Hospital may require Covid-19 vaccine for all employees

Olson: 'We want to take all considerations. We have not made a decision yet'

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Community Hospital CEO Gregg Olson said Tuesday that the hospital has not yet decided whether or not it will require employees to be vaccinated against COVID-19.

"We're working on that right now," Olson said. "We're working with our medical staff and looking at what we should do going forward. It's a tough conversation to have. We want to protect our patients, visitors and community and also those that feel strongly against it. We want to take all considerations."

Olson said one of the biggest reservations RCH would have against requiring the vaccine for employees is the chance that the hospital could become short-staffed because of it.

As a smaller, rural hospital, RCH's bench isn't deep, Olson said. He doesn't want to chase employees away.

"It's hard to find the right

people," Olson said. "The last thing we want is to make a statement that people will not be happy with. That's

what makes it hard. What's the potential fallout and the big picture? We can't afford to lose staff and we don't

have the depth."

Olson said ongoing conversations are being had with medical staff

about a possible vaccination requirement.

Lights, camera, action!

VCCT's first show at Lincoln Arts Center opens Aug. 20

ROCHELLE — Vince Carney Community Theatre President Amy Frank feels like she hasn't seen her husband, Steve, on a weekend in two years.

Steve has taken on the role of "project manager" in turning Old Lincoln School into the Lincoln Arts Center,

which will be VCCT's new home.

"We should've been keeping track of volunteer hours that went into this," Amy said. "It has been enormous. A ton of hours, about \$250,000, the majority of which was donated or grants. We have taken the focus of making it so people walk in and say, 'Holy crap.' We did very well with what we had."

RCH: Roughly 85 percent of hospital employees fully vaccinated

The decision is not being rushed, Olson said. Some other hospitals have already mandated the vaccine for employees.

Informal conversations with the hospital's board have also been had on the possibility of an employee vaccine mandate. RCH's fully-vaccinated rate among employees currently stands at "around" 83-85 percent, Olson said.

"We have a very high number," Olson said. "I network with other hospitals like us and our rate is one of the highest. I think we've done a good job informing and educating our employees and we continue to do that. It is a personal decision and we get that."

Olson said that just because of the number of vaccinated employees, the majority of RCH employees would be in favor of a vaccine mandate.

"But are there people that have voiced concern over it? Absolutely," Olson said.

A few years ago, before COVID-19, RCH started mandating that employees receive a flu shot. That policy allows employees to not receive the flu shot, if they supply administration with a religious or health perspective on why they don't want it. Those that don't get flu shots are required to mask. Again, that policy dates back to pre-pandemic times.

Olson said that if RCH were to require the COVID-19 vaccine for employees, the policy would look something like the flu

shot policy did.

"I'm thinking as we move forward, whatever it is, we'd look at how that was handled," Olson said. "So everyone has a voice and won't have to worry about losing their job. If someone is against it for religious or medical reasons, we'd respect that and require COVID-19 testing on a pretty frequent basis for them."

Olson said in the healthcare industry and more, "everybody" is currently having the conversation about mandating the COVID-19 vaccine. He doesn't know what percentage of hospitals have mandated it for employees, but said it seems like larger organizations have required it.

Smaller hospitals like RCH have been less likely to require the vaccine due to difficulty of attracting staff, Olson said.

RCH does feel a respon-

sibility as the dominant healthcare provider in the community to educate staff, visitors and patients and be out in front on issues like the COVID-19 vaccine.

"Many of us feel vaccinations do work," Olson said. "They have a role in this process and we want to be available to those with questions. On a national basis it's pretty common knowledge that scientists are praising the vaccine's positive outcomes."

The recent uptick in COVID-19 cases haven't resulted in a lot of changes at RCH, Olson said.

