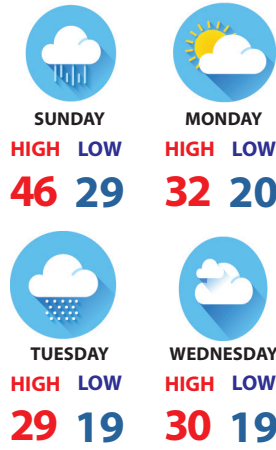

Bearrows plans to run for second term

'I truly enjoy what I'm doing and it's been very gratifying'

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows said Wednesday that he plans to run for a second term in 2023. Bearrows was elected in 2019 after serving on the Rochelle City Council. He cited his desire to see projects from his first term completed as part of his reasoning for running again. Among the projects mentioned were work on housing and seeing a daycare open and operating in the city.

"I want to see COVID-19 behind us and do some more of the things that a mayor does," Bearrows said. "Like when you work on projects and meet with developers, you become restrained when people are nervous about getting together. Yeah you can do Zoom meetings, but it's good to get in a room and kick ideas around. And with people like housing investors, they've been reluctant to invest due to uncertainty of the market. But I think things are starting to get better."

The pandemic started just after the beginning of

Bearrows' term. He's proud of the work the city has done during it.

"During the pandemic, our staff and leadership

have been supportive of our COVID-19 programs," Bearrows said. "Getting through that was as important as anything we've done.

I'm very proud of what we did. Those were things that we had to do. I was getting my feet planted as mayor just before the pandemic.

I did what I needed to do. I think we came through it well as a community."

Police bill mandates take effect Jan. 1

Chief Higby & Sheriff VanVickle: Larger changes still looming

ROCHELLE — Some changes to police work that stem from a bill signed in February will take effect Jan. 1 and impact the Rochelle Police Department and the Ogle County Sheriff's Office.

Both Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby and Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle were against House Bill 3653 included eliminating cash bail within two years, allowing the use of deadly force only when an officer acts in self-defense or defending others from bodily harm and mandated the use of police body cameras for all officers by 2025.

A trailer bill (House Bill 3443) passed over the summer relaxed rules around body cameras, removed some use-of-force restriction language and extended deadlines for new training standards. Higby said Jan. 1's changes will mainly include training man-

dates, as other parts of the bill don't take effect until later years or are still up in the air with lawmakers.

RPD is still waiting on guidelines for training on use of force and other changes and a curriculum will have to arrive on Jan. 1. Higby said he's heard most of the training will be offered online outside of use of force, which has to be in person.

"I think it will all be clear, I'm glad most of it can be online," Higby said. "With in-person, the mobile training units can only be in so many places and have a number of classes. Online makes sense. I don't think it'll be a stressor for us. Training was changing even before this bill. It's just a steady progression."

VanVickle said the biggest of the Jan. 1 changes is the first implementation of the body camera requirement, but that won't impact this area yet. Based on population, Rochelle would start in 2025 and the county would in 2024.

A rule that will take effect Jan. 1 that VanVickle has concerns about involves those arrested and in custody now being allowed three phone calls from their personal phone.

"The issue for us is not that they can do that, but who they can call," VanVickle said. "They're allowed three to whoever they want in their personal cell phone. Say we arrest someone for domestic battery, they can call the

victim three times and have conversations with them and that's a concern for us."

VanVickle says that could be changed in a vote in January and along with other things. His office is "not making many policy changes" due the bill because it anticipates more changes.

As far as body cameras, VanVickle said his office has not started to budget for them yet, but it did add in-car cameras over

the summer, which is part of the process for body cameras.

Higby said RPD is looking at starting to budget for body cameras and was told by a representative of a company that sells them that ordering early would be wise.

"We will budget for it in 2023 and implement it in late 2024," Higby said. "We want to be ahead on everything."

