Plans in place for vaccine mandate

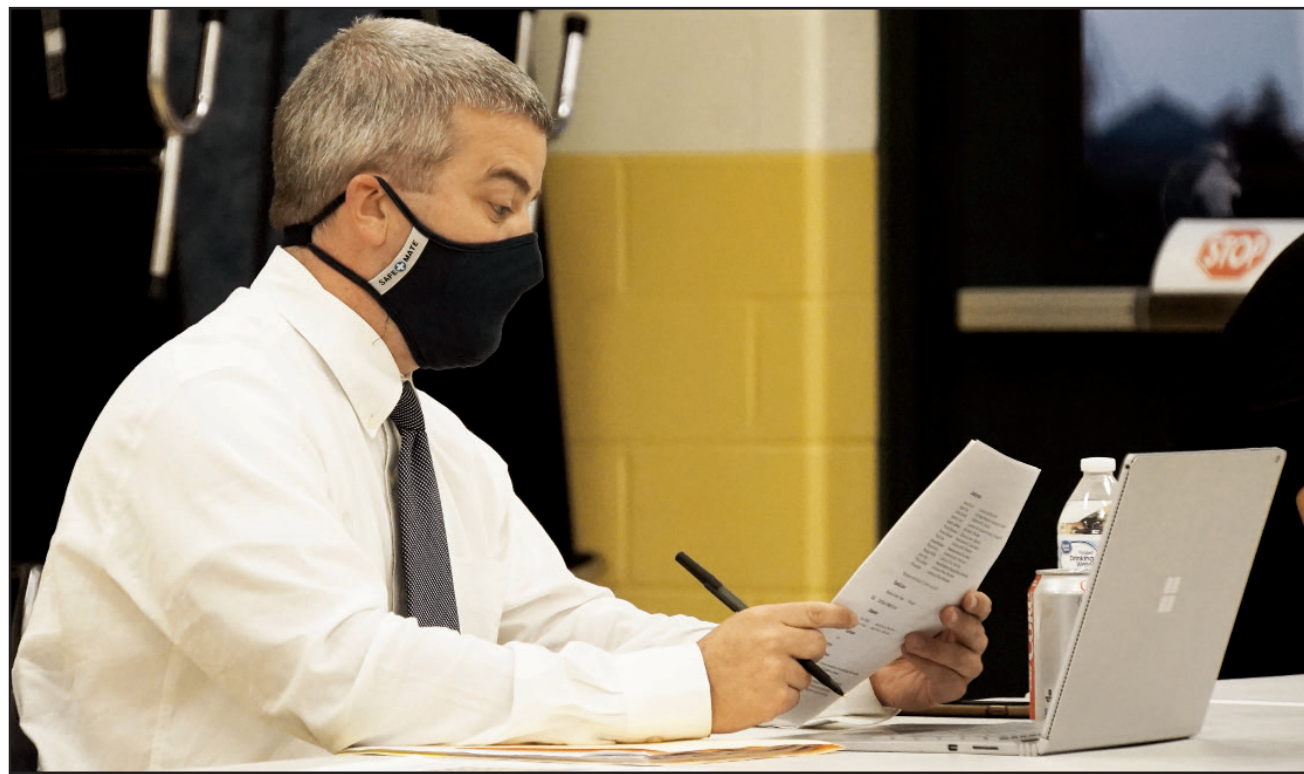
Weekly testing for unvaccinated staff starts this week

ROCHELLE — At the Rochelle Elementary School District 231 meeting Tuesday, Superintendent Jason Harper said plans are in place to follow Gov. JB Pritzker's vaccine mandate for all staff members starting Monday.

The mandate requires school employees to be tested once a week if they are not two weeks out from their second COVID-19 vaccination. Harper said between the elementary district and High School District 212, about 85-90 employees are not fully-vaccinated and will have to submit to weekly testing. 50 of those are in the elementary district.

After finding out it was unable to use rapid tests it had on hand due to the mandate, Harper said the district now plans to participate in a saliva testing program with Sauk Valley Community College that will see employees' tests transported to Dixon

to be tested and results will come later that day.

The Rochelle school districts will be paying for the employees' tests, as the state provides free testing for school students and staff members. Staff members have the option of getting tested on their

own, but Harper said the district wanted to have in-house testing for them.

The original announcement of the mandate came on Aug. 26 with it scheduled to take effect Sept. 5. It was pushed back when school districts and other required industries were

scrambling to find testing methods. Harper said the mandate has been difficult to manage.

"In these last several weeks we've gotten a constantly-changing message about what's acceptable and what's unacceptable," Harper

said. "So, our frustration lies with giving a mandate to schools without really any input from the schools and really very few ways in which the school can comply with that mandate."

Pritzker signs bill to save Byron plant

Illinois governor finalizes new legislation on Wednesday

BYRON — The familiar sight of steam rising from the Byron Generating Station continues, although it is down to rising from one tower as the station refuels.

With Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker signing a new energy bill that was favorable to nuclear plants into law on Sept. 15, the Byron Station will continue to operate. It's owner, Exelon Generation, had threatened to close the station on Sept. 13 without the new bill.

