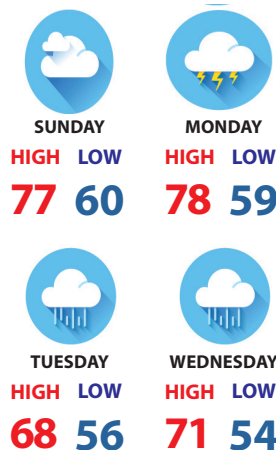

Little League holds National Cancer Survivor Month ceremony

4-year-old DeKalb girl battling cancer throws out first pitch

ROCHELLE — On Wednesday, the Rochelle Little League held a ceremony to honor National Cancer Survivor month for the fourth consecutive year.

Teams from every league gathered on the little league field for the ceremony. Banners were donated by local businesses commemorating the month and placed on each league's field. Before every game in the month of June, somebody who has cancer, is a survivor or was lost to it will be acknowledged and the song "We will rock you" will be played.

"Our slogan is #WeWillRockYou," Umpire Albert Burciaga said. "The meaning behind it is we're sending a message to cancer. Cancer, we're going to beat you, and we're going to rock you. The banners will stay up this whole month."

The ceremonial first pitch was thrown out Wednesday by Kate Lucarelli, a four-year-old girl from DeKalb. She was diagnosed with cancer in October 2020 and will finish treatment in January 2023.

Players from different leagues carried bases painted gold onto the field during the ceremony.

Every player wore something gold. That's the color of pediatric cancer, which the little league chose to focus on this year.

Little League Board Member Corey Kreider said the ceremony has gotten larger over the years and he believes it's a good platform to raise awareness so the young

players can understand cancer better. It shows the community that the little league is a family and is there for support.

"Especially with more and more kids getting diagnosed with cancer and more kids knowing family members that may have it, we just kind of want them to know that life is

short and baseball is still a game and it's still fun to do it," Kreider said. "Have fun and enjoy life. Life's too short to worry about the small stuff. The bigger the family, the bigger the support. The community's support makes little league a family."

Community Cash program launched

Herrera: 'It's another way for us to encourage shopping locally'

ROCHELLE — Mayor John Bearrows, the City of Rochelle and the Rochelle Chamber of Commerce have teamed up for a new Community Cash program.

Community Cash can be purchased at the chamber office at 501 6th Ave. for a one-to-one dollar to Community Cash ratio. It can be spent at any local business displaying the community cash logo. The program is still in its early stages and the chamber has a social media campaign planned to let the area know which businesses are participating.

"Say a store takes in \$50 worth of community cash, they come here and we'll cut them a check for \$50," Chamber Executive Director Tricia Herrera said. "There's no fee to be a part of it. The chamber is taking on the administrative fee part of it with our staff and printing and all of those things. Because it's just another way for our organization to support local businesses. We're going

to do some window clings to identify what stores are participating. Once we hear back from everybody, we'll put a list together and keep it on our website. That will be updated as we go forward."

Herrera said the program is something the chamber, mayor and city have wanted to do for a long time. Work was started on it just before the COVID-19 pandemic hit and put it on hold. Bearrows has long been an advocate for the program and worked to bring it to fruition.

"I really have to give the mayor credit for working hard to move this forward," Herrera said. "We love to partner with him. He's a very big supporter of shopping locally. Shopping local and shopping small are things we're very passionate about at the chamber."

Programs similar to Community Cash are used by other area chambers, Herrera said. She believes it will go a long way towards encouraging people to shop locally who maybe normally wouldn't.

She hopes it will help to educate the community on products Rochelle has that residents don't need to leave town for. Businesses large and small have already reached out to the chamber about interest in participating in the Community Cash program, Herrera said. Larger employers have asked about purchasing some to gift to their employees to both show their appreciation to them and support the community, "Say an industry comes in and buys a bunch for employees, our local businesses get to be part of that," Herrera said. "I think right now our next step is educating people on what the program is and what its goals are. Once people know that, I foresee it taking off. The fact that it's at no cost to anybody but the chamber is encouraging as well. You do not have to be a

chamber member to participate in this program. But if you are a chamber member, we'll offer some different things for those businesses." Herrera said during the pandemic, shopping locally became "a big deal" to support impacted small businesses. She doesn't want that feeling within the community to go away as COVID-19 fades. "I think the best things that came out of that time were the fact that so many businesses were supported and people learned what we have in Rochelle that they don't have to go out of town for," Herrera said. "They maybe didn't know that prior to the pandemic. They didn't know services and products that you could get locally that you could support. I think this Community Cash program will continue to help with that." Herrera called the chamber fortunate to have strong partnerships, in-

cluding with the mayor's office and the city. She enjoyed working with the city on the Rochelle Municipal Utilities Shop Local program during the pandemic that saw RMU customers get a credit on their bills for shopping locally.

