From the Heart group presents checks

ROCHELLE — At Tuesday's meeting of the Rochelle Rotary Club, From the Heart President and Founder Dave Eckhardt and Rotary President Sarah Flanagan presented four \$8,500 checks to local nonprofits from the recent From the Heart Gala.

Representatives from HOPE of Ogle County, Shining Star Children's Advocacy Center, CASA and Focus House all received checks Tuesday. The From the Heart Gala raised a record of just over \$68,000 in its 14th year.

That money is split evenly between eight nonprofits.

"I don't care how long I've done this for," Eckhardt said. "This is the best part of the whole event right now."

Executive Director for Foundation for Focus House Jeni Hardin said From the Heart is one of her foundation's biggest contributors.

"On behalf of all of us from Focus House and the foundation, thank you so much," Hardin said. "We really can't do what we do without you guys. For Rotary and everyone that donated and came to the event and supports Focus

House, we appreciate you."

CASA Executive Director Trisha Tayon said she was extremely appreciative of the donation, especially in a year where CASA had to cancel fundraisers. Her organization recruits volunteers that serve abused and neglected children in the court system in Ogle County.

"Last year we served the most children we ever have," Tayon said. "Our caseload has grown quite a bit and this will help with our training program and allow us to support more volunteers."

Library vote June 28

Referendum for Creston-Dement residents

CRESTON — A referendum will be on the June 28 election day ballot for residents in the Creston-Dement Library District to decide whether or not it gets a new library.

At a public meeting on Tuesday, a presentation was made on the years-long process of bringing a new library to Creston and the plans for a new building. Library Board President Doug Kroupa said the district has outgrown its current location at 107 S. Main St. and a new library would be built at the corner of Main and Cederholm Streets on land that was donated 10-12 years ago for a new library.

The total cost of the project is \$2.6 million. At least \$400,000 of that will be covered by grant dollars. The bond amount the district will ask for is \$2.2 million.

In 1992, the Creston-Dement Public Library District became a taxing

body. It covers more than Creston, expanding into the surrounding area to the edge of Lee County and towards Hillcrest. About 950-1,000 people live in the library area, Kroupa said.

With a 3.75 percent interest rate, which is the lowest and where the market is now, the property tax increase on a homeowner with a \$100,000 home would be \$72 on an annual basis. At 4.75 percent, the worst scenario for an interest rate, it's a \$79 year property tax increase for a

\$100,000 home.

"There's a lot of decisions we make that affect people's pocketbooks as we go along," Kroupa said. "We are very keenly aware of that and the reason we took the steps that we did is to make sure the way we spend our money is the most financially-responsible way to do it. We've studied this thing and have made it something the town needs and something that will grow as the town grows."

COVID plunging in Ogle County

OREGON — The COVID-19 positivity rate in Ogle County has plunged, the County Board learned at its March 15 meeting.

Kyle Auman, Ogle County Health Department administrator, told the board that the positivity rate in the county was 2.14 percent, which he said was the "lowest we've seen in quite some time."

The last time Auman reported to the board on COVID-19 in the county was in January, when the positivity rate was 22.58 percent.

Auman said the number of cases continues to taper off, with the county health department seeing about five cases per day.

He told the board the CDC has changed the data it uses to measure COVID, and that Ogle County is now considered to be at a low level.

Auman said throughout the pandemic, the health department addressed 13,897 cases of COVID. A total of 60.18 percent of the county's population is vaccinated and there was a total of 128 deaths from COVID to date.

Overall, 64.03 percent of the population in Illinois is vaccinated.

"Hopefully we'll keep these levels where they're at and we'll continue to taper off and we'll be able to get back to more routine business at the health department," Auman said.

That includes a recently completed assessment of health services in the county. Auman said the top areas the county identified to address are mental health, chronic disease and access to care. "We're looking forward to addressing those over the next couple of years and partnering with local organizations to address those issues," he said.

Yard waste recycling and brush pickup underway

ROCHELLE — Northern Illinois Disposal resumed weekly yard waste recycling with pick-ups beginning March 14. Yard waste is collected on your regular garbage day.

All yard waste such as grass, leaves, flowers, plants and sticks are recyclable through the yard waste recycling program every week, beginning March 14 and continuing through Dec. 15. All stick bundles must be tied together with string and cut in lengths of five feet or less with individual limbs not to exceed four inches in diameter. Larger limbs should be placed at the curb for brush pickup. Yard waste may be placed in kraft paper bags or a standard garbage contain-

er with handles, although not a recycling container, at a maximum size of 32 gallons and weighing less than 50 pounds. Plastic bags are not permitted for yard waste recycling. Place your yard waste at the curb by 5 a.m. on the morning of pickup.

