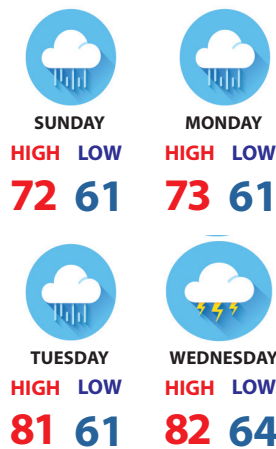

Stock+Field reopens

New name to be revealed soon

ROCHELLE — Stock+Field reopened as a surprise in Rochelle on Wednesday after a change of ownership and being closed in recent months.

The R.P. Acquisition Corporation — a wholly owned subsidiary of R.P. Lumber Co., Inc. — purchased the Stock+Field assets out of bankruptcy court in April 2021 and has

been working to reopen 22 locations in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, and Wisconsin.

Based in Edwardsville, R.P. Lumber Co., Inc. is a family-owned retailer that operates 72 full-service hardware and building material stores throughout Illinois, Missouri, Wyoming, and Iowa.

A corporate representative of The R.P. Acquisition Corporation said the store's doors won't be closing again and in "the next

couple of weeks" a new name and full rebrand will be announced and signage and logos at the store will be replaced.

Last month, Stock+Field took suggestions online for the new name with the intention of announcing its choice this month. The corporate representative declined to reveal the name or any clues to what it might be on Wednesday.

Man charged with aggravated robbery

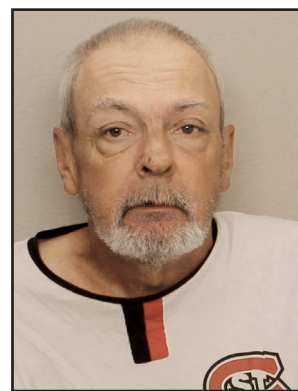
ROCHELLE — A Rockford man was charged with aggravated robbery Tuesday after an incident at Central Bank in Rochelle, Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby said.

Rodney Beese, 63, of Rockford entered the bank and presented a note to a teller demanding money and implied he had a weapon and that others may be involved, Rochelle Police Detective Terry Inman said.

Rochelle Police responded to a panic alarm at 1:56 p.m. and a report of a suspicious incident and a male leaving the scene, Higby said. Beese was given money before leaving the bank, Inman said.

Rochelle Police said it was originally believed that Beese presented a note outside at the drive-up window, but the incident actually occurred inside.

After getting a description of Beese, a Rochelle Police patrolman located a man fitting his description nearby at the Colonade Motel and he was

identified and arrested. An undisclosed amount of money was recovered with Beese, Inman said.

"I don't know if he was armed at the time, but we didn't find any weapons," Inman said. "As far as I know, it was just him. I believe the money we recovered was from the bank. Everything was turned over to the FBI. We don't have the amount."

Since banks are federally-regulated, the FBI became involved and will be handling the investigation. Local jurisdictions like Rochelle can't charge bank robbery, that would be up to the FBI, Higby said.

Beese was transported to the Ogle County Jail following Tuesday's events.

Land boundary agreement approved

Creston board: Rochelle Landfill could close at end of 2040

CRESTON — The Creston Village Board approved a series of agreements at its Tuesday meeting that would result in the Rochelle Landfill closing by or on Dec. 31, 2040.

The landfill would close earlier if there is no remaining capacity. In order to ensure that there is no remaining capacity, the annual limit for waste that can be disposed of at the landfill would increase to 650,000 tons per year.

The agreement is conditioned upon the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency granting a final and non-appealable order to eliminate the need to exhume cell one of the Rochelle Landfill.

Both the village and the City of Rochelle engaged an expert to review the need for exhumation and found there is currently no leakage from the landfill and exhumation would not be needed, Creston

Village Attorney Dave Tess said.

