New state mandates announced

Bearrows, Auman react to mask, vaccine policies

ROCHELLE — Gov. JB Pritzker announced at a Thursday news conference that masks will be required indoors statewide regardless of vaccination status beginning Monday amid the ongoing surge in the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pritzker also announced that employees in schools and healthcare settings will be required to receive the COVID-19 vaccine starting Sept. 5. Those who are unwilling or unable will be required to get tested for COVID-19 at least once a week.

Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows and Ogle County Health Department Public Administrator Kyle Auman took to Facebook Thursday in a video reacting to the changes.

"We must slow down and stop this spread," Bearrows said. "This mask mandate worked before. As your mayor, I'm asking you to pitch in and make this work again. It's not the end of the world. This

is something we have to do for each other."

There are no other mitigations currently in place for local businesses besides indoor masking and social distancing. The City of Rochelle has put multiple programs in place to help its businesses with pandemic-related losses since March 2020.

"The Delta variant spreads like wildfire and we have to slow this up," Bearrows said. "If we don't, then we could certainly see changes down the road that we don't like. As mayor of your city, I can tell you we pumped a lot of money into businesses during the last COVID-19 round. And I don't know if we can afford to do that again."

Auman said the OCHD has seen an upswing in cases over the last couple of weeks. Over the summer it saw 0-2 cases a day. Now it's seeing over 20 cases a day. The positivity rate in Ogle County Thursday was 6.4 percent.

The OCHD is currently working on five separate COVID-19 outbreaks and

well over 100 active cases.

"We've seen a shift in August in the 21-30-year-old population that was driving our case counts," Auman said. "Just in August, our predominant cases are in the 6-15-year-olds. Younger folks are absolutely spreading the virus. That's our school population. Luckily the mask mandate was put into place. I think we'd be in a lot more difficult of a

situation if we didn't have those mitigations currently in place."

Auman said hospital bed and ICU availability in the past 10 days has dropped four percent.

"Please be reasonable in your actions," Auman said. "This is a public health issue. It's called that for a reason. We need the public's help to address this issue."

Bearrows praised Ro-

chelle Community Hospital leadership and staff for their work during the pandemic.

"We're very fortunate in a town of 9,500 to have that hospital," Bearrows said. "Let's not abuse it. Let's do our best to slow this thing up. How we get through it is up to us. This can be a bump in the road or an absolute roadblock. Our city, county and our state can't afford another roadblock."

City manager provides 'Jackpot' update

Business expected to invest over \$130 million, add 150 jobs

ROCHELLE — Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said Friday, Aug. 20 that he's currently hearing that Project Jackpot will announce its intention to open a Rochelle location in November.

The still-anonymous business, which has purchased the former Nippon Sharyo buildings, is said to be making a capital investment of over \$130 million and adding 150 jobs that pay an average of \$52,000 per year before benefits to the area.

Fiegenschuh said he had previously been hopeful that Project Jackpot would have announced by now. Despite delays, he said he's "99.999 percent" confident that the company is coming to Rochelle.

"They kind of keep pushing it back," Fiegenschuh said. "They're coming. If you go out there, you'll see they're taking out concrete floors and putting in new floors. They're doing all kinds of work inside. They are

coming out of Chicago and I can only tell you there's issues with, they don't want to announce because they haven't told their employees. That's all I can tell you. Everybody keeps asking when they're going to announce. When they're good and ready. Right now we're hearing probably in November."

The Lee-Ogle Enterprise zone was amended by the Rochelle City Council and other area members to attract Project Jackpot by adding 10 years of 50 percent abatement, creating a category for companies that make an investment of \$100 mil-

lion or more plus adding at least 125 new jobs and a pay rate of \$50,000 or more before benefits and maintaining 95 percent employees. There are a total of 12 years of abatement for Project Jackpot's west building. The east building won't be abated at all.

The city also reached a development agreement with Project Jackpot.

"Everything is done," Fiegenschuh said. "They're spending money updating the substation portion. They're coming, they just haven't publicly announced who they are yet. I think there's things

going on behind the scenes at their current plant and they're not ready to announce because it could cause them some labor issues or other things there."

Fiegenschuh said the city has invested a "significant" amount in attracting Project Jackpot in terms of incentive dollars and staff hours. Infrastructure like the current substation project going on next to the Project Jackpot site has also been put into place.

"I wouldn't have gone to my mayor and council and said we should make this investment if [Economic Development Director Jason Anderson]

and I weren't confident they're coming," Fiegenschuh said.

