## City planning building renovation

### Former Johnson Tractor facility purchased this summer

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said Tuesday that the city has long-term plans to renovate and move more personnel and equipment to the building it purchased at 1030 S. 7th St. over the summer.

The city paid \$1.3 million for the former Johnson Tractor building. The water, water reclamation and electric departments have already moved to the facility. Fiegenschuh said he plans to have administrative services, which includes the finance departments and utility billing, join them.

"I'd also like to see myself and my administrative staff down there at some point," Fiegenschuh said. "And then long-term, maybe the police department would take over all of city hall."

The city recently interviewed five firms to do design work to rehab the inside of the former

Johnson Tractor building. Fiegenschuh said he's currently unsure of what renovation costs could be.

The thinking behind consolidating more departments into one location is to improve the city's efficiency, Fiegenschuh said.

"I think it's more efficient to have departments working together and it makes more sense," Fiegenschuh said. "The majority of what we do

involves utilities, so it's important to have that close to our finance staff. It's the most efficient thing to do long-term."

Moving its water and water reclamation departments to the new location has already allowed the city to market the building that used to house those departments for sale, along with the adjacent lot.

Those properties are located at 860 and 890 S.

7th St. An appraisal was completed for the building of \$195,000 and \$315,000 for the adjacent lot. The proceeds from sale will be put towards improvements of the Johnson Tractor building or paying down debt.

Some employees from the RMU building at 333 Lincoln Hwy. will move to the new building, but Fiegenschuh said there are no plans to sell that build-

ing right now and the city's community development department will remain there for now. He stressed that the consolidation plans are all long-term.

"I'm super excited about it," Fiegenschuh said. "It's a great move and I think it should've been done sooner. It's in the best interest of the city to have as many departments working together as possible."

## Village to pursue grant for downtown

### Uses for ARPA funds discussed

**CRESTON** — The Creston Village Board decided Tuesday to authorize Village Engineer Kevin Bunge to work on an application for a Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown grant for Creston's downtown area.

The grant has a \$250,000 minimum and \$3 million maximum

and can be used for sidewalks, streets, lighting and utility work in downtown areas. Bunge said the deadline is early January and work on an application needs to start soon. Trustees expressed interest in starting a full reconstruction of the area if Creston received the grant.

"You have to start from the bottom up," Trustee Curt Ward said. "There's no sense in doing the street if you're going to leave an 80-year-old water

main under it. And you still have storm sewer issues. The utility work spurs you into doing the street, which spurs you into doing the sidewalk. If you're going to do anything, you're pretty much reconstructing the whole street."

Bunge said no matching funds are required for the grant, but the village would likely need to put some money forward to get enough points to receive it. The cost of pursuing it would be on the lower

end of \$3,000-5,000, Bunge said. The grant requires applications to outline how COVID-19 has hurt municipalities' downtown areas.

"I need some assistance with outlining how COVID-19 has hurt the community for the application," Bunge said. "I've read through the grant documents a few times. It is written for communities like Creston."

Bunge said there may not be enough money in a potential grant to do everything the village would like to reconstruct its downtown infrastructure.

"But would there be enough to get the bones built? I think there is,"

Bunge said.

Trustee Mike Kerns was in favor of pursuing the grant.

"I say let him move forward," Kerns said. "And maybe next month we'll have better ideas on some of the questions Kevin has. If we don't try this, in 10-15 years we may have to do it all and come up with the money ourselves."

#### ARPA

The village board discussed what to do with the \$89,000 in American Rescue Plan Act funds it was awarded. Village President Tom Byro said Creston has three years to spend the money and will receive half this year and half in the spring.

The funds need to be spent on capital improvements and not maintenance work.

"We've talked about getting some fire hydrants," Byro said. "If we're going to order these three hydrants, we better do it this fall sometime so we can get them in the spring. Let's get together and figure

out how we want to use this money."

#### Census

Byro said the village has received its most recent census numbers and the Creston population has decreased by 35 people. Creston's population is reported to be 627 people. In 2010, it had 662 people. That could cause village tax revenues, which are based on population, to go down in the future.

#### Farm lease

Byro said a farm lease with Eric Petry has officially been signed. Petry will farm 144.6 acres of farmland the village owns in a one-year contract at \$310 per acre.