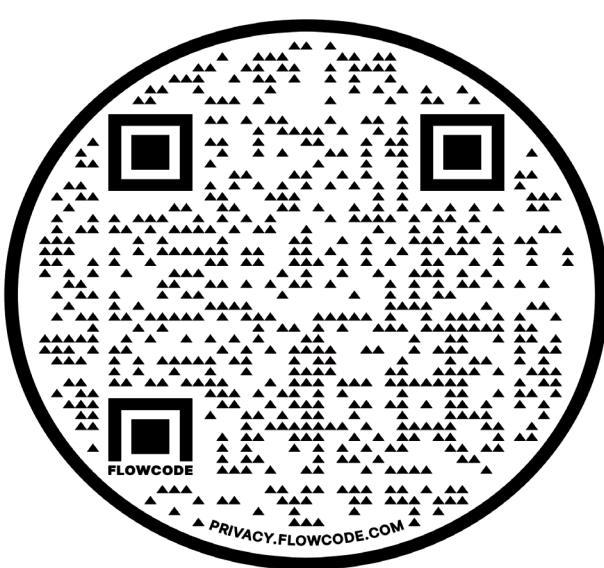

Application open for 2021-22 CFNIL scholarship cycle

ROCKFORD — Dec. 1 was opening day for the Community Foundation of Northern Illinois (CFNIL) scholarship application. With just one online application students access over 90 unique scholarships awarding more than \$350,000 this year alone. The application, accessed at <http://cfnil.org/scholarships> will close Feb. 1, 2022.

Each of CFNIL's scholarships were established by individuals or organizations that recognize the importance of helping

students achieve their educational goals, now and in perpetuity. The donors selected the criteria for each scholarship, based on their interests and the community's need.

CFNIL scholarships are for students in Boone, Ogle, Stephenson and Winnebago Counties and each scholarship has unique criteria. There are scholarships for graduating high school seniors, non-traditional students, students with financial need, student athletes, students of color and students pursuing careers in teaching, STEM, business, fire science and healthcare. Some scholarships are renewable for up to four years. The diversity of scholarship offerings reflects the diversity of CFNIL's donors and the communities of northern Illinois.

"Administering a scholarship program is a privilege on many levels: helping students across our region achieve their educational aspirations, honoring the generosity of generations of donors, and seeing first-hand the dedication and care of over 100 community volunteers as

they review applications," CFNIL President Dan Ross said. "Investment in the students of northern Illinois is truly an investment in our future, and year after year the exceptional efforts of these students, revealed through their scholarship applications, reassures us that our future is in very good hands."

All scholarship applications must be submitted through CFNIL's online application portal. Once registered for the portal, students answer questions about their academics, background and extracurricular activities. From these answers, applicants will be automatically matched to all scholarships for which they are eligible.

Applications are read and scored by committees of volunteers who use a "blind" review process and make award recommendations to CFNIL's Board of Trustees. Scholarship recipients are announced in late April. Awards are sent directly to the school the recipient will be attending.

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Township High School speech team opened its 2021-22 season hosting its novice tournament.

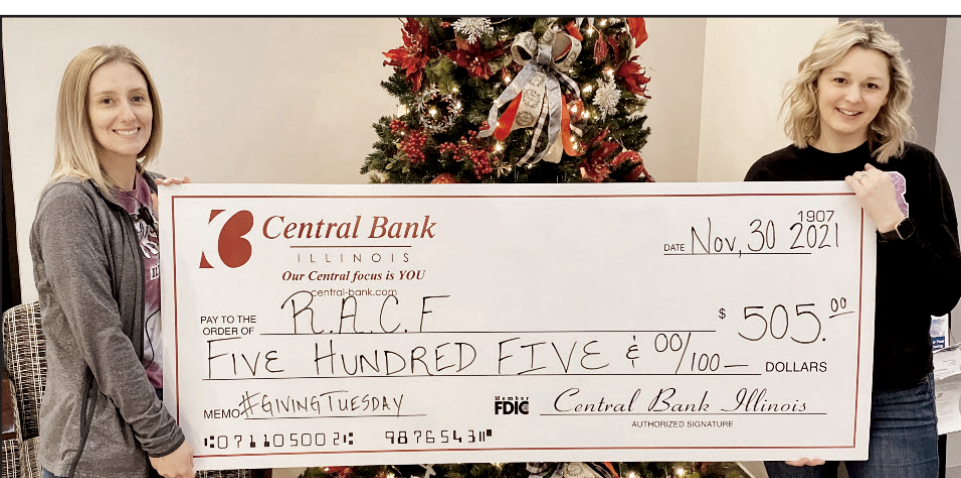
Of the nine schools competing, Rochelle earned second place in the team competition.

