Wattles returns from Poland

Rochelle dentist deployed for nearly five months

ROCHELLE — Dr. Mike Wattles of Maintain Your Smile Dental in Rochelle recently returned from a nearly five month-long Illinois Army National Guard deployment in Poland as a dental officer in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve.

Wattles' job while deployed was to set up a dental clinic and once it was up and running, he was in charge of a dental unit in an Army medical clinic.

"We were treating soldiers for emergencies like broken teeth or trauma or whatever would come up," Wattles said. "The other things we did, they sent us throughout Poland to do dental examinations on soldiers to see if they had any dental needs. I had to go and see the different divisions and the guys that were kind of on the front lines. That was pretty interesting. Basically we just treated dental emergencies there."

Wattles said the goal of dental officers like him was taking care of soldiers'

dental emergencies in order to keep them healthy and able to perform their jobs in the field, from infantry soldiers to officers. He called it "quite different" from the atmosphere, pace and type of treatment he practices in Rochelle.

According to Wattles, there is a great need for dentists in the military and

he'd like to see younger doctors get involved to help. But, it can be hard to do so and be pulled away for duty when you have your own practice. He was able to do so because he's in a group practice and had other doctors to cover for him.

Wattles didn't get into the military until he was

almost 50 due to that reason. He's now served for 10 years. Getting into the military was always something he wanted to do to follow in the footsteps of his family members.

"My dad was in the military in the Korean conflict," Wattles said.

Sound the Alarm set May 14

ROCHELLE — When asked about the value of the Sound the Alarm event on May 14, American Red Cross Disaster Program Specialist Lori Compton responded with three words. "It saves lives," Compton said.

The Red Cross is teaming up with the City of Rochelle and the Rochelle Fire Department for the smoke alarm and home fire safety event next month for Rochelle residents. Smoke alarms with 10-year lithium batteries will be installed by volunteers. Compton hopes to install at least 250 smoke alarms on May 14. 850 homes will be canvassed in advance of the event.

Cinco de Mayo festival scheduled May 7

Councilwoman Arteaga: 'We want to bring everybody together'

ROCHELLE — Rochelle's Cinco De Mayo festival is Saturday, May 7 from 4-11 p.m. in the downtown gazebo area.

The event hasn't taken place in the past two years due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Rochelle City Councilwoman Rosaelia Arteaga, the event's lead organizer, said during a Facebook live with Mayor John Bearrows last week that the event will feature food and craft vendors, live bands and folkloric groups and activities for children.

"We'll have lots of things for young kids like bounce houses, STEM blocks to build all sorts of things and we're looking for a petting zoo," Arteaga said. "We want this to be a family-friendly event for all ages. The committee is also working on food vendors and we have local ones and new ones. We don't want long lines. Hopefully everyone will come join us."

Bearrows said one of the things he thinks is extremely important about the

event is the chance to bring different groups together along with the opportunity

"If you don't know the culture of others, there's a tendency to stand off,"

Pritzker signs bills aimed at easing teacher shortage

Statewide vacancy rate was 1.5 percent in 2021 according to Illinois State BOE

SPRINGFIELD — Gov. JB Pritzker signed a package of bills Wednesday aimed at easing the state's shortage of teachers and other education professionals, even as a new report shows Illinois just added a record number of new teachers to its ranks.

Speaking in the library of Springfield High School just blocks from the Capitol, Pritzker said that while the education workforce picture is improving, more work still needs to be done.

"In Illinois, schools still have more than 2,100 unfilled teaching positions statewide," he said. "That includes 15 unfilled teaching slots here in Springfield and 64 in Decatur, with a similar need for paraprofessional positions. With new tools though, and new funding at their disposal, districts all across the state are working to find new ways to bring people into this profession and to encourage them to stay

there."

Pritzker signed four bills Wednesday, including House Bill 4246, which lowers the cost of renewing a lapsed educator license to \$50 instead of \$500; House Bill 4798, allowing currently enrolled teaching students with at least 90 credit hours to be licensed as substitute teachers; Senate Bill 3988, lowering the minimum age to become a paraprofessional in grades eight or below to 18 instead of 19; and Senate Bill 3907, allowing short-term substitute teachers to teach up to 15 consecutive days in a classroom instead of just five.

