## One year at The REC

### Park district reflects on operations

**ROCHELLE**—Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District Executive Director Jackee Ohlinger called opening The REC Center and building out its programs amid COVID-19 “quite the feat.”

The \$14 million facility at 802 Jones Road that opened Dec. 1, 2020 includes a four-court gymnasium, indoor turf, a fitness center, multi-purpose rooms, an indoor walking track and an aquatic center with two pools.

A monthly pass system

was used instead of memberships upon opening due to pandemic restrictions and uncertainty. When it was finally able to offer everything included in a membership in February 2021, The REC opened with 1,431 members. As of February 2022, The REC had 2,146 members. Throughout 2021 there were 72,000 members and drop-ins at The REC, not including participation numbers of programs and spectators.

“It was a nice increase throughout a year of unknowns,” Ohlinger said. This building took

20-something years. It’s been something in the works involving many people before me and the board worked to get this facility available to the community and it took a long time to get here. I believe that everyone is very excited about it. We have so many positive comments, not only how the building looks but how our staff is doing and the functions of it. I’m really proud of everything we’ve been able to accomplish and I think Rochelle made an excellent investment.”

## Creston board discusses quiet zone feasibility

### Truck route signs to be purchased and posted in village

**CRESTON**—At Tuesday’s meeting, the Creston Village Board discussed its efforts to put in quiet zones at its three railroad crossings to put a stop to train horns.

Village Engineer Kevin Bunge presented a total design engineering cost of \$10,400 that does not include construction engineering. The crossings are on Transit Street, Main Street and Woodlawn Road. Establishing a quiet zone requires putting in medians and signage on the north and south sides of the tracks and coordination with state and federal authorities.

“The scope of work is topographic surveys of the three areas, creative bid packages to go out for bids, assisting the village in establishing the diagnostic committee as required and attending two meetings, assisting the village with the bidding and contract phases of the project and it does not include construction phase services which

we can talk more about,” Bunge said. “Medians will be 60-100 feet. It will have to be approved by bigger agencies. I can estimate construction engineering, but it depends how much inspecting of the project we do. That depends on the contractor.”

Village Trustee Mike Kerns and Village President Tom Byro expressed concerns about Main Street and Transit Street being wide enough to accommodate medians. Kerns asked about possibly adding two gates instead of a median, and was told by Village

Trustee Curt Ward that the cost for that is about \$800,000 and an annual fee to the railroad.

“It could be impossible to do here with medians,” Kerns said. “I don’t see the medians working. They have to be 60 feet long. There could be issues on

Main Street around the library and you might only be able to get to that one way or no parking. Common sense, it doesn’t make sense. I see it being a problem. But I agree that the train horns are a huge problem.”

## Price named Coca-Cola Academic Team Gold Scholar

**MALTA**—Sierra Price, a Kishwaukee College student and Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) member, has been named a 2022 Coca-Cola Academic Team Gold Scholar and will receive a \$1,500 scholarship for the fall 2022 semester.

The Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation celebrates visionary leaders in PTK and sponsors the Coca-Cola Academic Team program by recognizing 50 Gold, 50 Silver and 50 Bronze Scholars with nearly \$200,000 in scholarships annually. Each scholar also receives a commemorative medallion.

"I feel ecstatic to receive this honor, and I am extremely grateful for the opportunities Kishwaukee has provided to me during my time here," Price said. "It's something I didn't really imagine would get this far when I was filling out the application, so I am very excited about this recognition."

Price plans to complete her associate in arts degree at Kish in May and transfer to Northern Illinois University to pursue a degree in marketing. She was inducted into Kishwaukee College's PTK Alpha Rho Eta chapter in December 2021. Each year, Kish nominates members for the scholarship program who go through a lengthy application process. Selection is based on academic achievement, leadership and engagement in college and community service.

"We had to do a long essay on a way that we have impacted our community. I work with the Chicago Track and Field organizing committee, and we have rejuvenated what was an old landfill in Geneva and turned it into an outdoor track and field facility. In

the essay, I was able to speak on how it impacts environmentalism and serving the community," Price said.

