Developing workforce housing in Rochelle

City receiving interest from developers looking at south side

ROCHELLE — Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said on Dec. 15 that the city has been approached by developers interested in bringing workforce housing to Rochelle.

Workforce housing is generally understood to mean affordable housing for households with earned income that is insufficient to secure quality housing in reasonable proximity to the workplace. It's geared towards families with income around the \$50,000 range.

"I think there's some very serious interest from some developers that we're familiar with and I would like to see that come to fruition," Fiegenschuh said. "At the very minimum, I want the city to be able to help in any way that we can and provide them an environment where they can do their project here in town."

Fiegenschuh said conversations with developers are in "very preliminary" stages and he declined to say whether they are local or not. He did say one group applied for some grants through the state and was awarded credits.

"That's really the first step, because those credits help pay for the project through the state," Fiegenschuh said. It's very early stages. We've been talking with them at this point about permitting and plat-

ting and things like that."

There is another developer looking at potentially doing some housing on the south side of town as well that wouldn't necessarily be workforce housing, Fiegenschuh said. That

would be multi-family housing and the city has had preliminary conversations with that individual as well.

Fiegenschuh said the city's role in those conversations is to answer

developers' questions and do what it can to keep the process as streamlined as possible and provide an environment where their project can happen.

City manager previews plans for 2022

Hickory Grove, south side among highest priorities

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle's 2022 plans include working to bring a housing development to town, finalizing the Hickory Grove project with demolition and development of the site, collaborating with other local organizations and finishing renovation of its new building on the south side and beautifying that area.

Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh spoke to the News-Leader on Dec. 15 about those projects and more that the city hopes to accomplish in the year ahead.

Fiegenschuh said the city has received potential interest in workforce housing in town along with other types of housing. A recent housing study outlined the need for more housing in town and solidified city staff's priority to see more of it.

"If there's interest, we'd like to partner with that," Fiegenschuh said. "The workforce housing and just housing in general, I'm excited to work on this next year."

The city council recently approved the demolition of the Hickory Grove facility that is slated to begin in late January and last until April. Seeing that work through and working on finding a developer for the site in the spring is another one of the city's 2022 priorities, Fiegenschuh said.

Also top of Fiegenschuh's mind for 2022 is continuing downtown improvements and continuing to push the expansion and reconstruction of Illinois Route 251 on the north side of town with the Illinois Department of Transportation, which manages the deteriorating roadway and has it on its future projects list.

Fiegenschuh also mentioned exploring the pos-

sibility of collaborating with other local units of government after recently finalizing a new school resource officer agreement with both Rochelle school districts.

"Maybe there's more

opportunities where we can collaborate with the schools or the county or township or park district," Fiegenschuh said. "We used to have these local government meetings where we'd all get

together once a month or once a quarter and then that just kind of died off right before COVID-19. Maybe getting back together and doing that."

Illinois continues to lose population

Census estimates show state lost more than 113,000 in one year

SPRINGFIELD — New estimates from the U.S. Census Bureau suggest Illinois is continuing to lose population.

The latest estimates, released Tuesday, pegged the state's population at 12,671,469 as of July 1, 2021, down by 113,776, or 0.9 percent, from the official 2020 census.

Several factors contributed to the change, but the single largest was domestic outmigration. According to the data, 122,460 people moved from Illinois to other states during the period from April 1, 2020, to July 1, 2021, while only 5,766 people moved into the state, a net loss of 116,694.

Those losses were offset by a net gain of 5,766 people through international migration as well as a "natural" increase of 2,778 people — the difference between in-state births and deaths during the period.

The Census Bureau routinely estimates national, state and county populations each year following a decennial census using a variety of data sources. But those estimates have been off in the past.

In 2019, for example, the Census Bureau estimated that Illinois had lost more than 51,000 people since the 2010 census while the official

2020 census showed the state had lost about only 18,000.

