## Welcome back

Senior center reopening Monday

ROCHELLE — After nearly a year of closed doors, the Hub City Senior Center is reopening.

“We are opening on Monday but are easing back into activities,” center director Connie Dougherty said.

The center will be open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Seniors are welcome to come in for coffee, to visit and to play pool.

According to Dougherty, under advisement from the Ogle County Health Department, there will be no Bingo, quilting, woodworking Movie Day or birthday parties. Lunch is also not being served yet.

“We will gradually add these activities back in,” Dougherty said.

With the reopening there are new rules and regulations that visitors will need to follow as well, including the initial change to the hours of operation. The maximum capacity will also be 50 people.

Other rules and regulations include:

Masks must be worn at all times, both when entering and exiting the facility, as well as for the duration while in the building. If unable to wear a mask, please stay home.

Everyone will maintain social distancing at all times, which means staying six-feet from each other unless you are members of the same household.

Upon entering the building each person’s name and contact information will be recorded and temperature will be taken. If a person has a fever of 100 degrees or more, they will not be allowed to enter. Likewise, if a person has symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or has had exposure to someone with COVID-19, they are asked to stay home.

Anyone exhibiting symptoms throughout their time at the senior center will be asked to leave.

## Man arrested on sexual assault charges

OREGON — A Hillcrest man was arrested Thursday by Ogle County Sheriff’s deputies and charged with predatory criminal sexual assault of a child and aggravated criminal sexual abuse.

Deputies arrested Jody T. Willis, 44, of Hillcrest, on two counts of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child — Class X Felonies — and four counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse — Class 2 Felonies — according to court records.

The arrest stems from an investigation the Ogle County Sheriff’s Office began in August of 2020 in which Willis is alleged to have sexual contact with a female minor.

On Friday, Willis posted 10 percent of the \$500,000 bond and was released from jail.

## Going out to the Boundary Waters

WHILE winter is just ending and spring just beginning, plans for summer are already in motion for Rochelle Police Department Detective John Kaltenbach. Specifically, a trip to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness for a group of youth that takes place in July.

Kaltenbach began taking trips to the BWCAW when he was a kid and Gary Cater – former Ashton High School principal - and Bob Rohr – former Ashton High School teacher - used to take a group of kids on trips up north. Since then, he has continued going to the BWCAW with family and friends every year. Kaltenbach introduced local youth to the Boundary Waters more than a decade

ago when he took the first group of kids on the trip thanks to donations from area groups, organizations and the City of Rochelle.

“This trip helps us [officers] build a better relationship with kids in the community and give them a positive experience that they won’t forget,”

Kaltenbach said. He hopes the department is able to continue providing this opportunity to kids in the community.

In previous years the groups chosen were students that were eligible due to good behavior at home as well as having no trouble within the commu-

nity – involving negative contact with the police department. And most times the kids chosen weren’t necessarily friends or even close acquaintances.

Last year’s group; however, thanks to COVID, was a little trickier to choose because students weren’t physically attending classes and not obtaining a normal school experience in general – specifically the senior class at the high school.

“Since the seniors weren’t getting to have a lot of their normal high school experiences I decided to choose a group of just seniors,” Kaltenbach said. “I ended up taking a group of kids that were all friends who had just graduated. They all got along.”

The group included Seth Gould, Nick Albers, Gavin Ansteth, Gyvanziel Quinonez, Ethan Etes and Diego Escobar. Along with

Kaltenbach, local attorney Russ Crull accompanied the group as a chaperone.

“I enjoy going on the trip to be a better part of and more invested in the Rochelle community. Rochelle has been so welcoming to me over the last few years and this trip allows me to give back in a small way,” Crull said. “I enjoy being able to introduce young people to the great outdoors, something that has been a passion of mine my whole life.”

Crull has gone on the trip twice now.

Leaving Rochelle on July 14, the group traveled in two vehicles up to Northern Minnesota. Before heading out to camp, the group spent time at Canadian Border Outfitters in Ely, Minnesota. This is where the group gets permits and any last-minute supplies for the week-long wilderness adventure.

“We spend the night before we head out to our campsite for the week,” Kaltenbach said.

After arriving at the Canadian Border Outfitters the group took their last hot showers and drank the last cold beverages they would enjoy for the next week, because BWCAW is part of the Superior National Forest in which no combustion motors are allowed. The only way in or out of the area is by canoe or hiking. The only supplies campers have are the items carried in a canoe and on backpack through the woods to the next lake. Tents are the only form of covered shelter and canoes are the mode of transportation.