"I was both excited and relieved to watch the Illinois Senate provide a concurrence vote in favor of SB2408," said Erin Folk, executive director of the Oregon PBYronark District and part of FAIR-COM (Fair Assessment Information Resource Committee). "Local taxing bodies, state legislators, community members and so many others have spent the past year working together for a common goal and our efforts paid off. Nuclear energy not

only creates the opportunity for clean energy, but it saves jobs, stabilizes the local economy and allows taxing bodies to continue to provide the services our residents have come to rely on."

The same day the Illinois Senate passed the bill, Exelon released a statement saying the Byron and Dresden stations would be refueled and not shut down. Dresden was scheduled to be closed later this year.

"We commend the governor, the General Assembly, our partners at IBEW Local 15 and the coalition of labor leaders and members who worked so hard to pass this roadmap for building our economy and addressing the climate crisis by investing in clean energy in a way that ensures that jobs and environmental benefits are shared equitably," said Christopher Crane, president and CEO of Exelon. "The new policy offers a better future for the employees who have run these plants at world-class levels, the plant

communities that we are privileged to serve and all Illinoisans eager to build a clean-energy economy that works for everyone."

Todd Tucker, executive director of the Byron Forest Preserve District, said that not only are the nuclear plants needed to reach clean energy goals, but they are economic engines for the local economy.

"It's paramount for our agency," he said. "It's paramount for our taxpayers, our schools."

As one of the local of-

ficials dedicated to keeping the plant open, Tucker said the grassroots effort to keep the Byron plant open certainly helped.

"You can't lay back and act like it's going to happen anyway and not do anything," he said.

The new bill was signed more than a year after Exelon announced the two plants would close. The Byron plant provides about 700 jobs as well as millions in local tax revenues.

The Byron CUSD 226

paid for the economic impact study, and it showed that about 74 percent of the district's revenue comes from the Byron Station.

The study showed that the Byron Station's direct contribution to the regional economy (GDP) is estimated to be more than \$288 million. That is 1.6 percent of the total GDP of the region. For the Ogle County, Byron Station's total contribution to the economy is estimated to be \$338 million; 17 percent of the county's total GDP.

Harper said so far, teacher's associations, non-certified staff members, transportation department members and others that the mandate applies to have been "great to work with." At this point, he said the districts have seen "zero staffing loss" due to

the mandate.

"They might not 100 percent agree with this latest vaccination and weekly testing mandate, but they understand it's beyond our community's control and at the end of the day, they're so passionate about being with our students and helping them out that they've been

willing to work with us on the mandate," Harper said.

Enrollment

Harper gave an update to the board regarding enrollment numbers in the elementary district. From kindergarten through eighth grade, total students currently stand at 1,367, an average per grade of

151.89. The district had 51 more students at this time last year.

"We do have a drop," Harper said. "We had 171 eighth graders graduate. We have 153 students coming into kindergarten. That's part of the change there. And then of course we had some attrition. Some classes have gone up and some have gone down. The aggregate across K-8 is a drop of 51 students. We'll continue to check the numbers and they're constantly changing."

Sub rates

The board voted unanimously to increase the pay

rate for substitute teachers from \$85 per day to \$105 per day.

Harper said the reasoning for the change involved the approaching minimum wage rise to \$15 per hour along with widespread recent challenges of finding employees in more than just the education industry.

The school district had done a regional study and found that \$105 a day is on the lower end in districts east of Rochelle and pay per day ranges from \$95-105 in Ogle County.

Harper said the pay change puts Rochelle in a competitive place and

honors the work subs are doing.

"I think it makes sense," Board President Dave Casey said. "We have to compete with everybody else."

Buses

The board unanimously approved a resolution to go out to bid to lease seven 77-passenger buses and purchase one mini bus in the future. Transportation Director Sherri Smith told Harper the districts need to replace several buses.

Bid recommendations will be brought to the board for review and approval.

Fiegenschuh talks contract extension

ROCHELLE — On Sept. 11, Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh celebrated his fourth anniversary on the job.

On Sept. 13, the Rochelle City Council unanimously voted to renew his employment agreement until May 2023.

"It means a lot," Fiegenschuh said. "I love my job and I love working for the City of Rochelle. My staff is amazing and the community is amazing. It's been a wild ride, but our team has accomplished a lot and we still have a lot to do. It meant the world to me."

Fiegenschuh's new agreement runs concurrent with Mayor John Bearrows current term ending in May 2023. Because Rochelle is a non-home rule unit of government, under a state statute the city manager's

contract can't go longer than any mayor that's in office.

Rochelle's city manager said that his tenure has included "ups and downs," but he believes "quite a bit" has been accomplished in his four years.

"I don't take any credit for anything," Fiegenschuh said. "It's a team effort and we have great department heads and more importantly a great mayor and city council. From Mayor Chet Olson when I first came here to Mayor Bearrows now, and we've had two new council members come on. We've got a good leadership group."

When asked about the work that's been done in his tenure, Fiegenschuh highlighted the purchase and work done to demolish Hickory Grove later this year.