**PAW PAW** — A missing Paw Paw woman was found deceased on Tuesday, a Lee County Sheriff's Office press release said.

On Monday at 10:17 p.m. the Lee County Sheriff's Office responded to rural Paw Paw for a report of a missing 37-year-old female. The family reported having last contact with the missing female late Sunday afternoon.

Deputies responded to the area and were assisted in their search by drone operators from Lee County Emergency Management, Bureau County Emergency Management and the

Amboy Fire Department.

After daylight on Tuesday, the search expanded to include the Lee County Volunteer Core Search and Rescue Team, Amboy Police Department, Dekalb County Sheriff's Office, Paw Paw Fire Department, Compton Fire Department and the Shabbona Fire Department.

At approximately 10:40 a.m. on Tuesday searchers located 37-year-old Nicole Bruno in a rural creek embankment, deceased.

The Lee County Coroner's Office was notified and planned to conduct an autopsy Tuesday.

Ward said with the median plan, there would still be parking on Main Street. He spoke of the importance of the board making a decision and moving forward with a plan and said train horns are the number one complaint the board hears from village residents.

“People ask why we can’t do it when other towns have,” Ward said. “We’re here to represent all of Creston. I’ve had a lot of people wanting the train horns to stop. The board needs to make a decision. There’s a process available to do it. For Transit Street, we need to talk to the ICC about how to address that. The other option is to make it a one-way street. Woodlawn definitely has room for a median.”

Trustee Greg Hopkins said farm machinery that uses those streets will have to straddle the medians. “Byro said the board will continue work on the issue. “We’ve got some information and we need more information to see what comes up on this,” Byro said. “Physically, being able to do it is going to be interesting. We’ll keep going and we’re not going to stop looking at it.”

### Truck routes

Trustees discussed a plan to purchase and put 18 truck route signs in the village to relieve damage to roads from trucks.

Ward said he imagines the cost will be at least \$200 per sign and that the village is likely looking at \$4,000-5,000 in signs and posts. The village will also pass a truck route ordinance that will go into the state database. The reason the issue was originally brought up was due to lost truck drivers being on undesired routes in the village including near the school.

“Our main goal is to keep these guys that get lost coming through town in the best areas we can,” Ward said. “It’s the trucks that miss their turn and turn on Beck Road and come wandering through the narrow residential streets. Under Illinois law if you don’t establish truck routes, then basically any street is a truck route. Our local streets are not designed for even the turning movements of all that weight.”

The board also briefly discussed the idea of talking with the Ogle County Sheriff’s Office and Rochelle Police Department about the possibility of getting an officer to patrol in the village to increase enforcement of truck routes and issues like speeding heading into the summer.

### Water issues

The village board unanimously voted to move forward with its water main project that it will utilize American Rescue Plan Act funds for. Cres-

ton was recently awarded \$89,000 in ARPA funds that it has three years to spend. Water mains are an eligible expense for that money.

The work will be done on a total of 1,700 feet of water main. Bunge said engineering costs are \$9,250, but construction costs are unclear due to the volatile nature of the materials market.

“We need to continue this to get this stuff done before the state comes in and says we have to do it,” Byro said.

Byro said the village’s water operator will be

attending next month’s meeting to discuss the IEPA lead/copper audit project that Creston will have to start this year.

Due to a mandate, homes in the village will have to be inspected to see if lead or copper piping is bringing water into them. The village will eventually have to pay to fix it if somebody has lead going into their home.

Bunge said houses built around after 1970 will likely have copper or plastic lines.

“This is going to be a big deal for Creston and a big deal for the entire

state,” Byro said. “And we’ve got some well issues we need to talk about. Unfortunately we’re going to have to spend some money. That one well has never been pulled since I’ve been on this board over 30 years. There’s some stuff we’re going to have to look at. This lead pipe thing is going to be a big deal. We’ll have to go into the older houses and make some arrangements to see what they’ve got.”

The village has to start the process this year and do a required amount and complete it within two years.

“And then we notify who’s got the stuff and then the money is supposed to come from the federal or the state to fix all of it,” Byro said. “We’ll come up with a letter to residents explaining what’s going on. More information to come next month.”

