## School improvement goal presented

### District 231 Board approves resource officer agreement

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Elementary School District Assistant Superintendent Tony Doyle presented a school improvement goal annual overview at the school board's monthly meeting Tuesday.

Doyle said social emotional learning (SEL) will be the main goal as the district moves forward amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Students returned to all-day, in-person schooling at the start of the current semester.

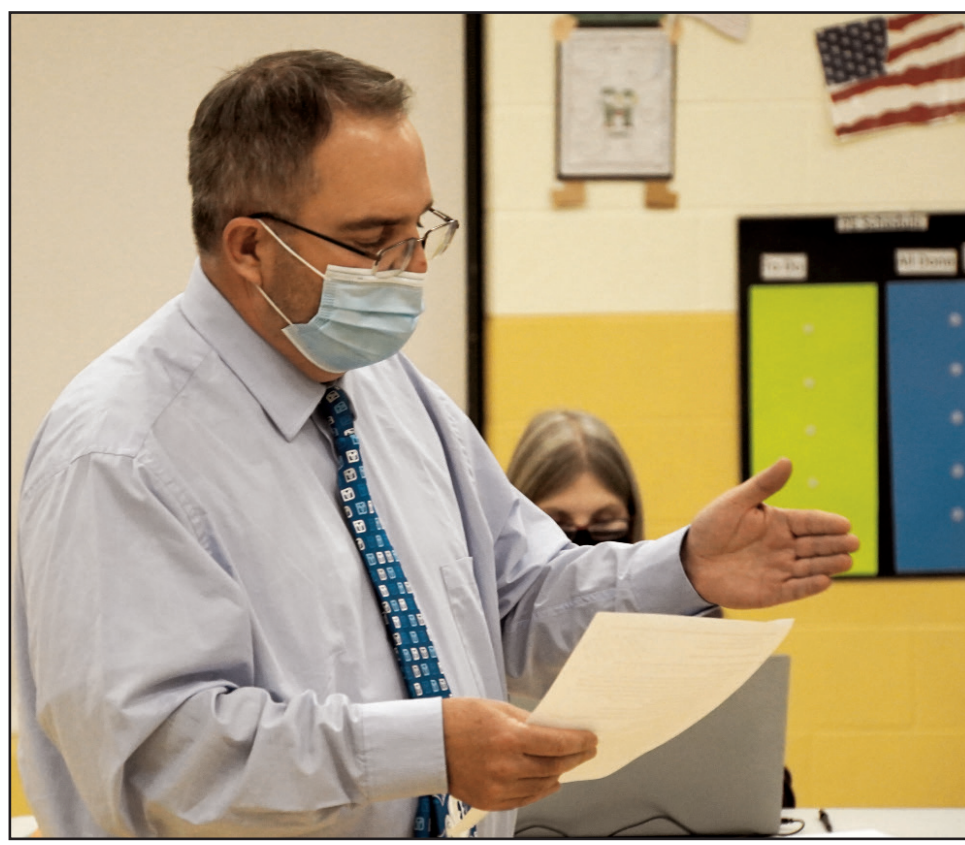
Social and emotional learning is defined as "an integral part of education and human development and a process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills and attitudes to develop." Social emotional learning was also the main focus of the high school district's school improvement plan, which was presented last month at that district's board meeting.

"If we don't get a good handle on our social emotional learning with stu-

dents and staff, it really doesn't matter what else we're doing," Doyle said. "Kids have to be able to regulate themselves, we have to be able to give them support and staff have to be able to regulate themselves. It's never been more important than it is now."

Doyle said the elementary district has had some growth on the topic, but added it "has a long way to go." An additional counselor was recently added so there is one in every elementary school building. He said the district is attempting to get an SEL paraprofessional in each building and said it has been a challenge due to "some turnover" with paraprofessionals this year.

"We're all in this together trying to get that social emotional piece in place," Doyle said. "We're going to continue to use student and parent feedback and counselor recommendations to improve what we're already doing. Simply listening to what our kids are telling us. Listening to everyone will help to guide us. We have to be consistent and

purposeful."

Cosme Becerra, a fifth grade teacher at Tilton School, spoke during the public comment portion of the meeting on behalf of teachers that asked him to attend and said students have shown aggressive behavior towards staff

and peers and "very few" of them have been held accountable for it.