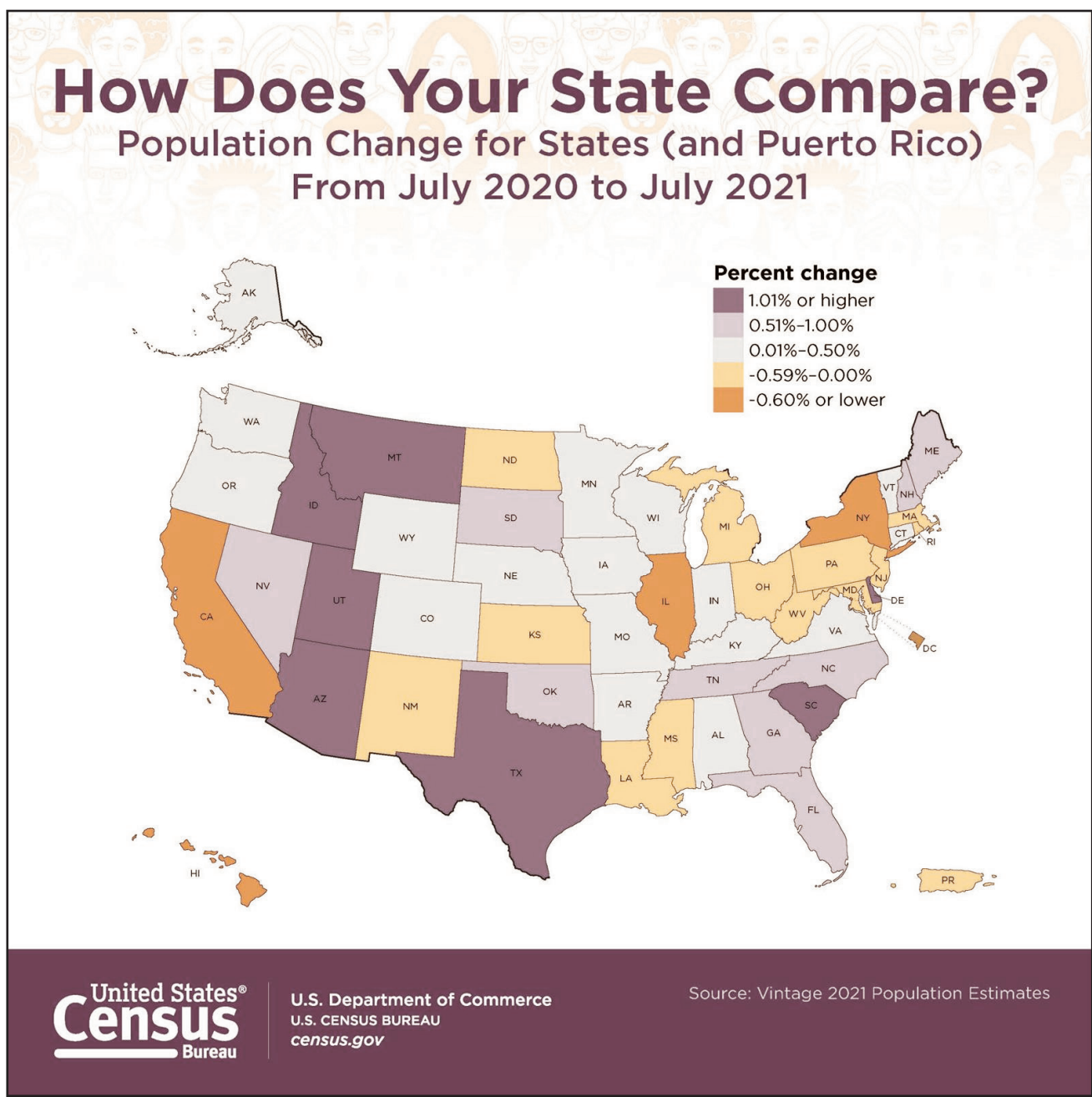
Still, the latest estimates for Illinois reflect broader national trends of decreased international migration, lower birth rates and increased mortality, due in part to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Overall, the Census Bureau said, the U.S. population grew by 444,464, since the 2020 census, or 0.13 percent, the lowest growth rate since the nation's founding.

"Population growth has been slowing for years because of lower birth rates and decreasing net international migration, all while mortality rates are rising due to the aging of the nation's population," Census Bureau demographer Kristie Wilder said in a news release. "Now, with the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, this combination has resulted in a historically slow pace of growth."

The estimates showed that both the Midwest and Northeast regions saw net population declines over the year while the South and West regions both gained population.

Over the past year, the Census Bureau said, the nation's population growth was due to a natural increase of 148,043, and net international migration of 244,622, marking the first time that net international migration exceeded natural growth.



Between 2020 and 2021, 33 states saw population increases and 17 states and the District of Columbia lost population. 11 of which had losses of more than 10,000 people. This is a historically large number of states to lose popula-

tion in a year.

On a percentage basis, Illinois had the third largest population decline, behind the District of Columbia, at 2.9 percent, and New York, at 1.6 percent. Idaho, Utah and Montana had the largest percentage increases.

