Building purchased Hicks BBQ secures new location

ROCHELLE — Hicks BBQ, a local food concession and catering business, recently announced it has purchased the building at 315 Cherry Ave. and the lot west of it.

No, the building will not be a restaurant. It will be a centralized location for the owners, Jeremy and Erica Hicks, to continue and grow their catering and food truck business. Some carry out and events may be in the cards in the future for Hicks BBQ at the location.

"The new building will help considerably," Jeremy said. "We have stuff stored in four different places right now. We do a lot of catering. This will centralize us. We do more catering than anything. But we don't want a restaurant. People ask us that a lot."

Hicks said he and his wife have been looking to get into a building for a couple of years. They considered building something in Hillcrest, but wanted to be in the downtown area. The couple have

been using the kitchen at Headon's Fine Meats in Creston for their catering and wanted to have something in the middle.

Hicks BBQ is planning an overhaul of the building including paving the lot for a place to park its two food trucks. The inside of the building will be gutted, cleaned and repainted. A new roof will be added and windows and doors will be replaced.

"We're going to revamp the whole place," Jeremy

said. "It won't look anything like it does now. We want to be local and downtown. People have to find our trailers wherever they are now. I'd like to have it open by the beginning of summer. We'll do it as soon as we can."

Jeremy said the building purchase came from a desire to reinvest in his home area and have a place where customers can find Hicks BBQ easily.

Downtown grant application submitted

CRESTON — At its Tuesday meeting, the Creston Village Board heard an update on its grant application for an overhaul of its downtown area.

Creston applied for a Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown grant for \$780,000, \$195,000 of which would be matched locally by the village. It would include reconstruction of its downtown including new water mains and storm sewer, reconstruction of the street,

all new sidewalks, curb and gutter, parking and more.

Village President Tom Byro said Village Engineer Kevin Bunge was unable to attend the meeting, but did update the board and said the application was submitted and he's waiting to hear the result. At previous meetings, Bunge has said the grant application process will take a year and if selected, Creston wouldn't start construction or have to pay any costs until the latter part of 2023.

"We haven't heard anything yet," Byro said.

Backyard hockey rink enters fifth year Williams: 'It's fun to share it with my kids'

ROCHELLE — David Williams grew up skating on Spring Lake in the winters.

He still enjoys skating and hockey. He now has six children, two of which play the sport. Williams always wanted to have a hockey rink of his own. Five years ago, after joining a group for backyard ice rinks on social media, he took the plunge and made one of his own at his home on Raindance Drive outside of town. He's done it every year since.

"It progresses every year," Williams said. "It's kind of like an addiction. You want to do something bigger and better. It started out as a 40-by-80 rink and now it's 90-by-50. The amount of hours, it's hard to keep track because I stagger it out. Total hours for a setup by myself would probably be around 30. Some things I need help with. If I have help, I could probably do it in eight hours with two or three guys."

Williams makes the rink out of treated plywood sheets and puts in brackets to hold them up. He drives steel rods through those brackets three feet into the ground. After that, he gets a liner and has tankers of water delivered to fill it.

Work on the rink starts around Thanksgiving weekend and the water comes around mid-De-

cember. He watches the weather for when a cold front is coming in so the water doesn't sit and attract leaves. After freezing, Williams said skating can usually be done through February before he starts tearing down the rink by the middle or end of March.

"I think it's fun to share it with my kids," Williams said. "I think it's just some-

thing that will help them as they become parents. Just knowing to do something for your children, nothing's really impossible. Having a hockey rink in their backyard in the middle of a subdivision, who would ever think that's possible? But you just put in the effort and you can make just about anything work."

Maintenance of the rink can be a lot of work, but Williams said he enjoys it. He combats snow and warmth every winter. He spent three hours snowblowing the rink after the most recent snowstorm before shoveling it and using a pull behind zamboni to level it.