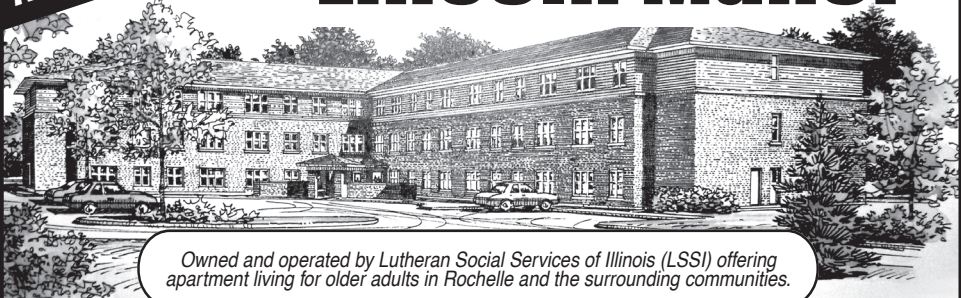

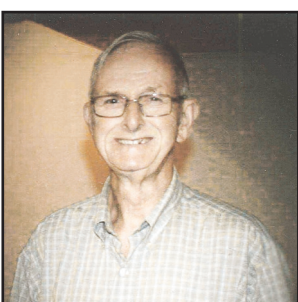

Mr. Detig served as past president and director on the pork producers association board of directors and was involved in 4-H youth activities in Ogle County.

These scholarships are in addition to the \$1500 Del Flessner Memorial Scholarship, honoring the former manager of the Ogle County Farm Bureau; and two \$1,000 General Farm Bureau Scholarships.

The George R. LeFevre Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship funded by the Jeff and Joyce Tremble Family and the Farm Bureau. It recognizes Mr. LeFevre for his lifetime of service to agriculture and youth education in Ogle County. It will be awarded to a recipient studying in a field of agriculture.

The Mary R. LeFevre Memorial

Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship funded by the Jeff and Joyce Tremble family and the farm bureau. It recognizes Mrs. LeFevre for her dedicated service in the healthcare

profession and involvement with youth education. It will be awarded to a recipient studying in a healthcare related field.

Finally, an Ag Technology Scholarship will be awarded in an amount of \$1,000. It will be awarded to students studying in an ag technology field similar to diesel mechanics, crop technician or similar fields of study.

Eligible applicants must meet the following criteria: must be a high school graduate; must be an Ogle County Farm Bureau member or dependent of a member; must be accepted at an accredited university or college and pursue an agricultural or agricultural-related field of study; must be a resident of Illinois and must demonstrate a financial need.

Applicants can be graduating high school seniors or students currently enrolled in an accredited college or university.

Applications successfully completed and submitted will be judged on criteria including: academic performance, demonstrated interest in agriculture, financial need and character/personality.

Those interested in receiving a scholarship application should contact the Ogle County Farm Bureau at 732-2231; or stop by their office at 421 W. Pines Rd. in Oregon. Applications can also be downloaded by visiting our website at www.oglefb.org

All applications and accompanying materials must be received no later than April 1, 2022.

Agriculture students and Illinois Farm Bureau (IFB) members, spouses and children are eligible to apply for 82 college scholarships offered by the IAA Foundation, Illinois Farm Bureau's chari-

table arm. The scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 to \$7,500, will be awarded in total of \$159,500 for the 2022-23 school year.

Students may apply for a variety of scholarships, including three IAA Foundation Top Scholarships, where winners will each receive \$5,000 awards. Another \$7,500 award goes to the Illinois Farm Bureau Legacy of Leadership scholarship winner. VanVickle said the changes made to the original bill since it was signed have made things “more palatable” for law enforcement, but new laws benefiting criminals is a problem for him. He cited the elimination of cash bail that will take effect Jan. 1, 2023.

“After that takes effect, the taxpayers will be fully funding the judiciary,” VanVickle said. “Cash bail money has been helping with costs for decades and now that money will be gone. Besides the monetary aspect, look at what happened nearby in Waukesha.

Somebody was let out on too low of a bond. Now there won’t even be a bond. People currently sitting in jail for things will now be out before their paperwork is even done.”

Removing qualified immunity for law enforcement officers is still a part of HB 3653 that is up in the air. It protects officers civilly and personally from lawsuits related to actions on the job. Higby believes if qualified immunity went away, it would be a “big deal.”

“I do have concerns about retirements if qualified immunity goes away,” Higby said. “We have six of us in the department that are over 20 years in. Those

with a few years left would be more likely to get out. We have 21 officers. Take six out, and that’s a big chunk. And it’s difficult to get qualified applicants for open positions.”

VanVickle said his office has concerns about potential retirements due to changes and it has already seen people retire who “weren’t quite ready to” due to how policing has changed. He’s seen it happen in the wider world of law enforcement as well.

