## Library referendum June 28

### Board Member Korth: ‘We believe in what we’re doing’

**CRESTON** — Creston-Dement Library District officials are preparing for a June 28 election day referendum for residents of the district to decide whether or not it gets a new library building.

The total cost of the project is \$2.6 million. At least \$400,000 of that will be covered by grant dollars. The bond amount the district will ask for is \$2.2 million.

With a 3.75 percent interest rate, which is the lowest and where the market is now, the property tax increase on a homeowner with a \$100,000 home would be \$72 on an annual basis. At 4.75 percent, the worst scenario for an interest rate, it's a \$79 year property tax increase for a \$100,000 home.

In 1992, the Creston-Dement Public Library District became a taxing body. It covers more than Creston, expanding into the surrounding area to the edge of Lee County and towards Hillcrest. About 950-1,000 people live in the library district, Library Board President

Doug Kroupa said.

The process of bringing a new library to Creston has taken about 10 years so far, Kroupa said. The main reason for the desire for a new building is the library outgrowing its current space at 107 S. Main St. The new library would be built at the corner of Main and Cederholm Streets on land that was donated years ago for a new library.

“The library is a very important part of the community,” Kroupa said. “What we’ll see in town coming down Main Street if the referendum passes

will be a new library that will be just about 7,500 square feet. This is a great time to do it. We’re at low interest rates. The prices of materials are coming down. We’re out of room in this facility.”

In recent years, fundraisers have been done and donations have been received in the effort to bring a new library to Creston. That money has been used for the planning and legal processes. Kroupa said the library will be appropriate for a town of Creston’s size.

“We’re not planning on

building anything that’s out of bounds,” Kroupa said. “We built it with growth in mind so as the community grows, we can add on to the library if we need to.”

Creston’s current library is not handicap accessible. The current bathrooms at the facility have had issues and senior citizens sometimes struggle with the stairs at the entrance. There is no storm shelter at the current location. The new library has plans for all of those issues.

## Quiet zone work underway

**CRESTON** — At the Tuesday meeting of the Creston Village Board, Village President Tom Byro said he was told by Village Engineer Kevin Bunge that work has begun on the quiet zone project to end train horns in Creston.

At last month’s meeting, the board unanimously voted to spend \$10,400 on engineering to start the process of possibly getting the village’s railroad crossings turned into quiet zones. Bunge will bring village trustees cost options to improve the crossings at a future meeting. Options will include putting medians at the intersections, if possible, that prevent vehicles from going in between train gates along and having train horns at the crossings rather than have the trains use their horns through the village.

The village will also have to meet with larger organizations and have them sign off on the eventual project, which could take at least a year.

## Zoning board discusses Hickory Grove items

### Subdivision of Eighth Avenue parcel for storage approved

**ROCHELLE** — At its Monday meeting, the City of Rochelle Planning & Zoning Commission voted unanimously to continue two Hickory Grove-related agenda items to its next meeting for the second consecutive month.

The planning & zoning commission will not meet in July and its next meeting is planned for Monday, Aug. 1.

The first agenda item was a petition by the city to subdivide the property located at 1123 N. 7th St. to re-subdivide two lots and parts of others. One lot would be transferred to Rochelle Hospitality, LLC, the owner of the Comfort Inn & Suites next door to the Hickory Grove site.

The second item was Rochelle Hospitality, LLC petitioning to subdivide property located at 1133 N. 7th St. The purpose is to re-subdivide a portion of two lots into one. The newly-subdivided lot would be an exchange of land as per an approved

development agreement with the city. The land exchange would allow the hotel to build an exterior pool, in conformance with city codes, which is required by the franchise.

Both items will possibly be up for public hearing and approval in August, if ready. If approved, the items would go before the city council for final approval. The items had to be continued due to work

still being ongoing on the preliminary and final plat of subdivision.

City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh has said in the past that the subdivision and replatting and coming to an agreement on a land

swap must be done so the hotel can put in a pool and several parking spaces in the Hickory Grove lot that are owned by the hotel would be given to the city.