Those bills come on top of numerous other measures the state has taken in recent years to lure more people into the teaching profession.

Pritzker noted that the budget bill he signed into law April 19 increases funding for minority teacher scholarships to \$4.2 million. And starting next year, the minimum

annual salary for first-year teachers will increase to \$40,000 due to a bill he signed in 2019.

"That law, combined with proper funding and all the work to remove barriers for qualified people to enter this profession, is increasing the ranks of teachers across our state even now," Pritzker said.

According to a new report from the Illinois State Board of Education, those efforts appear to be having an impact.

ISBE's most recent Unfilled Positions Survey, released April 21, shows Illinois schools hired a record 5,676 new teachers in the fall of 2021, the most ever recorded in a single year and more than in the past five years combined. That was enough to lower the statewide vacancy rate to just 1.5 percent.

But the survey also showed schools in Illinois still have more than 2,100 unfilled teaching positions, mostly concentrated in chronically struggling schools, underfunded

schools and those serving low-income communities.

"Our low-income, bilingual and special education students have the least access to the teachers they need to grow and thrive," State Superintendent Carmen Ayala said at the news conference. "We also have a severe shortage of substitute teachers, as was noted,

and need an additional 2,400 paraprofessionals to fully meet our students' needs in the classrooms."

A survey conducted in 2021 by the Illinois Association of Regional Superintendents of Schools found 88 percent of local school districts believed they had a teacher shortage problem while 96 percent

reported problems finding enough substitute teachers.

Applications open for seven unique CFNIL scholarships

ROCKFORD — Seven unique scholarships, with applications and award cycles which differ from the main CFNIL Scholarships program, are accepting applicants until May 31. Applications must be submitted via CFNIL's online application portal. Each scholarship has distinct criteria, represent a broad range of educational and career aspirations, and each was created to honor the memory of someone much-loved by the donors who established the

awards.

Four of the seven scholarships are designated for members or family of members of IAFF Local 413 Firefighters, or students who are studying fire science or to be an EMT. Students complete one application to apply for all four: Lt. Kelli Ingardona Memorial Scholarship, Phyllis Howard Memorial Scholarship, Terrance Freeman Sr. Memorial Scholarship and the Tyler Kinison Memorial Scholarship.

The remaining three scholarships have individual applications:

Daniel Edwards Memorial Scholarship: Provides educational resources to students from Ogle County who are pursuing a career in the skilled trades. Applicants must be a resident of Ogle County and pursuing a career in a skilled trade which does not typically require a bachelor's degree, such as auto repair, diesel mechanics, plumbing, electrical, carpentry or welding.

Diane Thompson-Wells Memorial Scholarship: Provides educational resources for marching members of the Phantom Regiments Drum & Bugle Corps. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior or current four-year college/university student who is a current marching member of the Phantom Regiment. Applicants may reside anywhere within the United States.

Richard J. Schnell Memorial Scholarship: Provides educational resources

for students pursuing a career in dentistry or dental hygiene. Applicants must be enrolled in an ADA-accredited dental or dental hygiene program, or a graduate post-doc program, in the state of Illinois or at Indiana University School of Dentistry.

Additional criteria may apply for each scholarship. Visit <https://cfnil.org/scholarships> for full criteria and program details.

All applicants for these scholarships must be submitted through CFNIL's

online application portal by 5 p.m. on May 31. Applications are read and scored by committees of volunteers who use a "blind" review process and make award recommendations to CFNIL's Board of Trustees. Scholarship recipients for these special off-cycle scholarships will be announced in June. Awards are sent directly to the school the recipient will be attending. Deputies respond to single-vehicle rollover accident

