Daycare survey results presented

Sale of South Seventh Street properties approved

ROCHELLE — City of Rochelle Director of Marketing, Public Relations and Tourism Jenny Thompson presented the results of a recent survey to assess daycare needs in town at the city council's Monday meeting.

The survey was circulated as the city works to help bring a daycare back to town after Kishwaukee Family YMCA Child Care Center at 1010 N. 15th St. closed last year. The survey received 309 responses with 72 percent of respondents saying they're in need of a daycare and 71 percent saying their children would be likely to attend a daycare if it opened in town.

Thompson said most of the families have 1-2 children under the age of 12 that they'd be enrolling in daycare and "most people" are looking for care for children under five who aren't school age yet and need all-day care.

Forty nine percent of respondents said a lack of childcare is preventing a

parent from working outside the home and 75 percent said a lack of childcare is limiting a parent's career options, Thompson said.

For future steps, Thompson said the city received a \$10,000 grant from the

Rochelle Area Community Foundation to start putting something together for a daycare. The city is currently working on recruiting board members to start an independent nonprofit that will start fundraising

once established.

"Right now we don't have a mechanism to receive donations but we've had a lot of different industries and community members express interest in making contributions to-

ward the center," Thompson said. "As soon as this is established, the board could accept donations. This would all be done by the board, not by the city."

Housing 'absolutely a priority' for city officials

'I do think there's a lot of opportunity to expand housing'

ROCHELLE — At its Nov. 8 meeting, the Rochelle City Council heard a presentation on preliminary findings of a Northwest Illinois Workforce Housing study from Daniel Payette of the Blackhawk Hills Regional Council.

Payette said there's next to a zero percent vacancy rate for residential rental housing in the area and what used to rent for \$800 per month is now renting for \$1,200 a month and is less affordable. He added that despite current high costs of construction, there is a need for blue collar housing along with senior housing.

Payette said Rochelle has had a lot of focus on industry, but there potentially could be more focus on residential housing.

City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh reacted to the preliminary findings of the study last week and said part of the mayor and city council's 2018 strategic plan involved more focus on housing and trying to get more people to move

to town.

"Part of that is trying to make sure there's enough housing," Fiegenschuh said. "I found the preliminary part of the study to be very interesting. I do think there's a lot of opportunity to expand housing in Rochelle. I think there's an opportunity for us to collaborate with some of our local developers to maybe do some projects."

Fiegenschuh said that in his four years as city manager, he's heard from residents that the city needs more opportunities for housing for all levels of income. He said once final findings of the study are presented that the city will try to put a plan together to improve housing in town.

"Absolutely housing is a priority going forward," Fiegenschuh said. "I would say it's not just housing. Any time the city can work on projects that benefit the quality of life for our residents, it's a priority. Housing is certainly one of the top two for that."

The city manager mentioned workforce housing, which is geared towards families with income

around the \$50,000 range. He thinks there's a lot of opportunity for that in the Rochelle community.

Fiegenschuh said that before the COVID-19 pandemic, the city was in talks with housing developers about a development going out by Walmart that would've included work-

force and senior housing. He said that didn't pan out because the land wasn't zoned for that type of use.

The city has taken some steps in the past to foster housing including rebating property taxes for new housing and waiving building permits.

"We did some little

things, but at the end of the day, you have to have people who want to build a house and you have to have a developer, at least on a subdivision side, who is willing to invest the money and be able to recoup it," Fiegenschuh said.

RCH Foundation Board President: 'It's been very gratifying'

Harris has seen board's work expand significantly over last 10 years

ROCHELLE — After becoming president of the Rochelle Community Hospital Foundation Board, Reed Harris began writing letters to RCH employees. "I've written them to those who think outside the confines of their position and go above and beyond for patients or their peers," Harris said. "I felt it really was required to let them know we were thinking about them."

Harris has been on the board for 10 years and has been president for the last two. Before that, the Rochelle native retired after working for the BNSF Railroad for 39 years and moved back to town. He wanted something to keep busy. He started volunteering at the hospital's lab 12 years ago and was later convinced to join the foundation board. "I thought it was a good

fit for me," Harris said. "I wasn't looking for a job, I just wanted to stay busy. I was also looking to give back to the city that helped raise me. I thought the hospital was a good way to do that. That's how I got started."

Harris said the board has "done a lot of good things" in his time on it. He recalled helping fund equipment like MRI, CAT and mammogram scan machines. He's seen the board add more committees and funds. The board has also established employee scholarships for continuing education and certifications.

Having the chance to serve on the board has been "very gratifying" for Harris. When starting out, he said it was nice to know there was a foundation that helped the hospital get what it needed for patients and that there were people in the city that wanted to help.

Harris thinks around five years ago new strategy meetings started to help the board develop its mission and vision to expand the ways it helps the hospital.