Rochelle Street Department will resume brush collection on the third Monday of the month beginning March 21 and continuing through December. Brush should be placed in the parkway by 6 a.m. for pickup.

The city's brush collection program is for the removal of brush and tree limbs too large for weekly yard waste recycling. Brush and tree limbs set out for

collection shall be placed in the parkway, parallel with the curb, not exceeding eight feet in length. Limbs larger than 6-8 inches in diameter should be in a separate pile cut for crews to safely handle. Do not place brush in the street or over sidewalks. Brush and tree limbs removed by a contractor must be properly disposed of by that contractor. The city will not accept brush or tree limbs set out by contractors. Brush may be loaded with a tractor or chipped. Wood chips are available at the street department yard free of charge to all Rochelle residents. Please contact the street division at 815-562-2494 with questions or if you would like wood chips.

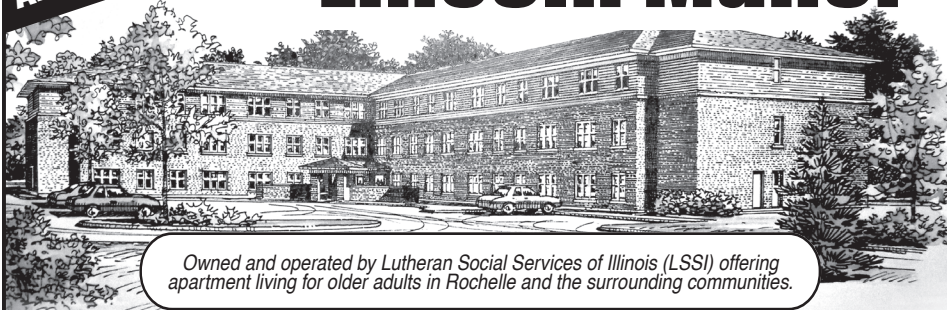

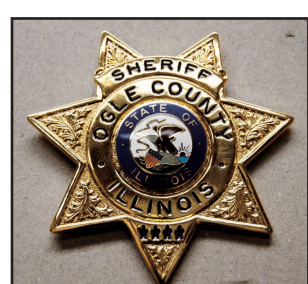

“It’s not a Taj Mahal in any way, shape or form. It’s a rough, basic, functional, long-term investment for the town.”

If the referendum passes in June, construction would likely start in 2023. The library board has worked with an architect and has plans made up. The 7,200 square-foot library would be a high-durability building with a children’s area, adult area, study rooms, facility for meetings, a staff area, bathrooms that could be used as storm shelters, storage space, a patio, handicap parking and a 30-spot parking lot.

“There will be a lot of opportunities for learning and activity to make the town grow,” Kroupa

said. “If we ever needed an expansion of it, that’s planned in.”

In 1986, a group of volunteers in Creston started the library with book trucks and the library didn’t have a permanent location before it began renting its current location from Headon’s Fine Meats. The library grew and expanded into the space next door as well.

Kroupa said that until 2009, the library had 60-90 patrons come in monthly and operated 15-20 hours a week.

In 2010, changes were made and the library is now open over 40 hours a week and has seen 500 patrons a month at different times. Computers and resources have been added such as 3-D printing and model

rocketry.

“We’re packed to the gills,” Kroupa said. “A larger facility is needed for the patrons. Those strategic business plans we made for a library focused on the needs of the community so we could grow with the community and have a facility in town that met the needs of the school, seniors, young people without a place to go and anyone who needs additional information. It’s been a very active community. This is a very crowded environment we’re in now.”

Hurdles in Kroupa’s 12 years as board president working on the project included surveys and getting the land cleared for the project. Fundraising activities were done and

