Energy bill expected to save Byron plant

'I'm confident the senate will push us past the finish line'

BYRON—The Illinois Senate is expected to pass an energy bill Monday with incentives aimed at saving the Byron Generating Station.

Illinois Gov. JB Pritzker has said he will sign the bill into law, "as soon as possible."

With the Byron nuclear station set to close Monday, area officials who have been keeping a very close eye on the process were optimistic after the Illinois House passed the bill on Sept. 9.

"SB2408 is another step towards achieving the goal to keep Byron Nuclear Station operational and the State of Illinois achieving their clean energy goals," Erin Folk, executive director of the Oregon Park District and part of FAIRCOM (Fair Assessment Information Resource Committee), said. "I have remained optimistic throughout this process and I am confident the senate will push us past the finish line on Monday."

Exelon has said the sta-

tion would close Monday if the measure was not passed. In fact, power was already being reduced at the Byron station even before the bill was passed by the house, Paul Adams, senior manager for corporate communications with Exelon, said. Exelon did not have a comment in reaction to the vote on Thursday, but did point to a what the company has said earlier.

"With so much at stake for our employees, plant communities, consumers and the environment, we have gone to extraordinary lengths and considerable cost to establish off-ramps that will allow us to reverse the retirement of Byron up until the last moment. That includes ordering fuel for the plant that can be re-directed to another of our nuclear units if legislation fails, and prepositioning hundreds of outside contractors to either refuel or defuel the plant. As we have said before, Monday, Sept. 13, is the day we will need to either commence work on refueling or begin the process of permanently de-

fueling the plant and removing it from service. There is no option for extending that deadline past Monday," the statement read.

The bill includes nearly \$700 million in incentives for the Byron and Dresden stations. Dresden is scheduled to be shut down

later this year. As reported by Reuters, Illinois Senate President Don Harmon said the Senate will vote on the bill Monday.

"Today, with the House passage of SB 2408, the State of Illinois is one historic step closer to reaching a 100 percent clean energy

future," Pritzker said Thursday. "I look forward to SB 2408's swift passage in the Senate, and signing it into law as soon as possible, because our planet and the people of Illinois ought not wait any longer."

Pal Colwill, a longtime friend of Cote's, attended breakfast Wednesday.

"I've known him all my life," Colwill said. "I grew up around his fam-

ily. I learned some French by being around them. It's amazing to have a friend for that long."

Before everyone went their separate ways Wednesday morning, Cote sang another song.

"He's got a dozen songs like that," Colwill said. "And they're all memorized."

Hillcrest trustees discuss abatement proposal

Board approves funds for soil boring work at former asphalt plant

HILLCREST — Hillcrest trustees discussed sales tax abatement proposals for a new business that will take over the former Grennan Meats building sometime within the near future.

Greg Hackbarth and Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows approached the board Wednesday evening after first appearing before the village trustees last month. Hackbarth plans to open a new vehicle repair shop at the former Grennan Meats building located off Maple Avenue and Illinois Route 251 in Hillcrest. Hackbarth plans to renovate the building and add a retail space.

"We've already closed on the property and we were here before we closed on the property," Bearrows said. "Some of the things that will be done will hinge on help from the sales tax

money. They're planning to open a retail portion of the business, which they haven't had before. Over the last full year, the business generated about \$32,000 in sales tax. We're estimating that around \$22,000 in sales tax revenue will be generated within the first 12 months."

Proposals discussed between Hackbarth, Bearrows and Hillcrest trustees included a five-year, stair-step sales tax abatement that would begin at 65 percent over the first two years before dropping to 50 percent over the next two years and 40 percent over the fifth and final year. Trustees said they will review prior sales tax abatements with businesses in the village before finalizing an agreement. No decisions were finalized during Wednesday's village board meeting.

"I sold Greg the building and I've known Greg for a while," Bearrows said.

"We've worked on different projects and he's done work on trucks for the City of Rochelle and the village. I believe in his business and I think he'll bring a great business to Hillcrest."

Projects

Hillcrest trustees approved up to \$15,000 for storm sewer replacement work and up to \$6,000 for tree removal in the village. The \$6,000 allotment will fund the removal of five trees from the detention pond area near Windover Park Lane and Windward Lane. The \$15,000 allotment will fund the beginning of a storm sewer replacement project that will include work on the storm sewer infrastructure on Errett Road, Linda Avenue, Wayne Road and Roy Avenue.

