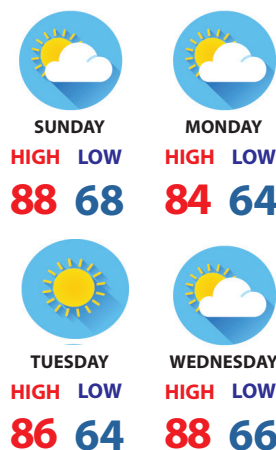

## A family tradition Seebach's Sweet Corn open for season

ROCHELLE — Jeff Seebach's family has been growing and selling sweet corn at its stand for as long as the 47-year-old can remember.

Seebach's Sweet Corn opened for business on Wednesday of this past week. The stand at 11594 E. Kyte Road is open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The family can be reached at 815-213-5229 or 815-562-7561. Squash,

cucumbers and tomatoes are also sold at the stand. Large orders of sweet corn should be called in ahead of time.

"The corn was ready," Jeff said. "I was hoping for last week but it was way too young and we gave it several days and it came on. It's usually around this time every year. With the cooler weather earlier in the year, it slowed it down. Sweet corn loves the heat and humidity. That moves it up fast and cool nights

really slow it down."

Seebach has been fielding questions since June about when he thought the corn would be ready for sale. He usually doesn't know until just days before. He said he doesn't keep track of the hours he puts into sweet corn, but said it's "quite a few."

He works from home and takes vacation for the first week of sweet corn when it's at its busiest.

## Rainwater Farms begins sweet corn sales

ROCHELLE — Rainwater Farms' sweet corn began as Jeff Rainwater's Future Farmers of America project in 1989.

Rainwater wanted to see if he could grow a sweet corn that people would buy. Back then, sweet corn and vegetable stands in town weren't common.

"It was one of those things, can you take a prod-

uct and grow it on your farm and make money?" Rainwater said. "The answer was yes. And that's how it started."

Now, Rainwater Farms has about 50 acres of sweet corn. Along with its stands, the farm deals to grocers like Woodman's and Schnucks and restaurants.

Sunday will be Rainwater Farms' first day of sweet corn sales of the season.

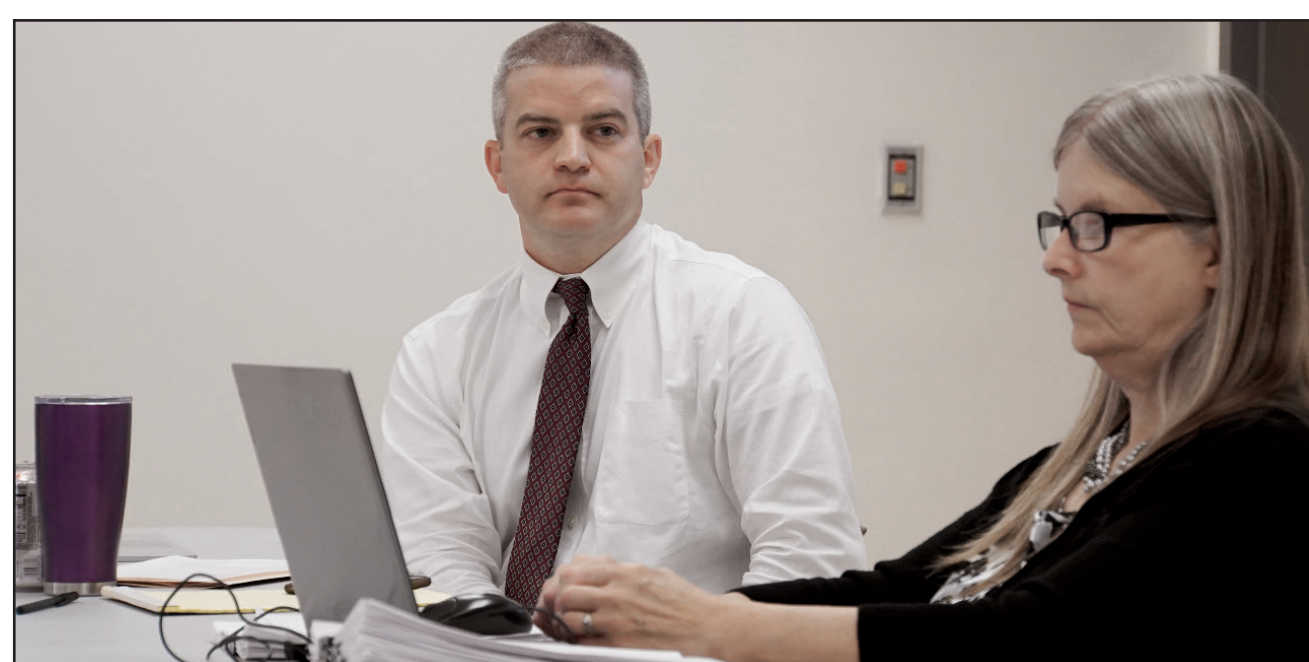
## Harper: COVID-19 guidance still needed 'Guidance really needed to be out weeks ago'