The term is from March 1, 2022 until Feb. 2023. It gives Petry the right to renew for one year at the same price, terms and conditions. Byro said at a recent meeting that the village wanted a short-term agreement because of "other things" going on in the future that may change the course of future leases.

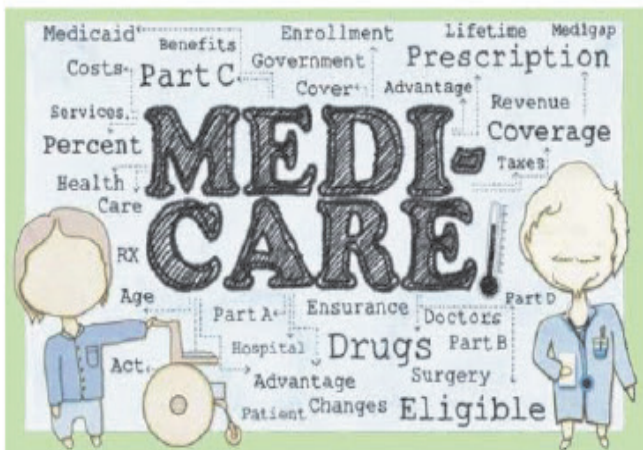

**ROCHELLE** — The City of Rochelle presented a \$1,169.15 check Wednesday to 926 Custom Embroidery Owners Heidi Bratko and Dana Theiss as part of its facade grant program.

The program covers half the cost of any improvements made to business fronts in town. The

embroidery shop is the most recent recipient. Bratko and Theiss said improvements included painting the brick and a new copper sign.

“We went from just blending in to making this pop out a little bit more,” Bratko said. “The brick used to be like the color red and brown. We wanted to stand out. We went with the copper sign. Our building is so pushed

back, we wanted to pop out. We’re just happy to be downtown and we think it’s starting to come alive.”

Theiss said the lettering of the sign is a thicker metal and will have an antique look over time.

“We appreciate the city and everything it’s done helping us out with this,” Theiss said. “It’s been awesome.”

Mayor John Bearrows

attended the check presentation and said he’s thankful to have the business in the community and praised it for how it supports other businesses in town. The money for the facade grants for businesses in the down-

town area comes out of the downtown TIF fund.

“They affect every business in town and we’re very happy to have them here,” Bearrows said. “This check today is possible only because of our very aggressive city

manager and staff that came up with the program and our very supportive city council that passed this program to make this happen. We’re just extremely excited to have them here and have them as part of the community.”

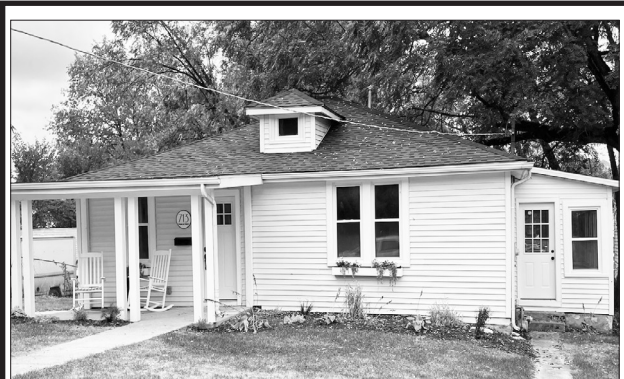

## Always assume the gun is loaded

ALWAYS assume the gun is loaded.

Those words were bored into my brain by my father and older brother when I was only 8 or 9 years old and learning how to handle firearms on the farm.

One time, we were leaving the field and my brother ordered me to unload my rifle. I popped out the clip and handed it to him.

He said, "Are you sure the gun is unloaded?"

I said it was.

"Are you certain?"

"Yes," I said rather indignantly.

He took the rifle from me and jacked a round from the chamber. I looked down at my Keds, embarrassed.

I thought about that incident this past week when I read about Alec Baldwin accidentally killing someone on a movie set. Someone apparently handed him a firearm and told him it wasn't loaded with live ammunition.

He believed what he was told and inadvertently killed one person and wounded another.

I can't imagine the remorse someone must feel in such a situation. But there is a lesson from Illinois' history that shows such a mistake need not stand in the way of future accomplishments.

In 1912, a 12-year-old was playing with a rifle during a party at his central Illinois home when he shot a 15-year-old girl in the head. That boy grew up to be governor, twice was his party's nominee for

president and served as ambassador to the United Nations.

