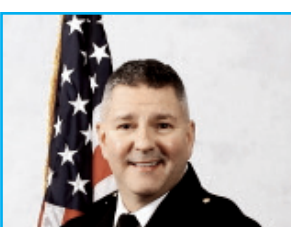

# Harper discusses student testing program

‘We hope to help families determine their child’s status much quicker’

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Schools Superintendent Jason Harper said the districts’ new onsite COVID-19 student testing program ran about 15 tests per day after starting last week.

The optional testing program is located at May School and is designed for symptomatic students or staff members who want to clear themselves to return to school with a negative rapid test. Harper thinks the site will administer more tests as the weeks go by.

“We anticipate this number will most likely go up as the typical cold and flu season ramps up during the late fall and winter,” Harper said in an email.

The districts plan on testing Monday through Friday from 8:30-11:30 a.m. as long as they have the resources to run the program. Hours could change based upon resource availability and changes in testing hours will be posted on the districts’ Facebook pages.

Once a child has received a negative COVID-19 test and they are symptom-free for 24 full hours without medication, they can return to school.

Parental written consent is required for testing.

The school districts use BinaxNOW COVID-19 antigen tests that they’ve received through the Ogle County Health Department. The rapid test is a nasal swab that is inserted roughly one centimeter

into the nose. Test results are texted to testees. In many instances, test results come back within 30-45 minutes.

“Through our partnership with the OCHD, we continue to have access

to free BinaxNow tests,” Harper said. “We continue to work with the OCHD to ensure our district has enough free test kits to continue our local program.”

# ‘It’s a really hometown type of shop’

Rochelle antique store Pickin’ Station opened in February

**ROCHELLE** — The history starts before you even get inside Pickin’ Station, the Rochelle antique shop that opened in February.

The site at 708 Lincoln Ave. was a Texaco gas station years ago. Studebakers were also sold there. That’s why Owners Pam Easton and Stan Bennett decided to have an old Texaco sign and gas pump and a Studebaker car out front. Easton said she’s had to turn down buyers for the historic items.

“I just want to bring back a piece of Rochelle’s history,” Easton said. “That’s why we did that. I just happened to see this was for sale. We wanted to have that old gas station theme and sell that kind of stuff. It was perfect that this used to be a gas station. So many people want to buy our display stuff. And I can’t sell it. If I do, what’s going to attract people here?”

Easton and Liliana Rodriguez, the shop’s man-

ager, say business has been “going really good” despite just eight months in business. Pickin’ Station has seen customers come from “all different states” including Alaska.

The shop operates under

a consignment model with and rents out selling space to 40 different vendors along with the things Easton sells of her own.

“I chose the vendor model because I wanted variety,” Easton said. “I didn’t

want to just sell my stuff. Because not everybody likes a certain kind of stuff. If you have variety, then you catch all different kinds of people that want different kinds of stuff. I think it’s better to have variety than

to just do my own thing.”

Easton and Rodriguez attempted to detail some of the rarer and more interesting items that have come through the shop.

## Creston board finalizes sewer rate increase

Trustees unanimously approve farm lease during Tuesday meeting

**ROCHELLE** — The Creston Village Board unanimously approved the raising of its sewer rates in the village by 5.5 percent starting Jan. 1, 2022 at its Tuesday meeting.

The decision comes after Rochelle Municipal Utilities, which provides sewer service for Creston, informed the board that it would be raising its rates to the village 5.5 percent every year for three years. The first increase took effect Aug. 1. The increases were made to cover improvements to RMU's water treatment plant.

The village previously planned on increasing rates by three percent Jan. 1 to cover expenses of its own. Rather than deciding to go up to an 8.5 percent increase to cover RMU's increase and its own, Creston officials opted to just raise their planned increase by 2.5 percent. The plan is for a 5.5 percent increase for three years before reverting to a three percent increase annually in 2025.

### Farm lease

The board unanimously approved the lease of 144.6 acres of farmland the village owns to Eric

Petry in a one-year contract at \$310 per acre.

The term is from March 1, 2022 until Feb. 2023. It gives Petry the right to renew for one year at the same price, terms and conditions. Petry did not attend the meeting and still needs to sign the agreement.

Village President Tom Byro said at last month's meeting that the village wanted a short-term agreement because of "other things" going on in the future that may change the course of future leases.

### Water meter reader

Byro said the village has yet to hear about the status of its new water meter reader that it approved a \$9,795 expenditure for at its August meeting.

The new handheld device also comes with an annual \$1,950 a year service contract between the village and the company that provides the handheld and a radio frequency. The village is currently looking to hire someone local to use the water meter reader.