"It's been very gratifying becoming president and seeing some of these things expand even further," Harris said. "I just like giving back to the city. The community we have is very lucky to have RCH there. A place to go whenever they're sick. To have it that close and have it be a community hospital and not run by a big conglomerate is very special. Anything we can do to help the patients, employees or hospital makes me feel good."

In the future, the board president would like to expand activities to get more donors in the door. Board committees are starting to try to set up new activities besides the foundation's annual golf outing and connect better with donors.

"I think we need to market ourselves more," Harris said. "Some of our donors

are patients and some are employees. I think we can make a closer connection

if we can get out there and I think that connection will expand what our vision is."

"They're there to make a profit. There are all kinds of things that go into that. Hopefully we can do something in the future."

Fiegenschuh believes there are areas in town where housing development could be seen. He said the city will need to be proactive about looking at its comprehensive plan and zoning to help with possible housing.

The planned demolition of the Hickory Grove building could result in housing on that site if the eventual redevelopment goes that way. Fiegenschuh said in years past when the demolition was first talked about, there were potential developers interested in putting up housing or apartments there.

The city could work with developers in public-private partnership along with the state and others to promote housing in the future.

"If the city is going to invest in it, we want to make sure we're partnering with somebody who is going to be successful because we're using public dollars," Fiegenschuh said. "I thought the study was very interesting and I think there's a lot of opportunity for us here in Rochelle to do all kinds of housing mixes. Not just applying for grants for it, but also working with our local developers to get that done."

Bricks engraved at Veterans War Memorial

ROCHELLE — On Nov. 17, 23 bricks were engraved at the Rochelle Veterans War Memorial.

The procedure for engraving bricks is as follows: brick order forms are received, scanned and emailed to the engraver. The engraver returns a .pdf file of the brick order for verification. Then stencils are made by the engraver and brought to the memorial for engraving.

Lydia Roberts (treasurer of the Rochelle War Memorial Association) and Chuck Roberts (president of the Rochelle Veterans War Memorial Association) placed

white named markers for the bricks to be engraved.

The engraver then secures the stencil to the brick, sand blasts the stencil, forming the letter and finally applies a black paint to highlight the lettering. Locations for new bricks to be engraved are distributed uniformly. Sometimes bricks are placed next to others at the direction of the person ordering the engraving, when practical.

After brick installation, updated brick location sheets are placed in the sign to the north of the

memorial. Brick order forms can be obtained at the VFW or online at the City of Rochelle website under community-documents at <https://www.cityofrochelle.net/community-documents/3219-rochelle-veterans-war-memorial-rev007/file.html>.

All brick orders received before the fall deadline of Sept. 15 were engraved and the location sheets have been updated. Bricks are typically engraved in the spring and fall.

There are currently 853 engraved bricks at the memorial.

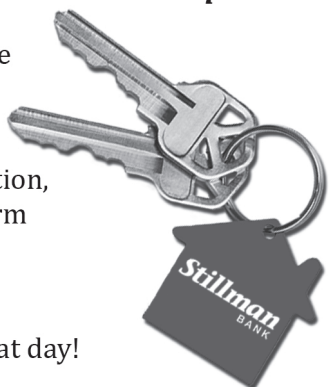

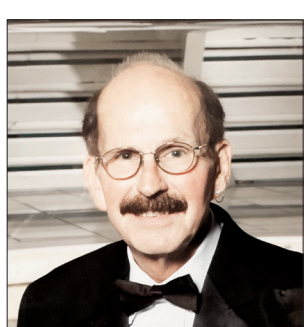

Winning the Battle Against Worry

DO you spend time worrying about things in life that are beyond your control? Are you constantly trying to figure situations out? If that's you, I want to let you know that you can rest in God and trust Him to fight your battles for you. It took years for me to learn that worry is useless. All it did was aggravate me and it didn't change a thing. Worrying is like sitting in a rocking chair and rocking all day—it keeps you busy, but you get absolutely nowhere. At the end of the day, you're still sitting right where you were when you started. God didn't create us to live worried and stressed-out. The truth is there is no need to worry because we can trust God completely. The Bible says that we shouldn't worry about tomorrow or what we're going to eat or drink or wear

because tomorrow will have sufficient problems of its own (see Matthew 6:25-26). And God gives us the grace we need every day to handle whatever that day brings. We need to learn how to trust God one day at a time. Instead of trying to figure out tomorrow, we just need to thank God for today. In 1 Peter 5:6, the Bible talks about humbling ourselves under the mighty hand of God that he may exalt us in due time. And the very next verse says, "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you" (NIV). God wants to take care of us. It amazes me that many times we believe that if we think about our problems long enough, we can actually figure them out. We would be so much better off if we would just wait on God to show us what we need to know about the

situation. I want to encourage you to get comfortable with not knowing. Part of trusting God is having unanswered questions. Many people have questions they want answers to, but when they get those answers, they don't feel the need to trust God anymore. When I need a breakthrough and I'm trying to figure everything out, I just say, "God, I thank You that

