Farmhouse fire

Eight area departments respond

STEWARD — A rural farmhouse in Steward is a total loss after a Tuesday afternoon fire that saw no injuries, Rochelle Fire Department Chief Dave Sawlsville said.

Around 2 p.m. Rochelle Fire and all Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District Departments were called for a structure fire at 2930 Herman Road. Lee County Sheriff's Deputies were first on scene and notified other first responders of a heavily-involved fire. The fire was through the roof when fire departments got on scene.

The fire was upgraded to a second alarm and along with Ogle-Lee (Flagg Center, Steward, Creston and Hillcrest), Ashton, DeKalb and Shabbona Fire personnel responded. The response was mostly to get water trucked to the site, which can be a challenge with rural fires, Sawlsville said.

"We set up a tanker shuttle," Sawlsville said. "Every rural department has a truck to haul water to fires like this. We set up a foldable swimming pool next to the engine and fill it up and the engine draws from that. The tenders fill wherever is closest, I believe they did in Steward today. It was thousands of gallons."

Sawlsville said there was nobody home at the time of the fire and the last owner left the house around 10:30 a.m. He said he's unsure how long the fire was burning, but said it likely had a "huge head start" and was called in by a driver on Illinois Route 251 that saw the smoke.

Two occupants live in the home, and they notified first responders that they had a couple of cats and a couple of dogs.

Facing COVID challenges as a school nurse

ROCHELLE — In April 2020 when it became evident that COVID-19 was going to be a long-term obstacle, the Rochelle Elementary School District health office staff started meeting once a week.

The office is staffed by school nurses Joelle Buita

(Tilton Elementary and Rochelle Middle School) and Deb Cicogna (Lincoln and Central Elementary) along with health aides at each school. Those meetings became a check in to see how the pandemic was affecting staff members personally and to determine how to best support students.

Starbucks opening mid-April

Pease: 'They're starting to get products in'

ROCHELLE — City of Rochelle Community Development Director Michelle Pease said Thursday that the new Starbucks location next to Walgreens on Illinois Route 251 on the north side of town is slated to open its doors in mid-April.

"We met with the store manager and they're starting to get products in," Pease said. "They'll do some training and be able to stock everything. I would say mid-April is a fair guess."

City officials held a groundbreaking ceremony for Starbucks last August. The 2,000 square-foot location will have indoor and outdoor seating and a drive-thru. It will employ about 25-30 people and has created 75-80 construction jobs.

The City of Rochelle first began speaking with Starbucks last January.

EV station construction underway

ROCHELLE — Construction on new electric vehicle charging stations is underway on the south side of Rochelle, City Community Development Director Michelle Pease and Building Inspector Geoff Starr said Thursday.

The station will be located in the lot of Casey's General Store at 330 S. 7th St. and will have eight chargers for vehicles. Starr said the project is expected to be completed in the second quarter of this year and he imagines it will be done by this summer.

The project is a partnership between Casey's and an outside company that is putting in the charging stations. Pease and Starr declined to name the company involved.

"I can't speak on when they plan on announcing the name," Starr said.

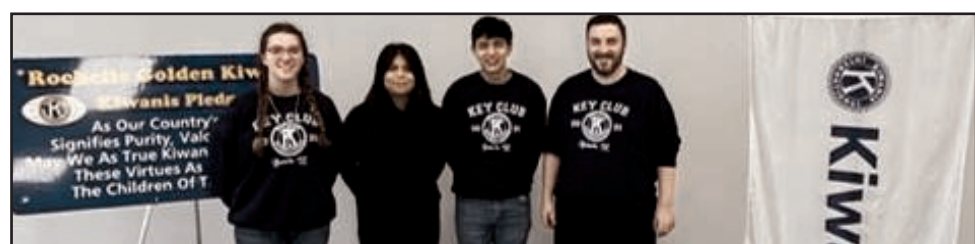

Illinois Route 64 bridge work begins April 1

OGLE COUNTY — The Illinois Department of Transportation announced March 25 that weather permitting, work to repair the Illinois Route 64 bridge crossing Interstate 39/U.S. 51 at exit 104 in Ogle County will begin

on Friday, April 1.

Work will repair the bridge deck and joints and install a bridge deck overlay. Illinois 64 will remain open to two-way traffic with traffic shifts and reduced lane widths during the \$782,870 project,

which is expected to be completed by September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered.

Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years,

IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,535 miles of highway and nine million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of trans-

portation. Accomplishments through year two included approximately \$5.2 billion in improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway and 270 bridges along with 428 additional safety improvements.

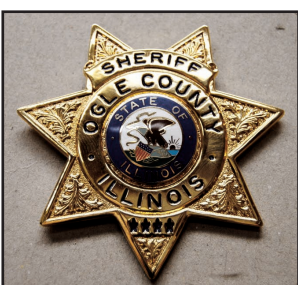
Deputies respond to single-vehicle accident

OREGON — On March 29, deputies investigated a one vehicle accident in the 10,000 block of West Illinois Route 72. A grey 2015 Dodge Journey driven by Taylor Michalak, 24, was westbound on Illinois Route 72 when it left the roadway. The vehicle entered the south ditch before striking a tree and coming to rest. Michalak and a male passenger were examined and released by Forrester Fire and EMS. Michalak was issued a citation for improper lane usage. The accident remains under investigation.

On March 29 at approximately 9:06 a.m. deputies responded to the 4,000 block of North Mulford Road for a single-vehicle accident which had occurred earlier in the morning. Upon arrival, deputies discovered the operator of the involved vehicle had left the accident scene. While deputies were investigating this ac-

cident, a second accident was reported on Interstate 39 near mile marker 108. After further investigation it was learned that driver involved in the accident on Interstate 39 was the same driver of the vehicle involved in the accident on Mulford Road. Subsequent to the investigation, deputies arrested and cited David L. Cunningham Jr., 38, of Monroe Center, for driving while license revoked (two counts), failure to report an accident, failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident, unlawful use of a weapon, possession of a weapon/no FOID card, unlawful possession of firearm by felon, improper container/driver (cannabis) and operating an uninsured motor vehicle. Cunningham was transported to the Ogle County Jail and is being held with no bond.

On March 30 at approximately 12:52 a.m. deputies conducted a traffic stop in the 6,000



block of North Leaf River Road. During the course of the investigation, Joan C. Stanis, 60, of Leaf River was arrested for aggravated driving under the influence of alcohol, driving under the influence of alcohol and driving on a revoked license. Stanis also received citations for improper traffic lane usage, illegal transport/carry alcohol driver and operating an uninsured motor vehicle. Stanis was transported to the Ogle County Jail where she was held pending an appearance before a judge.

On March 31 at approximately 6 a.m. deputies responded to a one-vehicle accident in the 17,000 block of West Milledgeville Road. After an investigation it was determined that a black Chevrolet Trail Blazer being driven by Mark R. Much Jr., 32, of Milledgeville, was traveling eastbound when he lost control on the snow covered roadway. The vehicle entered the south ditch and struck a culvert at that location. Much was transported to the hospital by Milledgeville EMS for minor injuries sustained in the accident. No citations were issued.

OREGON — Former Executive Director at The Next Picture Show in Dixon, Michael Glenn has a new role in Ogle County's seat in Oregon. The Coliseum Museum of Art, Antiques & Americana (CMAAA) is a recently-formed not-for-profit focused on renovating and repurposing the historic Coliseum building in downtown Oregon to create a new cultural center for the area.

A native of the area, Glenn's background includes roles as executive director of Hopegivers International in Columbus, Georgia and executive vice president of the National Religious Broadcasters Association in Washington DC. Most recently, he served as executive director of the Next Picture Show, a community fine arts center in downtown Dixon.

"Mike is an exciting addition to our team," Ron Bry, CMAAA Board

vice president, said. "His background and skillset are what we need to guide the building renovation, develop partnerships with businesses and organizations, and create the programs and events in order to foster a creative environment for Oregon and the surrounding area."

Opened in 1922, the art deco facility at 124 N. 4th St. was once a center of activity for the community. Sitting on the edge of the Oregon Commercial Historic District, renovation has already started with plans for a south entrance ramp, new lighting, construction of permanent display cases and the addition of a digital media studio on the second floor.

CMAAA's mission is the acquisition and display of art, antiques, Americana and history, including both permanent and rotating exhibits, and to provide a venue for artists representing all facets of art an opportunity to host exhibitions and offer their creations for sale through a museum store.

"Oregon and the county offer tremendous cultural resources," Glenn said. "The Coliseum will be an integral part of the community and reflect the values and quality of life. In conjunction with some of the other area attractions, we expect to help draw local and long-distance visitors.

