District awaiting legal process

Harper expresses mask-recommended preference

ROCHELLE — At Tuesday's Rochelle Elementary School District Board of Education meeting, Superintendent Jason Harper said he was currently unable to offer a recommendation on COVID-19 mandates due to the ongoing legal process regarding them.

All Rochelle schools are currently temporarily under a mask recommended policy for students and staff and ceased student/staff exclusions for quarantine as "close contacts" and staff vaccination/testing requirements. All of those measures were previously mandated by executive orders of Gov. JB Pritzker.

On Feb. 4, a judge in Sangamon County issued temporary restraining orders related to the Governor's COVID-19 executive orders and emergency rules issued by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) regarding COVID-19 mitigation strategies for students and staff in school.

Harper said in a Feb. 6 letter to parents that the

districts' legal representatives interpret the judge's current ruling to invalidate the governor's executive orders and IDPH's and ISBE's rules, rendering the mandates unenforceable against every school district in the state.

A possible stay to preserve the COVID-19 mandates had not come as of Wednesday, but the state did start an appeals process of the judge's ruling.

"I've said at previous meetings that my recommendation to the board

is that we adhere to state mandates," Harper said. "We've been advised that they have the force of law behind them. That was my recommendation, to do that until those executive orders were terminated, modified or overruled in the courts. That is essentially what's happened."

Harper said that until he knows what the legal outcome will be at the state level, he can't offer a recommendation. He did say that mask recommended is his preference, if pos-

sible. Before the governor mandated masks just before the start of the school year, Rochelle schools planned a mask optional approach.

"Right now based on the hypothetical, I think I can comment that when we've had the support of legal counsel which is what I come to you all making recommendations on, I would recommend if we're able to do so, to go to a mask recommended approach," Harper said.

Rochelle PD navigating retirements

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Police Department Chief Eric Higby said Monday that the city is currently working to replace four retirees this year, one of which has already occurred.

Deputy Chief Jeff Leininger retired last month and was replaced by the promotion of Terry Inman. Higby said three more retirements are planned for the rest of the year and RPD recently finished taking applicants for patrol officers at the end of January.

The next steps for hiring include written tests, oral interviews and psych, poly, background and medical evaluations before applicants would go to the police academy in late April if hired and if they haven't already been to it.

Free Canes for Veterans honors Cote

Gift outfitted with service memorabilia of Rochelle WWII vet

ROCHELLE — Bert Cote was using his new cane so much this week that he misplaced his walker.

The 100-year-old World War II veteran received the cane on Tuesday from Free Canes for Veterans, a Florida organization that creates canes free of charge for veterans that are dependent on them. Free Canes for Veterans has sent creations all over the United States.

"My dad was so excited," Cote's daughter, Jeanine Harms, said. "I went over to help him find his walker. He was so excited to get that cane that he forgot all about his walker. He'll get some use out of it."

Cote's cane is adorned with memorabilia from his own service along with his brothers'. He served in the U.S. Army 2nd Armored Division known as "Hell on Wheels" from 1941-1945.

Cote served in Germa-

ny under General Patton and was part of a mortar squad. His nine brothers also served in various other branches of the service.

After the war, Cote stayed behind to help get people back into their homes because he spoke French due to his French-Canadian upbringing.

"The lieutenant came to my barracks and told me to put my stuff on and follow him," Cote said. "We went all over Germany getting displaced persons and shipping them back to where they were. It was quite a job. I stayed over there a few extra months. I liked it."

The story of how the cane came to be started during the holidays. Harms got three Christmas trees for a display at SideTrack Bar in Ashton from St. Patrick Church. A woman from Arizona came in and said to send the trees to Free Canes for Veterans, which makes canes out of them.

"We donated three trees and one came back as that

cane," Harms said. "It was awesome. My dad almost started crying."

Military history is a large part of the Cote family. Harms talked about how her mother worked at the steam engine factory

in town that made trains for the war during WWII. A lot of her sisters did as well while their husbands were at war.

Harms wanted to remind the public that during Christmas 2022, old

Christmas trees can be sent to make more canes for veterans.

"I knew it was coming and that my daughter sent for it," Cote said. "We didn't expect it to be so pretty."

City completes shop local program with \$3 million local investment

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle has tallied the results of its Shop Local incentive program, set into motion as the COVID-19 pandemic took a toll on local businesses. The program resulted in nearly \$3 million invested in local businesses, a press release said.