If the cost estimates of doing the project come back as too expensive, the board is not committed to spending past the \$10,400 in engineering it approved Tuesday.

"The quiet zone is just an ongoing progress," Byro said. "We're seeing what ideas we can come up with. It's going to take at least a year if not two. By the time you get everyone involved, it could even be three years."

### Appropriations

The board held a first reading of its budget appropriations for fiscal year 2023 for future expenses. It will be voted on at Creston's July meeting.

Village Treasurer Penny Payton said the current appropriations total is \$659,255, which is "much the same" as it was last year. Payton asked board members to bring up any necessary changes, including possibly adding more money to the village's utility funding plans with projects coming up such as well maintenance.

### Grant

Byro also said Tuesday that he was told by Bunge that he hasn't heard any updates on the application Creston submitted for an Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic

Opportunity Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown grant for \$780,000, \$195,000 of which would be matched locally by the village if awarded.

The grant would include reconstruction of Creston's downtown including new water mains and storm sewer, reconstruction of the street, all new sidewalks, curb and gutter, parking and more.

At previous meetings, Bunge has said the grant application process will take a year and if selected, Creston wouldn't start construction or have to pay any costs until the latter part of 2023.

"Their answer could be late spring or early summer of next year," Byro said.

### Utility work

Bunge also relayed to Byro that he's prepared to work with Village Water Operator Mike Megurdichian on an upcoming well rehabilitation project whenever necessary.

At last month's meeting, the board unanimously voted to move forward with well maintenance after a presentation by Megurdichian about Creston's water wells. The work will likely take place after summer is over.

Creston has two wells (well two and well three). Well three was drilled in

1980 and has never been pulled to be examined for maintenance. Pulling well three means replacements to its equipment will be made at a cost of \$40,000. The bid to make those improvements would include a backup plan in case the village's other well was unusable during the time of well three being maintained.

Well two maintenance could easily cost \$100,000, Megurdichian said. That was last done in 1996.

The design and permitting on a water main replacement project in Creston are also ongoing, Byro said Tuesday.

"We're rolling along with all these projects and I don't know when they're going to get done," Byro said. "I was hoping to get some bids out for some of this stuff soon, at least for the water lines. But so far, no luck."

### Water

Village trustees dis-

cussed issues with Creston's water that are being seen with chlorine similar to last year. Chlorine inputs are being raised to deal with ammonia issues. Village residents may taste or smell chlorine in their water and work on the issue is ongoing.

### Policing

Village trustees discussed issues in Creston including people riding motorcycles and four wheelers on the streets

and vandalism done to the village's pump station and back side of its water tower on Monday.

The idea of asking the Ogle County Sheriff's Office about having a deputy patrol in Creston was again brought up after brief discussions in recent meetings.

"I have not talked to the sheriff about a deputy possibly patrolling here, but I plan to," Byro said.

The next village board meeting is Tuesday, July 5.

## Rochelle Gardens Care Center fined by IDPH

**SPRINGFIELD**—The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) announced in its 2022 Quarterly Report of Nurs-

ing Home Violators that Rochelle Gardens Care Center at 1021 Caron Road in Rochelle has been fined \$25,000.

Rochelle Gardens received a type "A" citation of the Nursing Home Care Act.

An "A" violation pertains to a condition in which

there is a substantial probability that death or serious mental or physical harm will result or has resulted. The 74-bed skilled care fa-

cility was fined \$25,000 for "failing to protect a resident from physical abuse and failing to incorporate the Identified Offender Report

and Recommendation into the offender's care plan."

The report released by IDPH said a resident was abused by another resident.

## LIBRARY: Referendum for \$2.6 million project next month

“And the kids area will be bigger and more accessible,” Library Director Kristi Scherer said. “The library will be so much more readily available.”

Kroupa said recent efforts leading up to the referendum have included signs being put up to vote yes on the issue on June 28. Presentations have been made by library board members at meetings of other government bodies. A meeting was held earlier this year to discuss details of the proposed new library. Social media outreach has been done. Library board members said June 7 that they’re hopeful with the referendum vote approaching and that they feel positive after the work it took to get to this point.