He was Adlai Stevenson II, one of Illinois' greatest sons.

Ruth Merwin was shot when a rifle Stevenson was handling unexpectedly discharged.

A 1952 biography, "Adlai E. Stevenson of Illinois," said the future politician's sister was holding a party when a military-academy student in attendance was urged to perform the military manual of arms.

Adlai Stevenson fetched a rifle, which the student examined for safety before performing the drill. Unfortunately, the student wasn't thorough in his examination, and one shell remained in the rifle. A few minutes later, when Stevenson took the gun and attempted to mimic the older boy's performance, the gun suddenly discharged.

The bullet entered Ruth Merwin's forehead and she fell dead onto the carpet.

But in his 1976 biography, "Adlai Stevenson of Illinois," John Bartlow Martin tells a different story. An anonymous eyewitness whom Martin interviewed claims that "Adlai took the gun from the other boy, pointed it at one of the girls, Ruth Merwin, and pulled the trigger."

No one has ever contended that the shooting was intentional. The gun was supposed to be unloaded, after all.

Having covered many shootings during my newspaper career, I find

the second story more believable. Guns rarely discharge on their own and 12-year-old boys are prone to horseplay with firearms—especially when girls are present.

What's more interesting is how the accident may have influenced the rest of Stevenson's life.

Unlike many politicians, Stevenson was self-deprecating and lacked the swagger common of those who have risen to high political office.

Perhaps the accident made him all too aware of his own human frailties.

Forty years after the accident, William Glasgow of Time magazine, was doing research for a cover story on the presidential candidate when he found a report of the event in The (Bloomington) Pantagraph's archives. He asked Stevenson about it and after a long silence, he said: "You know, you are the first person who has ever asked me about that since it happened—and this is the first time I have ever spoken of it to anyone."

Not even his wife or children were aware of what had occurred at the party Dec. 30, 1912, in his Bloomington home.

But there were hints in his life that indicated that childhood tragedy influenced his career in public service.

In 1955, Stevenson wrote a letter to a woman he had not met, whose son had unintentionally killed another child. His advice was brief: "Tell him that he must live for two."

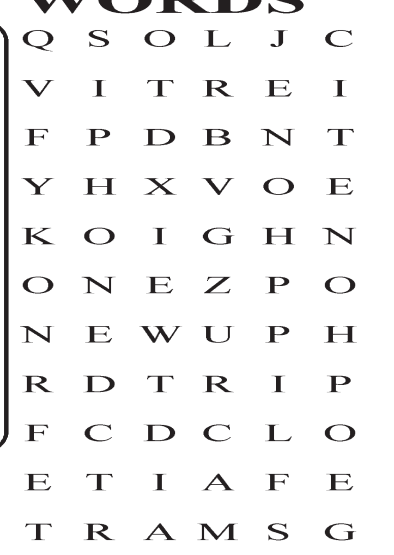

## Kish offering seven short-term training programs in Spring 2022

**MALTA** — The Kishwaukee College Continuing Education department is offering seven short-term training programs during the spring 2022 semester. Short-term programs at Kish are designed to provide students with skills and training needed to meet local workforce demands. The programs range from 11-20 weeks and allow students to immediately start a career or build upon their skills with additional training.

Spring 2022 classes will be offered in online, in-person and hybrid formats. Participants will need access to a computer and the internet to participate in the programs with an online component. Some programs will include an externship.

The short-term Training programs offered in spring 2022 are:

The dental assistant program runs from Jan. 16-April 9 with online lecture and in-person practice. Dental assistants are skilled health care professionals who work closely with dentists and dental hygienists to provide quality preventive and corrective dental care and administrative support in dental offices. In-person practice will be conducted from 6-9 p.m. on Tuesdays in a local dental office.

The PC technician program runs Jan. 18-April 30 in-person. PC technicians are professionals trained to install, configure, upgrade, troubleshoot and repair desktops, laptops, mobile devices and printers. This class will prepare participants to take the A+ certification exam through a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on application of PC technician topics and skills. Instruction in-person practice will be conducted from 6-8 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Kishwaukee College.

The pharmacy technician program is Jan. 16-April 30 online. Pharmacy technicians assist pharmacists with dispensing prescription medication. Workforce Innovation and Opportu-

nity Act (WIOA) funding is available to those who qualify.