The next morning the group boarded towboats for a ride through the first nine miles of connecting lakes where motors are allowed. They would then use canoes to get to their final destination where they would set up camp for the week.

Going on the trip means working as a group. Everyone in the group participated in everything from cooking to navigation to doing their own laundry and washing their own dishes. A team effort meant sharing the load and working to make sure that the gear was divided appropriately and that the team worked together to reach goals each day.

“Unfortunately, in the age we live in, I think the kids really struggle with even the brief detachment from their electronics and social media. This trip allows these kids to enjoy the outdoors without distraction and focus on the fun activities at hand,” Crull said. “My favorite part of the trip is being able to teach the kids more about fishing.”

Meal time was also a

group effort.

“We ate good... I took up extra stuff because I knew these were 18-year-old kids. Instead of just taking one pack of pancake mix I took two. We were like, we’ll challenge you guys to eat all the pancakes,” Kaltenbach said.

Dehydrated meals were part of some of the provisions brought along and fish that the campers caught.

“Some of the kids said they didn’t like fish but after trying fresh-caught and prepared fish, they changed their mind,” Kaltenbach joked. “They said it didn’t even taste like fish they had had before.”

Along with fishing, the kids spent time swimming in the lake. On one specific day, Kaltenbach recalled that one of the boys decided he would swim from their side of the lake to an island across the lake.

“It ended up being a lot further than he thought it was,” he said. “He made it tho.”

The trip often teaches the kids about teamwork and last summer’s trip was no exception from years’ past. Teamwork was proven on the day the group traveled out of camp back to the outfitter’s post.

“The day we left camp it was extremely windy and the water was really rough and choppy,” Kaltenbach explained. “It was a challenge to get the canoes to the pick-up point and the guys were snapping at each other and giving up... The mental and physical part of coming out under extreme weather – which we fought off the entire time we were there. The first day we were there was beautiful blue skies like this and we no sooner go to camp and got slammed by a storm before we could even get the tents set up... We had challenges the entire time. With all the challenges the students faced on the trip, they always pulled through and got the job done. There is no doubt that they are physically and emotionally stronger.”

During a Rochelle City Council meeting following the trip, the students were given the opportunity to talk about their experiences on the trip.

“This trip was amazing and honestly one of the best times I’ve had in my entire life. Everything from the fishing to the people to the experience, the harsh conditions. The great team building that the harsh conditions on the way back built... It’s a great experience for everybody and I actually will head back soon,” Seth Gould said.

### Donations

The trip would not be possible without contributions from various donors.

Donors of last summer’s trip included monetary donations from Flag Township and the City of Rochelle for allowing the trip through the police department.

“Without help from the community, this trip wouldn’t happen,” Kaltenbach said. “I am grateful for the donations.”

## Deputies respond to several accidents

On March 2 at 9:54 a.m., the Ogle County Sheriff's Office, Forreston Police Department, Forreston Fire Department and the Forreston Ambulance responded to a two vehicle accident with injuries on Illinois Route 26 at Coffman Road. A Ford F250 pulling an enclosed trailer was following a red Ford Fusion southbound on Illinois Route 26. The Ford Fusion slowed to make a left turn onto Coffman Road when the Ford F250 failed to yield to the Ford Fusion. The Ford F250 rear ended the Ford Fusion causing the Ford Fusion to cross over Illinois Route 26 and come to a stop in the east ditch. The Ford F250 came to a stop on the roadway. The driver of the Ford Fusion, Roger F. Kilker, 84, of Forreston, and his passenger, Audrey R. Kilker, 83, of Forreston, were transported to Freeport Memorial Hospital by Forreston EMS and Freeport EMS with minor injuries. The driver of the Ford F250, Daniel P. Reif, 54, of St. Paul, Minnesota, refused medical attention. Reif was issued a citation for failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.

On March 2 at 1:53 p.m., deputies conducted a traffic stop in the 20,000 block of East Illinois Route 64. After an investigation, deputies arrested Kelly Truell, 31, of DeKalb, for driving without a license and speeding. Truell was given an I-bond for his citations and was released from the scene.

On March 2 at approximately 2:51 p.m., deputies responded to the 5,000 block of South Lowden Road in reference to a traffic crash. An S10 truck driven by Tobias Knapp, 21, of Sterling, was northbound on South Lowden Road, approximately one-half mile south of Lighthouse Road. He was attempting to pass another vehicle in a double yellow no passing zone. It struck a 2500 Chevrolet truck head on that was travelling southbound. The 2500 was driven by James Bertsch, 61, of rural Oregon. Neither driver sustained injuries. Both vehicles had to be towed from the scene. Knapp was cited for improper passing and fail to reduce speed to avoid an accident and given a March 31 court date in Oregon. The Ogle County Sheriff's Department was assisted by Oregon Fire Department and Ambulance.

