\$14 million project underway

Prologis Substation will increase distribution capacity, reliability

ROCHELLE — Any expenditure that comes before the Rochelle City Council has been researched, questioned and all the details pounded out. Then it's sent out for bids and the best, hopefully the lowest, bid is considered.

The council makes the final decisions, always. When Rochelle Municipal Utilities comes to the council, these are big-ticket items, but they're typically passed smoothly because the deep dive on the project has been done by the staff. RMU is the unsung hero of the "Hub City," without

it, all of our lives would be quite different. And it's a "jack of all trades and master of them all." They operate a state-of-the-art sewer treatment plant, internet, water and electricity all here in town. RMU can generate power in peak times which offsets the city's purchasing power with PJM Intercon-


nection, LLC (PJM), the city's regional transmission operator. To Rochelle residents, this means lower rates, but it also means quick customer service and problem solving. That's unique as many cities contract that out to other, and even private,

District moves on from closing school

ROCHELLE — In the end it was of little fanfare when the Rochelle Elementary School Board voted unanimously to close May School. Superintendent Jason Harper reminded the board

that in February he made a recommendation to close the building due to declining student enrollment in the district. Current projections put May School at half capacity next school year with that trending downward going forward. Harper added that the district will continue to

maintain the property. In March, the school board hosted a parent/community meeting to answer any questions of concerns. "My recommendation remains the same as it did a few months ago," Harper said. It's an interesting situation as the property legally

could go back to the developer's family if it's not used by the school district. That clause was put into place when the subdivision was developed roughly 60 years ago. Harper said they are working with the May family to figure out the details and the district continues to appreciate its

longstanding relationship with the May Family. Along with the closing of May School and the declining enrollment, the board voted to adopt an attendance center model for the district. This also was discussed at the March public meeting.

Hillcrest board votes on village improvements

HILLCREST — Hillcrest trustees voted to move forward with infrastructure improvements to the village water, sewer and roadway systems during their April meeting Wednesday evening. The improvements will include a new water tower, a new shallow well and a new water treatment plant as well as water, sewer

and roadway work on the south end of the village. The Hillcrest board is working with Baxter & Woodman Engineering to apply for grant funding to help pay for the project. The estimated overall cost for the 200,000-gallon water tower, the shallow well, the water treatment plant and the first phase of infrastructure work is \$5.24 million. Plans to improve the village infrastructure were paused in

April 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Phase 1A of the water, sewer and roadway improvements would include Scott Avenue, Errett Road and Erickson Road. If the village cannot secure enough grant funding, trustees said they would consider diving up the work further to spread out the cost of work. Trustees received a low bid of \$39,941 from AC Pavement Striping Company in Elgin for seal coat work on the north side

of the village this summer. The bid was roughly 5 percent below the estimated cost for the project. Trustees approved an annexation agreement, special use permit and two fencing variances for a 226-acre solar farm, Rochelle Solar LLC, off Twombly Road. Village President Jason Fore announced that Randy Salsbury will serve as president pro tem for the near future. The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, May 12 at 7 p.m.

Aging rural population needs more attention

SPRINGFIELD — Improving quality of life for the aging rural population requires a focus on digital literacy, integrated services and social connection.

The Rural Health Summit group recommends the following actions to improve health and quality of life for older rural residents:

Utilize technology to enhance the capacity and digital literacy of rural communities to better treat chronic conditions through telehealth and telemonitoring.

Invest research and program funds in designing rural-specific models for the aging population that align sectors to provide integrated, personalized and comprehensive services.

Address social isolation among the rural

elderly populations by implementing social isolation screenings and community-based programs.


The Rural Health Summit will host a webinar on April 22 at noon to discuss the issues faced by aging rural residents.

“These policy recommendations aim to address both the preexisting conditions and acute challenges caused by Covid-19 for our aging rural population,” said Dr. Sameer Vohra, chair of SIU Medicine Department of Population Science and Policy. “Conversations with statewide experts uncovered a great need but also a huge capacity and drive for innovation in our rural communities. We hope leaders from across the state will collaborate to help close health disparities faced by older rural residents.”