Rochelle's first-ever hiring expo held Thursday

'We hope we can change people's paths for the future'

ROCHELLE — Every time somebody was hired at the Rochelle Community of Opportunity Hiring Expo on Thursday, a bell rang.

The in-person city-wide event at Rochelle Township High School featured over 43 commercial, retail, non-profit, healthcare, industrial and staffing companies offering full-time, part-time and seasonal work. Some offered signing bonuses, employee referral rewards and other incentives to separate themselves from other employers.

The event was sponsored by the City of Rochelle, the Office of Mayor John Bearrows, Kishwaukee College, RTHS, Rochelle Foods—Hormel, 102.3 The Coyote and

Superhits 93.5.

The event was born out of a workforce shortage locally and nationally due to a multitude of reasons including the rise of people working remotely, higher wage demands, COVID-19, additional domestic responsibilities and the leverage of workers considering changing jobs.

"I am absolutely blown away," Bearrows said. "I am so happy with the turnout. I'm so happy we had 165+ pre registered before we started. And now a lot are coming in that weren't pre registered. A lot of great things are happening. I want people to come to this job fair thinking that they're going to change the path of their future and make Rochelle their forever home and the community of opportunity."

City of Rochelle Industrial Development Manager Peggy Friday said Bearrows came up with the idea several months ago and a team was put together to get it done. Kishwaukee College brought expertise from the many job fairs it's put on. Booth spaces were filled up in a couple of weeks.

The hiring expo was the first of a city-wide nature. Friday said the success of Thursday's event will mean more in the future. She was happy to see collaboration between educators, the city and businesses.

"I think we'll maybe do this quarterly or as the need arises," Friday said. "The city has been proactive on how to solve this crisis. Our goal is that Rochelle is going to figure this out. We want people to realize there are

really good jobs here and a good variety. There's hundreds of jobs to be filled in Rochelle and we want to figure that out as a community."

Rochelle Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Tricia Herrera said she was excited to see the job fair in action and people being hired

on the spot. She said she "absolutely" wants to see more events like it in the future.

He also highlighted bringing "Project Jackpot" to town, a still-anonymous business that plans to announce its intention later this year to fill the vacant Nippon-Sharyo buildings and invest over \$130 million and add 150 jobs to Rochelle.

He's also proud of the announcement that Starbucks will be building a location on Illinois Route 38 next to Walgreens. But, the city's work during COVID-19 likely tops his list.

"Probably the thing I'm most proud of is getting through this pandemic and what we were able to do to help support our small businesses," Fiegenschuh said. "I'm happy we're getting Starbucks, but I'm happy we've got other places in town that are already here that serve coffee. Just supporting our current businesses in town and what we've been able to do to help them has been amazing."

Fiegenschuh said challenges have included the potential early closing of

the Prairie State Energy Campus. The city has a \$150 million stake in the coal plant until 2042. Recent legislation states it will be able to open until at least 2038. Now, the city has to begin planning for that economic impact and how to replace that power.

The city manager is happy with the work Rochelle has done on its finances and hopes to stay on that trajectory and continue improvement.

The city is nearing a new union contract with its police department. It

has broken ground on one electrical substation and is planning another. Fiegenschuh is excited to see those completed.

"There's just a lot of good stuff going on," Fiegenschuh said. "We have a great mayor and city council and a great staff to work with. The other thing we're doing that I'm excited about, when I came in we implemented a new strategic plan and we're updating that plan. Because we have a new mayor and two new council members, I thought it was important for them to

be able to have input in the vision of where they want to see the community and the city go."

The city is also lobbying the state to reconstruct and widen Illinois Route 251 from near Flagg Road to just south of Illinois Route 38 in the near future. That will be "a great project," one Fiegenschuh wants to see through to the end.

"Getting Project Jackpot in and being able to announce," Fiegenschuh said. "The Illinois Route 251 corridor improvements and Hickory Grove over the

next couple of years, those are all just off the top of my head."

The thing Fiegenschuh loves most about city government is that each day something new comes up. He believes that in six months he could have a complete new list of issues or priorities. He hopes to be Rochelle's city manager long after his new contract expires in May 2023.

"I'd love to retire from here," Fiegenschuh said. "It's a great community and a lot of great people. It's home now."

Landscape waste and open burning in Ogle County

OREGON — The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) responds to several citizen complaints each fall regarding the open burning of landscape waste and other materials.

These complaints range from the illegal open burning of waste and trash to nuisance conditions produced by smoldering leaves, grass clippings, and other landscape waste.

The OCSWMD discourages the open burning of landscape waste in Ogle County and encourages residents to either bag up and have the landscape waste hauled

away to be composted, or use the lawnmower to mulch up fallen leaves, as opposed to open burning.

If you live in or near a municipality there may be more restrictive ordinances in place regarding the open burning of landscape waste. Check your local ordinances prior to any open burning of landscape waste.

In Illinois, most waste materials are prohibited from being openly burned. Materials which are commonly unlawfully burned include furniture, mattresses, carpet, textiles, construction and demolition debris, plastic materials and garbage.