"Our machine has still not come in," Byro said. "We're waiting on that. We do have a couple of people now that live in

town that are possible people we can use if we get this thing going. We'll have to go with another month of bills that are estimated."

### Downtown grant

The village is currently looking at applying for a Rebuild Illinois Main Street & Downtown Capital Program grant to improve its downtown area. Village Engineer Kevin

Bunge said the minimum funding the village can request is \$250,000 and the maximum is \$3 million.

"There's \$50 million available for the whole state," Bunge said. "If you ask \$3 million for a community this size, you're probably not going to get it. It is specifically for downtowns in rural areas. It needs to be improvements to a street with substantial commercial frontage on it. You need to show you've been hurt

by COVID-19."

Grant applications are due Jan. 10. The grant can be used for sewer, water or street improvements including street scape, lighting and sidewalks.

### ARPA

Byro said the village should be getting the first section of its American Rescue Plan Act funds this month. The second half will come in next year. The payouts are for \$43,000 "and change" each.

The village is still deciding what to do with the funds and they must be used for "bondable" improvement projects and not maintenance.

### Halloween

The village board said Halloween trick-or-treating will take place in Creston on Sunday, Oct. 31 from 5-8 p.m.

"It's optional for the residents," Byro said. "If they want to wear a mask, they can."

## Higby: Car thefts, burglaries not up from last year

'Honestly they're just about identical to last year'

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby said last week that despite what you may see on social media, car thefts and burglaries in town are not up from last year.

Local Facebook groups have seen multiple posts of car burglaries in town over recent weeks and the summer. Higby said there have been 15 car burglaries this year so far and there were 15 in all of 2020. There have been eight car thefts this year and there were nine in 2020.

"Honestly they're just about identical to last year," Higby said. "This year, it seemed like our car thefts were up and that vehicle burglaries were up. I suppose we have another couple of months where we could surpass those numbers of last year.

Any time we run numbers like that, you could pretty much pick your category and think that we'll be higher this year, but we don't end up having many spikes."

Higby said during the summer there was "a rash of" 3-5 car thefts in a week or two.

"I was thinking this year we'd have more," Higby said. "When you have a rash of them like that and they're right on top of each other, it gives that perception, public or internally, that we're having an uptick. Social media is a big part of that too."

Higby detailed the steps that are taken following a car burglary or theft that include fingerprinting the car, checking Ring doorbell cameras and other types of cameras in the area and speaking with neighbors and owners of

the vehicles.

Higby said that "almost none" of the impacted vehicles are actually broken into and that the vehicles involved are usually unlocked.

"It's people leaving cell phones or change and things like that," Higby said. "That's what the people are looking for is a quick grab. We'll literally have people tell us they'll watch these people go up and down the streets and they're yanking on door handles. If they're locked, they'll go to the next car

rather than break in. The next one will likely be unlocked. If people would just lock it up, that's how you keep your stuff safe. Don't keep your keys in your car either. That's what happened with most of the car thefts this year."

Higby said the department tries to remind residents to lock up their cars on social media and during some neighborhood watch meetings.

The Rochelle Police Chief said the burglaries in town this year have not been in a specific area and

have been "pretty much all over the place" from the north side to the south side and in the middle of town. The most recent one was Sept. 24 at the Petro Travel Plaza, Higby said.

Some burglaries may go unreported in town due to victims not thinking that anything is missing from their vehicle, despite not finding it how they left it.

"I will say I'm aware that some people will be the victims of burglaries or criminal trespass to a vehicle where they get up in the morning and can tell

their stuff has been rifled through but they don't really feel like anything's missing, so they take to social media and they don't call us," Higby said. "The other day we caught people doing burglaries and found some property on one of the guys but we couldn't tie it back to a specific car. Nobody came forward, so there was no arrest. You don't have a victim. That happens probably more often than we know."

Harper said other schools like Rochelle have gone in different directions and some do not offer onsite rapid testing and some offer testing in other ways that meet their specific community needs. The districts are not required to provide onsite testing for students and staff and chose to offer it on their own. Harper said in his original release about the program that he hopes

it will not only decrease student absences, but also help students and staff take another step towards normalcy in the school year. The state is allowing school districts to participate in a "test to stay" program. Following an indoor exposure, with the exception of a household exposure, if schools test close contacts on days one, three, five and seven from date of exposure, a child can remain in the classroom as long as they

test negative. Harper said that so far, the test to stay program has allowed students to return to the classroom more quickly than in the past. "Depending on the situation, we also do rapid tests for students who experience a symptom while at school during the school day," Harper said. "In providing increased access to rapid tests, we hope to help families determine their child's status much quicker than before."