The Community Cash program may yield a lot of work for the chamber office, but that isn't a concern for Herrera. "We're hoping it becomes a lot of work," Herrera said. "It's a program we've never done before. There will be some kinks

early on such as helping everyone to know what the program is. I'd like it to become a lot of work, because that means people are using and supporting the program. Our biggest thing is we're willing to

do whatever it is as long as it benefits our members. If people have questions, don't hesitate to shoot us an email or give us a call. I'm ready for another program to take off to help our members."

Immanuel Lutheran Church celebrating 150th anniversary

LINDENWOOD — “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.” Heb. 13:8

That is the theme for the 150-year anniversary celebration at Immanuel Lutheran in Lindenwood. And we thank and praise God for all of His blessings on the congregation over the past 150 years and pray that He will continue to bless Immanuel. The months long celebration will begin with a special worship service on June 12 at 9 a.m. Following the service there will be a community-wide picnic with family activities.

The first official recorded act of the congregation was the baptism of Franz Friedrich Wilhelm Broitzmann on June 10, 1872. During the founding years several pastors served the congregation in their homes. In 1875, Pastor F.W. Richmann, of Elgin, conducted Lutheran services every third Sunday in the Lindenwood Union Church.

In 1891 trustees were elected and on Aug. 10, the congregation purchased a parcel of land from C.E. Perry, upon which the first church was built. Later in 1911 the parsonage was built.

The Rev. Adolph C. Staats was called to serve the congregation and under his guidance St. Paul in Rochelle was organized on Feb. 24, 1897. He served both congregations for three years until he was called by the Rochelle congregation to serve them.

On Jan. 8, 1911, Pastor Herman C. Schoenbeck

of Rochelle was called to serve the congregation in Lindenwood and he introduced the practice of conducting one worship service per month in English. Prior to this all services were spoken in German. Starting in January 1942, German services were discontinued, and all services were in English.

The most recent building addition to the church was completed in December 2005, making the sanctuary and facilities handicapped accessible. This latest addition was conceived under the guidance of Pastor J. Derek Riddle, and was completed while Pastor David Yarrington was serving the congregation. The mortgage burning celebration for this expansion was conducted less than 10 years after the building dedication.

June 12 will mark the beginning of the 150-year anniversary celebration with Rev. Dr. Matthew Rosebrock leading the special worship service, and guest Pastor Rev. J.

Derek Riddle participating.

After the service there will be several activities: pitching horse shoes, sack races, a community potluck picnic and a home-made pie auction. Music entertainment will be provided by local talent Mike Crowe and church members will be roasting a hog for the picnic dinner.

This event will also be a fund raiser for Lutheran Church Charities Ukrainian Relief Fund. 100% of all donations going to Lutheran Church Charities will go to the relief fund. LCC then sends the financial aid directly to Ukrainian Lutheran Pastors to provide basic necessities to refugee families in Ukraine. If available, Lutheran Church Charities will have a comfort dog at the picnic.

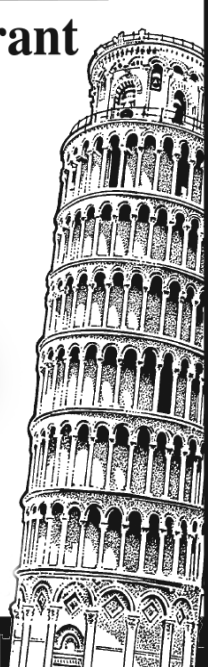

Inaction won't cut it anymore

I am not ashamed to admit that I shed a few tears for the children murdered in a senseless act of violence in Texas on May 24. A shooter went into a school and killed 19 children and two teachers. The parents of those kids will never see them grow up. They will never hold them again. They will never get to tell them they love them again.