High-paying jobs top Fiegenschuh's list of why he wants Project Jackpot in town. The business will be a top-10 Rochelle Municipal Utilities wastewater and water user and its top electric user. He said that will keep electric rates stable for residents.

"I think it's going to be great for the community and the investment we're making will be paid off in less than eight years based on their usage," Fiegenschuh said.

"It could be paid off within six. They could potentially add 40 percent load onto our system. The amount of power they're going to use was the same amount the whole town of Princeton used when I was city manager there. It's a significant power user and we're happy they're here."

Fiegenschuh sees an opportunity in the future to potentially work with Project Jackpot to put some solar panels on its

property as the city may look to expand its green energy portfolio.

Talks between Project Jackpot and the city began in late 2019 following the company's purchase of the Nippon Sharyo buildings. Fiegenschuh hopes all the

work done since will come to fruition soon and the public will get the answers it's been looking for.

"The economic impact, when they come out of the enterprise zone, the amount of property taxes they're going to be pay-

ing," Fiegenschuh said. "This is a big win for Rochelle and I know people are kind of impatient about it. We're not trying to be secretive. We're legally bound by nondisclosure agreements. They have their reasons."

City officials lobbying for Route 251 improvements

‘We have a section of roadway out there that we know is failing’

ROCHELLE — In 2004, The City of Rochelle sent a letter to the Illinois Department of Transportation requesting it look at improvements to Illinois Route 251 through the north side of town.

Those requests included urbanizing that section and putting in curb and gutter, new pavement, pedestrian paths and traffic signals. At that point, the state said they'd do it and put it on their multi-year plan, City Engineer Sam Tesreau said. The multi-year plan is put together every five years and various projects are evaluated for things like funding.

“Long story short, it's been on their multi-year plan now for about 17 years,” Tesreau said. “But it is part of the plan. Over those years, we've had a lot of discussions with the

state about accelerating the project and trying to push forward with the funding, but sometimes it's a very political situation where funds are going to be distributed.”

Phase one of the project was completed in 2009 at the intersection of Flagg Road and Illinois Route 251. That went from the Illinois Route 251 bridge down to Fairview Drive. There was a series of public meetings about the full project in 2008 that Tesreau said were “really positive” and he felt things were trending forward.

“Then it just got shelved,” Tesreau said. “The more we asked, it was always funding, funding, funding. Most recently though in the past month, I know the state has engaged a consultant to start looking at the section again and finish up design plans. How long that will take, I'm not quite sure.

They haven't let us know. I'm hopeful within the next two years we could probably see construction. But I also know it's taken this long to happen.”

The area the city wants reconstructed is from Fairview Drive where the original Illinois Route 251 project left off to just south of the intersection with Illinois Route 38 along with a section of Illinois Route 38 to the east just past Lincoln Highway, Tesreau said.

Tesreau believes construction would take “a little over a year” to complete. There are some things the city would be responsible for such as street lighting, utility adjustments, pedestrian pass and a small portion of signalization upgrades. He said the city is ready to do that.

The city and state have an intergovernmental agreement for maintenance of the road that

includes pavement striping and minor pothole patching. What Illinois 251 needs goes “well beyond” maintenance, Tesreau said.

“Our frustration as a city is we have a section of roadway out there that we know is failing,” Tesreau said. “This section of the roadway has in fact gotten to that point where it needs

to be fully reconstructed. It needs to be widened out to five lanes including the bi-directional lane down the middle.”

The Spark Shop coming to Rochelle this fall

Collaborative effort to serve as retail incubator for small business owners

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Chamber of Commerce, Rochelle Retail Advisory Board and the City of Rochelle announced plans last week for The Spark Shop.

The collaboration is planned to be a retail incubator for local small business owners and will be housed in the historic filling station building downtown. The Spark Shop is for businesses that are currently home-based but are looking to someday have their own brick and mortar location. About 10-12 vendors will be in the space at a time selling merchandise on a quarterly basis.

“We want to make sure we're the ones fostering that growth,” Rochelle Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Tricia Herrera said. “We know that Rochelle downtown and as a business community is great. You just want to help other people know that too. The biggest question I get at the chamber from small businesses is ‘How do I start?’ Where do I start and what do I do?”

We just want to make that's a little more accessible to everybody.”

will also be meeting with an advisor with the Small Business Development Center from Waubesa and Kishwaukee Community Colleges to further help them graduate into the region.

Herrera said the advisor can help business owners with business plans and what they want to do. It will be available to those that are in all phases of planning.