"There has been no consistency with consequences with communication involving individual buildings," Becerra said. "Students have shown aggressive behavior towards

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Township High School hosted its Veterans Day Breakfast Thursday to honor local veterans.

RTHS Principal Chris Lewis welcomed veterans to the school and said it was nice to have them back after the annual event was canceled last year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We got to October and thought about how we'd celebrate Veterans Day and I know the breakfast has always been a nice touch," Lewis said. "We enjoy having you guys here. Thank you for joining us. We can study history, we can listen to your stories, but we'll never fully understand the sacrifice you made for our country. We can't thank you enough for your service."

The Veterans Day breakfast was different than in years past to prevent the spread of COVID-19. There were

fewer students than usual, just those accompanying veterans attended along with two servers. The RTHS band wasn't on hand to play the service medley and masks were required. The school wanted to make sure it could continue its tradition safely.

Mayor John Bearrows attended the event and spoke.

"We need to remember our veterans every day," Bearrows said. "Not just one or two days a year. I challenge each and every one of you in this room that every time you see a flag, remember what it stands for. Say a little prayer and thank God for our veterans. Because we couldn't be doing this today without them and their sacrifices."

Following breakfast, the service medley was played, and each veteran stood as their song was played.

Bearrows closed his speech by saying the best way to honor the country's veterans is to take an active role in maintaining freedom in America and showing veterans that the country is worth all that

they have given and lost.

"We must teach future generations about what it means to be an American," Bearrows said. "We should all come together, promote peace and pray for an end to the violence that seems to be out of control while instilling the values that are so important that only we as a unified country have the power to do."

The building of a Habitat home takes many hours

of planning. It begins with and orientation/ application event at which a person in need of affordable decent housing can apply to be awarded an interest free mortgage on a new home.

To qualify, a family must be willing to partner with Habitat and put in "sweat equity." They must have a need for affordable decent house. They also must be able to make regular monthly payments.

Habitat uses volunteers and gifts in kind to build a quality house and a minimum cost. This is not a free home. It carries an interest-free mortgage

and regular payments will be made.

It is required a family attend one of the above two meetings.

They must bring: copies of driver's license or state ID (proof of Ogle County Residence), copies of federal tax returns over the last two years including W-2's, copies of your last month's pay stubs, copies of last two bank statements (checking and saving) and proof of any other type of income (child support, social security, disability etc.).

Habitat plans to break ground in Rochelle next

spring. It just finished a build on South 9<sup>th</sup> Street and the new house will be two doors down. It also built a house in 2018 on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Habitat is excited to meet its new partner family and get started.

Habitat is also looking for volunteers to server on a couple of committees. It is looking for someone to head up its fund-raising group, volunteer committee and a church relations person. Chamber Executive Director Tricia Herrera said the event is in the chamber's top three of fundraisers and it allows people to have a good time and network before the busy holiday season.

"It's a way to get exposure for smaller businesses and a night out for everybody," Herrera said. "This is our fourth year doing it. Last year didn't take place because of COVID-19. It's really been a good event for us. Families and kids are welcome to come."

We like to say it's the official start of the holiday shopping season. Things like this help the chamber expand its programs. We do fundraisers so we can expand services for home-based and small businesses."

## Compton woman suffers fatal injuries in Tuesday accident

**ROCHELLE** — A Compton woman suffered fatal injuries in a Tuesday accident on Illinois Route 251, an Illinois State Police press release said.

At 5:53 p.m. the state police responded to Illinois Route 251 approximately a quarter mile north of Gurler Road. The preliminary investigation revealed a truck tractor/semi-trailer combination driven by Mark A. Geesey, 57, of Dixon, was entering Illinois Route 251 northbound

from a private drive and was struck by a southbound minivan driven by Nancy D. Mlynski, 64, of Compton.