The City of Rochelle will need to approve that

agreement and two others at its Monday meeting for the plan to move forward, Tess said. All agreements

are contingent upon each other. All must pass or all fail. An IEPA approval process will also follow

that would take eight months to a year.

4-H blue ribbon livestock auction set for July 31

OREGON — The annual 4-H blue ribbon livestock auction has been set for Saturday July 31, and it is going virtual. The 4-H auction committee invites the public to support 4-H project work by bidding on a quality 4-H animal!

The auction will start at 3 p.m. online. It will feature 4-H market hogs, lambs, beef animals, goats, poultry and rabbits as well as beef, swine, lamb and goat carcasses.

Live animals may be purchased and sent to a locker or may be bought and resold at a slaughterhouse. Transportation to processing plants will be provided. A floor price will be set according to the current market trends the day of the auction. A list of current market prices will be available. Pork and lamb carcasses will be sold whole. Beef carcasses will be sold in halves.

Auction order will be: beef carcass, live beef, sheep carcass, live sheep, swine carcass, live swine, dairy basket, dairy & meat goat wethers, poultry, rabbits, beef, sheep and swine.

Project exhibits

Ogle County's 302 4-H club members in 14 clubs will showcase approximately 615 4-H project exhibits and 750 project animals during the 2021 Ogle County Fair, Oregon, July 28 through Aug. 1.

4-H Fairs are held nationally to allow youth the opportunity to exhibit projects that have resulted from in-depth yearlong studies of areas that interest them.

As part of the exhibition, non-animal exhibitors meet one-on-one with project judges to receive feedback about their displays and gather ideas for future project expansion.

Animal judging tests 4-H'ers abilities to produce, maintain and select healthy animals with excellent breeding and market potential. Animal showmanship classes provide 4-H'ers with the opportunities to develop and refine their animal presentation skills.

At the 4-H Fair, competition exists at two levels. 4-H'ers first compete against themselves for exhibit ratings. Every exhibit — animal or non-animal — is assigned a rating of blue, red or white.

Blue ratings are awarded to youth with entries that meet class guidelines and represent high-quality work. White ratings are assigned when entries do not meet class guidelines or exhibits are of low quality. Red ribbons are assigned for exhibits falling somewhere in between.

Once ratings have been assigned, all of the blue award winners compete against one another for the chance to become class champions or overall division winners. A number of blue-awarded non-animal exhibits are also selected each year to represent Ogle County 4-H at the Illinois State Fair.

Beyond the competition and learning, the Ogle County 4-H Fair is a celebration! It marks the end of a year of youth development, club and county activities and community service, new friendships, and family building.

members, judges, auctioneers, and supporters who make this annual educational extravaganza possible.

STEM Café: The Physics of the Olympics

DEKALB — On Wednesday, July 14, two Northern Illinois University physics professors will discuss the physics of the summer Olympics at an online STEM Café.

The online STEM Café begins at 6 p.m. and is free and open to the public. Registration and more information at go.niu.edu/Olympics.

"There's a huge amount of interesting physics and science that will take place during the summer Olympics," Associate Professor Jahred Adelman said. "It can all be understood without using any complicated mathematics, and in most cases, without any math at all."

According to Adelman, the basic concepts of Newton's Laws, conservation of energy and conservation of momentum can explain what happens when a diver jumps off the platform, when a gymnast pushes off the vault or when a soccer player kicks the ball.

"Thinking about sports from the perspective

of a physicist can lead to surprising insights," Adelman said.

Adelman, a particle physicist whose research focuses on the Higgs boson and particle accelerator technologies, will be joined by fellow particle physicist Professor Mike Eads.

While both professors focus much of their research on understanding matter and energy at the tiniest, subatomic level, Adelman says particle physics nonetheless has

a foundation in older descriptions of the mechanics of larger objects.

"The physical laws describing everything taking place in Tokyo 2021 are no different from those that explain everyday life, from driving a car to walking to work to taking the train," Adelman said. "But their everyday nature makes these laws anything but routine. The more we understand these rules, the more extraordinary and special they become."