### Sealcoating

Byro said the village will not be sealcoating roads this year and will reassess next year. Creston did not sealcoat last year either, but did some roads in each of the two prior years.

## Rochelle Fire receives \$24,000 in grant funding

SPRINGFIELD —

The Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal (OSFM) announced Wednesday that the Rochelle Fire Department (\$24,000) was among the recipients of the 2022 small equipment grant program. A total of \$2.5 million was awarded to 104 fire departments/districts and EMS providers across the state. The program was established to provide grants of up to \$26,000 each for the purchase of small firefighting and ambulance equipment.

“All communities deserve safety, and this program helps ensure our smaller and rural fire districts aren’t left behind when it comes to the tools they need to do their jobs,” said Governor J.B. Pritzker. “I’m proud to be able to provide more than 100 districts with new lifesaving equipment. It’s another way we can

demonstrate our gratitude for all that they do to help their neighbors live safely.”

This program is an innovative approach to a problem that has long caused difficulties for fire departments and not-for-profit ambulance services in Illinois, particularly those that have hardships in generating the necessary revenue for small equipment. The purpose is to allow eligible applicants the opportunity to purchase small equipment that they may otherwise not be able to purchase. The OSFM received 373 applications, requesting around \$8.4 million in funding for this grant period.

“Funding provided from our Small Equipment Grant Program is a huge benefit, especially to our rural volunteer departments in the state. These funds allow departments to purchase

important equipment their firefighters/EMT’s need to work more effectively and safely while protecting the lives and property of their community mem-

bers,” said Illinois State Fire Marshal Matt Perez.

Most Illinois fire departments, fire protections districts, township fire departments, and stand-

alone, nonprofit ambulance service providers were eligible to apply. All fire departments, fire protections districts and township fire department

applicants were required to have participated in the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS) for a minimum of two years prior to applying.

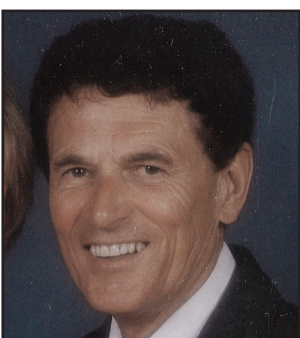

### Ogle County offering free oak tree saplings

**OREGON** — The 52<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the first Earth Day, a day dedicated to preserving our environment, is on April 22. Arbor Day, a day designated in 1872 to promote the importance of planting trees, is recognized this year on April 29. What better way to celebrate these days than to plant an oak tree for future generations to enjoy! The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) will have free oak tree saplings available for Ogle County residents on April 22 and 29 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 909 Pines Road, Oregon, while supplies last. There will be a total of 900 bur oak, red oak and swamp white oak trees for distribution on a first-come, first-served basis. Residents can take up to 10 (total) saplings per household to plant on their property while supplies last. Take only what you can plant and care for. This means caring for it after it is planted (watering, weeding, wrapping) and

protecting it from animals and mowers. The free saplings will be located in the garage on the south side of the parking lot at the OCSWMD. They will be individually-wrapped bare-rooted saplings, should be kept cool and moist and must be planted as soon as possible. Information about each species, planting instructions and tree posters will also be available. The site is under video surveillance. The limit per household is 10 trees. Those wanting more trees can put their name on a list to be contacted if extra trees are available. The trees were donated by Living Lands & Waters (LL&W) Million Tree Project in East Moline. The Million Tree Project was initiated in 2007 to help further the Living Lands and Waters mission to protect, preserve and restore the natural environment of our nation’s major rivers and their watersheds. Their mission is to not only clean up the river ways but to also