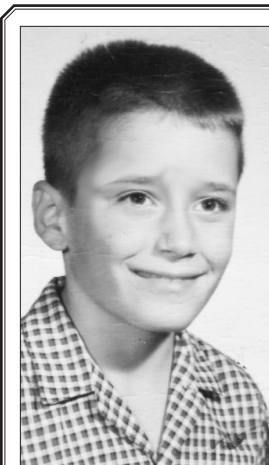

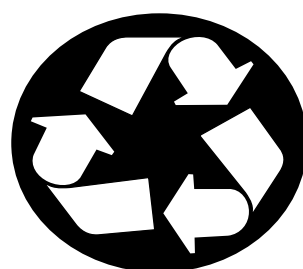

FIRE: Home a total loss after Tuesday blaze in Steward

Sawlsville said he was unsure Tuesday evening if the pets were able to get to safety.

High winds were another issue that firefighters dealt with Tuesday.

“The wind was blowing a lot out there and because of the direction, there was nothing to block the wind from the fire,” Sawlsville said. “There were steady 20 m.p.h. winds and some gusts of over 30 m.p.h. that fanned the flames and made for fast spread.”

Sawlsville said response times were higher Tuesday due to the location of the fire being so far south and being so far down a gravel road that intersects with Illinois Route 251. Firefighters did what they could with the 700-800

gallons they arrived with before more water could get on-scene. Sawlsville said his department sees “a couple” rural fires like Tuesday’s each year.

Sawlsville said the cause of the fire is under investigation and there was no obvious possible cause to speak of.

The two-story farmhouse was a total loss and Sawlsville said it will have to be torn down and rebuilt. He estimates that and the cost of the belongings inside to be around \$250,000.

“Red Cross was on scene to help the displaced owners,” Sawlsville said. “They’ll help them with a place to stay. While nobody was hurt, the sad part of the story is there are two displaced homeowners who lost everything.”

Realizing my own privilege

A few months ago, I was pulled over by a Springfield-area police officer for a minor traffic violation.

He shined a flashlight in my car and said, "Mr. Reeder, are you carrying?"

I replied that "no," my firearm was home locked up in a safe.

He replied "You should always carry. It doesn't do you any good if its home locked up."

He gave me a verbal warning and sent me on my way.

I couldn't help but wonder how different that encounter might have been if I were Black.

In 2020, I wrote a piece about Rep. Curtis Tarver, D-Chicago, who was pulled over not far from his home for having a burned-out headlight. An officer asked him, "Do you have a gun in the car?" He responded he did and showed them his valid conceal carry permit.

But he says he was still hauled into a police station, handcuffed to a table for seven hours and not allowed to call an attorney. They treated him this way despite knowing he was a lawyer and a state lawmaker.

Nine months later, charges against him were dismissed because it was determined he hadn't broken any law. But the cops kept his gun.

Tarver is Black. I'm white. He was arrested despite being licensed to carry. I was scolded for not carrying.

That's the definition of white privilege.

I might add that white privilege isn't necessarily something someone seeks. And it doesn't mean

you haven't had struggles in your life. It just means that one of those struggles wasn't related to the color of your skin.

Sometimes it manifests itself in big ways such as whether one is arrested. But often smaller things are more telling.

Last week, our puppy chewed up my well-worn pair of work boots. I went to my favorite shoe store, a place where I've always found the service to be excellent.

There was one other customer there, a Black man with his family. He has a good job as a union dry wall installer, and he too was buying a new pair of boots.

After trying a pair on, I asked if I made the purchase whether they could throw in a free pair of socks. In a rather officious tone – as if he were speaking to an audience, not just me – the manager told me, "We never do that."

And he pointed at my sales associate and said, "He could be fired if he did that."

I stepped into the washroom and when I returned the African American family had left. The associate had my boots boxed up and handed me a free pair of socks. He said, "You're a good customer – you deserve this."

My first reaction was, "That's nice, he changed his mind."

As I drove home, it dawned on me that whole charade was done so they wouldn't be obliged to also give a free pair of socks to the Black customer who was spending the same amount as me.

White folks, myself included, can be pretty clueless when it comes

to the privileges we are extended.

Several years ago, I was driving just south of Springfield Memorial Hospital when I came across a van that had broken down on a side street.