On March 3 at approximately 10:15 p.m., Ogle County deputies responded to the 500 block of South Ash Avenue in Forreston in reference to a disturbance. After investigation, deputies arrested Steven Croffoot, 26, of Pearl City, for disorderly conduct and resisting a peace officer. Croffoot was transported to the Ogle County Jail where he was released to correctional staff and held in lieu of bond.

On March 4 at approximately 9:30 a.m., Ogle County deputies responded to the Ogle County Probation department. After an investigation it was learned that Rueben C. Burgess, 31, of Rochelle, had defrauded a drug screening test. Burgess was placed under arrest for defrauding a drug and alcohol screening test and transported to the Ogle County Jail where he was held in lieu of bond.

## Secretary of State announces current investor threats

**SPRINGFIELD** — Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White is urging investors to be wary of internet and social media schemes promoting precious metals, cryptocurrencies, promissory notes and foreign exchange markets. This week marks Consumer Protection Week and White reminds investors to contact the Securities Department to report investment fraud. “We expect to see more complaints from investors who have been lured into schemes offering the promise of high returns in order to supplement lost income due to the pandemic,” said Secretary White.

The North American Securities Administrators Association (NASAA), which includes the Illinois Securities Department, conducted a nationwide survey, which found fraudulent internet, or social media schemes as the top investor threat. Other top schemes included cryptocurrency-related and precious metals-based investments, foreign exchange-related schemes and investments involving foreign exchange and

cryptocurrency-related schemes disguised as membership or investment programs.

White said investment offers that sound “too good to be true” often share similar characteristics. The most common telltale sign of an investment scam is an offer of guaranteed high returns with no risk.

The NASAA survey, which included responses of enforcement officials throughout the United States, Canada and Mexico, also indicated that 82 percent of state and provincial securities regulators anticipate that fraudsters will continue to attempt to prey on investor fear and anxiety related to changes in financial markets and the economy due to COVID-19.

White reminds Illinois investors to verify that the salesperson and the investment itself are properly licensed or registered.

## Vaccine rollout, budget recovery plans and bill veto top Senate work this past week

**SPRINGFIELD** — Concerned with continuing reports of problems with Illinois’ COVID-19 vaccine rollout, Senate Republicans have been meeting with local health departments in recent weeks to determine how the system can be improved.

State Sen. Brian Stewart (R-Freeport) says what they found is that the Pritzker Administration needs to abandon its “go-it-alone” attitude and instead work with lawmakers and other state and local officials to make the vaccine rollout work for all Illinoisans.

After the Senate President’s office cancelled legislative session in Springfield this week, lawmakers met remotely and started moving legislation in virtual Senate committees. Members are expected to return to the Capitol next week.

In other news, Illinois restaurants, retailers and businesses are speaking out

against a specific component of Gov. J.B. Pritzker’s budget plan that will harm their attempts at recovery. Several Senate Republicans are also joining with local business and medical communities in asking Gov. Pritzker to veto a prejudgment interest bill passed during the waning hours of “lame-duck” session in January.

### Vaccine rollout

For months, Senate Republicans have called on the Pritzker Administration for more inclusion of the Legislature in all aspects of the COVID-19 pandemic response, including the state’s COVID-19 vaccination rollout. Seeking a solution, and acting on a suggestion by the Governor, Senators have been working with local health departments over the past several weeks, including a Zoom meeting last week with more than 40 county officials, to identify the major issues they are experiencing in getting vaccinations to their residents.

Based on local feedback, the Caucus produced a report outlining the biggest issues and suggestions from the local health departments. On March 4, Senate Republican Leader Dan McConchie (Hawthorn Woods) and Deputy Republican Leader Sue

Rezin (Morris) sent the report to the Governor, along with a letter asking that Pritzker consider the suggestions and begin to collaborate with local officials and lawmakers to make the vaccine rollout work for all Illinoisans.

### Restaurants, retailers oppose budget provision

On behalf of local restaurants, retailers and businesses, several Republican Senators are speaking out against a specific component of Gov. Pritzker’s Fiscal Year 2022 budget proposal.

In his budget plan, the Governor recommends reducing the Retail Discount, a critical mechanism in place that only partially reimburses our business community for collecting and transferring Illinois’ sales tax on behalf of state and local government.