ROCHELLE — After hearing feedback from parents at board meetings in recent weeks, Jason Harper, the superintendent of Rochelle's elementary and high school districts, said guidance is still needed before return-to-school COVID-19 policies can be implemented.

Parents and community members filled rooms at both recent school district board meetings and spoke out against mandatory masks and in favor of an optional style.

"We appreciate parents and community members sharing their opinions and insights on returning to full-time, in-person learning for next year," Harper said. "We have had feedback on various facets of schooling during the pandemic dating back to March 2020. As the state of the pandemic changes, people's views evolve in all sorts of ways. We continue to listen to our public, consider current guidance and local transmission

data, then work to implement plans that allow for safe, consistent in-person learning while trying to avoid being too restrictive."

Harper said detailed guidance is still needed on many issues that will have a "considerable" impact on the district's day-to-day operations and the daily lives of families.

Two major issues left unresolved are quarantine

protocol and remote learning expectations.

"This guidance really needed to be out weeks ago which has led to avoidable frustrations," Harper said.

The Illinois Department of Public Health recently adopted guidance from the CDC that states masks should be worn by all individuals ages 2 and older who are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

The CDC also recommends maintaining at least 3 feet of physical distance between students in classrooms.

Harper told the board in his monthly report Monday that he'd hoped to have more information and guidance to share by the meeting. He said guidance hasn't been updated since July 9.

Harper said he'd con-

tinue to update the board on changes and associate with the RTHS teacher's association, the school's nurse, the Ogle County Health Department, the Illinois State Board of Education, IDPH, legal counsel and the legal counsel that represents the school via insurance in regards to liability.

## City co-hosting hiring event Sept. 16 at RTHS

Bearrows: Largest regional in-person hiring event

ROCHELLE — Rochelle John Bearrows announced on Facebook Thursday the details of the city’s plans for a hiring event on Sept. 16 at Rochelle Township High School.

Bearrows said the event will be the region’s largest in-person hiring event and will be hosted by the city, his office, Kishwaukee College, RTHS and Hormel’s Rochelle Foods.

So far, the details of the event include setup, lunch, business-to-business networking and a message from Bearrows from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. along with Hubs for Hire from 1:30-2:30 p.m. and the event will be open to the public from 2:30-5:30 p.m.

The event is open to Rochelle employers only and there is no cost to attend. An email will be received

early in August that will explain the registration process through College Central.

Booth space is limited in the gymnasium and will be assigned as businesses register. Once all spaces are gone, a waiting list will be created. There will be separate spaces to conduct on-the-spot interviews.

Extensive marketing in the Greater Rochelle Region will be done to attract the maximum number of job seekers, Bearrows said. If you would like to help sponsor in any way, he asked that you let the city know as marketing materials and radio/television ads are being prepared as well as incentives for workers to attend. The event will be open to approximately 250 high school students, hence the Hubs for Hire portion.

That hour will provide employers the opportunity to share information, openings for job shadowing, mentoring or internships and discuss what might be required academically to fill future positions in companies.