“We lose institutional knowledge,” VanVickle said. “And it shouldn’t go unnoticed that 16 sheriffs have retired early. That’s unheard of. That should say

something. That should tell citizens there’s an issue.”

The Ogle County Sheriff said HB 3653 has already changed law enforcement and “without a doubt” will continue to. Higby said it’s “tough to say” what the extent of the changes will be at this point.

“If qualified immunity goes away, it’s a big change,” Higby said. “If it stays, I don’t see much of an impact. Training was already ramping up. It will change how we do some things. Like the cannabis legalization and concealed carry, people were scared about it being a big change but it ended up being a minimal impact.”

Bearrows said there are several things he’s proud of that have been accomplished during his term. They include working on opening another railroad transload station after Global III closed, seeing Project Jackpot fill the Nippon Sharyo buildings, pushing utilities under both Interstate 88 and 39 for the new Love’s and Pilot truck stops, a boundary agreement with the Village of Creston, purchasing the old Johnson Tractor building to consolidate city staff and approving an intergovernmental agreement with Ogle-Lee Fire for a training facility for fire, police and Rochelle Municipal Utilities employees.

“There’s a lot going on and I’m excited about a second term,” Bearrows said.

Bearrows called his time as mayor so far “very gratifying.” He said he was “totally embraced” by city staff and they’ve made his work as mayor easy.

“We have a great team,” Bearrows said. “We have the right people in the right places.”

Years before serving as mayor and as a council member, Bearrows lived outside of the city limits. He recalls when he used to say he should move into town and run for office.

“I always wanted to,” Bearrows said. “And then I did and ran for city council and it felt right. I wanted to provide leadership. I feel I have. I truly enjoy what I’m doing and it’s been very gratifying. I want myself and my kids to be able to look back on what I’ve done and helped to do as mayor and be proud of it.”

No injuries after car strikes U.S. Post Office building in Creston

CRESTON—No injuries were reported Thursday after a car accidentally struck the Creston Post Office at 111 N. Main St. just before noon.

RTHS Wrestling

Hubs take down Marengo

Senior captain Nadig leads Rochelle to 52-17 win over Indians

ROCHELLE — Caleb Nadig has taken on a much larger leadership role with the Rochelle Hub varsity wrestling team this season. The only senior in the varsity lineup and the lone captain on the team, Nadig looks to set an example for his teammates each time he steps on the mat.

Those teammates include Caleb’s freshman brother Joseph who, like his older brother, entered Wednesday’s nonconference dual against the Marengo Indians with two victories this season. The two brothers were each winners again on Wednesday, with Caleb and Joseph each pinning their respective opponents as the Hubs cruised over the Indians 52-17 and moved to 2-1 overall.

“I just try to lead by example and let my work ethic speak for itself,” Caleb said. “I work as hard as I can every day and I think my teammates can see that. I think they can see the intensity that I wrestle with and they can carry that into their matches. It’s a great feeling to see Joseph out there and I’m really happy for him. I’ve been dreaming about wrestling with

him for years.”

Sophomore Tommy Tourdot scored Rochelle’s first points of the dual, pinning Marengo’s Gavin Prudlick in the 106-pound bout before freshman Xavier Villalobos totaled two takedowns, two reversals and one near-fall for an 11-1 major decision against Dakotah Nelson in the 113-pound bout. Joseph Nadig then stepped in to wrestle the 120-pound bout against Robel Addis, winning with a second-period pin to put the Hubs ahead of the Indians in the match 16-0.

Marengo claimed the next two matches, with Matthew Rose winning the 126-pound bout and Ethan Struck winning the 132-pound bout for 11 unanswered points. Trailing 5-4 in the 138-pound bout against Logan Miller, freshman Grant Gensler scored a third-period takedown to win via 6-5 decision before Caleb Nadig pinned Mason Lampe in the 145-pound bout.

“We have a lot of underclassmen but I think they’re going to get stronger as the season progresses,” Nadig said. “I think those guys have a lot of potential to rise through the ranks and become the next leaders of the team. We’re working

hard to make each other better in practice every day and I think we’re doing a good job of creating team unity and supporting each other the best we can. I want to see us continue to work hard and push each other.”

Senior Matt Eyster and freshman Brandyn Metzger

took the 152-pound and 160-pound bouts via forfeits to extend Rochelle’s lead to 37-11. The Hubs etched out decisions over the next two bouts to seal the dual victory, with sophomore Brock Metzger outlasting Maverick Quatrokro by 3-1 decision in the

170-pound bout and junior Troy Papke holding off Devin Storti for a 3-0 decision in the 182-pound bout. Marengo’s Rune Boyd pinned to win the 195-pound bout.

