those that attended the event braved 95-degree temperatures. "The chamber play day is kind of like Christmas to us," Herrera said. "We've had it in 95-degree weather and we've had it in 20-degree weather. We've had it in the rain. It never dampens the spirit of the event. That's what is exciting to me."

munities of Chana, Creston, Esmond, Kings, Lindenwood, Rochelle and Steward. Organizations eligible to apply for grants are nonprofit organizations with valid 501(c)(3) designation and units of government including but not limited to public libraries, schools and municipalities.

Wednesday's event saw grant recipients, RACF

board members and donors attend.

"The grant recipients are super excited to be here," RACF Executive Director Emily Anaya said. "It shows we believe in what they're doing. And that our donors believe. Because they continue to come back and fund. We have donor-advised funds that fully supported many of the programs

here. For a grantee to feel that and know that, they're extremely excited and they feel they have purpose and they're doing worthwhile work every single day."

Anaya said Wednesday evening was all about honoring and celebrating the good in the community, on both the donor and nonprofit sides. The grant cycle makes for "a lot of

work" for RACF, including its grants committee reading and evaluating the entirety of every application that comes in and meeting to make recommendations to the RACF board, which carries out the approval process. Grants are then gifted out and checks are presented ahead of the event.

Sheriff's Office begins July 4 safety campaign

OREGON — The Ogle County Sheriff's Office announced plans for stepped-up 4th of July traffic enforcement with a focus on impaired and unbuckled drivers. The safety campaign will run from June 16 through the early-morning hours of July 5 to encompass three summer weekends leading up to and after Independence Day. "It's simple: If you're driving, don't drink or use marijuana or other drugs," Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle said. "Our officers will be working around the clock to keep impaired drivers off the road and enforce all other traffic laws." The Sheriff's Office will join the Illinois State Police and more than 200 local police and sheriff's departments for the increased statewide enforcement effort. Use these tips to help ensure a happy and safe holiday: designate a sober

driver and give them your keys before you go out, don't let friends or family members drive under the influence, if you are drunk or impaired by marijuana or other drugs, call a taxi, take mass transit, use your favorite ride-sharing app or call a sober friend or family member to get you home safely, promptly report drunk drivers to law enforcement by pulling over and dialing 911 and make sure everyone in your vehicle wears their seat belt. It's not only the law, but also your best defense against an impaired driver. The "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over," "Drive High Get a DUI" and "Click It or Ticket" programs are made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation. The enforcement period runs concurrently with IDOT's media campaign, reminding motorists that "It's Not a Game" to drive impaired.

operating a motor vehicle with suspended registration. He signed a promise to comply and was given a June 22 Rochelle court date.