RTHS is committed to working with employers to provide a qualified young workforce, Bearrows said, and Kishwaukee College is as committed to providing “special training and certifications.” “To give me a rough idea of who will participate, and reach out to me if you plan to participate when registration opens,” Bearrows said. “It would be a great problem to have to need a larger space. We appreciate the hospitality of RTHS and look forward to a successful hiring event for you. Save the date.”

## Workforce shortage plaguing businesses

ROCHELLE — Rochelle Area Chamber of Commerce Director Tricia Herrera said this week that workforce shortage issues have been seen “across the board” in local business sectors.

The workforce shortage is nationwide and Rochelle Mayor John Bearrows recently told the News-Leader that there are currently 300 open jobs in town. Herrera said businesses big and small have seen the impacts, namely the industrial, food service and retail sectors.

“Our industrial businesses are offering large bonuses and still can’t staff,” Herrera said. “It is concerning. We want places to stay in business and be productive and profit. What will happen if they can’t staff? Will some have to consolidate? Will some have to close their doors?”

Herrera said the issues have been ongoing for all of 2021 and possibly in the later months of 2020. The food service industry has been dealing with it “for a while.”

As far as the cause of

the shortage, Herrera thinks part of it is due to additional benefits of unemployment programs that may outweigh working along with some being uncertain about being out in public and working around others during the pandemic.

Herrera said the chamber is putting a job reforce board on its site to advertise openings and get the word out on who is hiring. The City of Rochelle recently announced a job fair that will take place Sept. 16 at Rochelle Township High School.

“A job fair will help,” Herrera said. “A possible solution hasn’t been made clear yet. All industries have tried different things. Reaching out in different ways, offering things like bonuses. Nobody has figured out a solution yet.”

His employer works with him so he can pick when he needs to. Jeff's mother, Christy, usually handles selling at the stand. "I just come out and do what needs to be done," Jeff said. "It's constantly going. By the time you're done picking, planting and working the ground to prepare it. We spray it and put up an electric fence all the way around it. I would say you can put in as much time as you want on it. I could put in 100 hours and someone could work 50 and still have almost the same result."

Seebach said the sweet corn stand means "quite a bit" to him and his family. His father, Jerry, started the business that also includes pumpkins in the fall. Jerry also grew strawberries but set that aside due to its labor-intense nature.

Jerry passed away in 2019 and his sons have carried on the work.

"It's kind of a family tradition," Christy said. "It's a fun thing to do. It's a lot of work for Jeff and a lot of hours. Jerry started it years ago and I think he did it to help supplement his income and pay the taxes on it. He passed away and Jeff is carrying on the sweet corn and Scott is doing the pumpkins. They help each other."

Jerry Seebach enjoyed selling sweet corn and pumpkins most of all because of the interactions with customers. Jeff recalled the pride he took in selling to people all the way from Chicago and one customer that took 15-20 dozen ears back with him to Washington D.C.

"He probably wouldn't have sold sweet corn if he couldn't talk to people when they stop," Jeff said. "People enjoyed it. As long as people are enjoying it and keep coming out, we're going to keep doing it. He set it up and I watched him

and learned from him."

Christy said there are people who have been coming to the stand to buy sweet corn for 20-30 years. A lot are neighbors. She's seen kids grow up and now come back to buy corn as adults.

Jeff sees people around town that he recognizes, but doesn't know personally. People that are customers every year.

When Jeff was a kid, picking and selling sweet corn was his summer job. They used to sell it right out of their garage. The first time he remembers selling, a dozen ears cost 50 cents. There used to be only two varieties sold. Now it's five.

The sweet corn season lasts about 4-6 weeks. It's done in separate plantings so corn keeps coming in over that time.

"My dad used to do just do one planting," Jeff said. "We used to have one acre and now we do three. It's right around here and we keep an eye on it. It's easy to bring it right up here and sell it."

