## Anaya named RACF director

### 'I knew I wanted to give back to the community'

ROCHELLE — When raising money with other Rochelle Township High School cheerleaders to be in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade years ago, Emily Anaya realized she had a skill — and a passion — for fundraising.

"That was the first time I realized, 'This is what I'm going to do,'" Anaya said. "It had an impact on me."

Anaya was named the new executive director of the Rochelle Area Community Foundation in recent weeks and started her position June 1. After growing up in Rochelle, Anaya worked for Rochelle Community Hospital for nine years as foundation and community events coordinator before becoming supervisor of philanthropy and major gifts at SwedishAmerican Foundation in Rockford.

Anaya has also served on the allocation committee of the Rock Valley United Way.

"You see that impact," Anaya said. "It's about the legacy that the donor is leaving behind. You forever have a hand in helping somebody or a family

or community. I think that for me is what makes me feel good and I know it's rewarding."

After being in health-care for 16 years, Anaya was ready for something different. She has an appreciation for the impact that RACF has had on the local community. She'll replace Kim Montgomery, who was executive director for 12 years.

Upon her exit, Montgomery recommended to the board that the executive director position be changed to full-time. That's what Anaya will be.

"It was good timing," Anaya said. "I think the RACF is looking to grow and the education and experience I received up in Rockford kind of made this a good fit. I just kind of came in here and interviewed with no expectation. I was really excited and wanted to hear more about them and what their goals were. Everything just really kind of aligned."

Anaya plans to be in the RACF office during business hours each day and by appointment to meet with donors and the community to grow the foundation. When it comes to running a foundation and working with donors, you can't put

a time limit on the work, Anaya said. Donors want to meet at all times of the day and being accessible to the community is important.

Anaya said the RACF board is extremely passionate about growing the foundation and it knew expanding the role would meet those goals.

"Hopefully we can exceed those expectations they have," Anaya said. "I know I have my work cut out for me and I'm excited to do that. I'm very eager and motivated."

Anaya remembers from her time at RCH when the community foundation was started by its founder, Leonard Carmichael. The biggest draw of the position for her was the community foundation board.

"They're all ages and from all walks of life," Anaya said. "You don't really see that, how active they are. They have a passion for what they're doing and it's great to see Leonard's legacy really go forward."

## Police reform changes

ROCHELLE — State lawmakers passed a follow-up criminal justice bill last week that remedied some police concerns following House Bill 3653, which was signed into law on Feb. 22.

House Bill 3653 included eliminating cash bail within two years, allowing the use of deadly force only when an officer acts in self defense or defending others from bodily harm, making it easier to decertify officers by eliminating signed affidavits of complaint and mandating the use of police body cameras for all officers by 2025.

## New library project put on hold

### Decision made due to current costs of labor, materials

CRESTON — The new Creston-Dement Library construction project is on hold for now, Creston Village Board President Tom Byro said.

The library gave the board the news at its Tuesday meeting. The decision is due to current high costs of labor and materials.

"Because of costs, the library has decided to wait a year," Byro said. "Most of their money is from grants. They're going to hold off to see what happens with the economy."

Byro said the new library project has been in motion for "a couple of years." Earlier this year, the land planned for the new library at the intersection of Main Street and Cedarholm Street was brought into the village.

**ROCHELLE** — Stock+Field is changing its name and needs your help. The new ownership group — the R.P. Acquisition Corporation — is planning for the future of the brand and wants to hear from each community they will serve.

## POLICE: Local law enforcement officers react to new state legislation

Both Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby and Ogle County Sheriff Brian VanVickle were against HB3653. The recent trailer bill (HB 3443) relaxed rules around body cameras, removed some use-of-force restriction language and extended deadlines for new training standards. HB 3443 was the first trailer bill following HB 3653. VanVickle believes it won't be the last. The sheriff has testified in front of lawmakers about various changes and said he spent all of Memorial Day weekend on conference calls concerning them.

"It was a good discussion," VanVickle said. "A myriad of topics have yet to be addressed. We focused on being able to review our own body camera footage. That was contentious. And some of the decertification issues associated with inaccurate police reports due to not being able to review body camera footage."

The charges of obstructing and resisting arrest were separated in the trailer bill. Previously, an underlying offense was required to arrest someone for obstruction, Higby said.

"That's been rectified and that's good," Higby said. "If we had a crime scene roped off and someone came in and messed with it, we wouldn't have been able to stop them or charge them."

