Powering Rochelle homes Methane gas plant generating energy

ROCHELLE — Since 2011, Rochelle Energy, LLC has operated at the Rochelle Landfill and has powered homes in Rochelle Municipal Utilities' service area.

The power plant collects greenhouse gas from the landfill and cleans it before sending it to three large Caterpillar engines that run off methane gas and produce energy. That energy goes directly onto the City of Rochelle's grid and can power 2,000-4,000 homes each year.

"The two big benefits are

the reduction of greenhouse gas and odors," Archaea Energy Director of Renewable Partnerships Wes Lawrence said. "The electricity that is produced is the same as would come from any other source. It's kind of like a circle of life. For example, sludge is taken from the wastewater treatment plant in Rochelle to the landfill and produces methane that is made into electricity to power that same wastewater treatment plant."

The Rochelle Energy plant was sold to Archaea Energy, one of the largest renewable energy producers in the United States, in 2021. Lawrence was president

of Rochelle Energy before that.

The power plant has several employees and a group that supports them, Lawrence said. Approximately 550 plants like it exist across the U.S. at landfills that are large enough to support them.

Producing energy isn't the only positive of the plant.

"Having the plant there and gathering methane and sulfur makes a difference for odors in the area," Lawrence said. "It's not just producing energy. It's also helping a day-to-day thing like the smell."

Seven residents displaced by duplex fire

No injuries caused by Tuesday afternoon blaze on 2nd Street

ROCHELLE — Seven residents were displaced by a fire at a duplex on Second Street on Tuesday afternoon, Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville said.

Rochelle Fire was called at 4:39 p.m. to 508 N. 2nd St. for the report of a house fire. The call was elevated to box level and all Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District departments (Creston, Steward, Hillcrest and Flagg Center) responded as well. No injuries occurred due to the fire, Sawlsville said.

The fire was contained to one side of the duplex. When Sawlsville arrived on scene, he saw heavy fire and smoke blowing out the back of the building and the fire spread from one room to the entire unit. Rochelle's engine crew arrived and put out a lot of the fire right away, Sawlsville said. The fire was under control after about 40 minutes.

There was nobody home in the unit at the time the fire started and the situation went unnoticed until it started to show outside, Sawlsville said. Residents

were home in the other half of the duplex but were sleeping before getting out safely.

The non-burned half of the duplex sustained smoke and water damage and those residents were displaced. The Red Cross is helping to

secure a place for residents of both units to stay, Sawlsville said.

The burned half of the duplex was a complete loss and will have to be rebuilt, Sawlsville said. He estimated the total damage

cost to be at least \$50,000. Fire crews were on scene for about three hours after the fire was put out to check for hotspots and investigate the cause.

"It was a very hot, intense and fast-moving fire,"

Sawlsville said. "It melted the electrical boxes behind the duplex. It started in one of the back bedrooms, but we're still unsure of the cause and trying to figure that out. We don't think it was suspicious."

“We need to cut that out and repair it,” Trustee Mike Kerns said. “It’s south of Huber Feed. It’s just a great big huge hole and it keeps sinking and breaking up bigger. And the county won’t fix that for us. That hole has been there for a long time. It’s never been patched. We can get it on next month’s agenda and have time to get someone to do that before contractors get busy.”

Grant

Bunge confirmed to trustees at the meeting that Creston’s application has officially been submitted for a Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown grant for \$780,000, \$195,000 of which would be matched locally by the village if awarded.

The grant would include reconstruction of Creston’s downtown including new water mains and storm sewer, reconstruction of the street, all new side-

walks, curb and gutter, parking and more.

At previous meetings, Bunge has said the grant application process will take a year and if selected, Creston wouldn’t start construction or have to pay any costs until the latter part of 2023.

“Everything went pretty well with it,” Bunge said. “You guys got good letters

of support from impacted businesses downtown which counts for a lot. Now we’re just in waiting mode. I will let you know as soon as we hear anything.”