enhance the watersheds by planting native trees and removing invasive plants. OCSWMD and the Rock River Trail Initiative have supported this mission for several years by facilitating and distributing over 10,000 trees per year to units of government, forest preserves, and conservation groups in all of the eleven counties that border the Rock River in Illinois and Wisconsin. Planting the trees along rivers, streams and waterways is strongly encouraged by these groups. This should have a long-lasting positive impact on the Rock River watershed. Residents are encouraged to submit digital photos of their trees after planted and in subsequent years to LL&W or OCSWMD, to verify the success of the program and to help to sustain donors to the program. Willahan said he was impressed with the newly-constructed standalone building and everything turned out well and on-time in one the faster builds the company has done. Ground was broken in August. The 2,000 square-foot store has indoor and outdoor seating and a drive-thru and created 75-80 construction jobs. Starbucks has hired a total of 30 employees for the location and the majority of them started with the company about three weeks ago and have been traveling to DeKalb or Rockford for training. Hiring wasn't a difficulty amid employment shortages in all industries, Willahan said. "We've had no problem getting positions filled," Willahan said. "We still

have quite a few applications on file. Once we get open and we get things assessed on where we're going to be and all that, we'll be looking into hiring even more help." Starbucks will be prepared for a rush of customers upon opening the new location. Willahan said staff will be "bulked up" in the coming week and more seasoned partners from other locations will be brought in to help the newer employees through opening. "We're going to bulk up so we can be prepared for a lot of customers the best we can," Willahan said. "It's going to be a learning experience for us all until we figure out what the cadence is for Rochelle." Willahan said he's excited about the location and

its proximity to two major roads in Illinois Route 251 and Illinois Route 38 along with The REC Center, Walgreens and the eventual development of the former site of Hickory Grove. The Starbucks location's manager said Rochelle and area residents can expect a warm and friendly place where patrons can hang out and relax. Starbucks refers to its storefronts as "the third place" for its customers. "Your first place is your home and your second is your work," Willahan said. "The third place is here. We want everybody to be able to come in here and feel comfortable and relaxed and feel welcome. People can come in here and just kind of get away and have a great beverage, a snack, lunch or whatever

## Being a defense attorney is admirable

DEFENDING the accused shouldn’t be a mark of shame.

But in the world of politics, there may not be a more loathsome creature than a criminal defense attorney.

I’ve been thinking about that these past few weeks as I watched Republican Senators attack U.S. Supreme Court nominee Ketanji Brown Jackson and Democrats assail Illinois GOP gubernatorial hopeful Richard Irvin.

Their transgressions? At some point in their careers, they defended people accused of crimes.

Never mind that our Constitution gives defendants an absolute right to legal counsel.

In our monochromatic world of soundbite politics, prosecutors are good and defense attorneys are bad.

The last person to serve on the U.S. Supreme Court with any experience as a defense attorney was Thurgood Marshall, who retired from the bench 31 years ago. And his work as a defense attorney ended in the 1950s.

That’s a long time to go without anyone bringing the perspective of a defense attorney into deliberations.

According to a study by the libertarian think tank Cato Institute, defense attorneys are underrepresented among federal judges. As of April 2021, 318 former prosecutors were sitting as federal judges, more than one-third of the 880 total across the country. This was followed by 243 lawyers who had represented the government as “noncriminal courtroom advocates”. Among the smallest fractions of those who became federal judges were former criminal defense attorneys – about 76 total – and former public defenders, who numbered only 58, less than 7 percent of all judges.

Considering law is a diverse field encompassing nearly every aspect of the human condition it is disappointing that we draw our

justices from such a shallow pool.

The Democratic Governor’s Association launched a television ad against Irvin citing his past as a defense attorney.

In a breathless voice, a narrator says Irvin defended people accused of domestic abuse and sexual assault as if they have unearthed some hidden character flaw. Well, lawyers defend people. Sometimes they are innocent and sometimes they are guilty – but all have a right to effective counsel.

The attack is particularly disappointing considering that Gov. J.B. Pritzker is a lawyer himself. He ought to know how important the role of defense attorneys are in our society. (The same could be said of the multitude of Republican lawyers on the U.S. Senate Judiciary committee taking jabs at Ketanji Brown Jackson.)

A couple decades ago I covered an Illinois Supreme Court race in which one candidate boasted that he had never been a defense attorney.

I found it disappointing that this Harvard-educated lawyer embraced the idea of never having defended anyone as a mark of pride, something that would make him a better Supreme Court justice.