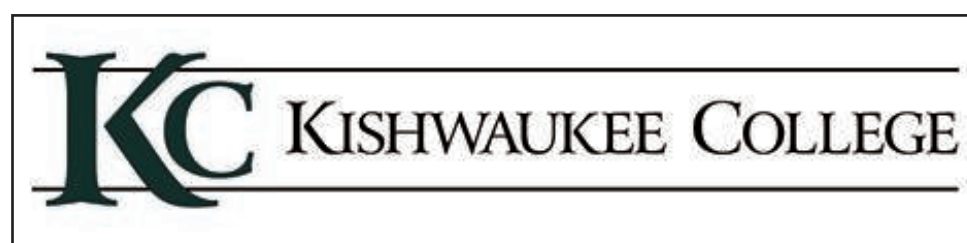

Library using grant to maintain, expand services

Among the efforts, the library:

Hired and trained four temporary, part-time employees to maintain in-person and online services after COVID-19-related budget constraints.

Created extensive instructional guides and videos to help students navigate online resources.

Investigated new technologies and created accessibility guidelines for developing instructional materials.

Purchased more than \$6,000 in books to support new curricular programs and update collections for accredited programs.

Subscribed to new online tools like NoodleTools and PowerNotes to help students cite and manage sources.

Translated key departmental materials for the Spanish-speaking community.

Held the Commonly Grounded event with presenter Jeff Foster from Common Grounds Café in Sycamore to encourage entrepreneurship, community engagement, and the value of education among the community with a focus on disadvantaged populations.

The ALA is the foremost national organization providing resources to inspire library and information professionals to transform their communities through essential programs and services. The Kishwaukee College Library was one of 34 institutions to receive ALA COVID Library Relief Funds.

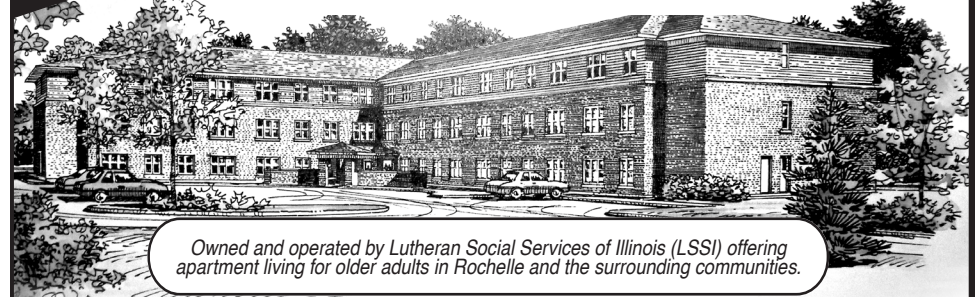

Rochelle has been good to he and Erica, as residents have constantly found them and waited in line wherever they've been set up in the past.

"Rochelle treats us great," Jeremy said. "No matter where we are. They go out of their way to show support."

Jeremy and Erica started in competition barbeque in 2007 or 2008. They started doing it out of their driveway and cooked for family and graduation parties. The hobby kept escalating. The catering aspect grew and they got into food concessions at the Cypress House farmer's markets in 2014.

"We sold out in like no time during the first one

we did and we caught the bug and bought a food truck and didn't look back," Jeremy said.

In 2019, Jeremy worked the Hicks BBQ business full-time. The couple had a big year planned after that. And then the COVID-19 pandemic happened and Jeremy went back to his construction job. Erica runs the business primarily now and left her own job to take it on.

Hicks BBQ offers full-service catering and has done large events in the past. For that and both food trucks, Jeremy said the business has stuck to barbeque, but the menu has grown. All cuts of barbeque and "pretty much anything cooked on a fire" are offered. The couple has even done some steak

frys and crawfish boils recently.

"We don't reheat anything," Hicks said. "It's fresh. Our rubs, sauces and sides are ours. Nothing is store bought. We stay up all night cooking. It's truly a labor of love. It's really rewarding when people come out to support us and book us."

