YEAR IN REVIEW 2021

A look back at some of the top Rochelle News-Leader stories of the past year

July 4
ROCHELLE — Gov. JB Pritzker visited the 'Hub City' on Thursday afternoon.

Pritzker was in town visiting Kennay Farms Distilling with a film crew in tow. He recognized the distillery for its work early in the COVID-19 pandemic when it adapted to making hand sanitizer rather than spirits. A member of Pritzker's video team reached out to Kennay Farms Owner Rick Kennay and asked in the days before to set up a tour and interview, Aubrey Quinn, in charge of marketing at the distillery, said.

"It was a pretty cool experience," Quinn said. "We were pleased they picked us out. We felt pretty special. It was cool to meet them. They were shooting video for four hours. They wanted to see products bottled. We bottled a single barrel whiskey. They filmed shots around the tasting room and we walked across the street to eat lunch. It was casual. We talked about the transition that we made last year."

July 21
ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Area Community Foundation celebrated its 15th anniversary of operation in its 16th year on Monday with a golf outing at Fairways Golf Course.

The event, originally scheduled for last year during the COVID-19 pandemic, had to wait a year. 72 golfers took to the course that had tables with representatives from community nonprofits represented.

"On behalf of the foundation, we thank everyone for their participation," RACF Board Vice President Dennis Berg said. "We were going to have one last year, but we had to postpone it. As you're playing, there's 10 nonprofits out there. Make sure you engage with them and thank them for what they do. Without them, we don't have the community we have. We appreciate all the work they do."

The workforce shortage is nationwide and Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows recently told the News-Leader that there are currently 300 open jobs in town. Herrera said busi-

nesses big and small have seen the impacts, namely the industrial, food service and retail sectors.

"Our industrial businesses are offering large bonuses and still can't staff," Herrera said. "It is concerning. We want places to stay in business and be productive and profit. What will happen if

they can't staff? Will some have to consolidate? Will some have to close their doors?"

The gala will have hors d'oeuvres, dinner and dessert, a live and silent auction and games and raffles. There will be complimentary valet parking and photographs. A table of eight costs \$700, couples cost \$185 and individual tickets cost \$95. The items at the gala include a 75-inch TV, a Gale Sayers autographed jersey, a Jerry Rice autographed jersey and a Justin Fields autographed jersey.

"Our goal for our first year was \$30,000," Eckhardt said. "We've come a long way. We only had two groups that benefited from it when we started. It's just been incredible. We had no idea it'd go where it

has. We're our own 501(c)(3) nonprofit now. The biggest thing and what I enjoy most is giving the checks. And it's more every year."

Last year, the gala was held virtually due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eckhardt said that was "fun" and turned out successful. From the Heart decided to keep a virtual

aspect in 2022 and will host a virtual drawing on its Facebook page on Feb. 5.

Those who are unable to attend the gala the same day can still participate in the drawing and event in that way.

"For the virtual raffle drawing, it's \$100 per ticket, and you'll have

one entry into each of the three prizes," Eckhardt said. "One is half a hog with processing, one is a quarter beef with processing and a 75-inch Samsung TV. They also get a \$25 voucher for Flight Deck. It essentially costs \$75. If you want additional chances, you can pay an extra \$20 per ticket."

ROCHELLE — Due to a significant increase in the number of COVID-19 cases in the community and a significant increase in patient volumes, Rochelle Community Hospital needs to limit the number of visitors in our facility. Please help us by adhering to our visitor restrictions.

Visitor restrictions are still in place. Patients in the emergency department or on the medical/surgical

floor, including ICU, will be allowed one designated visitor (must be the same person) for the duration of their visit. Visitors must be age 18 or older. This will help to minimize public traffic throughout the facility and decrease the chance of spreading COVID-19 within the hospital.

In addition, only one person may accompany a patient to same day surgery, convenient care, the multi-specialty Clinic or

family healthcare Clinic.