Approvals

Hillcrest trustees approved the 2022 tax levy, which saw an increase of

\$1,400. Trustees also approved the purchase of new water meter reading equipment at a cost of \$7,895 as

well as soil boring work at the former asphalt plant at a cost of \$21,495. The former asphalt plant is

where the village plans to eventually construct a new water tower and water treatment plant.

Creston board approves increase in sewer rates

Trustees vote to grant liquor license for Headon's Fine Meats

CRESTON — The Creston Village Board decided at its Tuesday meeting to raise its sewer rates in the village by 5.5 percent starting Jan. 1, 2022.

The decision comes after Rochelle Municipal Utilities, which provides sewer service for Creston, informed the board that it would be raising its rates to the village 5.5 percent every year for three years. The first increase took effect Aug. 1. The increases were made to cover improvements to RMU's water treatment plant.

The village previously planned on increasing rates by three percent Jan. 1 to cover expenses of its own. Rather than deciding to go up to an 8.5 percent increase to cover RMU's increase and its own, Creston officials opted to just raise their planned increase by 2.5 percent.

Village Treasurer Penny Payton said Creston is "holding its own" right now with its sewer fund and potential American Rescue Plan money could help with repair expenses it needs.

The board plans to finalize the rate increase at its meeting next month. The plan is for a 5.5 percent in-

crease for three years before reverting to a three percent increase annually in 2025.

Liquor license

The board unanimously approved a Class A liquor license for Headon's Fine Meats that will allow it to sell wine, beer and hard alcohol out of the shop.

A modification was also made that changed Class D licenses so Headon's Owner Mark Hibshman could sell alcohol during off-site events like farmer's markets. Those events would have to be approved by Village President Tom Byro, who acts as liquor commissioner.

Other Class A license holders like the Mooseknuckle could also do off-site events.

Hibshman said the change would allow for local wineries and craft brewers to come in for events like farmers markets. He also serves as a village board member and abstained from the vote.

COVID funds

The board unanimously approved an ordinance that will allow it to spend Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund money that it may receive. Byro said the amount would be \$98,000 and it is separate from the

\$87,955.90 in American Rescue Plan Act funds that the village is eligible for that was discussed at last month's meeting.

Farm lease

The village board agreed to lease 144.6 acres of farmland it owns to Eric Petry in a one-year contract at \$310 per acre. The agreement will be finalized at next month's meeting. Byro said the board wanted a short-term agreement because of "other things" going on in the future that may change the course of future leases.

driven by Voss then struck all three vehicles and Skinner, who was outside of his vehicle as well. Skinner was then struck again by a 2005 silver Toyota Highlander driven by Latasha Motley, 24, of Chicago. Skinner suffered life-threatening injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Lemon was transported to an area hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries. Voss, Clayton-Lang and Motley reported no injuries at the scene. The information in the press release was listed as preliminary and no further information was available. No charges have been made pending an investigation.

Free From Every Fear You Face

IT'S amazing how many things people can be afraid of. There's the fear of sickness, job loss, failure, commitment, and public speaking. Some people are afraid of things like taking tests, swimming, animals, insects, heights or even what the future holds—and the list goes on.

Whatever the fear may be, it's important to know that it does not come from God. In fact, fear is one of the primary weapons Satan uses to keep people from fulfilling God's destiny for their lives.

So I ask you: What are you afraid of today? Is there a situation or circumstance that threatens to overwhelm you? Is something stealing your peace and causing you to worry? If so, I want to encourage you to know that God sees you, He loves you, and He wants you to

trust Him to help you.

First John 4:18 says, "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear..." (NIV). Understanding how much God loves us and desires to help us is the antidote for fear.

When I think of my own children—especially when they were younger—there's almost nothing I wouldn't do to help them if they were in trouble. If we feel this way about our children, then how do you think God feels about us? And unlike us, He has no limitations. Nothing is impossible with Him—He can help us in every situation, on every occasion.

Hebrews 13:5-6 says: "... God has said, 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.' So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can

mere mortals do to me?'"