You're working right now. I don't see any progress or feel anything happening, but I've prayed. And the minute I prayed, I believe You started working, and I am going to see the victory." In 2 Chronicles 20, King Jehoshaphat faced many enemies coming at him all at once. At first, the Bible says he felt fear, but then he "set himself [determinedly, as his vital need] to seek the Lord" (verse 3). Jehoshaphat had a big problem, but he didn't sit down and worry. Instead, he set himself to seek the Lord and hear what God had to say. Then in verse 15, God sent a prophet who told Jehoshaphat to "be not afraid or dismayed at this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's" (AMP). Well, that is good news. You can win the war with worry because God

wants to fight for you. In verse 17, he says, "You need not fight in this battle; take your positions, stand and witness the salvation of the Lord who is with you." So the position Jehoshaphat took was to get down on his knees and worship God. And he stayed there, worshipping God until he got a breakthrough. Then, in verse 22, when all the people began to sing and praise the Lord, their enemies got so confused that they killed each other. If you want to confuse the enemy when problems are coming at you, instead of worrying, put your focus on God—worship, sing, and give praise and thanks to Him. Trade your worry for worship, and watch God begin to work. Don't ever say again, "I'm just a worrier." Your new confession is, "I do not worry. I trust God."

Nutrient loss reduction strategy report announced

THE Directors of the Illinois Department of Agriculture and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are announcing the release of Illinois' third Nutrient Loss Reduction Strategy (NLRS) Biennial Report.

The report describes the continued progress being made in Illinois as well as challenges to reduce nutrient losses from multiple sources to improve water quality in Illinois and downstream to reduce the hypoxic zone in the Gulf of Mexico.

The 2015 Illinois NLRS established a goal to reduce the amount of nitrogen and phosphorus in Illinois waterways by 45 percent with interim reduction goals of 15 percent nitrate-nitrogen and 25 percent total phosphorus by 2025.

Implementation of the statewide strategy is guided by the Illinois EPA, Illinois Department of Agriculture and University of Illinois Extension with the Policy Working Group and other stakeholder groups and councils. Like other states, Illinois faced unprecedented challenges, including extreme flooding in 2019,

followed by the global pandemic in 2020.

Despite these events, partner organizations, working both collaboratively and independently, remained committed to the strategy with the assistance of virtual meetings and continued engagement. It has been evident that additional resources, outreach and land and facility improvements are necessary to meet the strategy's main objective of improved water quality in Illinois. Illinois has seen progress in application of agricultural conservation practices, wastewater treatment plant improvements and government support at the local/watershed level. That said, shifting climate conditions require the need for continued reductions from all sectors.

During 2019-2020, the agriculture sector reported spending nearly \$27 million implementing the Strategy outside of traditional government cost-share programs. In addition, the Nutrient Research and Education Council invested \$6.9 million for nutrient research and education programs. During that same period,

over 72,000 people attended more than 1,020 outreach events including field days, conferences or workshops to learn about practices that can be implemented to reduce nutrient loss from farm fields.

Through its Partners for Conservation cost-share program, the Illinois Department of Agriculture assisted farmers by redirecting funds to implement an additional 93,750 acres of cover crops after a historic flooding in 2019. The department's Fall Covers for Spring Savings program also supported 50,000 additional acres of cover crops in 2019. This year's report shows Illinois farmers are reporting increased knowledge of the strategy, which resulted in an increase in cover crops, with 1.4 million acres planted, representing a 135 percent increase from 2011. Illinois also saw a significant decrease in phosphorus fertilizer application rates in 2019 with 11.2 million acres of croplands reported as having less applied compared to 2011.

Spending by the point

source sector increased significantly from \$65.1 million in 2019 to \$185.2 million in 2020. Point source sector reductions are largely regulated through Illinois EPA's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit program, with 36 percent of major municipal wastewater treatment facilities having permit limits for total phosphorus. Facilities are taking additional steps, and since 2018 have developed 71 nutrient reduction optimization studies and 59 nutrient reduction feasibility studies. Outreach and education have also continued in the point source sector with 13 events held, reaching more than 2,600 stakeholders.

Illinois EPA's Water Pollution Control Loan Program continues to provide low-interest loans for wastewater treatment plant upgrades. In 2019 and 2020, Illinois EPA invested over \$200.2 million to projects to improve nutrient removal, green infrastructure, urban stormwater treatment, and control of combined and sanitary sewer overflows.

Thanks to online platforms, the urban stormwater sector continued to reach a broad audience of more than 14,000 stakeholders, sharing tips for homeowners to reduce nutrient losses from their property. Additional practices from this sector showed more than 77 percent of Illinois' Municipal Separate Storm Sewer system communities have implemented street sweeping and approximately 64 percent have implemented leaf collecting. With leaves representing a significant source of urban phosphorus loads, implementation of both practices results in decreased loading. In 2020, Illinois EPA launched the Green Infrastructure Grant Opportunity program, providing funding to projects that reduce stormwater reaching Illinois waterways. Illinois EPA saw great interest in the first year of the program and provided \$5 million in funding, with an additional \$4 million being provided by local match, which will support 11 projects.