The driver was a young African American man who had recently graduated from high school. He said he had run out of gas and was worried about being late for his job working in a restaurant.

I had him climb in my truck and I drove him to a gas station several blocks away. I got out of the truck and grabbed a nozzle to fill up my gas can.

The young man said, "You can't do that. This is my neighborhood station and you have to pre-pay."

But it was the station I stopped at routinely on the way to work, and I had never prepaid.

Sure enough, as soon as I stuck the nozzle in the can, gasoline flowed.

I looked at the young man who was dressed in a nice pair of jeans. I had been doing yard work that day and was wearing a pair of bib overalls. So, it wasn't how I was dressed that got me treated better.

He drove an old van, but I was driving an old pickup.

Perhaps I was treated better because I have some gray in my hair, but I doubt it.

It would seem my skin color offered me a privilege that's denied others. That's just not right but it won't change until more white people realize that the privileges they receive often are denied others.

“I can just tell you that when we went in to do our pre-construction meeting about a month ago, they asked us to keep everything on the down low for now. I think because it’s proprietary, they want to keep it close to their vest. Once the signs go up,

everybody will know.” On a possibly-related note, on the website of Tesla, an electric vehicle manufacturer, a Rochelle supercharger site is listed as coming soon with a target opening in quarter two of 2022. But, the address of 330 S. 7th St. is not named and the listing says timing and location

are subject to change. The process of the charging site began over a year ago when a permit was obtained, Starr said. The high-speed charging station will be 1,200 amps, 277/480 volts. The only other electric vehicle charging stations in town are currently in the downtown parking lots in the

400 block of North Main Street, which were put in by the city and Rochelle Municipal Utilities last year. “There’s a push for electric cars and sustainable energy and I think we’re probably going to see more pop up because of that,” Pease said. Starr believes the new

charging station location was likely chosen due to convenience of being close to the interstate highways. Pease agreed and said in the area they’re not common yet and electric vehicles can only go so many miles before having to find a charging station. She hopes having more in

town will help economically. “One of the things I think it will do is bring people off the interstate for us,” Pease said. “If we can do that and pull them into town and they charge their car and have lunch and shop locally, that trickle-down effect for us is pretty important.”

COVID: School nurse detail challenges during pandemic

They quickly morphed into a weekly meeting between school nurses across all of Ogle County.

“Being a school nurse is an independent and autonomous role,” Builta said. “We usually work alone as the only health care provider for our school. It was really nice to have the other school nurses in Ogle County and DeKalb to talk with. We all took something away from the conversations. We developed communication tools that allowed us to more easily communicate with the Ogle County Health Department and within our own district. We shared frustrations, celebrations and even a few tears.”

COVID-19-related duties for school nurses included identifying positive cases, notifying and communicating with families and contact tracing. Builta said those new responsibilities required more hours of work and putting some of her usual work on hold. “I always felt like something didn’t get done,” Builta said. “Like I was missing completing a task. I would wake up at night remembering that there was a parent I wanted to touch base with, or a teacher that I needed to talk to about a student concern. Myself and the staff I work with were all consumed with COVID-19. It has been very difficult.”

Prior to the pandemic, typical school nurse responsibilities included making sure students get daily medications, helping students with chronic health concerns, responding to urgent and emergency situations in school, ensuring students get appropriate physicals, immunizations, dental exams and vision and hearing screening.

Sacrifices of some of those practices had to be

made in the interest of time. Builta said she dealt with COVID-19-related issues daily from the time she got to school until the time she left. With the pandemic in a lull recently, health staff in the elementary district has been able to get caught up on those things like hearing and vision screenings and hopes to get it all done by the end of this school year.

As a school nurse, Builta said her job is to provide education and be a resource for families. And that’s what she has done during the pandemic. When she would call a family to talk to them about their child testing positive for COVID-19 or being a close contact to someone that was, the conversation didn’t stop there.

“I would be on the phone for as long as it took for the family to ask all of their questions,” Builta said. “To some of our families, this was absolutely the worst thing that they could imagine. My job was to normalize the situation as much as I could and provide the family with all of the education that I could, to make them as comfortable as possible with the situation before we hung up. Some families would call me daily to check in. They just wanted to know that someone was there to answer their questions.”