People may not know it, but they are already physicists! We all intuitively understand and use Newton's Laws without even realizing it."

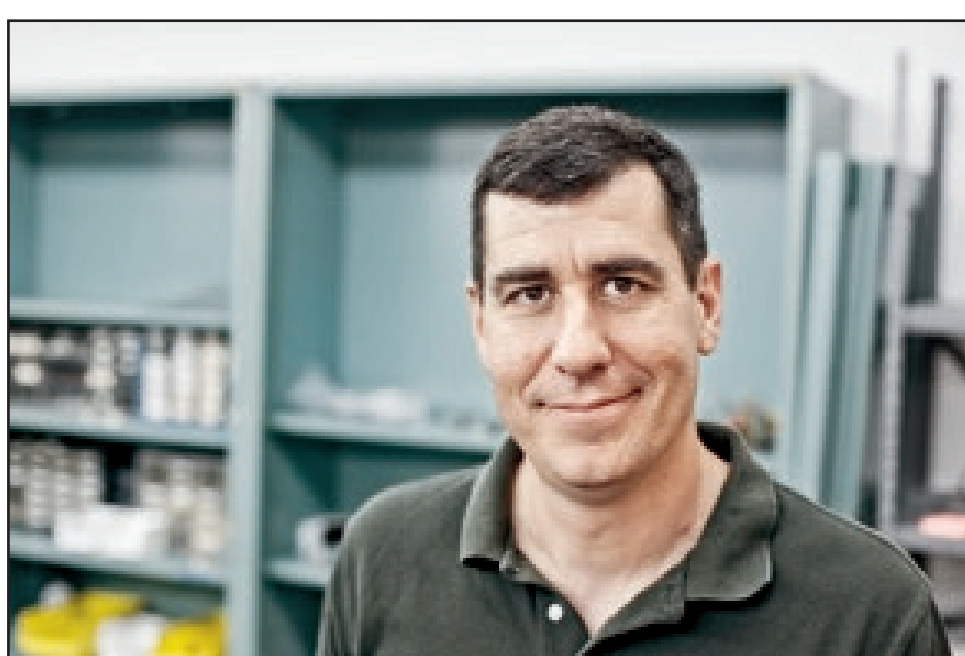
Adelman and Eads share a love of sport, and they relish the chance to apply knowledge of physics to the sports we all love.

"Thankfully, being good at a sport is not a requirement for understanding it," Adelman said.

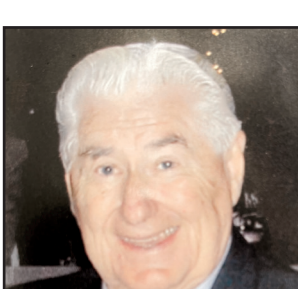

EMBALMING PROCESS

The embalming process essentially involves replacing the blood and other bodily fluids with a preservative such as formaldehyde. Embalming is required by law only under certain circumstances, but families that intend to have a public viewing of the body usually choose to have it done, embalming preservative powers give them more leeway in scheduling a funeral. Embalmers are adept at restoring natural features that have been injured or to people who die after a long illness. They have a range of techniques to deal with various difficulties. They can replace missing hair, rebuild fractured features, or disguise the effects of



the drastic weight loss from a long, wasting illness. Before it is placed in the casket, the body is dressed and prepared for viewing. Hair is shampooed and set, and men get a shave. Families are sometimes encouraged to bring in a recent photograph of the deceased to help guide them.

Are You Ready for an Upgrade?

DO you enjoy your life? Are you living with real peace, joy and fulfillment? Or are you stuck in the pain of past mistakes, abuse, injustices or some other hurt you've endured?

I know what it's like to live in "survival mode," just getting through each day and dreading a lot of what I had to do. I also know how life-changing it can be to discover the truth that God wants us to enjoy our lives. John 10:10 says, "The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, until it overflows]" (AMP).