It is well documented that increased precipitation results in higher nutrient loads. Higher nutrient loads

are expected to occur in wetter years compared to drier years. Illinois EPA continues to partner with the United States Geological Survey to monitor and analyze water quality data and will continue to discuss options to analyze the data to account for variations in flow. Ultimately, the 2015 strategy was built to incorporate flexibility into implementation, thus allowing the addition of two new practices - saturated buffers and terraces - to the list of recommended agriculture conservation practices. Additional recommendations may be added in future Biennial Reports.

Long-term solutions to protect joints

PERIODIC aches and pains can affect anyone. Individuals who are physically active and even those who live largely sedentary lifestyles may experience pain from time to time. In fact, many professional and amateur athletes experience relatively minor, short-term injuries at one point or another, and rest is often the best remedy to overcome such obstacles. Though minor tweaks may be somewhat normal, long-term issues like persistent joint pain should not be written off as par for the course. It can be tempting to write joint pain off as a concern only serious athletes need to worry about. Terms like “tennis elbow” and “runner’s knee” can give less physically active individuals a false impression of joint pain and what causes it. But the Mayo Clinic notes that lack of exercise can contribute to pain and stiffness in the joints. That’s because exercise strengthens the muscles and tissues that surround the joints. That added strength puts less

stress on the joints. In recognition of the threat posed by chronic joint pain, the Arthritis Foundation® recommends individuals take various steps to protect their joints over the long haul. Focus less on fashion in regard to footwear. High heels may be the epitome of glamorous footwear, but women who routinely wear high heels will pay a steep price. The AF notes that heels put added stress on the knees and increase risk for osteoporosis, and experts indicate that three-inch heels are seven times more stressful on feet than one-inch heels. But women aren’t the only ones whose footwear fashion sense could be hurting their joints. Men also must pay attention to what they’re putting on their feet. For example, sandals without a back strap force toes to overgrip the edge of the sandal, putting need less strain on each foot and potentially causing issues with the toes. Alternate between sitting and standing throughout the day. Joint stiffness



and strain can develop when individuals spend lengthy periods of time sitting or standing. The AF recommends taking a break to stand up or sit down every 30 minutes. Professionals who sit at a desk all day may want to switch to height-adjustable desks that make it easy for them to transition from sitting to standing and still get their work

done. Maintain a healthy weight. Being overweight causes a ripple effect that impacts the entire body, including the joints. The AF notes that researchers have determined that losing 11 pounds can reduce risk for osteoarthritis of the knee by 50 percent. On the flip side, each extra pound an individual carries puts four times the

stress on his or her knees. Exercising to lose weight can provide the added benefit of preventing joint stiffness. Opt for low-impact activities. Low-impact activities like cycling and swimming are easier on the joints than fitness classes that involve high-intensity dancing and kickboxing. In addition, when choosing

between a treadmill and elliptical machine, the Mayo Clinic notes that ellipticals are generally considered low-impact machines that are less stressful on the knees, hips and back than running on a treadmill or even outdoors. Various strategies can help individuals maintain healthy, pain-free joints over the long haul.

Age-based health screening guidelines

EARLY detection is crucial to overcoming serious illnesses. Preventive care is something parents prioritize when raising children, but it’s a crucial component of healthy living as an adult as well. Health professionals recommend various age-specific screenings and tests, and these can serve as a guideline for individuals as they navigate adulthood. The following age-specific health screening rec-

ommendations, courtesy of Beaumont Health and Columbia Doctors Primary Care, can serve as an preventive care guideline, though doctors may advise patients to get more frequent screenings depending on their medical histories.

18-39 years old

Cholesterol: A cholesterol check should occur around age 20, then every five years until age 35. Afterward it can occur annually.

Skin screening: An annual full body screening will identify any suspicious moles or skin lesions.

Cervical cancer: Women in this age range should receive a Pap smear every three years and an annual pelvic exam.

Breast exam: Self-examination of the breasts and examination by a clinical provider should take place every year.

Testicular exam: Men should conduct self exams for testicular abnormalities. Doctors may examine the testicles during annual physicals as well.

Tdap vaccine: All adults should get the Tdap vaccine if they did not receive it as an adolescent to protect against pertussis, and then a Td (tetanus, diphtheria) booster shot every 10 years.

HPV vaccine: The human papilloma virus vaccine is recommended if you did not receive it as an adolescent.

any colorectal illnesses is recommended beginning at age 50.

Prostate screening: Prostate screenings begin at age 50 unless you are a high-risk individual, in which case screenings begin at age 40.

Osteoporosis: Doctors may recommend a bone density test and osteoporosis screening at age 50 and up if certain risk factors are present.