Jeremy said his love of cooking and the growth of Hicks BBQ have changed his outlook on his career.

"I really do enjoy it," Jeremy said. "It's the hardest work I've ever done, times two. All I ever wanted to do when I was a kid was run heavy equipment like my dad. It was all I ever did. And then cooking came along. I was afraid I wouldn't enjoy it if I was doing it for a living."

An update on several city projects

I hope everyone in the community had a safe and wonderful holiday season. With 2022 well underway, I thought I would update everyone on several city projects.

The city has been working on implementation of a new EAM (Enterprise Asset Management) and ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) software systems. The new systems will allow for enhanced inventory controls, a new GIS system, facilities management, greater inspection controls, a new budget, human resources and accounts payable and receivable system and great flexibility to track and manage service calls, work orders and capital improvement projects.

I'm most excited for the new utility billing software that will allow our customers to track in real time their water and electric usage. The city has been working on this system for the past two years and full implementation is expected by July 2022. These types of systems are needed for a complex organization like ours with a budget that exceeds \$85 million, owns, and manages multiple utility functions and utilizes fund accounting (over 30 different funds)

Recently the city issued approximately \$18 million in alternate revenue bonds for upgrades to Rochelle Municipal Utilities' electric distribution system. By taking advantage of the low interest rate environment, we will be able to complete the many needed

updates to support our utility load growth and increase system reliability and avoid future inflationary costs. The overall interest rate is approximately

two percent over 15 years (when the debt will be retired). Because the city retired \$14 million in electric revenue bond debt last year and due to the low rates, funding the debt service will not require a rate increase. The funds are being utilized for system upgrades totaling more than \$22 million. This includes finalizing the Prologis Park substation, construction of a new substation on Center Point Drive, upgrades to our Twombly Road substation, a new 10.1 mile 34.5 KV line to connect the Center Point substation to the Prologis Park and Twombly Road substations and upgrades to consumer service facilities (transformers, distribution lines, etc.).

This work is many years in the making and was needed years ago. Many thanks to former Electric Superintendent Jason Bird and current Superintendent of Electric Operations Blake Toliver for advocating for these projects and overseeing their implementation.

Speaking of critical infrastructure, I would like to thank Adam Lanning, the superintendent of water and water reclamation, along with his team for all their hard work initiating upgrades to water well 8 near Caron Road and working to complete a new well and well house on 2nd Avenue. Both projects are being funded through a com-

bination of reserve dollars and grants and loans through the IL EPA. Well 8 was drilled in the 1960s to provide water for our industrial customers and is need of an iron removal system. Well 4, the city's oldest well, was drilled in 1926. The work being done includes a new building, new pumps and motors, conversion to liquid chlorine and installation of a new water main. The layout is also designed for a future radium removal plant if it's needed.

Finally, I would like to thank Mayor John Bearrows and our entire city council. Without their leadership and forward thinking, these projects would not happen. When they developed the city's strategic plan in 2018, every councilperson emphasized the need to maintain and reinvest in our infrastructure. Along with commercial development and housing, this was a top priority. I am very pleased with how far we have come in the past four years, and I am looking forward to continued growth for our town.

I'm wishing you all a happy and healthy 2022. Let's hope baseball starts on time and the Red Sox win the World Series.

Farm bureau offering training, scholarships

ILLINOIS growers and grower farm operators who transport or apply anhydrous ammonia, or otherwise maintain anhydrous ammonia equipment, are now required by state regulation (8 IAC 215) to complete certified grower training.

Growers and grower farm operators have until April 1 to be initially certified and must participate in refresher training every three years.

The certification includes all individuals employed by or otherwise authorized by a grower to transport or apply anhydrous ammonia, or maintain anhydrous ammonia equipment.

The Ogle County Farm Bureau in cooperation with Carroll Service Company will host an in-person training program on March 9, at the Ogle County Farm Bureau Building in Oregon.