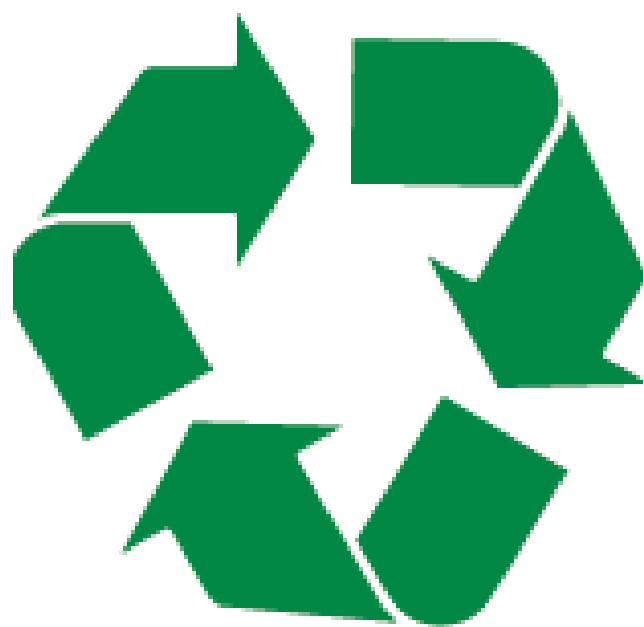
Those changes were already in place earlier in the pandemic and have stayed in place. RCH still screens at its main entrances and has a dedicated COVID-19 unit. Olson said the hospital has seen "maybe 2-3" COVID-19 patients in the past six weeks. That's "probably" still more than

it saw just prior to those six weeks.

"But our policies really haven't changed," Olson said. "We're doing the same things we have been for 20 months. I think we've already made preparations. We planned and strategized when the pandemic hit and just refer back to those. We haven't changed that drastically. If this uptick does continue, we'll pursue the same strategies we have."

One surprise Olson has seen is an increase in non-COVID-19 patients that isn't historically common for this time of year. RCH's med surge unit has been "busier" with non-COVID-19 patients.

"That's been interesting," Olson said. "We're not the only ones. Other hospitals like us are seeing it. When things were shut down, people deferred care. I think that could be part of why we're seeing this."

Microwave ovens are accepted and are \$5 per unit.

VanVickle joins Rochelle Fire full-time

ROCHELLE — One summer Zech VanVickle was building a house for a firefighter.

“He brought me in and thought I’d be a good fit for the fire department and I jumped right into a firefighting class and I’ve been doing it ever since,” VanVickle said. “It’s been about five years now.”

VanVickle was recently hired full-time by the Rochelle Fire Department as a firefighter/paramedic and started on Thursday. He’s the department’s 13th full-time firefighter and the move was made due to the department absorbing “quite a bit” of overtime recently, Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville said.

The department had 12 firefighters, not counting Sawlsville, for the past 15 years. The number of calls goes up every year, Sawlsville said. The number of EMS

calls has continuously risen for 20 years. Fire calls have trended down and leveled off “a bit,” Sawlsville said.

“Predominantly, easily 80-85 percent of what we do is EMS or ambulance calls,” Sawlsville said. “But those continue to go up. We hired additional staff 15 years ago but as time goes on they earn more vacation time so they’re gone which creates a vacancy. We have to staff four personnel 24/7. We try to fill with paid on-calls, but we can’t always do that. A 13th full-timer will fill that space and cut down on some overtime for us. We’re glad to have him.”

VanVickle is a Rochelle native and started working with the department part-time in 2018. He’s been on Ogle-Lee Fire since 2016 and has worked closely with Rochelle Fire over that time.

“It was a long-term goal of mine to work here,” VanVickle said. “It’s nice to be able to work in a full-time ca-

capacity with everyone. I like the EMS side. It’s a passion of mine, being

able to help people with medical issues. And obviously firefighting is a

big part of our job, being safe about it and helping conserve property.”

VanVickle comes to the department as an already-certified firefighter with a paramedic license. He was able to hit the street on day one and didn’t need any additional training, Sawlsville said.

The department has talked about adding an additional firefighter/paramedic for a number of years, Sawlsville said.

“We’re thrilled to have him,” Sawlsville said. He’s smart, motivated and well-trained.”

VanVickle called working in his hometown “very fulfilling.”

“It feels like I’ve accomplished something and it’s nice to be able to serve my community and give back to the community that’s given me so much,” VanVickle said. “I’m happy to be here and excited to see where my career takes me.”