God wants you to know that He's always going to take care of you as you place your trust in Him—always. You don't have to know His exact timing or how He will do it, but you can be assured that He will always meet your needs.

"Do It Afraid!"

We need to understand that when the Lord tells us not to fear, He's not saying we will never feel fear. We will all feel afraid at various times in our lives; however, He is telling us not to allow fear to control us and prevent us from moving forward.

True courage is moving forward in the face of fear. You still feel fear, but you are determined—with God's help—to move forward anyway.

When we feel fear, we

have a choice—we can do it afraid.

In the early days of my ministry, I was invited to speak at a conference. One of the speakers had canceled, and I was their replacement. I wasn't one of the primary speakers—they asked me to conduct one of the smaller workshops.

When the day came, all of the workshop speakers had to get up on stage and share what they would talk about the next day. I remember the other speakers having titles like pastor, reverend, and so forth. But I was just Joyce from Fenton, Missouri—a nobody from nowhere.

When it was my turn to talk, I was absolutely petrified. The 900 people in the audience looked like nine million to me. I was so

scared that when I opened my mouth, nothing came out but a squeak. Right then, I wanted to run off the stage. I could hear the enemy's thoughts running through my mind: What do you think you're doing here! Who do you think you are?

But in spite of the fear, I took a deep breath, started again, and shared what my workshop was about. The next day, to my surprise, many people came to hear me speak. I thank God I didn't run from fear that day, because I would have missed out on a great opportunity He had in store for me.

Satan wants us to shrink back in fear and live tiny, useless lives. But God desires for us to live free from the effects of fear and live big, fulfilling lives.

In John 14:27, Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; My [perfect] peace

I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid. [Let My perfect peace calm you in every circumstance and give you courage and strength for every challenge]" (AMP).

This is both a promise and a command. Through Jesus Christ, we can enjoy supernatural peace that goes beyond anything the world can offer. But we also have a part to play. God is saying, "Don't allow yourself to be paralyzed with fear. Refuse to let the enemy stop you!"

Remember, whatever you're facing today, God is bigger than your worries, your problems and your fears. He knows every one of your needs before you ever have them, and He delights in taking care of you. So you can confidently say, "The Lord is my Helper—I will not fear!"

Bill could keep Prairie State plant open until 2038

‘I think this is the best bill we’re going to get’

ROCHELLE — A state bill will go before the senate Monday that would keep the Prairie State Energy Campus, which the City of Rochelle has \$150 million in debt with until 2042, open until at least 2038.

The energy bill, approved by the Illinois House Thursday, requires Prairie State, in southern Marissa, Illinois, to be carbon-free by 2045, either by going offline or installing sequestration technology. By 2035, the plant must cut emissions by 45 percent. If it doesn’t meet that goal by the end of 2035, the power plant will have until June 30, 2038 to either retire a portion of carbon-emitting units or meet the decarbonization goal some other way.

Gov. JB Pritzker has said he will sign the bill if it reaches his desk.

Earlier this summer, the city held a press confer-

ence to urge the public to reach out to state legislators as it seemed an energy bill could close the plant earlier than expected in 2035. The city buys a large portion of its power from Prairie State and bought into the plant in 2007.

“I think this is the best bill we were going to get,” Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said. “We’re pleased something is coming. It gives us certainty that Prairie State will be open until 2038. And who knows where the technology will take us to help it remain open longer. Hopefully we can do that and do carbon capture.”

Fiegenschuh said he thinks cutting emissions by 45 percent by 2038 is obtainable in order to remain open longer. Under current technology, he said he’s been told there’s no way to capture 100 percent of emissions as is required by 2045. He hopes technology gets to that point by then.

Having certainty going forward was “the best

news” of the proposed bill, Fiegenschuh said. Another highlight for him was the bill’s language that would keep the By-

ron Nuclear Plant open through subsidies.

Rochelle doesn’t purchase energy from Byron directly, but its power ends

up keeping Rochelle’s lights on through the local grid.

“Byron is important for our county economically

and it provides power for our area,” Fiegenschuh said. “It’s reliable. We need it on those hot days when power use is high.”

