## Remembering Todd Smith

**Memorial tree planted at RTHS athletic complex**

**ROCHELLE** — Every time Rich Harvey drives by a tree planted on Purple Pass, he thinks of Todd Smith.

He pictures Smith on the football field, wrestling mat or basketball court talking to kids or coaches. The longtime Rochelle Township High School sports photographer and booster club president passed away in December. The tree was planted in his honor on May 17.

“We felt we needed to do something to honor him for how he was a part of RTHS,” Harvey, the school’s athletic director, said. “He was always there to support kids and coaches. Any time you lose someone who was so ingrained in what you do, it’s a challenge. We miss him dearly.”

Harvey said the school has received the plaque to accompany the tree this week and a dedication is planned for a later date. There are multiple monument trees around the school’s property.

The tree was sponsored

Smith passed away at the age of 62.

## Spring Lake project nearly complete

**Pool scheduled to open Saturday, June 5 at 12:30 p.m.**

**ROCHELLE** — In June, kids won’t just be returning to Spring Lake Pool after it was closed in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

They’ll be returning to a facility that has recently undergone \$500,000 worth of renovations including the addition of a splash pad, patched and repainted pools, new shade umbrellas, an upgraded locker room with LED lighting, 16 new lower entrance parking stalls, new fencing and revamped landscaping.

“We can’t wait to see the kids’ faces,” Flagg-Rochelle Park District Executive Director Jackee Ohlinger said. “They’re going to be ecstatic. One, they haven’t been here in so long and they’re just anxious to be part of normalcy with their friends. Now they have some new things to catch their eye

and experience.”

The park district received a \$310,000 grant in matching funds from the state’s Open Space Land Acquisition and Development program. When completely finished, the total project will be \$620,000.

The pool is slated for its opening day on Saturday, June 5 at 12:30 p.m., if weather allows for the newly-painted pool to dry and be filled and operational by then, Ohlinger said.

The park district decided to apply for the OSLAD grant to couple all of its Spring Lake maintenance projects that were coming up. Getting those funds allowed the splash pad to be put in as well.

The concession area was made smaller to make way for the splash pad. Use of the splash pad will be included in patrons’ entrance admission fee while the pool is open. When the pool is closed, the community can use the

splash pad at no expense. “We’ll open up the gates,” Ohlinger said. “There’s a lot of free hours of it. Really we’re talking about until 12:30 every day it’s available to

them. And then one of our biggest struggles is that our lifeguards are mostly students. They go back to school early August. Trying to keep the pool open in August is a challenge.

Even if we have to close then, they’ll still have the splash pad for many more hot days ahead of them to be utilized at any time.”

When the park district asked the community what it wanted from Spring Lake improvements, shade and additional, closer parking were the top responses.

Six new large shade structures have fulfilled that need. The 16 new parking stalls near the splash pad will make getting to and from the pool easier for parents and grandparents with strollers or small children.

"They could only park at the marina or along those side streets and walk down those steps, which is a challenge," Ohlinger said. "Having some priority parking for those that need

it at the entrance level was important."

A couple of years ago, the decking at Spring Lake was redone. A new heating and filtration system was put in for the pool in recent years as well. Much of the new landscaping will require little-to-no maintenance.

"We really spent a lot of time and effort improving this place because of its real value to the community," Ohlinger said. "It's the only outdoor pool. Efficiency is a big thing. A lot of the maintenance projects we did are going to be cost-effective for the district in the long run."

Interim Aquatic Director Marianne Swanson worked at Spring Lake during its

first year in 1981. Safety and handicap accessibility are her favorite facets of the recent renovations. The deck no longer has levels and those in wheelchairs are able to move around the facility.

Swanson is excited to see how the community takes to the new splash pad.

"The splash pad is state-of-the-art, and also supervised during open hours which I think is nice," Swanson said.

Swanson said until the district receives total guidance, Spring Lake staff will be following whatever COVID-19 recommendations are. She hopes it will be opened completely with

no restrictions by mid-June.

Swanson called last year's closure an 'anticlimactic' summer, but believes the community is in for a great 2021 season due to reopening and renovations.