Water mains

Bunge said he plans to bring an estimate of engineering fees and construction costs for two future water main replacement

projects that the village wants to use American Rescue Plan Act funds for.

Creston was recently awarded \$89,000 in ARPA funds that it has three years to spend. Water mains are an eligible expense for that money.

Gaming

Village Attorney Russell Crull discussed the idea

of the village potentially raising its rates on gaming machines in Creston if the board desired to do so. A law changed in the state that allows municipalities to now charge up to \$250 per machine after it was previously \$25.

“Some towns have considered doing it since the state changed it,” Crull said. If you want to con-

sider that in the future, we can do that. There’s quite a bit of debate about it with other towns. Some people go all the way to \$250 and some haven’t raised it at all. It’s really up to you guys. It would just be an ordinance modification.”

The Moose Knuckle has five gaming machines. They are the only gaming machines in Creston.

2021 Ogle County final multiplier announced

OREGON — Ogle County has been issued a final property assessment equalization factor of 1.0000, according to David Harris, director of the Illinois Department of Revenue.

The property assessment equalization factor, often called the “multiplier,” is the method used to achieve uniform property assessments among counties,

as required by law. This equalization is particularly important because some of the state’s 6,600 local taxing districts overlap into two or more counties (e.g. school districts, junior college districts, fire protection districts).

If there were no equalization among counties, substantial inequities among taxpayers with comparable properties would result.

Under a law passed in 1975, property in Illinois should be assessed at one-third of its market value. Farm property is assessed differently, with farm homesites and dwellings subject to regular assessing and equalization procedures, but with farmland assessed at one-third of its agriculture economic value.

Farmland is not subject to the state equalization factor.

Assessments in Ogle County are at 33.16 percent of market value, based on sales of properties in 2018, 2019 and 2020. The equalization factor currently being assigned is for 2021 taxes, payable in 2022. Last year’s equalization factor for the county was 1.0000. The final assessment equalization factor was issued after a public hearing on

the tentative factor.

The tentative factor issued in Dec. 2021 was 1.0000. The equalization factor is determined annually for each county by comparing the price of individual properties sold over the past three years to the assessed value placed on those properties by the county supervisor of assessments/county assessor.

If this three-year average level of assessment is one-third of the market value, the equalization factor will be one (1). If the average level of assessment is greater than one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be less than one (1). And if the average level of assessment is less than one-third of market value,

the equalization factor will be greater than one (1).

A change in the equalization factor does not mean total property tax bills will increase or decrease. Tax bills are determined by local taxing bodies when they request money each year to provide services to local citizens. If the amount requested by local taxing districts is not greater than the amount received in the previous year, then total property taxes will not increase even if assessments increase.

The assessed value of an individual property determines what portion of the tax burden a specific taxpayer will assume. That individual’s portion of tax responsibility is not changed by the multiplier.

RCH reminds public masking still applies for healthcare settings

ROCHELLE — With the changes in mask mandates, please note that federal rules still require masks in healthcare settings. Therefore, anyone entering Rochelle Community Hospital still needs to mask properly until further notice.

“It would be noticeably worse if the plant wasn’t there.”

Lawrence said over the years a lot of improvements have been made to take sulfur out of gas at the plant. The process involves millions of bugs eating the sulfur and their waste becomes a solid that plant employees collect.

“It’s not great for the environment for sulfur to be put out and lowering the sulfur helps lessen the smell,” Lawrence said.

The engines at the plant run 24 hours a day. Two of the three are running at any one time. Much like a car, they need routine oil changes and tuneups. A system at the plant tells staff exactly when an engine needs something and gives readings on the electricity being produced by them.

Each time an engine is taken out of service, the plant loses energy it could be producing. That makes maintenance a large priority for Rochelle Energy.

“If you don’t do that maintenance, the consequences could be catastrophic,” Lawrence said. “You have to keep things as consistent as you can.”

Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh spoke of the plant’s importance to the city and RMU’s electrical system. Rochelle Energy’s power coming directly onto the city’s grid helps reduce transmission and capacity charges for the city when it buys electricity from its main power provider.

