Volunteers got it done

Hundreds were vaccinated, but the event nearly didn't happen

ROCHELLE — It's one of the reasons living in a small community has its perks. It's the people — only people can step up and get things done when it seems the odds are against them.

That's what happened Wednesday in the "Hub City" at the United Methodist Church where several hundred people were signed up to get the vaccine for the COVID virus. But the vaccine didn't show up as planned. It was an event spearheaded by Rosie Arteaga; how-

Fire breaks out in living room

ROCHELLE — A resident in a local apartment building escaped serious injury Wednesday evening after a fire started in her living room.

Fire officials were called to 101 Seventh Ave. just after 5 p.m. where they found smoke coming from the building and the resident hanging from an east window. Fire Chief Dave Sawlsville and another resident helped pull her to safety. She was taken to the hospital for smoke

ever, she's quick to point out it was the everyone else, all the volunteers, who made it happen, including the Illinois Migrant Council and the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) of Rochelle, which included students and teachers.

Nevertheless, Arteaga

did a lot of legwork in a month's time to get the vaccine event to Rochelle. When she asked the Methodist Church if they could use their facility, they said yes immediately.

In short notice, she was required to get 300 people by Monday, or the event would be canceled, so she went to the churches

and businesses, including Rochelle Foods, and rounded up people to get the vaccine.

The plan was in place and all was good, people arrived on time at Hicks Hall at the church at 11 a.m. to get their shots.

But the vaccine hadn't arrived, so no shots. Noon went by and no vaccine. One o'clock, still no vaccine. By 3 p.m., though, they were in business as the vaccine arrived and inoculations started.

Arteaga is quick to point out the only reason the vaccine arrived at all is because of two people, Peg Feltes-Dordal and Fernando Molina, who came from Mendota. "I don't know what magic they did, but without

happened," Arteaga said.

She added that everyone was in high spirits despite the wait. And the good part was that those who showed up on time filled out all the necessary questionnaire and once the vaccine arrived it was smooth sailing. "It was all done manually, not on a computer, and it's similar to a form you'd get in the hospital or at the doctor's office," she explained.

Unfortunately, some had to leave because of work or other commitments, but anyone 65 or older or with disabilities didn't have to wait. Others filled out their forms and came back later.

The staff from Mendota worked diligently from the time they arrived until they departed at 9 p.m. One thing Arteaga learned at the last minute is that there has to be a medical doctor on the premise, so enter Rochelle's Dr. Pitamber Persaud who also happens to do work in Mendota.

exactly what the puzzle looked like, all the pieces seemed to fall into place.

"It could have been a disaster, it was very stressful ... but no one gave up," Arteaga said,

adding that the volunteers all stuck around to help.

In the end, 360 people received the vaccine. "Without the volunteers we had, it would not have happened."

inhalation.

The fire was unintentional and thus far it looks to have been caused by a cigarette. The bulk of the damage was contained to a reclining chair, carpet and a wall near the chair.

It was the only unit that suffered fire and smoke damage and the residents of the other 11 units were able to safely return to their homes around 6:30 p.m. after fire officials ventilated the building.

According to Rochelle Fire Department Lt. Zach Prewett, there was very little active fire when they arrived on the scene as the fire was at a point of smoldering.

They did use about 50 gallons of water to ensure the fire was extinguished.

The department was assisted by Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District crews from Creston, Flagg Center, Hillcrest and Steward as well as by the Rochelle Police Department.

Property damage was estimated at \$40,000 and damage to the apartment contents was estimated at \$5,000. The property is owned by Seldal Properties.

Forgery follow-up leads to more charges

FORT WORTH, Texas — David Fred Baker of Fort Worth, Texas, passed away peacefully at home on March 24, 2021 at the age of 69 after a 15-month battle with Glioblastoma.

He was born May 16, 1951 in Rochelle to the late Frederick "Buck" and Florence (Davey) Baker, a photo engraver and a homemaker, respectively. After high school, he attended Northern Illinois University and Kishwaukee College.

Dave was employed by Caron International in Rochelle as the dye house manager for many years before being hired for the manager trainee program in 1986 with Carnation, which was later bought by Nestle.

For 29 years, he worked in Logistics, holding the position of operations manager in Hamilton, New Jersey, then general manager in Fort Wayne, Indiana and Fort Worth, Texas.

