Diamond G Ranch plans to host multiple events starting with Sunday's barrel races

**ROCHELLE** — We may live smackdab in the center of the Midwest, but there is a glimpse of the true American West right under our noses. And it smells like the rodeo.

Diamond G Ranch, just five minutes outside Rochelle, has been here for nearly 50 years. Its history is rich in rodeos, cowboys and cowgirls, relationships and memories that never fade.

Those memories are continuing, thanks to Lane and Jenna Kreiser, who are bringing the property back to life after Lane bought the historic arena in 2017. Prior to the purchase, Lane knew it needed attention, but he also knew it would

be a gem.

Lane grew up in Amboy, Jenna in Marseilles, but both grew up with the rodeo. Now their kids, 9-year-old Brailee and 8-month-old Rodee, will truly grow up on a ranch that hosts rodeos and events.

They're doing what they can to spruce things up. "I want it to look welcoming, we're trying to liven it up," Jenna said.

Sunday, they'll host their first public event since Covid-19 closed many

**ROCHELLE** — It's the age-old dilemma, is it better to buy than to lease? At Monday's city council meeting the council all voted to purchased heavy

equipment from Maplehurst Farms, that the city regularly rents for various projects.

Maplehurst decided to get out of the business of leasing equipment recently, which gives the city the opportunity to

purchase the equipment they regularly leased, at a decent market price.

In a short period of time, it'll prove to be a cost-effective move as other places from where they could rent are a distance from the "Hub City,"

which adds to the cost of renting.

It was pointed out that in the past six years, the city has spent \$100,000 in heavy machinery rental. With the \$150,000 they

venues throughout the country. It's Jackpot Barrel Races all day and it's open to the public. The show starts at 10 a.m., although come out any time after 7 a.m. to watch the exhibition runs.

Admission is free, there's plenty of parking and a food vendor, Hector's out of Oregon, will be on hand. It's something for all ages and dogs are

welcome, too, so long as they're on a leash.

Not only are the spectators of all ages, so are the competitors. There are four divisions, Pee wee is 10 and under; Youth is 18 and under; Adult is 19 and over; and Senior is 50 and older.

### Improvements

But let's talk about how Diamond G and the Kreisers got to this point. The improvements and

additions they've made are significant, but some undetectable, like the expense for new gutters on the entire indoor arena and building.

One thing most will notice, though, is the new announcer's box which went up this year. The two-story building at the north end of the arena was constructed by Lane and some friends. The Kreisers do much of the work themselves, with the help

of friends and neighbors.

One major endeavor included shifting the entire outdoor arena to accommodate two natural gas pipelines that go through the property.

That was tricky, but now there no longer are fears of interfering with the pipeline.

Sunday's event is barrel racing, but they plan to host more events such as rodeos, bull riding, team sorting, team penning, roping and more barrel racing.

Jenna also is doing horse training, in her spare time. She trained her horse, Dallas, to sit on command in less than three months. She also has a bull that she boards in Wisconsin that is a show-

stopper and winner.

### History

Diamond G Ranch wouldn't have happened without the vision and hard work of Milo and Dena Gittleston, who purchased the property in 1972 and turned it into rodeo central.

Jenna said the same participants who made the rodeo a success nearly 50 years ago, come back now with their kids and grandkids and share stories of Diamond G Ranch.

Back in the day it was nicknamed the "cow palace."

Gittleston's daughters, Sandy and Donna still lease and operate the store.

One thing the Gittleston's started which the

Kreisers have continued is the New Year's Eve bull riding competition.

It's a huge hit in the indoor arena and they intend to continue in the years to come.

If you can't make the barrel races this weekend, there's another one around the corner on Saturday, May 15.

It's a new day at Diamond G Ranch and, just like always, everyone is welcome ... whether you have memories from its past, are a competitor or you're a curious member of the cheering crowd.

## Kish Early Learning Center earns rating

The college's program has held the distinction since 2013 & is moving into new, improved facility

**MALTA** — The Kishwaukee College Early Learning Center (ELC) has once again received the Gold Circle of Quality designation from ExceleRate Illinois, the State's quality recognition and improvement system for early learning and development providers.

The ELC first received this distinction in 2013 and has maintained the high-quality level since that time.