Geesey did not suffer from any apparent injuries. Mlynski suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The investigation and charges are pending. The ISP were assisted on scene by the Illinois Department of Transportation, Ogle County Sheriff's Office, Rochelle Police



Department, Rochelle Fire/EMS and the Ogle County Coroner's Office. The public is reminded that all persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

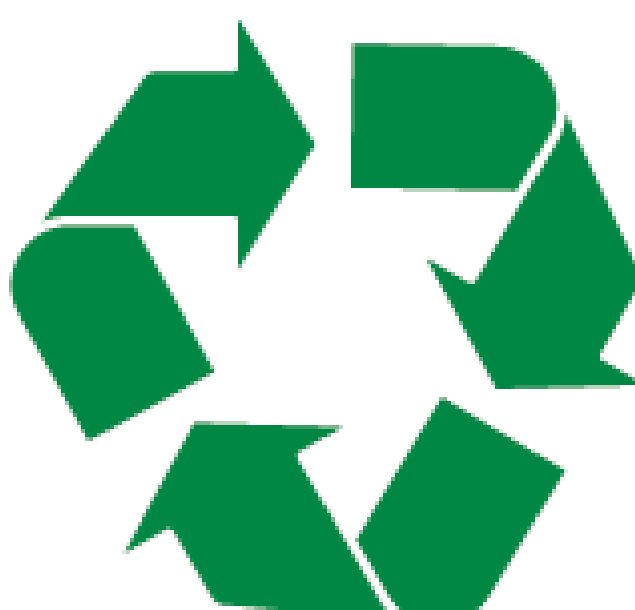
## County holiday light recycling starts Nov. 15

**OREGON** — Autumn is upon Ogle County, and it seems folks are getting an early start on holiday decorating. Some of those light strands from previous years may not be working anymore and can be recycled very easily here in Ogle County.

The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) is again partnering with local fire departments and villages to again offer several convenient drop-off boxes so those frustrating, nonfunctional holiday light strands can be recycled.

Starting Nov. 15, drop-off boxes will be available at the following fire departments: Rochelle, Byron, Stillman Valley and Mt. Morris. They will be located at the village halls in Polo, Forreston, Davis Junction and Creston. Light strands are also accepted at the Ogle County courthouse and at the OCSWMD office at 909 Pines Road in Oregon. Boxes will remain at these locations until Jan. 21, 2022.

Accepted light strands include Italian mini-lights, traditional lights, LED lights and other holiday



light strands. Extension cords are also accepted. Material not accepted include rope lights, wreaths, garland, metal stakes or silhouettes, live greens, plastic decorations, timers, and light packaging, plastic bags or cardboard boxes.

Placing just the light strands and cords into the bins increases material value and makes the recycling process more efficient for the processor. Lights and cords will be shipped to Dynamic Lifecycle Innovations in Onalaska, Wisconsin to be recycled. In 2020-2021, over 1,500

pounds of material was collected and recycled through this program.

So, as we prepare to untangle, test and put out those holiday lights this season, remember you can help the environment and recycle all those strands of lights which have brightened our homes in the past but now refuse to light up anymore.

## Hillcrest board swears in Huerta as trustee

### Tax abatement proposal approved

**HILLCREST** — The Hillcrest Village Board swore in its newest trustee during Wednesday's monthly meeting. Village trustees also approved the 2021 fiscal year budget at \$2.1 million as well as an eight-year tax abatement proposal for Hackbarth Trucking & Equipment.

The tax abatement proposal includes a sales tax agreement totaling 50 percent each year. Greg Hackbarth, who owns Hackbarth Trucking

& Equipment, recently opened a vehicle repair shop at the former Grennan Meats building along Maple Avenue on the northeast side of the village.

Village resident Jose Huerta was appointed and sworn in to fill the vacant position on the village board. Huerta fills the trustee position vacated by Randy Salsbury, who became acting president of the board after Jason Fore stepped down as village president earlier this year.

### Infrastructure

Salsbury said that plans for village water, sewer and roadway improvements will be placed on hold until the board can determine whether or not there will be grant funding to cover the cost.

Planned improvements included a new water tower, shallow well and water treatment plant as well as improvements to the existing village water, sewer and roadway infrastructure.

