Service planned
for Moorehead

Veteran, longtime
resident passes at 100

ROCHELLE — The Rochelle community will have its chance to pay respects to a longtime resident and World War II veteran after all.

Jim Moorehead passed away Jan. 25 at the age of 100. COVID-19 and winter weather made his graveside service family only and he was not able to be honored by the American Legion for his military service. That will happen May 22 at 11 a.m. at the southwest edge of Lawnridge Cemetery near Eighth Avenue. Anyone is welcome to attend, Moorehead's son, Butch, said.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there won't be any other events like a meal at the church related to the graveside service.

Moorehead served with the United States Navy during World War II from 1942-1944. He was assigned as a diesel mechanic to the submarine, U.S.S. Bluefish S.S. 222. He was a member of the

Rochelle United Methodist Church and Kiwanis at the southwest edge of Golden K, VFW, American Legion and Ancient Free & Accepted Masons of Illinois. He served on the Flagg Township Historical Society for many years and the Flagg-Rochelle Park District board for 22 years.

Butch Moorehead fondly recalled the community's response to his father's 100th birthday last year.

"50 cars came by and dropped off cards for him on his birthday," Moorehead said. "That was nice."

District 231 administrators discuss additional vaccines

Ages 12-15 eligible for Pfizer shot

ROCHELLE — 12-15-year-olds in both Rochelle school districts could be eligible for Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines starting this summer, Superintendent Jason Harper said at Tuesday's elementary

board of education meeting. The high school has already offered vaccines to 16-17-year-olds. Harper said nothing for younger students has been approved yet but the idea of vaccinating that population seems to be "gaining steam."

"The state and county will figure out that roll-

out," Harper said. "It could happen this summer with the Ogle County Health Department. We won't push or mandate getting it. We'd be willing to help facilitate vaccinations for those who want it unless the board feels differently.

The state hasn't mandated vaccines for staff or students.

Harper said going into next year, families who want their student to continue as a remote learner must provide proof of a documented medical condition of the student or someone in the home.

"Last year it was just up to parents and we were easy going," Harper said.

"We plan to have a greater percentage back. A doctor decides what is a medical condition. We're waiting for more clarity and guidance from the state. We want to let parents know they have time to see a

medical professional."

Harper said summer school in the elementary school will be larger and more robust this summer than in previous years.

"I jokingly say it's summer school on steroids," Harper said. "Longer days and more days. We'll still offer transportation as we have in the past, but it's a larger commitment for parents. It's open to those concerned about learning loss in the past year."

Hillcrest board receives infrastructure updates

Village could receive roughly \$151,000 from American Rescue Plan

HILLCREST—Hillcrest trustees received several updates from Baxter & Woodman Engineering regarding the American Rescue Plan, potential grant funding for infrastructure improvements in the village as well as the timeline for project design and construction. Trustees received the updates during their monthly board meeting in Hillcrest on Wednesday evening.

Carl Fischer, wastewater technical director, said the village could receive roughly \$151,000 in funds from the federal government through the American Rescue Plan, the COVID-19 relief bill passed by the U.S. Congress earlier this year. Fischer said the amount of money could change and that the village wouldn't likely receive money from the relief bill until the middle of 2022.

Fischer said Baxter & Woodman is still pursuing an unsewered community grant, as well as additional grant funding, for sewer, water and roadway improvements in the village. Hillcrest trustees voted to move forward with plans to drill a new shallow well and build both a new water tower and water treatment plant last month. The vote also included infrastructure improvements to the village sewer, water and roadways beginning on the southernmost end of the village.

Hillcrest trustees will

vote next month on when the project designing process will begin.

"We've divided six total projects into three groups," Fischer said. "The first group is the Priority 1A water main and the drilling of the well. The second group is all of the well equipment, the water treatment plant and the sanitary service. The third group is the elevated tank. Our proposed plan is to spread those six projects out over a five-year period from 2021-25."

Fischer said the generator replacement project is moving forward as well. Fischer said Baxter & Woodman is awaiting delivery of the new generator, which will power both the village water system and village hall. The replacement project is expected to be completed in October. Fischer requested \$35,602.42 in reimbursements for bidding services and a larger gas meter.

Agenda

Trustees approved salvaging the old village police car with a 4-1 vote during Wednesday's meeting. At the start of the meeting, several trustees took their oaths of office including Randy Salsbury, who was recently re-elected to a four-year term and is currently serving as president pro tem. Trustees Dan Potter, Renee Kerwin and Rick Rhoads, who were appointed to their positions previously, were also sworn in. Pam Pittman, who was re-elected, was not present.