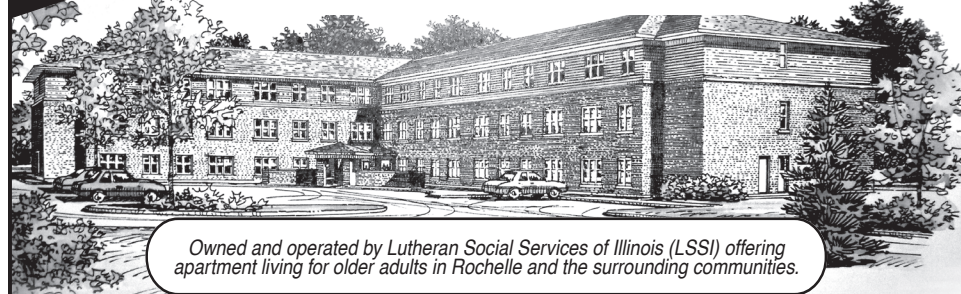

#### NOT ALWAYS BURIAL

In many parts of the world, burial is the most common form of final disposition - but it is not the only form. Many bodies are entombed, or placed in above-ground mausoleums. The procedures are similar to an earth burial, since the body is placed in a casket and is usually driven from the funeral ceremony in a procession. Entombment is the traditional form of final disposition in some areas. In New Orleans, for example, high water tables make ground burial impossible. Cremation is another form of final disposition that is gaining increasing acceptance in North America. However, this option is still not as popular here as in other parts of the world. The cremation



rate is roughly 15 percent in the U.S. and about 25 percent in Canada. By contrast, in European countries more than half of those who die are cremated. In some cultures, such as Japan, cremation is the most common form of final disposition.

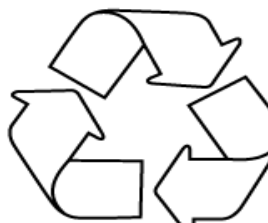

## Serenity Hospice hosting day camp Aug. 2

‘Being with others like them makes them feel less alone’

**ROCHELLE** – Serenity Hospice will be hosting a day camp at The REC in Rochelle on Aug. 2 for bereaved kids ages 6-15.

The camp will allow kids to meet peers who have experienced the same type of loss while enjoying games, crafts, swimming and other traditional summer camp activities. They will also learn coping strategies to help with their grief.

“We have had a lot of young families with significant losses with

young kids,” Serenity Bereavement Coordinator Cathy Warren said. “We knew there was a need. I trained with a doctor in Colorado on helping children and have met with other hospice workers that had done weekend camps and wanted to offer it here.”

The camp will run from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and any child is welcome whether or not they were a hospice family. The camp is free to participants and is being funded by a grant from the Rochelle Area Community Foundation.

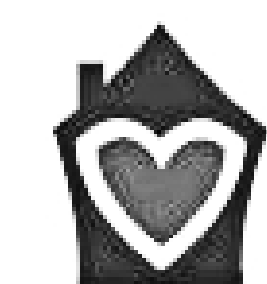
The camp will be the

first of its type that Serenity has done in Rochelle. It has done camps in the past in Oregon and COVID-19 put them on hold.

“We just got started with these grief programs for the youth and we’re excited to do more,” Warren said. “We got a grant from RACF. It’s perfect to have another place to do it. It was nice of them to offer, because we do these free of charge.”

Warren said there aren’t many programs like this for youth in the area, which she believes creates a “huge” need.

“I think especially in

small communities with kids in elementary or middle school, very few of their friends have lost someone and they may feel alone,” Warren said. “Some of their friends have maybe never even been to a funeral before.

Being with others like them makes them feel less alone. Others with experiences in common understand.”

Serenity offers numerous grief support programs and groups. Their programs are available

to everyone in the community, not just families who have had loved ones at the facility.