After all, when choosing a judge don’t we want someone with diverse experiences in a variety of areas of law?

I’ve spent years tracking police misconduct cases. And in my podcast Suspect Convictions I took an in-depth look at numerous cases of wrongful convictions. Although it is nothing new, it remains a national shame. Our country sends innocent people to prison.

Just consider that a 2019 report by the National Registry of Exonerations found: Between 2% and 10% of convicted individuals in US prisons are likely innocent, 2,666 people have been exonerated in the US since 1989, proven innocent people have served more than 23,950

years in prison so far and Out of 100 sentenced to death, four are likely innocent, but only two get exonerated.

Protecting the innocent should be the highest calling of those serving in the legal profession. I’ve met many bright, talented and committed defense attorneys. But I’ve also met some who have turned their presence as a safety net for the wrongly accused into a hammock of low expectations.

Many of those wrongly accused end up wrongly convicted because of less than zealous work by their attorneys. This underscores the critical need for a vigorous defense bar. We should be praising those who choose this important work – not casting aspersions on their character and fitness for office because they chose to serve defendants.

One of the most zealous advocates for the accused that I have met is John Hanlon, who recently retired as director of the Illinois Innocence Project.

Hanlon expressed disgust for the recent political attacks against members of the defense bar.

“It’s politics. That’s what’s going on pure politics,” he said. “It is repeated over and over again depending on what the cycle is and what office the person is seeking. They try to dirty them up with the alleged acts of their clients. And that’s just a shame.”

Former Scott County, Iowa, prosecutor Bill Davis said it smacks of hypocrisy.

“The people who attack defense attorneys are the same ones who extol the Founding Fathers. Have they forgotten that John Adams represented the British soldiers involved in the Boston Massacre? Our founders made a right to counsel a basic constitutional right. The system would not work without defense attorneys.”

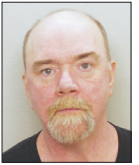

# AUTISM AWARENESS

## Six ways to recognize autism awareness

**A**UTISM has become a household word because of the vast number of lives impacted by this highly scrutinized and often confusing series of conditions. In 2018, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention determined that 1 in 59 children currently has autism spectrum disorder in the United States. ASD can affect the entire body, but it is typically marked by repetitive patterns of behavior, interests or activities. Difficulties with communication, intellectual disabilities and impaired social interactions are also noted. The autism awareness organization Autism Speaks estimates that one-third of people with ASD are nonverbal as well. Research implicates genetics as the cause of ASD in the vast majority

of cases. Generally speaking, children born to older parents are at a higher risk for having autism than those born to younger parents. Despite controversy, there is no definitive link between ASD and immunizations. Each April is Autism Awareness Month. April also hosts World Autism Day (April 2). The Autism Society, one of the leading autism organizations, established the observance month to "promote autism awareness, inclusion and self-determination for all, and to assure that each person with ASD is provided the opportunity to achieve the highest possible quality of life." There are many steps people can take to help the group achieve that goal, both in April and throughout the year.

1. Wear blue. One of the significant markers of autism support and awareness is the displaying of the color blue. Many organizations sell blue t-shirts and other promotional items that help raise awareness and money for the cause.

2. Attend an event. There are many marches or fundraisers for ASD in April. Participating in such events shows those with ASD that people care about them.

3. Go to a sensory friendly event. Venues like movie theaters and amusement parks offer "sensory-friendly" days for individuals with ASD and their families.

4. Embrace the ribbon. The puzzle piece ribbon represents the complexity and diversity of those with ASD. Pin a ribbon to clothing or attach ribbon magnets to cars.

5. Learn more. Dr. Temple Grandin is an autism



expert who is on the spectrum herself. Through her own words, Grandin shares unprecedented insights into what the autistic brain experiences. This education can be used in one's own life

or in the classroom. There are other educators with ASD who also offer their expertise online.

6. Donate when possible. Although there is no cure for autism, researchers

continue to work to learn more about it and any potential treatments that can improve the lives of those with ASD. Learn more about ASD at [www.autism-society.org](http://www.autism-society.org).