Two sessions will be offered. The first session will begin at 10 a.m. and conclude at noon; the second session will begin at 1 p.m. and end at 3 p.m. Both will be held on March 9.

Each session is limited to the first 30 people who register. Registration is required!

"No news is good news. I guess they haven't told us no. That's the way I look at it."

Quiet zones

After the board discussed its desire to get its railroad crossings considered "quiet zones" to alleviate train horn use in the village at its last meeting, Byro said Tuesday that Bunge has also been tasked with formulating a cost estimate for the project.

"As soon as he can get some information, he's going to get back to us," Byro said.

Train horns are one of the ongoing complaints the village receives from residents and recent sidewalk work improved crossings and made quiet zones more feasible.

Localities desiring to establish a quiet zone are first required to mitigate the increased risk caused by the absence of a horn. Raised medians are often placed between lanes in front of both sides of

the tracks to prevent the possibility a vehicle could attempt to go between lowered gates.

The village would have to make all three of its railroad crossings quiet zones. They include Woodlawn Road, Main Street and Transit Street. Transit Street would likely have to be made a one way due to it being narrow. The other two crossings would have center medians installed.

Water meter update

After receiving new water meter equipment in recent months, Village Clerk Jennifer Payton said a water meter reader has been hired and the village is doing interviews to hire a second.

Due to not having equipment and an employee to read meters, Creston has been charging estimated water rates recently and asked residents to read meters themselves.

"I am going to get a hold of our vendor tomorrow

and find out when they can come and do the training," Payton said. "Things are rolling. We're going to get it up and running and I'm hoping the next set of billings will not be estimated and that will be fantastic."

Water mains

The board discussed the idea of replacing water mains in the future. Cres-

ton was recently awarded \$89,000 in American Rescue Plan Act funds that it has three years to spend. Water mains are an eligible expense for that money.

The board discussed giving Bunge a list of water mains it wants to replace and having him create a cost estimate. The project would have to

be sent out for bids after that. Village Trustee Curt Ward said it's likely in the future that the EPA will mandate improvements to the village's water mains.

"We need to identify the ones to replace so we know exactly what we're talking about," Byro said. "I'll tell him we need to get started on that. It could be 4-5 weeks, then get a bid. It

could be next year before we get it done, but we need to get the process going."

Hourly rates

Following meeting in executive session, the Creston village board of trustees unanimously approved raising part-time employee hourly rates from \$13 an hour to \$16 an hour.

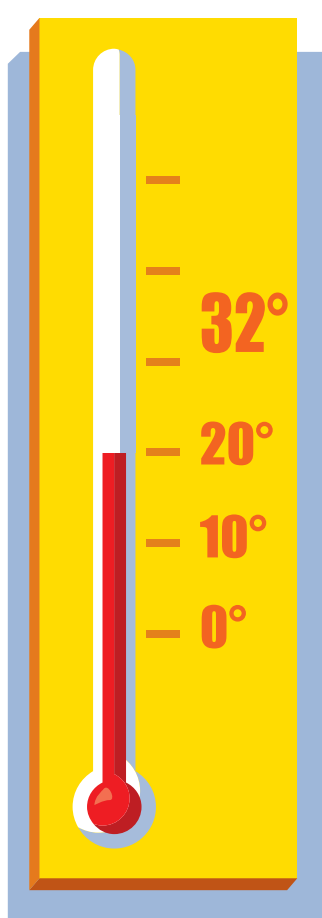

County Christmas tree recycling program wraps up

OREGON — The annual Ogle County Christmas tree collection and chipping program recently wrapped up around the county and final numbers for trees are now in.

A total of around 280 trees were collected and chipped up into useful mulch. That is a total of around 14,000 pounds or roughly seven tons of

trees not headed to the landfill. While the overall number of trees was down this past season, it was good to once again offer curb-side collection in some areas. Since program year 1999, a total of almost 16,300 trees, or roughly 408 tons, have been recycled into mulch and not ended up in the landfills.