Renewable energy sources make up six percent of the city’s total power load, which is above the state’s requirement. Rochelle Energy is a large part of that number. New state legislation passed last year involves a shift toward more green energy in the future and having sources like the landfill power plant will become more important for cities with public utilities like Rochelle.

“I hope we are able to continue this productive partnership with Archaea Energy for many years to

come,” Fiegenschuh said.

A boundary agreement approved by the Village of Creston and the City of Rochelle last year included plans to close the Rochelle Landfill by the end of 2040. The landfill will be taking more waste as it fills up

before closure.

Lawrence said the plant is looking at a potential increase in energy production of approximately 30 percent by 2030 as a result. That would mean providing power to 750-1,000 additional homes on

average.

“There will be a lot more dumping at the landfill in the future and as a result, there will be more gas and more energy produced by us,” Lawrence said. “But it will take a while to get to that level. It won’t be

extra work for us. We have three engines and two are running at any one time. We have the capacity to increase output. The plant will continue to run after the landfill closes. For 15-20 years after it closes, that gas will still be produced.”

The need for people to become organ donors

I glanced at the calendar and the date Feb. 26 stared back at me. It was my brother Danny's birthday. He would have turned 65.

A milestone birthday. At 13 you are a teenager. At 16, a driver. At 18, a voter. At 21, an adult. And at 65 you're a senior citizen.

But there is no Social Security check coming in the mail. His life came to an end too soon.

I'd almost forgotten the significance of the day. Earlier in the week, I chatted with a friend who had donated a kidney to a stranger. I mentioned I had a brother who benefitted from a liver transplant.

But even that conversation wasn't enough to jog my memory. The mind doesn't like being reminded of tragedy. Losing a sibling at age 48 ranks right up there among life's losses.

For months Danny had teetered atop the Mayo Clinic's transplant list waiting for a liver.

For years he suffered from a rare liver disease — primary sclerosing cholangitis. His liver was giving out. Death was near — unless a transplant liver was found.

While there are some excellent living donor programs, my brother's transplant surgeon determined he was not a good candidate to receive portion of a liver from a living donor.

So, I found myself in the perverse situation of hoping someone would die so that my brother would live.

His prospects grew dimmer as he waited.

Each day, 20 Americans die waiting to have an organ transplant. The waiting list for folks seeking

transplants exceeds 100,000.

Not enough people have signed up to be organ donors.

For my brother, his situation was more dire than most. Not only did physicians need to find a good genetic match but also someone who had never had mononucleosis.

Danny had never had mono. Our mother, a registered nurse, drilled in us the importance of good hygiene. We never shared cups, lolli-pops or dishes with friends. And mono, a common infection, never came our way.

But this careful attention to cleanliness became a detriment. If Danny received an organ from someone who had been infected anytime in their life, he could have life-threatening complications.

So, the potential donor pool was small. And all we could do was wait and pray.

I was at an investigative reporting conference in Atlanta when I received the early morning call.

It was my mother and she was crying.

Mom didn't weep easily.

But that day her tears were happy ones.

A donor liver had come through.

A middle-aged woman in Rochester, Minnesota, had died of a brain aneurysm. Sometime earlier, she'd signed an organ donor card.

That small act saved my brother's life.

On Father's Day 2004, he began his path to recovery. With the gift of a new liver his yellowing skin returned to a healthy peach color. His weakened body regained energy.

But this isn't an "and they lived happily ever after" story. I wish it were. Cancer began to grow in his transplanted liver and by December 2005, he was

dead.

My brother, a man who lived 48 years without tasting alcohol, died of liver failure. It's not fair. It's not right. It just is.

At age 57, I still see my big brother's influence. He's the reason I studied at Iowa State, why I love John Prine music and why I shoot free throws in the same stiff awkward manner he taught me.

I see his legacy in his adult son and daughter. Still, I wonder what might have been.

I can't help but ask was it worth it? He only lived a year and one half after his transplant. Well, when you don't know if your next breath will be your last, 18 more months is a blessing.