## Get involved with autism awareness efforts

**A**UTISM spectrum disorder has the potential to touch just about anyone. The World Health Organization estimates that one in 160 children across the globe has ASD, while some well-controlled studies have reported that figures are substantially higher than that. ASD affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups, meaning just about any family can be affected. In 2018, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released its biennial update of autism's estimated prevalence among the nation's children. The update was based on analysis of medical records, and where available, educational records of eight-year-old children from 11 monitoring sites across the United States. In a two-year period, the new estimate indicated a 15 percent increase in ASD prevalence. Understandably, anyone who has been affected by ASD wants to learn more

about what individuals can do to advocate for high quality services for those with ASD. The autism information group Autism Speaks says more work is needed to understand the increased prevalence and the complex medical needs that often accompany ASD. There are many different and effective ways to become more involved in the autism community. Many schools have integrated classrooms where children who have ASD work alongside their peers. Others may have specialized programs for those who need one-on-one support. Either way, the goal is to introduce children to ASD when they are young, as many have friends or classmates with ASD. Helping to dispel myths about ASD and encouraging support and compassion can improve relationships during childhood. Research into causation as well as treatment options and interventions for ASD

can be expensive. That makes fundraising a necessary component. Individuals can participate in many organized fundraisers, such as walks, runs, rides, and other activities. However, enterprising people also can create their own fundraisers or ones unique to their own needs. Those who do not have someone with ASD in their immediate family but know a relative, friend or neighbor with ASD can be a listening ear, a person to rally at events or advocacy meetings, or just a touchstone when a little extra support is needed. People who own businesses can support adults with ASD in the community through program's like the Organization for Autism Research's Hire Autism Initiative. Autism spectrum disorder affects many people. During April and throughout the entire year, there are many ways for people to spread the word about ASD and support ASD research.

Hager said there were a lot of challenges to overcome and it has felt good to start to near the end of the pandemic after The REC's first season open wasn't a true representation of the new facility's abilities.

The most recent winter was the first real taste of what the building can fully offer, Hager said. Basketball and other programs were offered for "pretty much every age" seven days a week. REC Basketball was during the week and men's league and youth travel basketball were held on weekends. RYBA moved under the The REC and the park district's umbrella. Youth travel basketball brought in teams and families from other towns. "I'd say youth travel basketball was one of the

big features of this winter," Hager said. "We're still getting the feel of everything because we have our own space. We changed RYBA a little bit and made it into REC Basketball. We changed a little bit of how it functions, but we had great numbers for both our girls and boys leagues and I only see that program growing in the wintertime."

Ohlinger said the park district is trying to grow its programs and bring more variety to The REC. Its other programs currently include soccer, baseball, pickleball and volleyball along with kids activities and crafts.

Hager said it's been a challenge to find what exactly members want and providing them with the best opportunities for programs. That includes the new fitness center and seeing which classes and equipment work for people and what's additionally desired.

"We had our general base for the building and then it became finding what our members like and don't like and trying to provide them with countless new opportunities both with inside fitness and just recreation in general," Hager said. "That's been a challenge,

just finding what our specific members are looking for and trying to best provide it for them."

The biggest surprise since opening for Ohlinger was immediate enrollment numbers in programs the park district ran for years before The REC such as little hoopsters or pee wee soccer. Numbers in some programs jumped from 20 to 80.

The REC's aquatic center programs have been at max capacity and the park district hopes to get more staff and trained instructors for those classes.

The next areas of focus at The REC will be building out programs for its turf surface, including baseball, softball and soccer along with doing more classroom-style activities in its multipurpose room spaces.

"I don't think we've scratched the surface of what we can actually do in this building," Ohlinger said. "There's a plethora of things that we could still bring. And we will. I feel really confident we'll find more staff and be creative in scheduling and keep improving year in and year out."

Outside of COVID-19 and program work, chal-



lenges at The REC since opening have included staffing and building operations.

Staff has had to learn how to work with features in its new building such as heating, air conditioning and lighting. Ohlinger said the park district has been lucky to have access to resources in the community, such as the fire department, which has helped with things like emergency systems, inspections and training.