It broke my heart. There have been more than 200 mass shootings in the U.S. this year. There were eight the weekend after the massacre in Texas. The numbers are simply numbing. This is an epidemic, clearly. But it is one we don't talk about seriously and with the intent to change things. This is generally a country of inaction. But we are frozen when it comes to gun violence. The reason? People are so deeply entrenched on each side of the issue, no one listens to those that disagree with them. Not listening or seeking compromise is also an epidemic in this country.

You see, there are those of you who have read this column up to this point and are convinced I want all guns melted down and turned into monuments of those killed. I don't. There are others who read that sentence and are convinced I have a stash of semi-automatic rifles in my home. I don't. I am a gun owner, but something must be done about these mass shootings. Something real, something meaningful, something that will save the lives of countless Americans – especially our children. Our children do not deserve to be gunned down anywhere, but especially at school, a place of learning and discovery.

I am not here to offer up solutions – there are many of them already out there and known to pretty much anyone paying attention. And no, the solution is not home schooling all children as some have suggested. If we go that route, we might as well just give up. But the problem, again, comes back to listening. We can't find workable solutions because we can't do the first thing we need to do – sit down and talk about this. And by us, I mean politicians. Sadly, they spend way more time grandstanding on this issue – and many others – than actually finding solutions. They are bought and paid for by special interests, so they can't even pretend to want to find solutions to this horrible and growing problem. Instead, it falls on places like schools to try to keep children safe. Soon, schools will be like prisons. Will that matter to those entrenched on each side of this issue? They will say yes, but their inaction will say a very loud "no."

Elected officials, please do something. Start by listening. Listen to things that make you uncomfortable or angry or sad. Listen. Listen to those you strongly disagree with. Hear what they have to say. That is where we must start. It is a conversation we have never really had – it is generally yelling and sloganeering and inaction. Well, inaction just won't cut it anymore. The leading cause of death among children and teens in the U.S. is now firearm-related injuries, according to the New England Journal of Medicine. I find that sickening and shocking. Clearly, we must act. It all starts with an honest, open conversation.

Being the son of a veterinarian

AS Father's Day approaches, I find myself contemplating the veterinarians in my life.

You see, I've been blessed with two veterinarians – my father and my wife.

Growing up, I was always "Doc Reeder's boy." Together we would ride from farm to farm across Knox and Warren counties. I observed and helped with countless surgeries.

Sometimes it was as simple as, "Hold the flashlight, Scotty."

Later, as a teenager, I was gripping the edges of a uterus incision as my father pulled a calf into the world during a Caesarean section.

I remember when I was in kindergarten, sitting cross legged in a barnyard answering my Dad's questions.

"How many stomachs does a cow have, Scotty?"

"Four, Dad."

"Well let's take a look at them, Scotty."

He then proceeded to perform a post mortem, explaining the purpose of each organ in language a 5-year-old could understand.

I remember falling off my bicycle in the second grade and walking home with an injured arm. My father took a look at it and

said, "It's either a fracture or a really bad sprain."

His next step was to take me to the veterinary clinic for an x-ray.

I still remember him striding into Cottage Hospital's emergency room with me by his side. He hollered, "He doesn't need to go to radiology, I've got an x-ray film right here."

Animal doctors seem more direct and practical than their human counterparts. Perhaps it's not having to deal with lawsuits and hospital politics.

But it goes beyond that.

Animal doctors have such an intense love for creatures that their homes tend to become, well, menageries.

When I asked my wife for her hand in marriage, I made her promise: no animals would be added to our family -- unless we both agreed.

She hasn't exactly respected this wedding vow. OK, perhaps she has won my repeated acquiescence by continually wearing me down.

I suspect the only reason I asked for the promise was because of childhood memories.

When I was 8, my dad came home with a billy goat. Dad was vaccinating cattle at a sale barn and as

a joke bid \$5 on a lonely goat that had no ears.

We ended up owning the beast that devoured newspapers, cigarette butts and just about anything else. The ruminant had no respect for fences or screen doors.

No sooner had the goat been put in the pasture than it jumped the fence, ran across our yard, peered through the screen door and baaed loudly. Apparently, it had once been a house goat.

My mother took to chasing Billy off of the porch with a broom — until he ate the broom.

Having no respect for fences, the animal took to sunning itself on the front porch, which caused more than

a few drivers to nearly swerve off the gravel road that ran by our house.