What the Governor has carelessly labeled as a “corporate loophole” is actually the business community’s way of attempting to recoup just some of the costs they incur from administering and remitting the sales tax required by law. In fact, according to the Illinois Restaurant Association, every time a consumer uses an electronic form of payment, retailers must pay a processing fee of 2.25 percent plus ten cents to credit card companies. Meanwhile, the retail discount only covers 1.75 percent of that total cost. The numbers are clear, businesses are already taking a financial hit from providing services on behalf of the state.

A point of further concern is the fact that this is not the first time his Administration has attempted to make changes to Illinois’ retail discount. In 2019, an even more aggressive attempt to eliminate the retail discount was proposed under Gov. Pritzker’s leadership.

Senate Republicans argue that government-imposed shutdowns have decimated the business community, and the state should be helping create a landscape for them to rebuild rather than adding to their cost burdens.

### Governor urged to veto prejudgment interest bill

Speaking on behalf of the business and medical communities in their districts, several Republican Senators asked Gov. Pritzker this week to veto the prejudgment interest bill that was passed during the waning hours of the “lame-duck” session in January.

House Bill 3360 allows plaintiffs who win a personal injury or wrongful death case in court to be paid their judgment PLUS an additional nine percent interest on judgment dating from the time the defendant first learned of the injury.

If signed into law, House Bill 3360 would require the payment of prejudgment interest for costs that have not yet occurred and are not yet known, requiring employers to pay interest that could go back years. Meanwhile, the proposed measure would drive up healthcare costs at a time when medical providers are already overwhelmed and deter physicians from working in the state.

The Senators noted that businesses and medical providers are still reeling from the COVID-19 pandemic and the subsequent statewide shutdowns Gov. Pritzker unilaterally imposed on the state. As they are working to get back on their feet, Illinois’ job creators and healthcare industry cannot afford to have any new cost burdens placed on their shoulders, which would only further hamper their recovery.

House Bill 3360 was sent to the Governor on Feb. 4.

That’s because they are children, and their reactions to grief don’t match those of adults. That doesn’t mean children don’t feel grief or know that something sad or final or tragic has occurred. Children are highly attuned to the emotions of the people around them, but they grieve in their own way, and it’s important that adults recognize a child’s need for honesty, love, and reassurance when death occurs.

Sometimes adult’s

preoccupation with grief prevents them from seeing that a child’s reaction to death is just as deep as theirs – even though it may be expressed differently, depending on the child’s age and stage of emotional development.

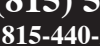

## Press past guilt and shame

**H**OW do you feel about yourself? Do you waste time feeling guilty about things in the past that you can't change?

I used to live with a constant, underlying sense of guilt. Because I was sexually abused by my father during my childhood, I grew up feeling that something must be wrong with me for him to want to do the things he did to me. This damage in my soul caused me to become ashamed of myself.

Guilt and shame are dangerous. Because when you live this way, you aren't just ashamed of something you've done or that's been done to you, you're ashamed of yourself. And it poisons everything else in your life.

But Romans 8:1 says, "There is now no condemnation [no guilty verdict, no punishment] for those who are in Christ Jesus [who believe in Him as personal Lord and Savior]" (AMP). This means it is not God's will for us to live with guilt and shame every day of our lives!

Facing the Truth That Led Me to Freedom

Giving up guilt and shame was not easy

for me. I had a really hard time believing that God loved me and that He wanted me to love myself. I don't mean that He wanted me to love myself in a selfish, self-centered, prideful way, but I had to accept God's love for me and love myself in a healthy way before I could love others.

I came to realize that most of the problems I had—the personality issues and unhealthy relationships—stemmed from the fact that I was ashamed of myself. The truth is when you don't like yourself, it's very difficult to get along with anyone else.

It was a life-changing revelation when God showed me that it was religion—not relationship with Christ—that makes us believe that it's right or good to feel bad about ourselves...to beat ourselves up for our mistakes and weaknesses.

God doesn't want us to live under the burden of guilt and condemnation because all this does is make us believe that we need to pay for our sin. And Jesus has already paid for it.

Second Corinthians 5:17 says, "If anyone

is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" (NIV). And verse 21 says that "God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

When we come to God and confess our sin, asking Him to forgive us, we become new creations in Him because of what Jesus has done. Jesus, who was perfect and never sinned, took the punishment for our sin so we could be made right with God and have a personal relationship with Him.

