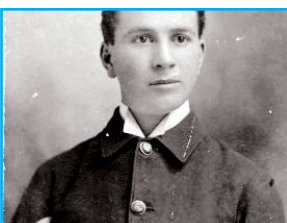

City soliciting proposals for Hickory Grove

'We'll do what we can to get a development that makes the community proud'

ROCHELLE — Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said Wednesday, May 18 that the city is working on a request for proposal (RFP) for potential developers for the recently-demolished Hickory Grove site and will have it ready in "the next few weeks."

The city is working with engineering firm Willett, Hofmann & Associates to finalize the RFP and will make sure the mayor and city council are supportive of it before sending it to developers who have shown interest and posting it online. Developers will likely be allowed 3-4 weeks to return proposals before interviews are set up.

"This is the mayor and council's project and they'll ultimately select who they think is the best partner for that location," Fiegenschuh said. "Our goal is to find the highest, best use. I would just ask people to be patient. It doesn't mean we're going to get a development there right away. But we'll do what we can to get a development that makes the

community proud."

Fiegenschuh said there's been developer interest in the Hickory Grove site, both recently and even dating back to pre-pandemic times before the city even officially owned it.

The city assumed ownership of the deteriorating Hickory Grove building in early 2020 for \$1 with the intention of demolishing it and developing the property. The building was previously owned by the Ogle County Civic Center Authority (OCCCA) board, which was under the Ogle County Board

umbrella. The city decided to purchase the site so it could control it and likely would've had to deal with it later if it was abandoned due to OCCCA being in financial trouble.

The \$361,900 demolition project of the facility at 1127 N. 7th St. began in January. The only remaining work is small facade improvements that need to be made to the Comfort Inn hotel next door, which Hickory Grove was connected to.

Land transfer work is also ongoing with the hotel. Four parcels the hotel

currently owns would be beneficial to the city and eventual developer and one parcel the city owns would be given to the Comfort Inn.

"The issue we're having is the Concord Towers needs access to garbage," Fiegenschuh said. "We need to make sure the folks there have access to have their garbage picked up because of where it's located on the south side of the building and that's kind of slowed the property transfer up a little bit. We'll work through that. We're moving forward with the RFP despite that and we'll

let the developers know that that portion has still not been completed."

Fiegenschuh reiterated that what eventually goes into the Hickory Grove site will be a mayor and council decision. He said personally, he'd like to see a development that's a mixed use of residential and commercial property.

"We had one potential developer back before the pandemic that approached us about the idea of a banquet facility," Fiegenschuh said.

Next substation planned for Centerpoint Drive

City officials state that work will take place within the next few years

ROCHELLE — After recently finishing its new \$13.8 million electrical substation on Ritchie Court, the City of Rochelle has plans to build another substation on Centerpoint Drive on the west side of town off Illinois Route 38, City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh and Rochelle Municipal Utilities Superintendent of Electric Operations Blake Toliver said.

Toliver said the location has been chosen to provide reliability on that side of town and the MightyVine greenhouse has been getting “larger and larger” and has required increased power.

“We knew this was coming down the pipeline, that’s why we’ve been preparing for it,” Toliver said. “We had to get the Ritchie Court substation built first before we could build this next one because it’s going to be fed from it. This will relieve more load from our Caron Road substation and a little bit from our Twombly Road substation. And it’s for more redundancy in that area.”

Toliver said he can’t yet speak to spec, size and cost of the planned substation. The city and RMU are in the process of potential load growth studies to determine things like transformer sizing and should know in “the next few weeks.”

Fiegenschuh said the project will have to go through design work and there are several large-scale projects at RMU’s power plant that are taking precedence first.

“I would assume after that, we’ll begin the design phase of the new substation,” Fiegenschuh said. “We also have to look at purchasing some property out there and acquiring some easements to install the utilities. That could take a few years to get done.”

The RMU power plant improvements will be a “huge step” in reliability for the downtown Rochelle area, Toliver said.