After screening, all visitors must remain properly masked for the duration of their visit anywhere in the facility, including the patient's room. Visitors with COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, coughing, sneezing, sore throat, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell, etc. must not visit patients.

Creston board to look at railroad quiet zones

Village President Byro: Downtown grant application finished

CRESTON—During its Tuesday meeting, the Creston Village Board discussed the idea of working to get its railroad crossings considered “quiet zones” in the future.

Village Trustee Curt Ward said train horns are one of the “ongoing” complaints the village receives from residents and he wants to start pursuing quiet zones for crossings after recent sidewalk work improved crossings and made quiet zones more feasible.

Localities desiring to establish a quiet zone are first required to mitigate the increased risk caused by the absence of a horn. Raised medians are often placed between lanes in front of both sides of the tracks to prevent the possibility a vehicle could attempt to go between lowered gates.

Ward said to start work on quiet zones, the village would have to file notices with the Illinois Commerce Commission and the railroad. The first step would be asking Village Engineer Kevin Bunge to work up a cost estimate for the project. A diagnostic meeting on site with all parties is required.

The village would have to make all three of its railroad crossings quiet zones, Ward said. They include Woodlawn Road, Main Street and Transit Street. Ward said

the most feasible scenario would be to make Transit Street a one way due to it being narrow. The other two crossings would have center medians installed.

“I think it’s a great idea,” Village President Tom Byro said. “It could take probably over two years.”

Downtown grant

Byro said during the meeting that the village has completed its application for the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown grant it plans to apply for.

The village’s application includes a \$650,000 reconstruction of its downtown including new water main and storm sewer, reconstruction of the street, all new sidewalks, curb and gutter, parking and more. The village has resolved to commit \$160,000 in matching funds if it were to receive the grant.

Bunge has said the grant application process will take a year and if selected, Creston wouldn’t start construction or have to pay any costs until the latter part of 2023.

Part of the application process is predicated on COVID-19 impacts to downtowns and Byro said the Creston-Dement Public Library and Headon’s Fine Meats Owner and Village Trustee Mark Hibshman have provided testimony about how

the pandemic negatively affected them.

“Hopefully those things will help us along,” Byro said. “I think everything is going well.”

Water meter reader

Byro said the village has received its new water meter reader equipment. Creston had been charging estimated water rates recently and asked residents to read meters themselves.

The village will now hire a water meter reader

operator and do training to “get everything going.” Byro hopes that everything will be in place for the village to read meters by February.

“We have a couple people that live in town that are interested in helping us do it,” Byro said. “We’re going to get those people lined up and this equipment running. We will let people know there will be a new meter reader. It’s a very important thing.”

Plow truck

Byro said the village’s

snow plow truck is out of service at the moment after brake lines went out on it on Jan. 2. The truck was towed to Prescott Brothers Ford to be repaired and could cost \$700-800 or even “around \$1,000.”

“That truck is a 2003,” Byro said. “We’re going to put more money in that pickup. But we need it. We’ve had people helping out in the meantime and so far, so good. Everything is going well.”

Insurance

The board unanimous-

ly approved insurance for the village for 2022. The total cost was \$11,828, up \$40 from last year with the same policy structure. Byro said the only thing that may change with the insurance is the addition of internet security insurance, which he’s discussed with the village’s insurer.

“You never know when you’re going to get hacked,” Byro said. “DeKalb got hacked. He said he’d check into that and get back to me. We can add that to the policy if we have to.”





What lies ahead for the city

HAPPY New Year. With Christmas and New Year's Day behind us, we look forward to what lies ahead for the City of Rochelle. The COVID-19 pandemic brought many challenges and changed the way we work and live. Rochelle has proven its resilience by pulling together. I am proud to be part of Team Rochelle.

As last year ended, I started thinking about the many great things that have happened in our community. Most notably, the city council passed a very achievable budget, despite the negative effects of the pandemic. In 2021, the State of Illinois mandated the closure of certain types of businesses and suspended gaming throughout the state. City gaming revenues are dedicated to funding the Police & Fire Pension Fund. Through careful strategic planning, city management created a revenue stream to fund the pension obligation rather than relying on the money to support the General Fund.