## Q&A: Simpson prepares for first Ogle County Fair as president

**Q:** How do you go about filling the pretty big shoes – or boots – left by former Fair Board President Harlan Holm?

**A:** “The passing of Harlan has been felt by

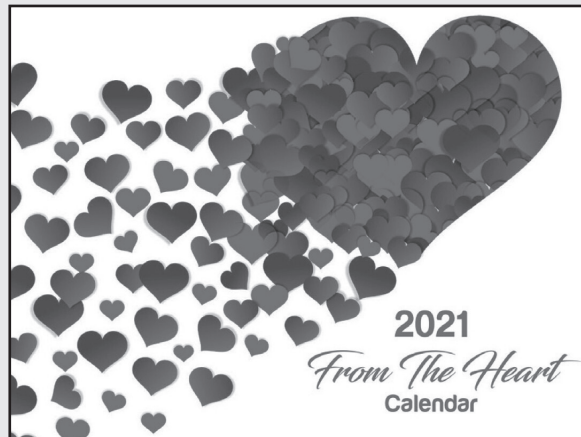
everyone but we have got great volunteers that have always been with us. We are able to continue to move forward.”

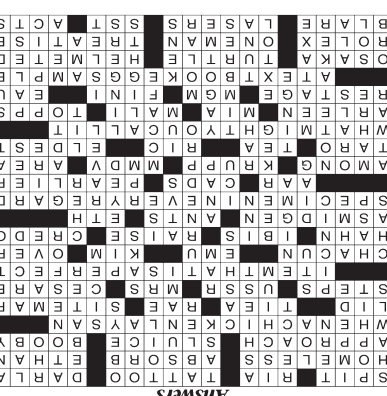

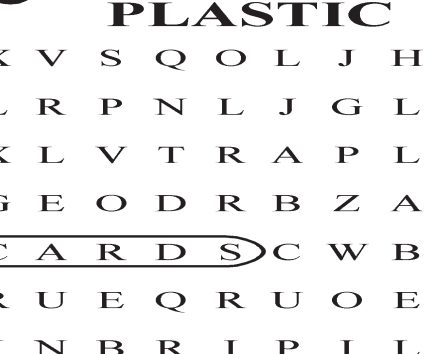

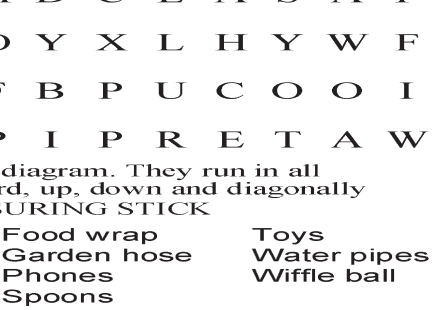

## OCHD will release its own guidance for schools

'This upcoming school year is going to be a little bit more contentious'

**OREGON** — With no guidance from the state, Ogle County's public health administrator told the County Board that his office will be releasing its own COVID-19 guidelines for schools "very shortly."

At the board's July 20 meeting, Kyle Auman said that the state has not released anything yet on what schools should do when they open, including whether or not students should wear masks. He said his office is trying to work with school districts in the county.

"But this upcoming school year is going to be a little bit more contentious than previous," Auman said, adding they are "... trying to make the best decisions for the students, the people of Ogle County and people in our region."

In Ogle County, the COVID-19 positivity rate was 2.9 percent, Auman said. That is up from last month when it was 1.8 percent. The regional positivity rate is 2.4 percent.

He said the reason for the increase has been several summer camps that have led to positive cases of COVID.

In Ogle County, 42.78 percent of the population is fully vaccinated, which is 21,785 people. Auman said that 32.2 percent of the school age population has been vaccinated. He said now that kids ages 12 and up can get the vaccine, his office has been focusing on them. By

winter, a vaccine should be available for kids ages 6 and up, he said.

The county is no longer doing mass vaccination events but does offer the vaccine in its Rochelle and Oregon offices by appointment on Tuesday,

Wednesday and Thursday.

Auman told the board that 14 counties in Illinois have been placed back into a warning status. He said most of the counties are in the southern part of the state or bordering Missouri.

"Several of those counties have significant issues with the Delta variant," Auman said. "If folks are vaccinated, they still seem to have good protection against the Delta variant."

### Typer honored

In other action, the board honored Marty Typer, who represented District 5 on the County Board until May, when he resigned to take a new role as Village President in Stillman Valley.