Before I discovered this scripture, I didn't understand that God meant for me to have a joy-filled

life. I loved God and was a born-again Christian, and yet I was miserable. But John 10:10 clearly shows us that Jesus didn't die for us just so we could be miserable until we go to Heaven.

He came so we can "have and enjoy life" now...in this life. And we can have this life if we'll choose to trust God and do what He shows us to do to become healed in our soul—our mind, will and emotions.

Face the Truth and Find Freedom

We all experience heartache or wounds from abuse or injustices of some kind. Getting hurt, hurts. But getting well hurts, too. One

reason people stay broken is because there is pain in the healing process. It requires us to face the truth about ourselves—where we are and how we got there. And I know how hard this can be.

Because of the severe abuse I experienced for years before I left home at the age of 18, I was angry, insecure, suspicious, manipulative and controlling. I wasn't able to have healthy relationships because I didn't like myself, which made me critical and judgmental of everyone else.

I used my past to justify my bad behavior until God spoke to my heart and said, "Your past is the reason you are the way you are, but don't let it be the

excuse to stay that way."

As I grew in my relationship with Christ, I learned the truth about His love for me...that He knew all about me and He loved me anyway. I was no surprise to God—He knew what He was getting when He chose me. And the same is true for you. The truth is we will always have some imperfections, but Jesus didn't come for the healthy—He came for the sick! That means we all qualify for help from God.

Pick Your Pain

The healing process is not easy; it takes time and we often make progress little by little. But the truth is you'll either have the pain of change or the pain

of staying the same. The question is: Are you tired of putting your energy into being miserable and mad all the time? Or are you ready for an upgrade?

The thought of staying the same is scary to me. It makes me shiver to think I could still be the way I used to be more than 40 years ago now. Even though there was a lot of pain getting from there to where I am today, I can honestly say there has been more joy than pain. God gave me the grace to never give up, and if He did it for me, He'll do it for you!

Ephesians 2:10 says, "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do" (NIV). God's plan for you is good, and

He wants to help you take your journey through the healing process so you can become everything He created you to be. You can trust Him to always be with you and to give you the strength to do everything you need to do (Philippians 4:13).

I really want to encourage you today to refuse to settle for less than the joy-filled life Jesus wants you to have. Face the truth about yourself and understand that if your soul has been severely damaged by abuse, abandonment, rejection, loss or anything else, the journey to wholeness won't be easy. But I promise you the joy you'll gain on the other side—the upgraded life you'll have in the end—will far outweigh the pain of the process.

How has your communication been?

RECENTLY, I've been thinking a lot about communication and what is involved for it to be effective.

During the month of June, over 20 members of the Northwest Illinois Incident Management Assistance Team deployed to Volk Field in Wisconsin for an exercise called Patriot21, as well as the Rockton Chemtool fire.

Members of the team come from many different backgrounds including local fire departments, emergency management, hospital groups and law enforcement. Following the tornado in 2015, I realized the need and benefit of incident management teams (IMT) and I became heavily involved in the Illinois IMT, Northwest IL IMAT, and the Eastern Area IMT.

Incident management teams bring a framework of nationally-qualified, position-specific individuals, to help organize the chaos of any event whether natural or manmade.

As the incident commander, my job is to make ensure every-

one is working in unison and this can only be done through effective communication, something we preached constantly at the recent exercise.

The need for clear and concise communication has to be bi-directional and was extremely crucial in Patriot21. This exercise was hosted by the Wisconsin National Guard and incorporated not only multiple National Guard air wings from across the country but also the following organizations: Wisconsin State Police, Nebraska State Police, Maine State Police, Illinois Urban Search and Rescue TF1, county and state emergency managers and multiple private organizations.

Managing a group of over 1,000 individuals, multiple air operations and a half dozen different work sites is a difficult task on the best days; however, without effective communication, response of this magnitude is impossible.