“We believe in what we’re doing and we believe this is what this town needs,” Board Member Mary Korth said.

If the referendum passes at the end of the month, construction would likely start in 2023. The library board has worked with an

architect and has plans made up. The new library would be a high-durability building with a children’s area, adult area, study rooms, facility for meetings, a staff area, bathrooms that could be used as storm shelters, storage space, a patio, handicap parking and a 30-spot parking lot.

Up until 2009, the library had 60-90 patrons come in monthly and operated 15-20 hours a week. In 2010, changes were made and the library is now open over 40 hours a week and has seen 500 patrons a month at different times. Computers and resources have been added such as 3-D printing and model rocketry.

Kroupa said he believes a new library will help to grow Creston’s equalized assessed value (EAV) and make the village more attractive to prospective residents. If the referendum’s result is a no, the library will continue to do its best to provide services in the space it has, Kroupa said.

“It would be so much nicer to do that in a facility that is commensurate with the town’s needs,” Kroupa

said. “This is a great building we’re in now, but we’re just flat out running out of room and it’s difficult for people to get in and out. It would be disappointing if it wasn’t voted in. If we did it again the year after,

we know it’s going to be even more expensive with interest rates going up along with building costs. This is an opportune time to get a project like this going in town.”

The new library venture

is “probably the biggest project” in Creston over the past 10 years, Kroupa said. He takes pride in the library board always looking to the future, and the June 28 referendum is an example of that.

“We’re a very responsive organization to the community’s needs,” Kroupa said. “We constantly refocus on what’s next. This is what we need for today and tomorrow as we continue to grow.”

The Hickory Grove building was demolished earlier this year by the city as it works to get the site sold and developed this year. The city recently put out a request for proposal for prospective developers that are interested in the site.

The city assumed ownership of the deteriorating building in early 2020 for \$1 with the intention of demolishing it and developing the property. The building was previously owned by the Ogle County Civic Center Authority (OCCCA) board, which was under the Ogle County Board umbrella. The city decided to purchase the site so it could control it and likely would’ve had to deal with it later if it was abandoned due to OCCCA being in financial trouble.

### Storage units

The planning & zoning commission held a public hearing on and unanimously approved a preliminary and final plat of subdivision for light industry-zoned property on 8th Avenue for the development of a self-storage facility with six units by Haywell, LLC.

Property owners within 250 feet of the property were notified and City Community Development Director Michelle Pease said no complaints or concerns were received. The issue will now go before the city council at its Monday meeting for final approval.

City staff recommended approval of the preliminary and final plat of subdivision subject to the following: the final stormwater management plan being approved by

staff, final engineering being approved by staff, the final plat being modified where necessary from staff comments prior to recording and the posting of required surety prior to the recording of the final plat.

“I know this is a development of Tim Hayden,” Planning & Zoning Commission Chairman Kurt Wolter said. “The other facilities he’s put up in town are very nice.”

### Workshop

The planning & zoning commission plans to hold a training workshop at its August meeting for its commissioners.

“We’ve been working on an opportunity for you guys to be able to have some commissioner training,” Pease said. “In conversations with the commission, you all want to better understand what

your role is and the kinds of questions that are appropriate. It’s important to me that you are all comfortable and you know how much we value your time. We’ve been working with the American Planning Association to set up a workshop for you guys and we’ll have legal counsel here as well.”

## Stillman Valley man to remain classified as sexually dangerous

**OREGON** — Ogle County State's Attorney Mike Rock announced on June 8 that Ray A. Gough, 72, of Stillman Valley, was found to be a sexually dangerous person by an Ogle County Jury. The case was presided over by the Honorable Judge Matthew Klahn.