Typer worked for Ogle

County for nearly 30 years.

"The people of Ogle County have always been very, very good to me," Typer said after being presented with a plaque by Board Chairman John Finrock.

The farm's home stand can be found at 17557 E. Twombly Road seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. The stand in Kings will also be open Thursday through Sunday. MightyVine tomatoes, grown in Rochelle, will also be available with the sweet corn.

Rainwater said over the past couple weeks, he's been asked everywhere he's gone in town when sweet corn is going to start. "I share in that excitement," Rainwater said. "I want to eat it too. I love it. I love being a part of that. There's a lot of pride that goes into a product that your public eats and loves. There's a lot of excitement."

The demand for sweet corn is at its highest in the first 10-14 days of sales. More corn will be sold during that time than the last 3-4 weeks of the season, Rainwater said.

The sweet corn production process is as follows: the ground is prepared, nitrogen is put down,

planting is done every 3-5 days depending on weather and spraying is done for weeds and bugs until a week before picking. It's harvested and comes in on wagons for sorting. Only the best ears make it.

Rainwater called this year "pretty good" for weather and optimal growth. It got warm and stayed warm and dry. Then came good moisture and more heat, but not too much of each.

"So far it's been great," Rainwater said. "The only thing that hurts us is the

current heat that shortens when we have to pick. But that's mother nature. We'd rather have heat than no heat."

Sweet corn is the most labor-intensive thing Rainwater Farms does. There's a lot of hands-on work that doesn't come into play when the operation does its normal corn and soybeans. That hands-on work will be done every day for the next 5-6 weeks until the season ends.

Rainwater estimates sweet corn is about 15-20 percent of Rainwater

Farms' operation. That changes from year to year. Each year he takes on more acreage and responsibility. He called the sweet corn operation "fairly extensive."

Some customers don't know that Rainwater Farms does anything outside of sweet corn.

"I would say this is what we're known for," Rainwater said. "Unless people know the family, they don't know we do other kinds of farming. If you drive in here, you get an idea it's not all for

sweet corn. This is what we advertise. I don't advertise that I'm a corn and soybean farmer like I do for sweet corn."

Rainwater doesn't mind the hands-on work that comes with sweet corn production.

"It's a big part of our livelihood," Rainwater said. "I get up every day and have a set amount of things to do to continue this livelihood. It doesn't matter if it's day one or day 365. Every day I'm getting up to do something to continue my livelihood."

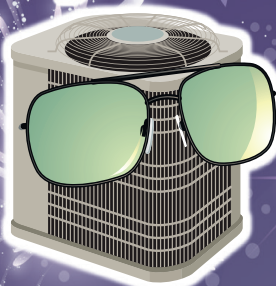

# Rochelle Junior Tackle football camp returns

## RTHS Football Lift-A-Thon scheduled for Tuesday, July 27 at 6 p.m.

**ROCHELLE** — In another indication that athletics are returning to normal in the Hub City, head coach Kyle Kissack and members of the Rochelle Township High School football program teamed up to hold their annual youth skills camp for third through eighth-grade players.

With the Rochelle Junior Tackle season only weeks away, dozens of local players gathered at the RTHS practice fields, working with RTHS coaches and athletes through several drills including throwing, running, passing, receiving and blocking. After both the 2020 camp and the 2020 Rochelle Junior Tackle season were canceled due to COVID-19, Kissack said he and his athletes were excited for the opportunity to host the next generation of RTHS football players.

"It makes your heart happy," Kissack said. "Our kids have missed the opportunity to serve the community and be with the younger kids. It makes our hearts happy, not only as a staff but as a program. The Junior Tackle program has

given so much to the kids and we've had a really fun week... These kids haven't played organized football in two years, so we've spent a lot of time working on the fundamentals and developing the chemistry needed to play RTHS football."

Camp kicked off on Monday, July 19 and ran through Thursday, July 22. The one-week camp leads directly into the start of the Rochelle Junior Tackle season, which begins with practices on Monday, July 26. For Kissack and the Hubs, hosting the annual youth camp once again provides Rochelle's grade-school and middle-school athletes with an early start before high school.