I would like publicly to thank the department heads, city staff and the City Manager for unit-

ing everyone to present a budget to the council they could approve, despite not always knowing when revenues from state and federal agencies will be received. The City of Rochelle is in a strong financial position because of the commitment by staff to be prudent in their spending.

The razing of Hickory Grove should occur within the next 45 days. The final bid to demolish the building was approved by council in Dec. 2021. Community Development and the city manager will recruit a developer to revitalize the property and generate property taxes on the historic site.

In 2021, we were fortunate to welcome new storefronts and participate in retail grand openings in the community. Business retention is a primary focus of our Community and Economic Development departments. In cooperation with the Rochelle Retail Advisory Board, Rochelle Chamber of Commerce, Kishwaukee College and the Small Business Development Center at Waubesa College, I am optimistic that jobs

will continue to be filled, and that the city will host a second Community of Opportunity Job Expo in the spring. The expo that was held in Sept. 2021 at Rochelle Township High School (RTHS) was a resounding success. It was heartwarming to see job seekers finding jobs that will lead brighter futures. We estimate that over 50 local jobs were filled because of the expo.

There are several roadway and utility infrastructure upgrades and replacements planned throughout the community in 2022. A modern infrastructure has a positive impact on our mobility and productivity. Additional job fairs and job retention meetings for locals, will also be on the docket.

And finally, the 2021 Rochelle Shop Local Program proved to be a lifeline for many of the small businesses within our community, and for that I say a huge thank you to the citizens of Rochelle who participated. Thank you for a great 2021, and might 2022 bring health, happiness, and prosperity to our community.

And he says he's never seen a situation like this in the industry is in now. COVID-19 created a chip shortage in auto manufacturing that has slowed new car production. At the beginning of the pandemic, demand slowed before speeding back up. Now there's "pent-up" demand with a shortage of new cars on the market.

"Demand is so high and you can't get the new cars, so it's just driven the market crazy," Myers, the general manager of Jeff Perry Chevrolet Buick Cadillac in Rochelle, said. "We have to sell what we have or sell used cars. And that's driven up the price of used cars. The factory has reduced some of the rebates on new cars, so the price of new is up, the price of used is up. It's just a shortage of cars. All created by COVID-19."

Aug. 1

ROCHELLE — The board of trustees at Rochelle Community Hospital announced a new partnership with the Flagg-Rochelle Community Park District in support of the new REC Center this week.

RCH committed \$400,000 to a 20-year marketing sponsorship at The REC, which will be paid out to the park district over a period of seven years. The hospital will be the sole and exclusive healthcare provider advertising at The REC.

this partnership with the REC Center will support healthier lives throughout Rochelle," a press release said.

Aug. 4

ROCHELLE — The Flip Flops and Blood Drops blood drive collected 62 units of blood during its operation Monday at the REC in Rochelle, exceeding its goal of 50. The drive is in honor of twin sisters Lana and Ellie Troha, who were born prematurely, weighing just over one pound each.

While in the hospital, both girls received blood transfusions. Sadly, Ellie passed away at five days old. Her sister, Lana, received eight units of blood within the first five months of her life. For the past four years, Lana's parents, Gabrielle and Derek, Rochelle natives, have partnered with the American Red Cross to host a blood drive in honor of her life and in memory of Ellie.

"That's a possible 186 lives saved," Gabrielle said of Monday's 62 units. "It went really well. It was steady and we had all the appointments come in. It was a great turnout. It makes me feel incredibly proud and happy."

The event featured police and fire demonstrations, a helicopter landing, a ballet folklorico presentation, games, giveaways, music and free hot dogs. Similar events are celebrated by local police departments all across the country on the first Tuesday in August.

Attendees watched the fire department use some of its life-saving tools on a car and the police department did both a taser and K9 demonstration.

Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby said the night gives officers the chance to interact with people outside of the scope in which they normally would.

"We're dressed differently, it gives people an opportunity to look at our equipment and do things like see the dog take a bite," Higby said. "A lot of times people ask us questions one-on-one and we're able to answer them. Because we're not on a call, we don't have a call waiting. It just gives us an opportunity to talk to people in a different environment."

Aug. 11

ROCHELLE — At its Tuesday meeting, the Rochelle Elementary District approved a school reopening plan unanimously that included a mask mandate, adhering to Gov. JB Pritzker's executive order last week.

Superintendent Jason Harper recommended last week and at the meeting that the board follow the mask mandate due to risk of increased liability, loss of insurance coverage, loss of recognition as a public school and loss of school funding. Both the elementary and Rochelle Township High School districts previously approved a plan with masks optional in recent weeks before Pritzker's executive order.

Aug. 15

ROCHELLE — Zech VanVickle was recently hired full-time by the Rochelle Fire Department as a firefighter/paramedic and started on Thursday.

He's the department's 13th full-time firefighter and the move was made due to the department absorbing "quite a bit" of overtime recently, Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville said.

The department had 12 firefighters, not counting Sawlsville, for the past 15 years. The number of calls goes up every year, Sawlsville said. The number of EMS calls has continuously risen for 20 years. Fire calls have trended down and leveled off "a bit," Sawlsville said.

VanVickle is a Rochelle native and started working with the department part-time in 2018. He's been on Ogle-Lee Fire since 2016 and has worked closely with Rochelle Fire over that time.

"It was a long-term goal of mine to work here," VanVickle said. "It's nice to be able to work in a full-time capacity with everyone. I like the EMS side. It's a passion of mine, being able to help people with medical issues. And obviously firefighting is a big part of our job, being safe about it and helping conserve property."

Aug. 18

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Township High School Board of Education approved a school reopening plan that adheres to the Gov. JB Pritzker's mask mandate by a vote of 6-0 at its Monday meeting.

Similar to the past few high school and elementary district board meetings, members of the community voiced their thoughts against masks in school and urged board members

to go against the state mandate and make masks optional in schools. The board previously opted for a mask optional approach before the governor's mandate.

High School Board President Tom Huddleston spoke to those in attendance at Monday's meeting and said the governor's executive order is a law in the board's eyes that it has to abide by.

"At the last meeting we completely agreed with you that masks should be optional," Huddleston said. "At that time it was a recommendation from the governor. The executive order took away our discretion. It requires us to abide by it with very many significant risks if we don't."

MT. MORRIS

— Rochelle's Danica and Mark Rogers have entered the U.S. National Straw Sculpting Competition in Mt. Morris that runs from Aug. 13-29. The competition is in its sixth year of operation and was in Rochelle for its first year. It's been in downtown Mt. Morris on the historic campus since.

Mark and Danica started entering the competition in its first year in Rochelle after encouragement by local sculptor Fran Volz and have been a part of it ever since. Their first entry was a 1970s troll doll. Then Danica and her cousin made King Kong and the Headless Horseman. And then it was the Ghostbusters Stay Puft Marshmallow man.

Aug. 22

ROCHELLE — Rochelle city officials held a groundbreaking ceremony Friday and announced that Starbucks will be building and opening a location in town on Illinois Route 251 next to Walgreens.

The location will feature a 2,000 square foot store with indoor and outdoor seating and a drive-thru. It is planned to open in spring 2022. It will employ about 25-30 people and it has created 75-80 construction jobs. The city first began speaking with Starbucks in January, City Community Development Director Michelle Pease said.

"This is quite an exciting announcement," Mayor John Bearrows said. "Starbucks is a major nationwide chain. Many months ago when we started talking about this, I spoke with Michelle and we talked about what could happen. I thought if we could land a Starbucks, that could be amazing in Rochelle. And now we know it's not only in Rochelle, but it's the only one in Ogle County."