City awards Cheri Picked Vintage with facade grant

ROCHELLE — The City of Rochelle presented a \$2,418 check Thursday to Cheri Picked Vintage Owner Cheri Moyers as part of its facade grant program.

The program covers half the cost of any improvements made to business fronts in town. The antique shop is the most recent recipient. Moyers said improvements included the replacement of a door that now allows for more daylight into the shop and ease of moving larger pieces in and out.

“I don’t know if it was the original door but it was definitely a wooden antique door with a storm door,” Moyers said. “We took that all out and moved the door over so it was easier to get stuff in and out. I think it gives it more of a commercial look. I think any kind of outside improvement always helps people come in and see what we’ve got.”

Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows said the entire downtown has benefitted from the program. The rest of the city is eligible for the facade grants as well.

torical,” Bearrows said.

Bearrows said the facade program has “immensely” helped a lot of businesses and has created “a lot of” improvements in the facades of older buildings. He’s happy to see businesses making improvements after months of the pandemic.

“It’s amazing,” Bearrows said. “And it’s catching. One business does it and the next one does and it continually improves the downtown or any part of town. It’s like with houses. We do the program with the lawns and one person gets nominated for a

great lawn and all of the sudden the neighbors want to try it. It’s a great thing. It’s a win-win for everybody.”

City Community Development Director Michelle Pease said the program’s new budget starts Jan. 1 and encouraged businesses to apply soon.

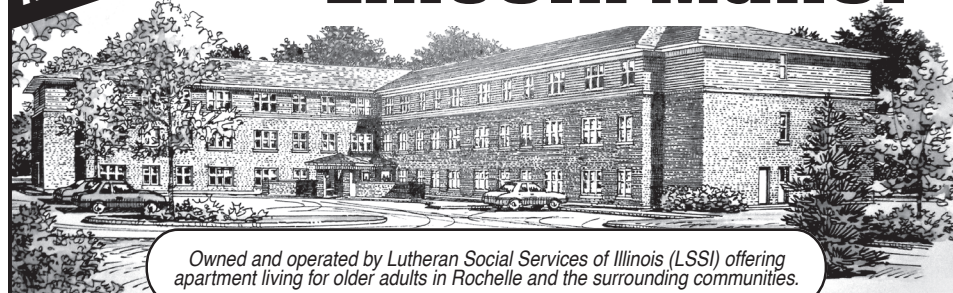

Elvin E. Plapp

MALTA – Surrounded by his entire immediate family, Elvin E. Plapp, 90, of Malta, passed away peacefully on Monday, Aug. 9. He was born in Rochelle on June 27, 1931 the son of the late William and Martha (Woltman) Plapp. On June 23, 1962 in Elgin he was united in marriage to Betty L. Koch. They enjoyed 55 wonderful years together. Elvin grew up in Malta and graduated as valedictorian from Malta schools. Upon graduating from high school, he briefly attended Northern Illinois University and the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana. When Elvin returned home in 1950, he

had the opportunity to run the farm owned by Harvey Schweitzer. Elvin grew his farm by purchasing additional acreage in the Northwest Malta area. Farming for 70 years, Elvin retired after harvesting his final crop in 2020. In 1953, Elvin reported to US Army basic training. He served in the Korean War in an artillery unit stationed near the DMZ at the Korean border. He was honorably discharged in June 1955. After a blind date set up by his sister, Elvin met Betty at a Blackhawks game. On Dec. 25, 1961, Elvin asked Betty to marry him after carrying the ring around in his pocket for



weeks as he was nervous to ask for her hand in marriage. In addition to farming, he enjoyed woodworking, gardening, traveling, making things for his grandchildren and collecting Farmall tractors (working and toy) and other farm implements. On July 3, 2021 the Plapp Family Agricultural Heritage Museum was dedicated at a wonderful 90th birthday

celebration attended by over 100 family and friends. Elvin was very active at Northwest Malta United Methodist Church including holding the office of treasurer for over 40 years and Mission Coordinator for many years. Elvin is survived by two sons; Larry (Kathie) of Delavan, Wisconsin and Rick (Gina) of Carmel, Indiana; three grandchildren, Megan Plapp of Rochester, Minnesota and Audrey and Evan Plapp of Carmel, Indiana; his brother, Edgar of DeKalb and a sister, Shirley Hudson, of Lakewood, Colorado. Elvin is also survived by his special friend and caretaker, Laurie Sarver of DeKalb.