“Maybe they've already thought of a business plan and what they want to do,” Herrera said. “Maybe they have absolutely no idea where to start. He's going to show them where to start and how to find funding. He has access to grants and stuff that can really help these types of businesses.”

The idea of The Spark Shop is to take a following from a vendor there and turn it into a brick and mortar location for downtown shopping. The city, chamber and retail advisory board want all the downtown storefronts filled with gift stores and things to attract people to the downtown.

Rochelle City Councilwoman Kate Shaw-Dickey said the idea started almost two years ago as a true business incubator where businesses can come in and

have a governing board oversee them and steer them in the right direction. After touring other towns' incubators, something on a smaller scale was necessary for Rochelle.

“We kind of morphed that into this cooperative to be able to work with several at one time as opposed to one at a time,” Shaw-Dickey said. “It lends something to the downtown as well. Help small businesses in Rochelle and still be kind of an attraction for people who are coming in.”

The Spark Shop plans to open sometime this fall. Around 25 people have already reached out about getting their products into the space, Herrera said. She hopes to get a couple of “staple” vendors to get people in the door where they'll see other offerings. Products could include candles, signs, tumbler cups, clothing, sweet treats and more.

Herrera believes Rochelle has “a great amount” of businesses that would be good for The Spark Shop. A lot of those would include the vendors that participate in craft markets that are held at Kennay Farms Distilling and The Cypress House.

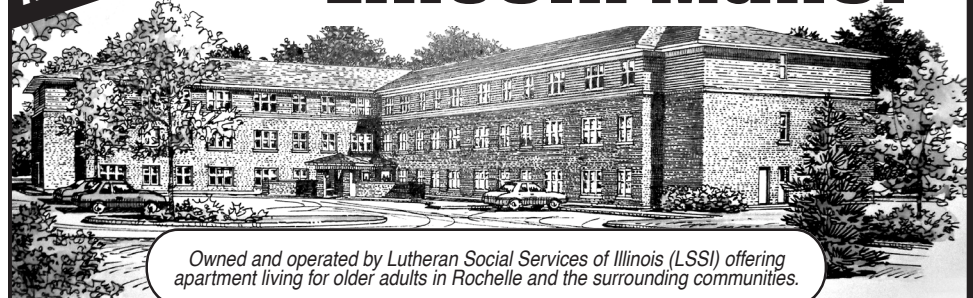

Man arrested for DUI

Szydzik skydives to celebrate 80th birthday

ROCHELLE — Ray Szydzik frequently passes Chicagoland Skydiving Center on his way to his son's farm outside Rochelle. One day his son took him to dinner at the Flight Deck Bar & Grill.

He watched the various skydivers, ultralights and wingsuits take off and land. He made the decision to tandem skydive on his upcoming 80th birthday.

Szydzik, of Cary, remembered the news coverage of President George Bush tandem diving on his 80th, 85th and 90th birthdays. He was motivated by the fact that he planned to skydive every fifth birthday.

He took the necessary precautions and had a physical a month before. He made the appointment for an 8 a.m. jump on Aug. 8.

Szydzik noticed he was the oldest person skydiving and said he felt "a little intimidated," but no one seemed concerned about



his age.

"Would they judge me if I decided not to jump? The thought went through my mind," Szydzik said in an email.

CSC Instructor Nate Plumb would jump with Szydzik. They talked as they geared up before the jump.

"We walked to the idling Cessna Caravan C208 Supervan plane, the noise almost drowned out any apprehensions I had," Szydzik said.

After hearing instructions, Szydzik felt the rush of cold air as he and Plumb shuffled to the edge of the plane.

"I looked down from 14,000 feet through my

goggles and said to myself 'sometimes you have to just trust and jump,'" Szydzik said. "And I did or maybe Nate helped. We descended quickly. There was no time to think about what was happening. We were freefalling for about 60 seconds."

The parachute opened with a mild jerk, and Szydzik couldn't take his eyes off the surroundings. He said the square farmlands seemed like an emerald checkerboard.

Szydzik said he felt happy and bewildered upon landing.

"Would I do it again?" Szydzik said. "I told Nate at my next 80th birthday. But now I'm ready."