“We knew we had to do something,” City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said. “So, we took this outside-the-box idea to our city council and they immediately jumped on board.”

Thanks to its locally-owned electric and water utility, the city was able to offer residents a \$60 bill credit for every \$300 spent at local businesses that had been affected by the shutdown orders. At first, the program was limited to just three per household, but then the city council expanded the program to allow an unlimited number of credits, maximizing the program’s benefits.

The program applied to restaurants, retail shops and hair salons in the utility’s service area, which includes Creston and



Hillcrest. Local industries even participated by purchasing lunches for their employees from the small businesses that were part of the program.

“The RMU Shop Local Program has been a wonderful incentive for our local community and retail businesses. A win-win for everyone,” Naomi Baldwin, owner of Colonial Flowers & Gifts in Rochelle, said.

A total of 5,755 applications were submitted resulting in \$538,500 in utility bill credits issued to accounts and \$2,981,109 invested in small businesses.

“I am just so proud of the way our community came together to support each other through a difficult time,” Councilwoman

Rosie Arteaga said. “Keep shopping local!”

Not only did the city re-invest in local businesses through the program, it also purchased tents and outdoor heaters; offered street closures and changed local ordinances to expand outdoor seating; expanded the utility assistance program for families in need; delayed utility shut-offs and eliminated late fees; hosted an employment fair and offered support in any way possible to local residents and businesses. The city also offered three rounds of the Restart Rochelle Grants totaling \$278,500 from the local CURES grant award. These funds covered operating costs that businesses incurred while closed.

GoFundMe established after Gurler Road home fire

Couple loses pets, vehicles to blaze

ROCHELLE — A GoFundMe fundraiser has been established for a couple that lost their home to a Tuesday morning fire at 2965 E. Gurler Road.

Rochelle Fire and all Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District departments were called to the address at 6:51 a.m. Tuesday morning for a fully-involved structure fire at the couple's home. The structure was a trailer home with a structure around it.

Rochelle Fire Lt. Jason Underwood said the building and the vehicles inside it were a total loss. He estimated \$50,000 worth of damage, not counting the cars.

The residents, Kyle Copeland, 23, and Faith Ross,

21, were transported to the hospital after the fire. According to the GoFundMe set up by Susan Gildea Webb, Ross's mother, both are okay and were released from the hospital.

"Faith got burned trying to go back into the house to save her kittens," Webb said on the GoFundMe page. "The fire had already engulfed the house and they lost their beloved cats. They are devastated. I am at a loss for what to do to help them. I am thankful and blessed that they are both alive and relatively unharmed."

Copeland and Ross were unable to gather any of their possessions before evacuating their home. So far, the family has received a few clothes, donations and toiletries.

The couple is staying

with Webb and are working on finding transportation to get them around in the future. Ross lost her welding gear and specialized clothing for work in the fire. All of their possessions will need to be replaced eventually.

"Just imagine you were standing in your front yard watching everything you have worked for your whole life burn," Webb said on the GoFundMe page. "That is what Faith and Kyle are dealing with. Thank the Lord they are alive. Thank you for your support and prayers."

Ogle County recycling event scheduled for Feb. 25

OREGON—The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will be holding a residential electronic recycling event on Friday, Feb. 25 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the County Annex Building at 909 Pines Road in Oregon.

A free permit is required in advance to attend this recycling event. Permits are limited and must be requested by 4 p.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 23. To obtain a permit call the OCSWMD at 815-732-4020 or email the department at solidwaste@oglecounty.org and provide your name address, phone number and email address. Permits are limited to one per household per month and allow up to seven large items to be brought in for recycling. A full list of accepted items and other event information is included with the permit. This event may be curtailed and/or cancelled due to inclement weather or other issues beyond the control of the OCSWMD.

This event is for Ogle County residential electronics. Accepted items include all types of televisions and

computer monitors, computers, keyboards, e-mice, all computer hardware and cables, laptops, tablets, cell phones, video game equipment, printers, FAX machines, copiers, scanners, VCR/ DVD players, cable and satellite boxes, all remote controls (please remove batteries), radios, stereo equipment, home phones, digital clocks, calculators, cameras, holiday light strands, extension cords, computer power back-up units, rechargeable batteries, CFL bulbs and printer ink cartridges. Microwave ovens are accepted for a \$5 fee per unit.