READER Jane told me about a frightening scene she witnessed this week. On Illinois Route 38 there are two pedestrian crosswalks with flashing yellow lights. When someone wants to cross this busy road, they push the button, the lights flash and traffic is supposed to stop.

Maybe supposed is too nice a term. Under Illinois law, motorists are required to stop for pedestrians in crosswalks. Required. What happened on Illinois Route 38 almost was a disaster. A young person on a bicycle pushed the button, the lights flashed, and they began to cross 38. One motorist had to slam on their brakes to avoid hitting the youngster, who was crossing with the lights flashing. Crossing when motorists are required to stop. Reader Jane noted that adults will watch for cars, and in fact she has had to wait several cycles of the yellow lights for traffic to stop to safely cross.

But youngsters may be too trusting and think adults will follow the law and stop. We know that is a dangerous assumption to make. How does the city help prevent a tragedy from happening? Lower the speed limit? Station a squad car there 24 hours a day? Provide a crossing guard? Change the flashing yellows to flashing reds? More to the point, how do we as adults

prevent a tragedy? We can start by slowing down, paying better attention and following the law. As the school year starts there will undoubtedly be middle school students crossing this road either going to or from school. They need to be warned that not all drivers are paying attention or obeying the law.

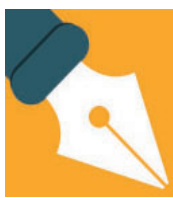
Be careful how we handle our future

The Lincoln Arts Center will host VCCT's first show, "Four Old Broads," this month. The show opens Aug. 20 at 7 p.m. and will run at the same time on Aug. 21, 26, 27 and 28 and at 2 p.m. on Aug. 22 and 29. The show is directed by Amy Frank and Terry Camplain.

The process of getting shows started at the Lincoln Arts Center began almost three years ago. It was supposed to open last year before COVID-19 threw things off track.

The cast of "Four Old Broads" includes Carol Weidmann, Sally Sawicki, Jane Prunty, Dianne Jenner, Terry Dickow, Michele McClane and Jeanette V. Mingus.

"When we were getting close to opening we started looking for a script and found this one and figured we'd have our founding members be the ones on the new stage," Amy said. "It was a perfect fit that the people who started it all would be on stage first."

"Four Old Broads" is a comedy about residents of Magnolia Place Assisted Living Center where retired burlesque dancer, Beatrice, and her devoutly religious friend, Eaddy Mae, team up with Maude, a woman obsessed with soap operas and planning her own funeral, and Sam, a retired Elvis impersonator, to figure out why the newest resident, Immogene, is suddenly losing her memory.

VCCT board members will be on hand before the opening show to give tours of the new space. The ticket booth and a concession stand will be up and running. VCCT will be offering five shows a year now instead of three. "Frankenstein" is planned for October and the annual gala in December will feature a radio show version of "A Christmas Carol."

Next year's shows are planned but not yet official. Additional entertainment outside of the VCCT umbrella will also be featured at the space going forward.

"This can be a huge asset for the community," Amy said. "And that was our plan. We

want it to be a community arts center, not just the home of VCCT. We have plans to be able to rent out the space for wedding receptions and quinceaneras and church organizations and things like that. It will be more than just the community theatre's productions."

Amy said the opening will be "a little bitter-sweet" after all of the work has been put in to make the Lincoln Arts Center what it is today. Since the VCCT started, having its own venue was always talked about as a goal.

"It's going to be a dream realized," Amy said. "Now it's a whole different business model that gives us room to grow. We're going to need the continuing

community support. It's also a huge deal repurposing a historical building. That has been a big part of the people who volunteer to help us on the weekends. It's people who went to school here, people who taught here. They're not necessarily part of the theatre group. That was the majority, but it's been a community project, not just a VCCT project."