Starting on Dec. 26, people dropped off trees at locations in Rochelle, Byron, Oregon, Monroe Center, Polo, Forreston and Leaf River. Rochelle residents placed trees out by the curb and the street department came out and chipped them at the curb.

In certain areas local Future Farmers of America (FFA) volunteers col-

lected trees and brought them to the drop-off point for chipping. This year's collection was held on Saturday, Jan. 8 and was the first organized FFA collection since the winter of 2018-2019 due to weather and pandemic-related problems. FFA volunteers in Byron, Forreston, Polo and Oregon collected trees curb-side

for residents in their respective areas and collected around 100 trees that morning and dropped them off to the chipping sites around the county.

The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) coordinates the program and wishes to thank all of the volunteers, municipalities, street depart-

ments and FFA students and teachers who actually do the work and handle the trees. This program will continue for 2022 and into 2023. Anyone interested in free mulch from the trees, please call the OCSWMD at 815-732-4020 for more information and sites where mulch will be available.

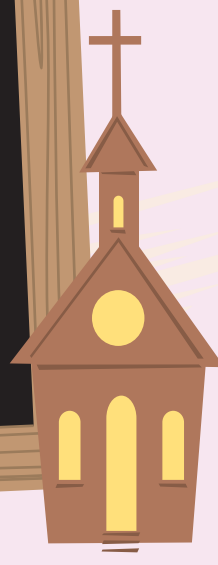

MORRIS — The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity bowling team finished fourth out of six schools in the Interstate 8 Conference meet at Echo Lanes on Monday. Rochelle scored 4,852 over six games, with freshman

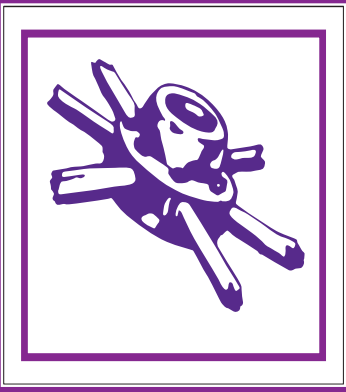

Huskies announce 12 additions to 2022 signing class

Sixteen freshmen and five transfers inked from December Signing Day

DEKALB – Fresh off completing one of the biggest one-year turn-arounds in college football in 2021 with nine wins and the Mid-American Conference Championship, Northern Illinois University football head coach Thomas Hammock and his staff continued to lay the groundwork for even more success with the addition of 12 players to the 2022 signing class on Wednesday.

The Huskies, who signed 16 freshmen and five transfers during the December signing period, (link to release/list), added seven offensive players, a specialist and five defenders to their 2022 class in the February group, which included both preferred walk-ons and scholarship recipients.

“Obviously this is an important class for us to continue the trajectory of our program,” Hammock said. “We’ve been able to stack three strong recruiting classes together, and that is going to help us maintain a competitive edge as we continue to improve as a program. I have to shout out my staff because we would not have been able

to put this class together without all the work they do. They do a tremendous job of going out, building relationships, working, evaluating and recruiting. We are constantly building our board and we recruit year-round.”

The success the Huskies’ staff has had in building relationships paid dividends with the most recent group of signees. After the signing of the initial group of 21 players in December, including eight freshmen defenders and four offensive players, including a trio of wide receivers, the focus for February became on finding those “difference-makers” that were still available.

“We call it ‘level up’ recruiting,” Hammock said. “After the initial signing day in December where we felt we addressed some needs, the focus becomes how can we add difference makers in our program, how can we add those guys that are a level up. We got into some serious battles down the stretch with Power 5 programs but because our relationships were so entrenched, and we had been recruiting these kids for forever, we were able to hold onto them at

the end.”