Dave married Jennifer (Gruben) on June 20, 1981 in Rochelle. Through nearly 40 years, six homes and four states, they built their life together, aware of how richly God had blessed them.

Dave and Jennifer lived in Rochelle before relocating to Yardley, Pennsylvania, Fort Wayne, Indiana and Fort Worth, Texas, where they spent the last 23 years.

More than anything else, Dave excelled at being "Dad" and "Pops." He loved his children and grandchildren deeply. He was a protector of all those he loved and he generously and sacrificially showed that love in quiet ways.

His love of sports never faded throughout his life. He starred on the basketball and tennis teams in school and continued playing softball, basketball and golf for many years. He made many life-long friends, especially from his years of playing slow pitch softball.

Dave, Jennifer and their girls attended innumerable sporting events, at the high school, college or professional level, watching football, baseball, basketball and golf.

Dave enjoyed nature, hunting and being outdoors. He loved spending time on his hunting land near Bowie, Texas, even when he didn't bring home "the big one." He found peace in just watching the wildlife and being in solitude. He

never grew tired of learning new things related to both nature and history. He was especially interested in the history of the Civil War, WWII and the Vietnam era.

On many family vacations, he would be the one reading every sign at each stop, which included many battlefields and national parks.

His longtime dream of owning a Harley Davidson was realized in 2014. For the next five years, while upgrading

to bigger and nicer bikes suited for longer trips, he traveled on numerous rides with friends, living his dream.

Dogs held a special place in his heart and they all seemed to love him back. After retiring, Dave volunteered at Baylor Hospital in Grapevine as a hospital escort for the therapy dogs as well as in the emergency department. This led to another volunteer job —

dog sitting for therapy dogs when their trainers needed to go out of town.

Dave was a member of Crown of Life Lutheran Church since 1999, where he served many years as an usher, played in the hand bell choir and served on various community outreach missions.

Dave is survived by his wife, Jennifer; children, Amy (Kyle) Eklund of LeClaire, Iowa, Lisa (Justin) Peipert of Keller, Texas, and Krista (Michael) Dellavalle of Lewisville, Texas; his grandchildren, Nora Peipert, Janie Peipert, Chase Eklund, Milo Dellavalle, and Blair Dellavalle; sisters, Barb Manning of Rochelle, Brenda (Dave) Jones of Creston and Mary (Jeff) Butler of Monticello; 13 nieces and nephews; and numerous great-nieces and nephews.

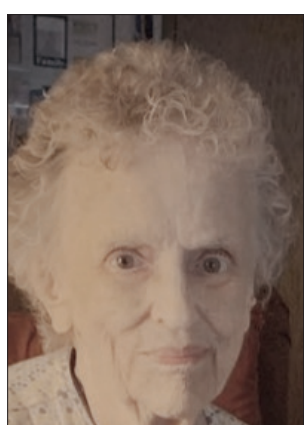

NOT ALWAYS BURIAL

In many parts of the world, burial is the most common form of final disposition - but it is not the only form. Many bodies are entombed, or placed in above-ground mausoleums. The procedures are similar to an earth burial, since the body is placed in a casket and is usually driven from the funeral ceremony in a procession. Entombment is the traditional form of final disposition in some areas. In New Orleans, for example, high water tables make ground burial impossible. Cremation is another form of final disposition that is gaining increasing acceptance in North America. However, this option is still not as popular here as in other parts of the world. The cremation

rate is roughly 15 percent in the U.S. and about 25 percent in Canada. By contrast, in European countries more than half of those who die are cremated. In some cultures, such as Japan, cremation is the most common form of final disposition.

Sheriff releases holiday results

OREGON — The Ogle County Sheriff's Office announced it made one DUI arrest and issued 93 total citations during the St. Patrick's Day enforcement period last week.

Escape the trap of the offense

IT seems these days that people are easily offended by opinions or ways of thinking that they disagree with or simply don't understand. The result is often strife and anger that causes strained or damaged relationships.

Some offenses are minor, like someone cutting you off in traffic or taking a parking spot you were waiting on. Others are harder to overcome, such as a rude, critical comment from a close friend.

We need to understand that offense is one of Satan's greatest tools to steal our peace and keep us from the good things God has planned for our lives.

The word "offense" comes from the Greek word scandalon; it literally describes a trap used to hold

bait in order to lure animals.