So when we refuse to give up guilt and shame by believing in what He's done for us, we're essentially saying, "Jesus, I don't think You did a good enough job, so I need to add my effort to try and make up for the mistakes I've made and get over this guilt." Our way of "paying" is feeling miserable and guilty.

The tragedy is, as long as we live this way, we will never enjoy the freedom we can have in Christ of being forgiven of our sin, and enjoy the good life He came to give

us (John 10:10). The key to pressing past guilt and shame was discovering the power in God's Word to overcome it. Eventually, as I spent time in prayer and Bible study, the truth renewed my mind and set me free (Romans 12:2; John 8:32).

I want to encourage you to read the scriptures I've shared in this teaching. Pray and ask God to help you agree with what He says more than how you feel or what you think about yourself based on your past. Study verses about His love for you, like John 3:16-17 and 1 John 4:8-16. Confess what God says about you: He loves you; He forgives you; He created you to be a unique, special, one-of-a-kind individual; and He has a wonderful plan for your life! (See Psalm 139:13-14; Jeremiah 29:11; Ephesians 2:8-10.)

If you will embrace who you are as a new creation in Christ and do your best each day to grow in your faith in God by studying His Word and seeking Him in prayer, you will make progress in becoming everything He made you to be. You will be free from guilt and shame...and have the life Jesus died to give you.

Solutions, anyone?

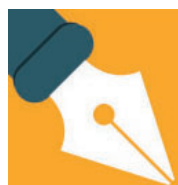

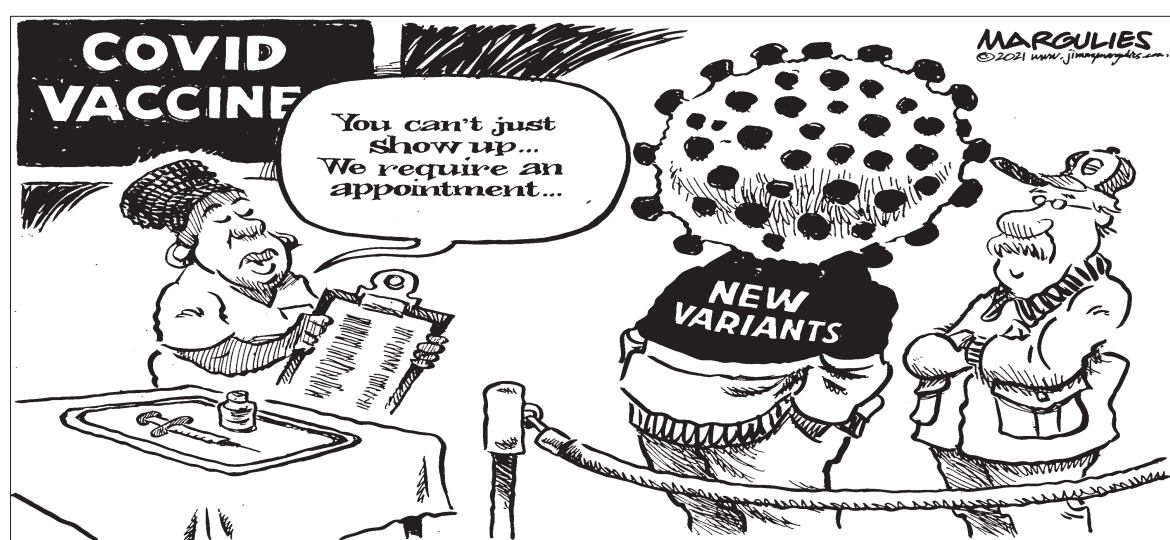

Life story last week. That seems like a pretty cool option to me.

I am opting to be cremated when the time comes. My mother did the same, and my dad spread her ashes in a beautiful part of the desert near where I grew up in Arizona. I am not sure where I want my ashes scattered, and I really feel like it doesn't matter. I won't be around to complain if they end up on River Road because my Harley riding friends accidentally spilled them on a memorial ride.

My dad is moving from my hometown soon, so I probably won't have a reason to visit again. There will be no

real connection there for me. So, I am glad my mom doesn't have a gravesite there that I would worry about. Is it being taken care of? Is it still there?

I am not concerned about what my wife does with my ashes. I love my life, and my wife and children. Hopefully someday I will have a grandchild or two as well. For them, I will only live on in memories and pictures - and a few videos too, of course.

But I don't need a place for them to come and visit. Life is for the living, so I want them to focus on being the best they can be and enjoying everything this beautiful world has to offer. I know that I am.

So, my wife knows she can make the decision on where my ashes will be spread. But I have it in writing what will happen to my beloved guitars. I can't leave that to chance.

