Sawlsville aids in tornado response

Rochelle Fire Chief: 'The level of destruction was just crazy'

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Fire Department Chief Dave Sawlsville was called last Friday night to help with response efforts after an EF3 tornado struck an Amazon warehouse in Edwardsville, killing six and causing multiple injuries.

Sawlsville is part of an incident management assistance team for large-scale events that are going to last over a period of days. Officials like him are called to help relieve local command team members that have worked long hours.

"I was called and asked if I could go at 10 p.m. on Friday night," Sawlsville said. "I said absolutely. I went down with three other guys to try and support the fire chief and his command structure. They do the first response. We don't go and take over the scene. We're just there to help with anything they need."

When Sawlsville first got the call, there were up to 100 people stuck in the Amazon building. He was

updated during his trip to southern Illinois and by the time he got there, seven people were still unaccounted for. One was later found to be not at work that day and safe.

Sawlsville praised Edwardsville Fire Chief James Whiteford for his command of the situation.

"He had plenty of resources, good accountability and a good operation going," Sawlsville said.

"He'd also been at it for six hours by the time I got there. He was able to leave and get some rest and food. I'm sure he probably didn't sleep, nobody would be able to, but at least he was able to disengage a little bit and come back with some fresh perspective."

Sawlsville responded in a similar capacity to the ChemTool fire in Rockton in June. He was there and in Edwardsville to be an

extra pair of hands and eyes and to offer suggestions. In Edwardsville, first responders' plan was to find the last missing individual before turning the building back over to Amazon. They did just that. Sawlsville was relieved of duty and returned to Rochelle after about 30 hours in Edwardsville.

Rochelle's fire chief described the damage he saw at the Amazon facility. The

tornado didn't touch power lines that ran across the front of the building, but cut a path through the middle of the fulfillment center. There were intact buildings to the left and right, and a 100-yard path left in between by the tornado. On the back side of the building, "huge" tension power lines were "decimated" by the storm.

Miss Connie retiring after 25 years

'That's something to pass on to people, that love of reading'

ROCHELLE — Connie Avery was raised as a reader.

Growing up, everyone in her family was an avid reader. That's why she's been passionate about working in libraries for the past 47 years. On Dec. 31, the youth services/assistant director at the Flagg-Rochelle Public Library, affectionately known by kids as "Miss Connie," will retire after 25 years in Rochelle.

"That's something to pass on to people, that love of reading," Avery said. "Because once you have that, it opens up so much for everybody. You're wanting people to see that it's not a chore. That's one thing that I've been working towards, to get families to do that and develop that love of reading."

Before coming to Rochelle, Avery worked at a small library as director and was ready for a change. She happened to see an ad in some library

materials that the children's position was open at Flagg-Rochelle. She had never done children's services by itself before and thought it was a chance to try something different.

She came and interviewed and the rest was history.

Avery has been witness to a lot of change at the library as technology developed. She recalls checking out books the old

way with cards in pockets. There were only three computers in the building when she started.

She remembers when the library was "the only show in town" when it

came to activities and when summertimes were busier. Technology changes made the ways she interacted with kids evolve.

Elementary school board approves tax levy

Superintendent Harper: Fannie May sales yield \$39,606 profit for district

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Elementary School District Board of Education unanimously approved its 2022 tax levy at its monthly meeting Tuesday.

The levy is 4.91 percent and under a five percent increase in local revenue so a truth in taxation hearing is not required. At last month's meeting, District Business Manager Kevin Dale said the district is currently seeing a \$16 million Equalized Assessed Value increase from last year to this year in calculating its levy.

Superintendent Jason Harper said he had no new news regarding COVID-19 in his monthly school reopening update to the board. It was mentioned that the parent teacher organization's Fannie May chocolate sales resulted in the district selling \$92,414 in 6,601 boxes of candy. The district's profit is \$39,606.

"Thank you to Mr. Doyle and the building principals who have been working on that and I would say that parent volunteers are the ones handling the delivery and organization and those types of things and we've sent a note out to get that out as best we can starting tomorrow afternoon," Harper said. "With that many boxes,

we also ask for patience as we go through this for the first time."