"I'm very thankful to this park board and previous board members," Swanson said. "They stayed with Spring Lake. There was

talk for a while of, 'Oh, we'll just shut it down. It's getting old. Instead of pumping the money back into the facility and bringing it back to where it was when we opened.' They made a commitment to our community and our kids. I can't say enough good things about their support."

Despite the recent completion of district-changing projects like The REC Center and Spring Lake's ren-

ovations, Ohlinger is tired, but not tired of projects.

"It's been a lot of work," Ohlinger said. "But, there's still a lot of wonderful things. It's exciting because we have community members that still suggest ideas that are wonderful. It doesn't really matter how tired I am. If there's something more we need to do to add value to Rochelle, I think the board and our staff are ready to do it."

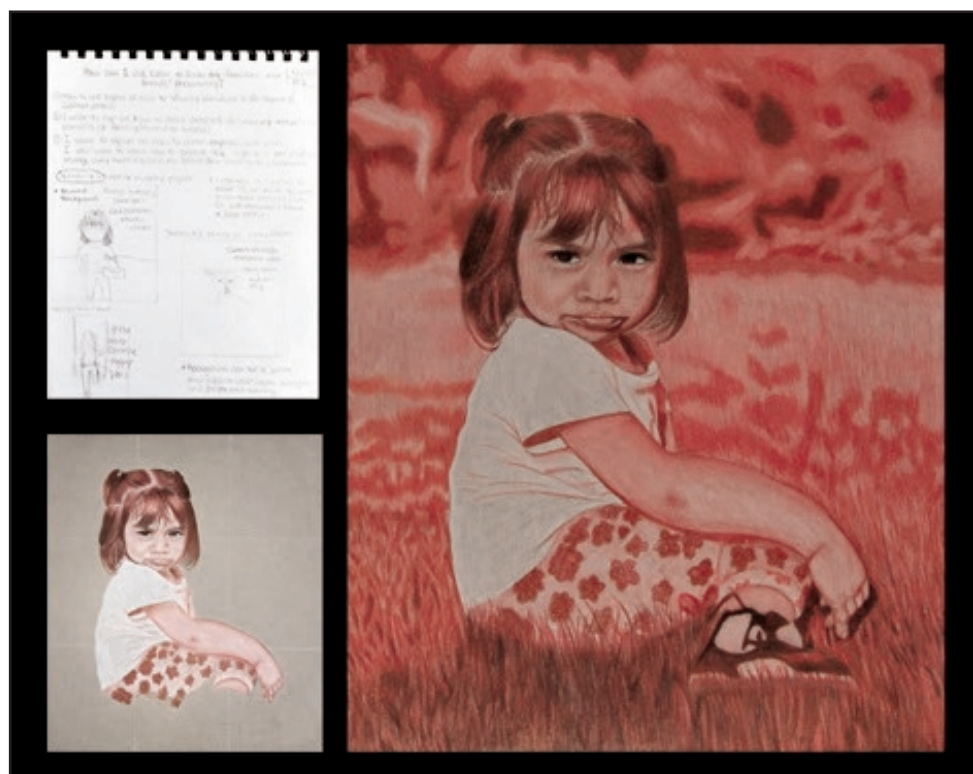

**OTTAWA** — U.S. Rep. Adam Kinzinger announced the winner of the 2021 Congressional Art Competition for the 16th District of Illinois.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic which had many schools using in-person and virtual learning, students were able to submit their art entries digitally as well as in person at the congressman's Ottawa district office. This year, Kinzinger's office received more than 20 entries.

Kinzinger personally called to share the news with the chosen student: Leslie Rodriguez-Nambo of Rochelle Township High School. Her color pencil portrait titled 'Sassy' showcases Rodriguez-Nambo's exemplary skills and attention to detail.

"As the winning piece, 'Sassy' will be displayed in the United States Capitol for a year. Our three honorable mention winners' work will be displayed in my district offices in Ottawa (Marlen Hueramo, RTHS), Rockford (Aaliyah Kahuhu, Dekalb) and Watseka (Jazzmyn DeFord, Ottawa).

## Praying without a doubt

**P**RAYER is a vital part of our relationship with God, and it's a great privilege, not an obligation. When you really think about it, it's amazing to know that the God who created everything and knows everything actually wants us to come to Him boldly—through Christ—to have a relationship with Him.

Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV) says, "Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." It's so important for us to trust God's love for us and know that He's merciful and sees us as righteous because of what Jesus has done for us (2 Corinthians 5:21). If we don't, we will struggle to have confidence that He hears our prayers and wants to help us.

The truth is God knows everything about us—what's right with us and what's wrong with us. He loves us unconditionally and He wants to have a relationship with us and meet every need in our lives. Our imperfections have nothing to do with His ability and willingness to answer our prayers.

Doubt is a common hindrance to answered prayer, and when we experience it, it's usually because we're focusing on us—our weaknesses and mistakes. The key is keeping our focus on God, trusting Him to give us wisdom and discernment so we know what to believe and what to do. James 1:5 (NKJV) says, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him."

True wisdom comes from God, and He wants to give it to us "liberally and without reproach." "Liberally" means He gives more than enough, and "without reproach" means that even when we're in messes we've created ourselves, we can still go to God and He will help us.

Now, this doesn't mean He won't correct us, teach and train us when we've made a mistake. Like any parent who loves their children, He disciplines us because He loves us and wants what's best for us. But when we're in trouble, He doesn't decide whether to help us or not based on our performance. His love is unconditional.

Here's an example to demonstrate what I'm talking about: If my son was in trouble with the neighborhood bully and called for his dad and me to help him, we wouldn't respond to him based on whether he had done all of his chores at home. It would be ridiculous if we heard him crying for help, yet we took time to check the list first to see if he had done everything he was supposed to do before we intervened.

As parents, we don't refuse to help our children because they don't do everything right, perfectly or the way we want them to all the time. God is our Father, and He knows we are not perfect. He wants to be involved in every part of our lives and we don't ever have to doubt that.

When we doubt God, we're left midway between believing and not believing—we're double-minded. But first Corinthians 2:16 says we can live with the mind of Christ. In other words, we can learn to think the way God thinks so we're not led by the mind of the flesh, "which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit" (Romans 8:6 AMPC).

James 1:6 says when we come to God for wisdom, it must be in faith "with no wavering (no hesitating, no doubting). For the one who wavers (hesitates, doubts) is like the billowing surge out at sea that is blown hither and thither and tossed by the wind." This doesn't mean we won't ever feel doubt, but when we do, we can know how to stand up to it.

Sometimes when I'm teaching, I doubt whether I'm sharing the "right" message based on how people seem to be responding to me. That's when I have to trust God and tell myself, "I've prayed about this. I've sought God about the teaching, and I'm not going to be double-minded. I trust God."

I want to encourage you to ask God for the desires in your heart and then stand in faith for Him to do His will. Decide to trust Him and His Word, no matter what you feel, what people say or what your circumstances look like. The only thing that really matters is what God's Word says, and you will overcome doubt by putting your faith in Him every time you pray.

When families gather after a death, one characteristic seems to hold true: however somber the adults may be, young children, after a while, cannot resist the urge to scamper around, play and, in general, act like children.

That's because they are children, and their reactions to grief don't match those of adults. That doesn't mean children don't feel grief or know that something sad or final or tragic has occurred. Children are highly attuned to the emotions of the people around them, but they grieve in their own way, and it's important that adults recognize a child's need for honesty, love, and reassurance when death occurs.

Sometimes adult's



preoccupation with grief prevents them from seeing that a child's reaction to death is just as deep as theirs – even though it may be expressed differently, depending on the child's age and stage of emotional development.

## Human remains found Wednesday afternoon

### Flagg Township Museum historian says bones could be up to 175 years old

**ROCHELLE** — Rochelle Police Chief Eric Higby said human remains found Wednesday are believed to be from an old cemetery in town.

Police were called around 3 p.m. by a homeowner in the 700 block of North 7th Street that was having sewer work done when what looked like a partial skull and rib bones were found, Higby said.

“It was difficult for officers to tell,” Higby said. “We checked with the library and a few other people and found out there was a cemetery there. We called the state police and the county coroner. We ended up putting the bones back in the ground. As far as we could tell, they were

part of a cemetery.”

Higby said the experience was new to his department and he wanted to make sure everything was done right. Digging ceased while the situation was sorted out. Higby doesn’t anticipate any more news will come of the situation.

“They certainly didn’t look fresh,” Higby said. “And they weren’t down a foot or two in a shallow grave. They were down there a ways.”