Given this history, you'd think I'd have gone into marriage to a vet with my eyes wide open. Dream on. My wife brought a cat into the marriage that hated all men. Within a week, the cat marked my suit and every freshly pressed white shirt of mine hanging in the closet.

But marital adventures in felines didn't end there. A couple of years after we wed, my wife was more

than eight months pregnant with our first daughter and she came home with a kitten that was born without eyes.

Between sobs, Joan said, "They wanted me to put him to sleep just because he was born this way. I couldn't do it, Scott. What happens if our child is born without any eyes?" As my pregnant wife stroked the blind kitten she added, "It's just a foster cat. It will stay with us just until we find someone who will give him a home permanently."

The "foster cat" lived with us for another 13 years. It had the floor plan of the house memorized, avoided the kids' toys on the floor with an eerie sixth sense and lounged on the window sill like a prince on a throne.

The current census in our home is: nine dogs, three guinea pigs, six birds, three sugar gliders (flying squirrels), two ferrets and one very overwhelmed cat.

Dad has been gone now almost five years. But I think about him every day when I scratch a dog behind the ear, give the cat a tummy rub – or go to the hospital for an x-ray.

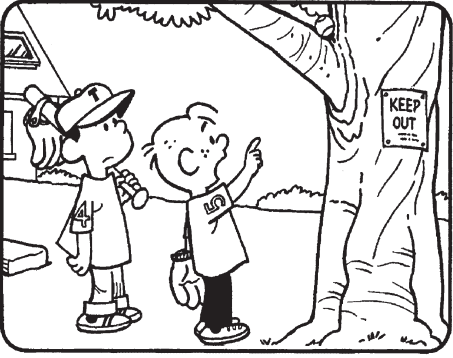

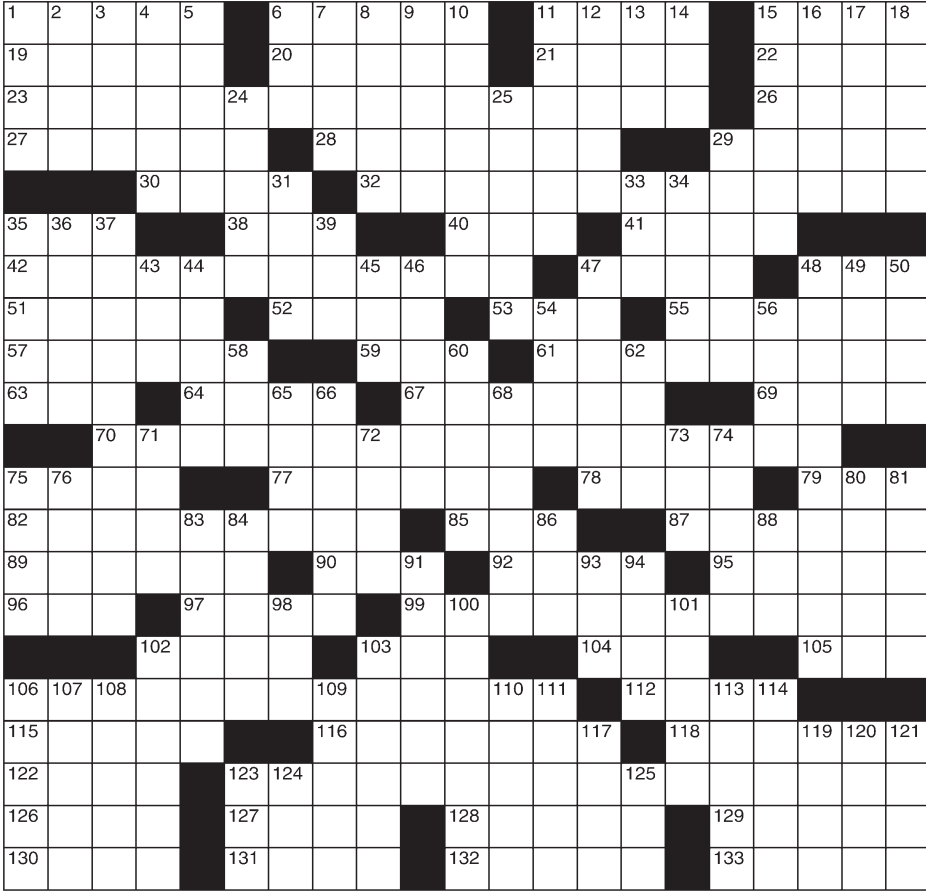

tend this recycling event. Permits are limited and must be requested by 4 p.m. on Wednesday, June 22. To obtain a permit call the OCSWMD at 815-732-4020 or email the department at solidwaste@oglecounty.org and provide your name address, phone number and email address. Per-

mits are limited to one per household per month and allow up to seven large items to be brought in for recycling. A full list of accepted items and other event information is included with the permit.

