## RCH combating registered nurse shortage

‘We have seen some activity that we hadn’t seen before’

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Community Hospital CEO Gregg Olson said last week that he’s seen the effects of a nationwide shortage of registered nurses locally.

As of last week, RCH had five open RN positions that its human resources department is in the process of filling. Not all of them are related to staff leaving and some of the openings are a result of sustained growth the hospital has experienced in patient care areas.

Olson stressed that no single department at RCH is more important than another, but outlined reasons for the importance of RNs on staff.

“They work at the top of their license,” Olson said. “They are the caregivers in many cases. They’re supplemented by nurse’s aides or medical assistants, but they do have somewhat of a leadership role when it comes to managing the patient. We desperately need those people in the positions that are there. They have that ability to react to what they’re seeing

with our medical staff to provide a plan of care and carry that out. They’re very important to the operation of this hospital and in any hospital.”

During the earlier, more serious stages of the pandemic,

RCH didn’t say many staff members in general leaving. Since then, staff members such as nurses have seen attractive new employment opportunities. He said registered nurse is one of the hardest positions

to fill right now.

There are companies that are hiring registered nurses away from RCH to work at home.

“They’re getting some pretty high wages to do that,” Olson said. “Not only

do they not have to physically come to work, they can stay home and watch their kids and do their job at the same time. It’s very attractive.”

## How Biden’s prospective vaccine mandate would impact local law enforcement

**ROCHELLE** — Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle said last week that his office would not be subject to a COVID-19 vaccine mandate made by President Joe Biden on Sept. 9.

The mandate calls for all employers with more than 100 workers to require them to be vaccinated or test for the virus weekly, affecting about 80 million Americans. The move was made due to rising COVID-19 cases and stagnating vaccination rates.

VanVickle said his office only has 78 employees and is not technically under the Ogle County umbrella that would also include all other county employees and make that number much

larger.

“The office operates on its own,” VanVickle said. “The only relationship with the county is that they approve our budget. It’s separate.”

VanVickle said most of the mandates that have impacted law enforcement have been through municipalities, like the City of Rochelle. City police operate as city governments do. When asked about the mandate’s impact on his department, Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby directed all questions to City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh.

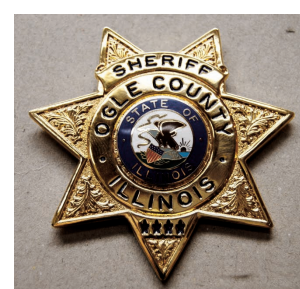
Fiegenschuh told the News-Leader last month that the mandate would affect the city and its employees including the police department. He said the city is taking a “wait and

see approach” to the issue and he thinks there could be court cases challenging the order, which could delay or change its outcome.

The city manager said he’s already had discussions with Rochelle’s legal team and their input was to wait and see what rules come from the department of labor.

“We’re assessing the order and monitoring it through the department of labor,” Fiegenschuh said last month. “We want to see what regulations or rules come out from the department of labor on how they think it’s supposed to be implemented.”

VanVickle said his office and law enforcement in the state has been impacted by a COVID-19 vaccine mandate that applies to the



police academy for new hires.

“I know there’s issues throughout the state,” VanVickle said. “New hires have to be vaccinated before they can go to the police academy. There have been individuals that have refused it. It’s their choice. It’s a concern. I know the City of Chicago and industries are seeing issues.”

VanVickle lamented the possibility that the academy mandate could lessen the already “record low turnout” for applicants for open law enforcement positions.

“It just compounds the issue of trying to get qualified people in to help protect the community,” VanVickle said.

The sheriff said he does

not document whether or not the employees of his office have been vaccinated. He has discussed the idea of a possible mandate coming out for law enforcement with them in the past.

“It’s been talked about at our office,” VanVickle said. “We’ve told them it’s their personal choice and we’ll let them make that decision for themselves.”

VanVickle said the sheriff’s office continues to use mitigation processes to prevent the spread of COVID-19 when employees interact with the community, each other, people in their offices and with operations at the jail.