ExceleRate Illinois helps families make more informed choices about their children's early learning while providing a framework for early learning and development professionals to identify opportunities to enhance their knowledge and skills.

"Every early learning and development provider who participates in

ExceleRate Illinois makes quality a priority," said Cynthia L. Tate Ph.D., executive director, Governor's Office of Early Childhood Development.

The program establishes standards to help infants, toddlers and preschoolers develop intellectually,

physically, socially and emotionally.

Kish's ELC has maintained its status as a top choice for early childhood education despite the challenges of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.

"We have had to implement a lot of cleaning and sanitizing accommodations to meet the increased safety guidelines through the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services," said Maria Lombardo, Director of the Early Learning Center.

"We have done all of that without sacrificing the high-quality early learning experience our children receive."

The ELC currently provides early childhood care and education for children ages 2-5. However, the ELC will soon move into a new and improved facility on Kish's campus, which will allow for expanded services to children ages 1-5.

Kishwaukee College is currently renovating a portion of its Campus

Operations Building to house the ELC.

The renovation is partially funded by a grant through the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Kish's current ELC facility was originally built as a temporary building in the 1970s and needs various upgrades to meet current and future demands, which the new space will provide.

The project is expected to be completed later this spring with operations moved to the new space in June following approval from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services.

sponded to the scene.

An autopsy was performed on April 30. The body was identified as Patrick Reum, 28, Rockford.

Reum was reported missing on Dec. 12, 2020 at 6 p.m. in the 600 block of South First Street in Rockford. His keys, wallet, phone and cigarettes were left inside his residence.

Reum's family members and friends have been searching for him ever since, they last hosted a water search in Rockford on April 17 with sonar and cadaver dogs.

The Lee County Coroner's Office, in conjunction with Rockford Police Department has notified the family and will continue the investigation.

spend now to purchase; they'll see a savings in a short period of time.

The three pieces are 2005 Volvo long-reach excavator, a 2005 John Deere excavator with three buckets and a 2006 John Deere dozer 6-way Series 2 wide track.

Ambulance rates will go up, but most won't see it in their bill. Rochelle Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville explained to the council that his department has kept the rates the same for four years, and they're the lowest in the region. The department participates in the program funded by Medicare and Medicaid, so because they're rates are lower, the reimbursements are lower from this program. Sawlsville recommended, and the council agreed, to raise the rates in accordance with the reimbursement plan from the program.

Sawlsville added that last year, nearly one-third of their ambulance calls were Medicaid. The final rate agreed upon is \$795, which will allow them to be properly reimbursed by

patients' insurance.

Resident Steve O'Connor approached the council during public comment about the management of Rail Fan Park. O'Connor voiced his frustration with the city's previous city manager who didn't follow through on projects and thus the park was "run into the ground." Currently, O'Connor is charged with keeping up the park's Facebook page and is wondering if there will be a Railroad Days festival in the future.

Mayor John Bearrows suggested O'Connor meet with the city manager, himself and/or Jenny Thompson, director of marketing, public relations and tourism for the city.

Bearrows added that he "found it offensive to be blasted" on social media regarding the issue as his door is always open, as is the city manager's.

Bearrows closed the conversation with saying there are some things in the works from grant money and suggested they all get together to discuss the issue.

**CHILDREN WILL BE CHILDREN**

When families gather after a death, one characteristic seems to hold true: however somber the adults may be, young children, after a while, cannot resist the urge to scamper around, play and, in general, act like children.

That's because they are children, and their reactions to grief don't match those of adults. That doesn't mean children don't feel grief or know that something sad or final or tragic has occurred. Children are highly attuned to the emotions of the people around them, but they grieve in their own way, and it's important that adults recognize a child's need for honesty, love, and reassurance when death occurs.

Sometimes adult's

preoccupation with grief prevents them from seeing that a child's reaction to death is just as deep as theirs – even though it may be expressed differently, depending on the child's age and stage of emotional development.

## Demolish Your Doubts

In Acts 27 (AMP), there's a great story about the apostle Paul. He was travelling by ship with some people when "a violent wind...[a northeaster, a tempestuous windstorm like a typhoon], came rushing down from the island" (v. 14). For days they were caught in the storm, and at one point it was so fierce, they were "violently tossed about by the storm" (v. 18) and had to throw the ship's equipment overboard. They ended up without food, hungry, stranded – seemingly without hope.