On a numeric basis, Illinois also had the third largest population decline, behind New York and California. Texas, Florida and Arizona had the largest numeric population increases.

State assisting to battle surging COVID-19 cases

SPRINGFIELD — Local hospitals and health departments will get help from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to meet the healthcare demand during a COVID-19 surge, adding staffing to provide medical care and provide vaccines and testing.

The state will also help ramp up COVID-19 testing, now operating six days a week beginning Jan. 3 to increase availability.

"We are also increase testing and continuing to distribute monoclonal antibodies, anti-viral pills and any treatments or personal protective equipment communities need," Gov. JB Pritzker said during a news conference Monday. "I will continue to do everything possible to protect all the people of this state, whatever your vaccine status. But what kind of year 2022 turns out to be depends on all of us doing what is best for all of us."

Pritzker was on a call with President Joe Biden and the National Governors Association on Monday morning to discuss the response to the Omicron variant.

Illinois Department of Public Health Director Dr. Ngozi Ezike confirmed that Illinois is seeing higher hospitalization rates. The state is now averaging 500 hospital admissions a day



due to COVID-19. While Illinois was still battling the Delta variant of COVID-19, the Omicron variant was introduced a couple of weeks ago. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention said earlier this month that the Omicron variant is the dominate strain of COVID-19 in the U.S. with more than 73 percent of new cases attributable to the variant.

To protect from the COVID-19, harm reduction strategies will still need to be employed, Ezike said, like wearing masks, social distancing, hand-washing and staying away from large crowds.

"We have a vaccine that is highly effective at preventing severe illness and death," Ezike said. "Currently, we are seeing a demand for booster doses, but it is critically important for those who have yet to receive even one dose of vaccine to get vaccinated."

The vast majority of cases, hospitalizations and deaths are among the

unvaccinated, Ezike said. Those most at risk are more than 65 years old, suffer from heart, liver or kidney disease, are Immunocompromised or have diabetes.

Vaccine clinics will be held in Cook, DuPage, Lake, Will, Kane, St. Clair, McLean, Sangamon, Peoria, Winnebago, Jackson and Adams Counties. Anyone age 12 older can get a first or second dose at these locations.

Community-based testing sites will be open Monday through Saturday in Aurora, Arlington Heights, South Holland, Fairview Heights, Peoria, Bloomington, Champaign, Harwood Heights, Rockford and Waukegan.

New state laws taking effect Jan. 1

Minimum wage increase, pets in public housing among new changes

SPRINGFIELD—Minimum wage workers in Illinois will see a boost in their hourly pay to \$12 per hour starting Jan. 1, while tenants in affordable housing units will be allowed to keep pets.

Those are just some of the more than 300 new laws that take effect in the new year.

The minimum wage increase is actually the result of a 2019 law that phases in a state minimum wage to \$15 an hour by 2025. This year, it will increase by one dollar to \$12 an hour.

The law allowing public housing tenants to keep pets is the result of Senate Bill 154, by Sen. Linda Holmes, D-Aurora, and Rep. Stephanie Kifowit, D-Oswego. It provides that tenants of multifamily housing units that are acquired, built or renovated with money from the Illinois Affordable Housing Trust Fund may keep up to two cats or one dog weighing less than 50 pounds.

It applies to residents of housing units that are designated as affordable housing for low- and very-low-income families. The bill passed both chambers in its final form on May 30 and Gov. JB Pritzker signed it into law Aug. 6.

Other new laws include: SB58 raises the private vehicle tax, which is a sales tax paid on the purchase of vehicles, by \$75 for each model year where the purchase price is less than \$15,000 and by \$100 for vehicles priced above that amount. However, the registration fee for trailers weighing less than 3,000 pounds will drop to \$36

instead of \$118.

HB226, establishing the Higher Education Fair Admissions Act, prohibits public colleges and universities from requiring applicants to submit SAT, ACT or other standardized test scores as part of the admissions process, although prospective students may choose to submit them if they wish.

SB1682 requires pharmacies to post a notice informing consumers that they may request current pharmacy retail prices at the point of sale.

HB562 enacts several changes to the Firearm Owner Identification card law. Among other things, it provides for a streamlined renewal process for FOID cards and Concealed Carry Licenses for people who voluntarily submit fingerprint records. It also allows the Illinois State Police to issue a combined FOID card and Concealed Carry License to qualified applicants, and it establishes a new Violent Crime Intelligence Task Force to take enforcement action against people with revoked

FOID cards.