EMBALMING PROCESS

The embalming process essentially involves replacing the blood and other bodily fluids with a preservative such as formaldehyde. Embalming is required by law only under certain circumstances, but families that intend to have a public viewing of the body usually choose to have it done, embalming preservative powers give them more leeway in scheduling a funeral. Embalmers are adept at restoring natural features that have been injured or to people who die after a long illness.

They have a range of techniques to deal with various difficulties. They can replace missing hair, rebuild fractured features, or disguise the effects of



the drastic weight loss from a long, wasting illness. Before it is placed in the casket, the body is dressed and prepared for viewing. Hair is shampooed and set, and men get a shave. Families are sometimes encouraged to bring in a recent photograph of the deceased to help guide them.

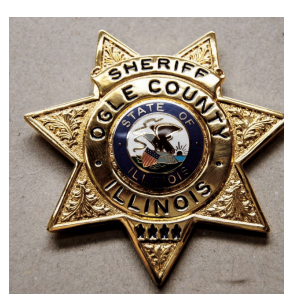

State Police to conduct special traffic patrols

STERLING — Illinois State Police (ISP) District 1 Commander, Captain Matthew Hodgdon, announces the ISP will conduct Special Traffic Enforcement Patrols (STEP) in Lee, Ogle and Whiteside counties during May.

These STEP patrols allow the ISP to focus on these fatal four violations which contribute the greatest to traffic crashes and fatalities: Driving Under the Influence (DUI), safety belt and child restraint use, speeding and distracted driving.

The ISP will increase our daytime and nighttime patrols to ensure the



safety of vehicle travelers through enforcement of all traffic safety laws. Impaired driving is a factor in more than 30 percent of traffic deaths in Illinois. Likewise, speeding is a factor in nearly 35

percent of fatal crashes; and, nearly 50 percent of vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes were known to not be buckled up. This project is funded through the Illinois Department of Transportation.

Sheriff releases distracted driving period statistics

OREGON — The Ogle County Sheriff’s Department announced it issued 285 total citations, including 13 violations to drivers for using a cell phone while driving during the April distracted driving enforcement period.

“We strongly enforce distracted driving laws for one reason – to save lives,” said Ogle County Sheriff Brian Van Vickle. The Ogle County Sheriff’s Office joined forces

with state and local law enforcement and highway safety partners for this enforcement effort.

Using your phone in anything other than hands-free mode in Illinois is not only dangerous, it is illegal. Break the cycle. Drop it and drive.

The Illinois distracted driving campaign is funded with federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

How faith in God can impact your life

LIFE in Christ is absolutely amazing when you learn to live by faith. And Romans 1:17 says that those who are believers in Him “shall live by faith” (NKJV). It’s the key to experiencing the abundant life Jesus died to give us, a life we can enjoy, “and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows]” (John 10:10 AMP).

The question is, how do we live by faith? What does it look like, practically speaking, to release, or use, our faith in our everyday lives?

In John chapter 11, we read about the time when Jesus raised His friend Lazarus from the dead. Lazarus and his sisters, Martha and Mary, were good friends to Jesus, and He’d had been to their home multiple times.

But when Lazarus was

sick and his sisters sent word to Him saying “he whom You love is sick” (John 11:3 NKJV), Jesus didn’t come right away to heal Him. His immediate response was, “This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it” (v. 4).

Jesus wanted them to trust Him and believe that no matter how bad the situation was, He could still do something to make it right. But that’s not the reaction He received.

When Mary, Lazarus’ sister, came out to meet Him, she said, “Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died” (John 11:32 NKJV). The Bible says that Jesus was “deeply moved within [to the point of anger]” when He approached Lazarus’ tomb (John 11:38 AMP). He was visibly

disturbed.

Think for a moment how Jesus must have felt. He knows what has happened and has come to fix the problem, but no one really understands what He’s capable of doing. He’s surrounded by unbelief.

And in the midst of the confusion, Jesus says to the people, “Take away the stone” (v. 39).

It’s interesting that Jesus was getting ready to raise a man from the dead but He told them to roll away the stone. He wanted to see their faith in Him through their obedience.

Romans 12:3 says God “has dealt to each one a measure of faith” (NKJV). So you have faith...but are you using it? It’s so important for us to use our faith because that’s how we grow stronger in our

relationship with God and trust Him more in every situation in our lives.

Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) says, “Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.” God rewards our faith when He sees it in action.