The open burning of

most waste in Illinois is in violation of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and can be punishable through substantial fines and/or a Class A misdemeanor.

Be a good neighbor this fall and eliminate the nuisance smoke conditions and other problems associated with open burning.

Foundation announces Ronald S. Sweet Jr. Endowment

MALTA — A new scholarship has been established with the Kishwaukee College Foundation honoring Ronald S. Sweet Jr. — one of the most successful coaches in the history of Kish's volleyball program. The endowed fund will provide ongoing scholarship support for Kishwaukee College students with significant financial need. Sweet's father, Ronald Sweet Sr., recently made a \$100,000 contribution to establish the scholarship. "We chose Kishwaukee College for the scholarship because it was a very important part of Ron's life when he was coaching there," Sweet Sr. said. "It was also instrumental in his decision to further his own education. Volleyball was Ron's passion. Not only did his coaching experience and accomplishments boost his own personal confidence, but the confidence and self-assurance of the members of his team."

"The foundation is honored to work with the Sweet family to commemorate Ron's legacy by providing financial support to Kishwaukee College students," Dr. Kayte Hamel, executive director of the Kishwaukee College Foundation, said. "This generous donation will directly impact students in our community for years to come."

Sweet Jr. started at Kish in 2001 as an assistant coach under Wayne King's program, which won National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division II National Championships in 2001 and 2002. In 2003, Sweet took over the program and would capture three more NJCAA Division II National Championships as head coach in 2007, 2008 and 2009.

His career record was 336-43 (.887) during his time as head coach of the Kougars, which lasted until 2009. During his tenure, Sweet would earn NJCAA

Division II Coach of the Year two times, NJCAA Region IV Coach of the Year six times, Arrowhead Conference Coach of the Year seven times and American Volleyball Coaches Association Midwest Coach of the Year twice. Additionally, he coached numerous NJCAA All-Americans and Academic All-Americans.

"Ron continued to build the Kishwaukee College volleyball program as a national powerhouse during one of the most successful eras of Kish athletics," Scott Kawall, Kishwaukee College athletic director, said. "His efforts went beyond the achievements on the court, as Ron truly cared about the success of his athletes in the classroom and beyond."

Following his time at Kish, Sweet coached volleyball at James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia and Wofford College in Spartanburg, South

Carolina. In 2018, Sweet was inducted into both the Kishwaukee College Athletics Hall of Fame and the NJCAA Region IV Hall of Fame. Sweet passed away in Nov. 2019.

While Sweet's ties to

Kish were through athletics, the scholarship will be available to any students with financial need who are enrolled in six or more credit hours.

"Ron would be very happy to know that all

Kish students, not just athletes, will benefit from this scholarship," Sweet Sr. said. "He would also be happy to know that he is still helping young men and women continue their education."

We have recently been watching a show where the main character drives a 1960s Ford Mustang. I am not positive on the exact year, but it might be a 1967, my favorite.

Seeing that car brought me back to high school, when I had a 1969

Mustang. Man, I loved that car. As I was flooded of memories of that green car that had no power steering (that was optional then) and was actually pretty hard to drive, I thought about how many great times I had in that car. Cruising with friends, taking a girlfriend to the dive-in movie and just cranking up the music on the way to school.

But one memory stuck out more than the others. My last couple of years of high school I had the greatest job I have probably ever had. Now, that is different from my career, which I love. But this job was the best. I was a pizza delivery driver for a local pizza joint that all the kids loved and everyone wanted to work at.

It was called Lujano's, and I started there when I was 16. It was owned by a guy named Gary, and his last name wasn't Lujano. When I found out his last name, it was clear why he didn't name the place after himself. I won't repeat it here

because it is, er, not really fit for a family newspaper. But if you are an adult and very curious, drop me a note and I will tell you.

Pretty much everyone who worked there was a teenager. I think the manager was 21. Needless to say, we had a great time. I had no problem taking as many hours as they would give me. I had to pay for my own insurance and gas, so I needed the job.

But this job was not only fun, it was a way of life. When we weren't working, we would hang out there. I ate there even on my days off. The pizza was incredibly good. I even made the dough and sauce myself many times.

Gary was in his 30s and was a super fun guy. One unique physical feature about him was he had huge thumbs. And I mean sideshow size thumbs. We would tell the new employees to give Gary a thumb's up, just to watch him nail them in the face with a glob of cold dough.

We had some great and probably dangerous pranks we pulled on new hires. When you walked in the back door after a delivery, there was a long counter on the right. That is where you tossed your car keys. Between deliveries you would fold boxes, roll dough or answer calls.

Well, we would take the keys from the counter when the newbie wasn't looking and put them in the oven. After a few minutes, we get

the keys out and toss them on the counter.

Next up, simply tell the new guy that he had a delivery and watch him grab his keys and scream in pain. Good times.

Another one was waiting for the new person to go to the bathroom. The employee bathroom was outside the back door. The exhaust fan on top of the oven blew out into that bathroom — right over the toilet, in fact. So, when the new person hit the bathroom, we would grab a handful of flour, go to the oven and toss the flour into the exhaust fan.