The policy recom-

mendations are the result of discussions from rural health stakeholders, community leaders, legislators, physicians and experts from organizations from throughout Illinois and build on the Rural Health Summit’s initial report, “Building a Healthier Rural Illinois: Understanding and Addressing the Challenges of Covid-19.”

The Rural Health Summit will release monthly topic-specific policy briefs and host corresponding webinars through January 2022 on topics of mental health, public health systems, nutrition and fitness, children’s growth and development, workforce development, opioids, health and housing and economic development. Additionally, the Department of Population Science and Policy is presenting the 21st Annual SIH/SIU Health Policy Institute – The Covid-19 Pandemic and Its Impact of Health Policy: A Renewed Focus on Healthy and Equitable Communities on June 8, 2021

Youth need to be prepared

SPRINGFIELD — Emergencies and disasters can happen at any time and anywhere. Disaster planning, response and recovery efforts should always take into account the unique needs of children, who make up roughly a quarter of the United States’ population. That is why this month, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) and the Office of the State Fire Marshal Office (OSFM) are taking steps to promote youth preparedness.

“Each year, millions of children are impacted by disasters,” said IEMA Director Alicia Tate-Nadeau. “Studies have shown, children are positive influencers in their households. Children can effectively bring the

message of preparedness home to their families. Participating in youth preparedness programs empowers children to become leaders at home and in their schools and communities.”

Kids practice fire drills each year at school, and families should practice these drills at home too, explained Illinois State Fire Marshal Matt Perez. “The office of the state fire marshal encourages families to practice their home fire escape plan twice a year. Every home needs working smoke alarms and a well-thought-out fire escape plan. Make sure all members of your family can identify two ways out of each room and a family meeting spot outside the home.”

Sparky the Fire Dog is mascot of The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). Sparky is used to help educate kids and parents on fire prevention and safety. The NFPA has established a Sparky website and Facebook page that offers a wealth of age-appropriate games, videos, apps and other activities that make learning about fire safety easy and fun.

Children who are prepared experience less anxiety and feel more confident during actual emergencies and disasters. Use this month as an opportunity to promote interactive activities within your family. One way to do this is by involving children in the development of a family emergency plan.

In other business, the board approved a cash rent agreement of \$230 for the 14 tillable farm land surrounding Lincoln School. Harper explained that Gensler Farms has been farming the acreage since the district purchased the land. The terms of the agreement have remained the same for the past three years.

The board voted to raise kindergarten registration fee from \$58.50 to \$60 for the upcoming school year. This fee includes the cost of milk.

The budget will go on public display shortly, with a few amendments. Harper explained that last fall the district didn't know what the revenues and expenditures would be, so they've since "tightened

up" the final budget prior to its approval.

The end of the school year is approaching, Harper informed the board that the last day students will be in the classroom will be May 26, which is a Wednesday.

On May 27, the teachers will utilize their last remote learning planning day. They were given a total of five of these days from the state and they'll use the time to pack up their rooms as some teachers will be switching buildings and classrooms. Then May 28 will be a teachers' institute day.

Just before adjourning, Harper informed the board that there has been really good interest in summer school and they'll be serving more students than ever.

Planning some boating? Brush up on safety first

SPRINGFIELD — Boaters are heading out on the water on pleasant spring days, and Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Conservation Police are reminding boat owners and operators to check their watercraft and their safety checklist to avoid encountering problems on Illinois lakes and rivers this boating season.

"No matter when you are on the water this season, make the safety of you, your passengers and other boaters your most important consideration," said IDNR Office of Law Enforcement Director Timothy Tyler.

"Review a boating safety checklist, and make sure your boat is tuned up and ready for the season before you back down the boat ramp or push off from the dock."

• Coast Guard-approved life jackets/per-

sonal flotation devices (PFDs) for everyone onboard, and all persons under age 13 must wear a PFD while a vessel is underway • If the boat is 16 feet or longer, it must have a throwable flotation device (ring, cushion with straps) available • Working fire extinguisher properly charged

- Working horn and a whistle
- Navigation lights must function properly
- Fresh flares (whether required or not)
- Current proof of registration/copy of registration application (if required).

IDNR Conservation Police strictly enforce boating safety laws and regulations, patrolling

Illinois lakes, rivers and other waterways throughout the year to encourage safe boating and prevent boating accidents, injuries and fatalities.