Using your faith simply means that you do what you can do—what God

shows you to do—and you trust Him to do what you cannot do. For example, if you’re praying for your spouse to become a believer in Christ, then don’t go to lunch with your friends and complain about how he or she will never change.

When you release your faith, you take some kind

of action that shows you believe God will do what He says He will do. You line up your attitudes and actions with God’s promises for you, according to His Word, and hold on to those truths when life gets tough. That’s what Jesus was asking the people to do when He told them to roll away the stone from Lazarus’ grave.

So many times when God asks us to do something for Him, we look at the situation and say, “There’s no way I can ever do that. It’s just too hard.”

Maybe you need to forgive people who have hurt you. Maybe you’re asking God for a new house and He’s telling you to clean up the one you’ve got. Maybe you’re facing a mountain of debt, yet you’re still using credit cards everywhere you go.

When challenges are

greater than our ability to resolve them on our own, we often say things like, “I can’t do it, God. It’s just too hard.” But that’s a lie the devil wants you to believe.

The truth is, God is never going to ask you to do something without giving you the ability to do it. Whatever the direction is, He’ll give you the strength, understanding, support, resources—anything you need—to do your part when you simply step out in obedience to follow His lead.

In these times, remember Philippians 4:13, which says, “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.” In other words, you can do whatever you need to do in life through Christ. You can roll away the stone that stands between you and your miracle.

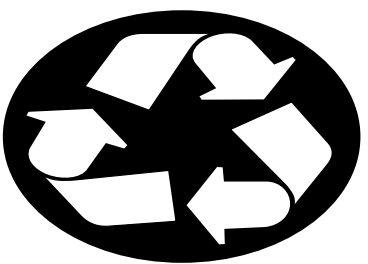

Now, there will always be some things that people will believe to be true while others will not. That has long been known. Religion is an example. Beliefs in what is true when it comes to religion are all over the place.

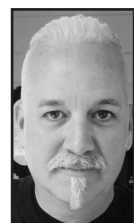

ROCHELLE — Two separate accidents occurred at the intersection

of Flagg Road and Skare Road this past week west of Rochelle.

Schneider retiring from teaching this month

ROCHELLE — Carol Schneider became a Rochelle Hub and social studies teacher in 2001. She said that she and Principal Chris Lewis were hired from among a field of 200 applicants vetted by David Anderson, department chair, a position Carol eventually assumed. She is retiring from teaching this month, so she took a moment to look back. A Rockford native, Schneider taught in Naperville and then as she raised her daughter Lauren and son Andrew, she spent 12 years as a tutor. “I worked with children from age five to adults finishing post-graduate degrees,” Schneider said. “When I decided to return to the classroom, I remember my husband cautioning me that, as society had, things in the classroom likely changed. He asked if I was scared, but what I remember about that time is being far more excited than scared.” Schneider said she has been both surprised and impressed by the culture at Rochelle Township High School and the overall positive experiences she has had in her classroom. “We are very, very fortunate here at RTHS, our students are well-behaved, good-humored and kind,” Schneider said. When Schneider and Lewis came aboard, the RTHS curriculum offered just one section of sociology. Schneider said it was taught more like a current events course than a college-prep course. She set

to work creating her own curriculum. “Carol really dusted off the history curriculum when she took on the psychology and sociology courses the department wanted to offer,” former colleague Ellen White said. “She brought the subject matter to new (and current) heights. Her knowledge allowed the courses to expand far beyond old textbook theories.” Schneider spent the next four years writing curriculum for what has become semester-long sociology and psychology courses offered to students on alternating years. “I love writing curriculum,” Schneider said. “All my classroom handouts and labs are created and customized by me.” “Carol brought a whole new group of students into the B (social studies) wing (of the Flagg Road campus) because of her teaching methods and experiments,” White said. “Many students took their early exposure to psychology and sociology under her tutelage and expanded that by continuing to take the same subject matter courses in college.” Schneider is proud to point to former students like daughter Lauren (RTHS 2010), who earned a degree in psychology and works for Illinois State University in research and planning, as well as Lauren Murphy (2015), currently completing her doctoral thesis in clinical psychology. 2021 grads Bella Lodico and Heidi Cruz have likewise decided to major in psychology. Schneider said she and her husband look forward to their next chapter which will include relocation to Bloomington, near Lauren and her family, which includes Carol’s 1-year old grandson, Archie. They also look forward to welcoming another grandson, Benjie, in September.

“That was us taking a risk. That really changed things for us financially and with exposure. A lot more people were willing to stop in rather than do it online.”