Flagg-Rochelle Public Library receives funding from state

Creston-Dement Public Library also awarded

SPRINGFIELD – Secretary of State and State Librarian Jesse White has awarded Illinois Public Library Per Capita and Equalization Aid Grants totaling \$18.1 million to 638 public libraries serving almost 12 million patrons. The Flagg-Rochelle Public Library District received \$20,291.58 and the Creston-Dement Public Library District received \$1,171.15. “Public Act 102-0039 allowed my office to award these grants at \$1.475 per capita, an increase from the previ-

ous rate of \$1.25,” White said. “I am extremely proud of the outstanding service Illinois’ public libraries provide to all residents. I truly believe libraries are cornerstones of our communities, and I am pleased to provide this increased funding to help them serve the public.” Some of the valuable services public libraries provide with grant money include the following: large print material for aging patrons, books, magazines, newspapers, CDs and DVDs, audiobooks and eBooks,

“We always hear Rochelle needs more retail,” Herrera said. “I think that’s where this was, ‘Here’s a way to do that.’ All the way back 5-6 years ago, it was more retail and Rochelle needs to address more quality of life issues. This is it. We want people to be able to run downtown Rochelle and pick up a birthday gift on a Saturday and not have to drive.”

The Spark Shop could also allow vendors to network and maybe team

up to start a storefront if they can’t do it on their own, Shaw-Dickey said. Some smaller vendors in town already sell products at larger businesses. The pandemic and a lack of resources available to be put towards the project had it in a holding pattern before recent months. “We’re just excited to get this going,” Herrera said. “The city, the chamber and the Retail Advisory Board love small business and this is our best way to help a small business.”

Family's pain remains fresh

AS Americans fled Kabul and desperate Afghans sought to follow, Jerry and Brett Young stood in the yard of their rural Rochester home Friday and remembered their boy who never got to see his 26th birthday.

"He loved to skateboard when he was younger. And he loved all kinds of music. He especially liked jazz, the blues and hard rock," Brett recalled of her son Chad.

His father Jerry pointed to two road signs hanging on a nearby shed.

One designated a portion of Illinois 4 as the "Cpl. James 'Chad' Young Memorial Highway." Another recognized him as a 2003 Glenwood High School graduate killed in that distant land.

This nation honors its war dead, as well it should. I admire the willingness of our servicemen and women to sacrifice for this great nation. But I'm left wondering if our nation is too willing to send men and women into harms' way.

I'm not a pacifist but I find myself often skeptical of our government's intentions.

Jimmy Carter, perhaps the best person to be president in my lifetime, annoyed many when he said the U.S. is the most warlike nation in history. That's a tough pill to swallow. But it's worth noting that of the 245 years the nation has existed, we have been at war 226 years.

A Brown University study found that since 9/11 the U.S. has spent more than \$6.4 trillion on military actions in the Middle East.

Think how many schools, highways, bridges and parks could have been created with that money.

Of course, those figures understate the cost of war. For families such as the Youngs, the cost has been immeasurable. Tears still flow freely 11 years after his death. And his was one of nearly 7,000 American service men and women killed in Iraq and Afghanistan.

At least 801,000 people have been killed by direct war violence in Iraq, Afghanistan, Syria, Yemen and Pakistan. Many were civilians.

"You know all politicians lie," Jerry Young said. "They will say things that aren't true or they will vote for something they really don't believe in because someone did them a favor."

While he had a strong opinion about the integrity, or the lack of it, exhibited by our elected officials, his opinion on the Afghanistan war is muted.

"I really don't have an opinion on what is happening over there other than its sad. It's like when Osama Bin Laden was killed, some reporter called and wanted our opinion. What are we supposed to say? We are glad he's dead?"

For Rock Island native Tyler Carroll, the war was almost half his lifetime ago. The 41-year-old, was one of the first soldiers to fight in Afghanistan after 9/11.

"I had friends killed over there and I know others who were badly wounded. And others came home with mental issues," he said.

The Afghanistan war is the longest in U.S. history.

"It's not affecting me as much as others," Carroll said. "It was so long ago for me. Was it worth it? Well, our initial mission was to destroy Al Qaeda and make sure the Taliban was not in control. Al Qaeda was dam-

aged, Osama Bin Laden has been killed but the Taliban is back in control. Perhaps they weren't ready for democracy. But many of the people we interacted with there seemed to want it."

Democracy runs in Carroll's blood. He's a scion of a Quad-City political dynasty. His grandpa is former state Sen. Denny Jacobs, his great grandfather was state Rep. Oral Jacobs and his uncle is former state Sen. Mike Jacobs.

Still, he is skeptical whether the U.S. should impose democracy on other nations.

One shouldn't be surprised. Most wars end in ambiguity. We honor the abstract causes for which men and women fought -- freedom, patriotism, service -- but we can also question the wisdom of policies that deployed them into harm's way.