Higby said if they weren’t sure that the cemetery used to be there, the situation would be different. The homeowner said he was advised when he moved in that it was near an old cemetery site.

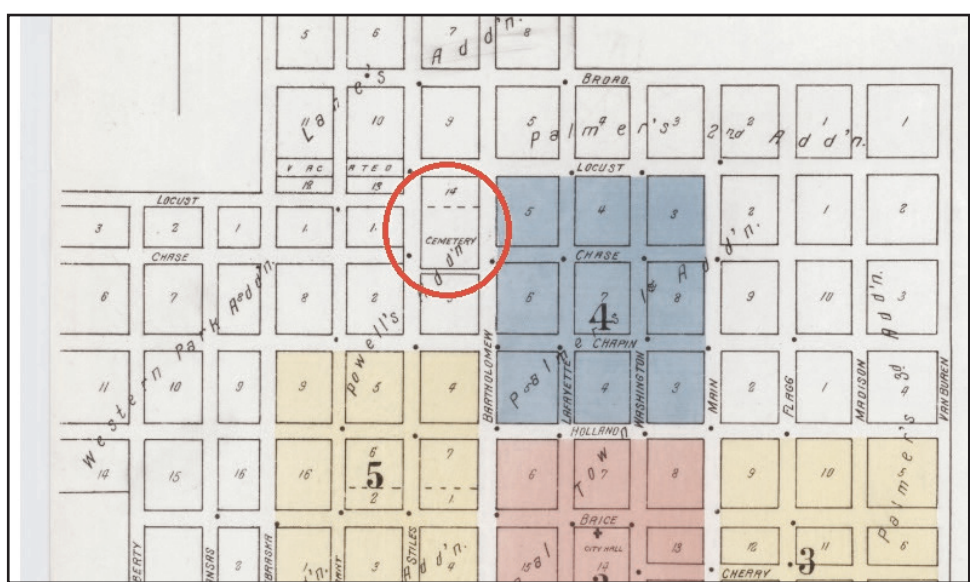
Flagg Township Museum Historian Tom McDermott said the cemetery that used to be on the site closed

down in 1874. That’s when the last burials were done there.

“That says if the body was originally there, it could be up to 175 years old,” McDermott said. “We can’t know anything for sure, but that’s if they were the first person there. The first person I can find that was buried at 7th Street was 1846.”

McDermott said he’s found one old issue of a Rochelle newspaper that said a man in 1915 found remains when building a house on North 8th Street in the area. That was the only other time he could find news of remains being found in the area.

Houses were first built in the area in 1906. When the cemetery closed, bodies were moved from the old cemetery to Lawn-

ridge, McDermott said.

“I think it was left up to families to move them,” McDermott said. “I think there was a lawsuit. I don’t know how it turned out. A lot of them weren’t marked well. I’m sure a lot of what they used was wood.”

“Obviously they didn’t get them all.”

## Illinois health care and business communities are under threat

SENATE Bill 72 is a detrimental piece of legislation that is currently sitting on Gov. J.B. Pritzker's desk. If signed into law, SB 72 will be crushing for both the small business community as well as the Illinois health care industry at-large – both of which are already struggling to recover following the devastating impact of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. As such, Pritzker should make the right choice and do what's best for all Illinoisans and veto SB 72.

SB 72 is a revised version of House Bill 3360, an even more dangerous piece of legislation that Pritzker vetoed a few months ago. House Bill 3360 proposed an increase in litigation costs for Illinois employers and health care workers – up to 9 percent, an amount far higher than any other state. Luckily, Pritzker acknowledged this preposterous amount in his veto message of House Bill 3360, in which he stated that "the proposed 9 percent flat rate is higher than many of these market-based rates adopted by other states." Additionally, the veto message stated: "HB 3360 would be burdensome for hospitals and medical professionals beyond the national norm, potentially driving up healthcare costs for patients and deterring physicians from practicing in Illinois."

Thus, Senate Bill 72 was quickly compiled and proposed as a "compromise" in light of Pritzker's veto. And while Senate Bill 72 reduced the amount of interest charged from 9 percent to 6 percent, this number is still outrageously higher than the national norm. Further, Senate Bill 72 does little to address the bigger problem that Pritzker himself stated in his veto message of House Bill 3360, which is that this increase in costs comes at a time when hospitals and businesses are barely staying afloat amid the pandemic. Simply put, Senate Bill 72 is not a compromise by any means and must be vetoed accordingly.