The votes come more than a year after the closure was announced. Exelon Generation announced on Aug. 27, 2020 that it intended to retire its Byron Generating Station and Dresden

Generating Station in fall 2021. Community leaders immediately jumped into action to save the station, which provides about 700 jobs as well as millions in local tax revenues.

Paul Dempsey, communications manager of the Byron station, said

that the station’s 2017 tax bill was more than \$38 million. The taxes went to a variety of taxing bodies, including the Byron School District, Ogle County and the Byron Museum and Library District.

There are also the char-

itable donations given by the station, which Dempsey said amount to about \$250,000. Donations have gone to Rock River Center in Oregon, Pinecrest Community in Mt. Morris, Hub City Senior Center and many others.

The Byron CUSD #226 paid for the economic impact study, and it showed that about 74 percent of the district’s revenue comes from the Byron Station.

The study showed that the Byron Station’s direct contribution to the regional economy (GDP) is

estimated to be more than \$288 million. That is 1.6 percent of the total GDP of the region. For the Ogle County, Byron Station’s total contribution to the economy is estimated to be \$338 million; 17 percent of the county’s total GDP.

NIU STEM Cafe: Cybersecurity

DEKALB — The past few years have shown us how essential the internet is for both businesses and individuals, as more and more of our banking, shopping, communicating and entertainment happen online.

Manufacturing is also becoming more reliant on the internet, as manufacturers connect digitally with supply chains. However, cybercrimes and scams are also becoming more prevalent, and they affect both individuals and businesses.

At the next NIU STEM Café, hear from two cybersecurity experts. Learn about common vulnerabilities and scams, signs of malicious intent and protective measures you can take. The STEM Café will take place online on Wednesday, Sept. 15, at 6 p.m. and is free and open to all. Registration and more information are available at go.niu.edu/cybersafe.

One expert speaker will be Jennifer Fowler, a member of the Strategic Cybersecurity Analysis and Research (SCAR) team at Argonne National Laboratory and an adjunct professor at Lewis University, where she teaches about encryption and authentication systems. Her areas of interest include cryptography, data privacy, cyberbiosecurity, biohacking and social engineering.

"Protecting yourself online can seem daunting," Fowler said. "This talk will impart tips and tricks to protect yourself while online banking, engaging in social me-

dia, reading and sending email and traversing the internet."

The other speaker will be Cesar Pena, a senior cybersecurity engineer at MxD in Chicago, which equips manufacturers with digital tools and expertise in many areas, including cybersecurity. MxD is working with industry and government to bring cybersecurity to the supply chain and the factory floor. MxD is also the National Center for Cybersecurity in Manufacturing, as designated by the U.S. Department of Defense.

According to the MxD cybersecurity team, "One thing that makes cybersecurity so challenging for manufacturers is that companies are only as strong as the weakest link in their supply chains. As organizations digitize and become more interconnected, they must be constantly vigilant with not only their own security practices but also with those of their suppliers."

The audience might be surprised to hear that, "According to the 2018 Verizon data breach investigation report, 86% of cyberattacks in the sector are targeted rather than opportunistic, and nearly half are thefts of intellectual property, undertaken to gain a competitive advantage."

At the STEM Café, Pena will talk about cybersecurity amidst the rise of ransomware in the U.S., and what companies (especially small to mid-sized companies) can do about the problem.

"Cybersecurity is an



increasing threat, and we are all targets," Pena said. "It's not a matter of if we are getting hacked but a matter of where and when."