There was no discussion of ongoing negotiations with the teacher's union on a new contract after multiple teachers spoke during public comment last month about

working on an expired contract. The board did meet in executive session and took no action following it.

The board also unanimously approved personnel changes to certified staff including the transfer of Heather Sweeney

from art/PE substitute teacher at Lincoln School to full-time substitute and the hirings of Katelyn Gabbard as a first grade teacher at Lincoln School and Saire Johnson as an art/PE/substitute teacher at Lincoln School.

Support staff person-

nel changes were also unanimously approved including the resignations of Kalynn Norris as a paraprofessional and Daniella Egland as an SEL paraprofessional (part-time), the retirement of Marla Bearrows from the cafeteria at

Rochelle Middle School and the hirings of Roxana Contreras (part-time Central School paraprofessional), Marisol Belmonte (special ed paraprofessional at Lincoln School) and Rebekah Nicolosi (lunchroom aide at Lincoln School).

"It's totally different," Avery said. "They're used to having a screen right in front of them and entertainment like that. When I've done story times and things, their attention spans are shorter. They can't sit and listen to a longer story anymore, so I use shorter stories and we do a lot of switching around. We read a couple of stories real quick and then we do some activities and then we keep doing different things."

Avery said it's been "very exciting" to see the way things have changed in the library due to technology and she's looking forward to seeing how it changes more in the future.

Miss Connie has been thinking about retiring for "a while," but just didn't see the opportunity with the library being busy and then COVID-19 hit.

"We were trying to work the library through that," Avery said. "We've had to make changes in what we're doing and offering and then I thought if I was going to do it, I should just retire. I made the decision and once I said it out loud, I had to stick with it."

Avery said she will miss the kids, staff and parents. But she plans to still be around and see people when she can. She's looking forward to being able to stay home when the weather is bad. She's excited to be able to read more "grown up" books now.

"While it's going to be hard, I will enjoy it," Avery said. "I've enjoyed my time here in Rochelle. I've made lots of friends in all kinds of ways. Sometimes I worked upstairs in the adult department. I've met a lot of people and that's fun. It'll be exciting to see people outside of the library."

County offering Christmas tree recycling

OREGON—The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department will partner with units of local government and certain high school Future Farmers of America (FFA) chapters to conduct the annual Christmas tree collection and recycling program.

Since the program began in 1999, there have been over 15,500 trees collected, with trees averaging around 50 pounds each, that equates to approximately 385 tons of tree material which were all turned into

usable mulch.

Starting on Dec. 26 the cities and villages that will have drop-off points include:

Oregon: Park District Maintenance Dept., 507 Hill St.; Byron: Byron boat launch lot, East Blackhawk Drive (Illinois Route 2); Forreston: 407 N. Locust St.; Leaf River: 605 Main St.; Rochelle: Atwood Park, 10th Avenue & 20th Street; Monroe Center: Lichty's Landscaping, 309 Pacific St. and Polo: southwest corner of East Colden Street

& South Green Avenue.

On Saturday, Jan. 8, 2022, local FFA chapters will provide curbside pick-up for trees. Remove all decorations, lights, plastic bags and place your tree at your curb by 8 a.m. This pick-up service will be offered in Byron, Forreston, Leaf River, Mt. Morris, Oregon and Polo. For Rochelle residents, the Rochelle Street Department will mulch trees at the curb during the first two weeks of January, weather permitting.

All trees should be free of light strands, garland and other decorations, no wreaths or other designs with wire backings and no artificial trees. Drop-off ends Jan. 23, 2022.


Megan is a 2010 graduate of RTHS and a 2014 graduate of Northern Illinois University. At NIU,

That same evening, deputies processed the crime scene, interviewed a suspect, obtained consent to search a location and subsequently recovered an

estimated \$850 in stolen property taken from the Casey's General Store.