Last year, IDNR Conservation Police investigated 81 boating accidents involving 36 injuries and 21 fatalities.

Conservation police issued 863 citations and

more than 3,200 warnings to boaters – and arrested more than 100 boaters on charges of operating under the influence (OUI).

"Wearing life jackets and staying sober while operating a boat are two of the most important things boaters in Illinois must do – for their safety and the safety of others," Tyler said.

"Our officers aggressively enforce the law against operating a boat under the influence. Our message to boat operators is simple: You booze, you lose."

While in high school, he came with many other teenaged men to work the summers at Del Monte in Rochelle.

His love for the town brought him back where he lived the rest of his life. He worked 30 years for Armour Swift-Eckrich (beginning the first day they opened in Rochelle).

He retired on a Friday and on Monday began his next 18 years with Kishwaukee College until his retirement on Jan. 1, 2008. The next day he had a major stroke.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and a founding father of the Northern Illinois Tres Dias movement in Illinois where he served on approximately 53 teams to help spread the Christian renewal weekends to thousands of men.

He worked for other renewal movements in Indiana, Iowa and Wisconsin. His inspiring talks about his little green wheelbarrow helped to enlarge the Lord's



kingdom.

He taught Sunday School off and on most of his adult life. Many teenagers thought he was the best CIA "Quiet Control" agent they knew.

His happiest days were with family and fishing on vacation with family and friends.

The gentle giant of a man married Connie Stroud-Miller Garrison in 1983 and became the step-dad to Marco (Bretta) Miller of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and Brook (BJ) Miller of Dixon; he was Papa to Zach Miller of Leadville, Colo., Autumn Philp of Cedar Falls, Iowa, and Ben and Quinn Miller of Dixon; and Big Papa to great-grandson, Oaklee Pickering, also of Cedar Falls.

He is survived by his brother, Bille Garrison of Steward; sisters, MayBell Garrison and Marie McCosh of West Plains, Mo., plus several nieces and nephews. He's also survived by his daughter from his first marriage, Michelle Dolley of Lynchburg, Va.

A special thanks to hospice helpers, Sheila and Stephanie. You became family members who helped us travel this journey. Thank you will never be enough.

Soil temps and moisture declining

C H A M P A I G N — Colder weather the second week of April has caused soil temperatures to decline in Illinois, according to Jennie Atkins, Water and Atmospheric

Resources Monitoring (WARM) program manager at the Illinois State Water Survey.

Soils cooled as colder weather moved into the state the second week

of the month, falling 6 degrees.

Soil moisture at 4 inches averaged 0.33 water fraction by volume (WFOV) on April 15, slightly below field capacity for most of

the soils monitored. Rains the second week led to increases in all regions of the state.

Overall, levels have declined 6 percent from April 1 on average.

entities. It's why you read about other areas being without electricity for several hours if not days.

The City of Rochelle and RMU have been able to see around corners and stay a step ahead of other communities.

So, when it was decided that the city needed another substation to assist the other two with electrical distribution, the staff began the long and tedious process which occurred before Prologis Park Substation went before the

council.

The end result is what is going to be a nearly \$14 million project on the south edge of town, off Ritchie Road and Ritchie Court. It'll be located in a primarily industrial area of town and serve current

factories as well as attract future industry.

"It's probably one of the biggest jobs done in the city in a long time," said Adam Lanning, RMU Superintendent.

So, what is a substation? A substation takes the

high voltage electricity that comes over the power lines from ComEd and transforms it into a lower

voltage for distribution to Rochelle's residents, businesses and industry. Lanning explained that the city used to own the power lines coming into town, but recently sold them to ComEd for roughly \$20 million. Much of that money went into RMU's electric department while some went into the city's general fund.

The project will begin next month and the city's portion should be done by December of this year. The ComEd has a portion they have to contribute the project, so the plan is to have it up and running in one year.

The cost is steep and over a bit budget, but that's only because the cost of raw materials went up drastically in the past year. Lanning said both plastic and copper are up over 300 percent over last year. "I'm used to a project being 5 to 7 percent over budget, but this is 12 percent,"

Lanning said.