When I was a child in the 1970s, I didn't think much about war. I was in 4th grade when Saigon fell in April of 1975.

Not long after that, I was canoeing down a river with my parents and we met another family paddling downstream -- a husband, wife and two little girls.

The man in the other canoe had no legs.

For the rest of the trip my mother was quiet and contemplative.

Finally, I asked her, "Why doesn't that man have any legs?"

Her voice cracked and she said, "He lost them in that awful, awful war. We should never have been there."

Last week, when I saw the hurt in Chad Young's parent's eyes and heard the reports from Kabul, I couldn't help but think the same thing.

Rochelle leaders looking for daycare answers

May Elementary School building could be off the table as potential option

ROCHELLE — Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said Friday, Aug. 20 that the city has “hit a brick wall everywhere we’ve turned” in efforts to help get a daycare facility back in town after Kishwaukee Family YMCA Child Care Center at 1010 N. 15th St. closed last year.

Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows said earlier this summer that the city, with the help of Rochelle Township High School District 212, was endeavoring to utilize part of May School as a possible daycare facility with an outside director after attempts to purchase and utilize the YMCA building did not come to fruition.

Fiegenschuh said a longer term lease at May School wouldn’t be possible in case the school district needed the building again.

“What happens if they want to bring kids back into that school and they need the school back?” Fiegenschuh said. “What do you do with the daycare center if it’s successful? I think May School is off the table. I don’t know. Maybe, maybe not. Maybe we’ll revisit it.”

Even if May School was back on the table, there was a \$50,000-60,000 a year expense for property taxes and lease and utility payments that would have to be paid for, Fiegenschuh said. That doesn’t include payroll. He said daycare centers are very payroll intensive.

“It’s an expensive endeavor and who’s going to pay for that?” Fiegenschuh said. “If we could go out and raise \$300,000-400,000 to cover building expenses, great. But that only covers you for 5-6 years. Long-term, how do you pay for it? I don’t know. There’s no easy answer. I just know the city shouldn’t be paying for everything. I don’t have a problem with helping, but it shouldn’t be all on our back.”

Fiegenschuh said the city has had “a lot” of meetings related to getting a daycare back in town and a lot of staff time has been spent on it. A current idea is trying to start up a 501c3 nonprofit to take it on.

He said people would be more likely to help with a nonprofit because of tax incentives.

“I really hope we look at starting a not for profit and let them go out and fund-raise for it,” Fiegenschuh said. “Maybe the city can be part of that. And try to find a location. It would be nice if we could find somebody to run it and they could use the old YMCA location.”

The city manager said the YMCA is looking at selling its building, but the city council isn’t going to spend the money it takes to buy it.

The way the building is set up, Fiegenschuh is unsure what else it could be used for.

“At the end of the day, I don’t want to commit the city financially in perpetuity to running a daycare,” Fiegenschuh said. “We weren’t running it before and it’s not really our job to run it now.”

Fiegenschuh recognized the need for a daycare in town and said he can’t imagine the stress residents are going through trying to find somebody to watch their kids while they’re at work.

There is a core group of about nine people involved in the efforts to bring a daycare back to town including Fiegenschuh, Bearrows, city staff, representatives from out of town that have run daycare centers, people from the Rochelle Area Community Foundation and volunteers in town.

“It’s not like people who want a daycare center are actively giving us ideas on how to get this done,” Fiegenschuh said. “We’ve been talking about this for the past year and it just seems everywhere we turn it’s just another hurdle to jump. We don’t want to give up, but nine people trying to solve this is not enough.”

The signals need to be improved, the drainage needs to be improved. It’s something we’ve been discussing now for a number of years and we just feel it needs to be done.”

Tesreau said he hopes some of the new funds the federal government has released will trickle down to the state and some movement will be seen on the project. City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh said starting this week the city will be having quarterly meetings with IDOT about Illinois Route 251.

He called the potential project a high priority and wanted the meetings to keep the state on track. Getting Illinois 251 reconstructed is one the city’s “bigger” lobbying efforts.

“People who think we can just fix it, we can’t,” Fiegenschuh said. “We have no jurisdiction over that route whatsoever. They maintain it, they plow it, it’s their route. The road is in horrible shape.”

Tesreau said the city has fielded “multiple” citizen complaints about the road. He thinks if residents made enough complaints to the state and contacted local legislators that it could help move the situation along.

The city engineer called the roadway’s maintenance over the years “band-aided together.”