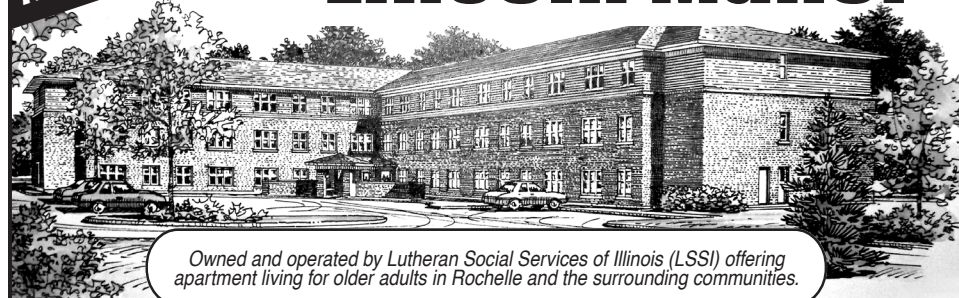

## Deputies respond to disturbance at Casey's General Store in Creston

**OREGON** — On Nov. 9 at 5:09 p.m. deputies and Oregon Fire and EMS responded to the area of 900 N. River Road for the report of a vehicle that left the roadway and entered the Rock River. After an investigation, it was determined Daniel Boyden, 30, of Oregon was traveling southbound on River Road in his Volkswagen Jetta when he lost control of his vehicle. Boyden was able to escape the vehicle and swim back to shore. Boyden was transported to KSB Hospital by Oregon EMS for precaution. At KSB Hospital, Boyden was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Boyden was released on a signature I-Bond. He was also issued citations for improper lane usage, failure to reduce speed to prevent an accident and operating an uninsured motor vehicle.

## Harold L. Rogers



## Why it's important to name names

THE No. 1 reason innocent people go to prison is because of government misconduct.

That's not just my opinion. It's the view of the National Registry of Exonerations, which catalogs wrongful conviction cases and their underlying causes. The group concluded recently that in 54 percent of cases in which someone was wrongly convicted, it was through willful wrongdoing by police officers or prosecutors.

When I covered Moline City Hall in the 1990s, I met a kind man named Darrel Parker, who was working for the city parks department. He had been wrongly convicted of murder in Nebraska. It took the state of Nebraska more than 60 years to acknowledge its mistake and fully exonerate him.

But how was he convicted? Police and prosecutors hid evidence pointing to someone else having committed the crime and a professional interrogator coerced a false confession from Parker.

At the time he was wrongly convicted, Parker was a farm kid in his mid 20s who had just graduated

from Iowa State University. And when I interviewed him decades later, I was a farm kid in my mid-20s who had just graduated from Iowa State.

I realized that neither my college degrees, my upbringing nor my professional status could protect me -- or anyone else -- from police misconduct.

Former Gov. Jim Edgar used to say, "The best disinfectant against corruption is sunshine."

It's incumbent on journalists, citizens and others to hold those in power -- including police officers -- accountable. And it's never enough to point vaguely at a department or agency and say, "There is a problem over there."

The nature of democracy is to hold individuals, not institutions, accountable.

After all, agencies don't go to prison. But individuals do. Bureaucracies don't have their name on the ballot, but candidates do. And an organization can't be shamed into compliance, but its people sometimes can.

That's why it's important

to name names.

When 118 people were tortured in its custody, the Chicago Police Department didn't suffer. But Commander Jon Burge did. He was sentenced to four and one-half years in prison and lost his pension. By holding that one man to account an example was set for an entire department.

When I was a Statehouse bureau chief for a chain of Illinois newspapers, a man named Gary Gauger dropped by my office. He was wrongly convicted of murdering his parents in rural McHenry County. He served two years on Illinois' death row before his conviction was thrown out. His conviction stemmed from false testimony on the part of police officers who investigated the case.

His tale of wrongful conviction left me speechless. And his is hardly an isolated case. There were 13 innocent men freed from Illinois' death row. Of those 13, 10 were tortured by Burge or those under his command.

During the 33 years I've been a reporter I've uncov-

ered police officers engaged in sexual assaults, theft, physical abuse and wrongful use of deadly force.

How did I find out about these acts of misconduct? Almost always I was tipped off by good officers outraged by what was happening in their department. A good cop has no use for a bad one. And our society has many good officers.

But sometimes police corruption takes a different form. I'm talking about sins of omission rather than commission. When a police officer looks away when someone commits a crime because they are powerful or connected, that is corrupt too.

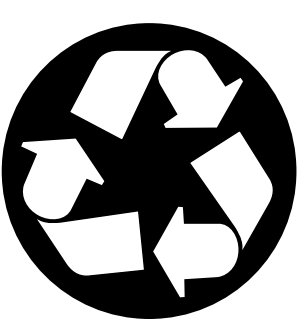
Everyone is entitled to equal justice under the law.