In November 2014, an

Ogle County Jury found that the respondent was a sexually dangerous person. Under Illinois statute, an individual found to be sexually dangerous can file an application of recovery every two years. That means that the person found sexually dangerous can complete a written application explaining

that they have recovered and are no longer sexually dangerous, a licensed evaluator will prepare a socio-psychiatric report and the court will set a hearing date and determine the outcome. Gough filed an application of recovery in 2020 and demanded a jury trial.

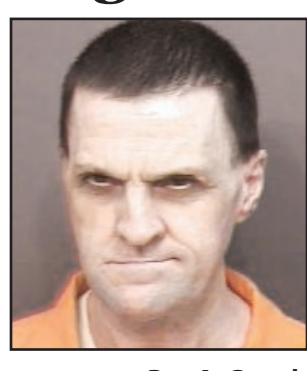
Rock and Assistant

State's Attorney Heather Kruse prosecuted the case at trial for the People.

"I'm very happy that the Ogle County Jury determined that the respondent remains sexually dangerous and that he stay in the Illinois Department of Corrections," Rock said of the verdict. "I also prosecuted the respondent in

2014 and I am grateful that the respondent's victims can continue to feel safe."

Gough will remain in the Illinois Department of Corrections under its treatment and care until such time that he is deemed not to be sexually dangerous or there exist conditions in which he can be safely released.

## State police arrest Polo man for possession of child pornography

**POLO** — On June 7, the Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) Zone 2 officials arrested Nicholas E. Duitsman, 25, of Polo for six counts of possession of child pornography (class two felony).

On June 7, ISP DCI Investigators executed an arrest warrant at Duitsman's residence in the 1,800 block of Brookfield Road in Polo following an investigation involv-

ing child pornography. During the investigation, DCI investigators secured evidence supporting the arrest of Duitsman, who is currently being held at the Ogle County Jail on a \$50,000 bond, 10% to apply. The investigation remains open and ongoing. No further information will be disseminated by the Illinois State Police.

### Let's save some mailboxes

“SOMEONE took out our mailbox again.”

It was my wife on the phone. We were talking while I was on my recent trip, and she was telling me a story about a crunching sound she heard. She figured it was another tree falling on our property, which happens every so often.

Turns out it was a speeding driver taking out our mailbox. Yes, this happens every so often too. In fact, in the more than six years we have lived in this house, it has happened four times. Three of those times the person crashed into our front yard as well. Thankfully we have a deep front yard, and our house is set well back off the street.

So, there I was, out buying a new mailbox post, digging a new hole, and setting that plastic beauty back in place so we can receive our daily pile of bills. Thanks, nameless jerk who didn't stop after hitting my mailbox. Oh yeah, my neighbor's mailbox was taken out too. He had to replace his as well. We joke about getting rich from mailbox insurance payouts.

We live on the south end of a curve that has a posted speed limit of 20 miles per hour. The road before it is posted at 30 mph. But people use it to get from one main road to another. I have no problem with that. I do have a problem with the speeders, especially the ones that take out our mailbox.

Repeatedly. I drive that road almost daily, and I can tell you it is hard to stick to 30 mph unless you use cruise control. But there are people walking, jogging and biking in the lanes made for them right next to cars with drivers who seem to be in a constant hurry.

## The history of hospitals in Rochelle

ONE of the earliest doctors to serve Rochelle was Dr. D.W. Vaile. He started his medical practice in Rochelle during 1853. He was one of several doctors to serve the community.

It wasn't until 1907 that Dr. Josephine Kennedy opened the first hospital. Located at 115 S. Washington St., and the Kennedy Hospital served the Rochelle area for two years. Dr. Kennedy performed operations and cared for patients in her hospital. Up until that point, patients were treated in their own homes.

By 1909, Dr. Kennedy had decided to close her hospital. In 1983, the house was razed and the land is now part of the parking lot for the Vince Carney Community Theater. Rochelle though had decided that having a hospital was essential to public health. A new facility was needed, and the search began.

