## Daycare building purchased

### Bearrows: Offer accepted with plans for daycare

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows said last week that an offer has been accepted on the Kishwaukee Family YMCA Child Care Center building at 1010 N. 15th St. that closed in 2020 and the buyer has plans to make it a daycare once again.

Bearrows said he heard that information from the realtor selling the property. He said he did not know the identity of the buyer. The transaction is now in the real estate process and the anticipated closing is somewhere around June 1. Bearrows said after that point, more information will come to light.

The buyer that is in the process of purchasing the daycare building is not affiliated with the daycare board that was recently established to work to bring a child care center back to town. Bearrows, who is chairman of that board, said a group did make an offer on behalf of the daycare board, but that offer was not accepted.

"There was another offer that went in that was

accepted, which I'm OK with," Bearrows said. "As long as we get that daycare open. It's finally going to come to fruition. It's been a long time coming."

Rochelle has been without a daycare center since the facility closed. The City of Rochelle took on preliminary work last year to bring a daycare back to

town. It put out a survey to residents that came back with overwhelming results in favor of a daycare with 72 percent of respondents saying they're in need of a daycare and 71 percent saying their children would be likely to attend a daycare if it opened in town.

The building at 1010 N. 15th St. was listed for

sale earlier this year by Hayden Real Estate, Inc. for \$399,900. It's 12,000 square feet, sits on 2.73 acres and includes eight classrooms, a sprinkler system, a commercial kitchen and outdoor space. The facility was built in 1993.

## Headon's opening Davis Junction location

### Hibshman: Memorial Day weekend targeted for opening

**DAVIS JUNCTION** — Headon's Fine Meats Owner Mark Hibshman said Thursday that his business will be opening a second location in Davis Junction at the end of this month.

The second Headon's will be located inside a new Benny's Corner Market just west of the intersection of Illinois Route 251 and Illinois Route 72. Benny's is another Rochelle business that is adding another location in Davis Junction.

In past years, Headon's used to work with Sean Considine, a Byron native and Super Bowl champion football player, and had a mobile meat truck that would set up shop in the area in Davis Junction, Stillman Valley, Oregon and Byron. Hibshman said since then, Headon's has seen a lot of customers from that area and has heard comments about the desire for another location.

Hibshman and his co-owner, his son Justin, had already had conversations about a location in the

area before talks started with Benny's Owner Tim Hayden. Headon's sells a lot of its products at the Benny's location in Rochelle.

"He said he was opening a new location and asked if I wanted a portion of it,"

Hibshman said. "I said we wanted to put one out there anyways, and it just kind of all came together. Basically we'll have about 800 square feet in the back and it's going to be part of the store. The store is going to be very well

set up. Our area is going to look like a small version of Headon's. We're going to have the antiques up there and an awning out in front of the inside area. Memorial Day weekend is the targeted date right now."

The Hibshmans took over ownership of Headon's in Creston just over a year ago after longtime Owner Lyle Headon retired and sold the business.

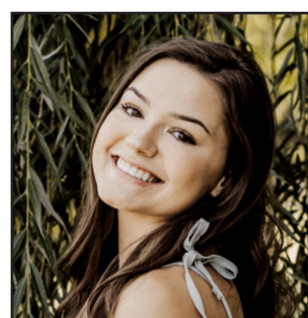

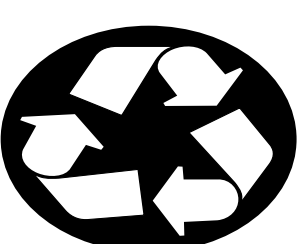

By the time officers arrived, the offenders had left the scene.

“There was a vehicle that we found out had left that location 10 seconds after our officers started to head that way,” Higby said. “That vehicle went north on Illinois Route 251 without lights on. It may have been related, but we’re not sure. We did get a description of the individuals but we never did locate them. We have some information to go on, but it’s kind of a long shot at this point. We did have a quick response, but it takes the offender just a shade less time than it takes us. Unfortunately they were gone by the time we got there.”

On Tuesday around 1

p.m. a 911 call of a robbery at the Clark Station at 1180 N. 7th St. was made by a third party. Higby said the caller was on the phone was the business’s clerk when someone entered with a knife and demanded money. The third party individual then called 911.

The offender was not given any money by the clerk before fleeing west on Carrie Avenue, Higby said. The RPD chief said the offender was a male and wore gloves and a mask. After arriving to see the man had fled, RPD searched the surrounding areas to no avail.

“It’s possible he had a car or apartment or home in the area,” Higby said. “We had a good response to that one, too. Unfortunately the delay is

just how long it takes for someone to call it in. The investigations into both robbery incidents are not likely to pan out without additional information or help from the public.”