ROCHELLE — Summer Country Jam will

return to Rochelle in 2022, Rochelle Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Tricia Herrera said.

The event previously took place at Rochelle Municipal Airport for five years up until 2017. It was not held in the two years after that. Herrera said the board wanted to hold the event last year before the COVID-19 pandemic came into play.

"It is coming back in 2022," Herrera said. "We've already started planning it. Planning is very preliminary right now. The chamber board has already voted on it and approved it. The community wants it back. The community has asked about doing it again. It was great for five years."

Aug. 25

ROCHELLE — Before he passed away in December, Todd Smith gave the Rochelle Township High School football coaches Under Armour shirts to wear under their polos during games.

"Last spring, I wore it every game," RTHS Football Coach and Teacher Brian Worthington said. "I intend to wear it every game until I retire. Because every Friday night, he's one of the things I want to think about."

Worthington spoke those words during a tree dedication in Smith's honor on Friday at the school. Smith's family and football players and coaches gathered to honor the late photographer and booster club president.

The tree was planted on Purple Pass on May 17. RTHS Athletic Director Rich Harvey said Smith wore many hats at RTHS and photographed dances,

musicals, sports, assemblies and more.

Aug. 29

ROCHELLE — Gov. JB Pritzker announced at a Thursday news conference that masks will be required indoors statewide regardless of vaccination status beginning Monday amid the ongoing surge in the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pritzker also announced that employees in schools and healthcare settings will be required to receive the COVID-19 vaccine starting Sept. 5. Those who are unwilling or unable will be required to get tested for COVID-19 at least once a week.

Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows and Ogle County Health Department Public Administrator Kyle Auman took to Facebook Thursday in a video reacting to the changes.

"We must slow down and stop this spread," Bearrows said. "This mask mandate worked before. As your mayor, I'm asking you to pitch in and make this work again. It's not the end of the world. This is something we have to do for each other."

Sept. 1

ROCHELLE — On Aug. 28, the park district held a grand celebration for The REC Center after it opened Dec. 1, 2020. The celebration was put off due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The \$14 million facility includes a four-court gymnasium, indoor turf, a fitness center, multi-purpose rooms, an indoor walking track and an aquatic center with two pools.

"I wanted to say welcome to everyone who has come to this incredible

The event was sponsored by the City of Rochelle, the Office of Mayor John Bearrows, Kishwaukee College, RTHS, Rochelle Foods—Hormel, 102.3 The Coyote and Superhits 93.5.

The event was born out of a workforce shortage locally and nationally due to a multitude of reasons including the rise of people working remotely, higher wage demands, COVID-19, additional domestic responsibilities and the leverage of workers considering changing jobs.

BYRON—The familiar sight of steam rising from the Byron Generating Station continues, although it is down to rising from one tower as the station refuels.

With Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker signing a new energy bill that was favorable to nuclear plants into law on Sept. 15, the Byron Station will continue to operate. It's owner, Exelon Generation, had threatened to close the station on Sept. 13 without the new bill.

The bill will also keep Prairie State Energy Campus, which the City of Rochelle has \$150 million in debt with until 2042, open until at least 2038.

Sept. 26

ROCHELLE—Chef Amadeus spent his week in Rochelle eating at local restaurants like The Rack, Sunrise Family Restaurant and The Iron Skillet.

Oct. 20

ROCHELLE—A ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremony were held Saturday morning at The Spark Shop, Rochelle's new retail incubator for local small business owners.

The Spark Shop is housed in the historic filling station building downtown. It's for businesses that are currently home-based but are looking to someday have their own brick and mortar location. About 10-12 vendors will be in the space at a time selling merchandise on a quarterly basis. The idea was put together by the Rochelle Chamber of Commerce, Rochelle Retail Advisory Board and the City of Rochelle.

The 10-week program offered the opportunity for residents to learn about the city and its various departments. Participants

went behind the scenes to learn how the city works through hands-on activities, facility tours and more.