In that moment, Paul stood in the midst of the survivors and said to them, "I urge you to keep up your courage and be in good spirits, because there will be no loss of life among

you..." (v. 22). He said that an angel of God told him this, and said in verse 25, "So keep up your courage, men, for I believe God and have complete confidence in Him that it will turn out exactly as I have been told."

How could Paul, in the middle of a horrible storm, ask the people to "be in good spirits" and have a good attitude? Because he believed in his heart—without a doubt—"that it will turn out exactly as I have been told."

I love that! It's a great picture of the power of faith in God when all hope seems lost. And we can have the very same faith that Paul had if we will overcome doubt.

We all face storms in life, and some are more

difficult than others. That's why we have the gift of faith. Ephesians 6:16 (ESV) calls it "the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one." Doubt is a type of "flaming dart" that the enemy uses to attack our faith.

We usually experience doubt after we've made a decision.

In James 1:6, the Bible says having doubt is like being tossed about like the wind, which feels like you're trying to go in two different directions at the same time. And it's miserable to be torn between two places, not able to decide what you really believe.

It's in those moments we have to choose wheth-

er we are going to believe God or the enemy...God or our feelings...God or what people tell us...God or our circumstances.

When doubt comes against us, we have to lift up the shield of faith. We do this when we open our mouth and say what God's Word says, rather than grumbling and complaining about the problem.

Our faith is released as we say, pray and do the Word. So in those times, open your mouth and say, "I believe that everything God has told me will come to pass!"

Maybe you're doubting whether you can hear God's voice or not. This happens because we usually doubt ourselves more than we doubt God. Now I'm not talking about actually hearing a voice; I'm

talking about that knowing we have inside our hearts about what is right or wrong. That's the still, small voice of God. Believers in Jesus Christ all have it, but many don't have the confidence to trust it.

The Bible says in James 1:5 that when we need wisdom, we can go to God, "who gives generously to all without finding fault" (NIV). This means that even with our imperfections, God will be faithful to us and give us what we need if we will ask Him for help. He loves us, blesses us and uses us in spite of us, because He is faithful! And we never have to doubt that.

I've learned through my own relationship with God that He's not expecting me to be perfect; He wants me to do my best to be in His will and take steps of faith as He leads me, through His Word and the prompt-

ings He speaks to my heart. Remember, He wants us to put our confidence in Him.

God really does want to speak to you personally and lead you in His great plan for your life. So don't be afraid to step out and do what's in your heart. If you make a mistake, you'll learn from it and go on. That's how we "step out and find out." And we all have to do it.

I want to encourage you to make confessions every day that will help you grow in your faith and confidence in God. We need to make declarations like, "God loves me. He wants to speak to my heart. I can hear from God. He is faithful to me and will lead me in His will for my life. And I believe it will be exactly as God has told me!"

By God's grace, we can be bold in faith and overcome every attack of doubt during the storms of life.

## Illinois loses population ... and a seat

For the first time in Illinois' history, the Land of Lincoln has officially lost population as reported by the 10-year Census. The state also loses one member from the U.S. House of Representatives.

Leading statehouse Republicans and Democrats differ on why. Census Chief Karen Battle said Illinois was one of three states that lost population over the past decade. "We know that from our population estimates program that the state of Illinois actually had negative net domestic migration," Battle said.

In 2010, Illinois had 12,830,632 people. In 2020, the Census shows the state had 12,812,508 people, a drop of around 0.1 percent.

Historical data shows 2020 is the first ten-year Census since 1910 where Illinois has lost population from the ten years prior, for a total of around 18,000 people.

The other two states lost a larger percentage: Mississippi lost 0.2 percent, West Virginia lost 3.2 percent.

All neighboring states to Illinois are keeping their existing number of Congressional seats while Illinois is one of seven states nationwide that is losing a congressman.

State Rep. Ryan Spain said that should be a wake-up call to majority Democrats that they need to enact pro-growth policies.