This event is for Ogle County residential electronics. Accepted items include all types of tele-

visions and computer monitors, computers and all computer hardware and cables, laptops, tablets, cell phones, video game equipment, printers, FAX machines, copiers, scanners, VCR/DVD players, cable and satellite boxes, all remote controls (please remove batteries), radios, stereo equipment, phones,

digital clocks, calculators, holiday light strands, computer power back-ups, rechargeable batteries and printer ink cartridges. Microwave ovens are accepted for a \$5 fee per unit. Remove items from packaging prior to arrival at the event, materials such as boxes, Styrofoam, and plastic packaging are not

accepted.

Hub netters on the rise

Varsity team finishes 12-3 while placing second in Interstate 8 Conference

ROCHELLE — Head coach Kristy Eckardt knew the Rochelle Hub varsity tennis team had a chance to be very successful this season. With all eight starters from last season back on the court, the team doubled its win count while nearly claiming its first conference title since 1949.

While the Hubs fell just short of their historic goal, Rochelle finished second in the Interstate 8 Conference Championship tournament, improving on the team’s third-place finish from last season. The Hubs went 12-3 overall and 4-0 in conference dual matches while placing second in the inaugural Hubs Dubs Invitational and the annual Hub Varsity Invitational at RTHS.

“What stood out to me the most was how we came together as a team,” Eckardt said. “They were all excited for the season we were having and they gained so much confidence this season. They were much more resilient this season, especially because we had a lot of bad weather this season and we weren’t able to be outside as much as we

normally would.”

After not losing any seniors last offseason, Rochelle will see four senior starters depart from the varsity team this offseason including doubles players Devansh Patel and Peter Forsberg as well as singles players Alex Gilbert and Jason Zheng, who each earned All-Conference Honorable Mentions. The Hubs will have four varsity starters eligible to return next season, however, including All-Conference First Team doubles honorees David Wanner and Owen Haas.

“It’s always hard to replace our seniors, who I thought were really strong players and leaders this season,” Eckardt said. “We fortunately had the largest roster we’ve had in any of my seasons here and we had quite a few players who split time with the varsity and junior varsity teams. A lot of our JV players had success this season and I think it’ll be an easy transition.”

Junior doubles players John Green and Nolan Fonfara are also eligible to return next season. JV players who could make the leap to the varsity team next season include juniors Ryan Ward, Evin Odle and Jace Whitehead as well as sopho-

“Evin played well in both singles and doubles and

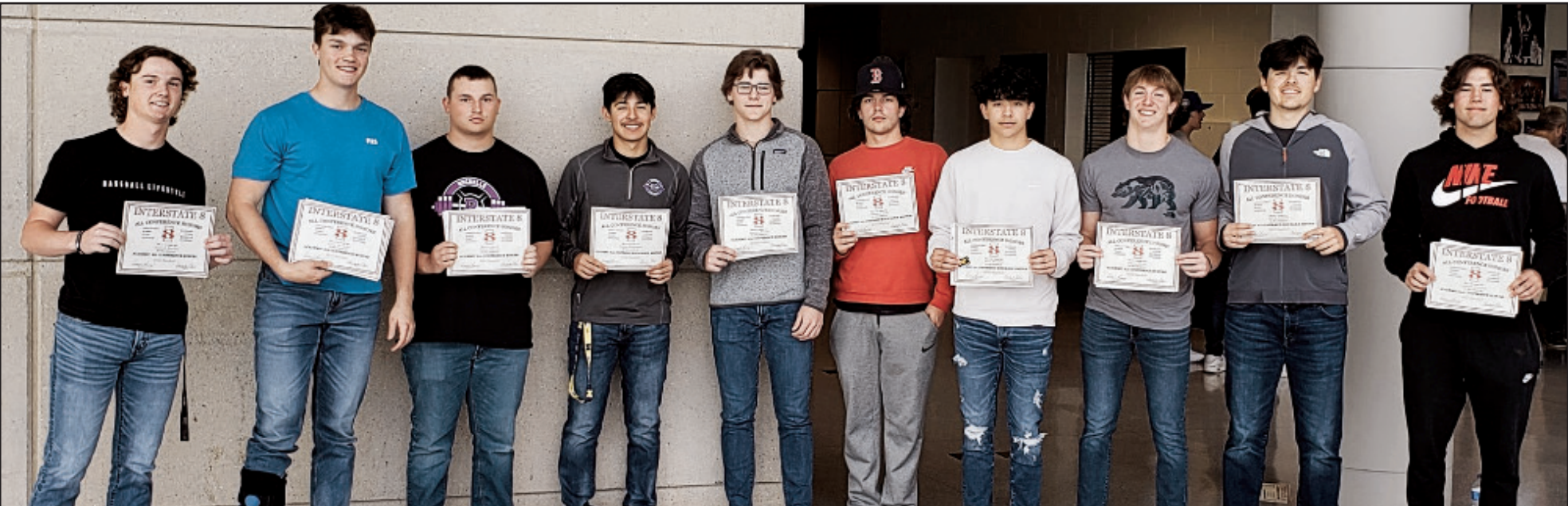
Parker was a really strong varsity doubles player for us last season. Jimmy did a nice job for us this year and