In a position separate from and secondary to her time as a school nurse, Builta worked with the Ogle County Emergency Operations Center during the first few months of the pandemic. She kept track of emergency volunteers’ time and everything the EOC did, mostly to help with future funding.

Her husband and children are all involved in emergency operations and firefighting, which she believes is why she got involved.

“We’ve always volun-

teered within our community, so it’s always been understood that if there’s something big going on, we’re going to be there working through it,” Builta said. “They were always very supportive. It was so amazing to watch the community come together to support one another and offer assistance to each other.”

Builtta said it became obvious very quickly at the beginning of the current school year that COVID-19 was going to cause hurdles for the school district to cross. When it became clear that school health offices wouldn’t be able to handle the amount of COVID-19 testing that was needed, administration stepped in and opened a testing site at May School.

“It was amazing to get that testing site,” Builta said. “I believe that we are the only school district in the area to offer testing services in a centralized location. The opening of this site was a real game changer for us. I am very appreciative of our administration for recognizing this concern and finding a way to address it.”

Other aspects of the pandemic that made work difficult included attendance, zones where people who possibly had COVID-19 could and could not be and limited social interaction with coworkers.

Health office members would work all day working to rectify who was and was not in school with COVID-19 causing absences. The nurse’s office at RMS was a “clean” room, and if someone showed symptoms, they had to be taken to another part of the building. Staff in the RMS front office couldn’t work closely like they used to in an effort to prevent spread.

Builtta said the recent COVID-19 lull has allowed

her to “take a deep breath” and have more time than in the busier pandemic months. She recently emptied a file cabinet that contained COVID-19 testing items. That gave her a chance to reflect on the past two years.

“The health offices have been so stressed this year,” Builta said. “Trying to keep our heads above water has been so difficult. It really starts to take a physical toll

on you. When your body is constantly running at the level of stress that we have been, it’s hard. Emotionally, physically, we are wiped out.

Builtta believes a school nurse is an important part of a team that is in place to care for students. She’s watched teachers pivot to online learning and back to in-person and work to catch up students that have been sick. Counselors and

secretaries came together to support families with things like attendance. Administration members stayed late to call parents to let them know about exposures. Every staff member asked what they could do to help, Builta said.

“It was definitely a group effort,” Builta said. “None of us can do our jobs alone, and together, we can truly make a difference in a child’s life.”

Streator rallies over Rochelle

Bulldogs score twice in final minutes, edge Lady Hubs 2-0 on Tuesday

ROCHELLE— With temperatures hovering around 40 degrees and wind chills below freezing, the Rochelle Lady Hub varsity soccer team battled the elements Tuesday afternoon, when the Streator Bulldogs came to town for a non-conference match that saw both teams pushed to their limits during the final minutes.

The Lady Hubs controlled the first half, maintaining possession for most of the time and nearly scoring on several close chances inside the Streator box. But the scoreless draw continued during the second half, where the Bulldogs used the tailwind to their advantage and converted on two through balls in the last five minutes to defeat Rochelle 2-0. Voight medals at 2022 USAW National Middle School Duals

CROWN POINT, Ind. — Rochelle eighth-grader Brenden Voight earned the opportunity to represent the Illinois Kids Wrestling Federation and the State of Illinois at the 2022 USAW National Middle School Duals this past weekend. Voight went 3-2 over five bouts, winning twice with the IKWF Gold team that reached the championship bracket and medaled in second place.

"It was a really cool experience," Voight said. "I was able to wrestle against kids from different states and a lot of the kids I faced didn't wrestle how we wrestle in Illinois. They had a bunch of different styles. It was a really fun weekend and it was a big confidence booster for me."

Voight won his first bout with IKWF Gold, defeating Nebraska Blue's Wyatt Jelinek by 11-2 major decision in the team's first dual of the pool round. IKWF Gold then defeated Nebraska Blue 67-6 before beating Team Illinois IESA Titans 52-27. The team followed with a 79-15 win over the MMWA Michigan National Team and a 60-6 victory over the Nebraska White team.

Voight edged Legacy National Team's Damyan Duncan by 1-0 decision in IKWF

Gold's final dual of the pool round, helping IKWF Gold defeat Legacy National 37-36 to finish the pools with a 5-0 record. In the Gold Medal bracket, IKWF Gold took down Nebraska Red 47-27 to reach the championship match, where the team fell 73-9 against Ohio USA to finish in second place.