You heard an almost immediate scream, followed by the newbie coming back into the kitchen covered in flour. What's not to love about that?

It was hot working there — the kitchen where we worked had no air conditioning and it was 115 degrees in the summer, but we didn't care. Lujano's was our home away from home.

I left when I went into the military. Sadly, a couple of years later Gary died in a vehicle accident, leaving behind a wife and two young children. A long-time employee took the business over and ran it into the ground less than five years later.

Sad, but I still have great memories of that Mustang and some great and rowdy times working at the best job ever.

Serenity has expanded their children’s resources to include day camps. The



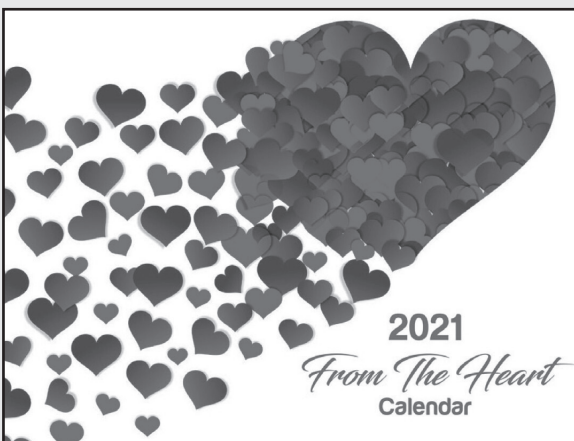

Herrera was encouraged by the turnout of employers and prospective employees. In talking with other communities that have attempted job fair-type events, she's heard they haven't been "all that successful."

"We're very encouraged and excited by this one," Herrera said. "I hope that all these employers get some of their spots filled and a little relief for their staff and just that great relationships get made."

MightyVine Office Manager Viviana Hernandez attended the event to find employees for the Rochelle tomato warehouse. She said MightyVine isn't like a warehouse or factory where production can just be stopped. Tomatoes keep growing. If they don't get picked or packed on time, they go bad.

"That's been a motivator for us to try to get out there and find people that want to join our team," Hernandez

said. "The workforce issues have definitely been affecting us. Today is amazing. Because we can spread the word and let people know we're hiring. We just want our name out there and people to know we have work available for anyone that needs it. I've already had success today."

Bearrows said Thursday was "extremely important" primarily because of the businesses and their ability to get employees and be profitable.

The mayor called the activity in the RTHS blue gym "extremely heartwarming." He said it shows the entire community was pulling together in the same direction for the benefit of everyone.

"We've heard the bell ring for some jobs that have been filled today," Bearrows said. "I'm just so happy. And honestly I'd be happy if we only had one job filled. We helped that one person change their life that's ready to make a change."

Harriers race at Skare Park

Hub and Lady Hub teams each take third

ROCHELLE — For the first time since 2019, Rochelle’s Hub and Lady Hub varsity cross country teams had the chance to compete at their home course, facing off against DeKalb, Oregon, Genoa-Kingston and Iowa’s Camanche High School in the Rochelle Invitational at Skare Park.

While the trademark hay bale hurdles and mud cup were not present for the meet on Thursday, head coach Mark Zilis and the Rochelle harriers enjoyed being back on familiar grounds. The Lady Hubs took third with 55 points in the meet, while the Hubs placed third with 64 points.

“This course is what

cross country is all about,” Zilis said. “The kids run through the river twice, which is something that isn’t done at any other race in the area. I think the kids are getting a little bit stronger with every practice and their improvements are showing up during races.”

Senior Sara Johnson was Rochelle’s highest overall finisher on Thursday, leading the Lady Hubs with a time of 22:43.5 for fifth-place. Junior Yuelma Ortiz landed one spot behind Johnson, finishing sixth with a time of 23:32.5. Juniors Karina Lopez and Gisselle Robles rounded out the top four Lady Hub runners, placing 19th and 20th with respective times of 29:17.5 and 30:46.7.

Junior David Wanner recorded the fastest time

for the Hubs in the meet, finishing eighth overall with a time of 20:58.7. Senior Josue Huerta wasn’t far behind, placing 11th with a time of 21:16.2 while senior Peter Forsberg took 15th with a time of 22:05.5. Sophomores Parker Lenkaitis and Alex Burke finished 17th and 20th with respective times of 22:32.0 and 22:50.8.

“Sara and Yuelma are constantly fighting for the top position,” Zilis said. “Our boys are constantly gaining ground and we have several guys who are fighting for the No. 1 spot. I think both of our teams will be very competitive when October comes around. We just have to keep working hard in practice. We have a hard-easy system where we focus on three days of

hard work and a few days where we back off and give the kids some rest so they can avoid injuries.”

First to the Finish

The Rochelle Hub and Lady Hub varsity cross country teams raced in the First to the Finish Invitational at Peoria’s Detweiler Park on Saturday. The Hubs finished 54th out of 55 Class 2A schools, while the Lady Hubs took 42nd out of 49 schools.

Junior Yuelma Ortiz and senior Sara Johnson ran respective times of 21:13.5 and 21:31.0 to lead the Rochelle girls in the meet. Senior Josue Huerta and junior David Wanner led the boys with times of 19:24.0 and 19:39.1.