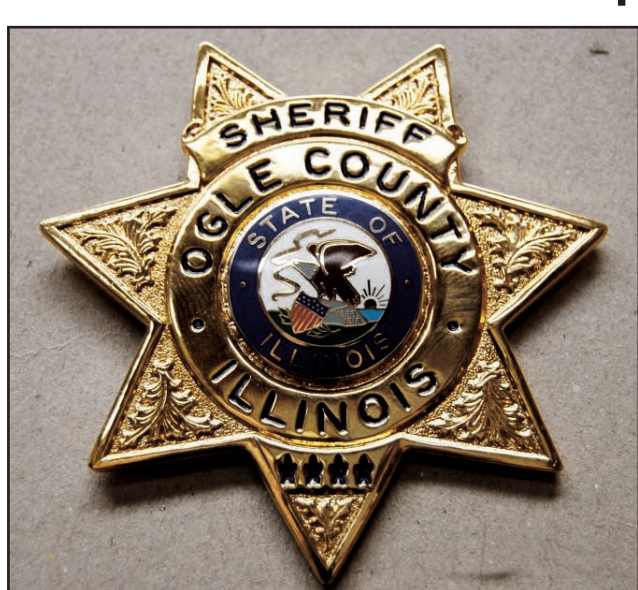

Deputies respond to single-vehicle crash near Route 64

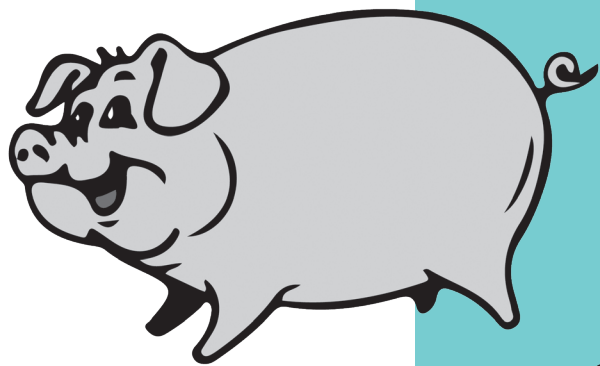

Factor in deduction of expenses that other people will commit to covering for wedding expenses, but only if you have concrete confirmation. A parent may host the rehearsal dinner. One's relative may offer to pass down an antique wedding gown to wear. But rather than simply removing these gifts from your savings calculations, keep them as a safety net to put toward unforeseen expenses.

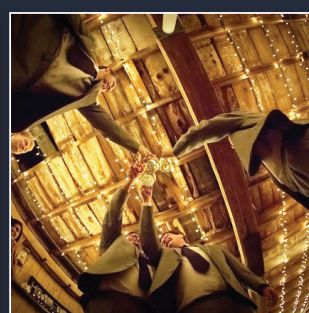

Picture perfect wedding day photography tips

FEW things document weddings more effectively than photographs. Carefully curated wedding albums and portraits hung on walls serve as daily reminders of a couple's special day. Photography is often left in the very qualified hands of professional photographers. However, couples can pitch in to make their photos really pop. These picture pointers from industry insiders can help couples put their best smile

forward. A carefully orchestrated timeline can ensure photos are the best they can be. Why? A wedding day is not a time for the bride or groom to try a dramatic new style, according to photographer Amanda Lamb. Resist the urge for a daring cut or

color. It's also likely not the place to try out new facial hair or heavy makeup. A couple unaccustomed to the way they look may be shy in front of the camera. Prepare wedding details, like gowns, shoes, accessories, etc., in advance to save time once the photographer arrives, suggests Desi Mendoza, a pro from Dez and Tam Photography. Invest in a beautiful hanger for the wedding gown as well, because you may want to photograph that on its own.

Couples can practice posing in front of mirrors to get a feel for body positions that put them in their best light. A photographer's advice in regard to posture is invaluable as well. Create space between arms and the body and learn how to angle the body so you look your best. Photos will capture wedding day memories forever. Couples can put themselves in the best positions for success by following some photography guidelines.

Factors to consider when planning your wedding day

THE notion that "timing is everything" is applicable in many situations, perhaps none more so than on a couple's wedding day.

Many couples spend months, if not years, planning their weddings in the

hopes that all that hard work will ultimately result in a day they will cherish forever.

The sheer volume of things to do on a wedding day can make couples feel overwhelmed. Those feelings can be overcome by emphasizing timing on the day of the wedding. Wedding day timelines will differ depending on variables that are unique to each couple's wedding, but the following are some factors to consider as couples organize the big day.

wedding parties.

Weather: Weather is the most unpredictable variable couples need to plan for on their wedding days. As the wedding day approaches, couples can monitor the day's forecast and then make any necessary changes to account for inclement weather. Getting around in a rainstorm will likely take longer than moving about on a sunny day, so some minor tweaks to the timeline may be necessary if storms or another type of inclement weather is in the forecast.

Couples can access wedding day timeline templates on various websites.

But it's important that couples remember that their weddings are unique, so online guidelines might not be realistic. A careful consideration of a handful of variables specific to couples' weddings can help them craft timelines that make their big day go smoothly.

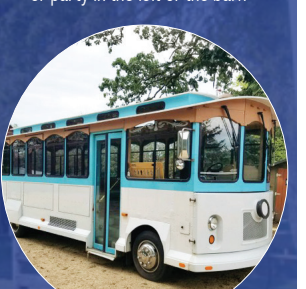
Venue(s): The schedule couples adhere to on their wedding day will be greatly affected by their choice of venue. Does the venue have somewhere on premises for the couple and their party to get ready? Are the ceremony and reception being held at the same venue? Before creating a timeline, consider the location of the ceremony and reception venue(s) and the accommodations each pro-

vides. Getting to and from multiple facilities won't be an issue if couples choose a multipurpose venue where they can get ready, tie the knot and dance the night away all in one place. Couples who will be moving from venue to venue throughout the day must build the time it takes them and their party to get about into their timelines. Wedding party: The size of the wedding party also bears consideration when planning a wedding day timeline. Large parties will require more time to get ready, and that should be factored into couples' timelines. Large parties also may be harder to corral and transport from place to place, so couples should build some extra time into their timelines to account for that. Small wedding parties can be easier to manage, so couples with small parties may be able to begin their timelines a little later in the day than those with large

How to get a perfect fit with your wedding dress

BECAUSE fashion preferences were once ornate and dependent on precise fits, ready-to-wear clothing really did not become widely available until the early 20th century. Such attire is now available in just about any retail store.