Similarly, offense is the bait the enemy uses to trap us. He uses people's words and actions to get our minds churning and stir up our emotions. This is the bait that leads to situations filled with bitterness, resentment, unforgiveness, hatred and revenge.

I often say that Satan sets us up to get us upset. He knows our weaknesses and what buttons to push to send us over the edge. The good news is, through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, we can know the truth of God's Word and refuse to take his bait.

In other words, when somebody tries to give you offense, you can decide whether to take it or not.

I understand that choosing to not be offended is not

easy, but we can refuse to be offended because God gives us self-control, which is a fruit of the Spirit (see Galatians 5:22-23). This means we can control ourselves with God's help and take responsibility for how we respond to life's situations.

It's easy to blame someone else for our attitude, thinking, If you didn't upset me, then I wouldn't feel this way or If you would just do this, then I would be happy.

But the truth is we will never be free from any problem as long as we're blaming somebody else. I'm not saying other people don't do anything wrong; however, we can't control what everyone else does, but we can choose

how we are going to react!

First Corinthians 13:5 says love "is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs" (NIV). Love is a choice. I can choose to forgive and let it go, or I can hold on to the offense and let the hurt turn into something even worse.

For example, sometimes an offense starts out like a paper cut. It's seemingly small, but if you don't take care of it properly, it can begin to fester. In time, it can become infected and cause you a lot of pain.

I can tell you from personal experience that it's so much better to take care of a problem when it's little, before it has an opportunity

to take root and turn into something more serious. I've learned that the quicker I can forgive somebody, the easier it's going to be. Sometimes this means being the first one to apologize and make peace—even if it's not my fault.

However, the more we do the right thing, the easier it gets. The quicker I forgive others and get rid of any offense, the more peace I have in my life. After a while, you realize that staying offended doesn't change other people or solve your problems—it only makes you bitter and angry.

I often say that staying mad at someone who has hurt you is like taking poison and hoping your enemy will die. You don't hurt them at all—you only hurt yourself!

Psalm 34:14 tells us to "seek peace and pursue it" (NIV). I've learned over the years (many times the hard way) just how valuable God's supernatural peace really is. Now, I absolutely refuse to live without it. It is so much greater than living with the toxic results of holding unforgiveness in my heart.

Opportunities to be offended will never go away, but we can grow wise to the enemy's tactics and learn how to respond in a godly way. So, the next time you are tempted to be offended, don't take the bait. Always remember that you have a choice. You can choose to be angry and bitter...or you can decide to forgive, believe the best of others, and enjoy God's supernatural peace.

I noticed in the voters' guide the county issued last week that across the county there are several board positions where no candidate filed.