Lung cancer screening: If you are a past or current smoker, it’s wise to have an annual lung cancer screening. The American Lung Association says adults

age 55 and up can have this screening covered by health insurance.

Mammogram: Women should begin receiving annual mammograms at age 40.

65 and older

Cervical cancer: Most women can stop getting Pap smears at this age if they have no history of cervical cancer. Women who have had a hysterectomy may no longer need pelvic exams after age 65.

Pneumococcal and pneumonia vaccines: These are recommended every

five years for certain conditions and risk factors.

Cognitive health: Doctors may assess your cognitive health to see if there are any risk factors for dementias.

In addition to these screenings, doctors may conduct annual depression screenings to assess mental health. Routine blood glucose monitoring may be necessary based on risk factors for diabetes.

Individuals are urged to speak to their doctors to map out a health screening schedule specific to their needs.

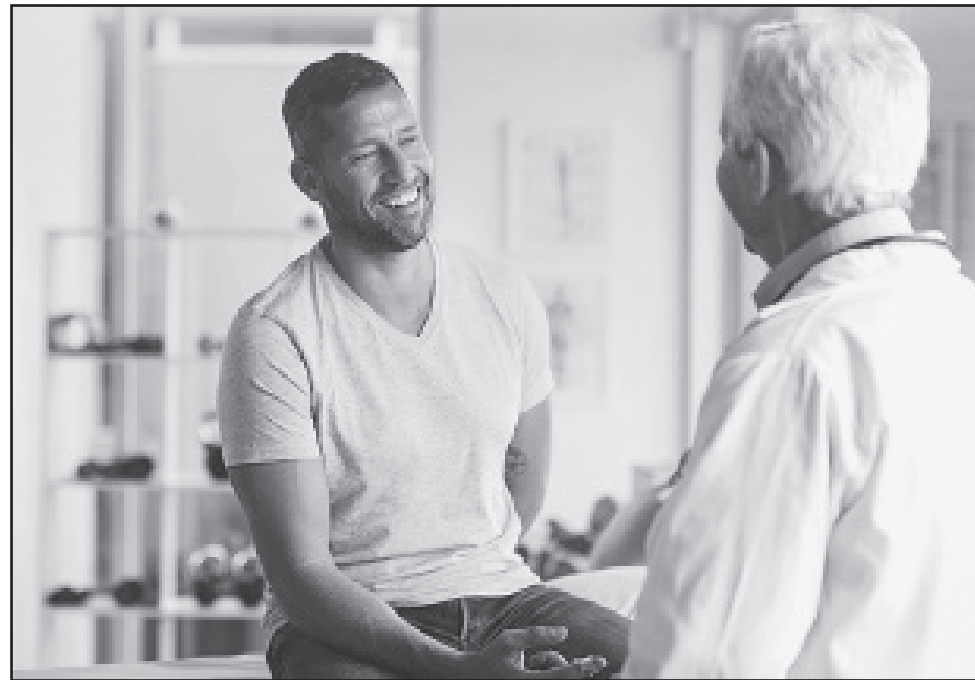

CITY: Agreement for new fire training facility approved

Property sale

The city council unanimously approved the sale of two properties on South 7th Street to Tim Bruns and T & R Rentals, LLC. Mayor John Bearrows abstained from the vote. 860 and 890 S. 7th Street were recently vacated by Rochelle Municipal Utilities personnel after a move to a new location. The properties were sold together for \$260,000. Those funds will go back to the RMU water/water reclamation department.

Fire training facility

The council unanimously authorized an intergovernmental agreement with the Lee/Ogle Fire protection district for the construction of a new fire training facility. The facility, planned to be located at 920 S. Main St., will act as a training center for the city and the district. City staff is also discussing a partnership with the Tennessee Valley Authority and the American Public Power Association to utilize the location for a midwestern pole climbing school and lineman training center. The approximately 12-acre property would be owned by the city and would be managed by the city manager and fire chief and was appraised for \$580,000 in 2021. Under the agreement, the OLFPD would pay the city \$263,000 and would split the cost of future development with the city based on usage of it.

Remodeling design

The council unanimously approved \$38,000 for retention of Cordogan & Clark for design services for remodeling of its new Commercial Service Building at 1030 S. 7th St. The former Johnson Tractor Building was purchased by the city earlier this summer. Cordogan and Clark will complete a master plan study that will entail a multi-step, all-encompassing plan for improvements to the building. If approved, design and construction would take place throughout 2022 with staff relocations beginning toward the end of 2022 or early 2023.

E's Corner Deli

The council unanimously approved a development agreement with E's Corner Deli, a deli/restaurant that plans to open at 430 Lincoln Hwy. The city will reimburse the business up to \$40,000 for the installation of a larger water service from the city's water main to the building and the installation of a new sanitary sewer line. The grant is conditioned upon E's Corner Deli commencing business operations by May 1, 2022.