What I came to quickly realize is the communication has to flow both ways and the messages have to be understood by

both parties. This was evident in the communication between the civilian and military organizations involved in this exercise.

We both spoke the same language but the meanings and acronyms caused issues. These breakdowns in communication are the same issues we face in our everyday life whether it's with a loved one, at work or a civic organization, communication is key.

Without effective communication, ideas cannot be fully understood and problems cannot be solved. The responsibility for clear communication requires participation by both parties.

I would implore you to take this effective communication challenge and become engaged in the future. Not only the future of our local community or county but also our state.

We hear a lot from the politicians in Springfield but have they heard from you? Has the County Board heard from you? Has your city council heard your concerns? How has your communication been?

Stock+Field stores are in the process of building up their inventories after the ownership transition. “You’ll continue to see more and more inventory,” the corporate representative said. “Our various merchandise categories will continue to build. Brands like Carhartt, Stihl, Cub Cadet and Ariat, those brands see us as a brand

new retailer. It takes awhile to get that inventory in. We think we’ve done good work on it so far.”

A sign at the store said new merchandise will be arriving daily and listed brands such as Red Wing Shoes, Under Armour, Columbia, Levi’s, Wrangler, Wolverine, Eddie Bauer and Lee.

Assistant Rochelle Store Manager Brian Richert said the brands the

current ownership offers have been received well by customers in the store.

As part of the landfill agreement, the village will receive approximately 124 acres of land east of the current landfill. 83 acres of that was farmland the village sold to the operator. It will also get money from the landfill operator, Tess said. As part of the agreement, there would not be a new landfill within five miles of the village limits of Creston. If the need to exhume cell one is eliminated, the City of Rochelle will not have to expend \$850,000 for its portion of the exhumation costs. The agreement would also eliminate the city's responsibility to pay \$750,000 towards the Mulford Road improvements. Lastly, the operator will make a payment of \$1.46 million to the city and a donation of \$40,000 to the Rochelle Area Community Foundation.

"This doesn't happen without strong leadership from both communities,"

Tess said. "It's been a 3-4-year-long process. It started with reviewing and obtaining reports on what the right thing is to do. I want to make it clear, to do this and what Rochelle will do, a strong consideration was given to possible environmental impact."

The second agreement Creston approved and Rochelle will vote on Monday involves an intergovernmental agreement between the two municipalities that ensures that both take the necessary steps to bring the landfill deal to fruition.

The third agreement Creston approved involves jurisdictional boundary lines. The village and Rochelle have been working on that type of deal for 20 years, off and on, Tess said. It would allow for both municipalities to know where lines are and smoother development to take place.

Under the agreement yet to be approved by its city council, Rochelle would have the land west of Mul-

ford Road and Creston would have land east of Mulford Road. The section between Interstate 39 and Mulford Road would be a shared revenue district.

For the recently-built Pilot Travel Plaza, Rochelle

will pay Creston \$500,000 after the city has been reimbursed for the amount of its infrastructure costs from all revenue derived from the plaza no later than 5 years after the agreement.

Creston will get 25

percent of the tax revenues going forward in the shared revenue district.

"We think this all really benefits the village," Creston Village President Tom Byro said. "Creston is right there, why can't we get

benefits off that land? We think it's a good one. It's a 20-year agreement. It's a benefit for both entities. More businesses could pop up there. We want Creston to have a say so. It's within a mile and a half of Creston."

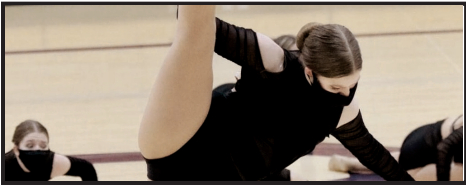

Building for the future

Hubs looking to improve in sprints and relays next season

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle Hub track and field team leaned on its success in the field events this season. Developing more athletes in the sprints and sprint relays will be the key for head coach Dale Bergeson and his staff as the Hubs look to build on their results this year.