The phlebotomy technician program runs Jan. 18-April 8 (a.m. session) and March 28-June 17 (p.m. session) in-person. Phlebotomists are skilled health care professionals who have been trained to collect, transport, handle and process blood and other specimens for laboratory analysis using venipuncture and micro collection techniques. Instruction and in-person practice will be conducted on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays at Kishwaukee College. Morning classes will be from 9:30 a.m. to noon and evening classes will be from 6-8:30 p.m.

The real estate broker pre-license program runs Jan. 18-March 31 online. Real estate brokers perform many duties in real estate transactions, including marketing homes, establishing escrow accounts and working to ensure transactions are fair and legal. Instruction will take place from 6-9 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays in a live, online format.

The sterile processing technician program runs Jan. 16-April 23 (online). Sterile processing technicians provide support to all patient care services in a health care facility. They are responsible for decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembling, sterilizing, storing and distributing the medical devices and supplies needed in patient care, especially during surgery.

The veterinary assistant program runs Jan. 16-June 10 with online lecture and in-person practice. Veterinary assistants are critical members of a veterinary staff trained to assist veterinarians and veterinary technicians with medical procedures on sick and injured animals. In-person lecture/practice will be conducted from 5-8 p.m. on Wednesdays at Ashton Animal Clinic in Kaneville and from 4:30-7:30 p.m. on Fridays at Ashton Animal Clinic in Ashton.

## US Cellular pledging up to \$13 million to close homework gap

**ROCHELLE**—Access to reliable connectivity causes a divide between youth who have access and those who do not. Currently, 35 percent of low-income households lack any access to broadband service at home.

This leads to an issue known as the “homework gap” among students who lack proper internet access. To close this gap, UScellular has launched the After School Access Project, a program that provides free mobile hotspots and service to nonprofits that support youth after the school day has ended and provides safe internet access for homework and education.

This is an expansion of previous hotspot donations the company provided to address connectivity needs during the pandemic. Seeing the greater need, the company has pledged to donate up to \$13 million in hotspots and service in 2022. Eligible 501c3 nonprofit organizations are encouraged to apply by going to <https://bit.ly/3B7zOZQ>.

“When we heard the stories of youth who couldn’t get access to reliable internet for their schoolwork, we knew we had to act,” Kristy Baron, UScellular director of sales for Illinois, said. “Connecting people and communities is our mission and the After School Access Project is just one way that we’re helping ensure students have the

reliable access they need to grow and pursue their dreams.”

Hotspots are standalone Wi-Fi networks that can connect several devices at once wirelessly and have proven to be a vital tool for youth to access the internet, study and complete homework. To date in 2021, UScellular has donated 2,800 hotspots and service to 33 Boys & Girls Clubs across the country, a \$2.6 million investment. Clubs have used them to boost their connectivity on site and loaned the devices out to youth and their families to support reliable access at home.

Rochelle nonprofit organizations that meet the following criteria are welcomed to apply that are certified 501c3 nonprofit organizations that operate within UScellular’s service area that are focused on kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade and are not a school or government entity.

Hotspot devices will be shipped to nonprofit organizations within 6 to 8 weeks of an approved, completed application.

“Closing the digital divide will require the involvement of many organizations and that is why we encourage nonprofits working with youth in afterschool programs to apply and use this resource to enhance the important work they are already doing,” Baron said.