Because ready-to-wear clothing is so readily available, the average person may be unfamiliar with custom-made or tailored items. In fact, a couple's wedding may be the only instance in their lives when they require the services of a seamstress or tailor.

Fittings are a part of wedding planning, and here's how brides-to-be can navigate the process of finding and being fitted for a dress.

Try on sample gowns. The first step is to make your rounds to various gown shops and try on the samples they have available. Most sample sizes will not be the size you wear every day, so expect

them to be ill-fitting. Do not be discouraged. Once a gown is chosen, the dress shop will take your measurements and order the gown according to the manufacturer's sizing guide. Again, this can be shocking, since the size will likely be larger than what you wear in street clothes. Some shops will also order a little larger to allow for adequate tailoring.

Schedule the first fitting. The first fitting should be anywhere from eight to 12 weeks before the wedding date, according to experts at WeddingWire, an online wedding information provider. This is the time it takes to complete most standard alterations. Complex customizations can take even longer. Brides should also budget a minimum of \$500 for alterations, which may or may not be included in the price of the dress.

Bring shoes and undergarments. Remember to bring along the exact

shoes and undergarments you will wear with your gown. A change in shoes or bra/corset can result in the alterations fitting poorly the next time. Bring these items along to all subsequent fittings.

Speak up. Martha Stewart Weddings suggests speaking up at fittings if anything is uncomfortable or needs tweaking. Seamstresses are masters at their crafts, but only if they understand the desires of the bride.

Check the details. The second fitting is designed to check that all issues from the first fitting have been addressed, the gown is comfortable and you can move freely. At the last fitting, ask the maid of honor to come along so that she understands how to bustle or help you handle complicated straps or closures.

Open communication with a seamstress and bridal shop can ensure brides-to-be get a dress that fits like a glove.



Guidelines for tipping vendors during wedding receptions

VENDORS may be in the background during a wedding, but the roles they play are vital to making ceremonies and receptions memorable for couples and their guests. It's customary to tip wedding vendors who provide great service. The wedding experts at The Knot note that the following guidelines can help couples determine how much to tip the unsung heroes who make their weddings so memorable.

Photographer/videog-

rapher: Photographers and videographers are unique among wedding vendors because their work will be looked at for decades to come. The Knot notes that it's not necessary to tip wedding photographers and videographers who own their own studios. Their fees are all the compensation they need. However, many photographers and videographers do not own their own studios, and the efforts of such professionals are worthy of a little something extra at the end of the night. The Knot

notes that a tip between \$50 and \$200 is standard for these professionals.

Reception staff: The reception staff works as hard as anyone during the wedding, and those efforts merit a good tip. Many reception venues include gratuities in their food and drink fees, and couples can check to see if they have already tipped staff and if they think the mandatory gratuity is sufficient. A tip between 15 and 20 percent of the food and drink fee is standard. Maître d' fees also may be built into the

wedding contract. If not, a tip between \$200 and \$300 is standard and can be delivered at the end of the night.

Band/DJ: Bands and/or DJs can set the tone for a

fun night couples and their guests will remember for years to come. Tipping musicians is optional, but it's the norm to do so when they provide exceptional service. Couples who

have a band playing can tip between \$25 and \$35 per musician, while DJs generally receive a tip between \$50 and \$150.

Drivers: Many transportation firms also include gratuities in their contracts, so couples should check to see if they've already tipped limo or bus drivers before paying them a little extra.

If the tip is not included and the drivers arrive on time and get guests to the wedding on time, then a tip that's between 15 and 20 percent of the total bill is standard.

Delivery personnel:

Individuals who deliver items like cakes and flowers are typically given a gratuity upon delivery. A tip between \$5 and \$10 per person is standard, though individuals who deliver items like tables, chairs and portable restroom facilities and then set those items up may be deserving of a little extra.