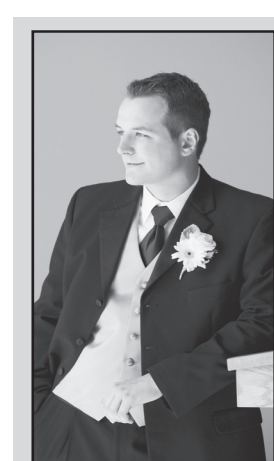

## Set Your Mind in the Right Direction

**I**N Colossians 3:1-2, the apostle Paul has specific and vitally important instructions for every believer in Christ who has accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. I have taught about these verses from the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, which says, "If then you have been raised with Christ [to a new life, thus sharing His resurrection from the dead], aim at and seek the [rich, eternal treasures] that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. And set your minds and keep them set on what is above (the higher things), not on the things that are on the earth."

Notice in verse 1 that those who have new life in Christ are to "aim at and seek" things that are above. I like the use of the word seek, because the original term in the Greek language means "to crave,

to pursue, and to go after with all your might." This is what it means to really seek God.

Paul continues his instructions by saying "and set your minds on things above." The Amplified Bible, Classic Edition reads, "And set your minds and keep them set on what is above" (emphasis mine). Setting our minds on the right thing once or twice won't do us much good, but if we set them in the right direction and keep them set, we will be victorious.

When Paul urges us to set our minds and keep them set "on things above," he is not simply telling us to prepare for the day we will go to heaven or to envision the pearly gates. He means that if we want to live a life that honors God, we cannot think about things that are low, base, common, or ungodly.

We need to put our minds where we want our lives to be, because our lives will follow where our thoughts lead. According to Proverbs 23:7, however we think in our hearts, that's how we will turn out. I always say, "Where the mind goes, the man follows."

To help us understand what it means on a practical level for us to think about "things above," meaning right and excellent things, let me start by listing some low things people often think about. Thinking about what you don't have, instead of what you do have, is a low thing. Thinking about people who have things you would like and saying they don't deserve them is low. Thoughts of jealousy, pride, anger, comparison, and judgment are low, as

is holding grudges against people instead of forgiving them. Focusing on your faults instead of your strengths is low, and so is wallowing in self-pity and feeling condemned about your past mistakes.

Of course, high thinking is the opposite of low thinking. When your thoughts are set on things above, you thank God for every blessing you do have instead of complaining about what you don't have. You rejoice with others over their successes instead of being envious. You encourage people who are pursuing what you would like to do or what you would like to have instead of secretly hoping they don't get it. You choose peace over anger, humility over pride, mercy over judgment, and forgiveness over unfor-

giveness. You pray instead of worrying; you trust God in every situation instead of taking matters into your own hands; you stand firm in faith that God has a bright future for you instead of feeling guilty over your past. There are many other ways to think high thoughts, and I believe these examples will help you know how to do that.

I hope you will always remember how powerful your thoughts are. A made-up mind is very powerful. What you think about will determine the quality of your life. When you think happy thoughts, you live a happy life. Don't let the devil control your thinking; do your own thinking. Think according to God's Word and believe the best of everyone.

Once you have set your mind on something, it's important to keep it set and

to not doubt yourself or become double-minded. The apostle James says, "The one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind... Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do" (James 1:6, 8 NIV).

Once you have explored your options, prayed, sought God's will, and made a decision in a matter, you can set your mind firmly on that course of action. You have to reach the point where you know that what you plan to do is the right thing and say, "My mind is made up. With God's help, this is what I'm going to do, and it will produce good results in my life."

Today, make a determined decision to seek God more and to set your mind on the promises in His Word. If you do, you'll find there is nothing you cannot do through Christ.

Why? Well, it is easier these days to react in a public way instantly. Read something you don't like on social media? Respond with a negative comment. Don't like something you read in the paper or an online publication? Comment or shoot off an email.

war. If they get return fire, they simply shut down the computer.