“We’ll have a lot more redundancy for the customers in the downtown area,” Toliver said. “The utility is focused on its existing customers as well, not just new customers. Everybody always thinks

we’re building new things for everyone new coming in, we’re not. We’re also

focused on what’s already here and trying to make that more reliable.”

The recently-completed Ritchie Court substation has capacity for 120 mega-

watts of power.

Visitation will be from 2-4 p.m. on Sunday, May 22 at Unger-Horner Funeral Home, 400 N. 6th St. in Rochelle.



Deputies issue arrests

OREGON — On May 17 at approximately 6:38 p.m. deputies along with Lynn-Scott-Rock Fire/EMS personnel responded to the intersection

of Chicago Avenue and Maple Street in Davis Junction for a two-vehicle accident with injuries. After investigation, it was determined that a blue 2017 Toyota Tacoma being driving by Robert Hoovler, 66, of Davis Junction, was traveling westbound on Chicago Avenue approaching Maple Street. At that time, a black 2008 Mercedes-Benz S550, being driven by Stephanie Smith, 43, of Rockford, failed to yield the right of way while traveling north on Maple Street through the intersection. The Toyota struck the Mercedes-Benz on the passenger side causing disabling damage to both vehicles. Hoovler and a single occupant of the Tacoma were uninjured. Smith and single occupant of the Mercedes-Benz were transported to a nearby hospital for suspected minor injuries. Smith was issued a citation for failure to yield at an intersection and given a return court date.

“The highest, best use in my mind is something that the community can be proud of. That when folks drive north or south on Illinois Route 251 or east or west on Illinois Route 38, they see something that they’re proud of in our community that brings people to our community to enjoy the other amenities we offer.”

The city manager said the city is aware of economic issues including high prices of building materials and interest rates going up, which could make a project more expensive for a developer. That is why it’s trying to get the RFP out as quickly as possible in case economic conditions worsen. Fiegenschuh said he wants the community to

know that regardless of who the city ends up partnering with to develop the Hickory Grove site, it will be a long-term partnership. And the process may not happen quickly.

“We want to make sure it’s done right the first time,” Fiegenschuh said. “I don’t want people to think there’s going to be a developer next year. It could take several years for something to happen. But what’s there now is better than what was there before. We’re halfway to where we want to go. The other half may take longer, but we’ll get there.”

The city manager is “very excited” to hear proposals and ideas for the site. He’s enjoyed having informal conversations in recent years when talking to those that have been interested. Those ideas

“sounded great” and were projects the community could be proud of.

“It’s been a great project,” Fiegenschuh said.

“When I came to Rochelle to be city manager, I started attending the OCCCA meetings and that group did the best it could to

keep that facility operating. Back then, I never thought we would get to this point. I drive by that site every day and it looks

amazing, and I’m hoping in five years when I drive by that site I see a project that looks even more amazing.”

But no, I did not ride. What fool would put a helmet on that perfect hair? Not this fool, I will tell you that.

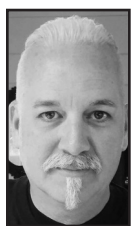

The Giant Slide

SHOULD the government subsidize nostalgia?

I've been thinking about that a lot this past week. The Illinois State Fair was in danger of losing my favorite attraction. No, not the butter cow or Turasky's thin-cut ribeye sandwiches or the annual steer show.

We are talking about serious high-brow entertainment: the Giant Slide.

Just about any ride in Happy Hollow is vomit-inducing for me. But I love that old slide. I've ridden down it with each of my three daughters as soon as they were old enough and brave enough to take the plunge.

The 40-foot-tall slide is for sale again, and several prospective buyers want to take the thing apart and move it out of state.

But Doug Knight, of Knight's Action Park, wants to keep it intact and on the fairgrounds.

The Springfield City Council voted Tuesday to support his purchase with a paid sponsorship of the slide, at \$30,000 a year for the next four years. For those who aren't mathematically inclined, that's \$120,000 in taxpayer dollars.