"I'm very happy we did this," Mayor John Bearrows said. "This process was for people who wondered about the city. For a city of 10,000 people with a \$95 million budget, this is a huge machine."

City officials said they plan to offer another Citizens Academy program in the future after the success of the first one.

Nov. 14

ROCHELLE—The Hub City Senior Center partnered with ProMedica Hospice Wednesday to host a Veterans Day celebration to honor and recognize local veterans.

The event included a brief ceremony followed by a pin and certificate presentation.

"On behalf of myself and our team at the senior center, we just want to thank you for joining us in this celebration to honor our veterans," HCSC Executive Director Diana King said. "Words cannot express the gratitude we have for each and every one of you for your service. Thank you so much."

Nov. 21

ROCHELLE—Thirty years went by faster than Seadin Ajvazi anticipated.

The owner of Sunrise Family Restaurant celebrated being open for 30 years in Rochelle on Thursday with family, employees and customers. Free coffee and desert were offered the entire day.

Dec. 15

ROCHELLE—The Rochelle City Council unanimously approved a \$361,900 bid for the demolition of the Hickory Grove facility at 1127 N. 7th St. at its Monday meeting.

City Engineer Sam Tesreau said McDonagh Demolition will take 60 days to complete the project and his guess is that it would start in late January. The demolition would end in April. It will consist of the complete removal of all above grade structures and below grade foundations where applicable,

a portion of the existing pavement, outside pool area and final restoration and seeding of the disturbed area.

The city assumed ownership of the deteriorating building in early 2020 for \$1 with the intention of demolishing it and developing the property. It has worked on the demolition project for a year to develop an agreement with the Comfort Inn next door to establish cross access easements, property acquisition, plating, façade improvements on the south side of the hotel after disconnection of the Hickory Grove facility and other general project specifications.

The bid approved by the council was approximately 35 percent lower than the estimated cost of \$575,000. The project will be funded by a Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois grant reimbursement up to \$365,750.

Dec. 19

ROCHELLE—Rochelle Fire Department Chief Dave Sawlsville was called last Friday night to help with response efforts after an EF3 tornado struck an Amazon warehouse in Edwardsville, killing six and causing multiple injuries.

Sawlsville is part of an incident management assistance team for large-scale events that are going to last over a period of days. Officials like him are called to help relieve local command team members that have worked long hours.

"I was called and asked if I could go at 10 p.m. on Friday night," Sawlsville said. "I said absolutely. I went down with three other guys to try and support the fire chief and his command structure. They do the first response. We don't go and take over the scene. We're just there to help with anything they need."

Hubs cruise over Sandwich

Lager’s alley-oop dunk highlights 80-50 win over short-handed Indians

ROCHELLE — An alley-off dunk off the backboard highlighted a stellar offensive performance from the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team against the Sandwich Indians on Wednesday.

With Sandwich limited to only seven players, Rochelle took advantage of a short-handed Indians rotation, building an early lead in a first quarter that featured an off-the-backboard pass from senior Noah Tanner Lager, who jammed the ball with two hands to ignite the crowd and the Rochelle sideline. Eleven different players scored points for the Hubs, who dominated the first quarter 29-6 and cruised to an 80-50 win over Sandwich.

“It was a really exciting moment to dunk that ball,” Lager said. “Dunking the ball during a high school basketball game is something you always dream about and being able to bring that energy to the court really helped us a lot early in the game. It was nice to see our reserves get some minutes tonight because they always push us to get better and it’s good

for the team.”

Eight Rochelle players scored in the first quarter including senior forward Zach Sanford, who finished with five points in his first home game since recovering from an ACL injury over the summer. Senior Ryan Simmons led the Hubs with 20 points on Wednesday, nailing three 3-pointers in the first half to fuel an offense that converted 19 first-half field goals.