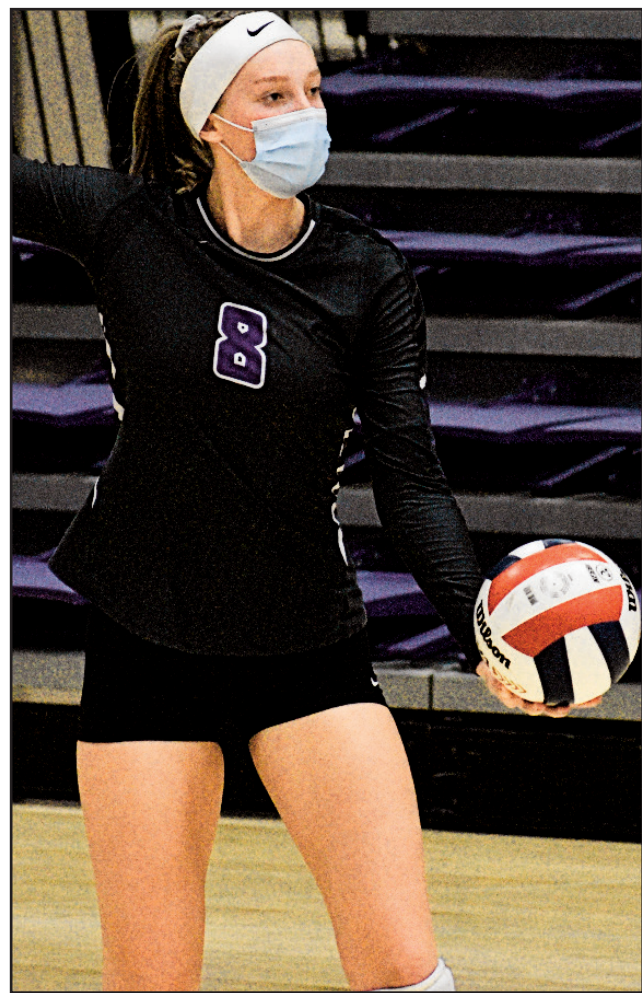

to seeing those guys step up and seeing what their roles will be this season.”



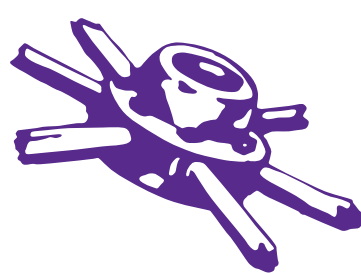

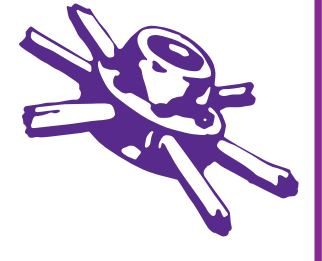

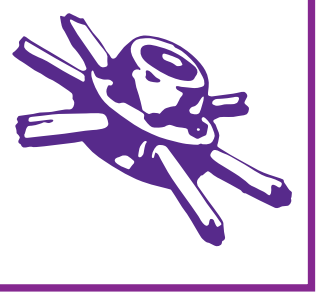

DeLille leaps into javelin throw at Carthage College

FORMER Rochelle track and field standout Mason DeLille made his mark on the high school program with his performances in the jump pits. A former IHSA State Championship qualifier and current school record holder in the varsity triple jump, DeLille continued his track and field career at Carthage College, where he's since discovered profound talent in another field event.

Looking to alleviate injury concerns toward the end of his sophomore season with the track and field team, DeLille decided to compete in the javelin throw, something he hadn't done much of throughout his two years with Carthage. DeLille's confidence and athleticism quickly translated to the javelin throw, with the former Hub student-athlete finishing seventh and earning All-Conference honors in the CCIW Championships with a personal-best mark of 46.64 meters.

"I had a rough stretch toward the end of my indoor season where I was out for about five weeks with back spasms," DeLille said. "I was able to resolve the injury by the first week of the outdoor season, but due to this injury and other factors, I switched up my events for the remainder of the season and I plan to keep these events for the next two years. I switched from triple jump to long jump and added javelin so I could do something not fully focused on my legs. After dropped triple jump and high jump, the season started progressing really well."