It gave Danny time to reconcile wounded relationships, love and look eternity squarely in its face.

Some woman, whose name we will never know, gave him a year and a half that he never would have had.

My brother was not a man prone to much introspection. He was a farmer. Most things were black and white: crop yields, commodity prices, hog weights.

Idle intellectual reflection was not something for which he was known. But when it came to the unknown woman who gave a part of herself to him, he became quiet and contemplative.

"I wonder what she was like. Did she have kids?" he said shortly before he died.

I wonder if her family misses her as much as I miss him.

We do know this much about the woman: She cared enough to give.

RTHS Boys Basketball

Hub season concludes

No. 5 Rochelle falls against No. 1 Metamora at IHSA 3A Peoria Sectional

PEORIA — A tremendous season came to a close for the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team during the IHSA 3A Peoria Sectional Semifinals at the Bradley University Renaissance Coliseum on Tuesday night.

Facing No. 1 seed Metamora for a chance to compete for a sectional title, Rochelle fell behind early and struggled against the athletic Redbirds, who smothered the Hubs with their man-to-man defense and frequently beat Rochelle defenders off the dribble. Behind four double-digit scorers including 6-foot-6 forward Ethan Kizer, who led the Redbirds with 15 points, Metamora cruised over Rochelle 70-42.

“We had one of our most amazing turnarounds ever this season,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “We set goals before the season and we saw a lot of potential in our kids, but when we were 5-8 after the Christmas tournament, we took all of those goals off the table and we asked our kids what kind of team we wanted to be. We started sharing the ball more and we started playing as a team after the new year. Our kids never looked back and they truly bought in to what we asked from them.

They truly became a family this year.”

Junior forward Raul Aguirre fueled the Rochelle offense in the first quarter, using his 6-foot-5 frame to back down for two low-post baskets and a free throw for the team’s first five points of the evening. But the Hubs (22-11, 11-3 Interstate 8) had issues with Metamora’s physical and athletic man-to-man defense, with the Redbirds forcing several turnovers and awkward misses around the basket. Metamora (27-6, 13-1 Mid-Illini) led 16-9 after the first quarter before ballooning their lead to double figures in the second quarter.

“We knew their defense could be a problem for us,” Thompson said. “We can’t mimic their defense. It’s an old-school, man-to-man defense where they don’t switch anything and they fight through every screen. We couldn’t get any dribble penetration and we had trouble with our hand-off action. Once they had the lead, they were able to stretch us out and on a big court, it made things tough for our kids to move their feet.”

Metamora showcased its balance on offense in the second quarter, with guards Drew Tucker and Zack Schroeder consistently winning one-on-one defensive matchups, allowing the

Redbirds to knock down wide open 3-pointers from the corners or finish athletic takes to the basket. Junior David Gerber and senior Noah Brown each hit triples for Rochelle’s lone two field goals in the second quarter, where Metamora took a 31-15 lead at halftime before blowing the game open during the second half to

seal the semifinal victory.

“We weren’t able to get into transition and they really focused on keeping Noah and Ryan [Simmons] off the 3-point line,” Thompson said. “When we scored the first bucket, I thought we had something because we could throw the ball inside. But their ability to spread the floor and force us to play

one-on-one defense... We weren’t good enough in our man-to-man and they had solid action off their dribble penetration. They made wide open looks and it was a very physical game. We couldn’t change our style of play in two days.”

Kizer swished two 3-pointers and finished an emphatic alley-oop in

the fourth quarter for the Redbirds, who led 53-26 after the third quarter. Tyson Swanson totaled 14 points for the Metamora offense, while Schroeder scored 13 points and Tucker added 11 points. Senior Adam Kemp led the Hubs with 12 points and three triples made in the game, with Aguirre scoring nine points.

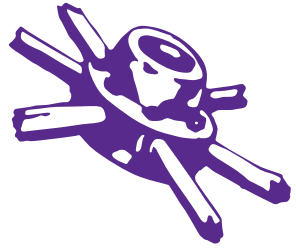