Just as in December, the February class is diverse in background as well as in positions played. The Huskies added a pair of players from the Carver High School team in Columbus, Georgia that helped lead the team to the 2021 4A state championship game, and two multi-position athletes from St. Pius X High School in Festus, Missouri. Running back Terron Kellman joins NIU from one of the top-ranked programs in the country and defensive tackle Reggie Jean was plucked from Class 2A Foundation Academy in Florida. NIU added four players from Illinois, including DeKalb native and Huskie legacy Dane Pardridge, a wide receiver from Marmion Academy whose father, Curt, was a four-year letterwinner at NIU who played on the 1983 NIU MAC Championship team and was selected in the sixth round of the 1986 NFL Draft.

While the external focus is often on the stars and recruiting battles, for Hammock and his staff, recruiting a strong class of preferred walk-ons is just as important. Last year alone, six players who



entered the program as preferred walk-ons earned scholarships.

“We only recruit walk-ons that we feel have the ability to earn scholarships,” Hammock said. “That’s important because we are selective; we evaluate the walk-ons the same as we do a scholarship kid.

They come in, they are treated the same and given every opportunity to earn a scholarship. The preferred walk-ons have built our program up. We’ve been able to increase the depth and the talent in our program with walk-ons, they are extremely valuable to us.”

Hubs stay hot with win over Stillman Valley

Dominant second quarter propels Rochelle to 79-45 victory against Cardinals

ROCHELLE — A dominant second quarter allowed the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team to score another decisive victory on Wednesday, when the Hubs hosted a nonconference matchup against Stillman Valley.

With the Cardinals missing one of their best players, Rochelle took the early lead before outpacing Stillman Valley 29-10 in the second quarter to more than double the Cardinal offensive total in the first half. Rochelle

converted 15 field goals including six 3-pointers in the first half, cruising to a 79-45 victory on Wednesday.

Senior Adam Kemp led the Hubs with 14 points and four triples made, while senior Noah Brown added 13 points and three triples of his own. All but two players entered the scorebook for Rochelle in the victory.

“We knew they were missing their best player, but I didn’t think we were very locked in during the first quarter,” senior Cooper Hasz said. “They showed up early and we knew we had to stay on top

of our game. When the second quarter came around, we did exactly that. We’re on a great run right now.”

Kemp fueled the Rochelle offense during the first half, sinking three 3-pointers in the second quarter while Hasz battled down low, scoring on three layups under the basket in the first half. The 6-foot-5 forward Hasz, who came off the bench earlier this season but has since become a starter, has seen his role increase significantly since his junior season, when he was out of the rotation and primarily playing

mop-up minutes.

“I feel like I put in a lot of work over the offseason,” Hasz said. “My teammates and I have worked really hard since the end of last season... Our defense has improved in every practice and it’s been great to see.”

Rochelle (16-9, 9-2 Interstate 8) led 52-24 entering the third quarter, where senior Tanner Lager and junior David Gerber each canned 3-pointers from the wings to preserve the Hub lead. Gerber, who finished with eight points in the victory, has also earned increased playing time dur-

ing the second half of the season.

“We’re in a groove right now and we’re coming for Ottawa on Friday,” Gerber said. “We’re a whole team and we’re not a one-man show. We all love each other and I think we’re going to keep succeeding. I didn’t play much at the start of the season, but I began working harder during practice and when I had chances, I focused on playing good defense and coach [Tim] Thompson has started trusting me a lot more.”

Brown did most of his

damage in the third quarter, burying two long-range triples and a layup in the third quarter. With the Hubs leading 71-39 entering the fourth quarter, Rochelle looked to feed senior forward Zach Sanford, who banked home three low-post shots for all six of his points on Wednesday.

Lager scored nine points and hit two triples for Rochelle, while Hasz totaled seven points and junior Raul Aguirre added eight points. Senior Ryan Simmons and sophomore Eli Luxton each chipped in six points for the Hubs.