At 8:58 p.m. on Wednesday, RPD received a call regarding shots fired in the area of 709 Lincoln Highway. Higby said the victims, a male adult and a female adult, were parked in the area and an individual walked up to their car with a gun and told them to leave the area. The victims pulled away, and one shot was fired into the car.

“We did not ever recover the actual round,” Higby said. “Officers saw a hole in the seat and that was the presumption. It went through the passenger door. Nobody was

injured. We’re not sure yet on a possible motive or leads. Every time we have a shooting, we consider gang activity, but we’re not ready to say that yet.”

The name and recipes of the shop have stayed the same since.

Hibshman called the opportunity to open a second location “awesome.” The Davis Junction shop will have fresh meat brought to it each day along with frozen brats, burgers and hot dogs. There will be limited deli items like pre-packaged potato salad and local items like vinegar and oil will be sold as well.

“Lyle is actually pretty excited about it because it was always one of his dreams to have multiple locations,” Hibshman said. “Hopefully this is the start of getting a couple more going in the future as well. It’s kind of funny, you know the rumor mill flies around. There were rumors that our Creston shop was going to close down. I’m like, ‘No way. We would never shut this down.’ It’s been a good year.”

Headon’s in Creston recently received a liquor license and has been able to add that type of inventory. The location is holding street fairs on the first and third Saturday of each month through September. Hibshman said it’s been good to bring people into the shop and the Village of Creston.

The biggest thing about the second location that excites Hibshman is the chance to sell to people in a new area where Headon’s has a “big following.” Outside of Benny’s locations and at the Creston shop, the only other places to get Headon’s products are at

Polo Fresh Market and ExpressLane, which are at a lot of the Shell and BP gas stations. Benny’s in Davis Junction will be the only non-Creston location with fresh meat.

While the Hibshmans did not own Headon’s during the most dire times of the COVID-19 pandemic, he said they still saw effects over the

past year.

“Being able to see our customers’ smiling faces again and being able to actually talk and everything, it’s great,” Hibshman said. “I think if the pandemic was still going on the way it was, I don’t know that we would’ve been able to open up another location. It’s definitely nice that all

that has eased up.”

In preparation for the new location, Hibshman said the Headon’s brat machine has been running “pretty much all day long” to get stock built up. Over the next couple of weeks it will be “crunch time” with decorating and preparing the Davis Junction shop.

People in the Davis Junction area and Ogle

County that are unfamiliar with Headon’s that come to the location can expect the same type of business that the Creston shop has done for decades.

“You’re always going to have a fresh cut of meat,” Hibshman said. “We only use the top beef. We’ll have different flavors of brats out there. We

have 57 flavors we carry now. And all of our stuff is all-natural. We don’t use any preservatives in our beef sticks or brats and that’s a key thing. Our beef strips and poultry items and all that are all fresh and top grade. We’re going to have the same thing. Just all the unique stuff that you don’t get in the big box store.”

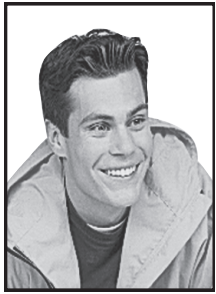

## Administration gives end-of-year details

Application to continue funding for district's HUB Program submitted

**ROCHELLE** — During Tuesday's Rochelle Elementary School District Board of Education meeting, Superintendent Jason Harper said Rochelle Middle School's eighth grade graduation will be held Friday, May 27 at Rochelle Township High School outdoors on the football field weather-permitting.

If the weather doesn't allow for it, the ceremony will be held inside in the RTHS gym.

"The RTHS graduation is the following day, so it's convenient and we'll continue to do what we've done in the past," Harper said. "We did not take any snow days off this year, so our last day with students this year will be May 24 and our last day with teachers will be May 25. We will do our typical end of the year celebration with teachers as we've done in the past. That will be the first time our entire district has been together since August 2019. We're looking forward to it and we'll share a meal and highlights of the school year. We're back to typical procedures with that."

District Assistant Superintendent Tony Doyle said it's been nice to see some of the traditional end-of-year activities return to elementary schools and RMS for the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic began.

"We're doing things like picnic days and field days," Doyle said. "Some classes have actually gone on field trips. It's kind of cool to see the fifth graders back over at RMS this week to have middle schoolers give them a tour. It's good to see those things come back and give us that normalcy we've all been craving."

### HUB Program

Harper said during the meeting that an application to continue funding for the district's HUB Program has been submitted.

The program, which is specifically targeted to support the district's K-8 at-risk youth using a before

and after-school model plus summer school, has been fully-funded by the grant for the past 10 years. The district currently receives about \$435,000 per year to run the program at no cost to it and the community. About 200 students are currently enrolled in it.