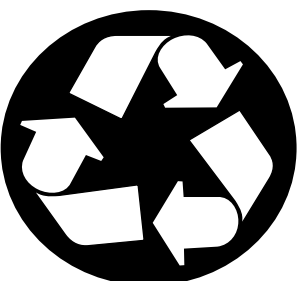

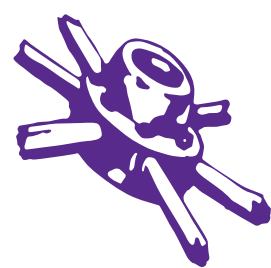

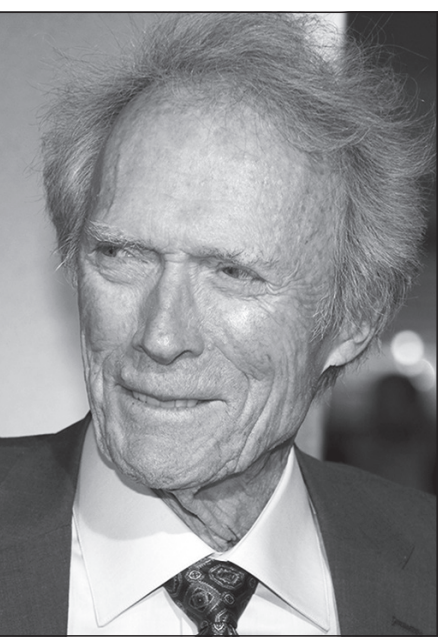
HOLLYWOOD — In 1955, **Clint Eastwood** began his career in “The Revenge of the Creature” (from “The Black Lagoon”). He landed the lead in the CBS series “Rawhide” in 1958, then went to Italy in 1964 and starred in “A Fistful of Dollars,” the first of three spaghetti Westerns. At 40, Eastwood directed his first film, “Play Misty For Me” (1971). He kept acting, but it was directing that earned him four Oscars (from 11 nominations). On Sept. 17, at 91, his 40th film will open, “Cry Macho,” which he directed, produced and stars in.

Clint cast country singer **Dwight Yoakum** as his co-star. Yoakum’s memorable films are “Sling Blade” (1996), “Panic Room” (2002), “Wedding Crashers” (2005) and most recently “Logan Lucky” (2017), with **Channing Tatum**, **Adam Driver**, **Seth MacFarlane** and **Sebastian Stan**.

Famed director **Frank Capra** won six Oscars and made his last film at age 64. **Alfred Hitchcock** directed 59 films (and never won an Oscar, though he did receive the Irving Thalberg Award from the Academy), directing his last one at 76. While Capra had two wives and four kids, and Hitchcock had one wife and one kid, Eastwood juggled his career with two wives, two partners and eight children. At least five of his kids have successful acting/directing careers, including **Scott Eastwood**, who can be seen in the recent hit “The Suicide Squad.” Clint had many memorable moments as an actor, but as a director, he’s in a class of his own.

At long last, **Shari Lewis** (who died in 1998) and **Lambchop** — who made their TV debut in 1956 with “Captain Kangaroo” on CBS, won 13 Emmy Awards and a Peabody — will finally be the subject of an upcoming documentary.

Not so lucky is **Johnny Depp**, whom the San Sebastian Film Festival is giving a Lifetime Achievement Award and getting backlash from women’s groups, including Spain’s Association of Female

Filmmakers. It follows the decree of an English judge who found the accusation of Depp beating his ex-wife, **Amber Heard**, “was substantially correct” (despite her beating him too?).

More bad news for **Harvey Weinstein**. Pulitzer Prize-winning New York Times writers **Jodi Kantor** and **Megan Twohey**’s bestselling book “She Said” is becoming a movie with **Carey Mulligan** playing Twohey and **Zoe Kazan** as Kantor, as well as **Patricia Clarkson** and “Brooklyn Nine Nine’s” two-time Emmy-winner **Andre Braugher**, plus **Brad Pitt** as one of the producers. The film is a dramatic retelling of the sexual harassment investigation that took down Weinstein and sparked the #MeToo movement. It will focus on their efforts to uncover and expose decades of allegations against Weinstein, who has already been sentenced to 23 years in prison on charges of sexual assault and third-degree rape, and is now facing more charges in Los Angeles. Tick, tick, boom ... time’s up!

Why should you see a financial advisor?

The social distancing and stay-at-home orders necessitated by the coronavirus have led many of us to feel isolated. Still, we've fought back through social media, "virtual" gatherings and walks in the neighborhood, where we could greet friends and neighbors (from 6 feet away). But when you're dealing with the financial effects of the virus and you're investing alone, you could encounter some problems that may prove costly.