Before moving to The REC Center, full-time park district staff was only made up of Ohlinger, Hager and Superintendent of Administration & Finance Maureen Stevens and one customer service representative. The new building required "a lot more" more staff, including

aquatic employees moving to year-round.

Amid a hiring shortage across all industries, the park district has felt those effects when looking to fill new positions, especially when it wasn't sure what positions would be needed in the new building.

"We might have 11-ish staff members now, not including our aquatic staff because we had them in the summer and now they're year round, in other areas for our recreation and front desk," Ohlinger said. "And we've probably only been closed seven days out of the year. That's a lot of hours for our staff to be working and they work really hard when they're here."

The park district's executive director said it's been nice to see families drop off their children for practice or

a program at The REC and be able to go and workout or swim and stay in the building. Hager said a lot of those parents that bring children in have ended up getting a membership for themselves.

After efforts to bring The REC to town, navigating its construction and working to open amid the pandemic, Ohlinger has enjoyed seeing it full of residents in recent months.

"It makes my heart happy," Ohlinger said. "When you put in all those hours, you certainly want to see success. And I think every one of us feels that when we walk in here and it's alive and exciting, whether it's little kids or seeing grandparents smiling watching some of the activities. It just makes everything worthwhile."

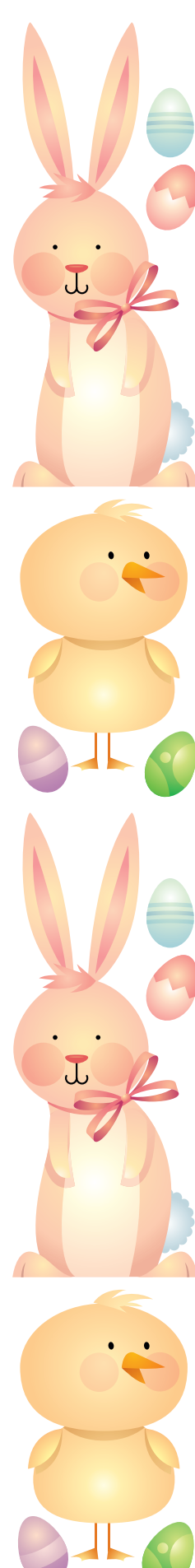

# Teams win home meet

Rochelle athletes sweep Interstate 8 Conference matchup with Ottawa, Plano

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub and Lady Hub varsity track and field teams each emerged victorious during Tuesday’s Interstate 8 meet against Ottawa and Plano. The Hubs finished first with 61.5 points while Plano scored 61 points and Ottawa totaled 47.5 points. The Lady Hubs won with 63 points while Ottawa collected 51 points and Plano had 50 points.

Senior Zach Sanford shined in the throwing events, winning the shotput with a distance of 14.36 meters and winning the discus with a distance of 39.93 meters. Senior Ryan Simmons won the high jump with a clearance of 1.68 meters and junior Hayden Inman won the pole vault with a clearance of 2.98 meters. Junior Trey Taft and senior Luke Orlikowski took third and fourth in the triple jump with respective distances of 3.20 meters and 3.12 meters. Rochelle’s 3200-meter relay team of Luis Hernandez, Max Orlikowski, Hayden Smith and Abel Huerta finished second with

a time of 10:55:55. The Hubs won the 400-meter relay, clocking in at 43.19 seconds behind Michael Ramsey, Landon DeLille, Ethan Wells and Griffin Ohlinger. Junior Ethan Bergeson won the 110-meter hurdles with a time of 20.79 seconds. Ramsey and Simmons took fourth and fifth in the 100-meter dash with respective times of 12.78 and 12.79 while DeLille finished seventh in 12.97. Junior Wade Smith placed second in the 800-meter run with a time of 2:36.00 while Huerta took third with a time of 2:37.70. Rochelle’s 800-meter relay team of Wells, Taft, Simmons and Ohlinger won with a time of 1:42.45. Inman placed second in the 300-meter hurdles with a time of 51.00. Luke Orlikowski and Ramsey finished third and fourth in the 200-meter dash with respective times of 25.70 and 26.01. Rochelle’s 1600-meter relay team of Troy Papke, Smith, Inman and Taft won in 4:18.81 while Josue Huerta, Hernandez, Alex Burke and Thomas Koziol took second in 4:34.20.