Our society imbues those who wear a gun and a badge with enormous power. They can take someone's property, take a person's freedom or take someone's life.

With that much power comes responsibility. And with responsibility comes accountability.

If we don't hold them accountable, who will?

## Factors to consider to maintain winter safety

**M**ANY changes are to be expected as fall gives way to winter. Temperatures drop for much of the country, and depending on where one lives, snow, wind and ice are to be expected.

As beautiful as snow-covered landscapes can be, winter presents unique hazards, notably slippery roads and surfaces. Chilly temperatures also can put people at risk if they spend prolonged periods outdoors unprotected.

According to the insurance company Carsurance, more than 156,000 crashes occur annually due to icy roads. Roughly 17 percent of all vehicle crashes happen in winter conditions. Winter hazards are not exclusive to driving, however.

While slippery surfaces may contribute to some accidents, visibility can quickly change with winter weather. Blowing snow can contribute to whiteout conditions. In addition, fog can be hazardous to drivers, aviators and mariners and contributes to thousands of travel accidents every year, advises the National Weather Service. It's important to slow down, leave plenty of distance, use your low-beam headlights, and recognize when it may be safest to pull over, such as when visibility is significantly compromised.

Shoveling snow or using a snowblower are common wintertime activities. Yet strenuous levels of activity in cold temperatures could put people at risk of heart attack, particularly if they are not acclimated to physical activity. Always warm up prior to shoveling snow to prepare the body for exercise. Go slowly and take frequent breaks. Avoid twisting and tossing snow over your shoulder,

which can contribute to back injuries.

Winter weather means turning up the heat or doing more indoor cooking. Carbon monoxide is produced through the burning of fuel in various forms, including stoves, engines, gas ranges, portable generators, and grills. The National Safety Council says carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless gas that can go undetected as it builds up in enclosed spaces. Never warm up the car inside of a contained garage. Do not use portable flameless chemical heaters indoors, and have furnaces, water heaters and other fuel-burning appliances checked and serviced by a qualified technician annually. Be sure that carbon monoxide alarms are on every floor of the home, and take it seriously if the alarm goes off.

Black ice is a common winter foe. Black ice forms when temperatures rise above freezing during the day, melting any snow on the ground and causing surfaces to become wet. If the temperature drops once more while the ground is wet, a thin, transparent sheet of ice can form. Black ice also may occur if moisture in the air condenses and forms dew or fog, and then the temperature drops below freezing, says the National Weather Service.

Black ice gets its name because it looks black on asphalt roads. However, it also can form on sidewalks and overpasses, or spots shaded by trees or other objects. Slowing down and exercising extreme caution are essential.

Winter is a beautiful season. But it can be just as hazardous as it is awe-inspiring. Taking steps to stay safe in unpredictable conditions is a necessity each winter.



## How to make driving in bad weather more safe

**I**MPAIRED visibility can be a safety hazard while driving. Everything from sun glare to hail can affect a driver's ability to see the road and navigate it effectively. Before drivers get behind the wheel, they should make note of their local forecast and make a plan for what to do if rain, snow or other conditions make it challenging to drive.

The International Association of Traffic and Safety Sciences indicates that, based on an examination of crash test data conducted by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the "likelihood of a crash increases during periods of low visibility, despite the tendency for less traffic and for lower speeds to prevail during these times."

Drivers can take several steps to improve their visibility when driving in poor weather conditions.

Inspect and change windshield wiper blades. Wipers are instrumental in clearing precipitation away from the windshield. If they're not functioning properly, wipers cannot do their jobs. Drivers should replace their wipers at the first indication that they are no longer effective. In some conditions, wipers can freeze or stick. Drivers should then pull over and clean the wipers manually.

Clear obstructions. Always make sure the windshield is clear before driving. This can include

removing ice and snow in the winter and cleaning off mud or bug splatter in the spring and summer. Use the front and rear defrost if condensation fogs up windshields and windows.

Slow down. Foul weather can reduce drivers' ability to see far into the distance. Drivers should always drive slower in inclement weather in order to improve reaction time.

Top off fluids. Always keep the windshield washer reservoir full and keep extra fluid in the trunk. In addition, look for a fluid that does not freeze in very cold temperatures.

Learn how to drive in fog. Each year, more than 38,700 vehicle crashes occur in fog, states the Federal Highway Administration. Travelers Insurance recommends slowing

down, staying focused and using regular headlights and not high beams when driving in fog.