Unfortunately, this type of anti-business, anti-health care legislation does not come as a surprise to us Illinoisans, as we have been seeing an increase in these sort of efforts for years. What is surprising, however, is the timing of it all.

For over a year now, health care workers have been fighting on the front lines of COVID-19. As we all know, this was something we had never seen before. We've lost patients, and sadly, many have lost their lives. As for small business owners, 2020 was far from kind to them. The COVID-19-led shutdowns forced many local Illinois businesses to permanently shut down, while the rest were left to fight tooth and nail to survive. In fact, many still are.

What the business and health care community need more than ever is support from their lawmakers, and the protection they deserve against the ridiculous type of litigation that Senate Bill 72 – and many other Illinois laws – incentivize. Instead, state lawmakers seem to be determined to do the opposite and continue to propose legislation that will only serve to harm these incredible, hardworking communities.

We must work together to find solutions for our state's litigious environment, as Illinois is now known to be an extremely unattractive place to work in the health care industry. As a doctor, I've seen the damage this does firsthand. I've watched as doctors have fled the state, exhausted by the expensive and toxic legal climate that hinders our ability to do our jobs. Not only that, but it decreases access to proper health care for all Illinoisans, as doctors continue to flee to practice medicine in more health care-friendly states.

There are many obstacles we must overcome – and many laws that we must reform – before Illinois can become a health care-friendly and business-friendly state. A great first step in the right direction, however, would be for Pritzker to do what's best for everyone, and veto Senate Bill 72 as soon as possible.

# PRIMETIME

## Effective exercises for seniors

**Strength training:** Se-

**Proximity:** According to Commonwealth Medicine, there are more than 15,000 SNFs in the United States. These

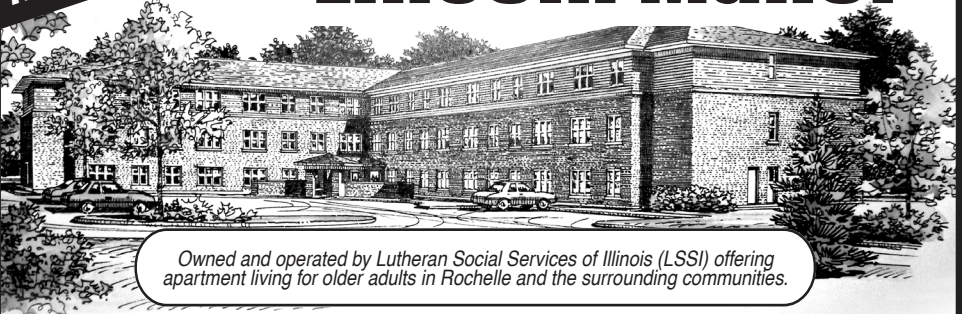

# Interesting facts about Memorial Day

EACH year on the last Monday of May, Americans celebrate Memorial Day. Memorial Day is a federal holiday that honors and mourns American military personnel who died while performing their duties in service to the United States Armed Forces.

Memorial Day has a rich history and one that's worth revisiting as the nation prepares to honor the sacrifices made by its military personnel over the centuries.

• Freed slaves played a role in the establishment of Memorial Day. The American Civil War is the deadliest military conflict in American history, as the Union and the Confederacy each suffered more than 800,000 casualties by the time the war ended in 1865. According to History.com, as the war drew to a close, hundreds of Union soldiers who were being held as prisoners of war died and were buried in a mass grave in a Confederate prison camp in South Carolina. After the Confederate surrender, more than 1,000 now-freed slaves honored those recently deceased

Union soldiers during a ceremony in which they sang hymns and distributed flowers. The ceremony was dedicated to the fallen soldiers and served as a precursor to what is now celebrated as Memorial Day.

• Confederate soldiers were honored, too. Confederate losses during the Civil War outnumbered Union losses, and those losses were not forgotten by southerners who survived the war. History.com notes that, in 1866, the Georgia-based Ladies Memorial Association, one of many similar organizations to arise in the aftermath of the war, pushed for a day to honor fallen Confederate soldiers. In fact, these efforts are believed to have influenced General John A. Logan. In 1868, General Logan, a Civil War veteran who was then serving as commander-in-chief of a group of Union veterans, ordered the decoration of Union graves with flowers on May 30. The day would ultimately be known as "Memorial Day."