“I think the sky is the limit for our team,” Nadig said. “I think if we work

as hard as we can, we can do great things this year. I think we could be in a position to make a run in the regional and possibly the team sectional and team state tournaments if we continue to improve.”

Lady Hubs suffer narrow loss against Ottawa

Rochelle takes two games as Pirates hang on for 11-pin series win

ROCHELLE — Only 11 pins separated the Rochelle Lady Hub varsity bowling team from knocking down the Ottawa Lady Pirates for the team’s second consecutive victory on Thursday.

The Lady Hubs won the first and third games of the three-game Interstate 8 Conference series, but a tough second game allowed Ottawa to hold off Rochelle by a final score of 2,348-2,337. Senior Alyssa Mickley rolled a 489 series, while freshman Cassidy Vincent added a 483 series.

“I thought the girls had a great week,” head coach Eric Widick said. “I’m very pleased with the way our girls started the season. I thought we were a little tight tonight, but this was our first home meet and we have some new bowlers on the team so I thought there were some nerves.”

Rochelle (1-1) started strong in the first game, winning 760-736 behind 170 from Mickley and 168 from Vincent. Ottawa’s

McKenzie Lewis stepped up for the Lady Pirates in the second game, shooting a match-best 206 to lead Ottawa over the Lady Hubs 822-757. Vincent fired 162 in the second game, with Mickley and senior Alyssa Schwanert each recording 149 for Rochelle.

“Alyssa [Mickley] has stepped back into form pretty well and what I’ve appreciated from her is she’s leading the other girls and keeping them going,” Widick said. “I saw her encourage our girls when they were struggling tonight. Alyssa [Schwanert] is still rounding into form, but I know she’ll settle down and once one of our players gets going, our entire team gets going.”

The Lady Hubs fought back in the third game, defeating Ottawa 820-790 but falling 11 pins short of winning the three-game series. Mickley recorded three straight strikes near the end of the third game to finish with 170, while Vincent struck out in the final frame to score 153.