Officiants: Officiants who are affiliated with a church or synagogue where the ceremony will take place are not typically given a gratu-

ity. However, The Knot notes that a donation to the place of worship between \$100 and \$500 is standard. Couples who still want to give the officiant a little extra can tip between \$50 and \$100. Independent officiants who receive fees directly from the couple need not be tipped.

These figures can serve as guidelines, but couples also can give a little extra if they feel their vendors have gone above and beyond.

Questions to ask prospective wedding officials

COUPLES make many decisions when planning their weddings. Everything from the design of save-the-date cards to the color of the napkins at the reception tables requires couples' input. Choice of officiant is another decision that's worthy of significant consideration.

Many couples may have an officiant in mind before they begin planning their wedding. In such instances, couples may choose an officiant who's affiliated with their place of worship or even a friend or family member who's been ordained or certified to officiate weddings. Couples with no such option can ask the following questions as they look to hire an officiant for their wedding.

Each state has its own requirements regarding who can sign the paperwork necessary for couples to be considered legally married. An officiant should meet these requirements.

Some officiants will do more than officiate the wedding. Some will help couples obtain their marriage license and even submit the documentation after the wedding. Those services can be important, but many couples are more concerned with what officiants will do before and during the ceremony. Ask if the officiant will write his or her own remarks to be delivered during the ceremony. Some couples may want to write remarks for the officiant, while others may need help crafting the message they want to convey.

Ask how officiants handle feedback and how willing they are to deliver remarks they did not necessarily write themselves. Some officiants

may have a template they customarily follow, but that doesn't necessarily mean they won't stray and personalize the ceremony based on couples' wishes. Couples should ask such officiants how far they're willing to stray from their routine if necessary.

Written testimonials from past clients can be invaluable, but couples can get a true feel for an officiant's style by watching video of ceremonies they've officiated in the past. Ask prospective officiants if they can share video of weddings they've presided over. It's not a red flag if officiants have no such video, which couples may have forgotten to share. But video can help couples get an accurate idea of how officiants may preside over their ceremony.

Many officiants will ask to meet with a couple at least once before the wedding so they can get to know them as well as possible. Ask each officiant if this is their policy. Pre-wedding meetings can be conducted in person or via Zoom. When discussing meeting before the wedding, ask the officiant if he or she will attend the wedding rehearsal. It's not customary for officiants to do so, though some might be willing to attend the rehearsal, especially if the ceremony will feature any elaborate components that require their involvement.

Couples also may want to broach some additional topics when questioning prospective officiants. Such topics may include:

Officiant's attire

Backups if the officiant falls ill prior to the ceremony

Officiant fees, and if extra services like attending the rehearsal incurs additional charges

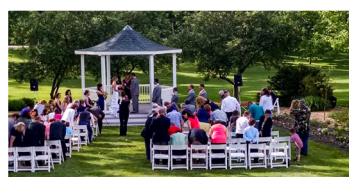

Then the bottom dropped out.

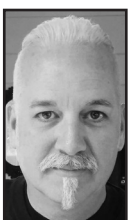
We got a call from the manager of the third band, the one who booked the gig, who told us the place had cancelled the gig. Apparently, the sound man couldn't make it.

The life of Jim Ryan

HE was a tough-as-nails-prosecutor who rose to become a two-term Illinois Attorney General.

But despite his success at the ballot box, he was not a natural politician. He hated the glad-handing part of retail politics. When reporters interviewed him, he was often stiff and uncomfortable.

But more significantly, Jim Ryan suffered from the hubris of not wanting to admit a mistake.

His life was filled with so much woe that shortly after his June 12 death his own family issued a press release comparing him to the Biblical character Job.

He lost a 12-year-old daughter, Anne, to an undiagnosed brain tumor in 1997. His 24-year-old son Patrick killed himself in 2007. His wife suffered from heart disease. And Ryan himself battled multiple bouts of Type 2 Hodgkin's lymphoma.

"From the time I met him until his death, Jimmy always was striving to do the right thing and to help people," his wife of 54 years, Marie, said in a prepared statement. "That was who he was and he was very successful at it."

When I read those words, I just cringed. He didn't always strive to do the right thing.

The Jim Ryan I knew sent two innocent men to death row.