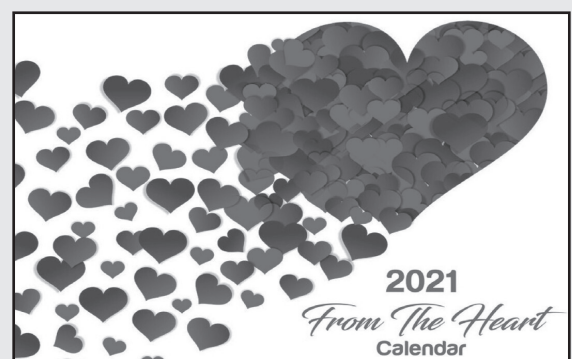
in for recycling.

Illinois is No. 1 in the production of pumpkins and No. 2 in the corn production. Theo included both on his license plate.

## Illinois, the Land of Lincoln

**OGLE COUNTY** — Abraham Lincoln's birthday was Feb. 12, making February a great month to learn about Illinois. Due to its location, climate, and soil Illinois is ideal for agriculture. Students throughout Ogle and Carroll counties took a closer look at the Land of Lincoln. Younger elementary students learned about many of Illinois' state symbols including: big bluestem, cardinal, bluegill, monarch butterfly, white oak tree, purple violet, white tail deer, and popcorn. They discovered

that Illinois grows more pumpkins and soybeans than any other state. In corn production Illinois is only 2nd to Iowa. They used this information to make their designer license plates.

After looking at Illinois' topography and its role in agriculture, older elementary students made relief maps. They discovered the hills in Jo Daviess and Carroll counties are a great place to raise beef cattle whereas the flat lands in the middle part of the state is ideal for corn and soybeans. Using clay they

made a 3D map of Illinois complete with a title, compass, and map key. They included major waterways such as the Illinois and Mississippi Rivers that are used to transport crops grown in Illinois.

These programs and activities were provided by Ag in the Classroom. Ag in the Classroom is offered through the University of Illinois Extension in partnership with Ogle County Farm Bureau, Carroll County Farm Bureau, Ogle County Soil & Water, and Carroll County Soil & Water.

## Local driver named 'Highway Angel'

ALEXANDRIA, Va. – The Truckload Carriers Association has named John Vesey, of Oregon, a Highway Angel for stopping to help a fellow driver who lost control of his truck during a fire and drove off the road into a corn field.

Vesey was westbound on U.S. 34, near Galesburg on his way to Monmouth to pick up a load. It was late in the morning when another truck driver passed him in the left lane of the 4-lane divided highway.

“As he got out about a quarter-mile ahead of me, he started to lose control,” Vesey said. “He went into the center median and then careened over to right side, went off in the ditch, and into a corn field.”

Vesey slowed down right away and pulled over.

“Once he got to the corn field, the driver jumped out of the truck while it was still moving,” Vesey said.

“I could see a flash of smoke and fire coming out of the cab.”

He grabbed a fire extinguisher and ran across the field. Vesey continued running toward the truck and emptied his fire extinguisher into the cab.

“I then went back to driver to see if he was alright,” he said. “He ended up having second-degree burns on his hands and his hair was singed on the back.”

Vesey then called 911. He went back and unloaded the driver’s fire extinguisher as well to be sure everything was okay. The fire was contained to the center console area. As Vesey helped the truck driver back across the field to the road, police, fire, and ambulance crews were arriving.

“Another vehicle (driver) across the highway came over to help as well. The whole thing

was maybe 10 minutes from start to finish,” he said, “pretty good for a rural community.”

Vesey is trained as a paramedic and has a lot of emergency response experience and training. I interned and spent the first year as a paramedic and EMT in Chicago and got my paramedic license. It was an awesome experience,” he said. “I spent a year on the private ambulance side and then moved up to NW Illinois and was a paramedic there.”

He was also an Eagle Scout and is a Navy veteran.

He’s been driving for 8 years and also has office experience. “I choose to be on the road,” he said. “You get a little bit of the road in you and you gotta scratch that itch. I love driving.”

Since the program’s inception in August 1997, nearly 1,300 professional truck drivers have been recognized as Highway Angels for the exemplary kindness, courtesy, and courage they have displayed while on the job.

## Inheritance funds Illinois conservation science

FRANKLIN GROVE – Upon learning of his unexpected inheritance, Keith Anderson of DeKalb County knew he wanted it to go to work in a way that honored his parents and helped the native plants and animals that Anderson cared for through volunteering at Nachusa Grasslands, a 4,000-acre prairie, woodland, and wetland preserve in Lee and Ogle counties.