The idea is that the attraction could be embossed with advertising and that would help promote Springfield as a destination. The slide, which was built in 1968, could be decorated with a Route 66 logo and become part of the upcoming Mother Road 100th anniversary observances.

Sorry, I'm not buying it. Advertising isn't the goal of this project.

The goal is to keep a beloved icon on the state fairgrounds and the advertising is a means to an end. While the city may get some benefit from the ad, I could point to a half dozen more cost-effective mediums.

Also, the slide isn't in Springfield. Yes, the fair is a wonderful local institution, but the Illinois State Fairgrounds has never been annexed into the city. So, despite the subsidy, the fair attraction will not contribute to city sales taxes.

Cities often subsidize private enterprises in the name of entertainment or just as a community amenity. Just think of the number of professional sports stadiums erected by tax dollars. This type of subsidy is not without precedent.

But where do you draw the line? Give money to the Giant Slide and then you are on that slippery slope of subsidizing just about anything.

But sometimes we fund things because they have historic significance.

Well, the most newsworthy thing to happen on the slide was in August of 1978 when then-Gov. James R. Thompson took his newborn daughter down the slide while holding her in his arms.

I was in junior high at the time and my mother was so outraged she mentioned it just about any time the governor's name came up. "How could he endanger his own child that way?" she would say with a tone of bewilderment bordering on disgust.

Flash forward 21 years and I'm a statehouse reporter interviewing the now former governor about

his lobbying activities. During the phone interview he was in Las Vegas with his daughter Samantha celebrating her 21st birthday.

The state fair was going on at the time of our conversation. I did the math in my head and it dawned on me that Mom wasn't exaggerating. Samantha was fresh out of the womb when Big Jim took her plunging down 130-feet of fiberglass.

So, I asked Thompson if he remembered the controversy.

He laughed and said he still had mothers stop him on the sidewalk in Chicago and tell him he shouldn't have taken his daughter on that slide.

After that interview, I didn't give the Giant Slide much thought until I had children of my own.

I first went down the slide with my oldest, Gracie, when she was 3 or 4. We were on the same burlap sack together at the top ready to make the plunge. She was afraid, but reassured by my presence.

We enjoyed our ride downward and have made it an annual family tradition.

Today my girls are 11, 14 and 16. It's no longer cool to be seen riding the slide with your Dad even if he is a few lanes over. I find myself begging my own kids to go to the slide. I get eyerolls in response. But usually on the final day of the fair we take the plunge.

While I may think city tax dollars could be better spent, I can guarantee you when I ride down the Giant Slide this year with my three girls, I'll be glad it's still here.

RMU's existing substations on Caron Road and Twombly Road have 65-megawatt and 40-megawatt capacities, respectively. The city will have "well over 200 megawatts" of capacity total after substation work is all said and done.

"Right now, we're looking at about a 100-megawatt peak after Zekelman Industries is fully loaded," Toliver said. "We'll have double that in capacity, which is good. You want to have enough room to grow, but you also want to have redundancy too."

Building two new substations in the span of a few years has been

"a lot of work," Toliver said, and it is unprecedented for the city and utility. He said he's glad the city partnered with BHM Engineering for the Ritchie Road substation, which helped RMU to find what would be best for its territory.

Fiegenschuh complimented the current and past mayor and city council members for their work to sell RMU's transmission assets to ComEd in recent years to help fund the Ritchie Court substation. The city also issued \$18 million in bonds for utility improvements last year at an interest rate of just over two percent.

"Because of things like that, this work has not

required a rate increase," Fiegenschuh said. "We were very lucky and timed it just right to be able to do this and cash flow it all without increasing our rates."

After the substation on Centerpoint Drive is eventually completed along with an expansion to RMU's Twombly Road substation, \$30 million will have been reinvested in the city's electric utility in less than five years. Toliver called that level of investment "mammoth."

The last big substation expansion RMU did was in 2015 at the Caron Road location, Toliver said. Before that, expansions were done in 2005 and 1997. He thanked the mayor, council and Fiegenschuh

for their support of the most recent improvements.