Police agreement

The council unanimously approved a four-year collective bargaining agreement with the Illinois Council of Police union after the city's CBA with its patrol officers

and dispatchers expired earlier this year.

The new agreement includes three percent cost of living adjustments for the next three years, an additional 15-year step added to the wage grid, a new shift differential for evening and overnight shifts, increased uniform allowance, sick leave accrual on a pay period basis to match other employees, compensatory time increased from 60 to 70-hour bank, an additional holiday day and increased employee contribution for health insurance. The union has already ratified the agreement.

"This agreement represents a good faith effort on both sides to come

to an agreement that is mutually beneficial to our employees and the city," the meeting's agenda packet said. "We have enjoyed a productive and positive relationship with our police officers and dispatchers and this agreement represents these positive steps."

Water meters

The council unanimously approved a \$539,718 purchase of water meter equipment. The city is working to have all of its 4,200 meters under the same manufacturer and system and is in the final phase of its replacement program which will install 1,900 meters and communication devices. Equipment

will start to be installed early next year.

Gas pump

The council unanimously approved the donation of a Standard Oil gas pump to the Flag Township Museum. The pump was donated to the city's historic filling station several years ago.

The filling station is being utilized as The Spark Shop, a retail incubator space for local makers and space is limited, so the city recommended that the pump be donated to the museum for display. The pump has no working components inside and has a value of under \$1,000. Councilman Tom McDermott abstained from the vote.

Good News

City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh presented a Good News award at the meeting to Finance Director Chris Cardott and Industrial Development Manager Peggy Friday after the city received the Government Finance Officers Association Distinguished Budget Presentation award.

"We applied for it the first time last year," Fiegenschuh said. "It's unheard of to receive it your first year. I'm very proud of all the hard work our staff has done. We're in such great shape financially. We have an amazing budget and kudos to Peggy and Chris for all their hard work."