Of course, with so much investment-related information available online, on television and in any number of periodicals, it's not surprising that some people feel they can invest without any assistance. But the volatility of the financial markets over the past few months has also pointed to the dangers of going solo in the investment world. And you might find that a professional financial advisor can help you in several ways, including the following:

Taking emotions out of investing. During this period of market turbulence, many self-guided investors are letting their emotions drive their investment decisions. As

a result, they sell investments when their price is down, "locking in" their losses. Furthermore, if they then stay out of the financial markets, they will miss out on the eventual recovery – and some of the biggest gains in market rallies usually occur right at the beginning. But if you work with a financial advisor who has helped you develop a personalized investment strategy based on your goals, risk tolerance and time horizon, you will be far less likely to react to extreme market conditions by making ill-advised decisions.

Maintaining perspective. When you're putting away money for the future and you suddenly have a lot less of it, you might start to wonder if that future is somehow in jeopardy. But if you've been working with a financial advisor and following your investment strategy, you'll know that you don't have to immediately cash out those investments that have lost value, and you may not need to liquidate them for decades if they were designed for a long-term goal, such as retirement. By the time you do need to sell them, their value may well have appreciated significantly. And if you've

got a well-constructed portfolio, you'll also own shorter-term, less volatile investments to help meet your current cash flow needs.

Understanding the history of investing. The recent market instability is unique in the sense that its cause – a worldwide pandemic – is so highly unusual, and it hopefully will be a once-in-a-lifetime experience. Typically, prolonged market downturns are triggered by explainable financial or economic factors, such as the bursting of the "dot-com" bubble in 2000. However, market drops of 20 percent or more – generally referred to as bear markets – are not at

all unusual and have happened every few years over the past several decades. Financial advisors are well aware of this history and share it with their clients. And for many people, the knowledge that "we've been here before" is reassuring and makes it easier for them to continue following their investment strategies.

The road to your financial goals is a long one, with many twists and turns. So you might like to have some experienced company along the way.

Ready for retirement?

What security Month. But what does retirement security mean to you? And how can you work toward achieving it?

Here are some suggestions:

Build your resources. While you're working, save in tax-advantaged accounts such as your IRA and 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored retirement plan. In your 401(k), contribute at least enough to earn your employer's match, if one is offered, and increase your contributions whenever your salary goes up. Remember, especially early in your career, time is often your biggest asset. Be sure to save early, since the longer you wait, the more you'll need to save to help reach your goals.

Look for ways to boost retirement income. When transitioning to retirement, you can take steps to align your income with your needs. For example, consider Social Security. You can start collecting it as early as 62, but your

monthly payments will be much larger if you can wait until your "full" retirement age, typically between 66 and 67. (Payments will "max out" at age 70.) So, if you have sufficient income from a pension or your 401(k) and other retirement accounts, and you and your spouse are in good health with a family history of longevity, you may consider delaying taking Social Security. You also might want to explore other income-producing vehicles, such as certain annuities that are designed to provide a lifetime income stream.

Prepare for unexpected costs. During your retirement, you can anticipate some costs, such as housing and transportation, but other expenses are more irregular and can't always be predicted, such as those connected with health care. Even with Medicare, you could easily spend a few thousand dollars a year on medical expenses, so you may want to budget

for these costs as part of your emergency savings, and possibly purchase supplemental insurance. You may also want to consider the possibility of needing some type of long-term care, which is not typically covered by Medicare and can be quite expensive. The average annual cost of a private room in a nursing home is more than \$100,000, and it's about \$55,000 per year for a home health aide, according to Genworth, an insurance company. To address these costs, you may want to consider some form of protection, such as long-term care insurance or life insurance with a long-term care component.

Do your estate planning. It's hard to feel totally secure in retirement if you're unsure of what might happen if you have an unexpected health event, become incapacitated or die earlier than expected. That's why you'll want to create a comprehensive estate plan.



Get in the habit of saving more money each month

Saving is a vital component of financial planning. However, more than half of Americans are saving too little and do not have an accurate grasp of their spending habits.

A recent survey from Intuit Mint Life found that, in 2019, 59 percent of Americans were living paycheck to paycheck and 65 percent didn't know how much they were spending on a monthly basis. The situation is similar in Canada, where the annual BDO Canada Affordability Index indicates 53 percent of Canadians are living paycheck to paycheck and 25 percent say their debt load is overwhelming.

While there's no magic formula to save money, and the amount of money one should save each month depends on how he or she wants to live now and in the future, a handful of strategies can help people save more money each year.