Rochelle City Manager Jeff Fiegenschuh reassured the council that there are funds to cover the additional cost for the substation. "Large industries expect our electricity to be up and running at all times ... this is cash funded, even though it's over budget, we have the cash to pay for it," Fiegenschuh said.

Half of the cost is material, but the other half is construction and installation. Last Monday, the council approved the bid of \$6,935,150 to Whittaker Construction.

Lanning said the material was ordered last summer to ensure it would be on hand before the project began.

What will Rochelle residents gain from this new substation?

"Residents will see improved reliability ... it's a strong investment in our community and we'll be able to provide reliable power for our residential, industrial and commercial customers," Lanning concluded.

EMBALMING PROCESS

The embalming process essentially involves replacing the blood and other bodily fluids with a preservative such as formaldehyde. Embalming is required by law only under certain circumstances, but families that intend to have a public viewing of the body usually choose to have it done, embalming preservative powers give them more leeway in scheduling a funeral. Embalmers are adept at restoring natural features that have been injured or to people who die after a long illness. They have a range of techniques to deal with various difficulties. They can replace missing hair, rebuild fractured features, or disguise the effects of

the drastic weight loss from a long, wasting illness. Before it is placed in the casket, the body is dressed and prepared for viewing. Hair is shampooed and set, and men get a shave. Families are sometimes encouraged to bring in a recent photograph of the deceased to help guide them.

The Problem with Feelings

I’ve learned from experience that feelings are fickle. One day they can be up, one day they can be down, and other days they are just all over the place!

God gave us feelings, and they are not wrong in and of themselves—they are an important part of enjoying life. We don’t need to deny that we have them, but we do need to prevent them from controlling us.

In 1 Corinthians 3:3 (AMPC), the apostle Paul is talking to new Christians, and he says, “For you are still [unspiritual, having the nature] of the flesh [under the control of ordinary impulses].”

The flesh is our desires—what we want, think and feel. And Romans 8:8 says that “those who are

living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please or satisfy God, or be acceptable to Him.”

The Bible is saying that always doing what we feel like doing will hinder us from doing what God wants us to do. We need to get to the place in life where we are not controlled by our emotions so we won’t miss out on His good plan for our lives.

I realize that some people are more emotional than others. However, with God’s help, we can get to the point where we obey God and do what His Word says to do —regardless of our feelings.

Let me give you an example. I was sexually abused by my father for years. My mother even-

tually found out but never confronted him because she was afraid of him. Needless to say, the abuse and pain I endured as a child deeply affected me, and it took years for me to experience the emotional healing I desperately needed so I could truly forgive my parents.

When they reached a point where they needed someone to help take care of them, the Lord spoke to my heart that He wanted us to bring my parents to St. Louis, buy them a house, and take care of them until they died. I shared it with Dave, secretly hoping he would resist the idea. But he said, “If you think this is what God is leading you to do, then we better obey

Him.”

We didn’t have a lot of money in the bank, and it was going to take most of it to do what God was asking. But the more I prayed, the more the Lord made it clear that He wanted us to take good care of them and treat them as if they had been the best parents in the world.

So we moved my parents to a house just eight minutes away from us, bought them a car and furniture, and met their every need. My father showed some appreciation, but he still remained the same mean and cranky man he had always been.

But one morning, three years after we had moved them to St. Louis, my mother called to say my father had been crying all week and asked if we could come over. Dave and I went, and that day my fa-

ther asked me to forgive him for what he had done to me as a child. He also asked Dave to forgive him.

We assured him that we had forgiven him and asked if he wanted to ask God to forgive him and begin a relationship with Jesus Christ. He said yes, and we all prayed right there on the spot. Ten days later, I had the great honor of baptizing my father at church!

I can truly say that for the next four years, prior to his death at age 86, I saw a true change in my father. I know without a doubt that he’s in Heaven. My mother had asked my forgiveness years before this, and I had the joy of knowing her last years were peaceful.

Now, when the Lord asked me to help my parents, I certainly didn’t feel like doing it. I had a choice to obey Him and do what I knew was right or follow my feelings and miss out on what He wanted to do in their lives and mine in the process.