Go out only if necessary. In snowy or icy conditions, drive only if it's absolutely necessary, as snow and ice can impair visibility and make roads slick, says AAA.

Avoid driving at dusk and dawn. The human eye can have trouble adjusting to rapidly changing light and darkness conditions, which are common at dusk and dawn. If possible, drivers should make trips during the heart of the day, especially if poor lighting conditions typically make it difficult for them to drive.

Drivers can take steps to improve visibility when inclement weather makes roadways hard to navigate.

## Students ages 5-11 can now be vaccinated

District 231 Board of Education resolves not to offer local clinic for students

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Elementary School District Superintendent Jason Harper discussed the COVID-19 vaccine recently being approved for 5-11-year-olds at the school board's Tuesday meeting.

At the beginning of the month, the CDC recommended 5-11-year-olds receive the vaccine manufactured by Pfizer and BioNTech and the Illinois Department of Public Health adopted the recommendation. The vaccine had previously been approved for people 12 and older.

At its Tuesday meeting, Harper and the district resolved to not offer a clinic for 5-11-year-olds at one of its schools. It has offered free clinics in the past for 12-17-year-old students with the help of the Ogle County Health Department.

The superintendent stressed that now and in the past the vaccine has been 100 percent optional and up to the parents of students.

Harper said the OCHD can't offer an on-site pediatric vaccine clinic "logistically and for a lot of reasons." The district's only other choice to conduct an on-site free clinic was a third party provider through the state that the district was "less than impressed" with after a

booster clinic for staff of both districts last Friday. Harper was prepared to recommend trying a 5-11-year-old clinic until that experience.

"The clinics run by the OCHD were smooth and efficient last semester," Harper said. "This was not like that. We had staff members waiting for 90 minutes or two hours. It was not good. I worked with the OCHD and Nurse Joelle Builta about other options."

Harper said options for

parents who choose to get their 5-11-year-olds vaccinated include the OCHD in Rochelle and Oregon, the DeKalb County Health Department, the Winnebago County Health Department, Meijer grocery store in Sycamore and area Walgreen's not including Rochelle. Local pediatricians may offer the vaccine as well, Harper said.

The superintendent said the OCHD told him it is comfortable with the area's options to meet

demand for the 5-11 population.

"They said the other options meet more family-personalized needs and maybe the more generalized approach isn't the way to go for a pediatric vaccine," Harper said. "We've had some inquiries about this and I want to build this information into parent communications."

Harper told the News-Leader last week that the pediatric vaccine is "one more piece to the puzzle" of this semester's

return to all-day, in-person instruction and the district will support parents regardless of the decision they make.

The OCHD recently provided Harper with guidance regarding the holiday season and COVID-19. Last year, it made a blanket recommendation of an adaptive pause for county schools due to the possibility of increased spread of COVID-19 around the holidays. That won't happen this year, he said.

"The OCHD said it has no intention to do a blanket recommendation for adaptive pauses over the holidays," Harper said. "This is something we're very happy to hear. We want to maximize every day with our students this semester and this year. We understand that things can change from building to building or classroom to classroom. But, to know that our students are going to be with us through the winter holiday break is great news to us."

Doyle acknowledged Becerra's comments and said they tie into the district's SEL work.

"It's never been more important than it is now," Doyle said. "Some of the things we've heard tonight, those things are true and they are happening. I was glad to hear Mr. Becerra talk about it."

Becerra is also the co-president of the teacher's union that is currently negotiating with the district on a new contract. Karissa Dobson, a fourth grade dual language immersion teacher at Tilton School, also spoke during public comment and walked the board through an example of her day while working under an expired contract.

Becerra said the union is working with Doyle and feels there's forward progress toward a new contract. Board President Dave Casey thanked both teachers for their comments and their work with students.

"For a lot of our kids, you guys are their safe spot," Casey said. "You're where they get a lot of the love. And thank you for that. I know it's not easy. The board knows it's not easy. From us to you, thank you very much."

### School resource officer

The board unanimously approved an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Rochelle extending its school resource officer program with the Rochelle Police Department until Sept. 1, 2024. The board agreed to pay 33 percent of the SRO's total compensa-

tion including salary, overtime, benefits and pension payments.