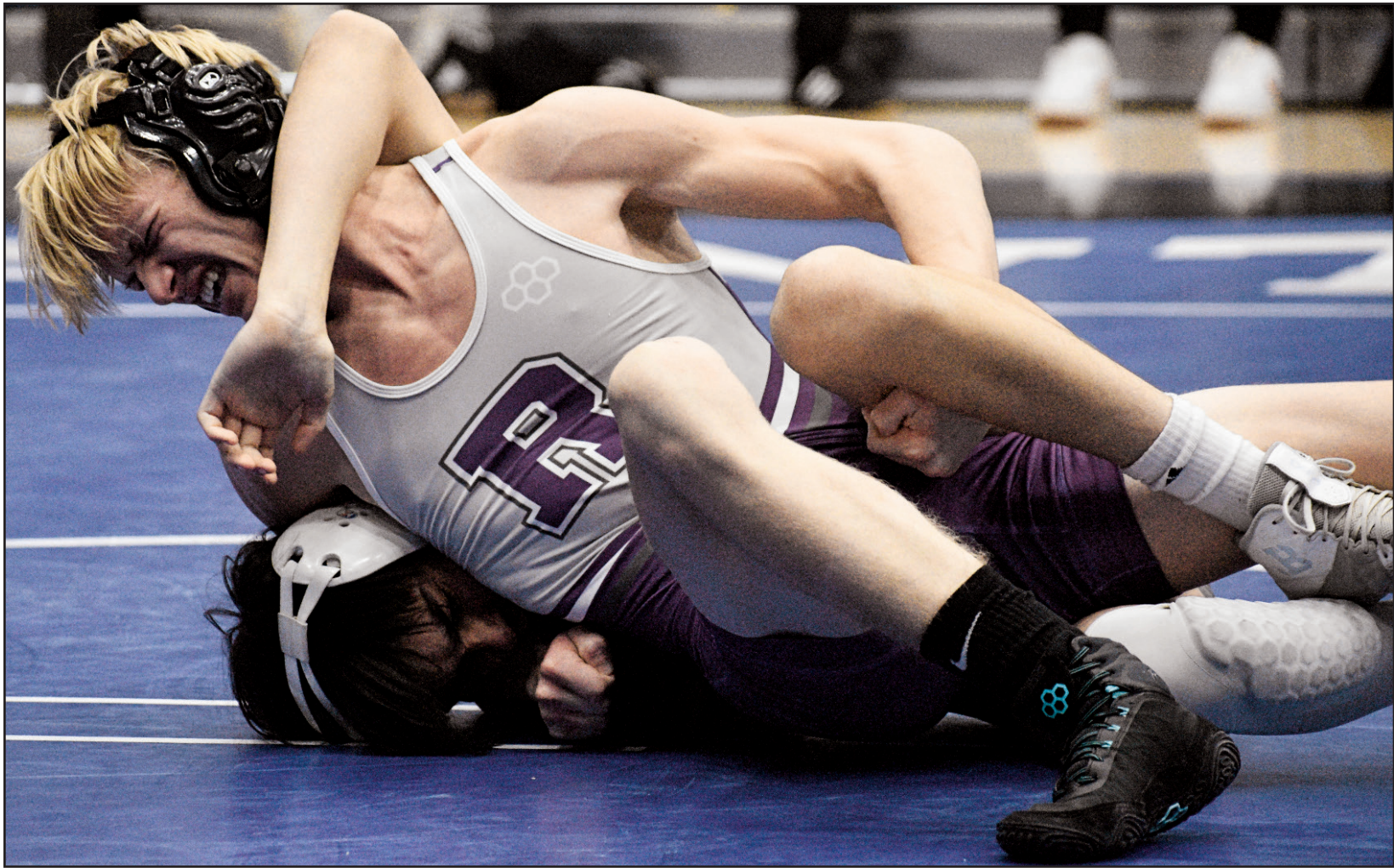

Harvey concludes collegiate career at Isthmus Bowl

FORMER Rochelle student-athlete Alex Harvey was grateful for one more opportunity to suit up alongside his Washington University-St. Louis teammates this past Saturday, when the Bears battled the University of Wisconsin-River Falls Falcons in the Inaugural Culver's Isthmus Bowl, which features one team from the CCIW Conference and another from the WIAC Conference.

Harvey shined for the WashU defense, totaling a season-best 10 tackles as the Bears fell to the Falcons 48-27 to finish the season with a 7-4 record. After seeing his junior season canceled due to COVID-19, Harvey was excited to make the most of his final season with the WashU program.

"Competing with my teammates one last time was a great experience," Harvey said. "I really enjoyed the whole process from traveling to preparing for a team we hadn't seen before."

A two-time Academic All-CCIW and one-time Academic All-UAA honoree, Harvey concluded his four-year collegiate football career with 117 total tackles including eight tackles for loss. Harvey also recorded four sacks, two fumble recoveries, one forced fumble and one pass breakup. In his first season, Harvey earned the Dean's Award as the team's Most Valuable Freshman.

"Throughout my career at WashU, I've enjoyed growing with my teammates on and off the field," Harvey said. "The defense as

a whole is an extremely tight-knit group and I know I can count on those guys to back me up through thick and thin. Committing to the grind year in and year out and seeing results was extremely rewarding. I've also been lucky to have been around such an extraordinary group of coaches who truly care about us as players and people."

Harvey played on special teams and filled a reserve linebacker role during his freshman season before becoming a starting linebacker as a sophomore. Despite losing his junior season to COVID-19, Harvey didn't miss a beat as a senior, starting at linebacker once again and playing all 11 games. Harvey appeared in 30 games throughout his four-year career with the Bears.

"I really enjoyed my senior season," Harvey said. "I learned a lot more about the game throughout my career. I began to understand why we made the calls we made and that allowed me to do my job to the best of my ability. I became sharper mentally over my four years and I really picked it up this season. I played faster and was in better positions as a result."

Harvey will travel to Middletown, New York for one final football game on Dec. 4 before his collegiate career officially comes to a close. Academically, Harvey said he will begin applying for medical school in March before graduating with a degree in biomedical engineering in May. Harvey said he hopes to enroll in medical school before the start of the fall 2023 semester.

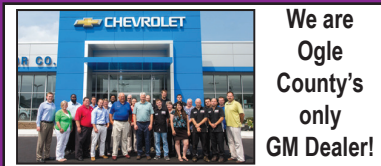

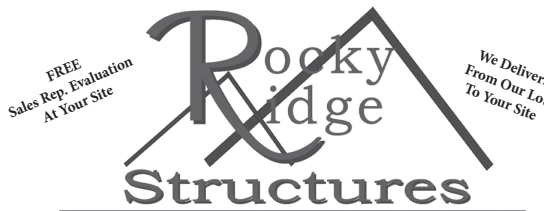

HOLLYWOOD — Ryan Gosling began his career on “The Mickey Mouse Club,” but we’d never have expected him to play “Ken” to the sexy Margot Robbie’s “Barbie.” Now that Disney owns Mattel, he’ll be back in the “club.” His last film, “First Man” (2018), barely broke even, but he’s since filmed Netflix’s most-costly film ever, the action thriller (with a \$200 million price tag) “Gray Man,” co-starring Chris Evans, Ana De Armas and Billy Bob Thornton. Will Ken’s missing equipment be restored for the Disney movie, or will Barbie dump him again?

Margot Robbie is still one of the busiest actresses in films. She stars in the still-untitled David O. Russell film with a magnificent cast, including Christian Bale, Rami Malek, Robert De Niro, John David Washington, Zoe Saldana, Mike Meyers, Michael Shannon and Chris Rock. She also toplines “Babylon,” as silent-film legend Clara Bow, co-starring Brad Pitt, Toby Maguire and Jean Smart (due Christmas 2022), and she’s in the all-star ensemble of Wes Anderson’s latest, “Asteroid City,” with Tilda Swinton, Bill Murray, Adrien Brody, Tom Hanks, Scarlett Johansson, Bryan Cranston and Jeff Goldblum. Anderson’s recent release, “The French Dispatch” (made two years ago and pulled from theaters), got positive reviews from 74% of respondents on Rotten Tomatoes.