The suspect, a juvenile, was arrested and transported to the Lee County Sheriff's Office where he was charged with burglary, a class two felony and criminal damage to property, a class four felony. The juvenile was processed and released to guardians, the release said.

The charges are merely an allegation, and all parties are presumed innocent until proven guilty.

Farm Bureau (IFB) Action Teams and the IFB Health Care Working Group, served as a delegate at the IFB Annual Meeting and participated in the IFB Leaders to Washington program, is a graduate of the IFB Agriculture Leaders of Tomorrow Program and much more. Sheaffer has been a farm bureau member for the last 48 years.

The Distinguished Service Award was established to honor and recognize an individual

or couple who has shown exemplary leadership and service to the farm bureau, agriculture and farmers in Lee County and beyond. Without the time, dedication, passion and vision from many hard-working volunteers like Sheaffer, the LCFB would not have lasted for more than 100 years.

The LCFB thanked Sheaffer for his continued service to the organization and is proud to recognize him as its Distinguished Service Award recipient.

2021 Ogle County Tentative Multiplier announced

SPRINGFIELD — Ogle County has been issued a tentative property assessment equalization factor of 1.0000, according to David Harris, director of the Illinois Department of Revenue said in a state press release.

The property assessment equalization factor, often called the "multiplier," is the method used to achieve uniform property assessments among counties, as required by law. This equalization is particularly important because some of the state's 6,600 local taxing districts overlap into two or more counties (e.g. school districts, junior college districts, fire protection districts). If there were no equalization among counties, substantial inequities among taxpayers with comparable properties would result.

State law requires property in Illinois to be assessed at one-third of its market value. Farm property is assessed differently, with farm homesites and dwellings subject to regular assessing and equalization procedures, but with farmland and farm buildings assessed according to standards based on productivity.

The equalization factor is determined annually for each county by comparing the sales price of individual properties sold over the past three years to the assessed value placed on those properties by the county supervisor of assessments/county assessor.

If this three-year average level of assessment is one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be one. If the average level of assessment is greater than one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be less than one. And if the average level of assessment is less than one-third of market value, the equalization factor will be greater than one.

Assessments in Ogle County are at 33.16 percent of market value, based on sales of properties in 2018, 2019 and 2020.

The equalization factor currently being assigned is for 2021 taxes, payable in 2022.

Last year's equalization factor for the county was 1.0000.

The tentative factor is subject to change if the County Board of Review takes actions which

significantly affect the county assessments or if local officials or others can present data showing that the Department of Revenue's estimates of the average level of assessments in the county should be adjusted. A public hearing on the tentative multiplier will be held between 20 and 30 days after the tentative factor is published in a newspaper of general circulation within the county.

A change in the equalization factor does not mean total property tax bills will increase or decrease. Tax bills are determined by local taxing bodies when they request money each year to provide services to local citizens. If the amount requested by local taxing districts is not greater than the amount received in the previous year, then total property taxes will not increase even if assessments may have increased.

The assessed value of an individual property determines what portion of the tax burden a specific taxpayer will assume. That individual's portion of tax responsibility is not changed by the multiplier.

"It's a big building," Sawlsville said. "They have to have water retention ponds. A car was picked up and thrown into one and there was building materials in there. The level of destruction was just crazy. Unfortunately, these days you see too much of it. There's weather changes where you're like, 'What in the hell is going on here? They have a tornado just outside of St. Louis in December?'"

The building did have storm shelters inside, but one of them was on the wall that the tornado hit, Sawlsville said. A concrete wall was broken off and folded over onto the shelter-in-place area. The 40-plus people who were able to get out afterwards were further into the building. "As soon as the fire

department was able to clear a path, 40 plus people walked out of that building," Sawlsville said. "Now you're like, 'My God, that's huge.'"

The six people that were lost in the disaster left an impression on Sawlsville.

"Two weeks from vacation, all these people were doing was their job," Sawlsville said. "They weren't doing anything stupid or crazy. They just showed up for work. It was just incredible sadness."