Not only did DeLille set a personal record

in the javelin throw at the conference championships, but his transition from triple jump to long jump resulted in another personal record at the Elmhurst Twilight Invitational, where he took seventh place with a mark of 6.13 meters in the long jump. After missing the majority of his freshman season because of the COVID-19 pandemic, DeLille said he was happy with how his sophomore campaign concluded.

"My sophomore season went well considering it was my first full season in two years," DeLille said. "It was nice to have more competition and the chance to compete outdoors... I'm planning on improving my personal record in the long jump. I started throwing javelin only two weeks before the conference meet and I quickly learned the throwing motion. My goal for next season is to throw in the 55-to-60-meter range and be in contention for national qualifying."

DeLille, who's currently studying mathematics and economics in hopes of pursuing a career in sports statistics and analytics, also received Academic All-Conference honors during his sophomore year at Carthage. With high expectations for his junior and senior track seasons, DeLille has stepped away from the Carthage soccer team after two years with the program. DeLille said his goal is to focus primarily on track and be in prime shape for the next two years.

"My track seasons have been great outside of COVID-19," DeLille said. "What I've enjoyed most are my teammates and my coaches. They make track and field enjoyable so it doesn't feel like a chore for me. I love having the ability to get better every day."

Huskies kick off 2021 season with fall camp

DEKALB — Huskie Stadium was alive once again with the sounds of whistles blowing, coaches barking out instructions and players encouraging each other as the Northern Illinois University football team began preparations for its 119th campaign on Friday.

The Huskies hit the practice field for the first time in 2021 at 9:30 a.m. and turned in a fast-paced two-and-a-half hour-plus workout under partly sunny skies. NIU head coach Thomas Hammock, who enters his third season at the helm of his alma mater, was happy with how the team looked at the first practice.

“Obviously, guys were excited to be out here,”

Hammock said. “The real part of camp starts tomorrow. After the newness wears off, now you have to come back, recover, get your mind right and say, ‘I have to continue to get better.’”

“The guys were in a good mind frame. You can tell they put a lot of work in over the summer. All of that showed up today. It was a pretty clean practice. We’ll watch the tape. Obviously, there are things we can get better on, but overall, I liked the energy and intensity. We have a lot of size out there and can’t get wait to get the pads on officially.”

This is NIU’s first fall camp to follow an offseason conditioning program, spring practice

and a season, however brief it was, under Hammock. Last season’s fall camp was halted almost before it got started due to Covid and the spring ball and summer conditioning was cancelled for the same reason.

While it’s still early, Hammock has noticed a difference among the returners who were able to go through the whole process.

“It’s way different,” Hammock said. “I think you see the difference when you see the freshmen go out there for the first time and you have a guy that has only been here a year longer than you, telling you how to practice, how to work, the plays. It’s a night and

day difference. For a true freshman to break into the rotation, he will have to wow us. We have depth, we have numbers, we have guys with experience, and we have guys that are hungry.”

Following the last team period of practice, Hammock and the coaching staff had the offensive and defensive skill players line up on either sideline and the offensive and defensive line stand on the end line of the north end zone to end practice. The Huskies ended their first practice with a conditioning session. Meanwhile, the true freshmen and younger guys saw extra team time.

“What we talk about as coaches is who wants

it the most. So we’re going to go back old school. We’re going to condition. We’re going to try and get as much information as we can get to see who wants it the most. On Sept. 4, we’ll play the 22 guys that want it the most.”

NIU opens the season at Georgia Tech on Sept. 4 before welcoming fans back to the stands at full capacity in Huskie Stadium beginning with the home opener versus Wyoming on Sept. 11. Kickoff for the game is at 12:30 p.m. (CT) and the game will honor First Responders and Health Care Heroes, while also serving as a Welcome Back Fans celebration.

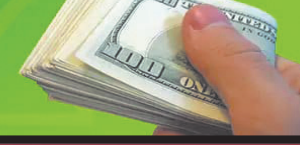