A full list of accepted items and further instructions will be included with issuance of the permit. The times on Thursday, March 3 include 10 a.m., 2 p.m. and 6 p.m.

The school will be an extensive review of the new election equipment and election day procedures. Training is designed to prepare you for carrying out your responsibilities at the polling place. This will include hands-on instructions that focus on election procedures and how the new voting equipment will work.

Illinois state statute requires judges of election to attend training. Election judges work from 5 a.m.

until after the polls close at 7 p.m. on election day. Judges receive a salary of \$100 per election and an extra \$20 if they attend a school. We hope to see you at one of the schools, not only for the extra \$20 for election day, but because the training will enable you to serve as an informed and knowledgeable Judge.

Deputies respond to two-vehicle, head-on collision

SCHOOL: Board awaiting court decision on mask mandates

“That’s where we were at the start of the school year before the mandate, and that’s where we find ourselves today.”

Harper said he did not know when a potential legal stay could be placed on the governor’s mandates or when a potential appellate decision would be made.

Multiple parents thanked the board for making masks optional after the restraining order during the meeting. Some expressed dismay that the school district required masks during the school year as a whole and didn’t defy the governor’s mask mandate.

“If something happens and the governor winds up trying to reinstate this, I would hope this school board, seeing the damage that has been done, would go along with the other districts that are suing the state,” parent Alan Stultz said. “I don’t know why

this school board didn’t get on board with the lawsuit and stand up for the rights of the parents and the students.”

Some parents asked for answers about what course the school district would take if a court decision reinstated the governor’s mask mandate.

“If there is an appeal and a reversal, I ask that you guys still decide to do the right thing and keep a mask optional policy here, which is what you should have done to begin with,” parent Cole Thomas said.

During the rest of his COVID-19 related update, Harper said that cases are down in the district right now after a mid-January high and that a testing site is still being offered for symptomatic students and staff and the district has enough tests for the month and is trying to secure more.

Board President Dave Casey was absent from the meeting and Board Mem-

ber Steve Builta filled in for him and led the meeting.

IT services

The board unanimously approved moving forward with a shared district technology services approach between the elementary and high school district. The elementary district has an outsourced agreement for IT services and the director used from that service recently resigned.

Employment

The board unanimously approved the resignation of Whitney Brandt (second grade teacher, Central School, end of 2021-2022), the retirements of Susana Guzman-Holland (end of 2022-2023), Sheri Klin-dera (end of 2023-2024), Theresa Crystal (end of 2024-2025) and Krista Barco-Kida (end of 2024-2025) and the employment of Alyssa Hansen (first grade teacher, Lincoln School, FY2023), Abeer Aljabari (paraprofessional,

Lincoln School) and Ben Harvey (paraprofessional, Central School).

During the public comment portion of the meeting, a parent brought up the issue of handicap accessibility at Central

School with the district’s new attendance centers model.

“Back in December, my wife and I went to the Central School Christmas program,” James Bingham said. “She called ahead and said she would be in her wheelchair and was

told they’d get the ramp out for her. It was a piece of plywood that lays on the stairs. Now that we have attendance centers, I’m wondering if there are plans to make Central School handicap accessible for students if they eventually go there.”

You see, I met my wife, Joan, on a blind date right before Thanksgiving 2001. We decided to go out again, so I found myself agonizing over what we should do on a second date. I knew she liked animals because she was a veterinarian. So, I invited her to go for a walk with me in Springfield's Washington Park with my Labrador retriever, Griz.

He was a nice dog. But we were two single males who had lived together for eight years. He wasn't too keen on sharing me with anyone else. So, he viewed Joan with a great deal of suspicion.

"He never takes his eyes off of you - ever," Joan said as we walked through the park with Griz leading the way. As we walked we talked about family, God, careers and other deep stuff.

After the walk, we went to my house to watch a movie. No sooner did we sit down on the sofa than Griz plopped down - right between us. We petted him as we watched Russell Crowe in Gladiator.

Occasionally, our fingers would touch as we both stroked the Labrador's fur. A little tingle ran up my hand each time our fingers brushed against each other. But Griz wasn't so impressed. He watched me intently but pointedly ignored this woman - an intruder in his lair.

After the show was over, Joan decided she was going to win his heart. She stepped into the kitchen, squatted down and called Griz's name. He responded to her calls with a glare.

He walked toward her with stiff-legged trepidation. No sooner did he reach Joan than he hoisted his leg and urinated on her blouse.