RTHS Baseball

Brutal weather leads to rough start for Hubs

Rochelle overcomes 10 cancellations, finishes with 6-16 overall record

ROCHELLE—Abrupt stretch of bad weather led to a rough start to the season for the Rochelle Hub varsity baseball team. With 10 total cancellations including the first eight nonconference games of the season, rhythm was tough to obtain throughout the spring.

Rochelle finished with a 6-16 overall record and sixteenth in the Interstate 8 Conference with a 4-10 conference record. The Hubs swept their home-and-home series with Sandwich while splitting their conference sets with Plano and Sycamore. Close games were unfavorable to the Hubs, who suffered 10 losses by four runs or less and eight losses by only two runs or less.

“The weather was some of the worst we’ve had over the eight years I’ve been coaching here,” head coach Jarrod Reynolds said. “We hardly played any nonconference games before the conference schedule started and we weren’t able to work out much during the early portion of the season. We had some injuries we battled

through and I thought those affected us as well, but overall, I thought we were able to stay in ball games and we played a lot of close games.”

The 2022 season was a down season on offense for the Hubs, who totaled more strikeouts (180) than runs (103) and finished with a .267 team batting average. All-Conference First Team senior Nate Burdin shined at the top of the order, however, totaling a team-high 30 hits while leading the starting rotation with a 2.77 ERA and 39 strikeouts in 43 innings. Senior Andy Buskohl earned an All-Conference Honorable Mention, recording a .429 average with 13 RBIs.

“I thought our pitching was pretty good overall,” Reynolds said. “I thought more of our issues were on the defensive end, especially during games that got out of hand... Our senior group did a good job for us this season and I think solidifying our pitching staff will be important for us moving forward. We definitely need to work on our offense as well. We struck out a lot this season, we didn’t score as many runs as we have

in the past and we only hit three home runs.”

The Hubs will lose 10 seniors from the varsity roster this offseason including Burdin and Buskohl as well as Eric Briseno, Braden Alfano, Owen Angell, Josh Lloyd, Forrest Gerber, Jacob An-

drist, Grant Messer and Danny Reyes. Rochelle will have several players eligible to return next season, though, including junior starters Noah Lara, Garrett Gensler and Colton O’Rorke. Juniors Aidan Rodriguez, Bradley Cooney and Alex Burnette

are also eligible to return.

“We struggled to put the ball in play this season,” Reynolds said. “We faced some really good pitching throughout the season, but we had a lot of swings and misses so we’ll need to improve in that area. Hitting the fastball away

and bunting for more hits are two things we’ll need to be better at next season. We stole over 40 bases this season and were highly successful there so we’ll look to continue being aggressive on the bases. We just need to find more ways to get on.”