Punishing the spouses of politicians

I always feel bad for the spouses. When politicians get charged with a crime, the political powers that be go after their mates too. Early this month, Gov. JB Pritzker booted Shirley Madigan from her position as chair of the Illinois Arts Council. It's a position that she served well and ably in for 37 years. When she took that job, Ronald Reagan was president, J.B. Pritzker was in high school and House Speaker Chris Welch was in the third grade. In the decades I covered state government, I've never heard a bad word about her. Ever. She has done remarkable work on behalf of the people of Illinois bringing art programs throughout the Land of Lincoln. For example, last month my oldest daughter competed in a poetry recital sponsored by the Arts Council. And she has developed partnerships with public television to educate viewers about Illinois artists. The job is voluntary. She has never received a dime for her work but has contributed mightily. But this month Pritzker said he wants to take the council in a new direction and fired her. No one believes the governor. He gave her the boot because her husband former Speaker Mike Madigan is in trouble and Pritzker wants to distance himself. So, a few hours before Mike Madigan was indicted on corruption charges, Pritzker picked up the phone and called him to let him know his wife was fired. Oh, they dressed it up a bit and let her submit her resignation. But you get the idea. The implications of the conversation were clear: a powerful man was talking to a once powerful man and letting him know his wife's fate. She wasn't a part of the conversation. She was treated as an appendage, not someone contributing in her own right, not even worthy of being spoken to directly when being let go. It smacks of sexism. Now, I'll be the first to say that the governor has every right to put whoever he wants into that job. And no one owns a job forever. But one has to ask if this is a gracious way to cut someone loose. Her only transgression would appear to be that she is married to the wrong fellow. No doubt, some will say she almost certainly wouldn't have received the position if it wasn't for her husband. I won't argue that. But I'll also point out that anyone who gets elected to high office in Illinois or serves in a prestigious post like heading the Arts Council is there because they have the backing of powerful, influential people. A few years ago, I heard similar sentiments expressed against Illinois Chief Justice Anne Burke. “Illinois voters should be appalled that Justice Burke has been named chief justice in the wake of her husband being under federal investigation. It's scandalous that we would have a couple like that, the wife of an indicted alderman sitting as the Chief Justice of our Supreme Court. In Illinois, you just can't make it up,” former state Rep. Jeanne Ives told the DuPage Policy Journal. Anne's husband, Ed Burke is Chicago's longest-serving alderman. He faces 14 federal corruption charges. And let me emphasize this: Both Burke and Madigan are merely accused of breaking the law. They have not stood trial or been convicted of a crime. In the United States of America, a person is innocent until proven guilty. Regular readers of this column know my strong libertarian sentiments. I'm skeptical of government. I'm not a fan of either Mike Madigan or Ed Burke's political philosophies. That's OK. In a democracy, we want diverse points of view in the public forum. While I admire the work and intellect of Anne Burke and Shirley Madigan, I haven't always agreed with their positions, either. But this isn't a defense or an endorsement of either person's policy positions. It's merely an observation that in the American legal system relatives of those accused of crimes are not punished simply for their kinship. And the American sense of fair play would seem to command that should be the case for public life as well. Even after her husband, former Gov. George Ryan, went to prison, his wife Lura Lynn continued to serve on the Abraham Lincoln Bicentennial Commission. She was instrumental in helping make the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum a reality. President Barack Obama sought her out when he spoke in Springfield to honor our sixteenth president. That was a kindness that spoke well of the man. He gained nothing by talking to the wife of a convicted politician. But that didn't stop him from according her the dignity and respect she deserved. It sets an example of graciousness worthy of emulation.

Mississippi man sentenced after local sexual assault

OREGON — Ogle County State's Attorney Mike Rock announced in press release that on March 15, Rocky Lara, 25, of Mississippi, was sentenced to six years in the Illinois Department of Corrections after a sentencing hearing held by the Honorable Judge John C. Redington for predatory criminal sexual assault of a child. In 2015, the Rochelle

Police Department investigated a sexual assault complaint made by a female minor against a male. During the investigation, Lara was developed as a suspect. The case was reviewed by the Ogle County State's Attorney's Office and charges were authorized. The defendant plead guilty on Jan. 12, 2022 and the matter was continued for sentencing.

Predatory criminal sexual assault of a child is a Class X felony with a sentencing range of 6-60 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections followed by three years to natural life of mandatory supervised release. The sentence is served at 85 percent. The defendant will have to register as a sex offender for natural life.

AGRICULTURE WEEK

The challenges climate change poses to agriculture

CLIMATE change poses an array of challenges. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration notes that the impacts of climate change on various sectors of society are inter-related, a connection that mirrors the ripple effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. The human health crisis that arose during the pandemic affected all aspects of life, as illnesses limited worker productivity, thus affecting the global supply chain, including the availability of food.

Scientists warn that a similar scenario could play out as a result of climate change. The agricultural sector could face considerable challenges in the years to come. The Fourth National Climate Assessment is a government-mandated report that must be delivered to the United States Congress once every four years. - **Flooding:** The Union of Concerned Scientists notes that many agricultural regions of the United States have already experienced increased flooding. The effects of flooding on the agricultural sector are often devastating and include accelerated soil erosion, water pollution and damage to infrastructure that challenges farmers' ability to get food from their farms to stores and, ultimately, consumers' dinner tables.
- **Drought:** The National Integrated Drought Information System reports that the primary direct economic impact of drought in the agricul-



tural sector is crop failure and pasture losses. The Government of Canada notes that areas of western Canada are already experiencing frequent and severe droughts, and scientists expect other areas of the country to be affected by drought more often in the years to come. The same

goes for the United States, which the UCS notes has already dealt with severe drought in California, the Great Plains and the midwest. Depleted water supplies are a byproduct of drought, and such depletion can take a toll on crops and livestock.