For five years city officials and local civic leaders worked toward securing a hospital for the people of Rochelle. W.A. Wolf owned a two-story apartment building on the corner of 13th Street and Lincoln Avenue. Mr. Wolf agreed to trade his property for property in Compton, Illinois owned by Dr. A.W. Chandler. Dr. Chandler also received \$8,500 to relocate to Rochelle and become the director of the new hospital.

The two-story building was remodeled including the addition of a third story. By 1915, the Lincoln Hospital was ready to serve the public. Dr.

Chandler and staff oversaw a 40-bed hospital with surgical service.

The early 1920s saw the addition of Drs. Bogue and Schaller to assist Dr. Chandler. In 1925, Dr. Petritz of Rockford purchased a half interest in the Lincoln Hospital as Dr. Chandler moved toward retirement.

For the next few years, the Lincoln Hospital served the community well. The Great Depression of 1929 brought great hardship to the hospital and in 1930 the Lincoln Hospital closed due to bankruptcy.

Mrs. Marie Talcott leased the hospital in 1931 and later purchased the structure. Talcott had a medical background and had managed medical facilities before. Talcott turned the business around and once again Rochelle could provide an excellent hospital.

A substantial fire broke out at the hospital in 1941. Smoke poured from the windows and hundreds of people gathered outside the scene of the blaze. Fortunately, the fire department and hospital staff were able to evacuate all of the patients.

Local residents welcomed the hospital patients into their homes. Mrs. Edward Carls, who was removed from the delivery room at the hospital and taken to the home of her brother-in-law, Frank Hewitt on 6th Street, gave birth to a son an hour and a half later.

The hospital was repaired but not before several deficiencies were identified. Mrs. Talcott sold the hospital to John Tilton. Mr. Tilton ex-

pressed a desire to convert the hospital back into an apartment building. The City of Rochelle negotiated with Mr. Tilton and the City of Rochelle Hospital organization was formed in 1942.

The city rented the building for \$250 a month. Mrs. Molly Abbott became the superintendent and managed the facility for the city. One major change instituted by Mrs. Abbott was the opening of the facility to all local doctors.

From 1942 through 1945, the Rochelle City Hospital was managed through the City of Rochelle. A bond issue was voted on and passed in 1943, and funds began to be raised to construct a new, state-of-the-art hospital in the 900 block of North 2nd Street. October 1945 saw the setting of the corner stone and construction began in earnest. The new City of Rochelle Hospital could serve 25 patients and offered a newly-upgraded operating room and nursery. The city council once again met with local leaders and it was decided that the hospital should be managed as a not-for-profit, not under the control of the city council, but under the direction of an independent hospital board.

In 1965, the city transferred control of the hospital to the hospital board. From these humble beginnings, the local hospital has continued to thrive, providing life-saving services to all of Rochelle and Ogle County.

## Additional details released in fatal Ashton UTV accident

**ASHTON** — Additional details were released on the afternoon of June 3 by the Lee County Sheriff's Office concerning a fatal June 2 UTV accident in Lee County that resulted in the death of a 15-year-old Ashton-Franklin Center High School student and injuries to two others.

At 5:17 p.m. on June 2, the Lee County Sheriff's Office responded to a one-vehicle UTV rollover accident on Hoosier Road just north of Naylor Road in Lee County.

"From the results of the preliminary investigation, it appears that the

UTV was traveling northbound on Hoosier Road when the driver lost control of the vehicle causing it to rollover and subsequently striking a pole," the Lee County Sheriff's Office press release said.

Names of the students involved were released Thursday night in a press release by the Ashton-Franklin Center School District. The Lee County Sheriff's Office only released ages.

Fifteen-year-old Calvin Messer was transported to Rochelle Community Hospital and subsequently

succumbed to his injuries. Two other male occupants, a 14-year-old and 15-year-old, were injured and transported initially to KSB Hospital in Dixon and then transported to OSF Peoria for further treatment, the Lee County Sheriff's Office press release said.

The crash remains under investigation. The Lee County Sheriff's Office was assisted at the scene by the Ogle County Sheriff's Office, Ashton Fire Department, Franklin Grove Fire Department and Ogle County Coroner's Office.