And even when evidence began piling up that a mistake had been made, he just ignored it. The men's names were Rolando Cruz and Alejandro Hernandez. They were convicted in the 1983 abduction and killing of 10-year-old Jeanine Nicarico.

The two men initially were convicted and sentenced to death, but after several appeals and two retrials each, both were exonerated and another man ultimately was convicted of the girl's slaying.

John Hanlon, a Springfield lawyer who represented Cruz and Hernandez, recalls traveling to Wheaton to meet with Ryan in 1995.

"I thought there was evidence that the two were wrongly convicted. I suggested that we try to do this new thing called DNA testing to see if it would match them to the crime. But he wasn't interested and he refused to go along with it. If he had agreed to it, this case would have been resolved years earlier than it ultimately was."

That wasn't the action of someone driven by a desire for truth – or justice. Nor was it as his widow claims a desire to "do the right thing." He was blinded by the arrogance of power.

It was the biggest case of his career and he protected that conviction and used it as a foundation to build a political career. As he sought higher office, two innocent men languished on death row for a crime they had nothing to do with.

I last spoke to Ryan in 2002 when he dropped by my office to chat and discuss his run for governor. Even then, he was unwilling to admit he made a mistake. And after more than a dozen men on Illinois' death row had been found to have been factually innocent, he still clung to the idea that society should be able to kill its own citizens.

That arrogance of not admitting a mistake may well have cost him a chance to be governor.

In 2002, he was the Republican

nominee for governor facing Rod Blagojevich. The Chicago Tribune relentlessly criticized his handling of the Nicarico case.

"They said being governor is all about judgement," lawyer Hanlon said. "And if his judgement was this poor in the biggest case of his career, how good would it be as governor?"

Ultimately, Blagojevich won the race. But his judgement didn't prove too great either.

Suffering is the mother of empathy.

In the years following his return to the political wilderness, I often wondered about Ryan. Did he reflect on his mistakes and rethink his own political positions in the wake of his son's death and his own declining health?

There is reason to think so.

In 2010, he again made an unsuccessful bid for governor. But he failed to capture the Republican nomination. For the first time he apologized for his role in the wrongful prosecutions. He said he "acted in good faith and still came up with the wrong result." He added, "The system and I failed to achieve a just outcome."

I doubt those words provided much solace to either Cruz or Hernandez after spending years on death row. But at least he said them.

His spirited defense of capital punishment dimmed over the years as well. Ultimately, he said he had "grave concerns" about the institution.

If even a hard as nails prosecutor can change his mind, perhaps there is hope for us all.

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Lady Hub basketball team returned to the hardwood late last month for the start of its summer skill and agility camp, with several incoming and returning student-athletes lacing up their shoes and getting a head start on the upcoming winter season.

Lodico transferring to Benedictine University

INCREASED strength in the circle enabled former Rochelle student-athlete Bella Lodico to enjoy a solid freshman softball season at Judson University. After leading the Eagles in several pitching statistics, Lodico will make the leap from the NAIA to the NCAA Division III level as she continues her academics and her softball career at Benedictine University in Lisle next year.

"I chose Benedictine University for many reasons," Lodico said. "I knew that Benedictine had a successful softball program in the past and I felt welcomed once I met the coaching staff and most of the girls on the team. The school itself is very environmentally friendly and safe as well and it made me feel at home. I'm looking forward to having tougher competition and traveling further away. I feel like the competition will make me a better person and athlete as well."

Lodico appeared in 16 games with a team-high 13 starts for the Eagles during

her freshman season. The left-hander led Judson University with 34 strikeouts and three victories in 78 and two-thirds innings pitched while recording a team-low 4.72 ERA. Lodico, who finished 3-for-13 in limited at-bats, said her goals for next season are to improve her strength and consistency.

"I thought my freshman season went really well," Lodico said. "My strikeout-to-walk ratio and my ERA improved immensely. I grew stronger during my freshman year, which improved my arm strength and helped me throw nearly 80 innings. I hope to bring positive results with my pitching, my energy and my encouragement to the Benedictine softball team next year. I'm going to work hard in order to earn a spot to play for my future teammates and my family."

Lodico threw at least seven innings in five of her 13 starts with the Eagles. Lodico, whose wins came against Concordia University Ann Arbor, Penn State DuBois and Trinity International, said she intends to study psychology while minoring in Spanish and social work at Benedictine in order to earn her bachelor's degree and pursue a future career in the foster care system.