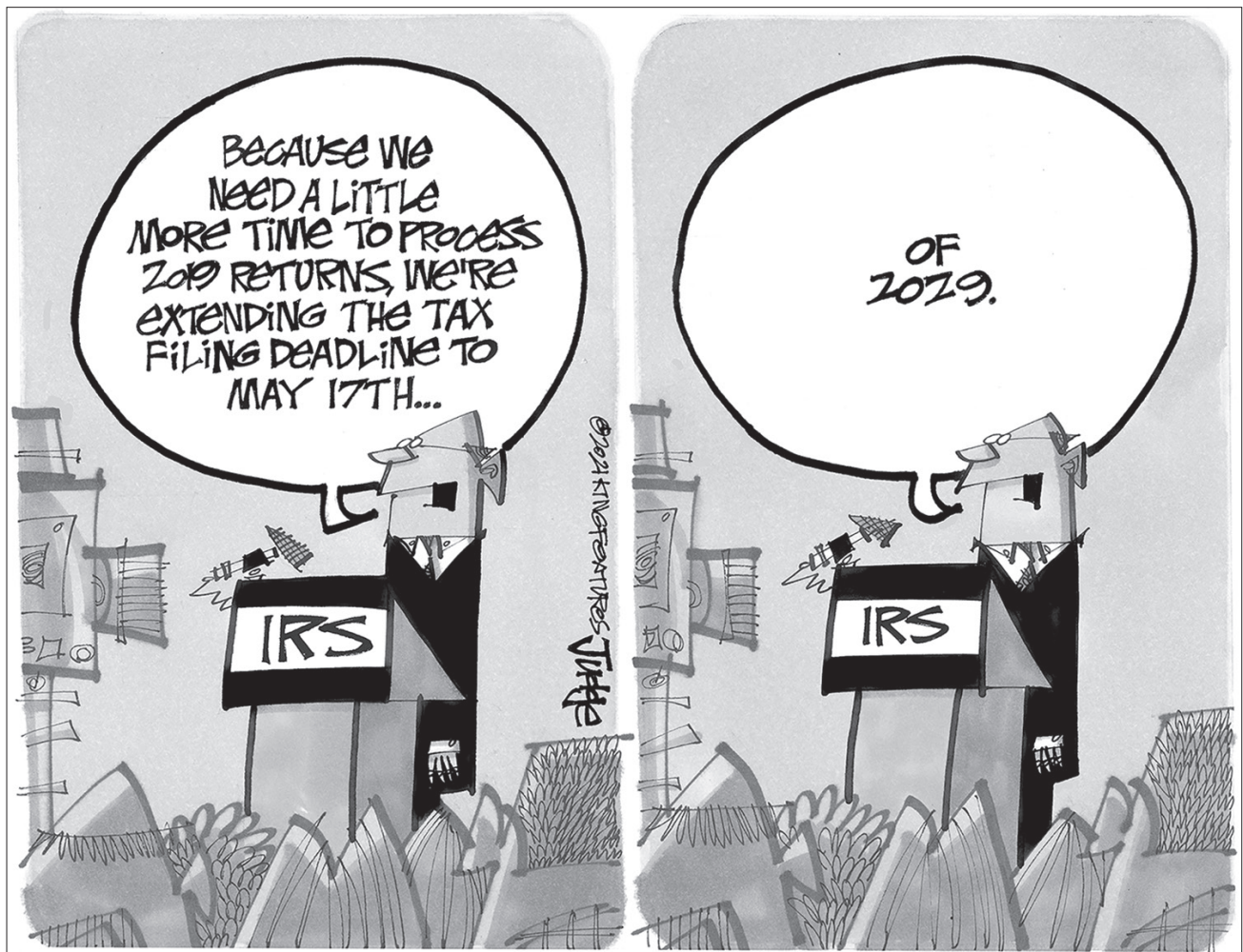
I have served on the park board and the library board and while serving on a board does take a lot of time, it is essential that people who care about their communities serve.

Illinois lawmakers missing the mark with small businesses

For far too long, Illinois lawmakers have neglected the Illinois business community.

They seem to have forgotten these local businesses make up the backbone of our state's economy. They are what bring our communities together and provide jobs for the hard-working people of our great state. Why, then, do our elected officials continue to pass anti-business legislation that burdens and adds extra costs to Illinois' job creators?

This is particularly perplexing given the current state of the economy and the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. It's no secret 2020 was unkind to businesses; so many of us had to shut our doors, unable to create any revenue for months. Now we are back and slowly picking up the pieces. However, as we do this, we're coming to terms with what it means to operate a business amid an ongoing pandemic. This includes the purchasing of safety equipment — masks, thermometers, etc. — that are now necessary to keep our customers and employees safe and healthy.

Many of us have had to reorganize floor plans, purchase and install dividers and Plexiglass to ensure proper distancing, and implement capacity limits. All this while we're doing everything we can to keep valued employees on our payroll.

What we need is support. But when we turned to our lawmakers for it, we were turned away. Rather than passing laws that would have helped us get back on our feet, Illinois lawmakers have instead tried relentlessly to pass laws that will only hurt us more by piling on additional requirements and costs that we can't handle.

Our lawmakers' anti-business tendencies picked up steam in 2019 when they began passing new tax and costly regulatory requirements on Illinois business owners. This included a significant, phased-in minimum wage increase now at \$11 an hour set to increase annually until it reaches \$15 an hour by 2025. At the same time, most of our neighboring states continue to honor the federal minimum wage

of \$7.25 an hour, making our labor costs wholly uncompetitive with our neighbors.