# ‘Dr. Love’ moves on

## Athletic trainer reflects on 15-year career at Rochelle Township High School

THROUGHOUT his 15-year career as the head athletic trainer at Rochelle Township High School, Mark Lovell would hang photos and newspaper clippings of student-athletes, many that he formed relationships with or helped recover from injuries, on a bulletin board inside his office.

Some of the student-athletes even signed their names on the photos, symbolizing one of the many ways in which Lovell connected with the student-athletes during his time at RTHS. As Lovell’s decade-and-a-half run as head athletic trainer came to a close last month, the artwork had been taken down from the bulletin board, but a stack of clippings still remained on his desk.

“It was a weird feeling to take everything down for the last time,” Lovell said. “I even had a ‘Hall of Fame’ of injuries from photos that kids gave me that I stuck on the refrigerator inside my office... As I took those down, I couldn’t believe that this was really coming to an end. I still have graduation invitations and announcements from kids

who graduated roughly 10 years ago that I hung up as well. Looking through all of that stuff again, it was a very weird feeling for me.”

Lovell’s 15-year run at RTHS and Northern Rehab Physical Therapy Specialists concluded on May 28. He’s since started a new career with Amazon, working as an injury prevention specialist at the company’s fulfillment center in Beloit, Wisconsin. Lovell said he plans to continue living in Rockford with his wife Amanda, his 6-year-old daughter Cameron and his 4-year-old son Paxton.

“It’s hard to make the change, but I’m very thankful for all of the years I spent here,” Lovell said. “The kids have been so much fun to work with and they were very accepting of me and my personality. I like to hassle them and give them a hard time, but I always tried to make rehabbing injuries fun for them. The coaches here genuinely care about the kids and they’ve been great to work with. I loved my experience here and it wasn’t an easy choice to make.”

Lovell recalled several fond memories as both an athletic trainer and a spectator during his time at RTHS. Some of his

favorite memories include watching the Rochelle Hub varsity football team snap Geneva’s 24-game winning streak during the ‘Mud Bowl’ back in 2009. Lovell also enjoyed seeing the football team knock off previously unbeaten Johnsbury in the second round of the IHSA 4A Playoffs

in 2017.

During Lovell’s second day as the RTHS athletic trainer in 2007, he was forced to bring out a spine board for an injured football player, who Lovell rode with on a helicopter as they were airlifted to a nearby hospital in Rockford. It was during that

same summer that Lovell earned the nickname ‘Dr. Love’, a nickname that remained with him throughout his entire tenure at RTHS.

“I was 23 years old when I first started working here,” Lovell said. “My first day, there was a kid who was bleeding and

when I went to help him, he asked me what my name was and I said my name was Mark. He wanted to know my last name and when he called me Mr. Lovell, it was an odd feeling because nobody had ever called me Mr. Lovell before.”

# Track club enters 43rd summer season

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Area Track Club is back for the summer, with RTHS head coaches Alison Vrana and Dale Bergeson as well as current assistant coaches and student volunteers leading over 60 local athletes through a variety of track and field workouts this past week.

# Salinas finishes career strong at Knox College

**B**RITNEY Salinas will never forget the final moments of her softball career at Knox College. Well into her senior season, which concluded this spring, Salinas had been enjoying arguably the most productive campaign of her four-year career with the Prairie Fire, hitting well over .300 and starting every game in the outfield. But some of her most memorable moments came during the team's two-game homestand and season finale against conference rival Monmouth College.

Salinas was one of several seniors honored during the Senior Day matchup on April 28, which lasted 18 innings with Monmouth College outlasting Knox College 5-4. Despite the loss, Salinas went 5-for-8 with one double and one RBI in the game. The former Rochelle Township High School softball standout went 1-for-3 with an RBI and a stolen base in the season finale on May 2, leading the Prairie Fire over the Scots 5-3 and catching a fly ball for the final out of the game.