“There’s only so long you can band-aid things before you have a complete failure of that facility,” Tesreau said. “In my opinion, that’s what we’re going to be looking at along certain sections.”

Rochelle’s recent changes to the targeted area around Illinois Route 251 including The REC Center, a planned Starbucks location and future development of the Hickory Grove site would benefit from improvements to the route.



“It’s not just a roadway for the motoring public,” Tesreau said. “But it’s also the gateway into our community. And we have an opportunity right now along that stretch of roadway to revitalize the area in terms of commercial retail and improvement like this will only add to that benefit that we could see in terms of access to those businesses.”

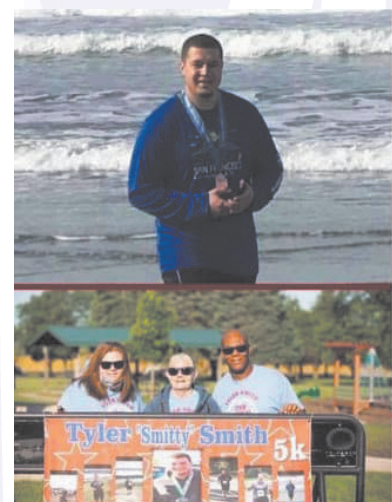

Hubs steamroll Woodstock

Rochelle records eight rushing touchdowns in 60-22 win over Blue Streaks

WOODSTOCK — As the temperature hovered around 90 degrees Friday evening, the Rochelle Hub varsity football team enjoyed a sizzling hot start to the fall season, torching the Woodstock Blue Streaks with eight rushing touchdowns and over 400 yards of offense in a 60-22 victory. Rochelle (1-0) will host Herscher for its first home contest of the season on Friday, Sept. 3.

Woodstock struggled out of the gate, committing an intentional grounding penalty in the end zone on its second play from scrimmage to net a safety for the Hubs. Rochelle cashed in on its first offensive possession, with junior Garrett Gensler scoring the first of his team-high four rushing touchdowns on a 2-yard run. Gensler led Rochelle with 126 total yards in the win.

“We knew we were tough and we showed that tonight,” Gensler said. “We ran the ball down their throats and they couldn’t stop us. I thought we got off the ball really well tonight and the blocking up front

was great. We had huge holes and we were reaching the second level. We have a small group this year, but we’re sticking together and we want to make a playoff run.”

Quarterback Liam Mickle carried the load for the Woodstock offense, finishing with 198 total yards and three touchdowns. With the Blue Streaks trailing 10-0 in the first quarter, Mickle marched Woodstock down the field, ultimately connecting with Sean Ryan on a 5-yard touchdown pass. Rochelle answered right back, though, wrapping up a brief scoring drive with a 4-yard touchdown run from Gensler on the team’s first offensive snap of the second quarter.

Mickle needed only two passes to find his second touchdown of the evening. After hitting Jared Kniola for a 31-yard strike, Mickle linked up with Caden Monti down the sideline for a 30-yard touchdown pass to make it a 16-14 game. But Woodstock had no answer for the Rochelle offense, which compiled 415 yards of total offense and 381 rushing yards in the win.

Seniors Josie Lundquist and Megan Thompson sealed the sweep soon after, besting Jenny Espinoza and Teresa Madera 6-4, 6-1 at No. 2 doubles. “It felt good to get two wins this week,” Dickey said. “We’re already playing well as a team and we’re seeing a lot of success already. I’m hoping that [MeLisa] and I can qualify for state and compete in the state tournament this year. I think