"I've been wrestling for four years," Voight said. "I came home one day and my dad asked me about wrestling so I decided to try it. What I enjoy most is having my hand raised by the official after I win a match. I always try to stay fast on my feet and score points whenever I can."

Voight went 2-1 with IKWF Gold and 1-1 with the alternate team, scoring a 3-2 decision against Team Kentucky's Abreyan Fletcher. Voight, who competes with the nWo Wrestling Club as well as Rochelle Middle School, said he plans to wrestle for the Rochelle Township High School team next year.

Voight was one of three Rochelle-area competitors to earn a medal during the IKWF State Championship meet this past month, finishing sixth in the 144 Senior Division.

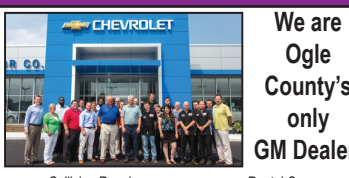

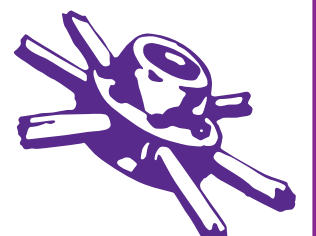

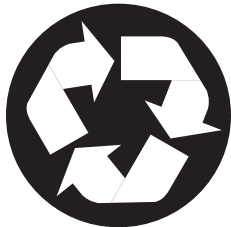

Huskies conduct first spring practice of 2022

Football team returning 18 starters

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University Huskies opened 2022 spring football practice on a foggy morning at Huskie Stadium Wednesday with a veteran — yet still young — team featuring 18 returning starters from its 2021 MAC Championship squad.

While 18 returning starters seems like a hefty number, it gets even more impressive when adding players like third-year sophomore Harrison Waylee — who has already rushed for 1,000 career yards in just 11 games for NIU — and redshirt freshman safety Devin Lafayette, who won the starting safety job during preseason camp in 2021 but suffered a season-ending injury in the season opener at Georgia Tech. Of course, there is also two-time All-MAC linebacker Kyle Pugh. After missing the entire 2021 campaign due to injury and playing just two games in 2019, the veteran returns to battle a host of “youngsters” for playing time.

After fielding the second-youngest team in the Football Bowl Subdivision a year ago, fourth year NIU head coach Thomas Hammock said he has already been impressed by the maturity of the 2022 team.

“The thing I see is more maturity from the guys,” Hammock said. “I think they have confidence. I think they have an understanding of what we want to do on offense, defense and

special teams. They can go out and execute. We have 95 guys on the roster this spring which is a lot more than normal. We were an extremely young football team last year, these guys have made strides in the weight room, they have made strides in conditioning, and they have an opportunity this spring to establish their roles for next season.”

NIU worked for a little less than two hours in shorts and pro pads in occasional drizzle and fog, and the day included plenty of team 11-on-11 work. Nine newcomers—eight transfers and incoming freshman Trey Porter—joined the 86 returnees, including quarterback Rocky Lombardi and 2021 first team All-MAC selection C.J. Brown, who led NIU in tackles with 109 as a second-year freshman.

On Tuesday during a press opportunity previewing spring ball, Lombardi and cornerback Jordan Gandy said the players and staff have put 2021 behind them and are focused on 2022 and improving every day.

“Last year is over,” Lombardi said. “We had a good year, but now it’s about staying focused, making sure we take care of business. I came here to win games and win a lot of games and I think we’ve got the team to do it this year.”

“We just have to keep getting better every day at the fundamentals,” Gandy said. “Things like tackling,



techniques, the small things that make a difference. Continuing to work on that and our scheme and making sure everyone has a good understanding of what we’re trying to do.”

The Huskies will practice Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday this spring with the Monday and Wednesday workouts in the morning, while Fridays will be either in the morning or at 6:30 p.m. in the evening. Saturday practices will be held at either 10 a.m. or 2 p.m. Practices are open to the public with fans asked to sit in the West Stands. A complete schedule of spring practice, along with links to the roster, YouTube videos, practice reports and more, is available at 2022 Spring Football Central on NIUHuskies.com. “I think we’re ready to get back to where we were 10 years ago when [NIU] had that run,” Lombardi said. “Most importantly, we’re going to have a really good team, I’m really excited about this year. If you like Huskie Football, this would be a good year for you to come out and watch us play. We’re going to do some special things.”