Rochelle finished sixth in the Interstate 8 Conference Championship meet and 10th in the IHSA 2A Sectional at Rochelle Township High School this season. The Hubs secured three victories in head-to-head competition including one over Rock Falls on Senior Night and two conference wins against Morris and Plano. The 2020-21 season was Rochelle’s first under Bergeson.

“Based on all of the circumstances and COVID-19, I thought the boys worked really hard,” Bergeson said. “Their times and their distances improved dramatically. We saw a lot of improvements and we received a lot of praise from other coaches for how our kids conducted themselves. We’re definitely looking forward

to seeing how much we improve next year.”

The Hubs will lose two key contributors in the field events including thrower Oscar Aguirre and former IHSA State Championship qualifying triple jumper Trevor Goodwin. Rochelle will return a pair of top-scoring field-event specialists, however, in junior thrower Zach Sanford and junior jumper Ryan Simmons, who each recorded third-place finishes at the sectional meet. Sophomore Hayden Inman could also return to lead the Hubs in the pole vault next season.

“Our goal was to get better in the throwing events this season,” Bergeson said. “Oscar and Zach really stepped up and they scored the majority of our team points in the shot put and discus. We want to get better in our relays, especially the 1600 and 3200-meter relays... I think back to five years ago where we had three of our four relay teams make the state meet. That’s an area we need to improve on for next season and I think we’re capable of doing that.”

Several distance runners will be eligible to return next year includ-

who step up and mentor our freshmen and sophomores next year.”



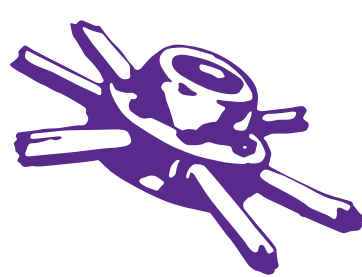

Huskies well represented on Steele's teams

Richie and Rudolph headline Preseason All-MAC Team

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University football team is well represented on Phil Steele's Preseason All-MAC Team as 13 Huskies were named to the squad the magazine announced this week.

The list features five Huskie offensive players, four defenders and four specialists and is headlined by first team selections wide receivers Tyrice Richie and Trayvon Rudolph, who made the team as a kick returner. NIU placed three Huskies on both the second and third teams each and five on the fourth team.

Offensive lineman Marques Cox, cornerback Jordan Gandy and defensive tackle James Ester were named to the second team, while center Brayden Patton, linebacker Devin Lafayette and kicker John Richardson earned third team selections.

Of the 27 fourth teamers on the preseason all-MAC list, five are Huskies. Tailback Harrison Waylee leads the contingent which also includes defensive tackle Devonte O'Malley, punter Matt Ference, long snapper Erik Abrell and Miles Joiner, a tight end who transferred to NIU via Youngstown State.

A 2020 first team All-MAC selection, Richie led the Huskies and ranked

fourth in the league in receiving yards with 597 on 53 receptions, both career bests. Richie, who tallied four 100-yard receiving games last season, was second on the team in scoring with four touchdown receptions.

Rudolph made an immediate impact for in his first season collegiate football, earning Freshman All-America honors by the FWAA and *The Athletic* as a kick returner and was named a second team All-MAC in 2020. Rudolph and Richie ranked first and second, respectively, in all-purpose yards as well.

Patton, who earned second team All-MAC last season has made 18 consecutive starts, nine at center and helped pave the way for a Huskie offense that averaged 367.5 yards. Cox and Patton were integral in helping Waylee top the 100-yard rushing mark in each of his last two games. Waylee led the Huskies in rushing with 456 yards.

NIU's leading tackler from a year ago, Gandy made 41 stops in his first season as a Huskie en route to a spot on the second team of the 2020 All-MAC squad. The DeKalb native added a team-best seven pass break ups and an interception. Safety Devin Lafayette, who earned third-team All-

MAC honors last season, was right behind Gandy with 36 stops, a tackle for loss, a sack and interception.