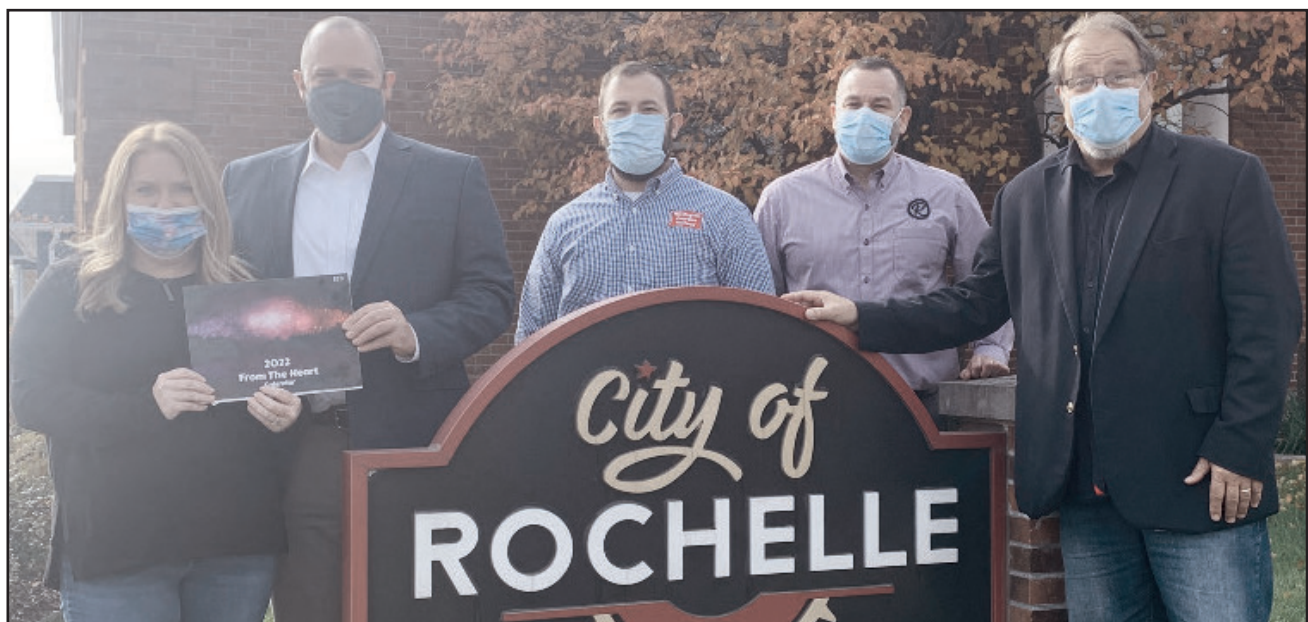

# Hubs' playoff run comes to end with 21-14 loss

Rochelle finishes 8-3 after second round loss to Chicago (St. Patrick)

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity football team cut Chicago (St. Patrick)'s lead to seven points with 4:14 remaining in its 5A second round playoff game thanks to a five-yard touchdown run by junior Cody Cullum-Stover.

The Hubs were unable to recover an onside kick afterwards and the Shamrocks' rushing attack finished off their 21-14 victory and ran out the clock at Triton College in River Forest Friday night.

Rochelle Head Coach Kyle Kissack was impressed by his team's effort after it trailed by two touchdowns for much of the game.

"They get into a tough game like this and just remain relentless with their physicality," Kissack said. "It speaks to the reliability to hang in and battle back from some adversity. Which also speaks to our resilience. Our kids are super resilient when you think about the things they've had to overcome and the games they've been in this year and the way

they've played."

The loss to 13th-seeded Chicago St. Patrick (7-4, 4-0 Chicago Catholic League/East Suburban Catholic Conference Purple Division) snapped fifth-seeded Rochelle's seven-game winning streak and ended the playoff run for the Hubs (8-3, 5-1 Interstate 8/Kishwaukee River Blue Division).

The first score of the game came on a six-yard run by Shamrock senior running back Alex Goworowski, who scored again later in the quarter on a 30-yard touchdown. He tacked on a third touchdown in the third quarter on a 44-yarder and finished with 155 yards.

"Goworowski is a good player," Kissack said. "We knew that.

Rochelle's first touchdown in the game came just before the end of the first half on a five-yard touchdown pass from senior quarterback Josh Lloyd to senior tight end Ethan Wells.

The Hubs recorded 230 yards rushing that nearly matched the Shamrocks' 258. Cullum-Stover ran for 95 yards, junior Trey Taft rushed for 41, junior Garrett Gensler ran for 45 and Lloyd recorded 49 yards rushing.

Kissack said Rochelle's trademark rushing attack isn't built to play from behind, but that isn't why it fell short

Friday night.

"The things that we do well are things that they didn't necessarily defend well," Kissack said. "You sort of look at the overarching picture of the game and there were a number of times where we made some critical self-inflicted mistakes that either shut down a drive or put us in a tough position to come back and get the first down. We battled back and had a shot. I thought just a couple mistakes here or there changed it and it could have been a different ballgame."

McQuade takes over the Lady Hub varsity basketball program from Tony Rowan, who stepped down at the end of the 2020-21 season after eight years at the helm.