High school program hosts youth summer camp

Local grade-school and middle-school players practice fundamental skills

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Township High School tennis program hosted its annual four-day summer youth camp this week, with players ranging from third grade through eighth grade taking the court to learn the fundamentals of tennis and sharpen their skills for the future.

The camp began on Monday and concluded on Thursday, with sessions running from 8-9:30 a.m. for third, fourth and fifth-graders while sixth, seventh and eighth-graders played from 9:30-11 a.m. The camp is run by current high school players as well as head coaches Lizzie Cartwright and Kristy Eckardt, who was pleased with the numbers of attendants this year.

“The kids are so eager to learn because a lot of them have never played tennis before,” Eckardt said. “It’s great to see them pick up the sport and to see

the light bulbs flash above their heads when they hit a good shot. We introduce the kids to tennis and we make it as fun for them as we can. It’s not about being the best on the court. It’s all about making friends and having fun.”

The camp teaches players the fundamentals of tennis, which include volleys, forehand shots and backhand shots as well as serves, footwork, scorekeeping and movement. More experienced campers focus on skills including control, power and strategy through competitive drills. The experience helps prepare players for a possible future with the RTHS tennis program.

“We’ve had the most players out here than we’ve ever had since I’ve been here,” Eckardt said. “Anytime the kids can get a racket in their hands and learn about tennis ahead of time gives them a head start on possibly playing tennis at the high school level. It makes a big difference.”

Kishwaukee College athletics enjoy successful school year

MALTA — It was a very busy and exciting year for Kougars Athletics in 2021-22.

Fall sports led off the year with an exciting first-time accomplishment in Women’s Golf. The Kishwaukee College Women’s Golf team became the first team in both Kish program and NJCAA Region 4 history to ever officially qualify for NJCAA DI Nationals during the Region 4 and Midwest District Championship in November. The team would go on to finish 15th in the nation at the NJCAA Championships in May 2022 in Sanford, Florida.

Freshman Amber Fel-lows finished third at the Midwest District Championship while also picking up NJCAA All-Region 4

team honors. The team became the 32nd team or individual from Kishwaukee to qualify for an NJCAA Championship in College history and the fourth in the past five years.

The Kougars Men’s Soccer team finished second in the Arrowhead Conference and advanced to the NJCAA Region 4 postseason. The Kougars fell to Prairie State College (PSC), the No. 4-ranked team in the country, by a score of 2-0 in a late match push by PSC.

Two sophomore student-athletes, Andrew Leon and Victor Guerrero, were selected to the NJCAA All-Region 4 team, while Guerrero, sophomore Tyler Scarbrough and freshman Julian Garcia made the All-Arrowhead Conference team.

The Women’s Soccer team was undefeated against all Arrowhead Conference opponents in the fall semester. Finally, Kish hosted the NJCAA Region 4 Cross Country Championships on Oct. 31 for the first time on Kish’s campus.

Freshman Antonio Suarez finished just outside the qualifying rank for nationals but posted personal bests each time throughout the season. Additionally, the Kougars hosted the Sycamore Invitational earlier in the semester on Aug. 31 as about 20 high school boys and girls teams competed on the Malta campus.

The shift to winter sports in November brought out both the Men’s and Women’s basketball teams, who had not played

official games in 2020-2021 due to COVID protocols. Both teams earned victories in the postseason as the Men’s Basketball team defeated Kennedy-King College in the opening round of the regional tournament, which marked the first playoff victory since 2014-15.

The men’s team also earned more wins in one year compared to three of the past four seasons. Freshman Joshua Bocher was selected to the NJCAA All-Region 4 team, while Bocher and Freshman Jalen Smith received All-Arrowhead Conference team honors. On the women’s side, the team finished 16-12 and in third place in a very competitive Arrowhead Conference.

In addition, this season was the first time since



the 2018-19 season that Kishwaukee advanced to the regional semifinal game while also having the most wins in a season since 2013-14. Sophomore Olivia Lambritsen and red-shirt freshman Chian Scott were selected to the NJCAA All-Region 4 team

and Arrowhead Conference team. Kishwaukee also had the first full season of Men’s Bowling in College history as the team participated in five invites from September 2021 through February 2022.

Freshman Aaron Olson narrowly missed the average cut to qualify for the NJCAA national tournament in March.