Lance Headon came to RTHS from Creston Grade School having participated in their school sports programs and the Rochelle Junior Tackle program. In high school, he played baseball and football for his four years.

His senior football team won the conference and all nine games of the season, only losing to DeKalb in the playoffs. The entire team was named as the Hackett Football MVP in 1989. Lance was one of four senior team members to be named to the Register Star Large School All-Area Team.

As a member of the Hub baseball team, he played the position of catcher for the varsity Hubs his junior and senior seasons being selected to the NCIC All-Conference team. Headon was also named to the first team All-State-Northern Half as catcher in 1990.

Upon his graduation, Lance joined his father in the family business and continued to support the Rochelle community sports programs. He and his wife, Cass are the parents of daughters, Amanda, Autumn, Aubrey and Sade’.

Jim Hopper

Hopper was a member of the 1967 graduating class. His school record for the 1600-meter run has held at 4:21.9 minutes since that time. Jim is primar-

ily known for his track accomplishments, being awarded All-Conference, All District and All-State in track for 1965, 1966 and 1967.

Hopper received four varsity letters in track and field and four for his contributions to the cross country team. He was the leading point scorer in track and cross country his junior and senior seasons. Hopper was the recipient of the 1967 News-Leader Award. As a freshman, he was a member of the first state-qualifying cross country team from Rochelle, which placed 10th.

Following his years at RTHS, Hopper attend Arizona State University. He was a U.S. Army helicopter pilot in the Vietnam War from 1970 – 71, receiving numerous awards including the Vietnam Service Medal and Purple Heart. Following his honorable discharge from the Army, he flew as a commercial helicopter pilot for various companies. His death came as a fatal helicopter crash in 2012 in Fairbanks, Alaska.

Dusty Provow

Dusty Provow attended RTHS from 2001-05. During his time as a Hub, Dusty played football, was on the wrestling team and even ran track his freshman year. During his sophomore year, Dusty added winter lifting to his schedule.

Dusty decided to focus on football during his junior and senior year of high school. He backed football with winter and summer lifting. Dusty’s hard work paid off when helped lead the Hubs to two conference championships during his junior and senior year. In his junior year alone, Dusty set the single-season rushing record with 1,643 yards and 23 touchdowns. He was awarded a unanimous All-Conference First Team honor on offense.

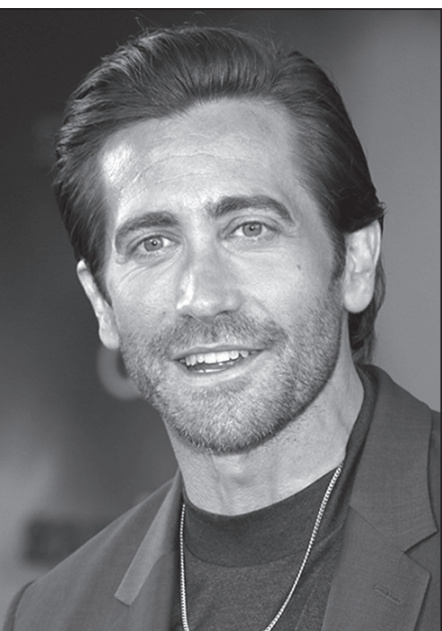

HOLLYWOOD — **Jake Gyllenhaal**’s breakout film was “The Day After Tomorrow” (2004), which grossed \$552 million. It was followed by “Brokeback Mountain” (2005), which featured romantic scenes with the late Oscar-winning actor **Heath Ledger**, shocking to some, but still able to win Oscars for its director, adapted screenplay and musical score, and a best-actor nomination for Ledger.

Gyllenhaal’s voiceover in the animated film “Spirit Untamed,” with **Julianne Moore**, opened in June and managed to gross \$38.6 million despite the pandemic. His Danish crime thriller “The Guilty,” with **Ethan Hawke**, **Riley Keough** and **Peter Sarsgaard**, was well-received at The Toronto Film Festival. He’s just wrapped-up **Michael Bay**’s action thriller “Ambulance,” with **Eliza Gonzalez**, about two brothers who steal an ambulance with a female paramedic and a critical patient in the back, due Feb. 18 in theaters.

Despite the success of “Brokeback Mountain,” it has taken 16 years for a major studio to make a romantic comedy about two men. **Billy Eichner** stars in “BROS,” which he co-wrote with **Nicholas Stoller** (who’s directing), with **Judd Apatow** producing for Universal Studios. It’s about two men with commitment problems who attempt to start a relationship. The “other” man will be **Luke Macfarlane**, who played the gay lover of one of the title characters of the 2006-11 ABC series, “Brother & Sisters.” In 2008 he “outed” himself as a gay man in an interview, but still played “straight” men in one Hallmark movie a year from 2014-19, two in 2020 and another in 2021.