I stood there horrified as the steady stream of urine raced down her side and formed a puddle on the floor. I kept thinking, "She's never going to go out with me again."

On the other hand, a relative gave me this sage bit of wisdom: "Marriage is something you should go into with your eyes wide open and through with them half shut."

When I ran this adage by my father, who ultimately was married to my mother for 58 years, he would just smile.

His folks were married 74 years, and my mother's parents' marriage lasted until the eve of their 50th anniversary, when a bad heart felled my grandfather.

They set good examples.

It is not enough to "feel" in love. Feelings are fleeting. Love is an action - not a mood. Love is choosing to put the needs and desires of someone else ahead of your own. I saw this sort of sacrificial love when my father would pick up my mother's frail cancer-stricken body and gently place her in bed. Or at harvesttime when my mother would cook meals and take them into the field so Dad could always have something good to eat when he was working such long hours.

I only hope Joan and I can provide an even better example for our three daughters.

If they ever ask the secret to a happy marriage I'll say this: love, forgive and never give up.

COVID-19 vaccines and the military

I remember it like it was yesterday, but it was more than 40 years ago.

I was lined up with a bunch of other young guys with our heads freshly shaved. Our uniforms still smelled new and weird to me. I was getting used to wearing boots.

Actually, I was getting used to everything around me at Air Force basic training in San Antonio, Texas.

I had gotten to know a few of the guys around me and was becoming friends with a dude from California and a nice kid from North Carolina. There was a wildman from Idaho who I liked as well.

But here we were under the hot Texas sun standing in twos. My arm was linked with another guy - I don't remember who - as our drill instructor spoke in a very loud voice to us (yell? Maybe).

"Just keep walking when they tell you to walk!" he said. "I don't want any of you babies passing out after this either! Grab some water and sit in the shade for a minute. This isn't the Navy, so no crying!"

OK, maybe those weren't his exact words, but you get the idea.

So, we walked forward and slowed down just long enough to get our shots from the shot gun. These things were like high-powered sprayers that forced the vaccines into our arms. We got a lot of them - there were multiple people on each side loading us up. We linked arms to keep the other

person from falling if he got weak from all the shots.

When we got to the end, our arms were sore and bleeding - mine not too much - and we grabbed some water and sat in the shade. I felt fine, but quite a few of the guys passed out. I will admit, I found it pretty amusing and was glad I didn't do it.

What was just put into my body? I didn't know, I was in the military. I was a government asset. My job was not to ask questions, as I was reminded about 2,677 times a day. My job was to do as I was told without question and without hesitation.

As long as it was a lawful order, of course. But we all know that is a very gray area.

That is the system in the military, and it has worked pretty well. When your superior tells you to do something, you don't play 20 Questions. You simply do the job you were trained to do.

I bring this up because I am reading that the U.S. Army is starting to kick out members who are refusing to get a COVID-19 vaccine. Some people are upset about this, but they shouldn't be. When you join the military, you sign a contract to do a job and to follow orders. If you can't follow orders, you don't belong in the military. It is really that simple.

I have talked with my brother, a retired Army Colonel about this a few times. He is a very conservative man, but he thinks the Army should kick these guys out if they refuse to get vaccines they are ordered to

get. He knows if soldiers start questioning everything, the entire system will collapse.

Vaccines are about readiness. Members of the military live in close quarters and can be deployed all over the world, so a variety of vaccine are necessary. That currently includes a COVID vaccine.

Now I don't want the government telling civilians that don't work for them that they must get a vaccine. Yes, I think everyone should for the sake of the country as a whole get vaccinated, but I don't think the government should force it on anyone.

But your private employer, when considering overall worker safety, should be able to make this or any vaccine mandatory. They must consider productivity.

Higby said RPD could get some lateral applicants that have already worked as officers elsewhere that could result in a new hire being on the street faster.

The three planned retirements are currently slated throughout the remainder of the year. Potential promotions would fill those positions and open up patrol officer positions for new hires.

"It's very difficult," Higby said. "When you start having to make changes, it complicates things further. Summer is a busier time with policing and people have vacations and we'll have to replace detectives. We need to bring people up before we need them and we need bodies to replace retirements. It will be tough with timing. We have to stay on our timeline."

Higby said he has six police academy spots he can use this year if needed for new hires. He would like to hire four officers if RPD is going to lose four due to retirement this year. Hiring would ultimately be up to City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh.