Additional training and preparation for new practices was pushed back to Jan. 1 rather than July 1. VanVickle and Higby said changes so far in their stations have been non-existent due to knowing a trailer bill was coming.

Higby said his department hasn't received any syllabi or notice of classes for training, which need to

be approved by a board. Both RPD and the Sheriff's office are in the later years of the body camera requirement. The requirement to have all officers wear body cameras is based on population. Rochelle would start in 2025 and the county would in 2024.

"We're trying to figure out how to financially do these things," VanVickle said. "Rockford just spent hundreds of thousands of dollars on body cameras."

Higby said the cameras will be a "major" expense and he wants that addressed. There is a \$1 million grant out there for body cameras right now, but he said that money would likely not support the whole state. There's a lot of additional costs associated with the cameras such as editing footage to blur out faces of those not involved in the police event, Higby said. He called the issue of body cameras "cumbersome."

Higby expects more changes to happen this fall. The biggest issue in his mind is qualified immunity for officers going away, which was part of HB 3653.

"Essentially, qualified immunity protects us," Higby said. "If we're doing the right things, we're protected civilly and personally. If you're doing something wrong, it's not absolute immunity. I don't see a reason for it to go away. It would be frivolous lawsuits. I don't know who would do this job if that happened."

Both Higby and VanVickle have concerns about their officers' desire to do the job after the planned changes take effect. They've spent time communicating with them about the changes and have kept them informed.

Higby believes those officers eligible for retirement would do so without qualified immunity and if they were open to "frivolous lawsuits." VanVickle has tried to reassure his deputies.

"I told them after this came out not to worry about retiring or leaving," VanVickle said. "We're still going to be able to do our jobs. We always have supported our deputies. We get them the best training and equipment possible. My priority is the people of this county first and then our deputies. We will continue that support."

Higby doesn't believe a "one-size-fits-all" bill will work for Illinois. He said policing in Chicago is far too different than it is in Rochelle. But he's happy to see progress with the trailer bill.

"There is an open dialogue now and good communication," Higby said. "It's unfortunate that it didn't happen sooner and we're correcting things that have already been done. But I'm glad things are this way now."

VanVickle testified in January that he isn't opposed to modernization of policing.

"But a wholesale change of what we do is a concern," VanVickle said. "Throwing everything out is inappropriate."

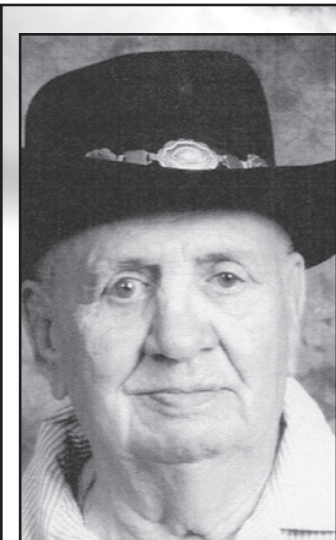

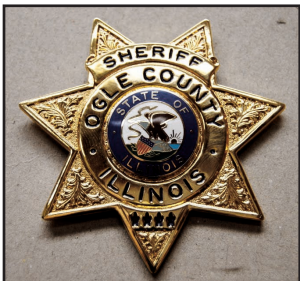

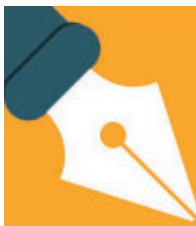
To my dismay, I found out that the Greenacre Dry

### The home builder and his huge impact

I enjoy when people comment on a column. One person said I made a major omission when talking about homes in Rochelle.

Tilton Industries, started in 1937 by John W. Tilton, built over 500 homes in Rochelle. He also had subdivisions in Rockford, DeKalb, Belvidere, Mendota and Rock Falls. Product for the house was shipped out on trucks from the Rochelle facility, which in the 1950s was contributing about \$1 million to the local economy.

His homes were even recognized by American Home Magazine in 1958 for the Best Home for the Money award.

I spent a few hours at the Flag Township Museum trying to find more information, but there was not a lot about Tilton Industries that I could find. He owned one paper in town, then added the Rochelle News and later the Rochelle Leader, which

created the Rochelle News-Leader you are enjoying today.

He also had companies to install plumbing, electricity and mill work, all the jobs needed to build a home.