I want you to take a moment and think about this: Are your feelings preventing you from doing something God has asked you to do? In the moment, it may seem that getting “your way” is more important or that you’ll be giving up too much if you go along with God’s plan.

But the truth is while you can’t always control how you feel, with God’s help, you can control what you do. And when you obey God, He always rewards you beyond anything you can imagine.

I encourage you to pray and ask the Lord for strength in this area. Ask for His help to choose His will over what you want, think or feel in the moment. Because you’ll never regret making good decisions, doing things God’s way!


Taxing should be fair for all

The area I grew up in — the desert Southwest — is in a horrible drought. And the heat, always bad, has been unbearable according to family and friends.

It never rained much where I am from. The annual rainfall in my hometown of Yuma, Ariz., is about 3.5 inches. We can get that in a couple of hours during a big summer storm here. In Oregon, the annual rainfall is 36 inches. Big difference.

But things are even worse than usual back home. The drought that has been plaguing the Western U.S. has reached a point where some scientists are saying the region is on the verge of permanent drought, according to published reports.

That is not good, obviously. While it is desert, the part of the country I am from is a huge agricultural center. Winter produce, especially lettuce, comes from the area. So those salads you enjoy could be in danger.

This drought is a combination of the natural dry cycle and climate change. Yes, climate change caused by humans.

This drought could have severe consequences not only for our food supply, but also for vacation meccas like Las Vegas. This drought includes Denver, Colo., Salt Lake City, Utah and Los Angeles, Calif. It is very widespread.

In other climate news, just last week, Scientific American magazine announced that it would stop using the term "climate change" in reference to man-made global warming and instead use "climate emergency."

The reason? The magazine said the climate emergency is here. Now. All around us.

Floods in California, massive hurricanes, record-cold that killed

power in Texas. Yes, this is a climate emergency.

They said we are facing a grave threat. By "we" they mean the human race. This is real, folks. This is not some wacky tree hugger fantasy aimed at killing the economy. It is a changing climate that could not only really kill the economy, but also kill us. Thankfully, we have mostly moved past people saying this isn't real. Sure, some still hold onto that, but the evidence is too strong to ignore reality.

So, this year my birthday and Earth Day, the news was not so good for the planet. Even if we take the drastic steps needed to help the climate now, I won't be around for the good news. But I hope you are, and your grandchildren are. If we continue to do nothing, that becomes less likely.



three trauma rooms, two isolation rooms and three holding bays for patients waiting for results. Five fast-track rooms are designed to quickly treat patients with mild ailments and injuries, such as sore throat, urinary tract infections and sprained ankles.

A behavioral health suite features four treatment bays designed to promote safety for patients and staff. When a bay is being used for a behavioral health patient, an overhead door will be lowered to ensure the patient is protected from any equipment that could be used to cause self-harm.

"Our physicians, nurses, patient care technicians and ancillary staff were all intricately involved in the planning and design of this project with one goal in mind, our patients. It was designed to bring the highest quality of care to our patients that ensures safety, efficiency and overall positive experience," said Andrew Oleksyn, DO, medical director, Northwestern Medicine Kishwaukee Hospital Emergency Department.

New medical equipment will be installed, including new stretchers and a second pneumatic tube station to efficiently send specimens to the lab. An

overflow area, equipped with medical gas, will accommodate additional patients if needed during a surge event. Additionally, a dedicated Security Services office will be embedded within the emergency department.

"The new layout of the department will offer more privacy and a quiet, healing environment, while supporting collaboration and teamwork with our staff and clinicians," said Kristen Tindall, MSN, RN, CEN, manager, Northwestern Medicine Kishwaukee Hospital Emergency

Department. "This redesign provides versatile spaces that can meet the unique needs of all our patients,"

The project is scheduled to take place in three phases over 16 months to allow optimal emergency department operations during construction.

Signage will direct patients to temporary waiting areas, and a relocated entrance when necessary. The timeline is subject to change based on review time by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).

SYCAMORE — The Rochelle Hub varsity football team did its best to contain the undefeated Sycamore Spartans when the two Interstate 8 Conference foes squared off Friday night.