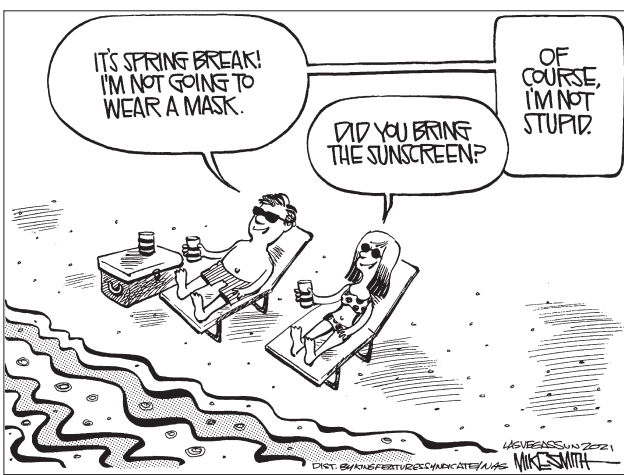
In early January, Gov. Pritzker attempted to decouple Illinois from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. Pritzker essentially wanted to take away the CARES Act's tax benefits intended to make up for the business community's losses and, instead, implement a massive tax hike on them. Pritzker ultimately failed in these efforts, although he has plans to revisit the issue. Had he succeeded, there is no telling how many more businesses would have vanished under his watch, and we must continue to urge legislators to oppose this.

The most recent example of our lawmakers' anti-business efforts came during that same lame-duck session in January when the Illinois General Assembly pushed through HB 3360 during the final days of the last session. There was no debate or discussion given the last-minute nature of it all, and the repercussions could be devastating.

Under HB 3360, litigation costs would soar for Illinois' hard-working business owners. If a trial attorney looking to line their pockets wants to sue us over a ridiculous claim, the litigation fees that would go into defending ourselves in the lawsuit would be enough to put us out of business for good.

If our lawmakers continue down this anti-business path, we will continue to lose precious local institutions that have served and employed our people for years. In 2021, I ask lawmakers to consider the consequences of their decisions, especially now as our businesses continue to deal with the devastation brought by the pandemic. Further, I urge them to consider the benefits that would result from more pro-business decisions, including a more stimulated economy and job creation. For everyone's sake, I hope they listen.

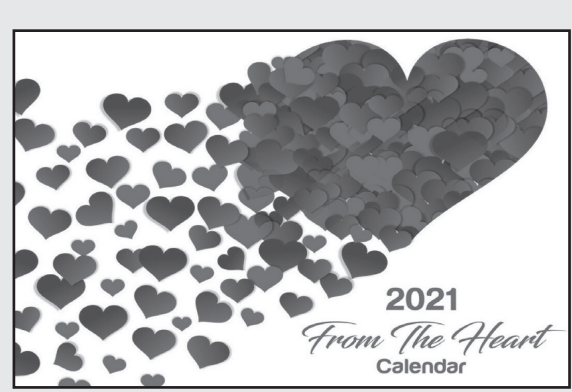

The church community has also assisted in coat drives and reading opportunities for children. Another resourceful relationship is when Kalnins

enlisted family and friends to support and teach students about agriculture and farming by creating a field trip to a local farm.

She actively supports her team to facilitate "Chana Cheer" opportunities, service learning, ranging from visiting a local nursing home or "paying it forward" activities by giving families in need baskets of food and supplies during the holidays.

Being creative

Another impressive network and learning experience she created and led was by partnering with the Educate Local Program of Northern Illinois University College of Education.

Students studying special education participated in Project TENT (Teams Exploring Nonfiction Together), NIU's most recent initiative in the college of education. The program provides teacher-licensure candidates with opportunities to gain experience and develop their perspec-

'Ride Smart' as the season kicks into high gear

"To keep everyone safe, we urge drivers and motorcyclists to share the road, be alert and to always ride sober. Motorcyclists are at an increased risk of injury or death when involved in a crash, so it is imperative that all riders 'Ride Smart' this riding season."

Motorcyclists need an M-Class endorsement and a valid driver's license

to legally ride in Illinois. Successful graduates of an IDOT training course (age 18 or over) are issued a completion card, waiving the M-Class testing requirement at an Illinois Secretary of State licensing facility.

To protect themselves, riders should always:

Wear personal protective gear on every ride, including high-visibility (Hi-Viz) clothing. Use eye protection, gloves, jackets, pants, boots and a U.S. DOT-approved helmet

Remember to "Don't Drink & Ride"

Illinois has offered free motorcycle training of all skill and experience levels since the Cycle Rider Safety Training Program began in 1976. The program is funded through license and registration fees. For more information, visit Start-SeeingMotorcycles.org.

"As more and more riders are getting ready for the season, we encourage riders to perform a thorough safety inspection on their motorcycle," said ISP Director Brendan F. Kelly.