“I wanted to honor my parents and the values that they knowingly or unknowingly passed on to me,” Anderson said.

Named for his parents, the Robert and Patricia Anderson Grant will permanently fund an annual science grant and grantee at Nachusa Grasslands. Science grants are raised and administered by the Friends of Nachusa Grasslands (“Friends”), the not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing for the long-term care and management of the preserve.

Anderson described his father as someone who worked hard at a leading pharmaceutical company for 37 years.

“Dad was a successful project manager who oversaw the construction of new office and manufacturing facilities in the United States and Puerto Rico for Abbott Labs,” he said. “He lived very humbly and wasn’t interested in the trappings of success.”

His mother was an avid gardener, loved house plants, and owned a retail plant shop in Mt. Prospect for a short time. Anderson relates that as a teenager, he spent many hours with his mother at wholesale greenhouses helping to purchase inventory for her shop.

“Between her houseplants

and time at the greenhouses, I think the seed was laid for my interest in the plant world.”

Anderson also credits his love of nature to the menagerie of pets they had as he was growing up, and his many happy hours spent playing in a field behind their house.

“My siblings and I spent a lot of time chasing butterflies, grasshoppers, lightning bugs at night, and the occasional snake, in that field,” he said. “I was particularly fascinated by ants and can remember spending countless hours observing them.”

Anderson also recalled that his Dad “planted a pin oak in the backyard of our house when we were kids. He spent untold amounts of time nurturing that oak, he was very protective of it.” Anderson’s father lived in that same house until he passed in December, and Anderson states that to this day, “that pin oak is the most beautiful tree, straight as an arrow and providing lots of shade.”

# Celebrating seniors

Hubs bounce back from LaSalle-Peru loss, defeat Kaneland on Senior Night

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity bowling team sent its four seniors off with a victory Thursday evening, when the boys took down the Kaneland Knights 2,737-2,309 and snapped a four-match losing streak. The Hubs (2-6) will face Kaneland on the road next week before competing at the Interstate 8 Conference Championship on Saturday, March 13. Seniors Reese Kirk, Keith Holland, Shane Sedlock and Leo Hernandez were recognized before the match.

“It was nice to get a win for our seniors,” head coach Jim Lyles said. “We have had a lot of bowlers score conference points this season and it’s awesome. I think all six of our varsity bowlers have scored points this season and I don’t think we had more than two score points last season. The kids are throwing the ball a lot better and they’re really listening.”

Kirk led all Rochelle bowlers with a 565 series on Thursday, while Kaneland’s Corbin Vines

finished four pins behind with 561. Rochelle won the first game 968-772 behind Kirk’s 197 and Holland’s 176. The Hubs extended their lead with an 854-737 victory in the second game.

Leading the Knights by over 300 pins, Rochelle cruised over Kaneland 915-800 in the third game to complete the conference sweep. Kirk rolled a series-best 204 for the Hubs in the final game.

**LaSalle-Peru**

The Rochelle Hub varsity bowling team fell 3,294-2,913 against LaSalle-Peru on Wednesday to move to 1-6 overall. Sophomore Evin Odle led Rochelle with a 533 series, while junior Devansh Patel added 516.

The Cavaliers defeated Rochelle 1,083-1,010 behind 225 from Landen Miller and 206 from Chance Hank. Patel fired 199 for the Hubs, while senior Reese Kirk rolled 198. LaSalle-Peru took the second game 1,029-913 despite Odle shooting a series-best 200 for the Hubs.

LaSalle-Peru finished strong to complete the sweep, downing Rochelle

# Hub offense stifled in home loss to Kaneland

## Rochelle senior Burdin eclipses 1,000 points as Knights prevail 66-45

**ROCHELLE** — The Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team had a hard time finding any offensive rhythm during Interstate 8 Conference action against the Kaneland Knights on Wednesday.

The Knights pressured Rochelle’s ball handlers on the perimeter all night, forcing numerous turnovers and cutting off any driving lanes to the basket. Behind senior Jamari Meeks, who scored a game-high 21 points and spearheaded Kaneland’s defensive effort, the Knights coasted over the Hubs 66-45. Rochelle fell to 4-6 overall and 4-5 in the conference. Hub senior Garrett Burdin totaled 11 points, eclipsing the 1,000-point mark for his high school career.