HB576 and SB1577 allow students in Illinois up to five excused absences to attend to their mental or behavioral health without providing a medical note. Those students will be given an opportunity to make up any work they missed during the first absence and, after using a second mental health day, may be referred to the appropriate school support personnel.

HB605 requires state agencies and institutions to purchase Illinois and American flags that are

made in the United States.

SB817 prohibits discrimination in schools against individuals on the grounds of wearing natural or ethnic hairstyles, which include dreadlocks, braids, twists and afros.

SB119 prohibits public health authorities from regulating or shutting down lemonade stands or similar operations that are operated by children under the age of 16. Known as "Hayli's Law," it was inspired by 12-year-old Hayli Martinez, whose lemonade stand in Kankakee was shut down

by local officials.

HB3922 recognizes June 19, or "Juneteenth," as an official state holiday that commemorates the end of slavery in the United States. In June, President Joe Biden also signed a bill designating Juneteenth as a federal holiday.

Local organizations receive CFNI grants

ROCKFORD — In Youth We Trust (IYWT), the youth philanthropy program of the Community Foundation of Northern Illinois, has announced the recipients of the Fall 2021 IYWT Adult/Nonprofit Grants cycle.

Seven organizations were awarded up to \$5,000 each for a total of \$19,500. This is the second time IYWT has awarded grants for proposals written by adults/nonprofit organizations, to benefit programs and projects that support youth in northern Illinois.

Ogle County's Pegasus

Special Riders program was awarded \$2,000 for a program expansion that will allow Pegasus to recruit more volunteers and include more riders in their riding program.

Farmworker and Landscaper Advocacy Project (FLAP), which operates in Ogle County, also received \$3,000 to help improve the health, wellness and educational stability of youth from low-income Latinx immigrant families in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson and Winnebago Counties by distributing technology, cash assistance to avoid

evictions, vaccination and workers' rights education for youth Latinx immigrant families.

Northern Illinois Food Bank received \$451 for its backpack program. NIFB is committed to increasing food access for 18,000 children in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson and Winnebago Counties who are facing food insecurity. The backpack program provides groceries to children by collaborating with 40 school and youth sites that offer a safe, convenient location for families to receive assistance. Children

gain access to consistent, healthy weekend meals so they can focus on their education rather than worrying if they will have enough to eat.

Other organizations that received grants include Regional Access and Mobilization Project (RAMP), Rock House Kids, Rockford Area Habitat for Humanity and Winnebago County CASA.

"The In Youth We Trust Council is excited to again offer two distinct grant cycles, which makes the impact on issues facing youth in our community

that much greater," Adalia Yeung, a senior at Rockford Lutheran High School and current IYWT council president, said. "It's an honor for council members to review proposals from so many incredible organizations and be able to award these grants which will directly support our peers across the region."

In Youth We Trust Council is made up of high-school-aged youth from across Northern Illinois. The program engages young people in community service and philanthropy. IYWT gives the council

members resources and opportunities to help solve problems affecting their peers and their quality of life. This year the IYWT Grant Programs will distribute up to \$40,000 in two grant cycles for youth-benefiting projects in the region. IYWT Council Members set grant policy, review youth-inspired service project proposals and recommend proposals for funding to CFNI's Board of Directors. Since its inception in 1994, In Youth We Trust has awarded more than \$500,000 for youth-led projects.

Micah found refuge in books and was an avid reader from a very young age. At the age of 20, he survived a second brush with death when he survived pancreatitis and went on to start a short career in over-the-road trucking. He loved traveling the country, but his physical condition deteriorated and he was soon diagnosed with Myotonic Muscular Dystrophy.

Over the last 10 years this condition took its toll and limited his movements considerably.

He grew up around steam traction engines and as a youngster learned to operate the family steam engines, another pastime he enjoyed while he could. Country music tunes were his favorite. 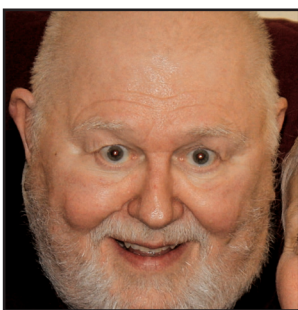
Steve and Claire, and two great-grandsons, Dexter and Milo.

HOUSING: Developers showing interest in Rochelle

“I’m excited about the interest,” Fiegenschuh said. “I think there’s some opportunity. I’m not a builder, it’s easy to talk about wanting these things when it’s not your resources that are out there. But maybe there’s some interest in some additional housing subdivisions in our community too. If there’s interest, we’d like to partner with that. The workforce housing and just housing in general, I’m excited to work on this next year.”