When called to larger incidents like the Edwardsville tornado, firefighters like Sawlsville go to help. But in every instance, they also learn something, he said. He never thought a tornado could snap a six-inch-thick cement wall in half.

Rochelle has buildings like that, too. Sawlsville plans to tell people locally

to put their shelters in the middle of their buildings and not against an outside wall. He said occupants are more likely to survive falling roofing that's lighter weight rather than a concrete wall.

Every time Sawlsville responds to a larger event, he has the chance to network and meet people with resources and expertise he didn't always think about beforehand. He cited seeing specially-trained dogs last week that could find where people were located under debris.

"More specialized things like that, those are connections you can make and it's a huge benefit," Sawlsville said. "And you go help your neighbor. It's a good feeling knowing if and when it's ever your time, they'll come and help you. I'm not sure you can put a price tag on that."

Defense shines in win

Lady Hubs shut down Sandwich 37-25 for first Interstate 8 victory of season

ROCHELLE — Defense has been an emphasis for the Rochelle Lady Hub varsity basketball team under first-year head coach Ryan McQuade. If Thursday’s Interstate 8 matchup against Sandwich was any indication, Lady Hub players have bought in on the defensive end.

Rochelle held the Indians to only 10 second-half points on Thursday, combining tough defense with a strong fourth quarter to defeat Sandwich 37-25. Freshman Kendyl Darby led the Lady Hubs (6-8, 1-3 Interstate 8) with 10 points, while Dickey followed with nine points and two 3-pointers made. The Lady Hubs limited Sandwich to just three fourth-quarter points. “I think we’re starting the season off pretty well,” Dickey said. “We’re playing really well as a team. I thought our man-to-man defense worked really well against them tonight, but I also thought we did well with our zone defense. Our help defense was really good as well.”

With Dickey and senior Lucy Bunger leading the defensive charge on the perimeter and 6-foot-1 senior Abby Luxton anchoring the

Lady Hubs inside, Rochelle successfully shut down Sandwich 6-footer Claire Allen, who was held to nine points on Thursday. Despite some struggles offensively, Rochelle’s defense forced several Sandwich turnovers and missed shots while creating easy scoring chances in transition. The Lady Hubs led the Indians 20-15 at halftime.

“It’s a big confidence booster for us to win this game,” Dickey said. “We feel more confident as a team when we’re winning more games and I think we play better as a team. I feel that as a senior, my role on the team is to show more leadership and be a leader for the underclassmen.”

Sandwich fought its way back into the game during the third quarter, bringing the Lady Hubs within two points and making the score 24-22 entering the fourth quarter. But Rochelle’s 13-3 run in the fourth quarter, which included a 3-pointer from Dickey and two transition layups from senior Zoey Tabor, allowed the Lady Hubs to seal their first conference win of the season.”

The Rochelle Lady Hub JV basketball team improved to 11-3 overall and 2-2 in the Interstate 8, defeating Sandwich 43-19.

Simmons, Aguirre lead Hubs over Genoa-Kingston

Rochelle snaps two-game losing streak with 67-55 win against Cogs

GENOA — Junior forward Raul Aguirre knew that he and his teammates on the Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team needed to bring more energy to the floor after losing five of their first seven games this season. Looking to snap a two-game losing streak against Genoa-Kingston on Wednesday, Aguirre and the Hubs returned to the hardwood with a newfound desire to win.

The 6-foot-5 forward strung together his best performance of the season, scoring 16 points while grabbing nine rebounds and blocking two shots as Rochelle defeated Genoa-Kingston 67-55 on the road. The Hubs (3-5, 1-1 Interstate 8) outrebounded the Cogs 48-31 in the win.

“We were definitely struggling at the beginning of the season,” Aguirre said. “We didn’t have a lot of energy during practice and at games, but we sat down and did some self-reflection. We brought more energy to the game on Wednesday and we picked up the tempo. My teammates definitely got me going and we were

getting all sorts of steals and deflections. I was able to knock down more shots as the game went on and I did my best to get my teammates involved.”