Wyka rolls first career 300 game

WITH one shot remaining for a chance at history, T-Byrd Lanes owner Dan Wyka calmly went through his normal routine as dozens of close friends and fellow league bowlers watched the 60-year-old Rochelle resident attempt to complete the first perfect game of his career.

Armed with the Motiv Golden Jackal he's owned for about three years, Wyka showed dominance over his first two games of league action Monday evening, rolling 246 in the opening game before striking in the first nine frames of his second game to shoot 267. Wyka continued to strike in the third game, staying perfect through his first ball in the 10th frame.

It was then that Wyka could feel the noise calming inside the house as bowlers stopped playing and watched from a distance as he looked to close out the perfect game. With his head down and his focus solely on the lanes, Wyka confidently struck on his 11th ball before stepping up once again and throwing perhaps the biggest shot of his lifelong bowling career.

"After I threw my 10th strike, I didn't look at anybody when I turned around," Wyka said. "I looked at the ball return and waited for my ball to come back so I could clean it like I always do. I set my pace, threw my next ball and I struck again. I turned around again and kept my head down because I could tell people had stopped bowling. I wanted to stay focused, so I went back to the ball return, cleaned my ball, set my feet and threw one of my best balls of the night."

Wyka's final ball of the evening was a no-doubter, with all 10 pins falling back into the pit as the number 300 appeared on the scoreboard. With perfection achieved, Wyka raised his fists to the ceiling in excitement as longtime friend and teammate Jim Lyles ran onto the approach for a warm embrace. The perfect game secured an 813 series, the first 800 series of Wyka's career.

"The place just erupted," Wyka said. "To finally bowl a 300 and an 800 series at 60 years old was really exciting. It meant everything to see all the bowlers come down and congratulate me. We all support each other, especially when someone has a chance to shoot 300. I'm happy that our bowlers are back and we're able to bowl

again... I wasn't as nervous as much as I was in the past. I'm not sure if it was because I was bowling well or not, but I didn't get nervous this time."

When Wyka stepped onto the approach in the 10th frame, it was the first time he had a chance to shoot 300 in roughly 12 years. But for Wyka, who's previous high score was 299 and who'd carried multiple potential perfect games into the final frame in the past, achieving perfection in his bowling center while nearly 50 league bowlers watched was a memory he'll cherish forever.

"To be at my home and to do it with the people I've been bowling with, week after week, for the last several years really meant a lot," Wyka said. "We weren't really focusing on throwing a perfect game. My teammates and I were joking and laughing all night and nobody brought it up. I was just throwing the ball and I think that's why it was easier for me to stay focused."

Sycamore shuts down Rochelle in I-8 semis

Hubs fall 10-0, will face Morris for third place this weekend

SYCAMORE — The Rochelle Hub varsity soccer team hung tough during the first half of Wednesday's Interstate 8 Conference tournament semifinal match against Sycamore. But the fast and talented Spartan attack was simply too much for the Hubs to handle in the end.

With a mild wind at its back, Sycamore scored on a corner kick in the 41st minute, effectively sealing the fate of the Hubs, who conceded seven second-half goals to the Spartans in a 10-0 loss. Rochelle (5-5-1) will face Morris for third place in the conference on Saturday at 10 a.m. All conference finals and consolation matches will be played at Rochelle Township High School.

"I thought we held them off for a while, but they have a big, strong team," head coach Brad Male said. "It wasn't a surprise that they were faster than us, but they were able to capitalize on a couple of through balls. We moved the ball well, but they were just quicker than us."

After missing a few chances at the net, Sycamore struck first during the sixth minute, using a cross from the right wing and scoring to take a 1-0

lead. With center backs Damian Salinas and Bryce Whitehead leading the Hub defense, Rochelle held the Spartans at bay for nearly 20 minutes before Sycamore scored on a breakaway through ball in the 25th minute. Using their speed to their advantage, Sycamore capitalized on another breakaway in the 39th minute.

"No matter what happens and regardless of the score, we have to keep playing until the end of the game," Male said. "I think that will be our key for the Morris matchup. We were a player down the last time we played Morris, but we need to keep moving the ball how we did over the second half of the season. We need to look for the open player and keep communicating."