At its Nov. 8 meeting, the city council heard a presentation on preliminary findings of a Northwest Illinois Workforce Housing study from Daniel Payette of the Blackhawk Hills Regional Council. Payette said there’s next

to a zero percent vacancy rate for residential rental housing in the area and what used to rent for \$800 per month is now renting for \$1,200 a month and is less affordable. He added that despite current high costs of construction, there is a need for blue collar housing along with senior housing.

Fiegenschuh reacted to the preliminary findings of the study by saying more housing in town has been a priority for the city and will be in the future. He’s heard from residents during his tenure as city manager that the city needs more opportunities for housing for all levels of income.

Once final findings of the study are presented, the city plans to work on putting together a more structured plan to improve

housing in town.

Fiegenschuh previously said that before the COVID-19 pandemic, the city was in talks with housing developers about a development going out by Walmart that would’ve included workforce and senior housing. He said that didn’t pan out because the land wasn’t zoned for that type of use.

The demolition of Hickory Grove planned to start in late January could also result in more housing in town if the eventual development of the site goes that way. Fiegenschuh said developers have reached out about the property for some “higher-density” residential housing.

“It’s ultimately up to the mayor and council,” Fiegenschuh said. “It’s their property. The city owns it

and they’re in charge of the city. We had some retail interest as well. That’s why we want to make a

request for information. We want to see all of the proposals and ultimately let the mayor and council

determine what they think is the best fit on that highly-visible spot for the next 20-40 years.”

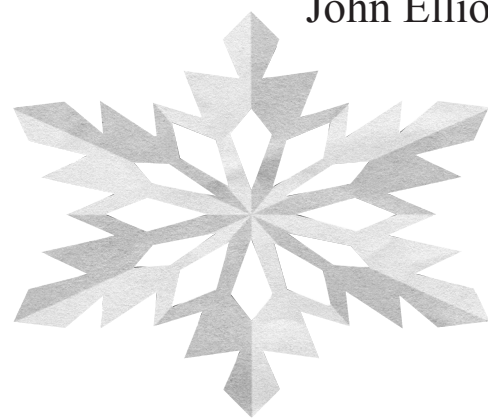

DMV facilities to close through Jan. 17

SPRINGFIELD — Due to an increase in COVID-19 cases statewide, Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White is announcing that all Secretary of State departments will not conduct in-person transactions — including Driver Services facilities — from Jan. 3 through Jan. 17. All departments and Driver Services facilities will reopen on Tuesday, Jan. 18. White is encouraging the public to visit ilsos.gov for online services.

Online transactions will remain open for all departments to conduct office services, including, but not limited to the following: renewing a license plate sticker, renewing

a driver's license or ID card for those who qualify (individuals may call 217-785-1424 to confirm their eligibility or to obtain their PIN), obtaining a duplicate driver's license or ID card, obtaining a driver record abstract and filing Business Services documents, such as incorporations and annual reports.

In addition, the drivers and vehicles services hotline phone number will remain open at 800-252-8980. Customers with issues involving administrative hearings may email adminhearings@ilsos.gov or call 312-793-3722 or 217-782-7065.

As a reminder, White has extended all driver's

license and ID card expiration dates to March 31, 2022. This extension does not apply to commercial driver's licenses (CDL) and CDL learner's permits.

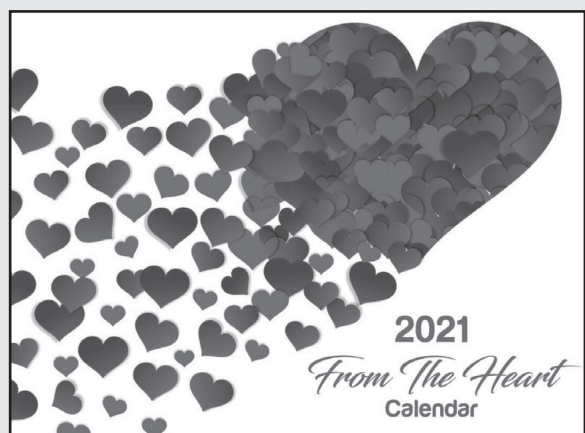
"After careful consideration and out of an abundance of caution, we have decided to close all Driver Services facilities beginning Jan. 3, 2022, through Jan. 17, 2022, due to the spike in COVID-19 cases," White said. "The health and safety of employees and the public remains paramount, and face-to-face transactions potentially increase the further spread of the virus. Our goal is to safely reopen all offices and Driver Services facilities

on January 18 for face-to-face transactions."