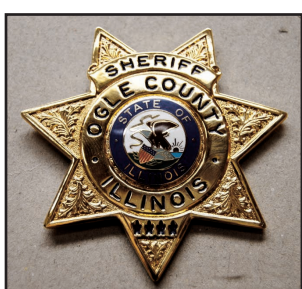

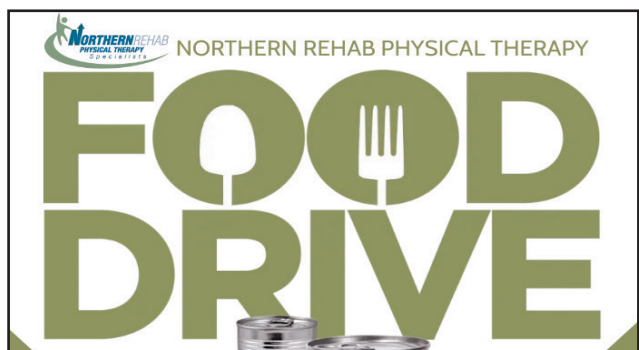
Northern Rehab hosting food drive

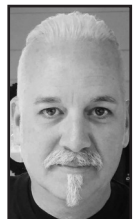

When in doubt, side with free expression

OUR society has developed quite a bit of consternation over folks who kneel on football fields.

First there was quarterback Colin Kaepernick kneeling during the National Anthem in protest of police brutality.

Donald Trump's response: "Get that son of a bitch off the field." Sigh.

On April 25, the U.S. Supreme Court heard the case of Joseph Kennedy, a Bremerton, Washington, high school football coach who was suspended from his job after repeatedly kneeling on the football field and praying after games.

It made some school officials uncomfortable.

But here's the rub; the only speech worth defending is that which makes people uncomfortable.

Writers at the left-of-center publication Slate are wringing their hands over the prospect of a praying coach. They have conjured up some vast right-wing conspiracy that would turn public schools into religious indoctrination zones if the high court rules in Kennedy's favor.

While I do identify as an Evangelical Christian, there is something about these types of public prayers that make me uneasy. I think of Jesus' admonition in the book of Matthew: "And when you pray, you must not be like the hypocrites. For they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, that they may be

seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you."

So, if someone were to ask me if I believe this is an effective way for Coach Kennedy to share his faith, I'd say "No." But if I were asked if he should be allowed to express himself in this way, I'd say, "Yes."

I feel much the same about Kaepernick. I personally can't see myself kneeling during the National Anthem. But I fully acknowledge racism and brutality remain enormous problems in law enforcement. I've uncovered many such instances during the past 35 years.

That said, I support Kaepernick. He and other athletes should be able to peacefully petition their government in the manner they see fit.

Sadly, varying factions in our society on both the left and the right want to silence those who they don't agree with. That approach is the antithesis of a free society.

When in doubt, side with free expression.

I began my journalism career covering the University of Texas Medical Branch for the Galveston Daily News. Shortly before I took over the beat, a university cop arrested a Muslim person for kneeling and praying on campus.

My reaction at the time was that was stupid. Why would the government interfere with that man's ability to pray?

Some might say that the difference is that Coach Kennedy is in a position of authority and his actions violate the separation of church and state.

But the problem with that argument is that we don't live in an antiseptic society. A math teacher wearing a yarmulke, a principal with an Ash Wednesday cross on

his forehead or a history instructor donning a hijab also are expressing their faith in state-sanctioned environments.

Would we really want to prohibit such acts? I think not.

One anonymous athlete said he felt compelled to kneel with Kennedy because he feared if he didn't he would lose playing time.

But Virginia Tech University soccer player Kiersten Henning claims she was booted from the team last year when she refused to kneel during the National Anthem.

No one should ever feel coerced to express themselves in a manner untrue to their conscience. But no one should be barred from freely expressing their beliefs either.

Figuring out where to draw the line between the two; that's the hard part.

The Red Cross is rallying volunteers to install 50,000 free smoke alarms nationwide this May in its Sound the Alarm events. Compton said at least 60 volunteers will be needed in Rochelle.

Volunteers will work from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and the rally location will be at The REC Center at 802 Jones Road in Rochelle. To volunteer, visit SoundTheAlarm.org. Background checks will be required of any non-employee volunteers.