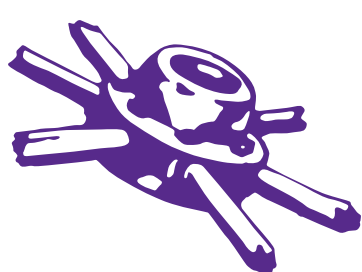

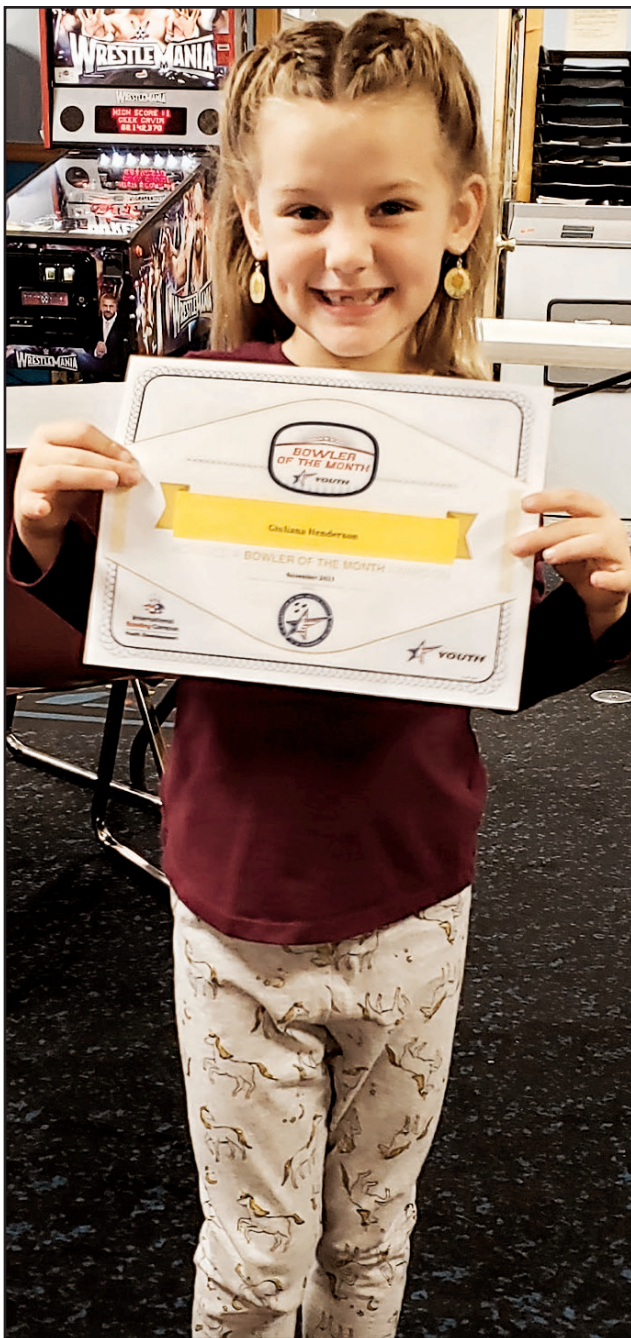

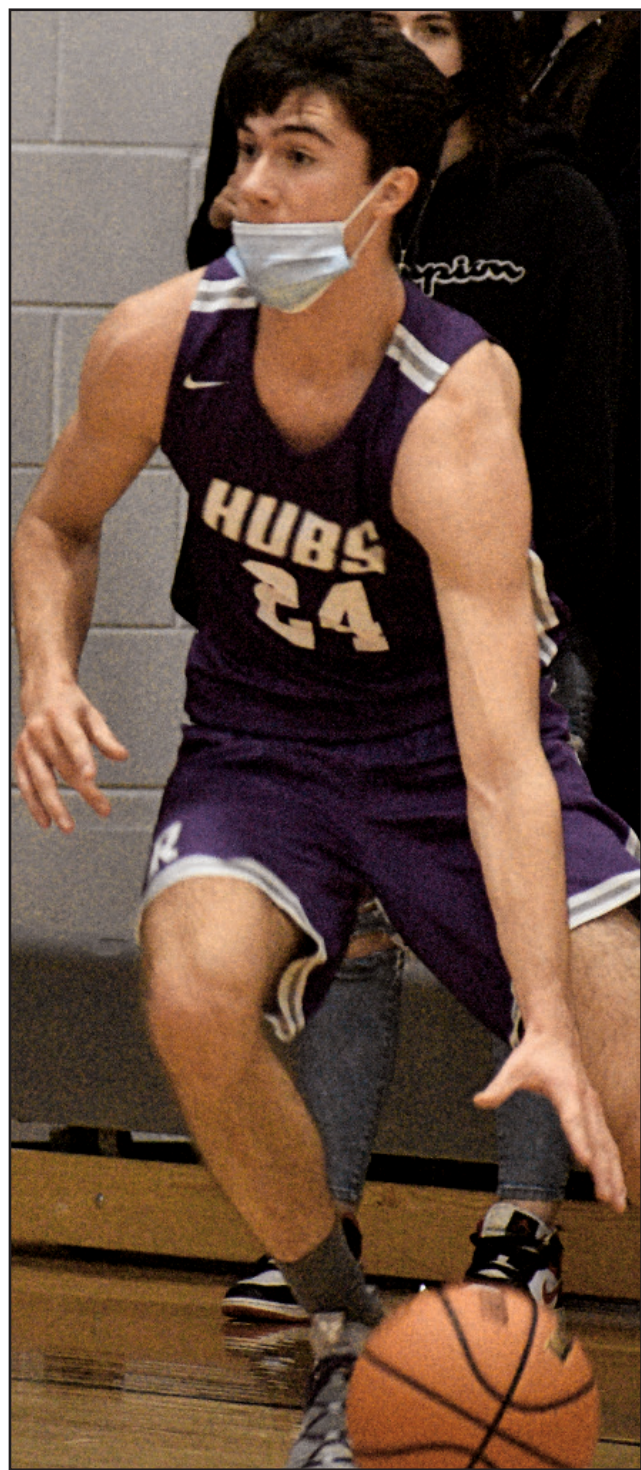
Hubs rally for win at Kaneland

HOLLYWOOD — While most stars are going back to work after two years of the pandemic, **Ryan Reynolds** plans to take the next year off. His newest film, the \$200 million “Red Notice,” co-starring **Dwayne Johnson** and **Gal Gadot**, opened Nov. 12, while his August release, “Free Guy,” earned \$331 million. Next up are Netflix’s “The Adam Project,” starring **Jennifer Garner**, **Zoe Saldana**, **Mark Ruffalo** and **Catherine Keener**, opening in 2022, and Apple TV’s \$75 million film “Spirited,” with **Will Ferrell** and **Octavia Spencer**. Both are in post-production.