In addition, White greatly expanded remote renewal for driver's license and ID card holders. Since this fall, White's office mailed letters to eligible customers with expired driver's licenses and ID cards requiring them to renew online, by phone or by mail. The office estimates that this helps to eliminate the need for approximately 1 million people to visit a facility.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security has extended the federal REAL ID deadline to May 3, 2023.

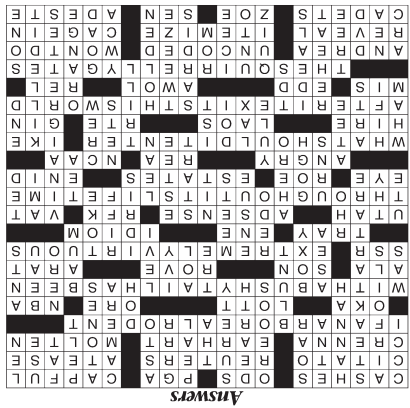

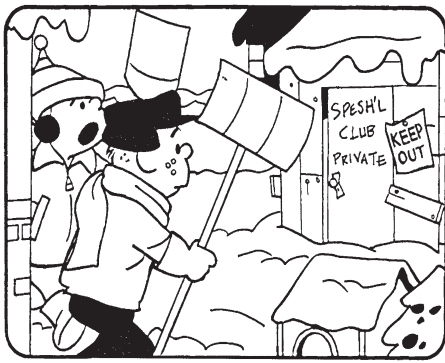

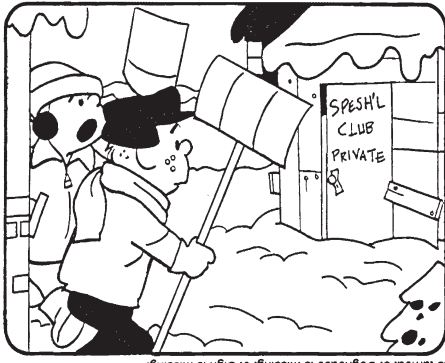

The city manager is also on the Rochelle Area Community Foundation board and is looking forward to participating in quarterly nonprofit leader meetings in the coming year that could give ideas of ways the city could help its residents.

"If there's things we're lacking for basic services, I'm not saying the city should start up the services, but if they're trying to start new services, are there things we can do as a city to help them?" Fiegenschuh said. "Just collaborating and working to do that."

After purchasing the former Johnson Tractor building at 1030 S. 7th St. over the summer, the city plans to renovate that facility and move more staff to it in 2022. Departments would include finance, utility billing, water/water reclamation and electric.

Fiegenschuh said he hopes to focus more attention on the south side of town and the city plans to do some additional beautification in that area along with focusing on its other corridors.

The city's 2022 will also include utilizing its staff in the best way possible.

"If any staff openings come up, we always recalibrate and look at how we can do things more efficiently," Fiegenschuh said. "Can we do cross training and combining positions and things like that? I have some ideas over the next couple of

years and I'd like to see us move in that direction too."

The city plans to hire two new police officers in 2022 with potential retirements coming up in the department. With all its departments, Fiegenschuh said succession plans and replacements are priorities.

"Because I do think the thing that makes an organization successful is having the right people in the right jobs and giving them the tools to be successful," Fiegenschuh said. "If we do have people move out of the organization, how do we replace them and do it with folks who should be

in those positions and who can make those positions even more successful?"

Fiegenschuh said economic issues dealing with the supply chain and the COVID-19 pandemic that have already been seen do make him nervous going into 2022. So far, low interest rates have allowed the city to fund a lot of

infrastructure projects with some short-term borrowing.

If interest rates start going up, the city will have to reevaluate or look at putting money in the bank and saving if interest rates are higher.

"I don't know if it's worrisome, it's just something we need to evaluate

as potential higher interest rates," Fiegenschuh said. "But inflationary pressures definitely worry me. Costs go up every year, but these inflationary pressures could potentially cause projects to be even more expensive. We've only got so many dollars. How do we stretch those dollars?"