# Hubs concede seventh-inning lead against Ottawa

## Late errors hurt Rochelle as Pirates rally for 6-5 victory at Helms Park

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity baseball team came within one out of securing its first victory of the season during Wednesday’s Interstate 8 Conference matchup against Ottawa. Looking to split the home-and-home series after falling 11-1 on Monday, Rochelle held a 2-1 lead with two outs in the top of the seventh inning. After the Pirates loaded the bases on a shallow single to left field, Ottawa’s Luke Cushing bounced a ball to third base, but a throwing error allowed two Pirates to score and give Ottawa a 3-2 lead. The Pirates added three more runs on a hit-by-pitch, a passed ball and another fielding error, Rochelle’s third of the frame. Trailing 6-2, Rochelle delivered multiple clutch at-bats during the bottom of the seventh inning, scoring three runs and putting the tying run on second base with two outs. But a deep fly ball to center field from junior Alex Burnette found the glove of Ottawa center fielder Conner Price, who squeezed the ball to secure Ottawa’s 6-5 win over the Hubs. Rochelle fell to 0-2 with the loss.

“We hit a lot of line drives late in the game and we saw a lot of our kids battle with two strikes,” head coach Jarrod Reynolds said. “We struck out 10 times on Monday and I never want to talk too much about strikeouts, but I thought we cut that number down today and we had a lot more hits today. I thought our offense definitely made some improvements from Monday to today.” Wednesday’s series finale was a pitcher’s duel for most of the afternoon, with senior Nate Burdin taking the ball for the Hubs and Rylan Dorsey taking the mound for the Pirates. Burdin nearly threw a complete game, striking out eight batters over six and two-thirds innings while allowing only one earned run in the top of the second inning. Trailing 1-0 in the bottom of the fifth inning, Rochelle took the lead when junior Noah Lara belted a two-run double to left-center field. “I thought Nate did a great job today,” Reynolds said. “Nate’s a great competitor and he threw a lot of strikes to keep us in the game. I don’t think we could ask for much more from our starter.”

senior Andy Buskohl smacked a double into deep right field. The left-hander Burdin then sent an RBI single through the left side of the infield to make it a 6-3 game. Senior Josh Lloyd’s



sacrifice fly to center plated another Hub run to bring Rochelle within two runs. With two outs in the inning, senior Jacob Andrist came through with a live-drive single off the bench before junior Colton O’Rorke fol-

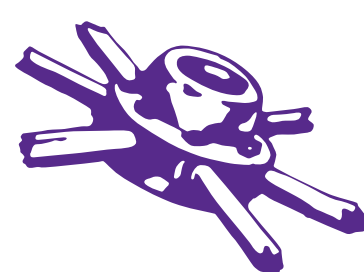
lowed with a ground-ball single to center to put the winning run on base. But Burnette’s flyout ended the Rochelle rally and sealed the Ottawa win.

Mayer**, and they ruled Hollywood film making.

As **Mike Hopkins**, senior VP of Prime Video and Amazon Studios, points out, “The real financial value behind this deal is the treasure trove of MGM’s catalog, which we plan to reimagine and develop with MGM’s talented team.” MGM owns EPIX and produces “The Handmaid’s Tale” and “Fargo,” etc. It produced the James Bond franchise with United Artists, which generated \$16.8 billion, and claims MGM’s catalog has more than 4,000 films, including “Moonstruck,” “Legally Blonde,” “Silence of the Lambs” and “Poltergeist,” as well as 17,000 TV shows. But what it doesn’t contain is movies you see on TCM, such as “The Wizard of Oz,” “Singin’ in the Rain” and “Gone With the Wind,” which were sold to **Ted Turner** in a 1986 package that he in turn sold to Warner Brothers (in a co-ownership deal). Can’t believe MGM’s Leo the Lion now roars for **Jeff Bezos**.