“We need people to come out and volunteer and help install and save lives,” Compton said. “Get into those homes and get those smoke alarms installed. That’s the big part of this program versus other things. You can go out and get smoke alarms from other programs, but the big thing is installing it. This program we install them and we’re ensuring that those are

working smoke alarms. They’re 10-year lithium batteries. The batteries can’t be taken out for games because the alarm will beep. They’re there to stay for 10 years. It’s continual security for people.”

The Red Cross has a long history of working in the Rochelle area, most notably when it helped area residents recover from an EF4 tornado in 2015. When there’s a fire with affected residents in town, the organization comes in to help with immediate assistance. That longtime relationship with the city and its fire services brought about Sound the Alarm.

“We just felt that this was a community that would benefit greatly from this service we offer,” Compton said. “We came out and talked to the fire department a couple of months ago and they were on board just from that first conversation we had with them. They’ve

been great to work with. It does save lives and I think it’s a wonderful opportunity for Rochelle’s residents to be able to have this service in their community and the outlying areas.”

Residents that want a free smoke alarm can email NWILalarminstall@redcross.org or call 815-562-6161.

Dave Boyles of The Red Cross said there are no income requirements for those that want a smoke detector and anyone is eligible to have one free of charge. A new smoke alarm with a 10-year battery will be installed regardless of the situation, including even if someone has a working detector that’s only a couple of years old.

Compton said installers will only be on scene for about 20 minutes in each home and will also be giving out education information about preventing fires and a laminated escape plan. That

way, residents can practice their own escape plan to get out of their home in case of a fire.

“That’s another piece to the whole puzzle,” Compton said. “You have typically less than two minutes to get out of your home when there’s a fire. So it’s very important to be able to get out of your home and to a safe spot. That’s part of the responsibility of the fire department. Before they will go and fight that fire, they’re making sure everybody is

out of that house. If you have been practicing that plan with your family, then you’ll be more likely to be able to get out of that house once that smoke alarm goes off.”

Compton said people not having working smoke detectors is the leading cause of fire deaths. Working smoke alarms can cut the risk of death from home fires in half. Boyles said seven people a day die from home fires.

The Red Cross isn’t just looking for volunteers for

the May 14 event. It also is in need of volunteers to go out and help local residents when they’re affected by disasters. When helping fire victims in the past, Red Cross workers have seen the impact Sound the Alarm has made.

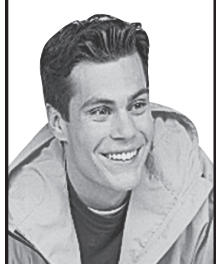
“We’ve actually had things come up where people had fires and they were saved by smoke detectors that we installed,” Boyles said. “That has happened across the country and in Illinois. It does save lives.”

RCH launches new electronic medical record

ROCHELLE — Effective today, May 1, Rochelle Community Hospital is now live with Epic, their new electronic medical record. The Information Services Department has been working with PointCore, a division of OSF Healthcare, to make the transition. A conversion of this magnitude involves a great deal of planning for implementation and requires the commitment of a great number of staff. Although employees have completed hours of training, please be patient as we continue learning with you.

This massive conversion began in October 2021 and migrated data from the current systems of Meditech (RCH) and Athena (Family Healthcare Clinic) into one electronic medical record. Conversion to Epic allows RCH to maximize clinical efficiency and easily exchange critical data with other sites.

With the conversion, RCH unveils its new and improved patient portal, RCHMyChart. Enrollment in the portal gives patients instant access to their health information, including laboratory and radiology results, medications, allergies, demographic information, visit history, discharge/aftercare information, online bill pay and more. Additional new features include appointment re-

quests and messaging your care team. RCHMyChart is a secure and seamless way to stay in control of managing your health. In addition to handling their own care, parent and health care proxies with authorized consent will appreciate the ability to access the records of those individuals for whom they manage care. The current hospital and clinic portals are still available through this summer.

To enroll in RCHMyChart you can: Use the activation code provided by email or text. Download the MyChart app on the App Store or Google Play Store. When prompted, choose Rochelle Community Hospital as your healthcare provider and follow the steps. Visit MyChart.com, click “Access MyChart,” select Rochelle Community Hospital, click “Sign Up” and follow the steps. Patients can also enroll at: www.rochellehospital.com.