“We have to be able to score and play good defense,” Lager said. “I feel like our shooting has improved over our last few games and we have to build on that. I think we can always improve on defense as well. It’s a big confidence booster for us to win this game tonight. Even though Sandwich has struggled this year, it helps that everyone was able to knock down shots tonight.”

Rochelle (7-8, 4-1 Interstate 8) led 49-20 lead at halftime over the Indians, who struggled to prevent cutters from getting inside and finding space around the baseline. Senior Adam Kemp scored all nine of his points in the first half, hitting one 3-pointer as well as a pair of baseline floaters and a tough one-handed

layup at the rim. Lager also made all four of his field goals in the first half, with his alley-oop slam from Brown capping off an eight-point performance.

Rochelle continued to push the tempo in the third quarter, where sophomore Eli Luxton swished the first of his two 3-pointers in the game and drove for

two layups to score eight of his 12 points. Brown added a deep triple from the right elbow to ice a seven-point night and junior David Gerber rolled in two layups

for four of his five points off the bench. Junior forward Raul Aguirre scored eight first-half points for the Hubs, who led 72-34 after three quarters.

Throughout his recovery, Sanford has received support from University of Dubuque track and field coach and recruiting coordinator Jake Malm. That support played a factor in Sanford's decision to continue his academics and his track and field career at the University of Dubuque next season.

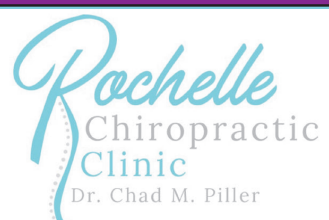
"I chose the University of Dubuque because I really enjoyed the campus and the atmosphere it had," Sanford said. "The coach was very concerned with my recovery and he checked in with me every week, which stood out to me. I'm looking forward to having the opportunity to compete for a few more years

after high school. I've learned new things and I've met new people throughout my time with the high school team and I think those things have helped me a lot."

Sanford set personal-best distances of 128 feet 8 1/2 inches in the discus throw and 45 feet 4 inches in the shot put during his junior season. The 6-foot-6, 240-pound athlete, who said he plans to compete in the discus, shot put and hammer throw with the University of Dubuque team, finished second in shot put and seventh in discus at the Interstate 8 Conference Championships this past season. Sanford also took third in shot put at the IHSAA 2A Rochelle Sectional.

"We're very proud of Zach and his commitment to track and field at RTHS," Bergeson said. "His hard work has paid off tremendously. As a staff, we're excited to see what Zach will accomplish this year at RTHS and in the future at the University of Dubuque. We couldn't ask for a better athlete to represent RTHS in track and field at the collegiate level."

Now a three-sport varsity athlete, Sanford has spent four years with the RTHS football and basketball programs, earning an All-Conference Honorable Mention during his junior basketball season. Sanford said he plans to study general science in high school education at the University of Dubuque in hopes of pursuing a career in teaching and coaching in high school athletics.

Hubs take down LaSalle-Peru

Dominant start lifts Rochelle to 81-57 win

LASALLE — Despite losing three consecutive games to close out the E.C. Nichols Holiday Classic and the 2021 calendar year, the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team swung in the new year with a dominant showing during Tuesday's Interstate 8 Conference matchup with LaSalle-Peru.

Behind five double-digit scorers including senior Noah Brown, who led the Hubs with 15 points on five 3-pointers made, Rochelle controlled the Cavaliers from the opening tip, outscoring LaSalle-Peru 30-10 in the first quarter and coasting to an 81-57 victory. The Hubs (6-8, 3-1 Interstate 8) shot over 52 percent from the field and finished 12-for-25 from the 3-point line.

I thought we moved the ball really well and our press really hurt them because we were getting a lot of steals and forcing them to turn over the ball."

Junior forward Raul Aguirre recorded 14 points and two steals for the Hubs, who forced 16

LaSalle-Peru turnovers. Senior forwards Cooper Hasz and Tanner Lager each scored 12 points, with Hasz grabbing nine rebounds and Lager pulling down six rebounds. Rochelle controlled the Cavaliers down low, outscoring LaSalle-Peru 38-24 on points in the paint and outrebounding LaSalle-Peru 35-25. The Hubs also outpaced the Cavaliers 26-11 in points

off turnovers.