"There's only one reason why we're not and that's the poor decisions that are coming from Springfield and we have to make that change desperately and urgently," Spain said. "If our state is not growing, it is dying."

Before the numbers were released, Gov. J.B. Pritzker acknowledged the state has seen a drop in population.

He said it's from what he's characterized as years of disinvest-

ment in the state's public universities with things like limited taxpayer-funded tuition grants. That's something he said led to younger people leaving the state. He said his administration has increased such funding to keep

Illinois students in Illinois.

"Collectively that has helped, but unfortunately as you know, just as that was starting to take effect, Covid hit," Pritzker said Monday.

But, state Rep. Dave Severin, R-Benton, said the reasons are clear: Democratic policies of increased taxes and increases spending are repelling job creators.

"And this kind of verifies it, high taxes and the regulatory environment that discourages private growth and investment," Severin said.

"We're losing businesses and people to border states with lower taxes."

The lost congressman in the next U.S. Congressman means less sway for the state, and less federal funding for the state. It also means Illinois loses a vote in the Electoral College.

The seat held by U.S. Rep. Rodney Davis, R-Taylorville, could be impacted by the reduction from 18 members of the U.S.

House from Illinois to 17. "It's unfortunate, yet unsurprising, that Illinois lost population over the past decade," Davis said in a statement.

"As state lawmakers determine the course for redistricting, I urge the Democrats to keep their word on supporting independent redistricting, particularly Governor Pritzker, who pledged to veto any partisan-drawn map. The politicians in charge should not be using the census to pick their own voters and protect their own power."

Sen. Omar Aquino, D-Chicago, and Sen. Elgie Sims, D-Chicago, co-chairs of the Illinois Senate Redistricting Committee, issued a statement late Monday.

"We are reviewing the information released today by the U.S. Census Bureau and remain committed to working with our partners in Washington to ensure Illinois continues to receive the federal resources and support our communities need," the joint statement said.

"While the Census Bureau

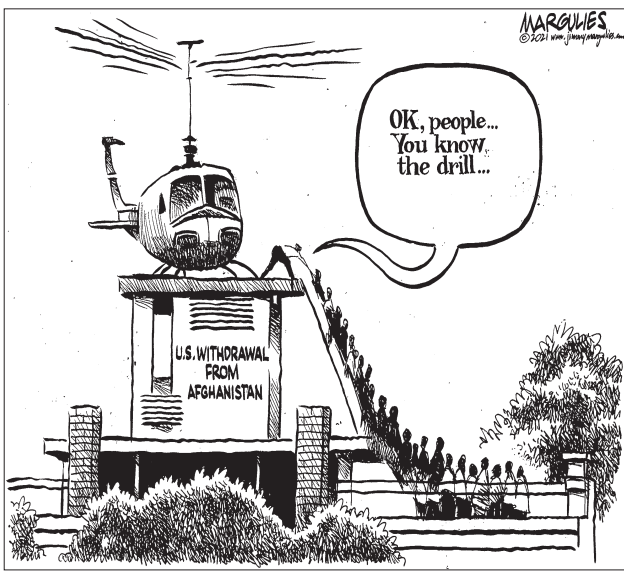

confirmed full redistricting information may not be released until September, we will not abandon our duty to craft a map by June 30 as required by the Illinois Constitution.

As others seek to delay and distract, we are focused on gathering input from communities of interest across Illinois to create a fair map that reflects the diversity of our great state."

Data for states to redraw state legislative districts are expected no later than Sept. 30, total Census data.