The brand sells women’s clothing and has started to bring in more unisex inventory. The shop will be open Tuesday through Friday 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Midwestern Clothing Company used to sell three or four items a week. Now the Kerstens and Fortson are unsure how much more inventory they can fit in their store.

The idea to start MCC came from a desire to be self-employed.

“I was thinking about it one day and I was like, ‘I want to do something I love that I have a passion for,’” Haley said. “I texted Kelsey and told her let’s do something. She texted me back right away and was like, ‘Oh my gosh. Alyssa just said that.’”

The Kerstens have been friends with Fortson since they were in fifth and sixth grade. The partnership seemed like a natural thing to do.

“Now we enjoy what we do,” Fortson said. “We don’t dread going into work.”

“I love the thought of not having to work except for here in the future,” Kelsey said.

Almost all of MCC’s sales come from the Rochelle area. The trio have heard from customers that they’re glad not to travel

to Rockford or DeKalb or look for clothing at Walmart.

Rochelle Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Tricia Herrera said it’s likely been over 20 years since there was a clothing shop downtown.

“People want to buy,” Haley said. “They want to support local. You can tell. When they come in, they want to find something. They want somewhere in town. The community has been amazing.”

The trio hopes to add men’s clothing at some point, along with children’s apparel and more accessories. Keeping up with trends and staying affordable are at the top of their list of priorities.

The Kerstens and Fortson called the learning curve of starting their own business “terrifying,” but some experience with finance and banking has helped them to succeed.

Working together has brought the owners closer.

“I’m with Kelsey all the time but there was a long time where we didn’t make the time with Alyssa to hang out like we used to,” Haley said. “I’m with Alyssa almost every day of the week now and it’s the best thing ever. We’re always all three together.”

The Midwestern Clothing Company owners have appreciated the community’s support as their business has grown.

“If the community wasn’t involved we wouldn’t have been at this point,” Haley said. “We really owe it all to Rochelle, honestly. We hope they’re excited as we are.”

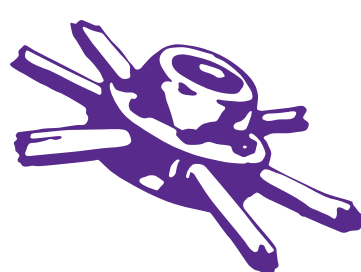

Goodwin commits to North Central College

HUB senior Trevor Goodwin will soon graduate from Rochelle Township High School as one of the more accomplished track and field athletes in recent seasons. It won't be the last time Goodwin laces up his spikes, however, as the talented jumper and hurdler will be taking both his academics and his track and field career to the North Central College Cardinals next year.

"When I arrived at the campus, their facilities were great and the college has an outstanding track record," Goodwin said. "They have a lot of national wins in track and field and they showed me how much they really wanted me there. They showed me how much of a family their team is and I knew I would fit in right away. Competing at RTHS has allowed me to compete in both the hurdles and the triple jump against some of the best kids in the state."

Goodwin has competed with the Rochelle track and field team for the last four years. Goodwin surged onto the scene during his sophomore season, where he extended his triple jump personal record by several feet before ultimately qualifying for the 2019 IHSA 2A State Championship, where he medaled in sixth place with his best-ever jump of 43 feet 9 1/4 inches.

Rochelle's fresh-soph triple jump record holder, Goodwin lost his junior season to COVID-19, but he started his senior season strong this year with a new personal best time of 16.71 seconds in the 110-meter hurdles. Goodwin holds a personal-best distance of 18 feet 8 inches in the long jump and a personal-best time of 45.28 seconds in the 300-meter hurdles.

"Trevor is someone who could make it to state in any event he does," Rochelle Hub head coach Dale Bergeson said. "I can't wait to watch him compete at North Central College. I'm proud of the person he is and he always wants to compete against the best athletes in the state."

Goodwin said he plans to study for a bachelor's degree in business economics in order to pursue a career as a lawyer. Goodwin said his interest in becoming a lawyer stems from his father Jason, who works as a detective in DeKalb. Despite

suffering a lower back injury recently, Goodwin is still hoping to compete in the IHSA 2A Rochelle Sectional on June 10.

"Our conference has some of the top athletes in the state," Goodwin said. "Going to state as a sophomore and facing the highest competition has helped prepare me for the college level... North Central College will be getting a determined athlete and someone who's ready to contribute to a lot of wins next year."