The Kougars Esports team began its first competitions ever as a team in “Rainbow Six Siege” during the Spring semester after competing as a team in “Valorant” in the fall semester. The team narrowly missed the postseason in both events, while freshman Antonio Suarez competed in “Super Smash Bros. Ultimate” during both semesters, finishing just one win away from advancing to the NJCAA nationals.

Lastly, Kish’s spring athletic teams had their share of success. In softball, sophomore Carli Klein picked up NJCAA All-Region 4 team and Arrowhead Conference recognitions, while freshman Tyler Jacobsen received NJCAA All-Region 4, Division I team honors for baseball. Kish was to host the NJCAA Region 4, Division I postseason tournament, but weather pushed it to Triton College. The Kougars will look to host the Baseball DI tournament again in May 2023.

In the classroom, Kishwaukee College saw 33 student-athletes nominated for the Arrowhead Conference Bob Bopp Academic Excellence Team during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, ten student-athletes received NJCAA All-Academic team recognition. Women’s Soccer led the way with six honorees. Baseball and Men’s Soccer had five each. Women’s Basketball and Softball had four each, and Women’s Golf, Esports and Men’s Bowling had three student-athletes each receiving honors. Around campus, Kish saw various exciting improvements to its athletic facilities.

The gymnasium floor was redesigned at the beginning of the year to go along with the newly renovated locker rooms and a training room that were completed in 2020-21. Renovations continue as the soccer field has begun construction of a brand-new press box as well as the start of adding new softball dugouts plus new fencing areas. All projects should be completed by the end of this summer.

“It was a very exciting year for Kish Athletics,” said Scott Kawall, director of student involvement, athletic director. “Ultimately, it was great to see the passion return back in our Kougars’ programs this past year - both in competition and in the classroom. I am very proud of all our student-athletes and coaching staffs that put in so much work.”

HOLLYWOOD — Becoming **Elvis Presley** landed **Austin Butler** in a hospital. To become “The King” for his movie role, Butler immersed himself in everything Elvis, and his body went into overdrive. Even when production shut down due to **Tom Hanks** testing positive for COVID, he continued his character study. Butler revealed, “The day after we wrapped, I woke at 4 a.m. with excruciating pain and was diagnosed with a virus that simulates appendicitis that hospitalized me for a week.”

He attributes his collapse to living, breathing and doing everything Elvis to build his portrayal. The usually jaded audience at the Cannes Film Festival gave the film a 12-minute standing ovation, and when Butler recreated some of Presley’s greatest hits — including “Jailhouse Rock,” “Blue Suede Shoes” and “Suspicious Minds” — the audience went wild. Then when **Priscilla Presley** (Elvis’ former wife) hugged him, the audience broke out in spontaneous applause yet again. “Elvis” opens in theaters Friday, June 24.

Little known fact: When Butler appeared on Broadway in “The Ice-man Cometh,” starring **Denzel Washington**, his dedication to the role and the play impressed Denzel so much that he started coaching him, and unbeknownst to Butler, Denzel called **Baz Luhrmann** (who he’d never met and didn’t know) and sang the praises of his cast member. Butler admits, “Denzel didn’t call me beforehand, he didn’t call me afterward; it was just this generous thing he did!”

Rob Reiner, who recently announced he’s making a sequel to “This Is Spinal Tap” (40 years after its original premiere), was shocked when he heard he’s been banned from Russia forever by **Vladimir Putin** because of a video he made in 2016 condemning Russia’s meddling in our 2016 election. Reiner is in good company, because Putin also has banished President **Joe Biden**, Vice President **Kamala Harris** and former

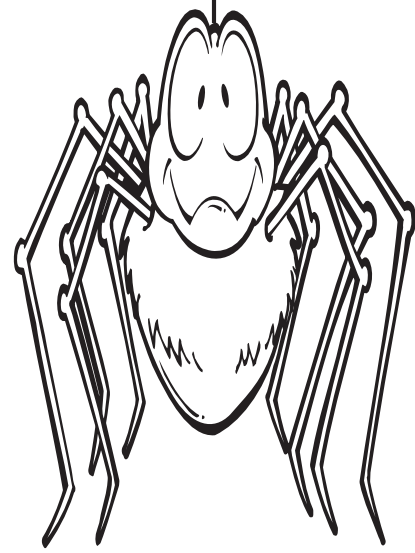