Defensive tackles Ester and O'Malley proved to be a potent combination for the Huskies last season. Ester had a breakout season last year, leading all NIU interior linemen with 17 tackles, eight solo, including two tackles for loss. O'Malley saw action in all six games and tallied five tackles, including three tackles for loss and two sacks, a team best.

Richardson, who led NIU in scoring last season, was a perfect 14-for-14 on extra point attempts and was 7-of-9 on field goal attempts. He hit a season-long 46-yarder in the season finale at Eastern Michigan. NIU's all-time leading punter, Ference boasts a 41.5-yard per punt career average. He finished second in the MAC with 31 punts and seventh in the league with a 42.2-yard average. The man responsible for getting the ball to Ference and Richardson, Abrell snapped on 31 punts, nine field goals and 14 point after touchdowns.

Joiner, who comes to NIU via Youngstown State as a graduate transfer, tallied 521 yards receiving and seven touchdowns on 33 receptions during his career with the Penguins.

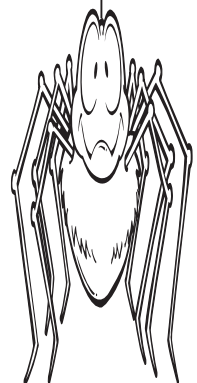

Nine Huskies on PFF 2021 Preseason All-MAC Team

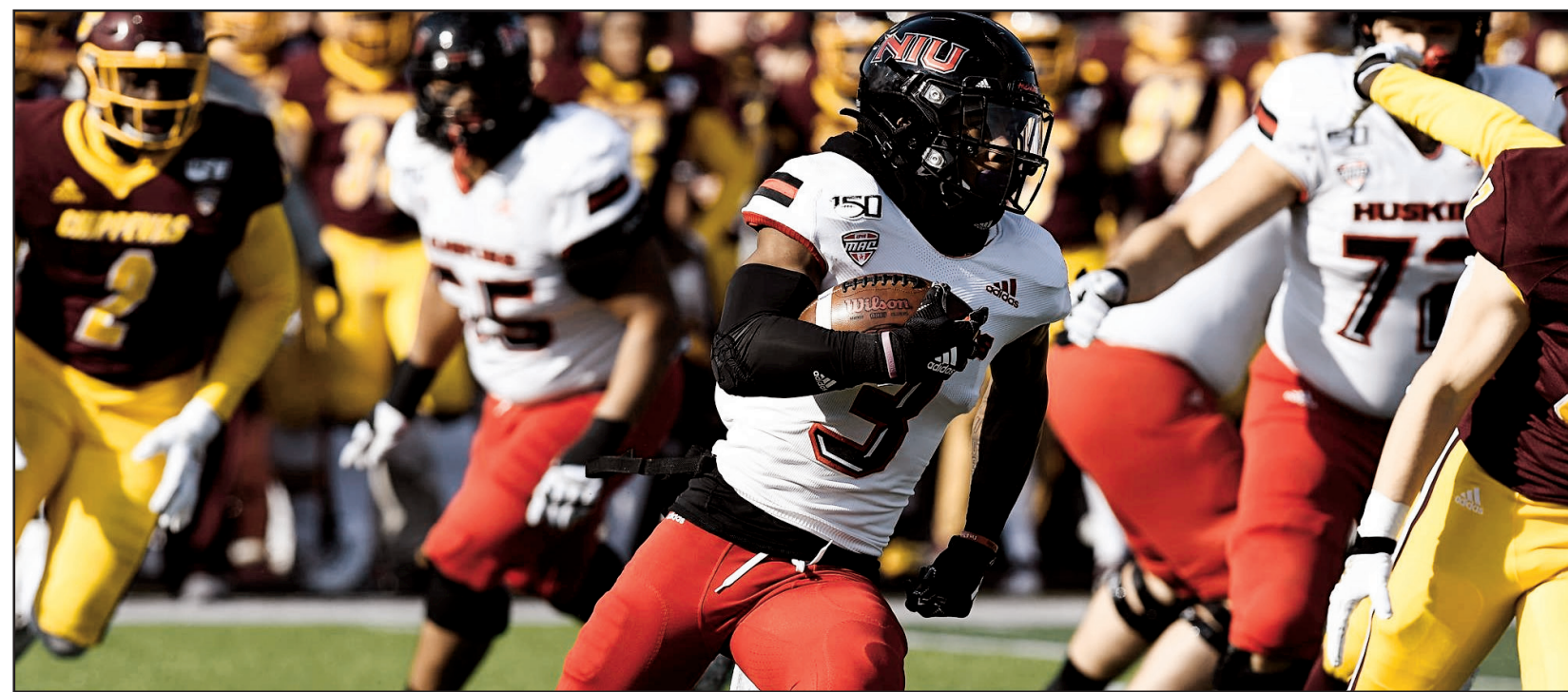
Richie, Patton, Richardson and Rudolph named to First Team