Genoa-Kingston opened the game with a 16-10 lead after the first quarter, but the Hubs dominated the second and third quarters, outpacing the Cogs 36-19 during that stretch to gain control of the nonconference matchup. Senior Ryan Simmons turned in an all-around performance on Wednesday, scoring 17 points with seven rebounds and three steals.

“It felt really good to get back on track,” Simmons said. “It definitely felt like we played as a team and that win was very important for us. Our team passed the ball around and we moved it well so everybody was getting open shots including me. I happened to be in the right place at the right time for all of them. My coaches expect a lot out of me and they expect me to lead.”

Senior Adam Kemp nearly recorded a triple-double for the Hubs, tot-

taling nine points, eight assists and 10 rebounds. Senior Noah Brown fin-

ished with nine points, two steals and five rebounds. Rochelle shot 45

percent from the field and outscored the Cogs 18-8 in second-chance points.

Jake Oates scored 18 points to lead the Genoa-Kingston offense.

Rochelle stuns Harvard with late-match rally

McBride, Villalobos score key victories as Hubs sting Hornets 35-34

ROCHELLE — Freshman Xavier Villalobos was well on his way to earning a technical fall against Harvard's Brian Hernandez during the Rochelle Hub varsity wrestling match Wednesday evening. But with Harvard leading Rochelle 34-23 and only one bout remaining in the match, Villalobos needed to deliver a pin to win the 113-pound bout and win the dual for his team.

Villalobos dominated the first and second periods, scoring three takedowns and two near-falls but coming just short of pinning Hernandez in each period. A third near-fall midway through the third period made the score 16-2 with a forfeit coming in the 120-pound bout, but with Harvard having the tiebreaker advantage, a technical fall would result in a Rochelle defeat.

With his teammates cheering from the bench, Villalobos successfully turned Hernandez over in the final moments of the third period, winning by fall and effectively sealing Rochelle's 35-34 dual victory over the Hornets. The Hubs improved to 7-2 on the season with the victory.

"I went out there and told myself I had to win," Villalobos said. "Then I had my coaches tell me with 15 seconds left in the second period that I couldn't tech him and that I had to pin him for

the win. At that moment, I told myself I had to go for it. I gave it my all and my coaches were really proud of me. These guys are like a family to me and it shows how much they trust me."

Harvard cruised through the early matchups, with Marquez Merida, Salvador Esquivel and Daniel Rosas each scoring pins in the 126-pound, 132-pound and 138-pound bouts before Ivan Rosas outlasted Rochelle freshman Grant Gensler for a 12-3 major decision in the 145-pound bout. Senior Caleb Nadig snapped Harvard's streak of 22 unanswered points, putting on a clinic with six first-period takedowns before pinning Kaden Vest to win the 152-pound bout.

Freshman Brandyn Metzger kept the Hubs going during the 160-pound bout, recording takedowns in each period for a 6-2 decision against Caden Scott. Freshman Jack Pavlak received a forfeit in the 170-pound bout, bringing Rochelle within seven points of tying the Hornets at 22-15. Sophomore Brock Metzger bumped up to the 182-pound bout, where Metzger battled against Gabe Sanchez before falling short in a 10-2 major decision.

With the Hubs trailing by 11 points, Rochelle sophomore Alexander McBride found himself locked in a tight contest against Edwin Quinones in the 195-pound bout. Despite trailing early in the match, McBride used

his opponent's aggressiveness to his advantage, countering missed shots with takedowns of his own to come back and send the match into overtime with the score 6-6. Another counter in overtime allowed McBride to win by 8-6 sudden victory.

"I knew we were down by a few points and I knew we had to win at least two

more matches," McBride said. "I wanted my opponent to shoot on me so I could roll and score my points, but he ankle-picked me a few times to get ahead... When I won the match, I knew that was one more match we needed for the team win. It's amazing for my confidence and I'm so proud of how we competed tonight. I thought

we did amazing and we all cheered for each other."