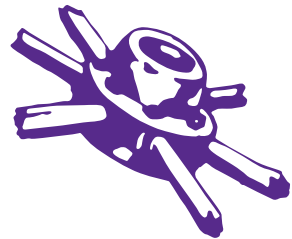

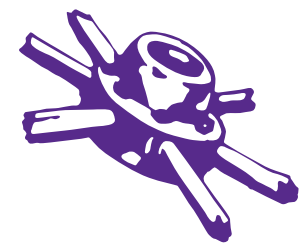

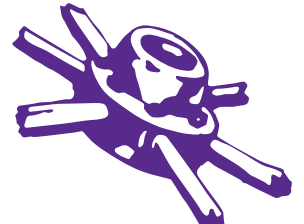

Near-rally falls short against Morris

Lady Hubs score four in seventh inning of 10-8 loss

ROCHELLE — A series of timely extra-base hits nearly brought the Lady Hub varsity softball team back from an eight-run deficit on Wednesday, when Rochelle attempted to avenge an early-season loss against the Morris Redskins in Interstate 8 Conference action.

Despite conceding eight runs over the first two innings, Rochelle found new life in the bottom of the seventh inning, with senior Bella Lodico and sophomore Morgan Smardo each delivering two-out, two-run doubles to bring the Lady Hubs within two runs of tying the game. But a pitching change helped seal the deal for the Redskins, who held off the Lady Hubs 10-8 and dropped Rochelle to 5-6 on the season. The Lady Hubs face Kaneland on the road next Monday.

“I was so proud of how our girls battled back,” head coach Lindsay Suess said. “They never gave up and we continued to hit the ball. Bella came in and pitched a very good game in relief.”

With her team trailing 6-0 in the top of the third

inning, Lodico took over on the pitcher’s mound for Smardo, limiting the damage before tossing shutout frames across the fourth, fifth and seventh innings. Down 8-0, Rochelle broke its scoreless drought in the bottom of the fourth inning, where junior Ashley Knight scored on a passed ball and an RBI groundout from Smardo plated senior Kendal Ansteth, who singled earlier in the frame to jump-start the offense.

The Lady Hubs added two more runs in the bottom of the fifth inning, with Ansteth sending a two-run single into right-center field to make it an 8-4 game. After Morris tallied two runs on five singles in the top of the sixth inning, Rochelle rallied for four runs in the bottom half. Sophomore Addie Friestad reached on a fielder’s choice before Knight and Ansteth drew walks to load the bases for Lodico, who drove in two runners with her double to left-center field.

Smardo then drilled a two-run double to right-center that scored two more runs, bringing freshman Ella Alfano to the plate as the tying run. But a three-pitch strikeout ended the game.

Hubs knock off Kaneland for first I-8 victory

Rochelle netters rally for home win against LaSalle-Peru

ROCHELLE — With four matches completed, attention immediately turned to the No. 2 doubles court at Rochelle Township High School on Thursday, when Hub junior Peter Forsberg and sophomore Owen Haas found themselves in a grueling battle against LaSalle-Peru netters Traeger Abens and Andrew Bollis to decide the winner of the Interstate 8 Conference meet.

"We're feeling pretty good and I think our chemistry has improved over the last couple of weeks," Gilbert said. "I think I've improved a lot over our last few weeks and I've been a lot more consistent.

That will be the key for me moving forward. Staying consistent and not hurting ourselves during meets will be important for us and we need to give our best effort."

The Hubs took a 2-1 lead after play concluded on the No. 3 doubles court, where sophomore John Green and freshman Parker Lenkaitis took down Noah Sherman and Elijah Arthurs 6-0, 6-2. LaSalle-Peru evened the match with a win at No. 1 doubles, where Rochelle juniors Jason Zheng and Devansh Patel fell 2-6, 5-7 against Cavalier duo Adam Sarabia and Gavin Jonassen. Haas and Forsberg secured the third and deciding point with their No. 2 doubles victory.

Dominant doubles performances resulted in the first Interstate 8 Conference win of the season for the Hub varsity tennis team Tuesday evening, when Rochelle battled the Kaneland Knights on the road.

Rochelle swept Kaneland in doubles competition, refusing to drop a single set as the Hubs cruised to a 4-1 victory over the Knights. Juniors Jason Zheng and Devansh Patel shined in No. 1 doubles, defeating Caleb Hwang and Andy McEvoy 6-3, 6-1. Junior Peter Forsberg and sophomore Owen Haas held off Nathan Baumgartner and Matt Managus 6-4, 6-1 at No. 2 doubles.