• Follow the 50/30/20 rule. The popular 50/30/20 rule advocates for allocating 50 percent of your budget to essentials like rent, food and housing, 30 percent for discretionary spending and 20 percent for savings. Many people cannot save 20 percent of their income. In such instances, people can make a concerted effort to save 10 percent of their take-home pay.

• Build an emergency fund. The credit reporting agency Experian recommends consumers keep between three and six months' worth of expenses in an emergency fund. The fund should cover expenses on the absolute necessities paid each month, like utilities rent/mortgage and groceries.

• Set goals. Savings goals can help a person stay on track and provide motivation to put money away. Establish separate savings accounts for each goal to reduce the temptation to spend. For example, if the goal is to save more for vacations, then a person can open an account where funds are used exclusively for vacations.

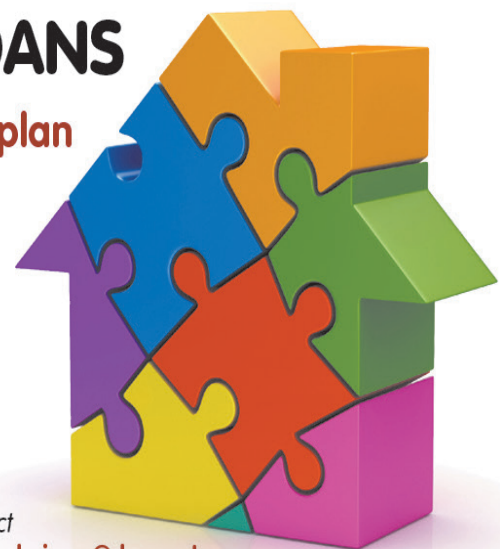
• Automate with your employers' help. Certain employers allow workers to direct deposit a paycheck into more than one bank account. It's easy to request the payroll manager put 10 percent or 20 percent of a paycheck into a savings account while the remainder is deposited into a checking account. Automated deposits can help individuals get accustomed to living on less.

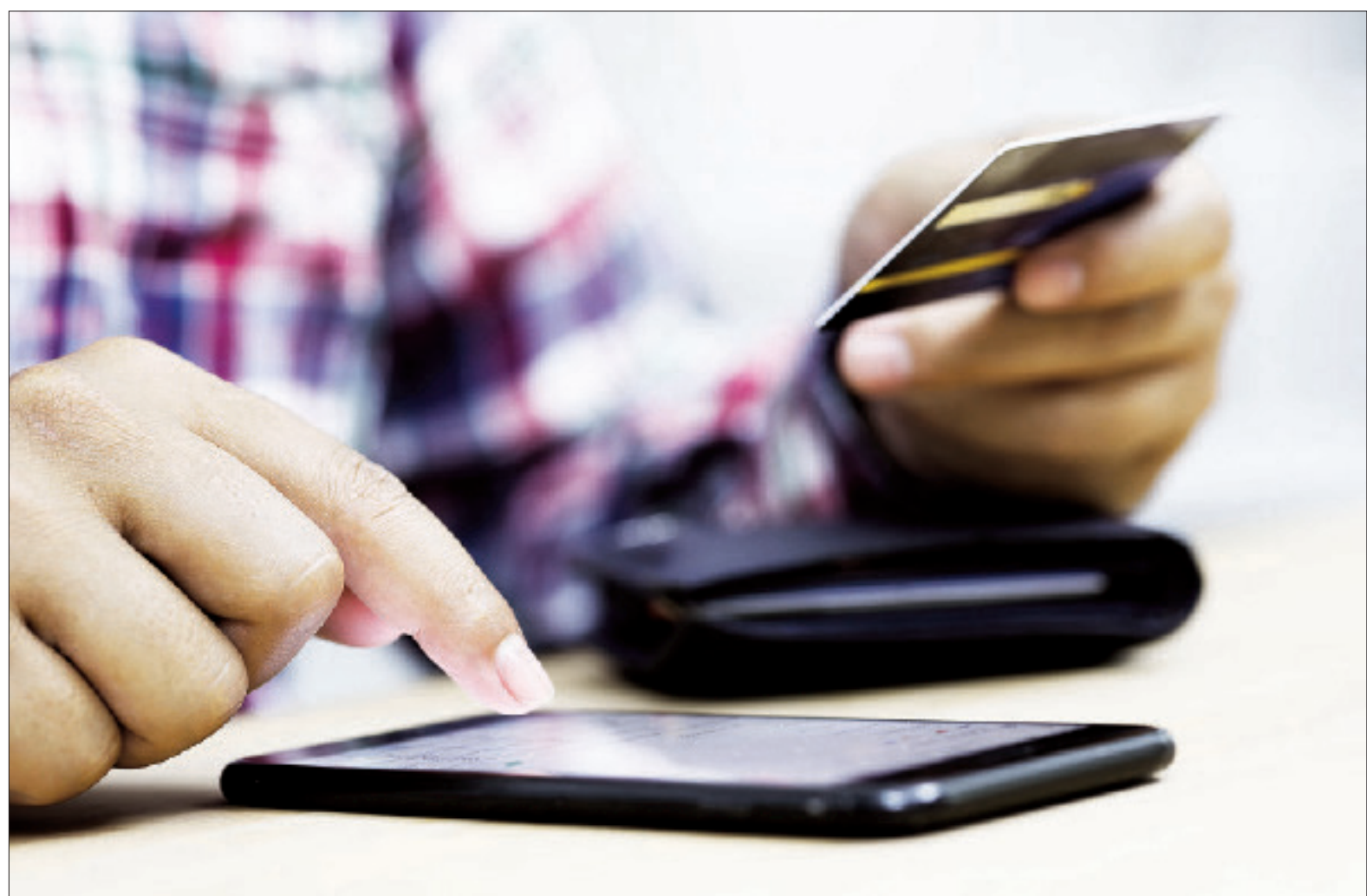
Behaviors that can hurt your credit score