“My brother was in Desert Storm. My grandfather was in Normandy and cousins that were in Vietnam. It was kind of a family history thing. But I used to have my own practice and I have five kids. I decided if I got the opportunity, I’d do it. It came up and I was able to join and I was glad I did. It’s been a good experience for me.”

The doctors that covered patients for Wattles at Maintain Your Smile deserve big kudos, he said. Wattles called it “very difficult” to leave his patients. “I’ve been here five years, so they become family and friends,” Wattles said. “You’re in the middle of treatment on some of them and they don’t want it to change either, because they’re used to you. It was hard to leave my staff and patients and be gone that long. When I came back it was quite a catch up to try to get back on track with everything.”

Wattles left for Fort Bliss in Texas just before Thanksgiving and spent three weeks there on training and pre-deployment. He arrived in Poland on Dec. 10 and stayed there until returning to Fort Bliss on March 26 for a week before a week of leave and returning to work.

Wattles’ time in Poland was his first overseas deployment. He expects it won’t be his last, due to the shortage of military dentists and the state of the world’s politics.

Poland is a neighboring country to Ukraine, which is currently the site of the Russia-Ukraine war. Wattles said the size of the base he was on tripled while he was there and activity “ratcheted up.”

“It was somewhat scary,” Wattles said. But Poland is a NATO country, so we really weren’t concerned. Some of the guys that are up on our front lines were on the Ukraine-Poland border. They were bombing right on the other side of the line. Those guys, I imagine they had some apprehension. But we were fine. It was

probably no more dangerous than being here, to be honest.”

The hardest adjustment about for Wattles was being away from family, friends and his work. He had to get himself into a “totally different” mindset, which took about a month, he said.

Wattles was able to communicate with family and people back home while in Poland, but found it hard to deal with the idea

of not being able to help out here in the case that something happened.

“I think that’s what you worry about most,” Wattles said. “Not being able to get back to help someone or do something if you needed to. That was the hardest part of the deployment for me. The military and the dental parts, which I’ve done for so long, were the easy parts. Being away from family and friends was very difficult.”

Wattles said he enjoyed interacting with younger soldiers during his deployment and seeing how the “military machine” worked up close. One thing that surprised him was the amount of dental needs there were.

Because of COVID-19, routine dental work was behind and there were more dental issues than normal, Wattles said. Active duty dentists did not treat anything other than emergencies for a longer

time than in the private sector.

“They kept me pretty busy,” Wattles said. “Busier than we normally would have been. You’d be surprised at how many dental problems there are and how they can put you out of commission. If you’ve ever had a toothache or a dental emergency, you know how distracting that is. In order for them to be able to focus on their job, they need to have us available for stuff like that.”

Rochelle scores 1-8 win

Smardo strikes out 11 as Lady Hubs defeat Plano for first conference victory

ROCHELLE — After striking out 15 batters against South Beloit on Thursday, Rochelle junior Morgan Smardo continued to find the zone Monday evening, when the Lady Hub varsity softball team hosted the Plano Reapers seeking its first Interstate 8 Conference victory of the season.

Smardo struck out 11 batters and held the Reapers hitless through the first four innings, finishing with a complete game as the Lady Hubs defeated Plano 7-2 to snap a four-game conference losing streak. Smardo, who limited the Reapers to three hits on Monday, helped her own cause with a double and a run to put Rochelle ahead 1-0 in the bottom of the first inning.

“I felt like we played more as a team today,” Smardo said. “We all hit the ball well and we played as a team. I felt like I was hitting my spots better and I had a good rhythm with my catcher. I thought the start of our season was a bit rocky, but we’ve really started to bond and we’ve become much closer together. We’ve definitely been hitting better and finding the gaps.”

Rochelle (2-6, 1-4 Inter-

state 8) added its second run of the game in the bottom of the second inning, where senior Ashley Knight led off with a triple before scoring on junior Addie Friestad’s RBI single through the middle. Freshman Lauren Dyer and senior Jordin Dickey then connected on back-to-back singles in the bottom of the third inning, with Dyer scoring on senior MeLisa Young’s sacrifice fly and Dickey scoring on an error to give the Lady Hubs a 4-0 advantage.