"At the end of the day, our job is to service our customers, current and future," Fiegenschuh

said. "These improvements needed to be made, especially for our current customers. When people locate in an area to do business, one of the things they rely on, especially

if they're a large power user, is reliable power. This is going to ensure we have that reliable power well into the future. Our number one priority is our customers."

Sanford makes state

Rochelle senior thrower qualifies for IHSA State Championship in shot put

ROCHELLE—Senior thrower Zach Sanford saw his confidence surge after setting a new personal record in the discus during the IHSA 2A Rochelle Sectional on Wednesday.

Sanford cruised into the discus finals with a throw of 41.10 meters, ultimately finishing fifth and earning his first sectional medal of the evening. Sanford’s strong showing in the discus set the stage for the preliminary round of the shot put competition, where the senior launched a heave of 14.80 meters on only his second toss, hitting the state-qualifying standard on the mark.

Sanford would take fifth in the shot put and earn a second sectional medal, but more importantly, his throw would clinch his first-ever berth in the IHSA State Championship, which will be held at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston next Thursday through Saturday.

“It feels like all of the hard work has paid off for me,” Sanford said. “I was feeling very confident coming in after I set a PR at the conference meet. I knew I could qualify for state and I couldn’t wait to

come out here and do it. The discus throw gave me even more confidence because I wasn’t supposed to do the event, but I decided to do it at the last moment and I threw a PR.”

Sanford will be the lone member of the Rochelle Hub varsity track and field team who will advance to the IHSA State Championship. Sanford is the team’s first athlete to qualify for state in the shot put since Joey Johnson advanced in 2006. The senior, who will continue his track and field career at the University of Dubuque next year, set his PR of 15.47 meters during the Interstate 8 Conference Championship meet at Sycamore High School earlier this month.

“It’s going to be a great experience,” Sanford said. “It will be my first time competing at a college stadium and I’m going to be competing against a bunch of really good athletes and athletes that I might be competing against in the future. I think I’ve improved a lot from where I was last season and all of the training I’ve done over the last year has helped me. My goal for the state meet is to make the finals and I think I’ll need to throw another PR in order to do that.”

Rochelle finished 12th out of 13 schools with six points in the sectional meet. Sophomore Irving Escalante took fifth in the 400-meter dash with a time of 54.49 seconds

and Rochelle’s 400-meter relay team (Escalante, Luke Orlikowski, Trey Taft and Ethan Wells) placed ninth in 47.19 seconds.

Junior Griffin Ohlinger finished eighth in the

200-meter dash with a time of 23.87 seconds and Rochelle’s 1600-meter relay team (Escalante, Caleb Wyssbrod, Luke Orlikowski and Nathan Sergeant) placed ninth with

a time of 3:45.73. Junior Hayden Inman took ninth in the pole vault with a height of 3.21 meters and senior Ryan Simmons finished ninth in the high jump with a clearance of 1.72 meters.

Lady Hubs win first regional match since 2009

Hernandez, Lara score as Rochelle edges Dixon 2-1 in semifinal round

ROCHELLE—Freshman midfielder Makayla Lara knew she had a free kick within scoring range of the Dixon net as the final minutes of the Rochelle Lady Hub varsity soccer team’s IHSA 2A Rochelle Regional Semifinal match against the Duchesses on Wednesday wound down.

With the match tied at 1-1 in the 73rd minute, Lara lined up a free kick from just outside the Dixon box. Looking to give the sixth-seeded Lady Hubs a late advantage over the fourth-seeded Duchesses, Lara blasted a left-footed shot that soared over a wall of players at the top of the penalty area before coming down over the Dixon goalkeeper and landing inside the net.

Lara’s free-kick goal proved to be the deciding factor on Wednesday, with Rochelle outlasting the Duchesses 2-1 and scoring its first match victory in a regional tournament since 2009. The Lady Hubs (10-9, 4-2 Interstate 8) will face top-seeded Boylan Catholic in the finals on Friday.