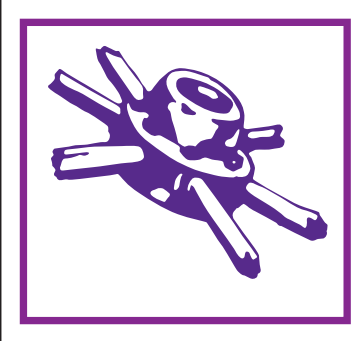

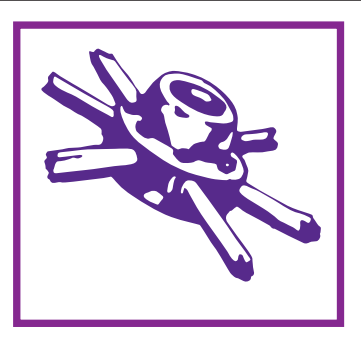

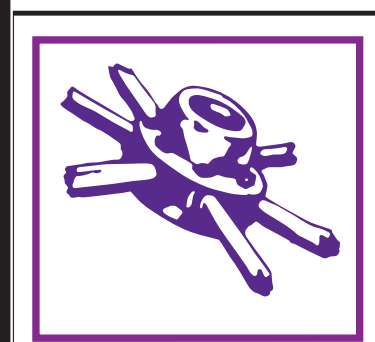

Harrington leads Hubs in matchup with Morris

Ohlinger fires low team score during road contest against Ottawa

ROCHELLE — Junior Damen Harrington stepped up for the short-handed Rochelle varsity golf team on Wednesday, when Morris faced off with the Hubs at Fairways Golf Course in an Interstate 8 Conference matchup. Harrington led Rochelle with 46, but the Redskins won 177-220 over the Hubs, who were without their No. 1 varsity starter in Griffin Ohlinger.

“It’s a struggle with our limited numbers right now but our top four players know they have to carry the load for us,” head coach Glen Mehrings said. “They know their scores are always going to count and they’re more mature mentally than they were last year... We don’t have a fifth or sixth varsity golfer right now, but we have some JV players who are working on their skills.”

Harrington started his round strong, carding a birdie on the second hole and making a few pars during the afternoon. Senior Rowan Williams added 52 for the Hubs against Morris, while sophomore Cale Workman totaled 60. Junior Wade Smith rounded out the lineup with 62. Rochelle (0-4) will travel to compete in

the Geneseo Invitational over the weekend.

“Damen struggled with some crooked numbers on holes during the first week of the season, but he’s a lot tougher mentally and he’s gaining a lot of experience,” Mehrings said. “Damen’s not a player who shoots in the 50s. Damen can shoot in the 42-to-45 range and it was a positive for us to see him finish around his scoring range today. I’m proud he was able to bounce back.”

Ottawa

Rochelle continued its Interstate 8 Conference scheduled with a road match against Ottawa on Thursday, falling 141-207 and moving to 0-5 on the season. Junior Griffin Ohlinger returned to the varsity lineup, leading Rochelle with 39 while junior Damen Harrington added 46.

“Griffin’s very competitive and he expects a lot out of himself,” Mehrings said. “But he’s very humble and he knows he can break 80 for 18 holes every time he’s out there. I think he knows how to put together a really good round and it’s been nice to see that early in the season. I think Griffin will make a strong push for All-Conference as well as the postseason this year.”

Gensler’s third rushing touchdown of the night, from 3 yards away, helped put the Hubs ahead 24-14.

“We came out strong and we stacked a lot of days on the practice field over the summer,” senior center Brodie Nantz said. “That’s what Rochelle football is supposed to look like. We

controlled the clock, scored a lot of points and ran the ball down their throats. Winning our first game, especially on the road, is huge for confidence, especially for the rest of the season.”

The Hub defense stepped up with a stop late in the second quarter, forcing Woodstock to punt before taking the ball over and scoring once again, this time on a

5-yard rush from junior Trey Taft. Rochelle led 32-14 at halftime, but Woodstock briefly gained momentum in the third quarter, recovering an onside kick and scoring soon after on Mickle’s 16-yard touchdown run.

Those were the last points the Blue Streaks would earn, however, with the Hubs sealing their victory behind 28 unanswered

points over the third and fourth quarters. Woodstock’s second onside-kick attempt failed, resulting in a 23-yard rush from Taft and a 30-yard rush from Gensler that saw him reach the end zone for the fourth time. Junior Cody Stover-Cullum scored on a 5-yard touchdown run, helping increase Rochelle’s lead to 46-22 after three quarters.

“Our backs were running hard and we were finishing our blocks up front all night,” Nantz said. “We were on top of their defenders after every play. We have a good group this year. There aren’t many of us, but everybody who’s out here wants to be here and we have a lot of heart.”

Junior Landon DeLille scored both of Rochelle’s

touchdowns in the fourth quarter, with his first coming on a 3-yard rush and his second on a 40-yard burst down the right sideline to cap off a 97-yard rushing performance on Friday. Junior Jaden Cook and senior Marco Castro each recorded sacks for the Hub defense, while senior Tanner Lager totaled a team-high six tackles.

HOLLYWOOD — British actor **Rege-Jean Page** made a splash in **Shondra Rhimes’** Netflix series “Bridgerton” on Christmas night of 2020. He became an overnight sensation. Fans of the show were shocked when he announced he’d be leaving the series after the first season. When he hosted “Saturday Night Live,” he confirmed he’d left the show. Netflix knew what they had and immediately signed him to star in the \$200 million film “The Gray Man,” opposite **Ana de Armas**, **Chris Evans** and **Ryan Gosling**, expected to be released for streaming next year. Then Paramount Pictures cast him opposite **Chris Pine** and **Michelle Rodriguez** in “Dungeons & Dragons” (due March 3, 2023).