ROCHELLE — Sydney Thorne never thought she would score four goals in a high school soccer match, but that's exactly what happened when the Rochelle Lady Hub varsity team kicked off the Interstate 8 Conference tournament against LaSalle-Peru on Wednesday.

The sophomore forward found the net twice in the first half, helping the third-seeded Lady Hubs take a 5-3 halftime lead over the sixth-seeded Cavaliers in a back-and-forth offensive battle. Lady Hubs defeat Cardinals 94-26, Hubs fall 69-67 in head-to-head meet

STILLMAN VALLEY — The Rochelle Hub and Lady Hub track and field teams went head-to-head against Stillman Valley in nonconference action Monday evening. The Lady Hubs scored a 94-26 win over the Cardinals, while the Hubs fell 69-67 in a closely fought matchup.

Lady Hubs

Senior Sylvia Hasz won the shot put with a distance of 9.56 meters, while freshman Aaliyah Losoya placed second at 8.60 meters and junior Samantha Sanford took third at 7.80 meters. Hasz and Sanford finished first and second in the discus throw with respective distances of 25.07 meters and 22.34 meters. Senior Teagan Meyers and junior Macy Ramos finished first and second in the high jump

with respective clearances of 1.48 meters and 1.23 meters.

Meyers won the triple jump with a distance of 9.90 meters and sophomore Kennedy Adamski took third at 8.66 meters. Rochelle's 400-meter relay team (Liberty Hayes, Rylee Jackson, Alex Neece and Alivia Henkel) won in 53.71 seconds. Neece and freshman Marianna Saldana took first and second in the 100-meter hurdles with times of 21.20 seconds and 21.50 seconds.

Hayes won the 100-meter dash with a time of 13.37 seconds, while Henkel placed second with a time of 13.47 seconds and Jackson took third with a time of 14.47 seconds. Junior Yuelma Ortiz won the 800-meter run with a time of 2:47.43, while senior Sara Johnson placed second with a time of 2:50.41 and freshman Zoe White took third with a time of 3:05.03. Rochelle's

800-meter relay team (Hayes, Meyers, Saldana and Neece) won with a time of 2:02.51.

White and freshman Bridgett Ramirez placed second and third in the 400-meter dash with respective times of 1:19.09 and 1:25.96. Henkel and Johnson took first and second in the 300-meter hurdles with times of 51.04 seconds and 1:02.93. Hayes and Saldana finished second and third in the 200-meter dash with times of 28.84 seconds and 32.06 seconds. Rochelle's 1600-meter relay team (Meyers, Kylie Smith, Jackson and Henkel) won in 4:46.07.

Hubs

Rochelle landed the top four finishers in the shot put including senior Zach Sanford (13.94 meters), sophomore Carlos Tomas (10.69 meters), junior John Jarrett (10.41 meters) and junior Landon DeLille

(10.33 meters). Sanford and senior Ryan Simmons finished first and third in the discus throw with respective distances of 36.42 meters and 26.37 meters. Simmons won the high jump with a clearance of 1.73 meters and freshman Jack Tilton took third at 1.58 meters.

Junior Griffin Ohlinger took third in the long jump with a distance of 5.34 meters. Sophomore Nathan Sergeant and junior Trey Taft went first and second in the triple jump with respective distances of 10.94 meters and 10.70 meters. Rochelle's 3200-meter relay team (Josue Huerta, Abel Huerta, Luis Hernandez and Thomas Koziol) won with a time of 10:16.78.

Rochelle's 400-meter relay team (Tilton, Hayden Inman, Anlun Meyers and Max Orlikowski) placed second with a time of 51.48 seconds. Ohlinger won the 100-meter dash with



a time of 11.88 seconds and sophomore Irving Escalante finished fourth with a time of 11.95 seconds. Koziol and Josue Huerta placed second and third in the 800-meter run with times of 2:28.38 and 2:39.86.