Credit plays a vital role in helping people realize their personal and financial goals. A good credit score can help people qualify for favorable home loan terms, ultimately paving the way for them to move into their dream homes. Strong credit histories also can help consumers earn perks, and young people who learn to use credit wisely can avoid potentially costly interest charges that tend to hamper many young adults' financial freedom.

Many consumers struggle with managing credit. According to FICO®, a data analytics company that developed the FICO score that many lenders use to determine consumer credit risk, more than 10 percent of consumers in the United States have credit scores lower than 550. Any score below 550 is considered very poor.

No two consumers are the same, but many struggling to establish good credit histories may engage in certain behaviors that can hurt their credit scores.

- **Taking out too many lines of credit:** Consumers without much experience managing their finances, such as college students and young adults, often find credit offers hard to resist. Retailers may offer significant discounts at checkout counters to shoppers willing to sign up for store credit cards. Inexperienced consumers may not recognize that such cards often feature inflated interest rates, especially when compared to more consumer-



friendly cards. Avoid opening too many credit accounts, as doing so can adversely affect your credit score and make it easy to lose track of spending.

- **Letting interest charges pile up:** Paying interest on consumer debt like credit cards will not help consumers improve their credit scores, so pay balances off immediately. That's easier to do if you only have one or two lines of credit that you monitor regularly.

- **Using credit for daily pur-**

chases: Credit is not cash in your pocket and it isn't money withdrawn directly from a checking or savings account, which is the case when using a debit card. So it's easy for consumers to lose track of their daily spending if they're doing that spending with a credit card. Balances can quickly pile up and, if they can't be paid off in full when the bill comes due, interest charges will begin to accumulate. This trap can be avoided if consumers

commit to using credit only in emergency situations or when purchasing big-ticket items that they know they can pay off when the credit card bill is due.

- **Failing to monitor credit score:** It's now easier than ever for consumers to track their credit scores. In fact, many credit card companies provide free monthly updates to card holders, who won't have to lift a finger to see if their scores have improved or worsened over the last 30 days. Consumers

should take advantage of this relatively recent perk so they can see just how their use of credit is affecting their overall scores. They can then use that knowledge to improve their scores going forward.

Certain behaviors can negatively affect consumers' credit scores. By learning about such behaviors and taking steps to avoid them, consumers can take a big step toward realizing their short- and long-term financial goals.

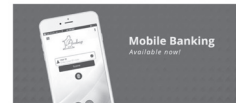