"We talk a lot about alignment and technique," Kissack said. "There's consistency within the Junior Tackle program and the concepts taught in the Junior Tackle program are the exact same concepts we're teaching at the high school level. When the kids come in as fifth-grade athletes playing tackle football, they're building a foundation to last through

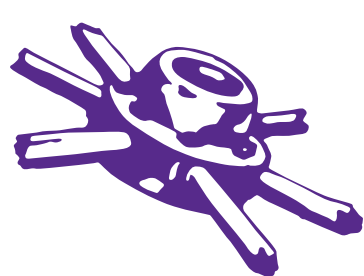

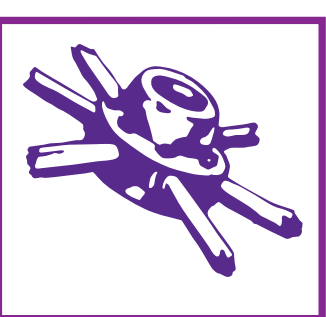

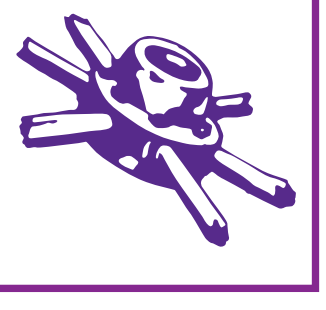

## Lundquist adjusts to new role at St. Ambrose

ABBY Lundquist made her mark on the Rochelle Lady Hub basketball program with her scoring and shooting, setting several records including the all-time career scoring record. But it was Lundquist's defense and facilitating that allowed her to stand out during her second season of collegiate basketball and her first with the St. Ambrose University Fighting Bees.

After transferring from Division II Daemen College, Lundquist found an immediate role with the NAIA St. Ambrose women's basketball program, appearing in 18 games and averaging over 15 minutes per game. In the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, Lundquist and her teammates saw constant schedule cancellations and adjustments, but persevered to finish with a 12-8 record.

"It was a challenging year," Lundquist said. "It was difficult because we weren't allowed to see other people outside of our team, but that made us rely on each other and we grew as a team. I was a defender this year and I really prided myself on my defense. I was always a scorer throughout my high school career, but since we have strong post players, I'm not needed to score as much. My coach put me on some of the

best scorers in our conference and I thought I contained them well. I drew several charges and I worked a lot on defensive techniques."

Lundquist shot 39.1 percent from 3-point range this past season and started six games for the Fighting Bees, who went 6-5 in the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference. Lundquist's notable performances include a nine-point effort in St. Ambrose's 52-48 win over Indiana University Northwest and a 13-point spurt in a 77-59 victory against Trinity International. Now with more focus on defense and passing the ball, Lundquist said she plans to move from shooting guard to point guard, where she played in high school, for the upcoming season.

"My goal for next season is to just enjoy basketball," Lundquist said. "I have two years left and I want to cherish the time I have playing the game. We want to win the conference as a team and I think we have the tools we need. I have loved my time playing collegiate basketball and the most important thing that has come out of my experience is the relationships I've built. I've built great relationships with my teammates and coaches at both Daemen College and St. Ambrose and it's such a blessing to be around people who have turned into another family for me."

## Healthy Hand Hygiene Habits



Protect yourself against COVID-19 and other diarrheal and respiratory illnesses, and help prevent the spread of germs to others, by following these simple hand hygiene guidelines:

1. Wash your hands with soap and warm water, lathering for at least 20 seconds.
2. If soap is unavailable, use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60 percent alcohol to clean your hands.

Wash your hands throughout the day, and particularly under these circumstances:

- Before preparing food
- Before eating
- After using the toilet
- After changing a diaper or helping a child use the toilet
- Before and after exposure to someone who is sick
- After coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose
- After touching an animal or picking up animal waste
- After handling pet food or treats
- After handling garbage or garbage cans
- Before and after attending to a cut or wound