• It took a long time for Memorial Day to become a federal

holiday. Despite tracing its origins to the immediate aftermath of the Civil War, Memorial Day did not become an official federal holiday until 1971, more than a century after the war ended. This is the same year the holiday was officially designated as taking place on the last Monday in May. The designation has periodically drawn the ire of veterans and military supporters who suggest it is now more widely seen as the unofficial beginning to summer and not a day in which the sacrifices of fallen U.S. soldiers are honored to the extent that they should be.

• Debate exists about which town has the longest history of celebrating Memorial Day. A handful of towns claim to be the first celebrants of Memorial Day. That debate figures to continue in perpetuity, but History.com notes that Waterloo, New York, was officially recognized by U.S. President Lyndon B. Johnson as the birthplace of Memorial Day in 1966. Doylestown, Pennsylvania, and Rochester, Wisconsin are some other towns that claim to have celebrated Memorial Day since the mid-1860s.

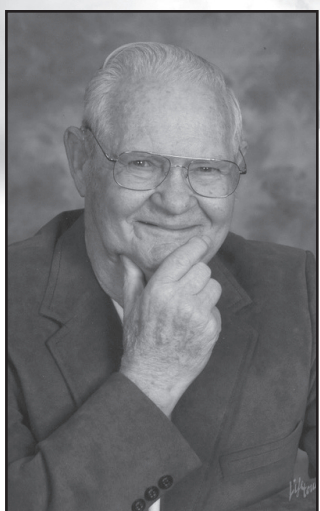

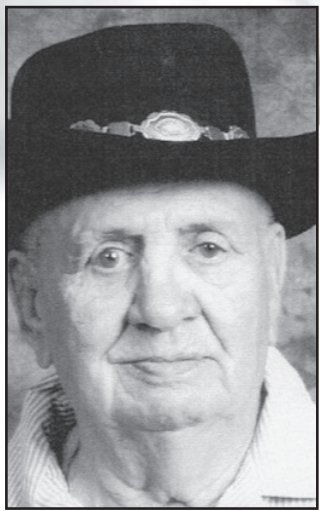

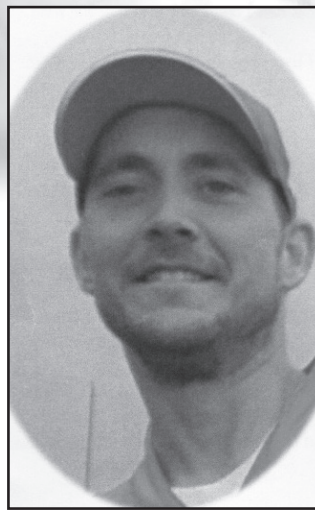

# Ultimate tiebreaker clinches win over Sterling

### Tourdot steps up as Rochelle splits triangular meet with Le-Win/Stockton

**ROCHELLE** — Hub freshman Tommy Tourdot knew that he would be the last wrestler to take the mat between the Rochelle varsity team and Sterling on Wednesday. What Tourdot didn't know was that his bout with Golden Warrior 113-pounder Karson Strohmeyer would not only feature the extremely rare ultimate tiebreaker, but decide the overall winner of the dual.

With Rochelle holding a 35-33 lead over Sterling, Tourdot entered the ring against Strohmeyer, battling back and forth before the third period ended in a 6-6 draw. Both wrestlers held each other off during overtime, setting up two 30-second tiebreaker periods. The intense match briefly fell away from Tourdot, who was unable to escape during the first tiebreaker.

Conceding one point to begin the second tiebreaker in the neutral position, Tourdot forced Strohmeyer into two stalling penalties, with the second coming right before the buzzer to send

the bout into a 30-second ultimate tiebreaker at 7-7. From the down position, Tourdot pulled off the move of the evening, reversing Strohmeyer near the edge of the circle to score two points and win the bout 9-7. The victory also meant Rochelle defeated Sterling 38-33.