HOLLYWOOD — Oscar-winner **Diane Keaton’s** 55th film, “Mack & Rita,” opens Aug. 12. The star of movie classics like “The Godfather” and “Annie Hall” has surrounded herself with three great actresses in her new comedy. First up is 91-year-old **Lois Smith**, who started her career on the CBS soap “Love of Life” (1951) and appeared in such classics as “East of Eden” (1955), with **James Dean**; “Five Easy Pieces” (1970), with **Jack Nicholson**; “Fatal Attraction” (1987), with **Michael Douglas** and **Glenn Close**; “Dead Man Walking” (1995), with **Sean Penn** and **Susan Sarandon**; and most recently “The French Dispatch” (2001). Also starring with Keaton are Emmy winner **Loretta Devine**, for “Grey’s Anatomy” (2011), and “Hot in Cleveland’s” **Wendie Malick**, most recently in nine episodes of “Young Sheldon.”

Oscar-winner **Susan Sarandon**, **Bette Midler** (who has three Emmys, a Grammy and a Tony) and two-time Emmy winner **Megan Mullally** are joining forces for the feel-good comedy “The Fabulous Four,” which will shoot July through September (with a mysterious fabulous fourth?). Sarandon is lending her voice to the superhero animated film “Blue Beetle” and

stars with **Trace Adkins** in the Fox series “Monarch,” about a fictitious country-music dynasty. Midler has completed “Hocus Pocus 2,” which will drop on The Disney Channel just in time for Halloween. Mullally stars in Hulu’s just-released coming-of-age film “Crush” and has the drama “Summering” due in August.

“Father of The Bride” (1950), which starred **Spencer Tracy**, **Joan Bennett** and **Elizabeth Taylor**, was reinvented in 1991 as a star vehicle for **Steve Martin** and **Diane Keaton**, and grossed \$129 million. It’s being revived yet again, this time starring **Andy Garcia** and **Gloria Estefan**. But film buffs will hardly recognize it since it’s about a Cuban family, the intended bride proposes to the would-be groom, and her parents have a dark secret to reveal ... they are getting divorced. It hits HBO Max on June 16, and since all that’s left of the classic film is the title ... “Everything old is new again!”

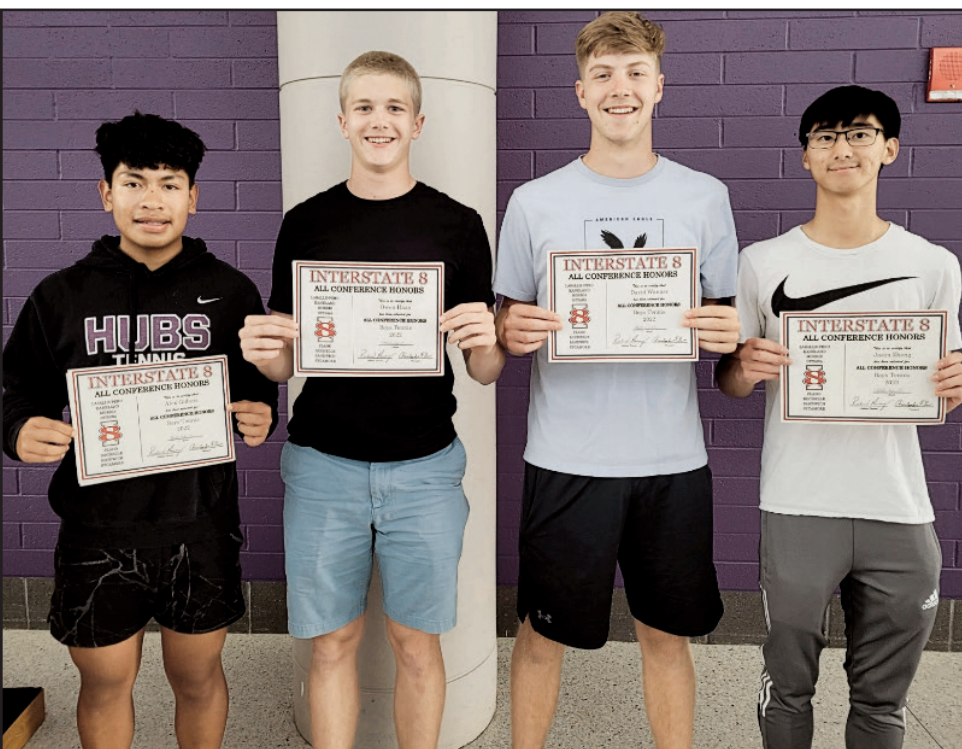