- **Economics:** The ef-

fects of climate change on crops and livestock may force farmers to change the nature of their farms. The UCS notes that farmers may be forced to choose crop varieties and animal breeds that are suited to the new conditions sparked by climate change. Going in a new direction could force

farmers to make potentially costly investments in machinery and other changes as they make the transition.

Climate change will pose unique challenges to the agricultural sector that could force farmers to make some difficult decisions in the years ahead.

Explaining precision agriculture

FEW, if any, aspects of life in the 21st century have not been touched by technology. Advancements in technology have affected everything from the way students learn in the classroom to how senior citizens connect with their grandchildren. How farmers and growers can adapt to meet emerging demands

THE world is ever-changing, and those changes include consumer preferences. Identifying what consumers want is a challenge for any business, and farmers and growers are no exception. New season kicks off

Ward nets 14 saves as Lady Hubs begin spring with 7-0 loss against Harlem

MACHESNEY PARK — The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity soccer team kicked off the 2022 season with a nonconference road matchup against the Harlem Huskies on Thursday. The Lady Hubs hung tough early in the first half, but the Huskies proved too strong in the end, capitalizing on the quick turf field and their back-wind advantage to score a 7-0 victory over Rochelle.

Sophomore Danica Ward battled in net for the Lady Hubs (0-1), totaling four of her 14 saves over the first 15 minutes of regulation to keep the match scoreless. Harlem broke the match open with a flurry of goals midway through the first half, however, scoring in the 15th, 16th and 19th minutes to take a 3-0 lead. Goals in the 26th and 40th minutes put the Huskies up 5-0.

“It wasn’t the score we wanted, but I thought we battled in the first half and we had some injuries

that hurt our momentum there,” head coach Brad Male said. “I think Danica has come a long way and she’s shown great leadership on our team. I’m looking for her to keep our girls organized in the back and keep them on the ball so we can minimize our shots on goal. I thought she had some tremendous saves during the match and I thought she never gave up.”

Rochelle started the second half strong on defense, holding the Huskies without a goal for nearly 25 minutes until Harlem found the net in the 64th and 66th minutes. The Huskies outshot the Lady Hubs 32-7 and 21-3 in shots on goal. Sophomore Kara Martinez led Rochelle with two shots on goal in the second half, while freshman Makayla Lara added one on goal.

“We’re always talking with our girls about how we have to look for the quick passes,” Male said. “We can’t be dribbling the ball around for too long and I thought we started

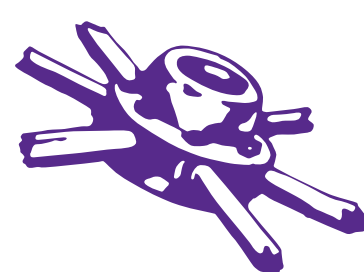

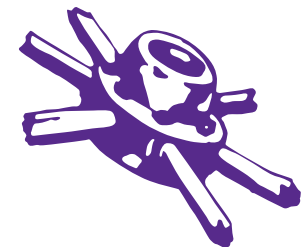

As if he isn’t busy enough, Hanks is currently producing the war mini-series “Masters of the Air” (related to “Band of Brothers” and “The Pacific”), with **Steven Spielberg** and his **Amblin Entertainment** for Apple+.

Also working on a TV anthology series for Apple+ is **Meryl Streep**, who is starring in “Extrapolations,” along with **Tobey Maguire**, **Marion Cotillard**, **Forest Whitaker**, **Sienna Miller**, **Kit Harrington**, **Matthew Rhys**, **Daveed Diggs** and **David Schwimmer**.

Last week we told you about **Melissa Joan Hart’s** two-year contract with Lifetime to produce, direct and star in made-for-Lifetime films, following her success in Hallmark’s “Mistletoe in Montana.” Hallmark has a stable of stars they use for most of their original productions. 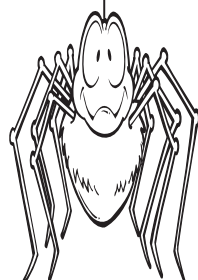

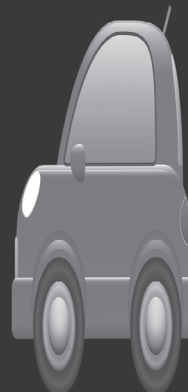