Harper said last month that the Illinois State Board of Education Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant cycle will be more competitive this time, with \$10 million being awarded statewide and more districts looking for post-pandemic programming for at-risk youth.

The district has been told that grants will be awarded sometime in October, after the start of the fall semester. Harper has said that the HUB Program will take place this fall at the district's expense along with other grant money possibly being used.

"Over the summer we'll come back to the board with a plan for how to start the fall semester next year with an after school program," Harper said. "We'll have costs associated with that. If we get the grant, those costs will be embedded and brought back through the grant process. If they're not, that would be a local burden. More details to come."

If the ISBE grant is not received, the program's future will be an "evolving conversation," Harper said last month.

### Retirees

Doyle recognized four employees within the district that will be retiring at the end of the year. They include Jan Morrissey, Heidi Mann, Robert Donovan and Mark Papke.

Morrissey is finishing her 19th year with the district. She started employment in August 2003. She has served as a special education and third grade teacher and is currently a second grade teacher.

Mann is finishing her 28th year at Rochelle Schools. She started employment in 1994. She has served as a first grade, third

grade and English-Spanish language teacher.

Donovan is finishing his 31st year. He started employment in August 1991. He's served as art teacher, art supervisor and sixth grade sports coach.

Papke is finishing his 30th year. He started employment in August 1992. He's served as industrial arts teacher, wrestling coach, assistant intramural boys basketball coach and a.m./p.m. supervisor.

### IPA Award

Harper recognized Lincoln School kindergarten teacher Nicole Tobler for recently winning an Illinois Principals Association Teacher Leadership Award. Tobler has taught for 14 years in the district.

"It's a great recognition for her and for Lincoln School and our district and community," Harper said. "We're very proud of her for this special recognition."

### Personnel changes

The board unanimously approved personnel changes including the resignations of Anna Adolph (seventh grade ELA teacher, RMS), Karissa Dobson (fourth grade, Tilton School), Jodi

Dickey (administrative assistant, Tilton School) and Jonathan Gehm (assistant soccer coach) and the hiring of Bryan Garcia Belmonte (special education, RMS) and Mattie Hoiness (special education, Tilton School).

### Insurance

The board took no action on the renewal of the district's health insurance due to the fact that it's awaiting more information on rates. Harper said the district's medical insurance rate will

come in at a 5.6 percent renewal, but information is still needed on vision and dental. Life insurance will see no increase. A decision from the board on renewal will come at its June meeting.

"I talked to the realtor this morning and asked how much I can reveal," Bearrows said May 6. "People want to know. I wanted to know. And when they said it was definitely going to be a daycare, I was like, 'OK, perfect.' At the end of the day, it's going to be a daycare."

Bearrows said the daycare board may be kept together indefinitely in case it can help the buyers with

fundraising or anything they may need.

"I hope and pray the sustainability is there, so that in 18 months or 24 months we're not back looking at the same thing," Bearrows said. "And I think it will be sustainable. I got the feeling this morning that it's going to be very strong. The buyers have daycare experience. Hopefully it's going to be good."

The mayor was excited by the news of a daycare

coming back to town after the effort became a priority of his since Kishwaukee Family YMCA Child Care Center closed.

"It really feels good," Bearrows said. "I can see the finish line. Not for the sake of me or the city, but for the sake of our community. Some folks have really struggled without having daycare. It's one of the best things that's happened in a long time. We're very appreciative of that."



HOLLYWOOD — Ben Affleck is directing and starring with Matt Damon in an untitled film for Amazon in which Damon plays a salesman for a fledgling shoe company named ... Nike. Affleck’s psychological thriller, “Deep Water,” with Ana de Armas, dropped in March, and his “The Flash” film is due in June 2023. Damon is upcoming in “Thor: Love and Thunder” and in Christopher Nolan’s “Oppenheimer” (father of the atomic bomb).

In 2002-03, Tony Curtis toured in a national company of “Sugar” (as Osgood Fielding III, the man romantically pursuing Jack Lemmon’s character), which they called “Some Like It Hot: The Musical.”

On Dec. 11, a new “Some Like It Hot: The Musical” will open on Broadway with a score by Marc Shaiman (“Hair-spray”), and a book by Tony-winner Matthew Lopez and “Late Night with Seth Myers” staff writer/performer Amber Ruffin (with a show on Peacock). Here’s the twist: While Broadway actor Christian Borle of the TV series “Smash” will play the Tony Curtis role, both the Jack Lemmon and Marilyn Monroe roles will be played by people of color, J. Harrison Ghee and Adrianna Hicks. If audiences don’t warm up to this “Hot,” they can’t blame it on the weather.