“I saw how close I was to their net and I knew the

shot would be within my range,” Lara said. “I asked for the ball to take the free kick and seeing the ball go through the keeper’s hands was really exciting for me. I knew we didn’t have much time left in the match and I was thinking we were going to go into a penalty-kick shootout. We knew we had to keep pushing and once we took the lead, we knew we had to give everything we had to try and keep our lead until the end.”

Rochelle and Dixon fought an evenly-matched first half, with both teams going scoreless until the last two minutes, where the Duchesses struck first on a breakaway goal from forward Katie Drew during the 39th minute. Looking for the immediate equalizer, the Lady Hubs pressured the Duchess defense as the clock wound down, with junior midfielder Mavi Avila placing a shot that bounced off the top crossbar and deflected toward junior teammate Jasmin Hernandez.

With only seconds remaining in the first half, Hernandez crashed the net and placed a perfect header

over the outstretched hands of the Dixon goalkeeper to even the score at 1-1. It was the first goal of the

season for Hernandez, who split time at midfield and defense during the match.

“Coach [Brad] Male

always tells us to follow the ball,” Hernandez said. “I’ve been scared to head the ball, but I knew that it

was my chance and it was such a great feeling.”

HOLLYWOOD — **Timothee Chalamet** plays the young Willy Wonka in the prequel to “Willie Wonka & the Chocolate Factory,” called “Wonka,” which will show how he became the chocolate king. Also starring **Olivia Coleman**, “Mr. Bean” star **Rowan Atkinson** and **Keegan-Michael Key**, it opens in December 2023. Chalamet has completed the American/Italian coming-of-age romance/horror film “Bones and All,” co-starring **Chloe Sevigny** and **Mark Rylance**. “Downton Abbey: A New Era” includes a wedding, a funeral and the beautiful French countryside. **Hugh Bonneville**, **Elizabeth McGovern**, **Michelle Dockery** and, of course, **Maggie Smith** have returned for this sequel, opening May 20 in theaters and July 4 on Peacock.

“Wicked,” the hit Broadway musical prequel of “The Wizard of Oz,” is without a doubt the second most successful Broadway musical of the past 20 years. It’s grossed more than a billion dollars, second only to “The Lion King.” Universal Studios bankrolled the Broadway show with the proviso, of course, that it gets to make the film version. The long-awaited movie, now in pre-production, stars **Ariana Grande** as Glinda, the role played by **Kristin Chenoweth**, and **Cynthia Erivo** as Elphaba, the Wicked Witch of the West, played on Broadway by **Idina Menzel**.

Now, here comes the twist. Universal, with dollar signs in their eyes and not satisfied with just its share of the billion-dollar bonanza from Broadway, must have looked at what Warners did with “Dune.” The original “Dune” opened in 1984 and was a modest success. The remake opened last September and grossed \$400 million. In order to make the new “Dune” more epic, they split it into two films, allegedly to tell the story better, thereby hooking die-hard “Dune” fans for the second film. Ergo, Universal has

decided the film version of “Wicked” needs to be two separate films.

Stephen Schwartz, who wrote “Wicked” for Broadway, is writing the music and lyrics for the film, while **Winnie Holzman** has written the screenplay. The studio explained, “It became impossible to wrestle the story of ‘Wicked’ into a single film without doing damage to **Jon Chu**’s adaption.”

Chu, the director of “Wicked” (as well as “G.I. Joe Retaliation,” “Crazy Rich Asians” and “In the Heights”), explained, “As we tried to cut songs, to trim characters, those decisions began to feel like fatal compromises to the source material, and we decided to give ourselves a bigger canvas and make not just one ‘Wicked’ movie, but two.”

Isn’t it strange that the original production, which opened in 2003, has played to full houses for 19 years at 2 hours and 45 minutes? Part one will open Dec. 25, 2024, with part two due Dec. 25, 2025. Methinks Universal is just being “Wicked”-ly greedy!