"We shot the ball very well and we were aggressive in taking the ball to the rim," Brown said. "It makes us feel good when everyone scores the ball because it shows that we're all capable of producing and we're all scoring because we're sharing the ball. I don't think we had the right mindset earlier in the season, but we're focused on getting locked

in for the regional now and we're ready to see what the remainder of the season has in store for us."

HOLLYWOOD — Knopf Publishing has announced an upcoming memoir by **Paul Newman** that will cover his thoughts on acting, directing, family, fame, Hollywood, Broadway, love, his marriages, drinking, politics and racing. Newman, who died in 2008, began secretly writing his memoir in the ‘80s, and it recently was found in his Connecticut home, where his widow, **Joanne Woodward**, 91, still lives, suffering from Alzheimer’s.

More than a matinee idol, Newman became a great philanthropist. Today, many people know him more from his picture on “Newman’s Own” bottles of salad dressing, pasta sauce, wine, etc., than from his films. Created in 1982, Newman’s Own has donated \$600 million to charities. He was Oscar-nominated 10 times and finally won a best actor Oscar for “The Color of Money” (1987).

But there was another side to Newman. At 18, I was shooting photos for movie magazines. Paul and Joanne were on Broadway in “Baby Want a Kiss” at a theater next to Sardi’s Restaurant. I haunted their stage door for photos, but he always said “No.” On their last day, as they went into Sardi’s for dinner, I handed him an envelope and watched him read it to Joanne. My poem read:

Dear Mr. Newman, You’ve rarely been one of those who’d stand still for a picture and pose.

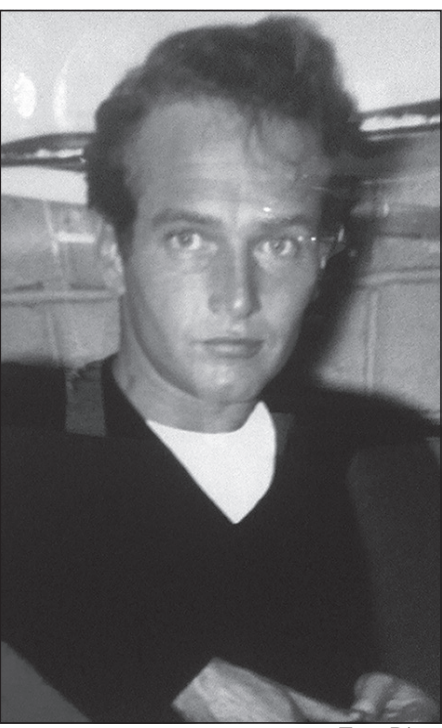
“Take it on the run,” is what you always say ... so I do, and a blur is what I throw away.

Mrs. Newman’s often difficult too. “Posing,” she says, “I never do!”

“I’m a wife and a mother,” she always replies, and that always draws a couple of sighs.

As a wife and a mother, she should get off the stage, why can’t she be nice, like Geraldine Page?

She’s a wife and a mother, just like her, at least she stands still so I don’t get a blur.

I followed you to your garage last week and heard you speak ... “Did it ever occur to you it might embarrass me?”

But it’s part of fame, Mr. Newman, don’t you see. In all the time you take saying what you won’t do, I could have taken 10 snaps of you.

Why can’t you have that old fashioned vice, instead of being disagreeable, try being nice.

That night I ran after his car, and after saying, “Great poem, you’re a great poet,” he finally posed, and that photo accompanies this story.

The next week, I encountered Joanne Woodward at Oscar rehearsals. “Don’t I know you from New York?” she asked.

“Yes, I gave you the poem at Sardi’s.”

“We loved it,” she said, “hung it in our basement and show it to all our friends!” Wonder if my poem will be in the book?