Leading 3-0 at halftime and 4-0 after the corner-kick goal from the southeast flag, Sycamore began pouring on the shots as Rochelle struggled to keep pace with the fast-moving Spartans. Back-to-back goals in the 47th and 49th minutes put Sycamore ahead 6-0 before another goal in the 56th minute put a shortened clock in effect. The Spartans never let up in the second half, scoring in the 57th, 61st and 66th minutes to cruise into the Interstate 8 finals on Saturday.

Defense shines during Huskie spring showcase

Rain doesn't deter NIU during spirited scrimmage

DEKALB — On a rainy Saturday in DeKalb, the Northern Illinois University Huskies spent the majority of the Huskie Spring Showcase in scrimmage situations as several hundred fans watched from the Huskie Stadium stands.

While the offense had its moments during the 11-on-11 action, especially early, the defense ended the day on top and was able to watch while the offense ran following practice, in a reverse of the previous Saturday's result.

"We came out offensively and were able to make some plays, and then the defense got some momentum," said NIU head coach Thomas Hammock. "That's what you want to see you want to see give and take. If you have give and take, then you know you have a good football team."

After running through 15 minutes of individual drills, the Huskies scrimmaged for all but 10 minutes of the 1:50 minute workout, working on third and fourth down and short situations early before moving into goal line, red zone and move the ball periods from various spots on the field.

Freshman safety Devin Lafayette (Brunswick, Georgia/Brunswick HS) grabbed a pair of interceptions during practice, while fellow safety Joshua Earl (Naperville/Neuqua Valley HS) and linebacker Nick Rattin (Palatine/Fremd HS) also recorded

interceptions during the scrimmage sessions. The practice concluded on an INT as cornerback Zhamaine March (Detroit, Michigan/East English Village Prep) out-wrestled Messiah Travis (Chicago/Solorio Academy) on a jump ball in the end zone.

"That's excellent work by the defense," Hammock said. "We want to get the ball. The defense made plays and that's what we want to do. We want to take the ball away and make plays."

Hammock said Saturday's practice showed that 1. The defense has caught on to some of the offense's calls during spring and 2. The - primarily - young secondary has made impressive strides this spring.

"We have guys that are stepping up," Hammock said. "You look at the two safeties today in Devin Lafayette and Jordan Hansen, Josh Earl made a nice play, and then our corners are playing excellent, guys like Myles McGee, Eric Rogers, Jordan Gandy and then Zhamaine March made the play at the end of the day. I think they are really going to be a weapon for us and our secondary is going to be a strength of our defense."

Offensively, the Huskies were especially effective during goal line situations, while Fabian McCray set up one touchdown with a long reception and scored another during "move the ball" periods. The second-year

freshman has impressed this spring, according to Hammock and gives NIU an even deeper group of talented wide receivers.

"[Fabian McCray] has had an excellent spring practice," Hammock said. "He's really matured, he's gotten better, and he's making the jump. We have a lot of guys that can play wide receiver and we are excited about all of them. You can't just single out one guy, we've got Tyrice [Richie], Cole Tucker, Trayvon Rudolph,

Messiah Travis, Mohamed Toure, Jeremiah Howard, Fabian McCray. We have a deep wide receiver group; we have to get them the ball and they'll make plays for us."

In charge of getting them the ball — behind a wall build by the offensive line — is quarterback Rocky Lombardi (Clive, Iowa/Valley HS), who has risen to the top spot on the QB depth chart, according to Hammock. Lombardi, Rodney Thompson (San Diego, California/St. Au-

gustine HS) and Dustin Fletcher (Flint, Michigan/Carmen-Ainsworth HS) all took snaps under center on Saturday with Lombardi working with the ones.

"Rocky has established himself [as the top QB]," Hammock said. "Ethan [Hampton] will be back [this week] and we'll get him up to speed, but he's certainly a guy that we think can continue to progress forward."

With three practices left in spring ball, the Huskies'

third-year head coach was pleased with what he saw Saturday but knows it was just one more step in the improvements he expects to see this spring.

"We're trying to keep moving forward on schedule and I think that's important for us," Hammock said. "Today was another practice, it was fun to have people in the stands, there was weather. The guys will watch the film and then we'll come back next week and try to improve on what we did today."