Applications across the country for law enforcement positions are down. But, Higby said he was pleased with the recent turnout the city received for its openings. From what the chief knows, similar agencies are getting 6-8 applications for open positions. RPD received 18.

"That's not bad right now," Higby said. "I think

the laws in Illinois along with national coverage of policing is playing a factor in the number of applicants and qualified applicants we're getting being down. I know when I tested here years ago there were 150 people testing for 1-2 positions and now it's 18 testing for four different positions."

Higby called the situation of applicants being down "unfortunate" and said the hiring process is all predicated on finding good applicants.

"It's a job that's near and dear to our hearts," Higby said. "It will continue to be a job that needs to be done by qualified people. It's still quality applicants we're getting,

there's just less of them."

Higby said that as police work has changed over the years, more manpower has been needed. Officers are spending more time on things like training and Freedom of Information Act work due to changes in laws. While more training has come about, time patrolling still has to be done. And more training requirements are coming in the future, he said.

Inman was sworn in Monday to start his duties as deputy chief. John Kaltenbach, who was recently promoted to detective sergeant, was sworn in as well. Both men will be sworn in officially at a future city council meet-

ing as well.

Higby called Inman's new position of deputy chief a "critical position" within the department. Inman will serve as chief when Higby isn't available and run the day-to-day aspects of RPD. Inman has a master's degree and "all the experience needed," Higby said.

RPD is authorized to have 21 sworn officers. It now has 20 since Leininger's retirement. Over the years with moving officers into school resource positions at Rochelle Township High School and Rochelle Middle School, less officers have been available for patrol.

"If those guys were

still on the street, we'd be fully staffed," Higby said. "Would we like extra people? Sure. But those costs add up and it would be a lot of extra cost."

Along with the four planned retirements this year, Higby said there are at least three more officers in the department that could retire. Any officer with 20 or more years on the job or coming up on age 50 is eligible for retirement. That's why the city started planning for this situation "a couple of years ago," but unfortunately, new officers can't be sent to the academy that far ahead of time, Higby said.

The chief called institutional knowledge and

having veteran officers important. RPD is fortunate to have officers in the middle of their careers who can be promoted to replace retiring officers, Higby said. Training will also aid in the transition, as new sergeants will have to go to supervisor school and new detectives will get more training as well.

"It will take a while to get things running the way they should be," Higby said. "I don't think it's a concern for the future of the department. We have good supervisors in place and we'll hire hard. New people are good. They start on the street and work hard and get more seasoned and well-rounded. An infusion of youth is good."

Senior Night winners

Lady Hubs close out regular season with 60-54 victory over LaSalle-Peru

ROCHELLE — Josie Lundquist was one of three four-year varsity seniors who took the court to start the Rochelle Lady Hub basketball team’s Senior Night matchup against LaSalle-Peru. Lundquist was also one of four Rochelle seniors to score in double figures as the Lady Hubs fought to finish one of their most successful regular seasons in recent history with a victory.

Having pushed through a trio of tough seasons over the last three years, Lundquist and the Lady Hub seniors showcased their growth on Thursday, commanding the early lead over the 18-win Cavaliers and fending off a fierce rally to score a 60-54 Interstate 8 Conference win. The Lady Hubs (14-16, 7-7 Interstate 8) will now prepare for the IHSA 3A Rochelle Regional, which begins with a quarterfinal matchup against the Plano Reapers on Saturday evening at 6 p.m.

“The support meant so

much to all of us and we knew that we were all going to come out and play on top of our game,” Lundquist said. “Everybody cheered us on tonight and this team means so much to me. I’m really proud of how we played tonight... We came into this season not knowing what to expect, but we’ve put in the work and I’m so proud of this senior group.”

Six seniors were recognized before the varsity game including four-year varsity players Zoey Tabor, Lucy Bunger and Lundquist as well as Abby Luxton, Jordin Dickey and Adriannah Davis-Carter. Rochelle saw five different players make baskets in the first quarter, where the Lady Hubs slipped ahead 10-7 before Lundquist caught fire in the second quarter, knocking down a 3-pointer and finishing two tough drives to the rim for seven of her 11 points in the game.