DEKALB — Nine Northern Illinois University Huskies have earned recognition on the PFF 2021 Preseason All-MAC Football Team release today, including first team selections Tyrice Richie (Chicago/Homewood-Flossmoor HS), Brayden Patton (Ellettsville, Indiana/Edgewood HS), John Richardson (Orland Park/Brother Rice HS) and Trayvon Rudolph (Crete/Crete-Monee HS).

In addition to those four, NIU redshirt freshman James Ester (Detroit/Cass Tech) and second year freshman Daveren Rayner (Indianapolis, Indiana/Lawrence Central HS) received spots on the PFF preseason third team along with senior punter Matt Ference (St. Louis, Missouri/Lafayette HS) and senior punt returner Cole Tucker (DeKalb/DeKalb HS). Senior Kyle Pugh (Chicago Heights/Bloom Township HS) was an honorable mention choice at linebacker.

Richie, a 2020 first team All-MAC wide receiver, accounted for 42 percent (53 of 127) of the Huskies' total receptions a year ago and was one of the three highest-graded receivers in the MAC, according to PFF. They give him strong marks for breaking tackles and making contested catches.

Patton, a "super senior" in 2021 who has started 26 games at either guard or center over the last three seasons, was the top-rated center on PFF's preseason

team. He finished 2020 ranked second in PFF's grades of MAC centers and was the fourth-highest player at that position among Group of Five players according to the website.

Richardson enters his third season as NIU's starting kicker in 2021 having made 21-of-27 field goals and all 44 of his PAT tries over the last two seasons. His field goals include a pair of game-winners and a career-long 51-yard three, in 2019.

Named a 2020 Freshman All-American at kick returner by both The Athletic and the Football Writer's Association of America (FWAA), Trayvon Rudolph ranked second in the nation in combined kick returns while averaging 23.9 yards on 30 returns.

Ester has played in 10

games over the last two seasons, including all six games in 2020 when he finished ninth on the team with 19 tackles and had a pair of tackles for loss and a sack. In his first year with the Huskies in 2020, Rayner made 27 tackles and broke up three passes with a pair of tackles for loss and a sack.

Another of NIU's six "super seniors" for 2021, Ference already owns nearly every NIU single season and career punting record, including punting average, which stands at 41.5 yards per punt with 46 punts of 50 yards or more as a Huskie. Tucker's sure hands and consistency as a punt returner – with 33 returns in 32 career games played – helped him secure a spot on PFF's third team.

Pugh has compiled 186 tackles and 12.5 tackles for

loss in a 34-game career that dates back to his arrival on campus in 2015. The NIU super senior had already received a sixth

year of eligibility prior to COVID-19 after seeing several seasons cut short due to injury.

In June, 13 Huskies

were named to Phil Steele's Preseason All-MAC Team with Richie and Rudolph named to the first team by that publication.