The current release of “Dune” was successful enough to get the green light to start pre-production on the sequel, “Dune: Part Two.” The original David Lynch “Dune” (1984) tried to tell the entire story in one film, but making it a huge two-part screen epic seems to have worked for this one. It grossed \$41 million in its first weekend and pulled in nearly 2 million viewers on HBO Max at the same time.



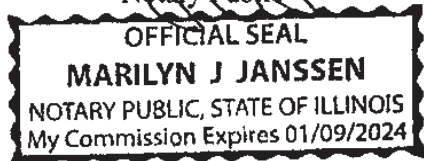

"I owe it all to my offensive linemen. I felt I performed well this season but there's always room for improvement and I plan to have a way better senior year. I thought I improved most in being more aggressive, not being scared of anyone and always going hard on every play."

Three two-way linemen earned All-Conference recognition for Rochelle including senior Brodie Nantz, junior Jaden Cook and freshman Kaiden Morris. A three-year varsity starter, Nantz started at center and chipped in three tackles on the defensive line

this season, while Cook started at left tackle and defensive end, recording 19 tackles, three tackles-for-loss and netting two sacks. Morris started at right guard and recorded four sacks on the defensive line.

"Being named All-Conference was a big accomplishment and honor for me," Nantz said. "It's one of the goals I've had for a long time. I felt like we all took big steps from last year. I thought I improved in being a better vocal leader and not letting my teammates turn on each other when things got tough. The team staying together was a big reason I was able to improve."

"It's amazing and it feels

like all the hard work I put in over the offseason paid off," Cook said. "I want to get to the next level and be better than anyone I face next year. I thought I played well this year, but I have things I still need to work on. I thought I improved most in keeping my pads down and staying low. I also improved my footwork and I thought that showed in my film."

"It's a great accomplishment and it's been a goal of mine since the beginning of the year," Morris said. "I felt I performed well but there's always room for improvement. I thought I improved in staying on my blocks, which has always

been a weak point for me."

Three senior defenders earned First-Team honors including defensive end/linebacker Braden Alfano, linebacker Tanner Lager and defensive tackle Marco Castro. Lager recorded 38 tackles including three tackles-for-loss, while Alfano had 38 tackles and one tackle-for-loss. Castro compiled 18 tackles, two tackles-for-loss, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.

"I'm honored to receive this recognition, especially in such a tough conference," Alfano said. "I'm really happy with how I performed this season. I was able to fill roles that

I had never played before when the team needed me. I thought my biggest improvement from last season to this season was being more versatile and being able to learn new schemes and positions."

"It's a great honor to be named All-Conference First Team this season," Lager said. "With us playing in a really good conference, I think it's a great honor... I feel like I really stepped up my defense compared to the spring season. I felt like my open-field tackling improved a lot compared to the spring season. Our defense really improved as the season went on."

"I'm very honored to

have been nominated and I'm incredibly proud of myself and my teammates," Castro said. "I felt like I did well, but some days I wish I had done better. I felt like we did a really good job this season and it was one of the best seasons we've had since 2004. I improved this year in getting more tackles and I had a good extra-point percentage this year."

Four Rochelle players took home All-Conference Honorable Mentions including senior quarterback/free safety Josh Lloyd, senior right tackle Grant Messer, senior tight end/defensive end Ethan Wells and junior left guard/defensive end Bradley Cooney.

When not testing you do not need to be on campus during finals. For instance, if you have a Per 1 study hall on a regular school day, you do not need to be here until 9:30 in time for the Per 2 final on Dec. 20.
If you are here, you may study, talk quietly, or have a snack in the Commons or opt to study quietly in the LMC (Library) until your next final begins. You cannot be anywhere else in the building, including locker areas or academic wings, if you are not taking an exam unless you have permission from an administrator or teacher.
Only students who are ill or have a cleared absence through the main office are excused from semester exams. If you miss an exam without an excuse, your final exam grade will be a zero.
If you have an excused absence, your grade will be marked "I" (incomplete) and you will take the final exam Wednesday, January 5, 2022, the last day of winter break. Classes resume Thursday, January 6, 2022.
How do I prepare for final exams? Final exams count as 15% of your semester grade for each course, so it's important to study and do as well as you can. In the weeks leading up to finals, teachers will give you a final exam review sheet or discuss with you ways that you can prepare.
Use FLEX Thursdays to prepare: schedule one on one time with a teacher, ask for a student tutor, visit Mr. Vrana's Infinity Math classroom, or arrange to take makeup tests or quizzes in the test room through your teacher.