"My coaches told me before the match that I needed to do something big," Tourdot said. "I had shots earlier in the match, but I wasn't able to finish them... I told myself I couldn't let go and I had to keep driving at the end. I went down in the ultimate tiebreaker, but I hit a stand-up and when he tried to return, I walked my hips over and got my two points before pushing him out. It was really nice to win the match and we've been performing really well as a team."

Senior Ivan Pineda opened the match for the Hubs (14-3), taking down and pinning William Howard at 120 pounds before sophomore Josey Weber received a forfeit at 126 pounds.

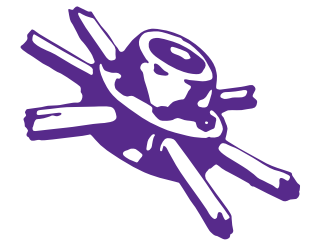

OTTAWA — The Rochelle Lady Hub track and field team battled for conference bragging rights at the Interstate 8 Championship meet on Wednesday, finishing sixth overall with 40 points. Rochelle will now train for the IHSA 2A Sectional at Plano High School on Thursday, June 3.

Freshman Alivia Henkel shined in the 400-meter dash, taking second with a time of 1:01.74 while junior Teagan Meyers placed third in 1:04.42. Junior

Liberty Hayes finished sixth in the 100-meter dash with a time of 13.96 seconds and sophomore Yuelma Ortiz took fifth in the 3200-meter run with a time of 14:24.36. Junior Sara Johnson placed seventh in the 1600-meter run and eighth in the 100-meter hurdles with personal-best times of 6:09.87 and 19.73.

"It was great to see our kids placing at the conference level," head coach Alison Vrana said. "Afi has continued to be more consistent in her throws and Alivia has continued to get faster. Teagan has

been more consistent in the high jump and I think we've set ourselves up well for the sectional next week. I'm looking forward to seeing the girls continue to improve."

The Lady Hubs took second in the 1600-meter relay, with Henkel, Hayes, Meyers and freshman Kylie Smith clocking in at 4:26.71. Senior Afi Gati finished third in the shot put with a distance of 10.59 meters and sixth in the discus with a throw of 28.67 meters. Meyers placed second in the high jump with a clearance of 1.52 meters and Henkel

took seventh in the pole vault.

"We're right on the bubble for all of the events we're hoping to see kids qualify for state in," Vrana said. "I think Afi can reach the qualifying standard in the shot put and Teagan has cleared 5 feet twice this season so she only needs one more inch. These girls are competitors and I think they'll compete as hard as they can to make it to the state meet. Alivia is right on the cusp of qualifying for state in the 400. We have a lot of chances to send kids to the state meet."

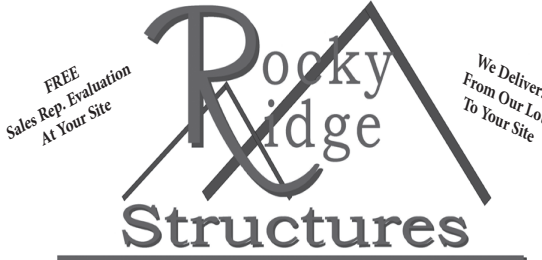

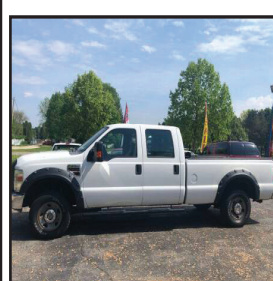

Senior Ben Harvey kept the Hubs in the match, dominating the first period against Max Pietale at 195 pounds with three takedowns, two near falls and a pin. Kaneland sealed the dual win at 220 and 285 pounds, with Miles Ripper edging Hub senior Noah Messer for a 7-0 decision and Nate Diaz outlasting Rochelle sophomore Jaden Cook in a 5-1 decision to conclude

the match.

"I think we're right there with the best teams in the conference," Vruno said. "I know the point differential was about two or three matches, but anything can happen on any given day. If we're able to move some kids around or score some huge pins, anything can happen."

### Harlem

The Huskies opened with an 10-0 advantage, scoring a pin at 120 pounds and a 17-6 major decision at 126 pounds. Wesley Brown recorded his second victory of the evening at 132 pounds, taking down Gabe McNamers twice before pinning him for Rochelle's first points.