Universal is touting “BROS” as the first gay rom-com made by a major studio, but Netflix already beat them to the punch with “Single All the Way,” which stars “Ugly Betty’s” **Michael Urie** and, well lookie here, **Luke Macfarlane**, dropping in December. Meanwhile, Billy Eichner is set to play

Paul Lynde in “The Man in the Box.” Lynde didn’t hide his “gayness” and successfully played **Ann-Margret**’s father in “Bye, Bye, Birdie” and Uncle Arthur in **Elizabeth Montgomery**’s “Bewitched” series. He never had to “come out,” no one cared.

While Universal getting more liberal, Netflix is turning cautious. They thought their upcoming film “Blonde” (based on **Joyce Carol Oates**’ best-selling book of the same name), with **Ana de Armas** as **Marilyn Monroe**, was “too graphic”! The film has Oscar-winner **Adrian Brody** as “The Playwright,” **Bobby Cannavale** as “The Ex-Athlete,” **Caspar Phillipson** as “The President” and **Michael Masini** as **Tony Curtis**. **Brad Pitt** is one of the producers, and what could have been more graphic than those violent scenes in “Once Upon a Time in Hollywood”?

Speaking of once upon a time, I was once lured to Paul Lynde’s house under false pretenses for a re-shoot and found myself locked up with him in his house ... but that’s another story!

During Provow's senior year, he suffered a severe ankle injury. Dusty was awarded All-Conference (unanimous selection running back) and All-State (along with the Hackett Award. He had several scholarship offers as his senior year came to an end. Dusty chose to decline the scholarships to stay and take care of his grandma as he had been doing the 10 years prior.

In 2010, Dusty joined the semi-pro football team called the Rockford Raiders, which was once the Rock River Raptors. He was then recruited to the Rockford Revolution, where he played with them until 2018. During Dusty's four years with the Rockford Revolution, he helped lead them to many playoff appearances, All-Star and championship games.

Dusty's family includes his wife Brandi Provow and his children Brianna Massie, Maddox Provow and Paisley Provow.

Matt Rogers

As a student at RTHS, Rogers played soccer for three years. He earned varsity letters as a sophomore and junior and was on the JV team his freshman year. Rogers lettered in basketball each of the four years he attended high school in Rochelle. His work on the court led him to receive numerous awards and recognition within RTHS and the surrounding area.

Rogers was named boys basketball Hackett MVP recipient for his junior season. He received the Hoffman Rebounding Award during both his junior and senior years and he was a First-Team NCIC All-Conference in 2004 and 2005. His play landed him on the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Third-Team All-State and he was an AP Honorable Mention.

Leading the local area in scoring, He was named as the Sauk Valley Player of the Year and the Register-Star Player of the Year in 2005. Rogers is fourth in school history for points

scored (1,433) and second in career rebounding with 613. Leaving RTHS with his graduation in 2005, Rogers played college basketball at Lakeland College, then finished his college career at North Central College, being named to All-Conference teams at each school.

After graduating with a degree in sports management, Rogers spent four years coaching at Kishwaukee College and working in the Rochelle area. He currently resides in DeKalb with his wife, Autumn and is self-employed running a home inspection business. In his spare time, he is now on the other side of basketball as an IHSA referee.

Dale Cappel

Cappel graduated from RTHS in 1977. As a Hub, he was a multiple sport athlete all four years of his high school career. He played one year of football, three years of golf and four years of basketball, track and baseball.

Cappel received twelve varsity letters at RTHS, including two in golf, and was captain of the team his senior year. Cappel earned two in basketball and was a recipient of the Hall Free Throw award. He earned four varsity letters in track and held the triple jump record for over 30 years until it was recently broken in 2019.

Cappel earned four varsity letters in baseball, receiving awards for leading the conference in hitting his sophomore year, high team batting average his senior season. His overall athletic achievements made him an excellent choice for the Rochelle News-Leader Award.

Following high school, Cappel remained active playing park district and recreational sports. In 1988, he entered the National Fitness Challenge Competition, winning the regional competition and later the national finals. That victory led to an offer to be captain of a team to compete against the Soviet Union. After eight months of training, the competition

was cancelled due to political tensions.

Dale and his wife Anita are parents to three daughters and grandparents of four. He and his wife own and operate a RV Resort Campground in Sycamore.

Brooke Hatfield

Brooke Hatfield spent her fall and winter seasons at RTHS as a cheerleader. She earned letters for the four years as a football cheerleader and again for the basketball and competitive season. Brooke could be found at the track in the spring. She earned four varsity letters and named overall MVP her junior season and Most Improved as a freshman.

As a member of the Lady Hub track team, Hatfield earned three trips to the IHSA State Meet. Her sophomore year, she was part of the 1600-meter relay team that placed sixth. Her junior year, the 3200-meter relay team earned a third-place finish. She finished her high school career as a senior by finishing fifth in the 800-meter relay and eighth in the 300-meter hurdles.

The RTHS outdoor school records still stand for Brooke's performance in the 100-meter hurdles, 300-meter hurdles, 800-meter relay and the 3200-meter relay. The 2010 indoor meet time in the 55-meter hurdles still stands today.