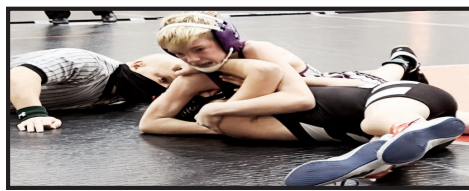

Lady Hubs win finale

Rochelle controls Sterling Newman 57-20 to conclude Dixon tournament

DIXON — The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity basketball team will enter the new year on a winning note after a dominant defensive performance against Newman Central Catholic on Tuesday.

Behind three double-digit scorers and a smothering full-court press defense, Rochelle shut down the Comets 57-20 to close out the KSB Dixon Holiday Classic. Freshman Kendyl Darby led the Lady Hubs with 12 points, while senior forward Abby Luxton scored 11 points. Junior Torrin Nantz added 10 points and converted two 3-pointers for the Rochelle offense in the win.

“It was important for us to get a win,” head coach Ryan McQuade said. “We talked before the game about not wanting to finish 0-3 in this tournament and wanting to get a win before the new year. We worked on a lot of things today and I thought our ball movement was a lot better. We came out with our press early in the game and we really took it to them.”

With several seniors including Lucy Bungler, Zoey Tabor and Jordin Dickey anchoring Rochelle’s full-court press, the Comets struggled to dribble the ball beyond the half-court line, with the Lady Hubs deflecting and stealing several errant passes to score easy layups at the basket. Rochelle’s strong defensive start allowed the team to build a 17-4 lead after the first quarter.

“I didn’t come out with the press right away because I wanted to see how we came out in terms of our energy,” McQuade said. “I wasn’t super pleased with our energy at the start of the game, but when we went with the press, we really started to ramp up the pressure and our energy was much better. We were able to take it to them for the rest of the first half.”

The Lady Hubs found success in the painted area during the second quarter, with Luxton hitting multiple low-post shots around the rim and sophomore forward Kennedy Adamski making a trio of mid-range shots near the free-throw line.

LAKE VILLA — The Rochelle Hub varsity wrestling team won all four of its matches at the Lakes Super Duals on Tuesday. Rochelle knocked off Carmel Catholic, Woodstock North, Cary-Grove and Prairie Ridge to move to 15-4 overall this season. Eight schools competed in the meet.

Carmel Catholic

The Hubs defeated Carmel Catholic 54-26 in the first dual of the meet. Corsair wrestler Matthew Lucansky won by fall to claim the 106-pound bout and Rochelle freshman Xavier Villalobos pinned Anthony Villanueva to win the 113-pound bout. Freshman Joseph Nadig and sophomore Riley Damask received forfeits in the 120-pound and 126-pound bouts for the Hubs.

August Monroe took a forfeit for the Corsairs in the 132-pound bout. Carmel Catholic scored another victory when Ethan Onan won the 138-pound bout with a 29-12 technical fall. Rochelle freshman Grant Gensler received a forfeit in the 145-pound bout and senior Caleb Nadig won

the 152-pound bout with a first-period pin. Freshman Brandyn Metzger took a forfeit in the 160-pound bout and sophomore Brock Metzger pinned Jake Roth to win the 170-pound bout.

Eli Melnick received a forfeit for the Corsairs in the 182-pound bout. Carmel Catholic recorded a 3-2 decision to win the 195-pound bout and Rochelle freshman Kaiden Morris pinned Patrick Lucansky to win the 220-pound bout. Junior Matt Dewey took a forfeit in the 285-pound bout.

Woodstock

The Hubs beat Woodstock North 59-24 in their second dual of the meet. Sophomore Jimmy Chavez took a forfeit in the 106-pound bout and freshman Xavier Villalobos pinned Nicholas Keisling in 50 seconds to win the 113-pound bout. Freshman Joseph Nadig needed only 35 seconds to pin Zechariah Vasquez in the first period and claim the 120-pound bout.

Woodstock North’s Waylon Schnulle won by fall in the 126-pound bout and Travis McClellan took a forfeit in the 132-pound

bout. Sophomore Alex Burke received a forfeit in the 138-pound bout for the Hubs and freshman Grant Gensler scored a second-period pin against Robert Carroll to win the 145-pound bout. Senior Caleb Nadig dominated the 152-pound bout against Jason Eismueller, totaling five takedowns and four near-falls to win by 19-4 technical fall.

Andrew Mohr pinned to win the 132-pound bout for the Trojans and Rochelle sophomore Alex Burke received a forfeit in the 138-pound bout. Freshman Grant Gensler faced Gavin Henriques in the 145-pound bout, recording three takedowns and two near-falls before winning by injury default in the third period. Senior Matt Eyster took a forfeit in the 152-pound bout and senior Caleb Nadig secured a second-period pin against Jeremy Strack to win the 160-pound bout.