Hubs on the board

Rochelle senior Walters nets deciding goal in 1-0 victory over LaSalle-Peru

LASALLE—Looking to break a scoreless tie during the second half of the Hub varsity soccer match against LaSalle-Peru on Wednesday, Rochelle senior Juan Cincire settled the ball outside the front of the Cavalier box and searched for an open teammate to score the first goal.

That teammate was senior midfielder Zane Walters, who handled Cincire’s pass inside the LaSalle-Peru box and booted a right-footed shot into the back of the net during the 52nd minute. The lone score was all Rochelle needed to win the match, defeating the Cavaliers 1-0 for the team’s first win of the season. The Hubs (1-2-1) will face Sycamore on the road Monday.

“We’re hoping that it’s the first of many wins for us,” Walters said. “We found a nice patch of the field to settle the ball on and they were slow defensively. I was able to make a touch around the defenders and the keeper was in no man’s land. We have most of our starters out at the moment

and we miss them a lot. I think we can win the conference with everyone back.”

Rochelle faced both LaSalle-Peru and the wind during the first half, but the Hub defense held strong behind a solid effort from junior captain Bryce Whitehead, who led Rochelle to its second shutout of the season after two tough matches against DeKalb and Kaneland. Sophomore Diego Cincire filled in for starting keeper Jarett Milan and earned his first shutout.

“Our communication was key today and we always want to make sure we’re the first to every ball,” Whitehead said. “The wind didn’t help us in the first half but we did our best to keep our shape. I think there are a lot of positives we can take from each of our games this season.”

With the wind in the second half, Rochelle had multiple cracks at the LaSalle-Peru net before Cincire and Walters connected for the first goal of the match. The Cavaliers had possession over the final minute of regulation, but the Hubs cleared several shots away from the team’s box.

Morris took the first set after a commanding start to the match. Rochelle fought back in the second set, leading the Redskins by two points before Morris tallied six consecutive points to help seal a 25-15, 25-20 victory over the Lady Hubs. Rochelle fell to 0-2 overall with the loss.

“I thought we looked better in the front row tonight,” coach Lindsay Suess said. “We had a lot of really good blocks... We made a lot of unfortunate mistakes in the first set and we had to take a deep breath and focus on what we can control on our side of the court. Our biggest adjustments will be keeping the ball in bounds and making better plays at the net.”

Morris took advantage of shaky serve-receives from Rochelle early in the

match, sparking an 8-1 run and forcing the Lady Hubs to use their first timeout. Rallying behind senior hitter Kennedy Dransfeldt, the Redskins continued to compile points, extending their lead to 18-8 and making Rochelle spend a second timeout.

Looking to bounce back, Rochelle started the second set strong, with senior defender Alexis Sanford notching two service aces for the Lady Hubs. Rochelle’s offense began picking up momentum in the second set as well, with senior setter Clare Green finding outside hitters Sylvia Hasz and Addie Friestad for a series of kill shots that helped the Lady Hubs build and maintain a slight lead over the Redskins.

Leading 19-17, Rochelle conceded six unanswered points, burning two timeouts during the 6-0 stretch. Morris scored two of the final three points in the match to seal the victory. Green led Rochelle with 10 assists and two blocks, while Hasz and Friestad each finished with five kills. Senior Afi Gati totaled two blocks and Hasz compiled a team-leading three aces.

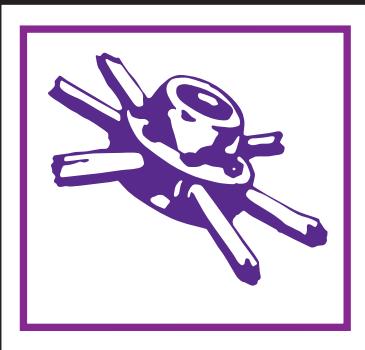

Neece leading the charge for Hub defense

WITH his team locked in a double-overtime battle against the Ottawa Pirates, Gabe Neece earned an opportunity to deliver one final victory for his senior teammates as the Rochelle Hub varsity football team looked to finish the 2019 season with an Interstate 8 Conference win.