“We’ll continue to take these steps,” VanVickle said. “We’ve had no active cases in the jail with inmates.”

## RCH seeing uptick in non-COVID inpatients

‘There have been days where we have not had a bed available’

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Community Hospital CEO Gregg Olson said last week that over the last several weeks the hospital has seen a “significant” increase in the number of non-COVID-19 inpatients it treats.

“There have been days where we have not had a bed available,” Olson said. “That’s pretty unusual for us. We’ve actually had to board a couple people in our emergency room to wait for beds to open up upstairs. We’ve not done that before, and that I’m familiar with. And the inpatients we’re taking care of are sicker than we’ve

typically seen in the past.”

RCH is still seeing COVID-19 patients and is averaging 1-2 per day, Olson said. It had many more during earlier times in the pandemic.

“It’s not the COVID-19 patients that are overrunning us right now with the volumes,” Olson said. “It’s sick people with other diagnoses.”

RCH has also seen a “significant” increase in the number of patients it’s treating in its emergency department, Olson said. In the last several months it’s seen “probably close to double” the amount of patients it usually sees, he said.

That isn’t just specific to RCH. Olson has col-

leagues all over the state that run similar-sized hospitals that are seeing the same scenario.

The hospital has also seen increased numbers of surgeries, Olson said. He believes some of that is due to having a new orthopedic surgeon on staff, but the increase is being seen in other surgical areas.

Olson believes part of the reason surgery rooms, the ER and medical floor have been busier is patients deferring care due to the pandemic.

“People have chronic conditions and the chronic conditions have worsened because of reluctance to go to a hospital because of the fear of attracting the virus,”

Olson said. “Now, people feel a little more comfortable and they are coming in more. We are starting to see these individuals who probably should have come in earlier. We’ve felt the

impact of that.”

When the pandemic first hit, hospitals like RCH closed down some of their departments such as the cardiac rehabilitation center, fitness center and cafeteria. He said the message that conveyed, whether RCH realized it or not, was that people should not come in unless they were really sick due to having COVID-19 patients in-house.

“It’s not that we chased people out of here, but we just wanted to be transparent with people and say we did have the virus in this building,” Olson said. “If you’re really sick, please come in. Don’t not come in. But if it’s something that can wait or you’re not quite that ill, then you have to make an informed decision.”

Olson said due to the pandemic and closing departments, RCH and the industry as a whole saw a “huge” drop in volumes. He said RCH had some of the worst revenue months of its fiscal history. But that was the best way RCH found to keep its patients, visitors, staff and community safe.

“I think it was those actions that were taken early on that made people say, ‘I’m not going in there. I’m going to stay home,’” Olson said. “And they did. Now, unfortunately in some situations, people probably should’ve come in. I can’t speak in specifics, but we have just seen a huge increase in the number of patients we’re seeing and they’re sicker.”

As far as whether RCH will continue to see higher inpatient numbers, Olson

said that is yet to be seen. He doesn’t think the hospital is at a point now where it could justify adding beds. It does have the ability to, if needed, add a level of 10 percent a year without state approval.

But, 90 percent of what RCH does is outpatient, Olson said. And he doesn’t think it’s going to stray too far from that.

“I think we’re going to continue to be mostly an outpatient facility that has good inpatient capabilities,” Olson said. “And we’ll have to see how this looks in the future. If we continue to see these high census numbers, yeah I think we have to think about what next steps we need to take.”

RCH did get extra beds from the state during the pandemic that were kept in reserve. They actually were not used due to the pandemic. Inpatient numbers didn’t get “out of hand” during that time, he said, but it’s now that RCH is seeing the “big numbers.”

Late in September, Olson said RCH was “bursting at the seams” due to increased inpatient numbers. That has lessened since.