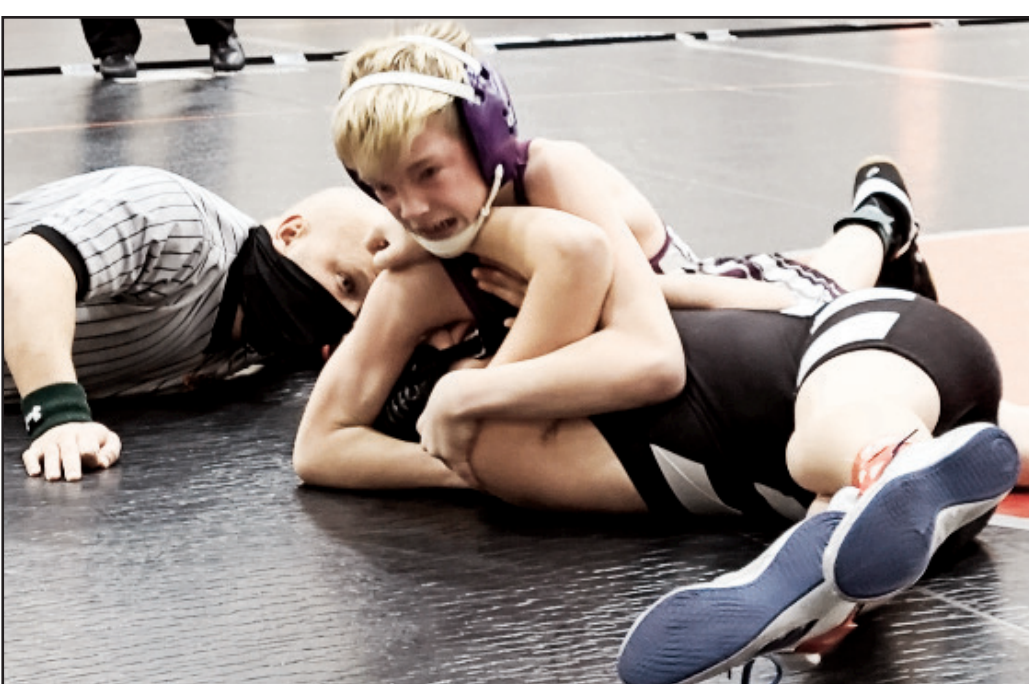

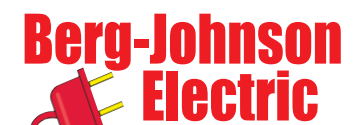

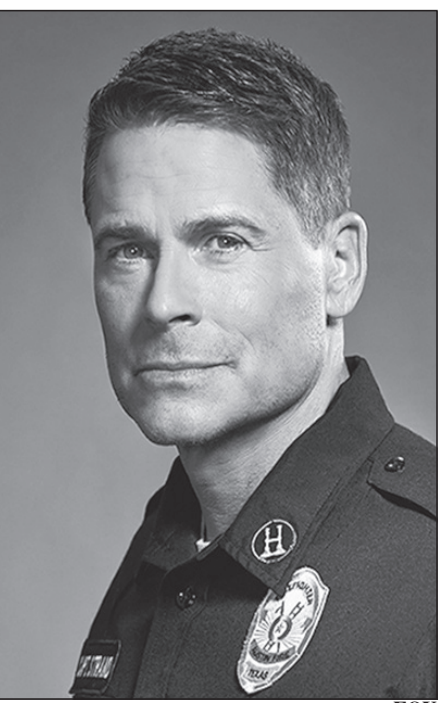
HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — “Twilight’s” **Edward Cullen** does “Batman,” and Harry Potter searches for “The Lost City.” “The Batman” is planned as a trilogy starring **Robert Pattinson** as The Cape Crusader, **Zoe Kravitz** as Cat Woman, **Paul Dano** as The Riddler, **Jeffrey Wright** as Commissioner Gordon, **John Turturro** as “Crime Lord” Carmine Falcone, **Colin Farrell** as The Penguin and **Andy Serkis** as “The Batman’s” butler, Alfred. All have signed on for the entire trilogy. **Daniel Radcliffe** joins **Sandra Bullock**, **Channing Tatum** and **Brad Pitt** in searching for “The Lost City,” due March 25. 

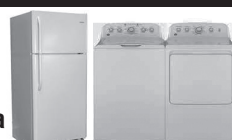