“I’ll never forget making the final catch for the final out in my final game,” Salinas said. “That was a special moment for me. I loved the team environment at Knox College, especially this season. I met some of my closest friends on the softball team and I always felt like I could relieve my stress and be myself. Knox College always emphasized school first, so I never felt like I had to choose between school and sports. It was a good balance and we had a lot of fun as a team.”

Salinas started all 31 games for the Prairie Fire this season, setting career-highs in several statistical categories. The center fielder recorded a .375 batting average while leading the team with 36 hits and 21 RBIs as well as a .430 on-base percentage and a .490 slugging percentage. Her five hits against Monmouth College were the most in a single game in her college career.

“I was really proud of how I performed this season,” Salinas said. “I loved our team chemistry this season and I felt it was the best it had ever been. We always picked each other up and kept our energy going. I wouldn’t change how my final season went or the people I shared it with.”

Salinas caught fire over the final month of her senior season, closing the season on a 12-game hitting streak while totaling 22 hits and a .537 batting average during that span. Her success at the plate helped her earn Second-Team All-Midwest Conference honors as well as the team’s Most Valuable Player Award this season. The awards were special for Salinas, who struggled with a shoulder injury during her junior season and worked to rediscover her confidence.

“The support from my teammates and

my family was amazing,” Salinas said. “I struggled last season with my hitting as well as a shoulder injury and falling into a slump. I wasn’t sure how I would come back this season. I worked hard over the offseason with my former travel team, Express Fastpitch, and I built my confidence back up. I broke my swing down again and when I returned to Knox, I continued to work with my coach until I felt my swing was smoother.”

Salinas started 101 games throughout her four-year softball career, finishing with 82 hits, 60 runs and 35 RBIs. Salinas, who received her bachelor’s degree earlier this spring, intends to enroll at Palmer College of Chiropractic in Davenport, Iowa, where she plans to continue her education for the next three-plus years before working under a practicing chiropractor. Salinas majored in biochemistry and minored in psychology during her time at Knox College.

“I always enjoyed the sciences, so I knew they were something I wanted to study further,” Salinas said. “Once I began exploring the biochemistry path, I realized that it combined my interests into one major and one that would greatly help me for my future at Palmer. With psychology, I always enjoyed learning about how the mind works and how it affects our thoughts, memories, emotions and behaviors. Psychology has interested me since high school.”

## Hubs back on the hardwood for summer camp

Rochelle team holding sessions on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4-6 p.m.

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub basketball program tipped off summer workouts Tuesday afternoon, with several returning student-athletes getting a jump-start on the upcoming season.

The summer skills camp will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4-6 p.m. at the Rochelle Township High School gymnasiums. The camp started on Tuesday, June 7 and will run through Thursday, June 30. Head varsity coach Tim Thompson said he and his staff will focus on several skills including fundamentals, setting and using screens, shooting, passing and post play.

“It’s nice to have our kids back in the gym and it’s now time for us to figure out what kind of athletes we have at all of our levels,” Thompson said. “We’re really going to focus on the fundamentals and skill development dur-

ing the summer. We’ll play about 15 games between the sophomore and varsity teams this month before we let our kids go back to their AAU teams.”

The Hubs will look to follow a successful varsity season this past winter, where the team finished 22-11 overall while winning the Interstate 8 Conference and IHSA 3A Regional titles. After losing a large senior class including two First-Team All-Conference honorees (Ryan Simmons and Adam Kemp) and two All-Conference Honorable Mentions (Noah Brown and Tanner Lager), Thompson will lean on last year’s juniors to take a step forward this summer.

“We’re going to work on our ball handling, our passing and our shooting,” Thompson said. “One thing we really want to focus on, especially with more bigger kids in our program right now, is post-entry passing. I think it’s a weakness in high school basketball and

it’s something we don’t do very well. Our returning post players will have to get more touches this coming season.”

Those players include senior forwards Raul Aguirre and Aidan Darby as well as junior Landon Mickley, who all participated in the first day of summer camp on Tuesday. Senior guards David Gerber, Colton O’Rorke, Landon DeLille and junior guard Eli Luxton were also active on the court Tuesday afternoon after earning their first years of varsity experience this past season.