## Theatre offering live shows

**DEKALB** — Every-one loves a good reunion with friends or family, and Stage Coach Players (SCP) would like to invite you to a reunion of sorts. 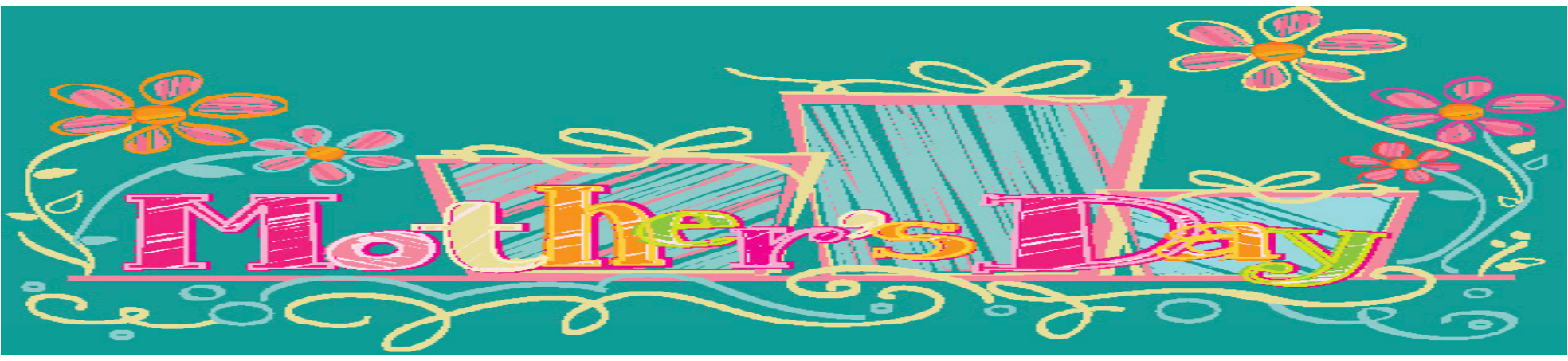

Rochelle tees off season with losses to LaSalle-Peru, Morris

**ROCHELLE** — The Lady Hub varsity softball team has shown a competitive fire over its first two games of the Interstate 8 Conference schedule. After a tough loss at Morris on Monday, Rochelle returned home for a matchup with the LaSalle-Peru Cavaliers on Wednesday.

Sophomore Morgan Smardo took the mound for her first varsity start, throwing a complete game and recording four strikeouts. The Lady Hub defense prevented LaSalle-Peru from any big innings, but the Cavalier pitching proved too strong, with Rochelle ultimately falling 6-1 and dropping to 0-2 on the season.

“I thought we came in and battled in every inning,” head coach Lindsay Suess said. “We had runners on base and in scoring position during almost every inning, but we need to make sure we’re getting those crucial hits. I thought Morgan threw the ball well for us today.”

LaSalle-Peru plated two runners in the first inning before expanding its lead in the third inning, where the Cavaliers scored two more to earn a 4-0 advantage. Af-

ter tacking on an insurance run in the fourth inning, Rochelle avoided the shut-out in the bottom half of the frame, where senior Kendal Ansteth walked and junior MeLisa Young doubled to make it a 5-1 ball game.

“Getting those crucial hits and timing the opposing pitcher up will be our biggest adjustments,” Suess said. “We also need to continue playing solid defense as we move forward.”

Taking advantage of an error from Rochelle, LaSalle-Peru scored one run in the fifth inning. The Lady Hubs strung together multiple near-rallied toward the end of the game, with Smardo and junior Regan Underwood each drawing fifth-inning walks before being stranded on base. Underwood and Smardo reached again in the seventh inning, with Underwood walking and Smardo hitting a line-drive single to right field before a strikeout sealed the Cavalier victory.

## Morris

The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity softball team opened its season at Morris on Monday, nearly escaping with an Interstate 8 Conference victory. Despite leading for most of the game, Rochelle conceded seven Redskin runs in the sixth inning

## Albers commits to Wartburg College

**R**OCHELLE senior Ethan Albers has been an anchor on defense for the Hub varsity football team, earning All-Conference First Team honors from the Interstate 8 during both his junior and senior seasons. A two-way lineman who enjoyed success on both sides of the ball, Albers will be ready to take his talents to the NCAA Division III level at Wartburg College next year.

"I chose Wartburg College because it fits the major I want to study and I love the aggressiveness and winning mentality of its football team," Albers said. "I'm looking forward to meeting new teammates, facing new competition and receiving new challenges to overcome."