Our first house in Rochelle was a Tilton Industries home that we moved into in 1971. Thanks Richard H. for the reminder about this home builder and his huge impact.

#### Westwood Subdivision

Speaking of housing, Westwood Subdivision is located west of Rochelle. For years it was pretty quiet on the building side. But in the past three years construction has boomed.

# Soaring into state

## Meyers qualifies for IHSA 2A State Championship in high jump

**PLANO** — With her family cheering from the distance and her coaches lending their support, Teagan Meyers approached her starting position at the high jump area looking to clinch her spot in the IHSA 2A State Championship meet at Eastern Illinois University next weekend.

The Rochelle Lady Hub track and field standout was one of four athletes remaining near the end of the IHSA 2A Plano Sectional high jump competition. With the bar set at 1.54 meters, Meyers confidently sprinted up to the bar, soaring over without any trouble as her coaches and family members exploded with applause. The clearance sealed a second-place finish in the high jump competition and a spot in the IHSA 2A State Championship meet next weekend.

“My main focus was not to mess up, but when I cleared the bar, I felt a weight lift off my shoulders,” Meyers said. “I’m really excited to qualify for state and I’m looking forward to going down

next week. It means a lot to me because it’s been on my mind since my freshman year, especially since I lost my sophomore year because of the pandemic. The applause from my family really meant a lot to me and their support helped me get over that bar.”

Meyers will represent Rochelle in the IHSA 2A State Championship meet, which will begin on Friday, June 11 in Carbondale. Meyers will be Rochelle’s first high jumper at the state meet since Katie Schwartz advanced in 2009.

The Lady Hubs finished seventh with 25 points in the IHSA 2A Plano Sectional on Thursday. Senior Afi Gati took third in the shot put (10.37 meters), while freshman Alivia Henkel placed fourth in the 400-meter dash (1:02). The 1600-meter relay team (Henkel, Meyers, Liberty Hayes and Kylie Smith) finished third with a time of 4:22.34.

“I’m trying to take everything one day at a time,” Meyers said. “My coaches have always been there for me and my friends have supported me. The support has been really important to me.”

# Hubs drop extra-inning regional heartbreaker

## No. 2 seed Dixon outlasts Rochelle 14-13 in IHSA 3A Semifinals

**DIXON** — Borden Field saw nearly 30 runs scored, several clutch base hits, multiple lead changes and extra innings Friday evening, when the seventh-seeded Rochelle Hub varsity baseball team battled the second-seeded Dixon Dukes in the IHSA 3A Regional Semifinals.

Rochelle broke the game open early, scoring six runs in the second inning to take a 7-1 lead over the higher-seeded Dukes. Dixon rallied to tie the game four different times, however, walking off with an RBI single in the bottom of the ninth inning to win 14-13 over Rochelle. The Hubs (7-12) scored six runs over the final three innings including four in the top of the ninth.

Rochelle struck first in the regional semifinal matchup, with junior Andy Buskohl sending an RBI single over the shortstop’s head to give the Hubs a 1-0 lead. After Dixon evened the game 1-1 with an RBI ground-

out in the bottom half, Rochelle opened its six-run second inning with an RBI single to center by junior Eric Briseno and a sacrifice fly by Buskohl. Senior Kyler Lara then belted a three-run triple to left field before scoring on a passed ball in the next at-bat.

Trailing 7-1, Dixon scratched runs in both the second and fourth innings to cut the Rochelle lead to four runs. The Dukes continued their surge across the fifth and sixth innings, scoring on a sacrifice fly to right field in the fifth before rallying for three runs in the bottom of the sixth on an RBI single up the middle and a two-run single to right field. Rochelle erased the 7-7 tie in the top of the seventh inning, when junior Nate Burdin singled before scoring on a passed ball.

Down 8-7 and needing one run to force extra innings, Dixon tied the game once again, sending an RBI single through the left side of the infield.