"We feel it's been a productive program and we're very appreciative of the services we've received from the police department and specifically SRO Jim Jakymiw," Superintendent Jason Harper said. "The city has already approved it."

### Attendance center survey

Lincoln Elementary School Principal Justin Adolph presented the findings of a survey the district did on its new attendance center model put in place this year that sends students to schools based on grade level instead of where they live in the district.

Parents and staff were surveyed. Adolph said responses were 74 percent positive overall and 64 percent positive on district transportation. Some of the negative responses were due to traffic or anxiety due to parents having to pick up children from multiple schools.

"We do have staff on hand to wait for kids if parents have to pick up at multiple buildings," Adolph said. "They described the anxiety of trying to hurry to get to the buildings. That's one thing we want to communicate is that that's not necessary. We're planning on some kids being left for 5-10 minutes while you travel to the buildings."

Communication was rated positive by 80 percent of parents. The district plans to do more district-wide communication going forward to make for less lengthy text chains for parents with kids in different schools due to

the new model. Adolph said the overall parent satisfaction was 90 percent.

The staff data's overall satisfaction with the new model was 54 percent and the building comfort level was 57 percent, Adolph said. The survey found staff's biggest needs were SEL and more collaboration time.

"Collaboration time is a benefit of this model and we're not where we want to be with that yet," Adolph said. "We do have a need for more meeting time and we're working on that. Overall, that's the data. We plan to give this survey again in the spring after we've implemented some things."

### HUB Project

HUB Project Director Amy Hayden gave an annual update on the district's extended learning program. She said enrollment has been "steady" and HUB has enjoyed a return to in-person learning. The HUB site changed with the attendance center model and now every student in the district is eligible for the after school program.

Hayden said that in the past, kindergarten and first grade numbers were smaller, but this year those levels reflect the most HUB students. "Quite a big" group has been coming this year for the morning HUB program, which helps with socialization and SEL skills.

Compensation was recently increased for HUB teachers, paraprofessionals and staff, which "hadn't been done much" over the course of the program's grant. Hayden said the program is preparing for its next five-year cycle and

its funding expires June 30, 2022.

"We've been meeting about what the next steps are," Hayden said. "We're committed to pursuing the

next five-year cycle of the grant. We're not eligible for continuation funds this time. We're working our channels at the state to see about a request for

proposal being released and being ready for that. We're working on what we want the after school program to look like for the next five years."

# Back on the hardwood

## Hubs gearing up for season opener at Strombom Thanksgiving Tournament

# Hubs building on eight-win season

## Rochelle finishes with best record since 2004

**ROCHELLE** — A tough second-round play-off loss against Chicago (St. Patrick) didn’t diminish what the Rochelle Hub varsity football team was able to accomplish this season. After finishing 8-3 overall and placing second in the Interstate 8/Kishwaukee River Blue Division with a 5-1 record, head coach Kyle Kissack and the Hubs are eager to build on this season’s achievements.

In a season that featured seven consecutive wins, Rochelle reached the second round of the IHSA Playoffs for the first time since 2017 and compiled its best overall record since 2004. Despite two forfeit victories, Rochelle’s offense rushed for nearly 3,000 yards while averaging 32.3 points per game and 269.7 rushing yards per game. The Hubs totaled 41 touchdowns and 205 first downs while converting 79.4 percent (27-of-34) of their fourth-down attempts.

“What I really enjoyed about our group this season was their selfless desire to play for one another,” Kissack said. “Our kids made a decision early on during summer camp when we had only 20-something players on the varsity roster and they bought in and sold out for each other. When we look at our season as a whole, our kids succeeded because of their selfless nature.”

The Hubs will return four junior running backs next season including Garrett Gensler (925 yards, 20 touchdowns), Trey Taft (759 yards, six touchdowns), Cody Stover-Cullum (684 yards, 10 touchdowns) and Landon DeLille (291 yards, two touchdowns). Rochelle

will lose some of its senior leaders including quarterback Josh Lloyd (383 total yards, three touchdown passes) and tight end Ethan Wells (one touchdown) as well as linemen Brodie Nantz and Grant Messer.

“We had a number of younger kids playing some significant positions,” Kissack said. “We paired those kids with seniors who had two or three years of varsity experience and I thought they really blended well together. We’re really going to miss our seniors and the amount of time and energy they invested into our program. Filling their shoes won’t be easy.”