We became aware of Ryan when he starred in the TV series “Two Guys, a Girl and a Pizza Place” (1998-2001), then came his breakthrough film, the title role in “National Lampoon’s Van Wilder” (2002). Five films later, playing George Lutz in “The Amityville Horror” clinched his stardom. In 2011, “Green Lantern” flopped and nearly derailed his career, but it was “Deadpool” (2016), which he co-produced, and its sequel, “Deadpool 2,” that each grossed \$785 million and made him very rich. Among the businesses he invested in was Portland-based Aviation Gin, which recently sold for \$610 million.

“That’s a wrap for me with ‘Spirited,’” Reynolds said. “Not sure I’d have been ready to say yes to a film this challenging, even three years ago. Singing, dancing and playing in the sandbox with **Will Farrell** made a whole lotta dreams come true, and this is my second film with the great **Octavia Spencer**. It’s a perfect time for a sabbatical from movie making. I’m gonna miss every second working with this obscenely gifted group of artists.”

He added, “My sabbatical could last two months to a year, but most likely it’ll be a six-month break.” Reynolds has been wed to Blake Lively since 2012, and they have three daughters, who he wants to spend quality time with.

WINTER SURVIVAL

Safety measures for winter drivers

WINTER weather causes many people to retreat indoors until the spring thaw. However, for those who embrace the cooler temperatures or find that life must go on despite snow and ice, taking inventory of their vehicles is a must before the first snowflakes start to fall.

Tire care is an especially important area of vehicle maintenance. The tire experts at Michelin say that regular tires may be ineffective for winter driving. Summer tires are made from materials that are optimized for warm conditions. When the mercury drops, these same materials can harden, reducing their ability to grip the road. That lack of traction can be compounded by the presence of snow or ice. Even all-season tires, which are designed to be driven year-round, can be insufficient in severe weather conditions. Winter tires can help drivers safely navigate winter

roadways.

Bridgestone Tires says that having the right snow tires matters when driving in winter weather conditions. It's important to look for tires that can disperse water sufficiently and also grip the road. Snow tires are designed to remain softer and more flexible to conform to the road better in cold conditions. Some winter tires are even studded to provide better traction.

Unfortunately, even the best winter tires cannot provide perfect traction on slippery roadways. That is why it is essential — in conjunction with the use of winter tires or snow chains — to modify driving techniques to navigate safely.

Drive slowly. Slow down on winter roads. Allow a greater distance for stopping than for dry conditions. Slippery conditions can make it more challenging to stop, and excessive speeds can make the situation worse.

Shift into low gear. On



hills, rely on low gears to maximize traction to travel up and down hills. This can minimize skids or sliding.

Get the vehicle a tune-up. In addition to tires, be sure the braking system, battery and other major components of the vehicle

are in good working order.

Replace windshield wipers. Reduced visibility can compromise the safety of drivers and their passengers. Replace windshield wiper blades before winter arrives. Consider purchasing winter-rated

windshield blades.

Know how to recover from a skid. When skids occur on black ice or slush, drivers should take their feet off of the pedals and steer gently in the direction they want to go. As the vehicle regains trac-

tion, only then should the brakes or accelerator be applied.

Winter weather requires making some vehicle modifications, and drivers may want to alter the way they drive to be more safe on the road.

Navigate around these four winter hazards

FRESH snowfall can bring a hush over any landscape and, temporarily at least, create a perfect picture scene. As idyllic as such landscapes can be, snow-covered sledding hills can pose various threats to outdoor lovers' health and safety.

Frostbite occurs when the soft tissues of the body start to freeze. It most commonly affects the fingers, toes and nose. The Cleveland Clinic says single-digit Fahrenheit temperatures are cold enough to cause frostbite. Frostbite affects skin cells and tissues and can cause severe damage. Frostbitten skin turns black as cells die from freezing. Numbness and a painful feeling of "pins and needles" occurs in areas that are exposed to the cold or cold water for too long. Dressing appropriately for weather, limiting time spent outdoors in very cold temperatures and maintaining strong blood flow can reduce risk for frostbite.

Winter weather can lead to slippery conditions. Falls on snow, ice or wet floors are common. When walking, wear shoes with sufficient traction, avoid icy patches and invest in walking poles or microspikes. Promptly wipe up melting puddles in the home to avoid slipping inside as well.