“David and Raul have already stepped into a leadership role for us,” Thompson said. “They’ve been active in our group text and making sure our kids are getting to their weightlifting sessions every morning. Eli will need to take a step forward next season and we’ll need to see some more from our juniors like Landon and our returning seniors like Aidan, Colton and Landon.”

## LOVELL: Longtime head athletic trainer departs from RTHS

“That same summer, a kid named Dan Ruppenthal, who was the sophomore fullback, called out to me and said, ‘Dr. Love!’ I looked over and asked what he needed and when the other kids acknowledged that, they started calling me ‘Dr. Love’. The kids spread it around from there and now pretty much anyone will call me ‘Dr. Love’ which is funny because I’m not a doctor and my last name isn’t Love.”

Lovell’s interest in becoming an athletic trainer originated when he was a student-athlete at Joliet Central High School. Lovell, who grew up in the small village of Elwood and played basketball before eventually joining the volleyball team, suffered a dislocated shoulder while diving on the floor for a ball during his senior season. After visiting the emergency room, Lovell completed three weeks of physical therapy before

returning to finish his senior season.

“The basketball coaches were telling me that I should play volleyball during the spring,” Lovell said. “When I dislocated my shoulder, I was told in the ER that my season was over, but when I went to the orthopedic facility, they told me to do physical therapy and see where I was in three weeks. The doctors said there was a 90-percent chance my shoulder would come out again, but it was my senior year, so I went back out there and I made it through my senior season.”

Lovell graduated from Joliet Central in 2001. He then attended Western Illinois University, where he earned his bachelor’s degree in kinesiology in 2005 before continuing on as a graduate assistant and securing his master’s degree in community health education in 2007. As a graduate student at Western Illinois, Lovell worked with several of the university’s athletic

programs including the football, baseball, soccer, tennis and swimming and diving teams.

“Western Illinois was affordable and it was close to home, but far enough to where I felt some independence,” Lovell said. “We had a lot more freedom as students back then and I loved the ability to go out there and have that sense of freedom. My graduate assistant position prepared me a lot more than being an undergraduate student did because I worked directly under the head athletic trainer, Mike Pendergast, for two years. I covered my first college football game as a graduate assistant and it prepared me a lot because it was a bigger stage for me to sink or swim. We traveled a lot throughout my time as a graduate assistant and I was able to visit some bigger schools like Wisconsin, Nebraska and Kansas and check out all of their facilities.”

It was through Western

Illinois where Lovell made his initial connection with RTHS. While Lovell was an undergrad, he formed a brief relationship with Rob Neighbors, who was a graduate assistant at the time before eventually becoming the head athletic trainer at RTHS. When Lovell became a graduate assistant, an opportunity was presented to replace Neighbors at RTHS.

“When Rob made his decision to move on, he reached out to the head athletic trainer at Western,” Lovell said. “I was working football as a graduate assistant during that time and the head athletic trainer printed out the email and said Rob had nothing but

good things to say about Rochelle. I reached out to [Kevin] Crandall and he was the one who ultimately hired me.”

Lovell said he’s received several phone calls from former RTHS student-athletes, including some who graduated several years ago or don’t live in the state anymore, since the news of his departure surfaced last month. He said that working in Rochelle reminded him of the small-town atmosphere he knew from growing up in Elwood. Lovell said he’ll continue to be around and stay active in the Rochelle community as he moves forward with his new career with Amazon.

“I appreciate the small-

town feel that Rochelle has and I think there are great people inside and outside of the school,” Lovell said. “I never felt looked down upon and I always felt accepted here, not only from the school but from the community. I still interact with families whose kids have been out of high school for years. It’s always cool to learn what the kids are doing after high school and it’s cool to see the closeness of the community and see how the kids grow up. The continued connections I’ve made throughout the years are probably one of the best things about Rochelle. I’m a talker and there are a lot of folks here who’re still eager to talk to me.”