“It’s always exciting when our players score over 1,000 points,” head coach Tim Thompson said. “He’s on the verge of 200 3-pointers for his career and he’s always had a scorer’s mentality... He’s been a good leader for our team this season and he’s shot the

ball well for the most part.”

Rochelle held an early 6-2 lead in the first quarter before Kaneland took over with its defensive tenacity, holding the Hubs to only four points over nearly eight minutes of play. Meeks converted seven of his eight field goals in the first half, many of them layups, igniting a 31-4 Kaneland run over the first two quarters that pushed the Knights up 35-16 at the half.

“We’ve talked about how hard Kaneland defends,” Thompson said. “They’re great at pressuring the ball and we had a hard time getting around them. They’re also great at defending the passing lanes and it was difficult for us to get into any offense. Our kryptonite right now is that we struggle with our guard play when teams play us tightly and don’t let us run offense. Kaneland wouldn’t let us get into transition and they guarded us really well tonight.”

Junior Noah Brown created a shooting spark for the Hubs in the third quarter, knocking down three triples for nine of his team-high 13

points. Rochelle attempted to get back into the game with its full-court pressure defense, but Kaneland countered with a steady dose of 6-foot-5 center David Kolev, who made four shots under the basket in the second half and hit a pair of free throws for 10 of his 20 points. The Hubs will play at Sandwich on Friday, March 5 at 7 p.m.

“Kolev was mopping things up around the rim all night,” Thompson said. “He used his physicality really well. We did everything we could defensively to get back into the game, but Kaneland was too disciplined with the ball... I told the kids after the game that we struggle when teams pressure us and we’re struggling when we can’t get in transition.”

**LaSalle-Peru**

The Rochelle Hub varsity basketball team saw its slim first-half lead vanish almost immediately during the third quarter of its Interstate 8 Conference rematch with LaSalle-Peru.

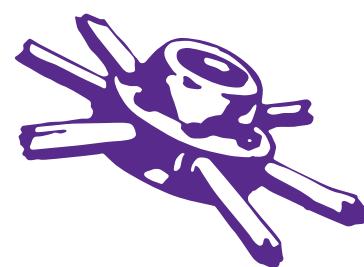

Rochelle has had trouble holding third-quarter leads this season, and the Hubs struggled to match the Cavaliers in the third quarter on Monday. Behind senior Drake Weber, who scored a game-high 33 points on 10-of-20 shooting and 12-of-25 shooting from the free-throw line, LaSalle-Peru took control in the third quarter, outscoring Rochelle 26-11 and ultimately coasting over the Hubs 73-63. Rochelle fell to 4-5 overall and 4-4 in the conference.

“Weber started getting into the lane during the second half and we started getting bogged down by foul trouble,” coach Jared Johnson said. “They kept getting to the line and they really slowed the game down on us... We need to understand that teams make

adjustments before the second half and we talk about making adjustments, but we sometimes don’t anticipate those adjustments that other teams make. It’s something we have to get fixed for next year.”

While it was a tough shooting night for the Hubs, who finished under 35 percent from the field, Rochelle bounced back from a six-point first-quarter deficit, scoring 28 second-quarter points to take a 36-33 lead at the half. The Hub defense forced 16 LaSalle-Peru turnovers, which led to 16 Rochelle points in transition. Although Rochelle had eight steals in the game, the Hubs committed a staggering 21 fouls, while the disciplined Cavaliers totaled only six fouls.

“We missed a lot of open shots,” Johnson said. “We missed nearly all of our outside shots in the first

quarter, which are shots we normally make, but we really got going in the second quarter. We have to be able to knock down shots, and when we’re not making those shots, we have to be able to get to the rim, which is an area we’re still struggling right now.”

Senior Garrett Burdin led Rochelle with a double-double in the loss, scoring 23 points and adding 12 rebounds. Juniors Ryan Simmons and Zach Sanford combined for 20 points and 13 rebounds in the game. Junior Noah Brown had eight points and junior Adam Kemp totaled six assists and nine rebounds for the Hubs.

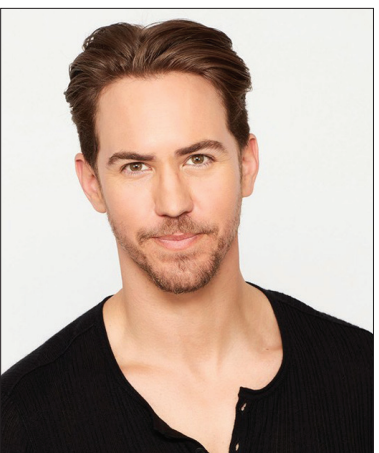