“Now it’s slowing down a little bit and getting back to normal,” Olson said. “I think we’ll probably end up getting back to where we were in time. As we grow as an organization and add more services, obviously our strategy is to attract more people. And we’ve been successful. Part of it is we’re also gaining some market share. That’s part of it, too. If that continues then I think we have to look at it.”

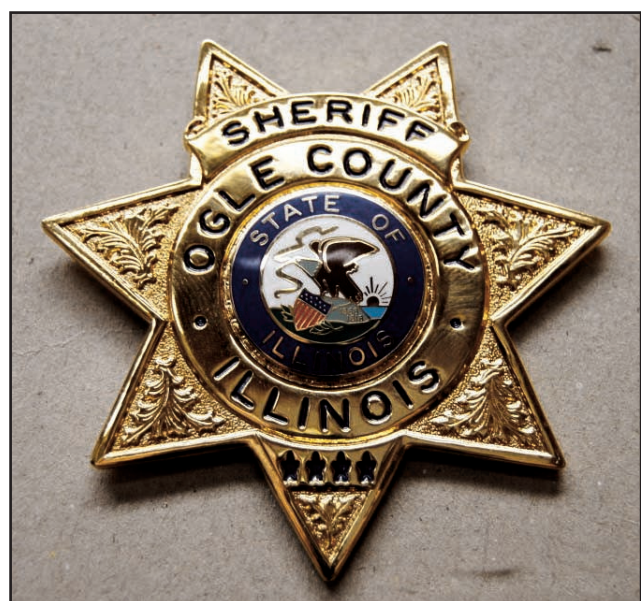

## Why society is not the way it used to be

I did something this past week that I never expected to find myself doing. During a normal conversation, it was brought up how things used to be.

Specifically, the “I remember” was when a quarter pounder meal was \$2.98, and buying gas for \$.24 a gallon when I was in high school. past generations comes back to a fundamental element of society, which is accountability for your actions — being accountable for the words you say, being accountable for the actions you take and doing them for the right reasons.

Accountability is nearly non-existent today, except for one constant. The buzzword has been holding police accountable, which I am completely in favor of, but what about the rest of society?

What about other professions and their bad actors? What about individuals that law enforcement interacts with? Are they being held accountable? Are these ever-growing crimes we see on the news the result of prosecutors not holding people accountable? Is the judiciary not holding people accountable? Why are we seeing record crime numbers even with all of the reform?

While the answer appears to be very simple, the days of the past have certainly changed; our direction as a country has changed because of a lack of accountability. We see the lack of accountability on social media, we see it in the mainstream news and it’s unfortunate because I would love for future generations in my family to grow up and live in a society with which I’ve benefited and lived.

Do not let others be the only impact your children learn from today. Impactful mentoring can start or end with you. We all need to be teachers and not just cheering from the stands.

"Plus make more money. We've seen that. We've seen insurance companies do that. We have lost some folks to that sort of arrangement."

RCH has also lost "some" registered nurses that have gone into a "travelers type of circuit" where they work for a company that assigns them to different parts of the country for 13-week stints where they're "paid very handsomely," Olson said.

RCH has had to bring in some agency registered nurses to help supplement its current staffing levels, Olson said. He said he hopes that's short-term because it's "very expensive."

"We have seen some activity that we hadn't seen before," Olson said. "Does it concern us? Yes. And it should. We're certainly holding our own. We have the staffing. Our goal is to

provide the best possible care we can for our patients and the community and keep our staff safe. We're going to do that."

Olson said he couldn't say enough positives about his staff as a whole about its work throughout COVID-19 and said the focus remains on the patients RCH sees. As far as registered nurses, there are some positions RCH is initiating where it will be doing things a "a little bit differently" and adding a nurse in a role it hasn't had before.

Olson said measures are being taken industry-wide to combat the registered nurse shortage and have been for a while. The issue was also seen a few years ago, he said. New programs were introduced and colleges, universities and technical schools did things like expanding class sizes.