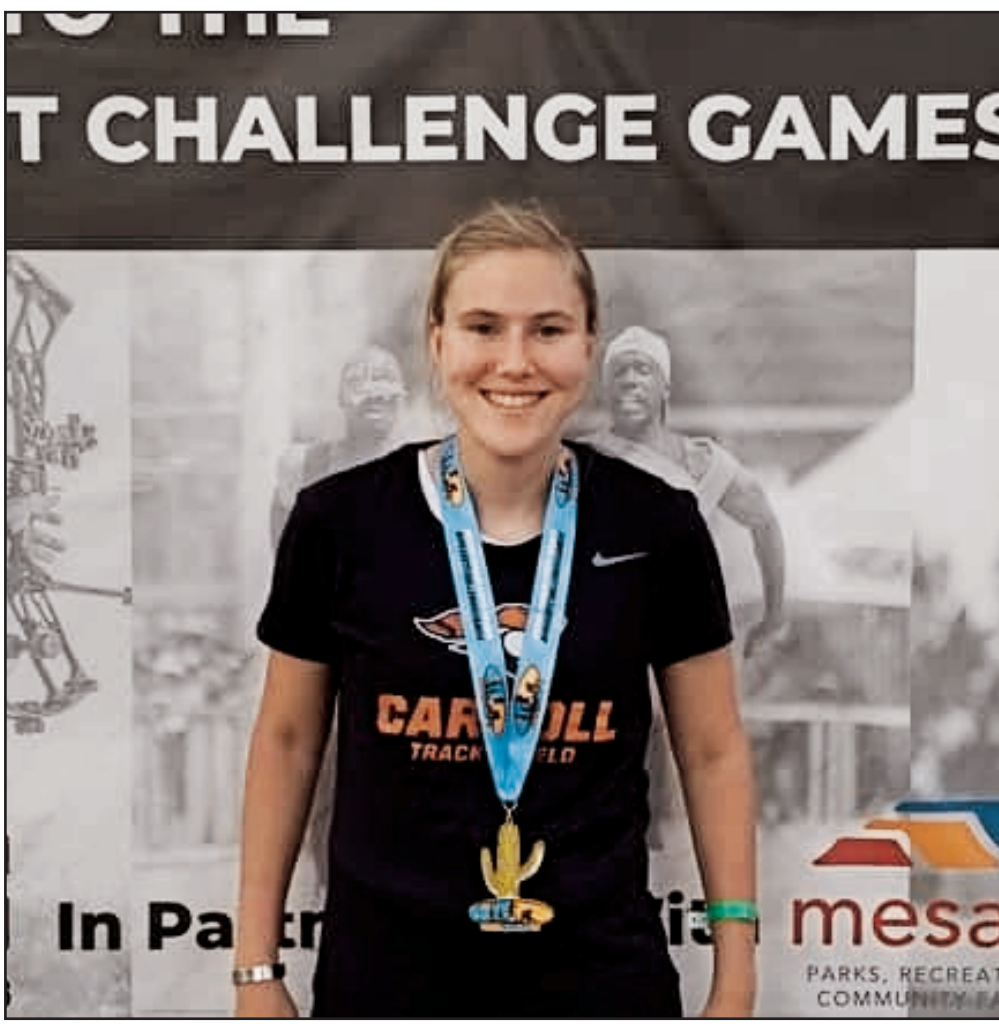

## Headon qualifies for U.S. Paralympic Team Trials

REPRESENTING the United States in the 2020 Tokyo Summer Paralympics would not only be a once-in-a-lifetime experience, but a dream come true for Rochelle Township High School graduate and U.S. Paralympic athlete Aubrey Headon. The former Lady Hub track and field standout will have an opportunity to achieve that dream later this month, when she travels to Minneapolis, Minnesota to compete in the U.S. Paralympic Team Trials from June 17-20.

A T35 and F35 classified athlete with cerebral palsy, Headon recently certified her classification during the 2021 Desert Challenge Games in Mesa, Arizona, where she competed in the 100-meter dash, the 200-meter dash and the shot put. Headon currently holds qualifying times of 17.99 seconds in the 100, 39.78 seconds in the 200 and a mark of 5.68 meters in the shot put.

"I had mixed feelings when I found out I made the trials," Headon said. "I was excited that I qualified but I was bummed that no spectators will be allowed. I didn't feel I performed my best due to my lapse

in training and the heat, but I was able to repeat my qualifying times."

With less than three weeks to prepare for the U.S. Paralympic Team Trials, Headon has resumed training with RTHS assistant track and field coach Vic Worthington. For Headon to earn her spot on the U.S. team, she must meet about 90 percent of a standard established by U.S. Paralympics. Headon will attempt to qualify for the U.S. team in all three events.