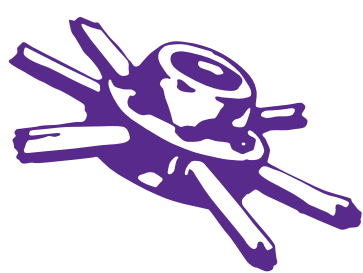

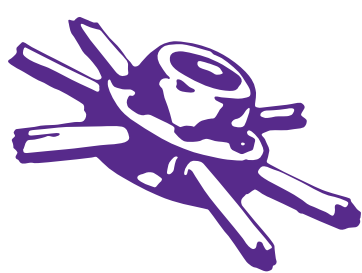

## Hubs eager to build on sectional performance

Ortiz, Johnson finish as top runners for Lady Hubs this season

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub cross country team reached sectionals for the first time in a decade this season. Head coach Mark Zilis said he'd like to see the Hubs make the sectional meet on a regular basis moving forward. Zilis also said he and assistant coach Dale Bergeson are looking to grow the numbers on the Lady Hub cross country team in the future.

The cross country season concluded this past weekend, with the Hubs finishing 18th in the IHSA 2A Woodstock Sectional and junior Yuelma Ortiz representing the Lady Hubs as an individual. The Hubs placed eighth in the Interstate 8 Conference and sixth in the IHSA 2A Burlington Central Regional, while the Lady Hubs took sixth in the conference and ninth at the regional.

"The key to being a successful cross country team is having runners who're willing to commit to running year round," Zilis said. "It's difficult to become a top-level team when runners come out without having much of a distance base. We have to encourage more kids to join the team and we need to encourage our returning kids to do more year-round training. We're hoping that we'll have a full summer where our kids can run between

400 and 500 miles next year."

The Hubs will lose a handful of seniors from this season's varsity roster including No. 2 runner Josue Huerta as well as Peter Forsberg, Luke Orlikowski, Max Orlikowski and Hayden Smith. Rochelle will return several underclassmen who stepped up for the varsity team including sophomores Parker Lenkaitis, Alex Burke, Luis Pizano and freshman Christopher Hickey. Junior David Wanner, Rochelle's No. 1 varsity runner this season, will also be eligible to return.

"I think our kids learned what it takes to qualify for the sectional and I'd like that to become a regular thing," Zilis said. "Next season looks very promising and I think we'll have some kids coming in from the middle school and surrounding schools who'll be a help to us. I want to see us move up in the ranks at future meets and we want to qualify for the state meet some day."

The Lady Hubs fielded a small roster this season, with senior Sara Johnson and Ortiz routinely battling for the No. 1 and No. 2 varsity spots. Johnson, who qualified for sectionals last year, and Emily Garcia are the team's two notable departing seniors, but there will be multiple girls eligible to come back including Ortiz as well as juniors Karina Lopez and Gisselle Robles.

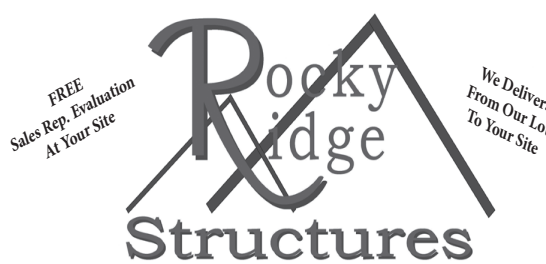

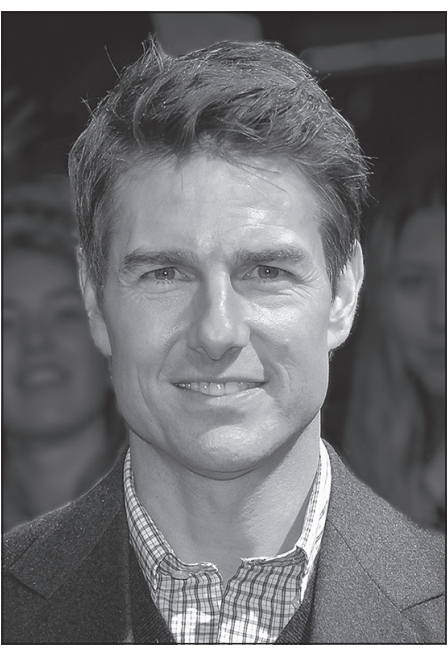