Following graduation in 2011, Brooke Hatfield chose to attend UW-Madison. She was a member of the Badger cheer team, making trips to the 2013 Rose Bowl, 2014 Capital One Bowl and 2015 Outback Bowl. She cheered at two Final Four basketball tournaments (2014, 2015) as well as the 2015 NCAA Basketball National Championship.

Brooke currently is working as a dermatology physician's assistant.

William E. Helms

Helms was a biology teacher, athletic director and a coach at Rochelle Township High School between

1935 and 1970.

Helms graduated from Macomb High School and attended Western IL State Teachers College having studied PE, social science and biology. He taught and coached at DePue High School and LaSalle High School prior to being hired at Rochelle. He later earned his master's degree from Northern Illinois University in 1954.

Helms began his employment at Rochelle in 1938. He served as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy during World War II, interrupting his teaching/coaching tenure to do so, returning for the 1945 school year. While at RTHS, Helms coached basketball, football, track, cross country and was director of athletics. He grew the athletic program from one coach (himself) to 13 coaches overseeing about 500 boys.

Helms was acknowledged for many years of service to high school athletics by both the Illinois High School Athletic Association and North Central Illinois Athletic Conference in 1970 upon his retirement. The William E. Helms Athletic Complex on the Rochelle Township High School 1921 campus was dedicated to him in November 1974.

Helms, who served as the Leatherneck football team captain in 1927, was inducted into the Western Illinois University Hall of Fame in 1975. Helms died

at age 88 in the Franklin Grove Nursing Home.

William May

May graduated from Rochelle Twp High School in 1905. He was a member of the first track team in 1902.

In the 1904-05 track season, May qualified for the Illinois State Championships. Not only did he qualify, he won the 50-yard dash tying the world record as a high school student. William became the first state champion in any sport to represent Rochelle High School. This was at a time when local track events were held on a horse track on the south side of town.

May graduated and moved on to the University of Illinois. At U of I, May ran the 100 and 220-meter races. He lettered all four years and became the first Rochelle athlete to win a Big Ten championship in 1907-08, taking first in the 100 and second in the 220.

May represented the United States in the 100-meter and the 220-meter races at the 1908 London Olympics. Although he did not medal, he is the only local athlete to have qualified for the Olympics. He later ran for the California Athletic Association and in 1909 tied the world record for the 220-meter dash.

May enlisted in 1917 and became a 1st Lieutenant in light field artillery. With a degree in business, May became a buyer for Montgomery Ward in Chicago

and later in New York where he died in 1979.

Lexie

Sondgeroth

Sondgeroth graduated from RTHS in 2011. While in high school, she lettered with the Lady Hub volleyball team her junior and senior seasons. Her greatest athletic accomplishments came as a part of the RTHS track and field team.

She excelled in her events, still holding school outdoor records in the 100-meter dash, 200-meter dash, 400-meter dash, long jump and 800-meter relay. The indoor school records in the 55-meter dash and 400-meter dash still stand. She was named the Sprinter MVP all four years at RTHS as well as the 2011 Field Event MVP and Overall MVP.

In college, Sondgeroth was a 14-time All-American, NCAA Women's Athlete of the Year for the Midwest Region and a national champion in the 400-meter dash and long jump. She holds the UW-Whitewater indoor records for the 60-meter dash, 200-meter dash, 800-meter relay and long jump along with outdoor records for the 400-meter dash and long jump. She received her master's degree in sports leadership and management from DePaul University.

She's enjoying being a mom to her 3-year-old and waiting for her new arrival.

FARM SAFETY

Safety tips for parents of young farmers

People who live in cities, exurbs or suburbs may not come across farms very frequently. But millions of people, including children, still live on farms. In fact, in 2009 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention noted that more than one million children under the age of 20 lived, worked or had a regular presence on farms in the United States.

Protecting children from injury on farms, especially those who perform work on farms, is of paramount importance. The American Society of Safety Engineers offers the following safety tips to parents of children who will be spending time on farms.

Know and obey the laws. Various state and federal laws are in place to protect young children from farm-related accidents and injuries. Age requirements dictate which jobs children can perform on a farm, and parents should adhere to those requirements. Asking children to do more than they're physically capable of can lead to accident, injury or even death.

Review equipment operation instructions. Before assigning children a task on the farm, parents should review the equipment operation

instructions. Doing so can help parents reacquire themselves with tools and equipment they may not have used in awhile, and that can make it easier for them to teach kids how to use such equipment. In addition, reviewing equipment instructions may provide insight to parents unsure if their children are old enough to use certain tools.

Inspect equipment. Before children perform any tasks on the farm, parents should inspect the equipment their children are likely to use to make sure each tool is safe. Make sure tools are in proper working order, as broken or poorly working equipment increases the risk of accident or injury.

Enroll children in farm safety camps. The ASSE recommends that parents contact their local Cooperative Extension and Farm Bureau offices to enroll children in farm safety camps. Such camps can teach kids safe farming techniques and the proper ways to use age-appropriate tools.

Set a positive example. Another way for parents to protect their children on the farm is to set a positive example. Parents can do so in various ways. Using equipment properly, removing tractor keys from ignitions when tractors are not in use and