“It’s a huge confidence booster for us,” Lundquist said. “We’ll be facing Plano for the third time this season and I think this win tonight sets us in the

Despite a valiant effort from LaSalle-Peru guard Brooklyn Ficek, who scored 13 of her 16 points in the second quarter, Rochelle remained ahead

29-23 at the half. The Lady Hubs looked to shut down Ficek throughout the second half, limiting the talented guard to one 3-pointer in the third

quarter behind stiff double teams and aggressive man-to-man defense on the perimeter.

RTHS Boys Bowling

Hubs looking to build on three-win season

Four-year bowlers Guevara, Patel headline departing varsity seniors

ROCHELLE — Head coach Jim Lyles saw several young players on the Rochelle Hub varsity bowling team step up through the 2021-22 season. With five seniors set to leave the program, Lyles will look for those players to continue improving as the Hubs look to build on a challenging three-win season this year. Rochelle finished 3-12 overall and 2-6 in the Interstate 8 Conference this season. The Hub took third in the Rockford Christian Invitational before placing ninth in the LaSalle-Peru Cavalier Classic and eighth in the Dixon Toughman Tournament. Rochelle closed out the season with a fifth-place finish at the Interstate 8 Conference Championship meet and a ninth-place performance in the IHSA Sterling Regional.

“I thought some of our younger bowlers really stepped up this year,” Lyles said. “Some of the houses we bowl at during the season have synthetic lanes and we struggle to hook the ball at those houses, but our kids learned how to play those lanes better so their balls can hook. We need to continue working

on our spares, but I thought our kids really learned how to throw the ball better and how to adjust to the lanes.”

Rochelle will graduate five seniors from the team this season including varsity starters Sergio Guevara, Devansh Patel, Luke Orlikowski and Max Orlikowski, who recorded the team’s high series in the regional. Guevara and Patel each spent four seasons with the Rochelle Hub bowling team and provided both leadership and experience that Lyles said the Hubs will miss as the team retools its roster for next season.

“Sergio and Devansh were really good leaders for us and they were always really positive,” Lyles said. “They were always asking questions and Sergio was huge for our program because he helped bring a lot of bowlers into the program when he first came out. Devansh was a really good asset for us as well. He barely averaged 100 during his freshman year, but he finished his career averaging anywhere from 170-180.”

Junior Evin Odle headlines a core of five returning players who could step up for the Hubs next season. Sophomores Christian Thorne and Jonathan Ala-

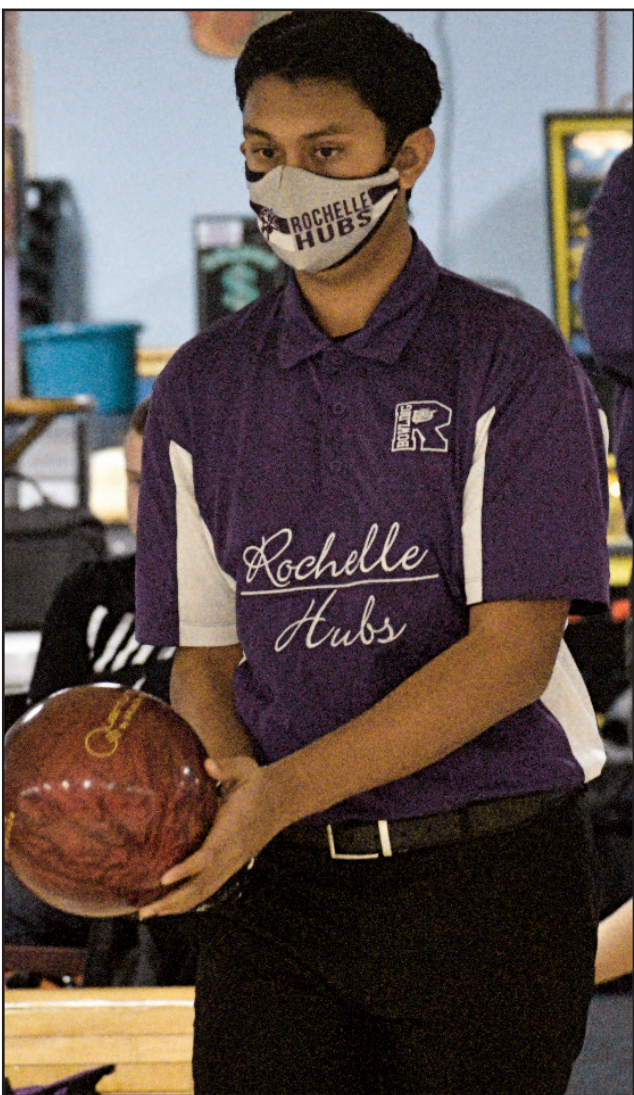
nis each earned first-year varsity experience this season, while freshmen Logan Frye and Trent Kreider are two more players who could see larger roles next