Rochelle’s defense held opponents to 21.3 points per game and 211.5 yards

per game. Four Hubs tied for the team lead with 38 tackles including senior linebacker Tanner Lager and senior defensive end Braden Alfano, who will each depart along with senior lineman Marco Castro (18 tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery). The Hubs will lose two starters in the secondary including safety Josh Lloyd (28 tackles) and corner Nate Burdin (12 tackles).

Rochelle will return several juniors, however, including linemen Jaden Cook (19 tackles, two sacks) and Bradley Cooney (nine tackles, two sacks) as well as freshman Kaiden Morris (two sacks). Gensler (38 tack-

les), Stover-Cullum (38 tackles, one forced fumble, one fumble recovery) and Taft (27 tackles) will all return at linebacker, while junior Aidan Rodriguez (17 tackles, one interception, one breakup) could become the team’s top cornerback next season.

“Our defense really matured as the season went on,” Kissack said. “We spend a lot of time over the summer building on defense and with the number of different looks we see, it’s important for our kids to get a lot of reps. We pushed through the first portion of our season and I was impressed with how our defense played and finished the season this year.”

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity bowling team continued its busy opening week of the winter season, hosting the Sterling Golden Warriors in nonconference competition Thursday. Sterling defeated Rochelle 3,259-2,892 and dropped the Hubs to 0-3 on the season.

The Golden Warriors took the first game 1,063-967 behind 223 from Ethan Melcher and 210 from Andrew Doughty. Senior Sergio Guevara fired 234 for the Hubs in the first game, while senior Luke Orlikowski rolled 163 and sophomore Christian Thorne added 159.

Sterling extended its

lead in the second game, winning 1,098-927 with Doughty shooting 233 and Tristan Oelrichs finishing one pin behind and recording 232. Guevara scored 185 for Rochelle in the second game, with Orlikowski bowling 172 and junior Evin Odle chipping in 168.

The Golden Warriors concluded the three-team sweep with a 1,098-998 victory in the third game. Doughty fired 205 to end the evening with a match-best 648 series, while Melcher recorded 230 for a 609 series and Oelrichs totaling 185 for a 600 series. Odle rolled 200 for the Hubs, while senior Devansh Patel bowled 188 and Guevara shot 170 for a team-high 589 series.

## HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — James Bond looks pretty good for a 58 year old. Bond first appeared on May 8, 1963 in the guise of **Sean Connery** in “To Russia With Love.” **Daniel Craig**, 53, the sixth actor to embody Bond, has gotten people back into movie theaters and broken box-office records worldwide with his latest and last film, “No Time to Die.” But Craig’s fifth and final Bond film leaves him two short of the record holder, **Roger Moore**, who played 007 seven times between 1973 and 1985. He was preceded by Sean Connery, who gave him life five times from 1963-1983.

As much fun as Bond movies are, the 26 films (not counting the one-off 1967 comedy “Casino Royale,” with four male and four female stars playing Bond) won only five Oscars, for visual effects, sound editing and the song “Skyfall,” and none for acting. Collectively, the franchise has earned almost \$7 billion globally. The single top-grosser was “Skyfall” (2012), which netted \$1.1 billion. The search for the new Bond has begun.

**Scarlett Johansson** has settled her lawsuit with Disney. Disney had agreed to a 90-day theater run of her film “Black Widow,” but started streaming it on Disney+ after 45 days for \$30 a pop. Johansson sued for the 45-day percentage she lost from the streaming move. Disney had assumed her \$20 million payday covered it, but rather than face a lengthy court trial with the entire movie industry waiting for a big payday precedent, they settled out of court and signed a non-disclosure settlement.

Also wanting her day in court is **Lisa Renna** (wife of **Harry Hamlin**), former star of “Days of Our Lives,” “Melrose Place” and currently “The Real Housewives of Beverly Hills.” A photo agency is suing Renna for \$1.2 million for posting eight photos of her-

The agency is suing because, “Once a photograph is posted, People Magazine or US Weekly are less likely to buy it.” Copyright laws generally protect writers or images produced through creative effort. It seems absurd that celebrities can’t use photographs of themselves taken by others, especially those taken in public without their consent (Renna says, “My kids grew up with them jumping out of the bushes in Malibu”). Still want to be a celebrity?