Headon recently completed her second year with the Carroll University women's track and field program. While she lost most of her freshman season due to COVID-19 cancellations, she competed in three outdoor meets this year, finishing with season-best times of 18.72 in the 100-meter dash and 41.03 in the 200-meter dash. As Headon prepares for the U.S. Paralympic Team Trials in Minneapolis, she said she will train with Worthington every day to be ready.

"My college experience has been interesting," Headon said. "I started doing indoor track and field during my freshman year, but then COVID-19 happened and my season was canceled. I had three outdoor meets this year, but my main focus was on the 100."

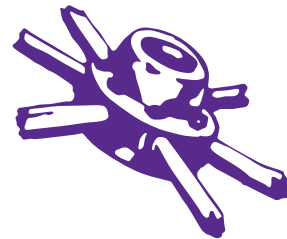

**GENESEO** — Two senior left-handers went pitch-for-pitch during the IHSA 3A Regional Semifinals on Wednesday, when Rochelle’s Bella Lodico and Geneseo’s Anna Narup combined to hold each of their respective opponents scoreless through the first three innings of play.

She finished her career on a high note and she’s meant so much to our program over the last four years.”

Narup was on cruise control early in the regional matchup, striking out six of her 11 batters in the first three innings and holding the Lady

Hubs without a hit until the top of the fifth inning, when Rochelle sophomore Addie Friestad ended Narup’s perfect game bid with a double. Sophomore Morgan Smardo and Lodico then hit back-to-back singles in the top of the sixth inning before stealing

second and third base to give the Lady Hubs their best chance to score.

### Local players win Optimist Tournament titles

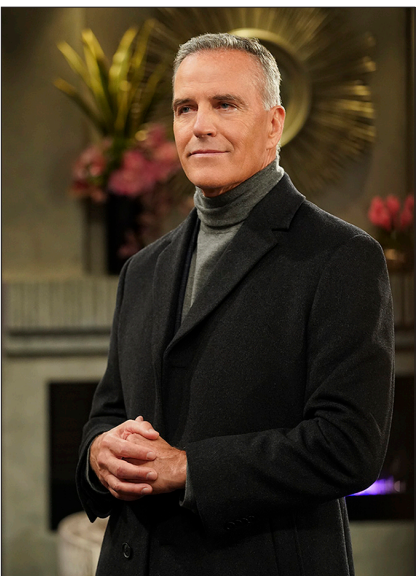

## Rochelle defeats Plano in Interstate 8 finale

Hubs snap seven-game losing skid with 10-7 victory

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity baseball team rallied for two crooked numbers on the scoreboard against the Plano Reapers on Wednesday.

Behind a four-run first inning and a six-run fourth inning, Rochelle erased a one-run deficit and defeated Plano 10-7 in the team's final Interstate 8 Conference matchup of the season. The Hubs, who snapped a seven-game losing streak with the victory, improved to 7-11 overall.

"We needed this win to build some confidence before the regional," senior Spencer Warborg said. "We want to make some noise in the regional and we really want that regional title. We need to find a way to get our bats going consistently and we need to keep pitching well. We feel confident in our pitching and we're not going to back from them. That's for sure."

Warborg drove Rochelle's first run of the game home in the bottom of the first inning, floating a shallow single to left field before senior Evan Meyers drilled a two-run single down the right-field line to make it a 3-0 game. Junior Nate Burdin plated another run in the next

at-bat, slapping an RBI groundout to the second baseman to put the Hubs ahead of Plano 4-0.

"We have Dixon on Friday and I thought that we could gain some momentum if we could get our bats going tonight," Burdin said. "I thought we all hit the ball well and we jumped on their pitchers today. We have to be fearless and we can't think that they're bigger than they are. We only had three games this season that we weren't competitive in. I think we can stun them."

Plano caught a spark in the top of the third inning, scoring five runs to slip ahead 5-4. The Reapers started their rally with a single before four consecutive batters reached base on a single and three walks. Another Plano single put the Reapers ahead with two outs.

Burdin reached on a dropped third strike to begin Rochelle's six-run fourth inning. Juniors Grant Messer and Owen Angell reached on a single and an error to load the bases for junior Eric Briseno, who brought two runners home with a single to right field. After Angell scored on a passed ball, juniors Braden Alfano and Josh Lloyd drew hit-by-pitches to load the bases for Meyers, who pounded an infield single to

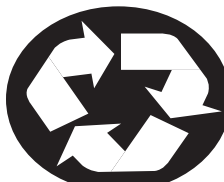