Winter activities may include skating or fishing on a frozen body of water. But it can be challenging to determine just how frozen a lake or a pond might be. Safety experts advise against going out onto the ice alone, and to heed any thin ice signs posted. If you fall through ice, try to gain a grip to pull yourself up (ice picks are a good investment) and spread out on your belly once you get out of the water. Anyone who ventures onto ice can carry a whistle to signal for help, which is louder than yelling. Hypothermia sets in within 10 to 15 minutes, so acting fast is key. Ropes, boogie boards, a spare tire and other items also can be used to save someone from ice without going onto the ice itself.

The lack of sun and short



days of winter can affect individuals' mental wellness. Those with seasonal affective disorder, or SAD, find winter challenging, according to the Cleveland Clinic.

SAD surfaces in late fall or early winter and may not subside until early summer. Make time to get outdoors, even when it's cold, to take advantage of at least 30 minutes of morning light. Doing so can improve mood. Exercise and find ways to engage in social

activities to stave off depressive feelings. Do not turn to food or alcohol to address depression.

Winter brings great beauty but also potential hazards that should be kept in mind and addressed.

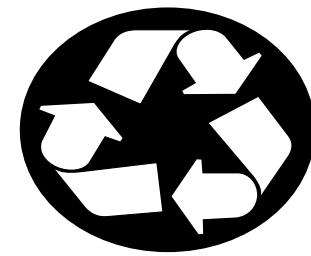

Freshman Joseph Nadig extended Rochelle's lead in the 120-pound bout, pinning Will Lindgren in the first period to put the Hubs ahead 12-6. Juniors Weldon Nay and Wesley Brown followed with decisions in the 126-pound and 132-pound bouts, with Nay beating Ryan Ortega 12-5 and Brown defeating Aaron Eastman 10-4.

Sophomore Alex Burke won by fall over Dean Baldrige in the 138-pound bout to give Rochelle a 24-6 advantage. Freshman Grant Gensler earned a 9-1 major decision over Cole Olsen in the 145-pound bout before senior Caleb

Nadig pinned Ade Sanni to win the 152-pound bout. Kaneland's Christian Duffing pinned to win the 160-pound bout.

Leading 34-12, Rochelle surged ahead after sophomore Brock Metzger defeated Nate Harper with

a 13-1 major decision in the 170-pound bout. The Knights pinned to win the 182-pound and 195-pound bouts before Hub freshman Kaiden Morris won by injury default in the 220-pound bout to seal the Rochelle dual victory.

Frustrated with how the previous quarter transpired, Simmons turned his calmness into intensity down the stretch, sinking clutch mid-range shots and scoring 10 of his team-high 19 points in the fourth quarter to lead Rochelle to a 74-69 win. The Hubs improved to 2-3 with the victory.

"We were mad about how things went down during the third quarter and I think getting mad and focusing on going hard were what helped me find my shots," Simmons said. "Everyone's excited about this win and it feels really good. It's our first conference win of the season and it's our first real road game. We didn't shoot very well at the beginning, but we came around."

Carlson led all scorers with 29 points on Friday, while Kaneland's Jacob Harrison scored 24 points. Harrison ignited the Kaneland offense in the first quarter, attacking the basket and converting multiple layups. Trailing 16-10 entering the second quarter, Rochelle ramped up its full-court pressure and man-to-man defense, deflecting several inbounds passes and creating turnovers that allowed the Hubs to break off a 14-5 run and take control of the game.

"We wanted to do a full-court press and then drop back into man-to-man

defense with some 1-3-1 zone," Simmons said. "We struggled with our press toward the beginning of the game, but we figured it out as the game went on. I thought our zone defense was OK tonight."

Seven Rochelle players scoring during the second quarter including senior Noah Brown, who scored 14 points and made four 3-pointers but was issued a technical foul and benched during the second half. With Brown's hot shooting hand on the sideline, Carlson caught fire during the second half, hitting four 3-pointers in the third quarter to carry the Kaneland

offense.

"We talked during our timeouts about keeping our composure and how we weren't out of the game," Simmons said. "We knew we had time left to fight back and that's what we did."

Losing 66-55 midway through the fourth quarter, Rochelle made one final run to stun the Knights, scoring 15 unanswered points and taking a four-point lead on a clutch corner 3-pointer from sophomore Eli Luxton during the final minute. Senior Adam Kemp stepped up at the free-throw line as well, making four shots to cap off a 12-point scoring performance in the win.