A two-year starter at both tight end and defensive end, Albers totaled 23 tackles while adding one fumble recovery and one interception in six games this season. Albers shined during his junior season, leading the Hubs with 6.5 sacks and seven tackles-for-loss. The 6-foot-2, 230-pound

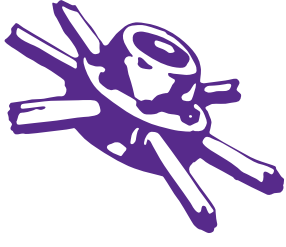

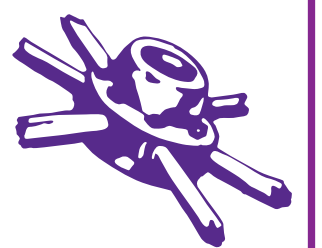

**Water Quality**  
RMU has developed a contingency plan to ensure that, through emergency preparedness, any risks to the water supply will be minimized.

**Water Resources**  
The sources of drinking water (both tap water and bottled water) include rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, reservoirs, springs, and wells. As water travels over the surface of the land or through the ground, it can dissolve naturally occurring minerals and radioactive materials, and can pick up substances resulting from the presence of animals or from human activity.

**Possible Contaminants that may be present in source water include:**  
**Microbial contaminants**, such as viruses and bacteria, which may come from sewage treatment plants, septic systems, agricultural livestock operations, and wildlife;

**Inorganic contaminants**, such as salts and metals, which can be naturally occurring or result from urban storm water runoff, industrial or domestic wastewater discharges, oil and gas production, mining or farming;

**Pesticides and herbicides**, which may come from a variety of sources such as agriculture, urban storm water runoff and residential uses;

**Organic chemical contaminants**, including synthetic and volatile organic chemicals, which are by-products of industrial processes and petroleum production, and may also come from gas stations, urban storm water runoff, and septic systems; and

**Radioactive contaminants**, which can be naturally occurring or be the result of oil and gas production and mining activities.

In order to ensure that tap water is safe to drink, USEPA prescribes regulations which limit the amount of certain contaminants in water provided by public water systems. FDA regulations establish limits for contaminants in bottled water, which must provide the same protection for public health.

If present, elevated levels of lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. Lead in drinking water is primarily from materials and components associated with service lines and home plumbing. Rochelle is responsible for providing high quality drinking water, but cannot control the variety of materials used in plumbing components. When your water has been sitting for several hours, you can minimize the potential for lead exposure by flushing your tap for 30 seconds to 2 minutes before using water for drinking or cooking. If you are concerned about lead in your water, you may wish to have your water tested. Drinking water, including bottle water, may reasonably be expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. The presence of contaminants does not necessarily indicate that water poses a health risk. The source water assessment for our supply has been completed by the Illinois EPA. If you would like a copy of this information, please stop by RMU or call our Water Operator at 815-562-4155. To determine Rochelle's susceptibility to groundwater contamination, information obtained during a Well Site Survey, which was performed by the Illinois Rural Water Association on July 15, 1999, was reviewed. Based on this information, several potential sources of contamination were identified within proximity of this water supply's wells. The Illinois EPA does not consider the City's source water susceptible to contamination. This determination is based on a number of criteria including: monitoring conducted at the wells; monitoring conducted at the entry point to the distribution system; and the available hydrogeologic data on the wells. In anticipation of the U.S. EPA's proposed Ground Water Rule, the Illinois EPA has determined that the water supply is not vulnerable to viral contamination. This determination is based upon the completed evaluation of the following criteria during the Vulnerability Waiver Process: the community's wells are properly constructed with sound integrity and proper site conditions; a hydrogeologic barrier exists that should prevent pathogen movement; all potential routes and sanitary defects have been mitigated such that the source water is adequately protected; monitoring data did not indicate a history of disease outbreak; and a sanitary survey of the water supply did not indicate a viral contamination threat. Because the community's wells are constructed in a confined aquifer, which should minimize the movement of pathogens into the wells, well hydraulics were not considered to be a significant factor in the vulnerability determination. Hence, well hydraulics were not evaluated for this groundwater supply.

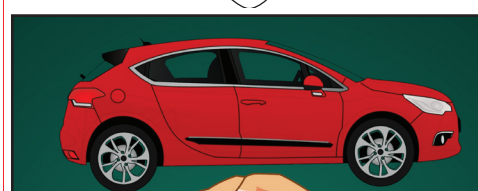

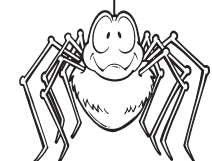