## Residential electronics recycling set for Oct. 16 and 29

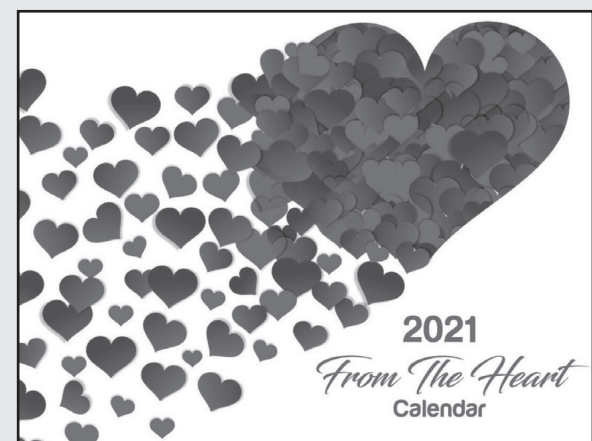

They've included a Murphy bed from the early 1900s, a whale gun that shoots harpoons and "a lot of" petroleum-related items that fit the shop's theme. Outside, you'll find a phone booth with a payphone in it. Inside, you'll find a vintage jukebox.

"We've had a lot of cool stuff come in," Rodriguez said. "But it comes in, and it sells right away."

Easton and Rodriguez said the Pickin Station prides itself on its atmosphere and they wanted to make it a comfortable place to come to even just

have a cup of coffee or tea. They like to keep the shop bright and the TV on. They enjoy talking and hearing stories from the people that come in.

"We have a lady that comes in every week," Easton said. "She's 88 years old. We call her Pickin Station grandma. Every Tuesday she sits with us."

Pickin Station tries to do a flea market at least once a month. The business also works with local residents that are attempting to sort out estates of loved ones that have recently passed away.

"They just give us a

call and say they have a space for us to come and look through," Easton said. "They have some stuff left over. I buy whatever I think I should buy and try to resell it here in the store. It happens a lot. People don't know what to do with their stuff and don't want to have an auction or a garage sale. They don't have time."

The owners of Pickin Station had to make the tough decision of opening during the COVID-19 pandemic. Easton said she didn't expect it to go as well as it has. She finally gave into urging from Rodriguez, her manager, and landed on a Feb. 2

open date.

"I said I was afraid it wasn't going to do very well," Easton said. "I think people got to the point where they were tired of being cooped up. They had enough of it. It had almost been a year during COVID-19. When I opened, they were glad we were here for someplace to go. There wasn't a lot open. I said we wouldn't know until we tried. I was going to wait until spring or summer. Then we started to get more vendors."

Now, prospective vendors have to be put on a waiting list before they can sell items at Pickin Station.

Easton said she thinks the antique industry is doing "pretty well" right now. She's seen the younger generations getting into it lately. Pickin Station sells some furniture to those that want something unique and don't want to buy from furniture stores.

Pickin Station is also proud of some of the local historic items it has that come from the city it resides in, along with promoting other businesses in the downtown and Rochelle area, Easton said.

"We have a lot of Rochelle stuff in here," Easton said. It's a really hometown type of a shop.

As much as we have wanted an antique shop with a little bit of everything, the best part is when you get the word out that we're here and we tell them about all the other shops there are around here. We refer people everywhere, all through town. We want to help other small businesses here."

Some of the history at Pickin Station doesn't come from the items at all.

"You can't wait to go in the next day to see the different kinds of people you're going to meet," Easton said. "That's what's nice. You hear the old stories."

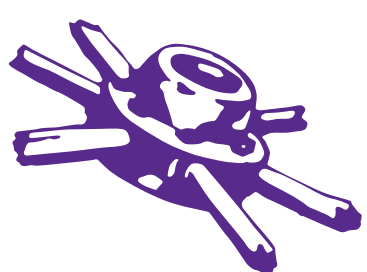

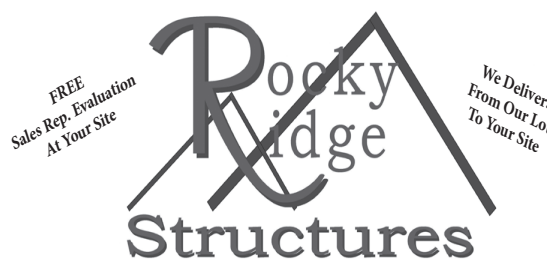

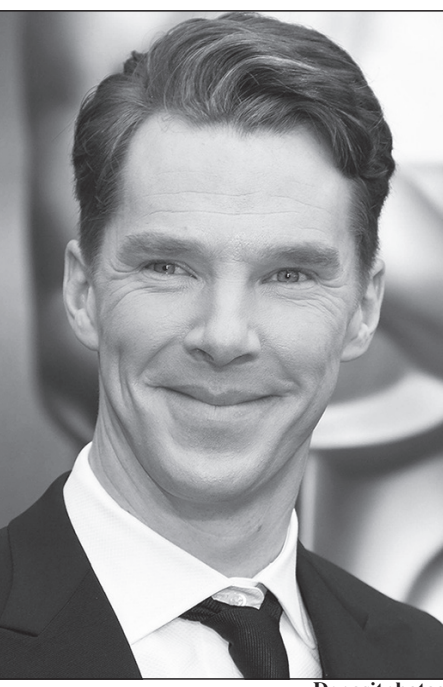

## HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — **Benedict Cumberbatch** lost his 2014 Oscar bid (for “The Imitation Game”) to “The Theory of Everything” star **Eddie Redmayne**. If the four-minute standing ovation at The Venice Film Festival for “The Power of the Dog” (due Nov. 17) is any indication, he’ll be in the running for an Oscar again. The film is based on a novel about a 1920s Montana rancher who is angered when his brother brings home a new wife and her son.