Neece had already rushed for one touchdown during regulation, but the two-way standout was called on to carry the football in each of the team's overtime possessions. Neece successfully broke through the goal line on both drives, ending the game with a career-high three rushing touchdowns while adding four tackles as the Hubs outlasted the Pirates 40-34 on the road. It was the highlight of the season for Neece, who returns as a senior starter for Rochelle this year.

"I thought I proved myself toward the end of last season," Neece said. "My favorite moment definitely was the last game of the year. I've definitely improved the most in trusting myself. I used to be very hesitant in making decisions, but not anymore. I want to continue working on the mental side of the game. I'm going to play the best football I can to help my team win."

Neece started at inside linebacker for the Hubs during their season-opener against Morris this past Saturday, totaling a team-high nine tackles despite the loss. The senior also recorded a second-half interception that preceded teammate Ben Harvey's rushing touchdown late in the fourth quarter. After nearly 18 months off the field, Neece feels confident in his abilities.

"I thought I played pretty well considering we hadn't played a football game in almost 500 days," Neece said. "I was happy with my performance overall. I think my role this season will be the same as my teammates in that everyone has a job to do in order for our team to succeed."

A four-year member of the RTHS football team, Neece has been involved

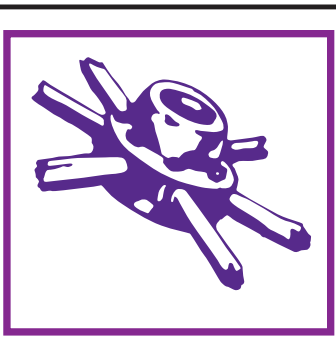

Hasz nets eight kills, five digs as Rochelle takes 16-25, 19-25 loss

OTTAWA — The Rochelle Lady Hub varsity volleyball team faced Ottawa on the road Thursday evening looking to avoid suffering a third straight loss to open the 2020-21 season.

Rochelle fell behind early in the match, with



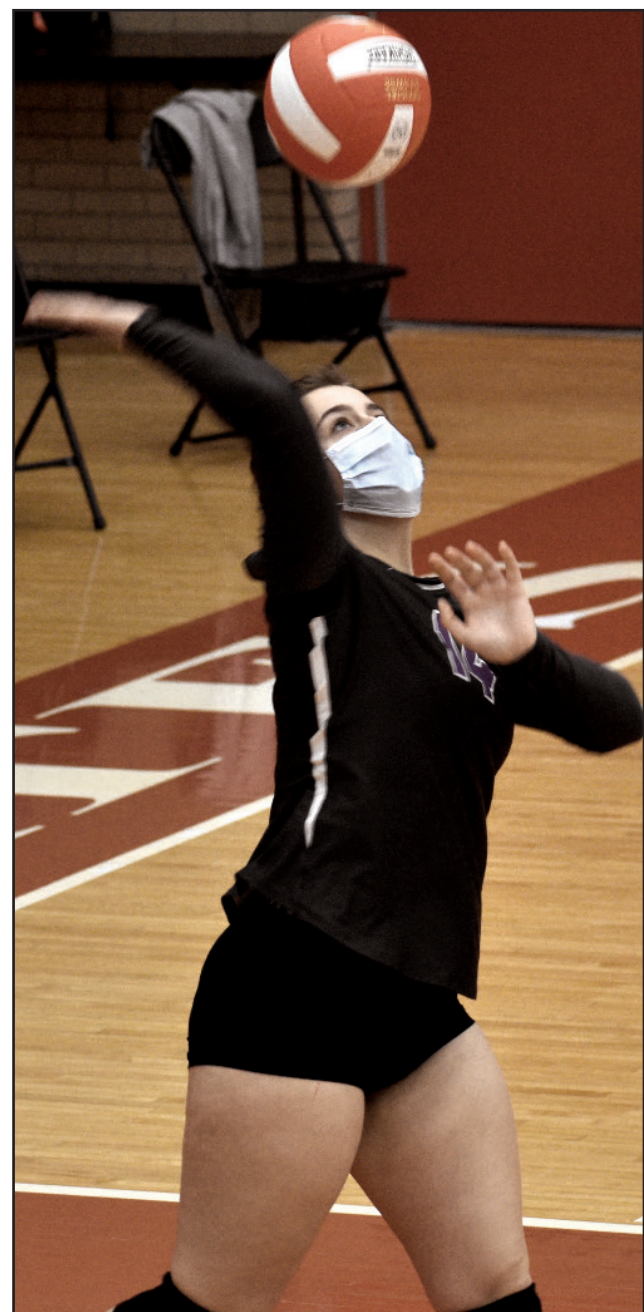

Ottawa leading 9-3 and forcing the Lady Hubs to call a timeout during the first set. With senior libero Ellie Kinn on the serve, Rochelle bounced back with a 7-4 run to bring the Pirates within three points and make Ottawa use a