Harvard's Nathan Rosas took the 220-pound bout by 8-4 decision, with Hornet heavyweight William Harter pinning soon after to win the 285-pound bout. Trailing 34-17 after an unnecessary roughness penalty cost the Hubs one team point, Rochelle sophomore Tommy

Tourdout stepped up in the 106-pound bout, using only 15 seconds to pin Jose

Pichardo. With Villalobos pinning Hernandez in the 113-pound bout, Rochelle freshman Joseph Nadig received a forfeit in the 120-pound bout for the final six points of the non-conference dual to clinch the Rochelle win.

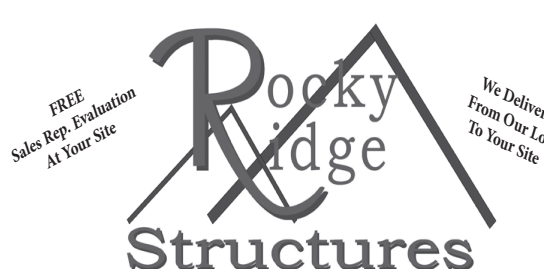

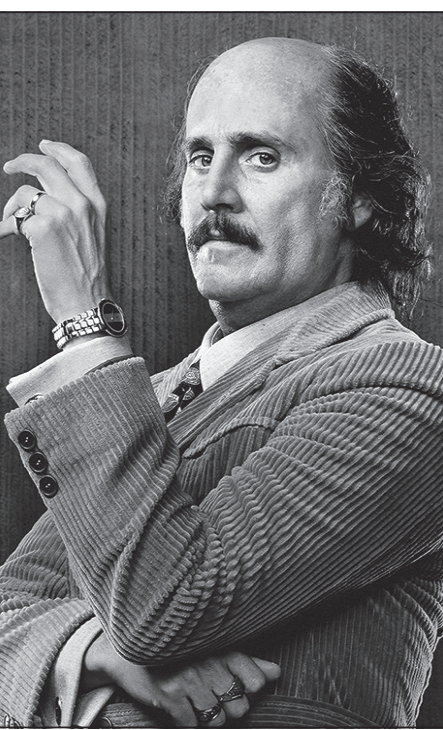
HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — **Jared Leto** won an Oscar for “Dallas Buyer’s Club” (2013) and proved he’ll go the distance for his characterizations. In “House of Gucci” (which opened Nov. 24), he’s unrecognizable playing **Paulo Gucci**. On his first day (deep in character), he ran into **Al Pacino** (playing Aldo Gucci) and said “Dad.” Pacino didn’t recognize him, thought he was a weirdo and walked away. Later, Leto saw him again and said, “Father.” Pacino was rushing away until another cast member whispered, “That’s Jared.” Pacino turned, arms stretched out, and said “son!”

Leto also has “Morbis” (in IMAX), due Jan. 28, with former “Doctor Who” and “The Crown’s” **Matt Smith**. Morbis suffers from a rare disease and tries a dangerous cure that turns him into a vampire. What woman wouldn’t want him nibbling on her neck? Sequels are already in the works. Leto next stars for director **Aron Aronofsky** in “Adrift,” about a fishing boat crew discovering a ghost yacht in open sea (coming Aug. 19). Leto pursued the rights for 10 years and brought it to Aronofsky and **Jason Blum**; now all three are producing.

Meanwhile, **Lady Gaga** is getting a **Cher** “Moonstruck” Oscar buzz for “House of Gucci.” Critics are saying the film has a “‘Godfather’ vibe” and that Gaga is “incredible,” as is **Jared Leto**. Director **Ridley Scott**, a three-time Oscar director nominee for “Thelma & Louise” (1991), “Gladiator” (2000) and “Black Hawk Down” (2001) and as a producer of “The Martian” (2015), has never won, though he did win an Emmy and was knighted in 2003. Scott is currently prepping yet another remake of “The Boston Strangler” (which starred **Tony Curtis** in 1968 and **David Faustino** of “Married With Children” in 2008). **Keira Knightly** plays the reporter who pursues the case, with co-stars **Chris Cooper** and **Alessandro Nivola**. Ridley Scott’s recent “The Last Duel,” with **Matt Damon**, flopped.