"There were more options," Olson said. "Virtual education where you

can sit behind a computer at your house. You have to do hands-on of course,

but a lot of times you can do a lot of the education piece virtually. There's

more opportunity for people to get into the nursing field. And I think that's

a result of having more access points to different programs."

# Hubs win fifth straight

## Rochelle defense steps up with three sacks in 28-20 victory over Plano

**PLANO** — When the Rochelle Hub varsity football team needed big-time defensive stops during Friday’s Interstate 8/Kishwaukee River matchup against Plano, freshman standout Kaiden Morris rose to the occasion, dropping Reaper quarterback Carson Gill twice for two of the team’s three second-half sacks as Rochelle held off Plano for a 28-20 victory on the road.

It’s the fifth consecutive win for the Hubs (6-2, 4-1 Interstate 8/Kishwaukee River Blue), who clinched an automatic berth to the playoffs with Friday’s victory. While Plano running back Ray Jones challenged the Rochelle defense, rushing for 140 yards and three touchdowns, Morris and the Hubs limited Gill to only eight completions and 23 yards of total offense.

“It feels great to get this win,” Morris said. “We wanted to come out here and shut them down on defense so we could come back out on offense and score. We’re taking everything one week at a time and we have to move on and get ready for our game against Sandwich next week.”

Rochelle scored on its opening drive Friday, erasing almost nine minutes from the clock and taking

the early lead on a 1-yard rushing touchdown from junior Garrett Gensler, who finished with 130 yards and two touchdowns on the ground. A bad snap halted Plano’s first drive, setting the Reapers back several yards before being forced to punt. The Hubs capitalized on the Plano mistake, scoring on Gensler’s 23-yard rushing touchdown during the second quarter.

“We’re rolling right now,” Gensler said. “We got after them tonight. Their defense was presenting some challenges for us but I thought we handled them well. They were talking a lot tonight and there were a few penalties, but we have good leaders and we stuck together.”

Plano cut into Rochelle’s lead before halftime, with Jones finding the end zone on a 4-yard touchdown run to make it a 14-7 game near the end of the second quarter. The Reapers received the second-half kickoff and quickly moved down the field, capping off a three-minute drive with another 4-yard touchdown run from Jones that tied the game at 14-14.

After Plano stopped Rochelle’s ensuing drive and forced the first Hub punt of the night, Rochelle

immediately responded on defense, with Morris sacking Gill for an 8-yard loss on fourth down to give the ball back to the Hubs. The defensive play energized the Rochelle sideline and the offense, which saw junior Cody Stover-Cullum break through the middle of the Plano defense for a 60-yard touchdown run on the very next play to put the Hubs ahead again.

Leading 21-14 entering the fourth quarter, Rochelle’s defense was presented with another chance for a fourth-down stop. Answering the call for a second time, Morris knifed through the Plano offensive line, sacking Gill for an 11-yard loss and forcing another turnover on downs. The sack set up a 10-play, 70-yard and nearly six-minute scoring drive that Stover-Cullum capped off with a 6-yard touchdown run to effectively seal the victory for the Hubs.

“We’ve been a lot more physical on defense,” Gensler said. “We changed up our scheme and it’s been working well for us. We’re getting stops when we need to and we’re making plays.”

Stover-Cullum finished with a team-high 137 rushing yards for the Hubs, who host Sandwich for Senior

Night next Friday at 7 p.m. Four players including seniors Braden Alfano and Tanner Lager totaled seven tackles on defense, with junior Bradley Cooney adding one sack.

Brandyn Metzger led the team with 10 tackles.

Sophomore Brock Metzger finished with six tackles and 53 rushing yards, while freshman Xavier Villalobos recorded an interception and had 56 rushing yards Friday. Freshman Ryan Senne had one tackle for loss.

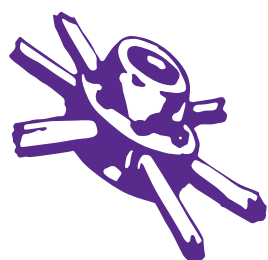