Huskies kick off 2021 spring practice schedule

Spring Showcase set for Saturday, April 10 at Huskie Stadium

DEKALB — The Northern Illinois University Huskies held the first of 15 2021 spring football practices Friday morning as head coach Thomas Hammock and his staff put the spring roster of 81 players, including 72 returnees and nine newcomers, through their paces at the Kenneth and Ellen Chessick Practice Center.

NIU returns 19 starters on offense and defense from a year ago, with 47 players on the roster who saw action in at least three games. NIU was one of the youngest teams in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) a year ago.

“It’s been a treat to go through a full offseason,” Hammock said. “We’ve seen guys make tremendous strides in the weight room, in football IQ, from an athletic standpoint. We’re certainly excited about the spring. It’s going to be a very physical, very intense spring on both sides of the ball.”

One of the most-watched position battles will be at quarterback where Michigan State transfer Rocky Lombardi, 2020 freshman Dustin Fletcher, returnee Rodney Thompson and freshman newcomer Ethan Hampton have all impressed Hammock.

“I think we have four guys we feel really good about at quarterback,” Hammock said. “This spring is going to be a great evaluation time for us. Nothing was guaranteed to Rocky [when he transferred to NIU], and he understands that. What he’s done every day is earn the respect of his teammates

by the way he works. The young guy, Ethan Hampton, has shown that he’s not going to take a back seat to anybody. We have four guys that are going to compete.”

Hammock expects competition at every position throughout the spring, while becoming a more potent offense will be a point of emphasis.

“Offensively, we have to become a much more explosive and dynamic unit and score more points,” Hammock said. “That’s going to be a heavy point of emphasis. We have to

create big plays. As an offensive team, it starts up front. Defensively, we have to tackle, we have to take the ball away and give our offense more opportunities to score more points. This spring, we’re going to take the gloves off and go after it every day, and I’m excited to watch these guys compete.”

With every player earning a “do-over” after the 2020 season was cut short due to COVID-19, the roster includes 18 players who return as first-year freshmen with a season, as well as six seniors who

took advantage of the opportunity to play another year of college football. Linebacker Kyle Pugh is back for his seventh season as a Huskie as he had earned a sixth-year of eligibility in 2020 after injuries limited his playing time earlier in his career. Also returning are multi-year starters Lance Deveaux Jr. (LB) and Brayden Patton (OL) as well as All-MAC performers Tyrice Richie (WR) and Matt Ference (P).

NIU will practice weekdays from 7-8:30 a.m. and Saturdays at 11 a.m. with

the workouts on April 3, 10 and 17 open to the public. On April 10, fans are invited to Huskie Stadium for the 2021 NIU Football Spring Showcase. The Showcase will provide an opportunity to see the team scrimmage, an emcee will be on the field to provide commentary and conduct on-field interviews with special guests during the practice, and there will be a player skills competition. Following practice, Hammock will address the crowd. More details on the 2021 NIU Spring Showcase will be available

in April.

Capacity at Huskie Stadium has been raised to 25 percent under the latest guidelines from the state of Illinois and local health officials. During the open practices, fans will be able to watch from the West Stands of Huskie Stadium (no field access) with masks and social distancing required.

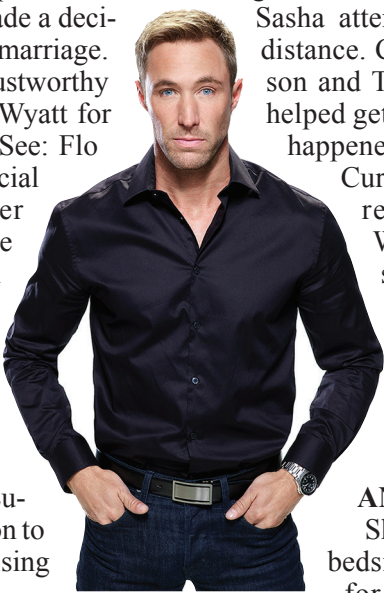