Paramount was so impressed with him that they’ve handed Rege-Jean the plum title role of “The Saint” in the reboot of the 1962 British series that starred **Roger Moore**, a future James Bond (1962-69), then **Ian Ogilvy** in “The Return of the Saint” (1978-79) and finally **Val Kilmer** in the 1997 theatrical film, which flopped.

Paramount Pictures is in a dangerous place. They agreed to release “A Quiet Place 2” for 90 days into theaters after “A Quiet Place” grossed \$350 million. But then they decided to cut the time in theaters in half so they could boost their Paramount+ downloading platform. Producers **John Krasinski** and **Michael Bay**, plus its star, **Emily Blunt**, were poised to receive a big bonus from the theatrical release, and they now are demanding that Paramount make up the monies they’ve lost due to the shortened release in theaters. Stars such as **Tom Cruise** and **Mark Wahlberg** are watching closely to see what Paramount will do, since both of them have major film releases upcoming through that studio. What Paramount does could affect the entire industry and some or all of the streaming platforms.

Meanwhile, MGM has been accused by director **Andrew Levitas** of trying to bury his film “Minamata” because of the personal negative baggage of its star, **Johnny Depp**. The film was acquired last fall after MGM relaunched American International Pictures (the studio that gave us the “Beach Party” movies with **Frankie Avalon** and **Annette Funicello** in the 1960s). This comes on the heels of Warner Brothers asking Depp to resign from his role of Grindelwald in the Harry Potter spinoff franchise “Fantastic Beasts.”

Depp’s messy divorce and battles with **Amber Heard** have been sensational tabloid fodder, which caused his last film, “Waiting for the Barbarians,” co-starring **Robert Pattinson** and **Mark Rylance**, to tank at the box office with an embarrassing \$761,361 gross. MGM is not the powerful studio they were in their heyday and want no part of the public relations nightmare that could go with releasing this film or the hassles of dealing with Johnny Depp’s woes! “#21 Dump Street!”

Orozco leads Hubs over Aurora Christian

Senior forward nets four goals in 6-1 victory at War on 34 tournament

EARLVILLE — Hub senior Josue Orozco has high expectations for his final high school season with the Rochelle varsity soccer team. The talented forward opened his senior season with a tremendous offensive performance on Wednesday, scoring four goals including two in each half to lead Rochelle over

Aurora Christian 6-1 in the first round of the War on 34 Championship.

Taking the field for the first time in nearly two years, Orozco broke the first-round match open during the 13th minute, finessing his way around the Aurora Christian defense and rolling a right-footed ball into the net to put the Hubs ahead 1-0. Orozco capitalized on another scoring chance shortly after, sending a left-footed

free kick over the Eagle defensive wall and bending the ball into the back of the goal, giving Rochelle a 2-0 advantage during the 15th minute.

“It feels good to be back,” Orozco said. “I’ve been working hard during practice and I’m giving everything I have. We want to make it back to the regional finals, but we need to stick together and work hard every day. I want to score

more goals than any player in RTHS history.”

Some miscommunication on defense hurt the Hubs during the 20th minute, when Aurora Christian netted its first goal of the match to make it a 2-1 contest. Rochelle responded with plenty of pressure on offense, though, resulting in an own goal by the Eagles during the 28th minute that was credited to Hub midfielder Diego Cincire. Lead-

ing 3-1, Rochelle surged ahead in the 34th minute, when sophomore Eli Luxton booted in a penalty kick after a foul in the box.

Orozco claimed both of the Rochelle goals during the second half, scoring in the 41st and 45th minutes on assists from Luxton and junior Christian Harding. Junior Jarret Milan recorded four saves for the Hubs (1-0), who will play for the tournament championship

on Saturday.

“We wanted to start fast and we were on them from the first touch,” senior defender Bryce Whitehead said. “We’ve been doing a lot of conditioning during practice and it’s been tough, but our conditioning is paying off. We’re a younger team this season, but we have players back who are doing a lot for us. We want to go as hard as we can and win every game we play.”

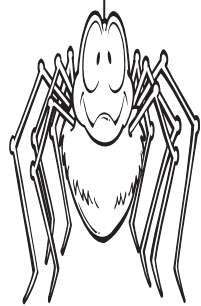