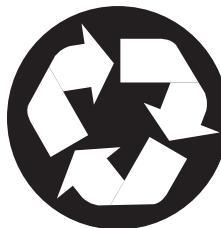

Lady Hubs score win over Sterling

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity bowling team scored another victory this week, rolling over the Sterling Golden Warriors 2,454-2,250 and improving to 3-4 on the season. Freshman Cassidy Vincent led Rochelle with a match-best 582 series.

The Lady Hubs took the series lead early in the match, winning the first game 846-756 behind Vincent's 194 and 166 from sophomore Faith Adams. Brendy Gatica and Hannah Conderman rolled 160 and 158 for Sterling.

Rochelle extended its lead with a 821-760 victory in the second game. Vincent fired a match-best 206 for the Lady Hubs, while senior Zoe Rourke scored 156. Rochelle swept the match with a 787-734 win in the third game behind 182 from Vincent and 145 from senior Anna Samo.

NIU Football

Huskies sign 16 new players

12 freshmen, four transfers joining program

ORLANDO, Fla. — Northern Illinois University football head coach Thomas Hammock announced the signing of 12 freshmen and the addition of four transfers to the NIU roster for 2022 Wednesday during the December signing day. Hammock made the announcement from Orlando, Florida, where the 2021 Mid-American Conference Champion Huskies are preparing to face Coastal Carolina in Friday's Tailgreeter Cure Bowl.

"We are certainly excited about the class," Hammock said. "We needed to be very strategic with how we put our class together, knowing that we have a lot of guys coming back with multiple years of eligibility. So, we were looking for guys that we can develop, as well as looking for some instant impact guys from the transfer portal, guys that we felt we can plug in and play or add competition at spots where needed to make sure we enhance."

The largest position group represented in the newest group of Huskies was at wide receiver where NIU added four freshmen and a pair of transfers. Defensively, NIU added four freshmen defensive backs and three linebackers, including one transfer. The rest of the group included an offensive lineman, defensive lineman and quarterback.

"There were some areas that we want to make sure we focused on, wide receiver being one, that we want to make sure we added the right type of talent in that room where we can

make it more competitive and try to become a more explosive offense," Hammock said. "We want to give [QB] Rocky [Lombardi] a lot of options and weapons for next season, and so we really wanted to hone in on that position. Defensively, we were looking for guys that can take the ball away, make plays on the ball, be dynamic and disruptive. Those were really the two areas that we wanted to focus on in this particular class to continue to build our team the right way."

While continuing to add players who will make an impact — whether in 2022 or beyond — Hammock noted that the most important "recruiting" continues to be developing the student-athletes currently on the roster.

"How we look at recruiting is we have to constantly recruit our own team," Hammock said. "That's the most important thing I talk to my staff about. Don't worry about somebody that's not here, recruit the kids in our program, make sure they have a positive experience, make sure they're having a great time on the field and off the field. If we can continue to do that, we can continue to be able to stack good seasons. The players in our program right



now are the most important recruits that we have."

Also critical to Hammock is the Huskies' walk-on program. At least five players who walked on to the program were awarded scholarships during the fall semester, and Hammock said the benefits of rewarding players already on the roster is the knowledge and information the coaches see in working with them every day.

"A big part of the recruiting process for us is our walk-on program," Hammock said. "What people don't realize is sometimes you take a walk-on and award a scholarship and that means you take a scholarship from the next class. For

example, Mason Blakemore is a young man that walked on and got a scholarship, as a result, we didn't sign a back — yet. We have more information about the young men already in our program, than kids in high school or at other schools. So if we think someone has a chance, we will reward that young man with a scholarship because we have the most information about him."

NIU claimed its sixth MAC Championship in 2021 while fielding the second-youngest roster in the Football Bowl Subdivision. The Huskies historic turnaround included seven "one-score" wins and a 41-23 victory over Kent State in the MAC Championship.