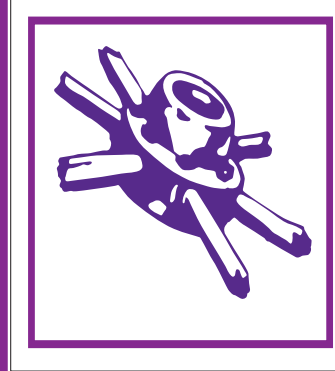

Tabor took the torch for the Rochelle offense in the third quarter, sinking a pair of free throws after a drive to the hoop before burying a triple and putting home a layup for seven of her 15 points. Trailing 45-33 entering the fourth quarter, LaSalle-Peru leaned on guard Taylor Martyn, who shined with five 3-pointers made in the quarter, most coming from the left-side corner.

“It was such as awesome feeling to be out there with my teammates and get this win,” Tabor said. “The energy was great and everybody showed up for us tonight. We really appreciated all of the support from the fans. Coach [Ryan] McQuade has brought a new approach to the team and we’re working together and focusing on

the small things. It’s a huge confidence booster for us to win this game on Senior Night and we’re ready to bring it at the regional on Saturday.”

Martyn’s incredible fourth-quarter shooting performance lifted her to a game-high 23 points and seven 3-pointers made, but the Lady Hubs successfully closed out the win. Rochelle’s forwards stood out late in the game, with Luxton going 6-for-6 from the free-throw line to finish with 15 points while freshman Kendyl Darby knocked down two low-post layups to end the evening with 11 points. Ficek totaled 16 points for LaSalle-Peru after a strong first half.

Dixon

The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity basketball team did everything it could to hang

tough during the first half of its nonconference matchup against the 26-win Dixon Duchesses on Tuesday night.

Four different players knocked down 3-pointers in the first quarter for the Lady Hubs, who continue to battle with tough defense and some success in the pick-and-roll offense during the second quarter. Rochelle trailed Dixon by only three points at the half, but the Duchesses shut down the Lady Hubs over the third and fourth quarters, limiting Rochelle to six points and ultimately cruising to a 52-29 win over the Lady Hubs.

“Dixon has a really good basketball team and I know their coach has been working with those girls for over a decade now,” head coach Ryan McQuade said. “I thought we were

well prepared and I thought we came out with a lot of energy, but we didn’t have that same energy during the second half. . . I think we’re performing really well as a team right now. The girls have shown great chemistry and we’ve improved.”

Senior Josie Lundquist canned the first of four Rochelle triples in the first quarter, hitting a shot from the left elbow for the first points of the evening. Seniors Lucy Bunger, Zoey Tabor and junior Torrin Nantz also made 3-pointers for the Lady Hubs (13-16, 6-7 Interstate 8), who trailed 13-12 entering the second quarter. Rochelle’s full-court press flustered the Duchesses early, with players like sophomore Alivia Henkel forcing deflections and forcing Dixon turnovers to create transition scoring opportunities on the other

end.

But the Duchesses rallied behind senior guard Sam Tourtillott, who led all scorers with 18 points in the game. Tourtillott aggressively drove to the basket throughout the second half, converting multiple layups and drawing fouls to get to the free-throw line. The Lady Hubs also struggled with Dixon’s three-quarter court press, which allowed the Duchesses to utilize their superior length to force turnovers of their own.

“We have to knock down shots against a team like Dixon, especially when they’re playing a zone defense and they have a lot of length,” McQuade said. “They basically dared us to beat them from the outside and I thought we did that during the first half. Dixon started pressuring us a little near the end of the first half,

and without a girl who can throw the ball over the top, we had some troubles when we tried breaking the press.”

Despite holding Dixon to a 26-23 advantage at half-time, Rochelle converted just one field goal in the third quarter, where the Duchesses outscored the Lady Hubs 16-2 to take control of the game. Henkel and Tabor each finished with six points to lead the Rochelle offense.

The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity basketball team won its final Interstate 8 Conference road game of the season Monday evening, defeating the Morris Redskins 36-29 behind nine points from senior Josie Lundquist and nine points from freshman Kendyl Darby. The victory sealed a season sweep of the Redskins.