Cumberbatch has more movies lined up. “The Electrical Life of Louis Wain,” about an eccentric British artist famous for his distinctive paintings of cats, arrives in theaters Oct. 22 and on Amazon Prime Nov. 5. He’ll again be Doctor Strange in “Spider-Man: No Way Home” (dropping Dec. 17) and in “Doctor Strange in the Multiverse of Madness,” due in March 2022.

Belmondo starred in such classic films as the crime drama “Breathless” (1960), with **Jean Seberg**, and “That Man from Rio” (1964), and was compared to **James Dean**, **Marlon Brando** and **Humphrey Bogart**.

When Belmondo passed away on Sept. 6, French television stations altered their schedules to screen his films, drawing more than 6.5 million viewers. The French newspaper The Guardian hailed him as an integral part of the history of French cinema and France herself. Dinklage’s Roxanne is **Haley Bennett** of “Hillbilly Elegy.”

Oscar-winning director **Taylor Hackford** plans to reinvent film noir with “Sniff,” starring **Helen Mirren** (his wife), **Morgan Freeman** and **Al Pacino**, as well as **Danny DeVito**, which has Freeman and DeVito investigating two murders in a luxury retirement community. Mirren also has the war drama “White Bird: A Wonder Story,” with **Gillian Anderson** (out September 2022), and the sequel “Shazam! Fury of the Gods,” coming June 2023.

## HUBS: Rochelle faces Plano on the road next Friday

Kaneland took the early lead in the first quarter, with quarterback Troyer Carlson finding wide receiver Sam Gagne for a 41-yard touchdown pass. Rochelle answered on its first drive of the game, taking over five minutes off the clock and scoring on a 1-yard touchdown run from junior Garrett Gensler, who finished with a season-high five rushing touchdowns in the win.

The Hubs flipped the script on the Knights during the ensuing kickoff,

emerging with a big special teams play after senior Ethan Wells sprinted and collided with a Kaneland returner, sacrificing his body to recover the short kick and give Rochelle the ball again. The Hubs capitalized on the Kaneland mistake, scoring on Gensler's 2-yard touchdown run.

Leading 14-7 in the second quarter, Rochelle saw its defense make the team's second game-changing play of the night, with senior Braden Alfano stripping Gagne of the football and junior Cody

Stover-Cullum recovering the fumble. The Knight turnover resulted in a long and methodical Hub scoring drive that erased nearly 10 minutes off the clock and resulted in a 21-yard touchdown run from Gensler, who shed multiple Kaneland tacklers on his way.

"We aren't beating ourselves," Kissack said. "We had some mistakes earlier this season that were self-inflicted. When that happens and we don't win first downs, it puts us in a really difficult position. We've been winning first downs

recently and we have five players who can carry the ball effectively and be a threat on every snap. We're doing a good job with our communication up front in terms of keeping helmets on helmets and handling stunts."

Rochelle received the second-half kickoff and moved right down the field, melting seven minutes off the clock and scoring on Gensler's fourth touchdown run of the night, this time from 2 yards away. The Hub defense stopped Kaneland on its next drive, forcing the Knights to punt before extending their lead once again, with junior Trey Taft busting outside and breaking tackles for a 43-yard touchdown run. Taft finished with a season-high 196 rushing yards.

"We talked after the

game about enjoying the win and protecting the team," Kissack said. "We have to stay humble on Monday and we have to find more ways to get better. Plano's a good football team and if we talk all next week about how we played tonight, we'll have problems."

The Knights went down fighting in the fourth quarter, with Carlson tossing two touchdown passes including a 45-yarder to Johnny Spallasso and a 36-yarder to Gagne. Gensler, who scored his fifth touchdown on a 1-yard rush near the end of the fourth quarter, totaled 68 rushing yards, while Stover-Cullum topped 100 yards for the second straight game, finishing with 106.

Rochelle will face Plano

on the road next Friday at 7 p.m.
